(57) **CLAIM**

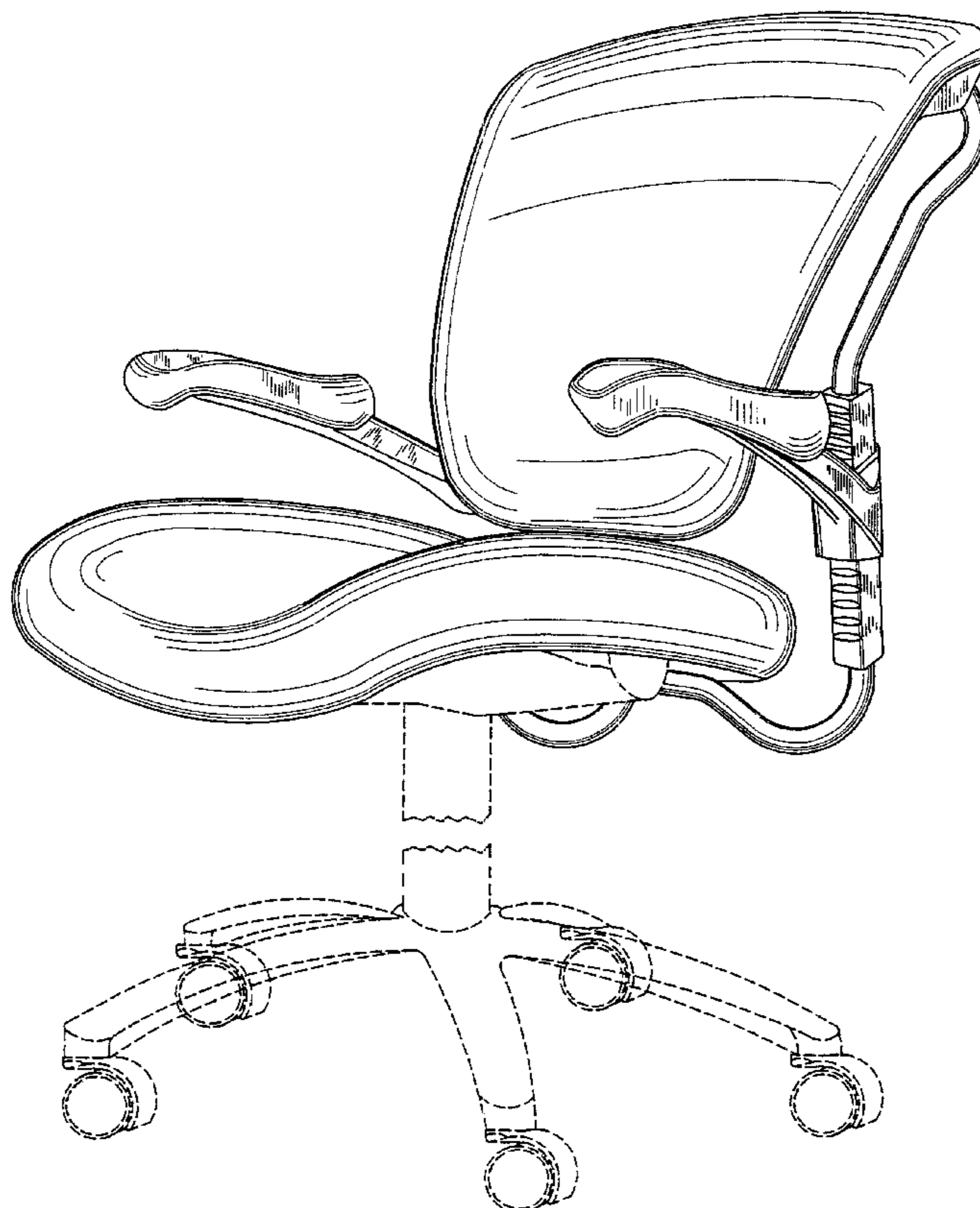
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of a chair of this invention; FIG. 2 is a perspective rear view of the chair of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 3 is a side view of the chair of FIG. 1.

