The ornamental design for a gemstone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a gemstone showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the gemstone;

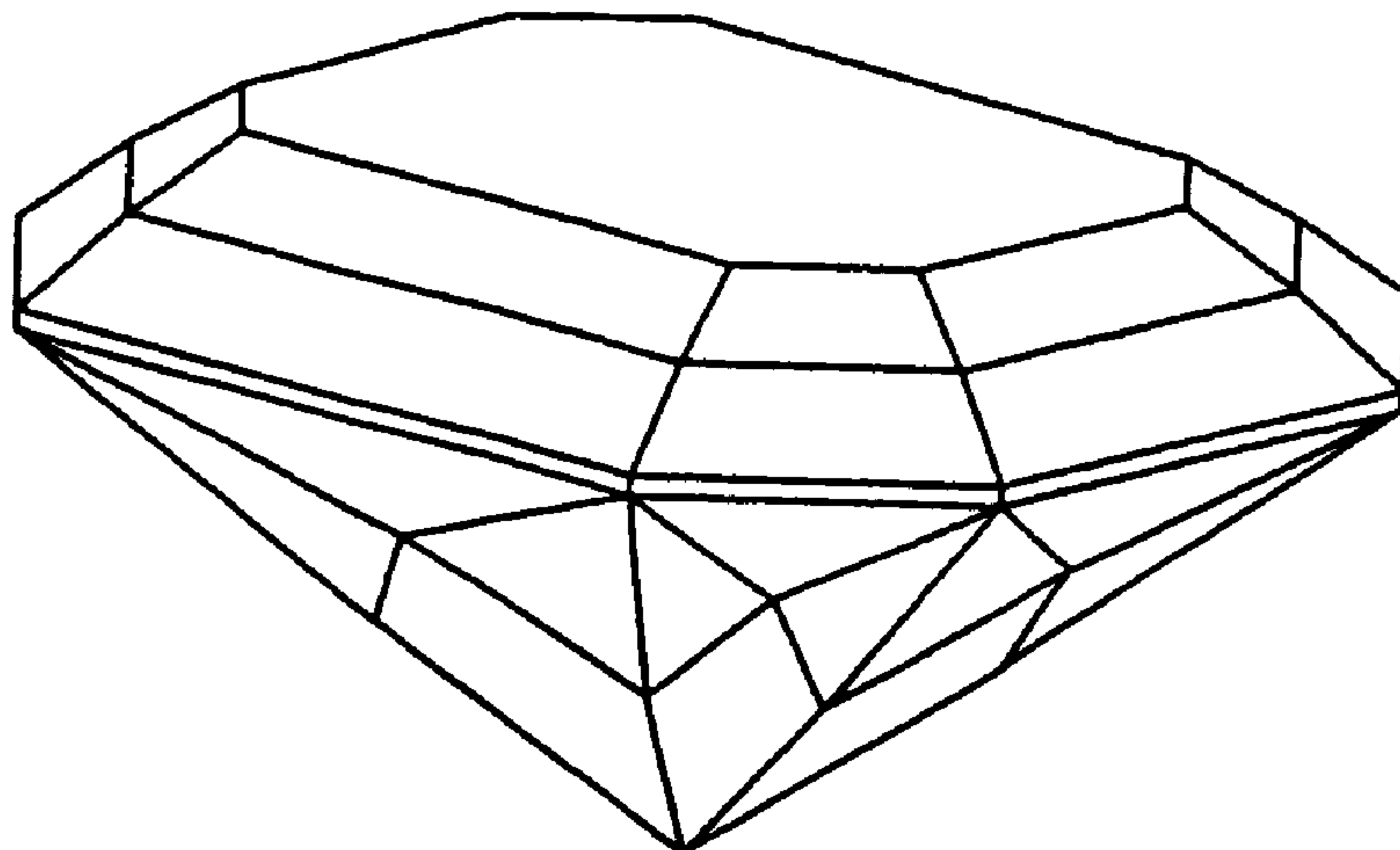
