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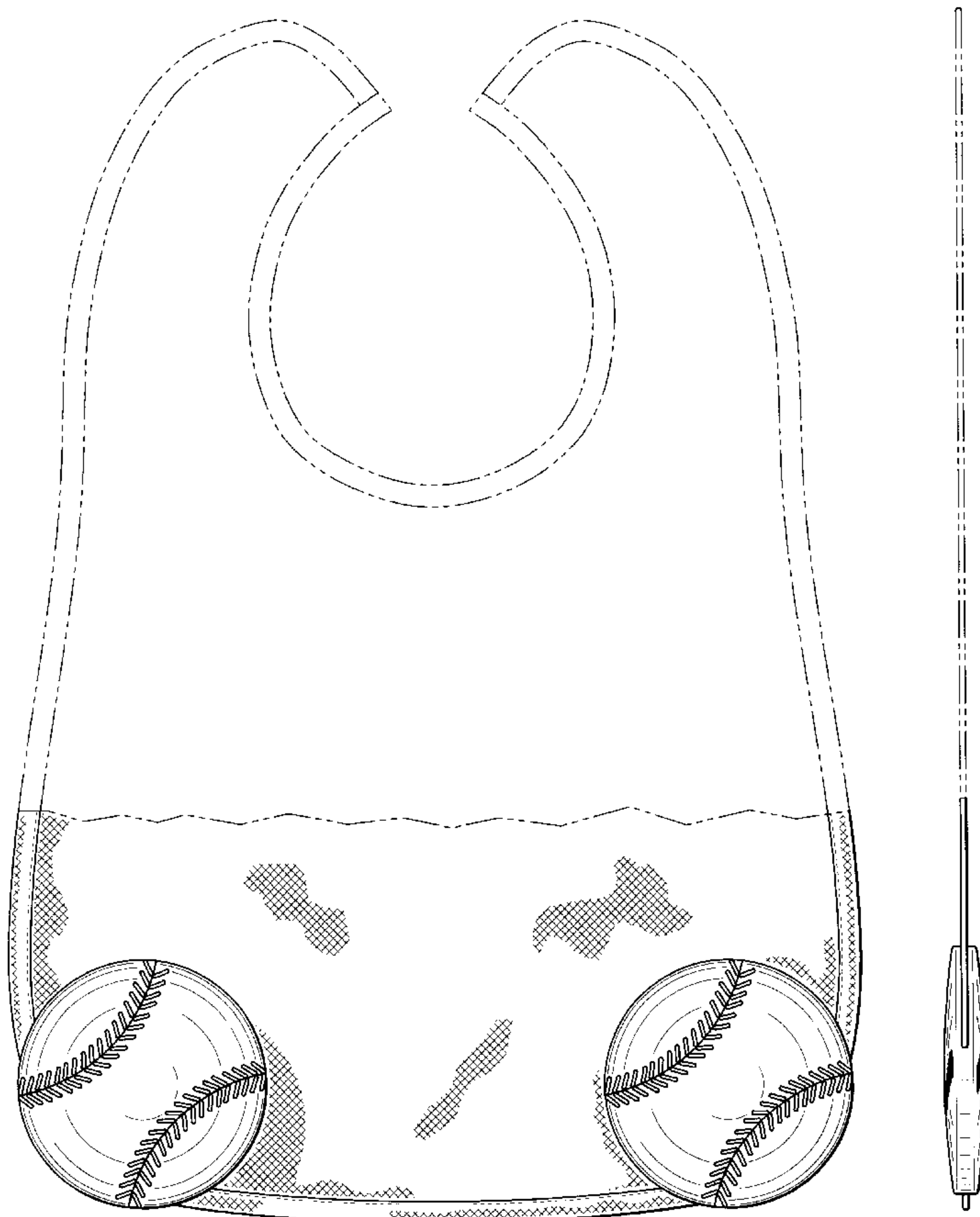
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a fragmentary front elevational view of a teether bib, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a fragmentary top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a fragmentary side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary side elevational view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 4; and,
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary rear elevational view thereof.