The broken line showings of the chair pedestal are solely for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure, and form no part of the inventive design.

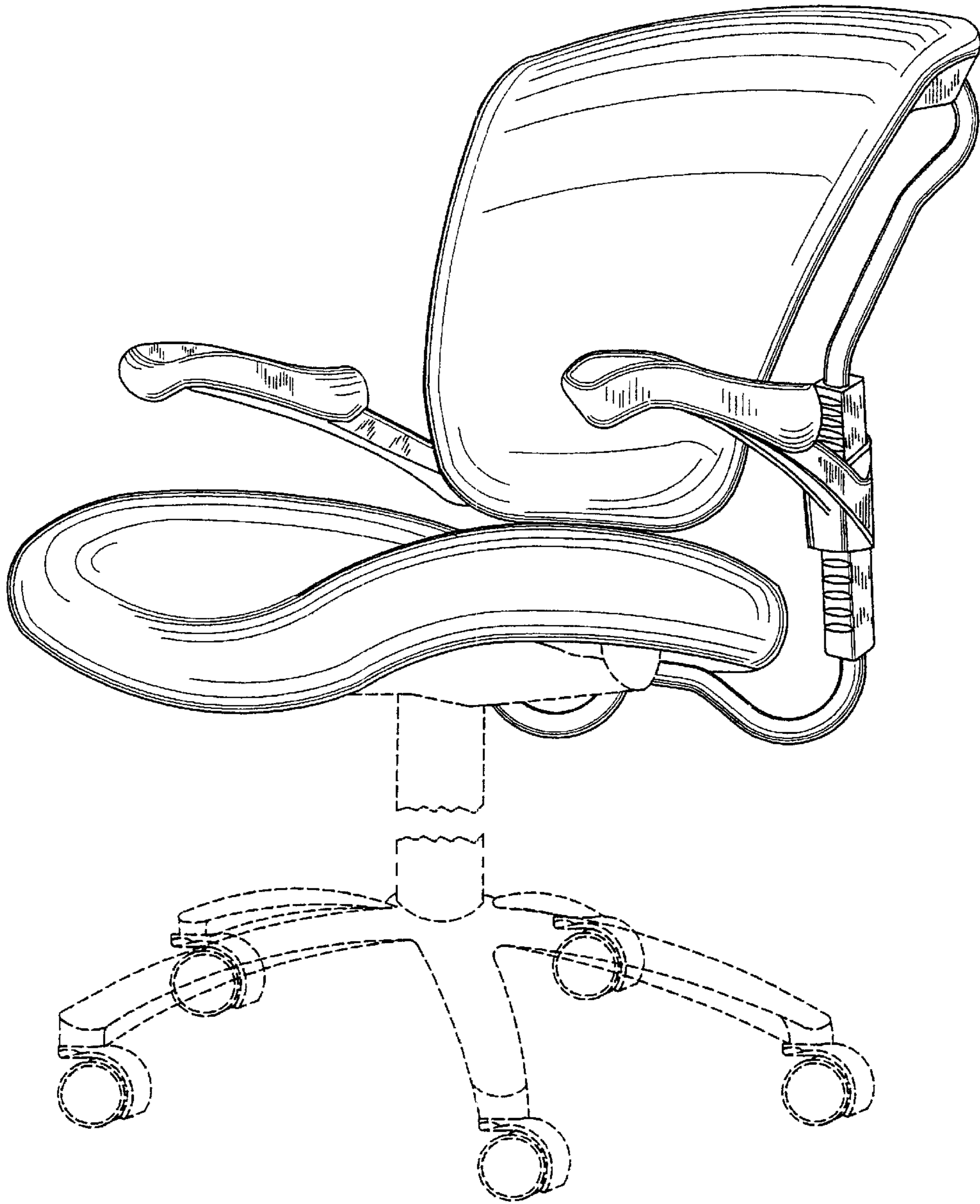

