**DESCRIPTION**

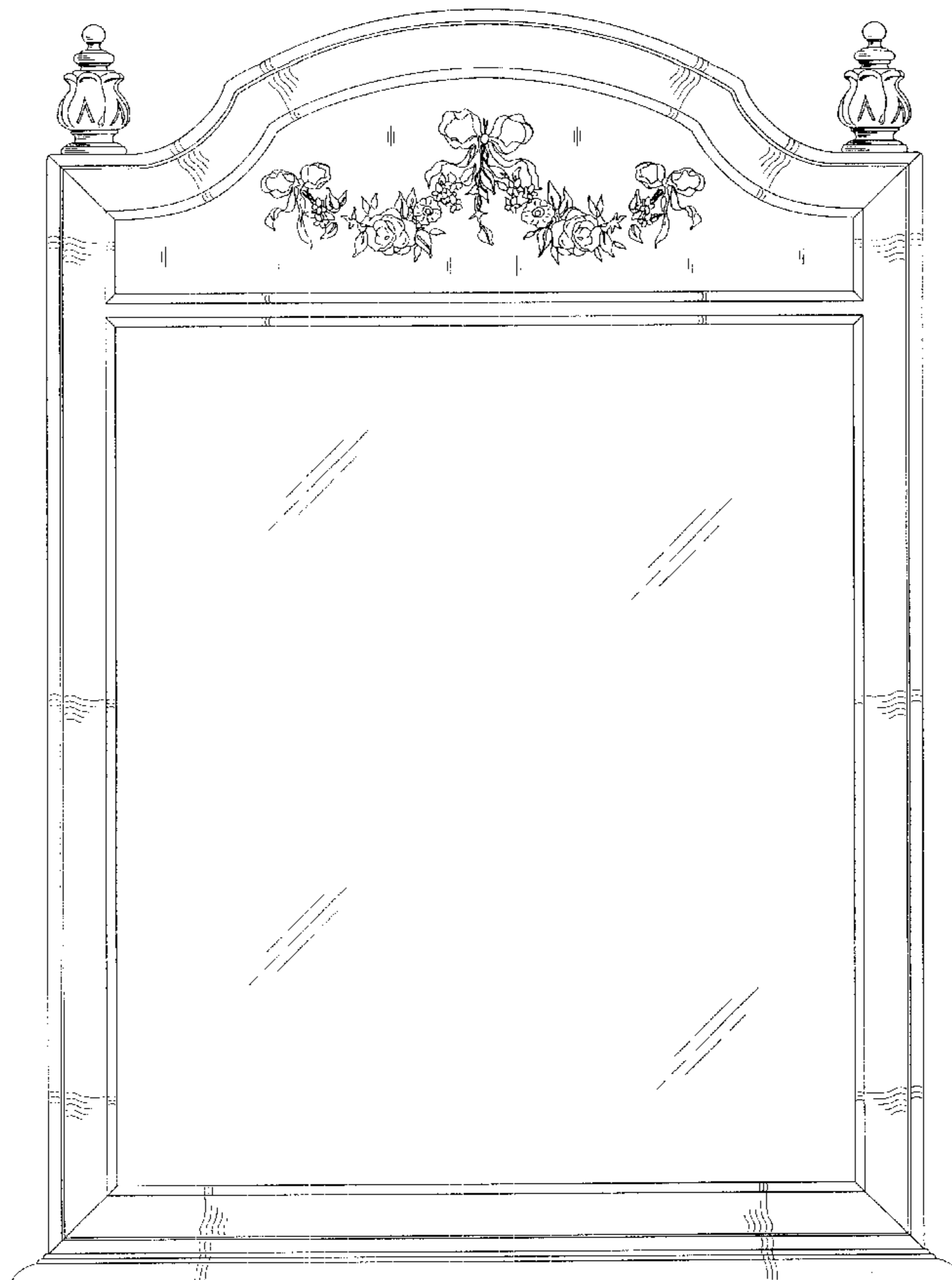
FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a