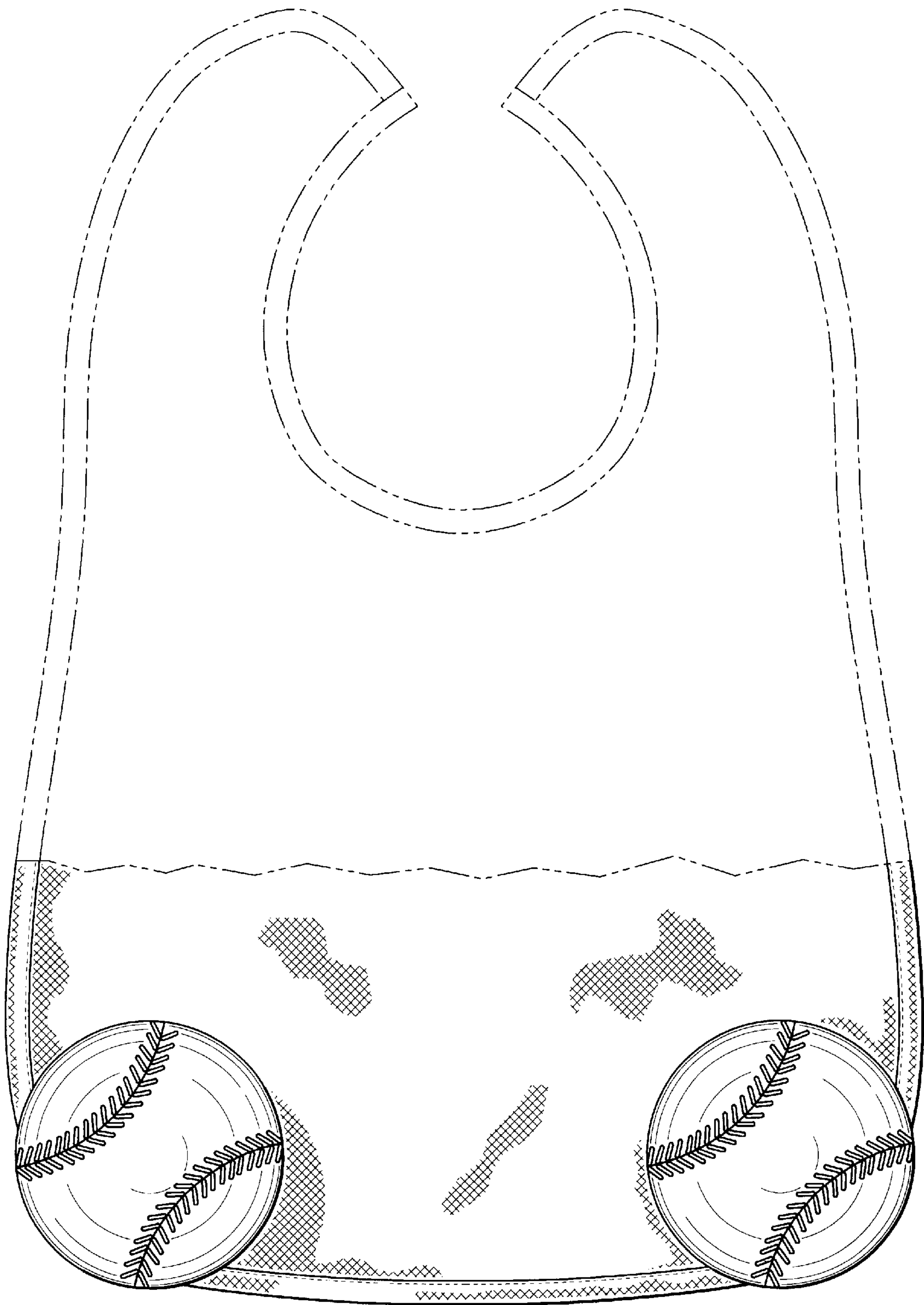

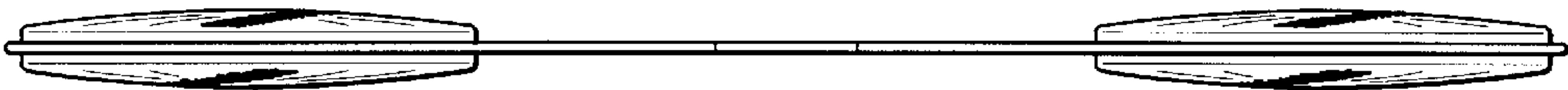

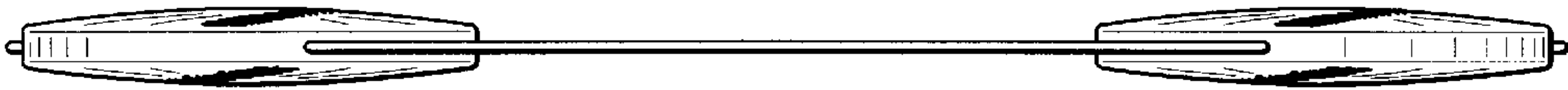