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the gemstone of FIG. 1;

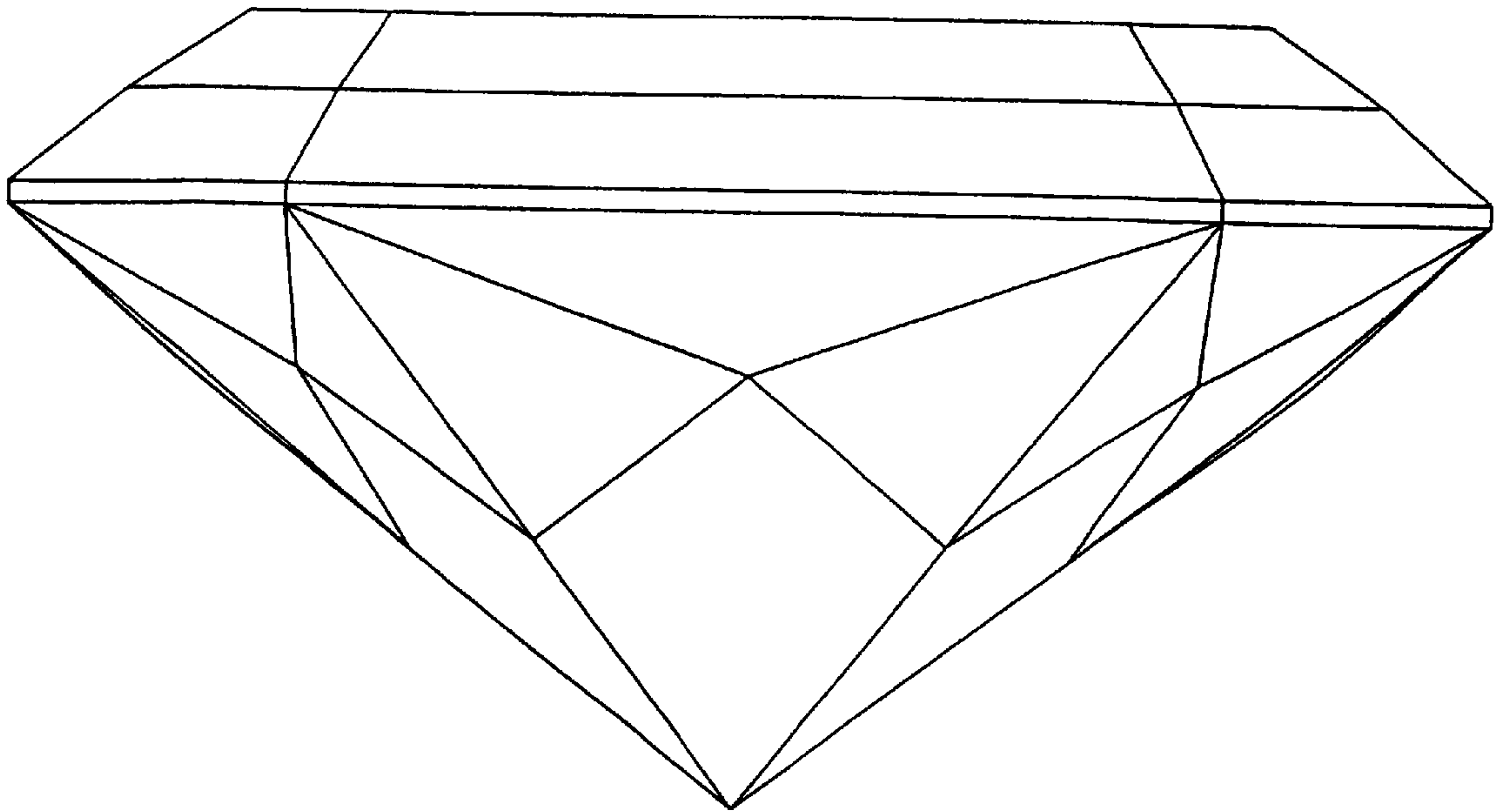

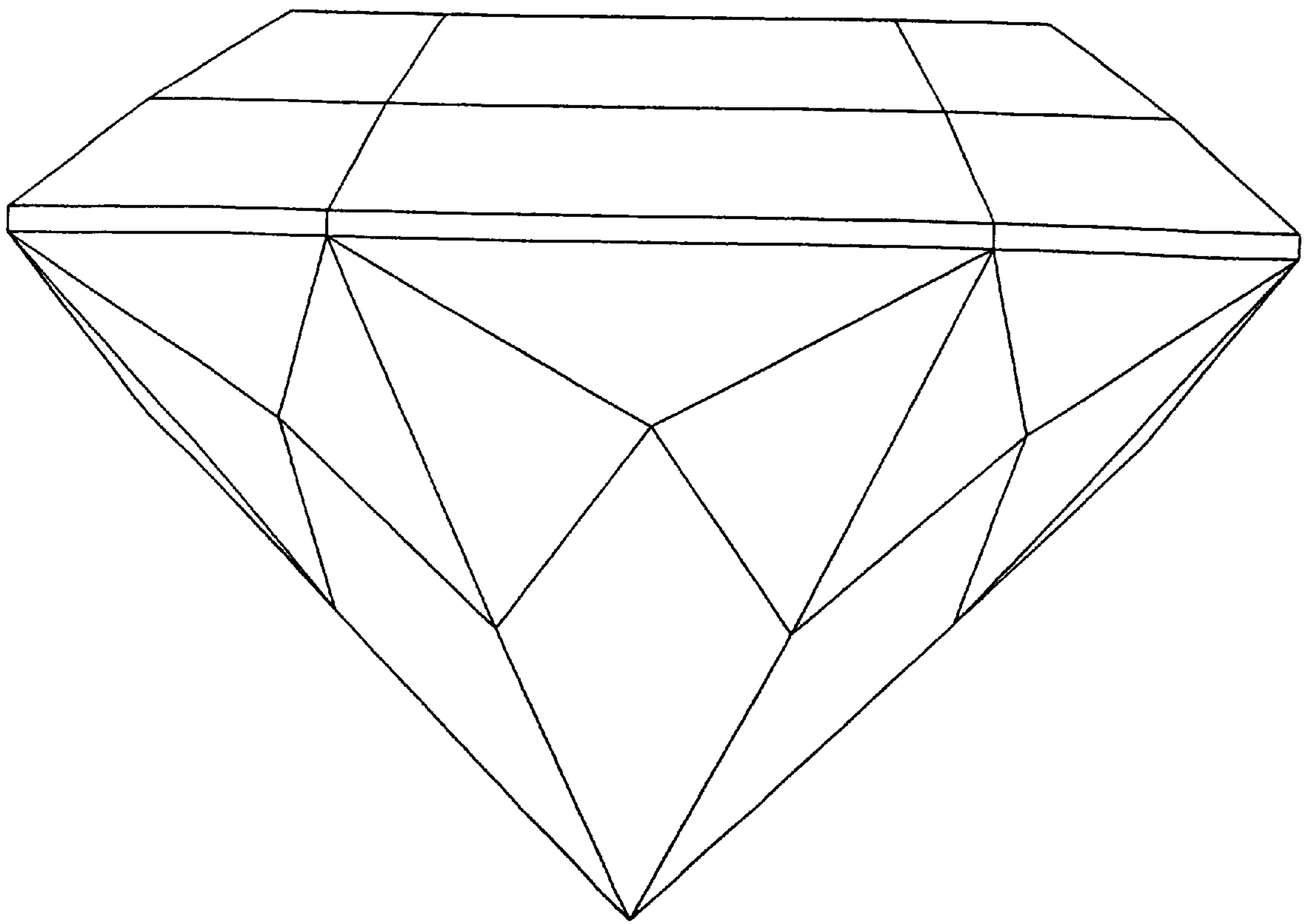