mirror showing our new design;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged front view of the centerportion of FIG. 1, illustrating floral and bow ornamentation; and,

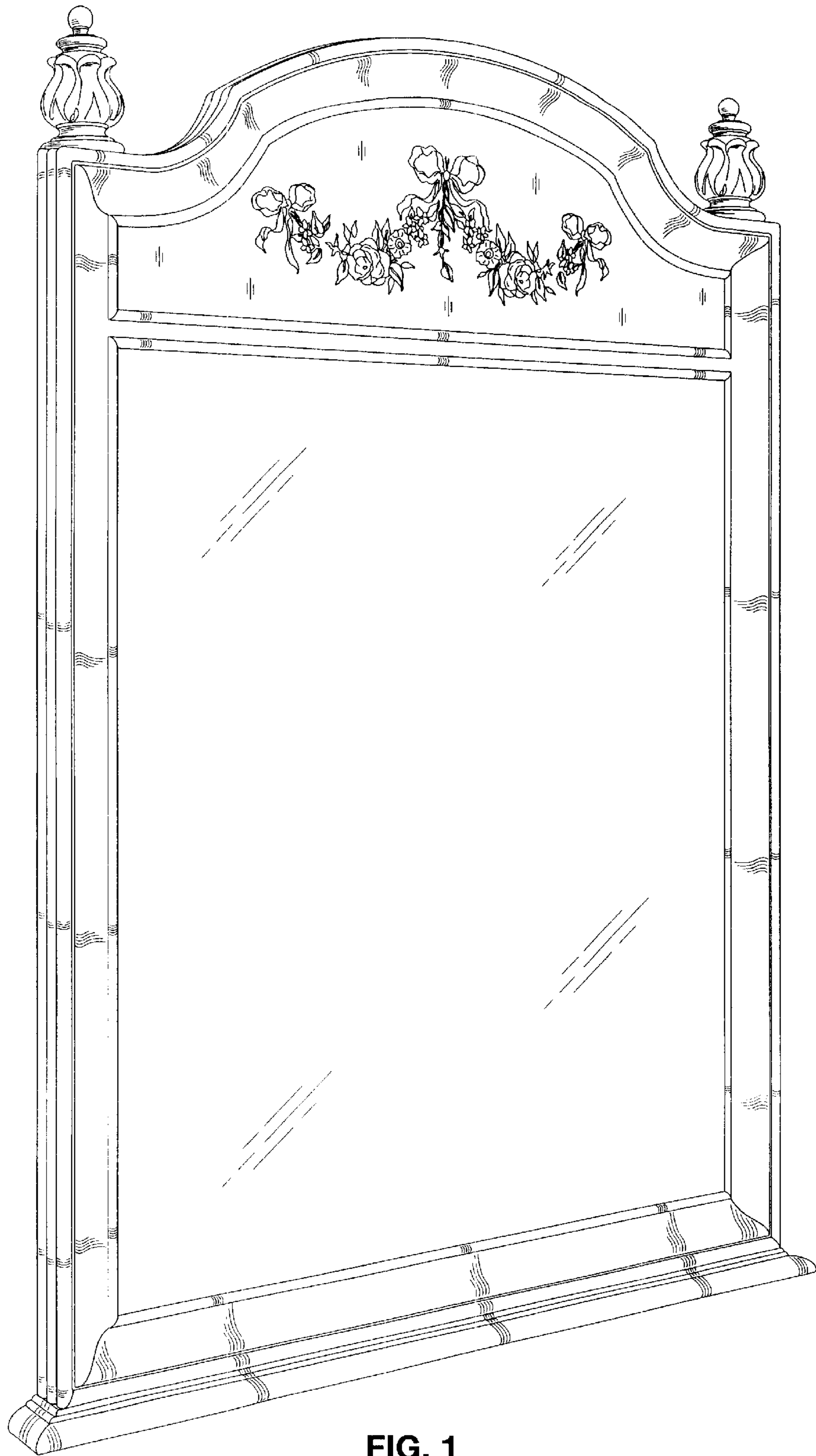

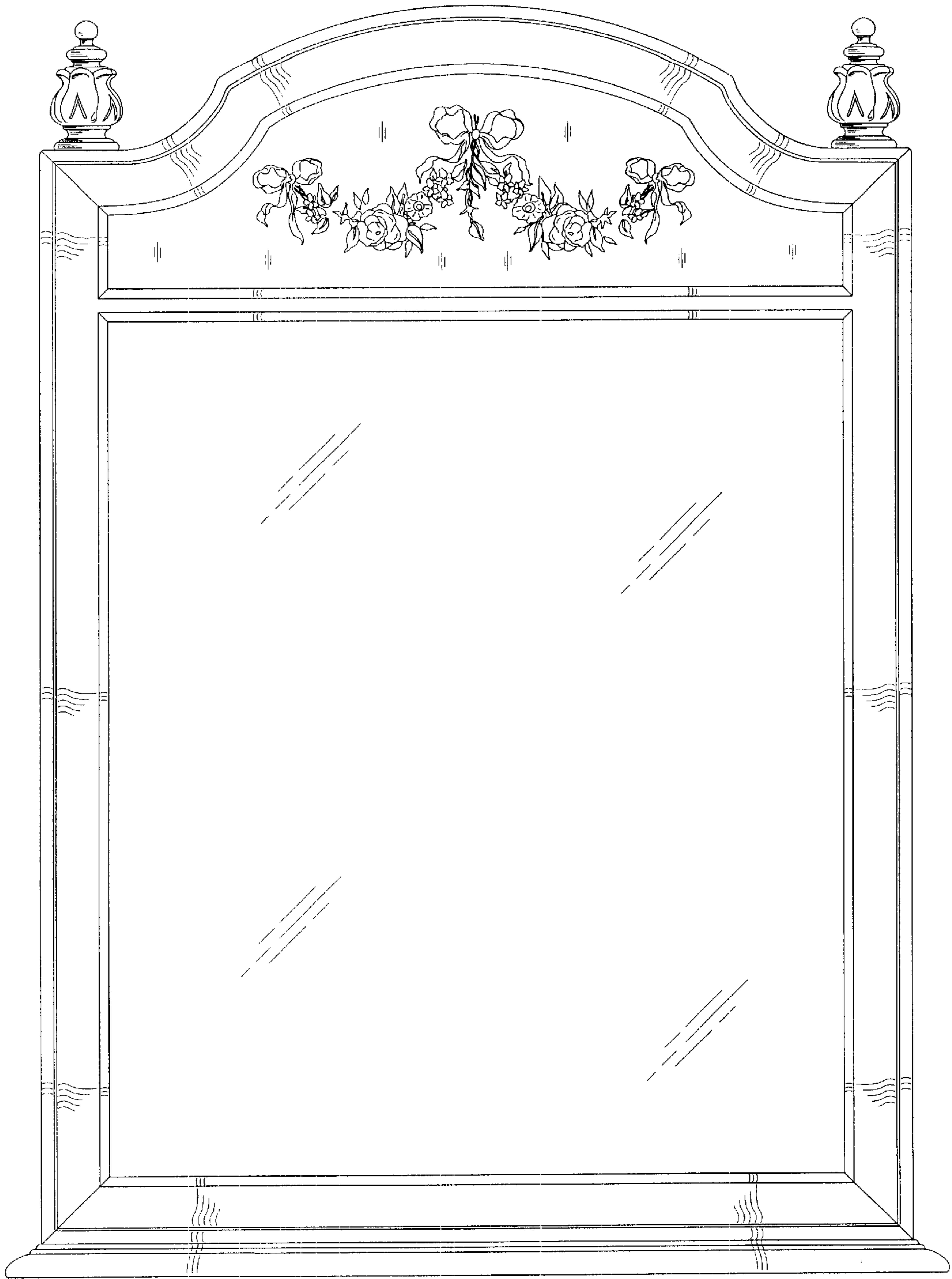
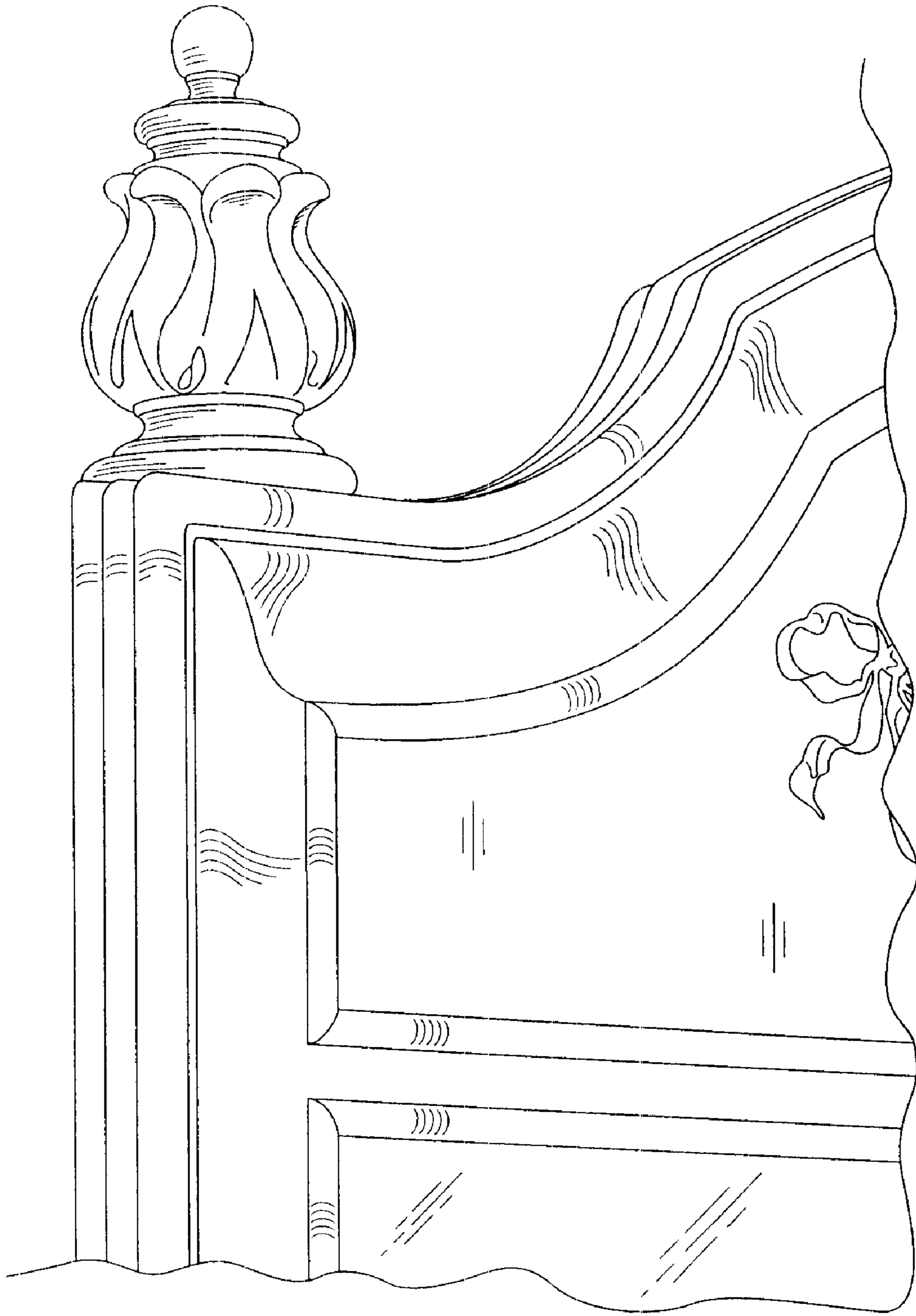