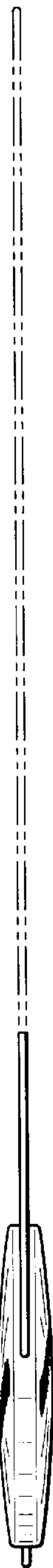

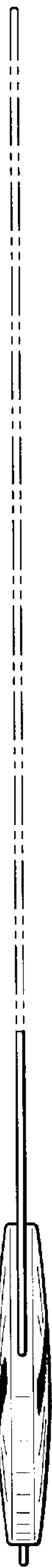

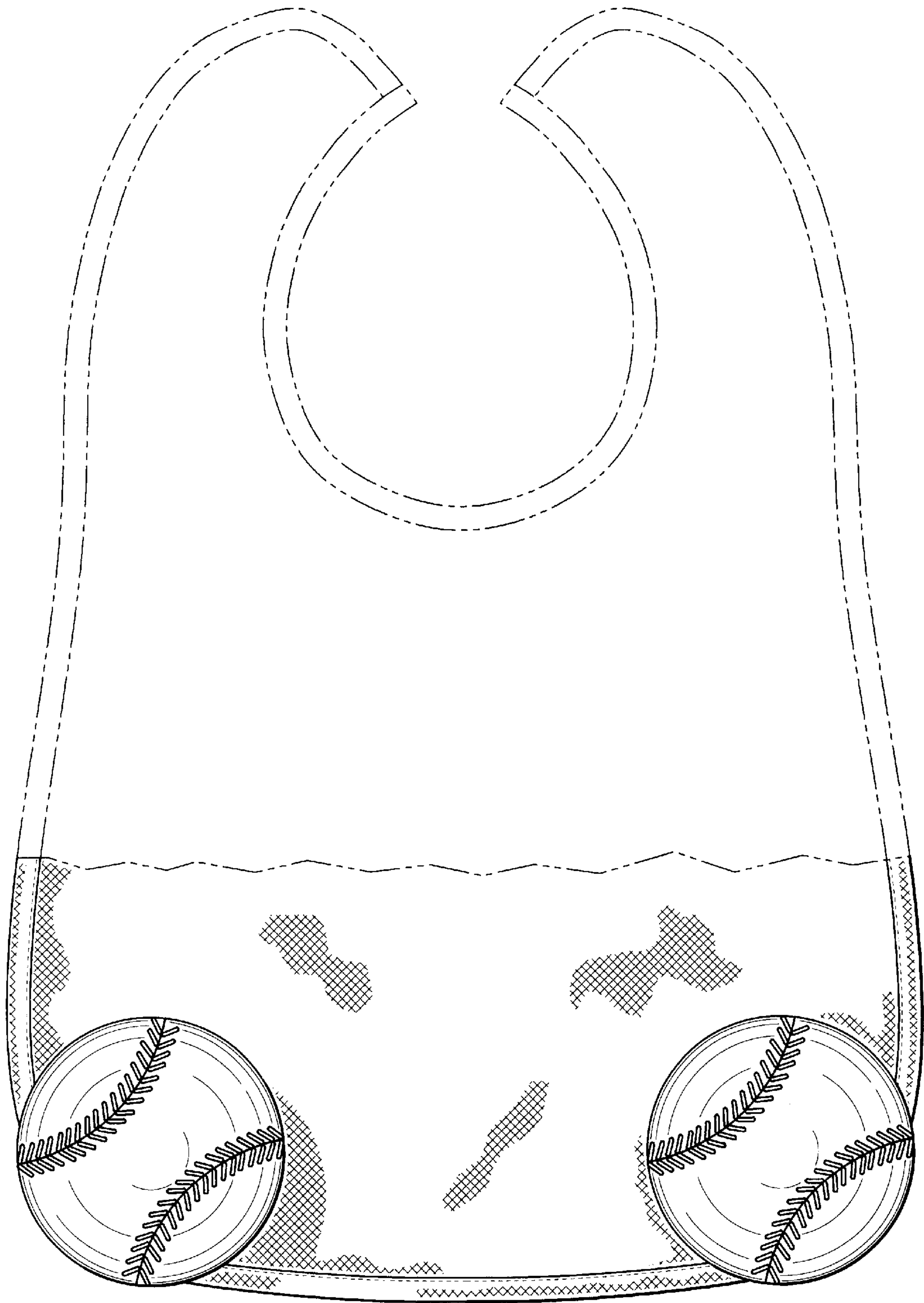