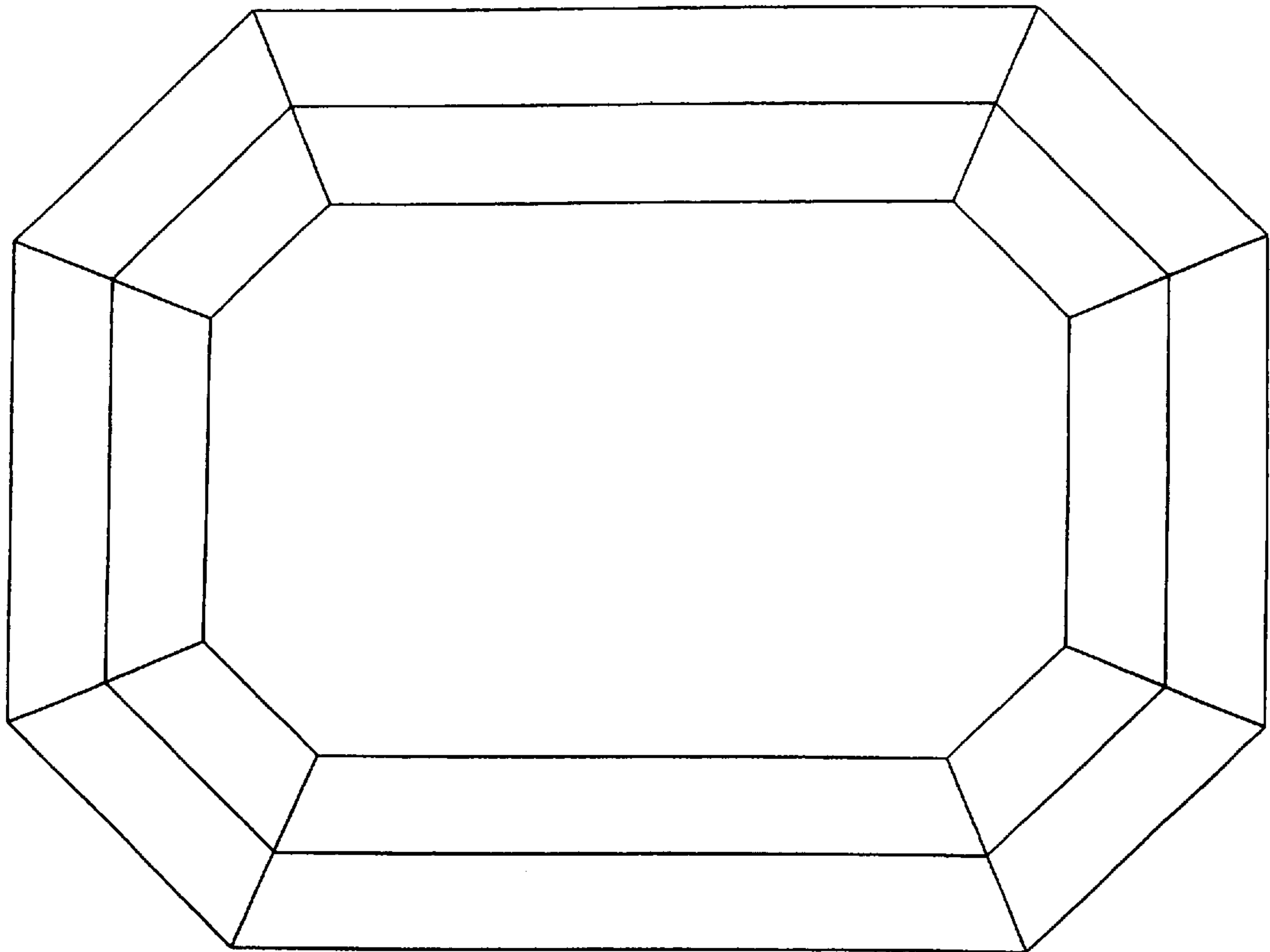

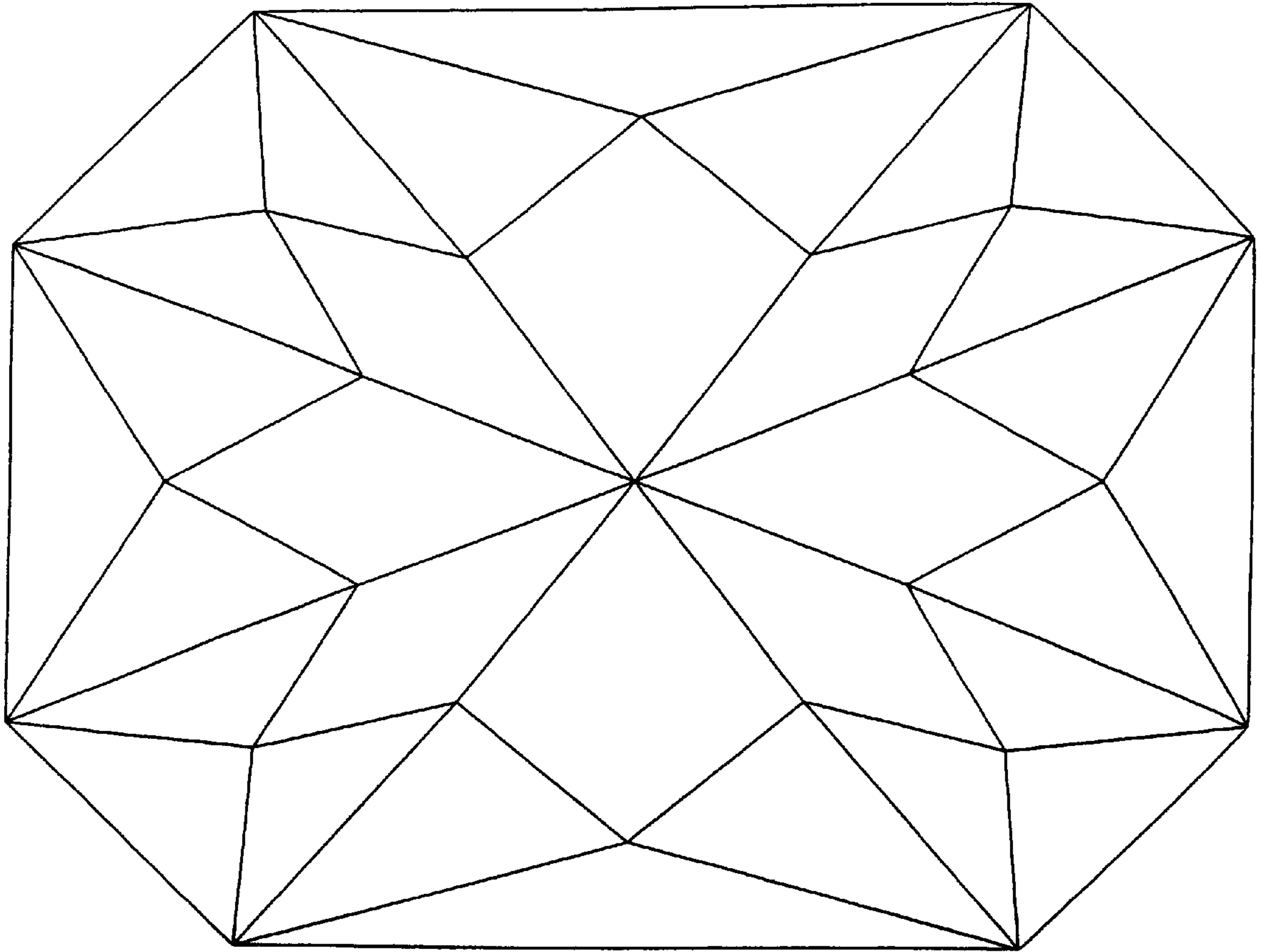