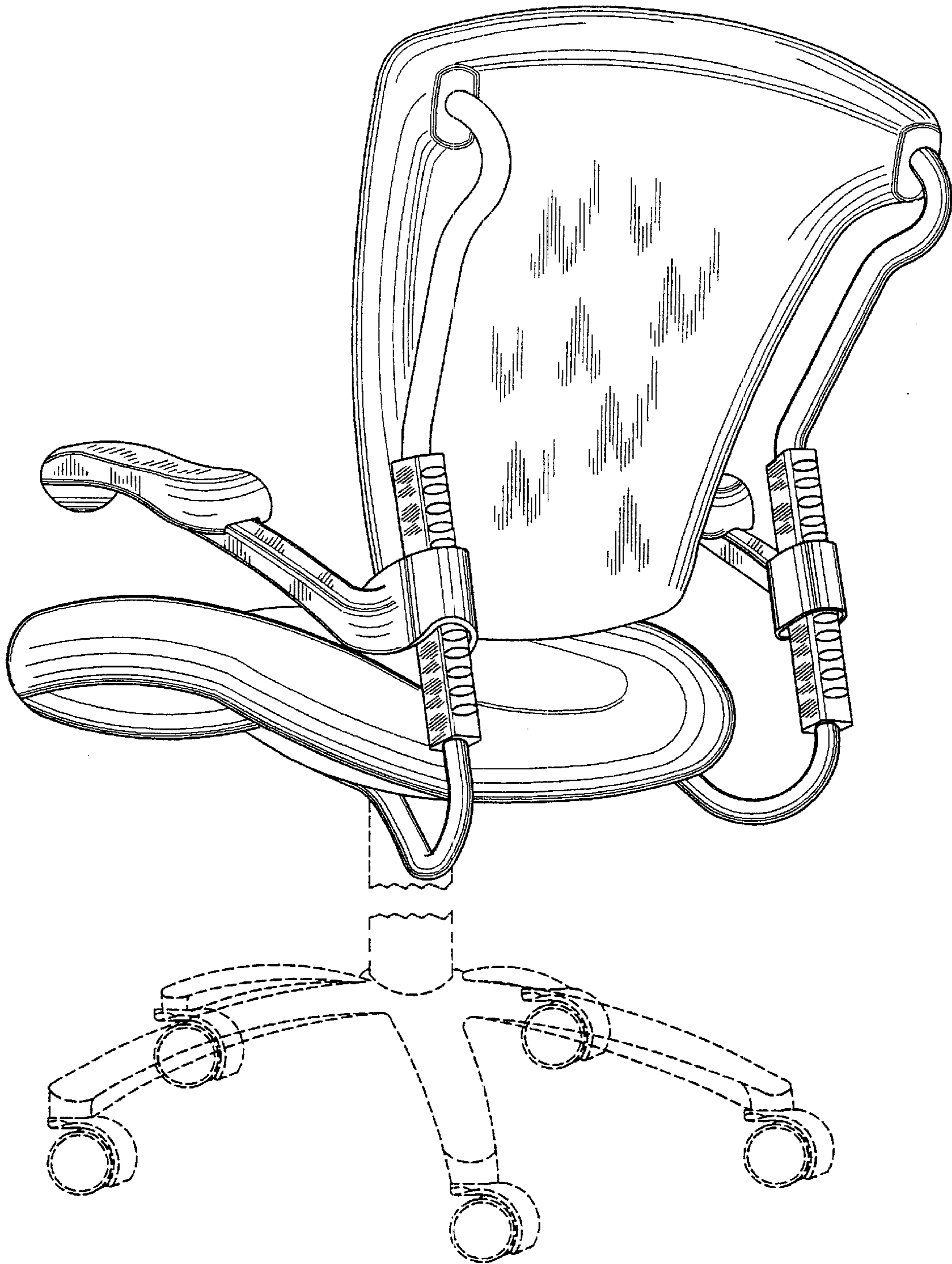

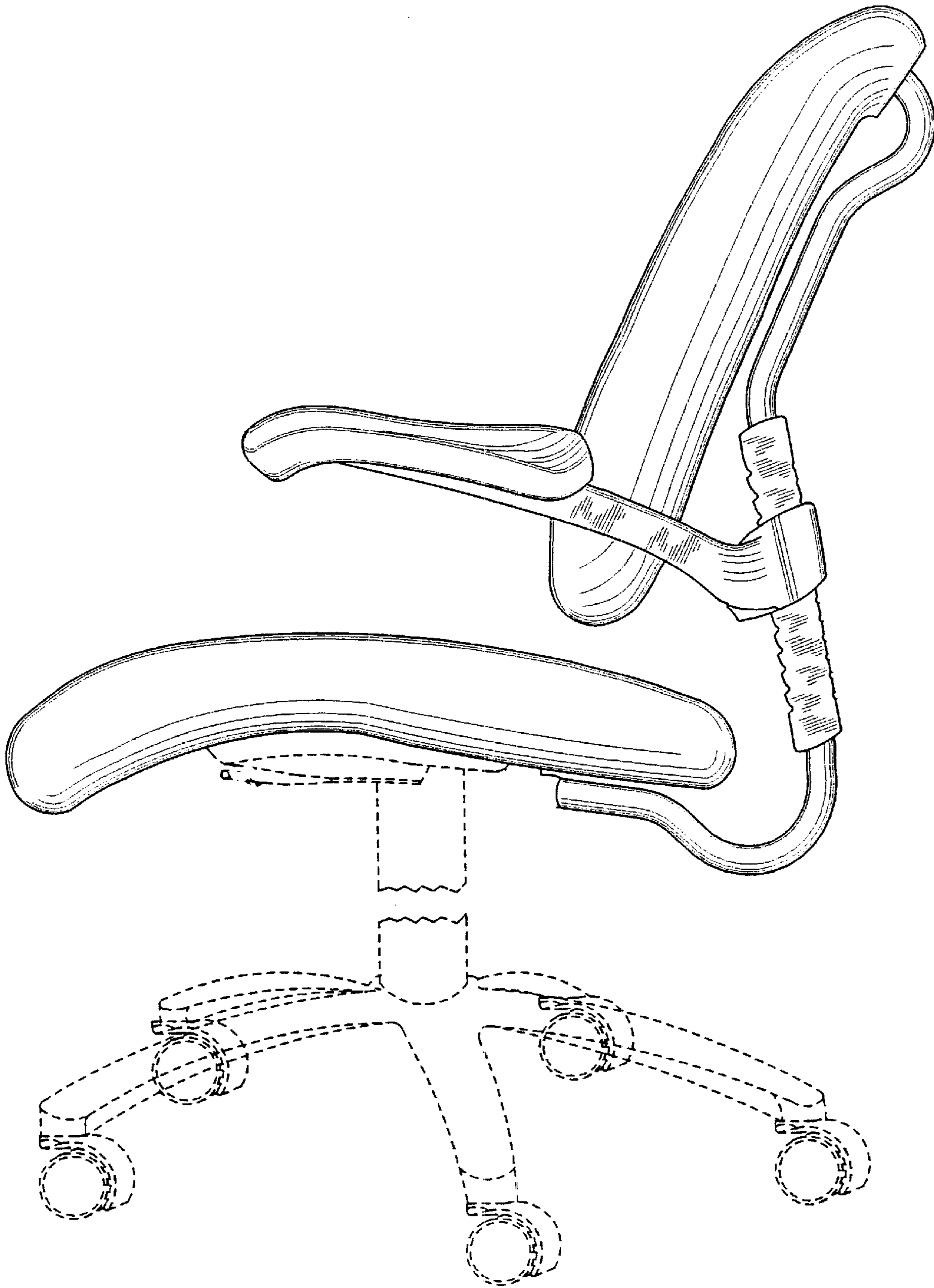