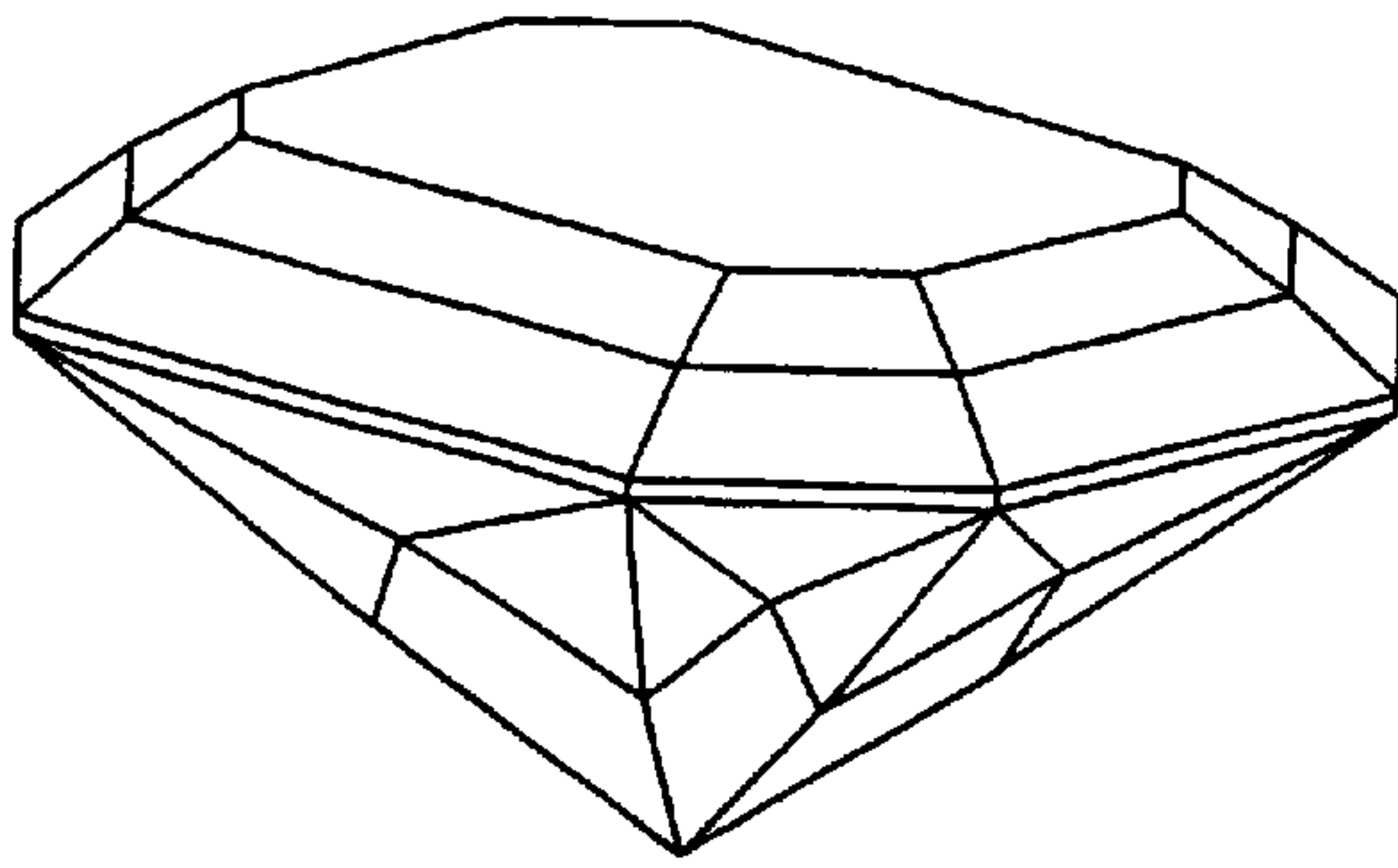

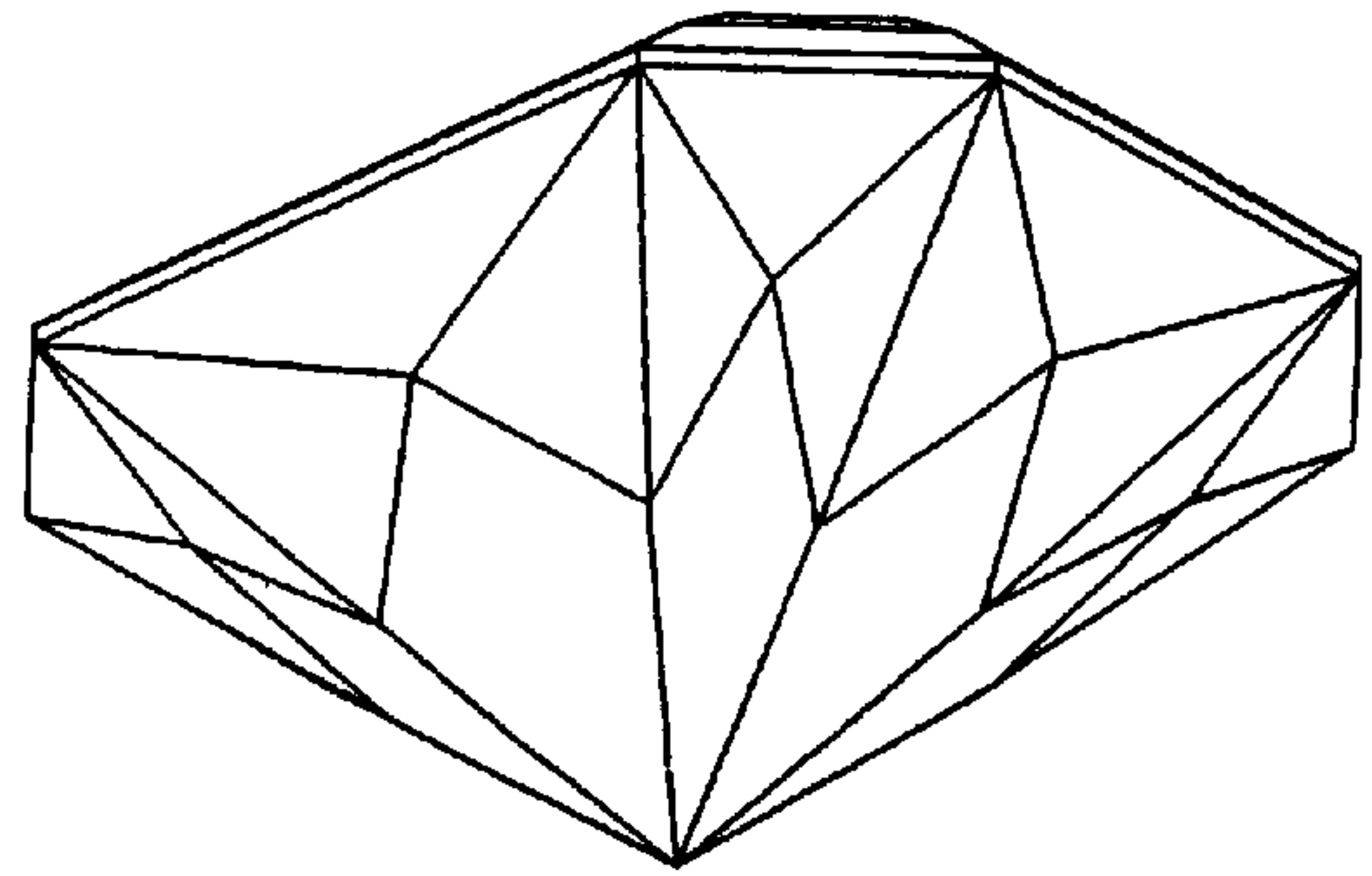
