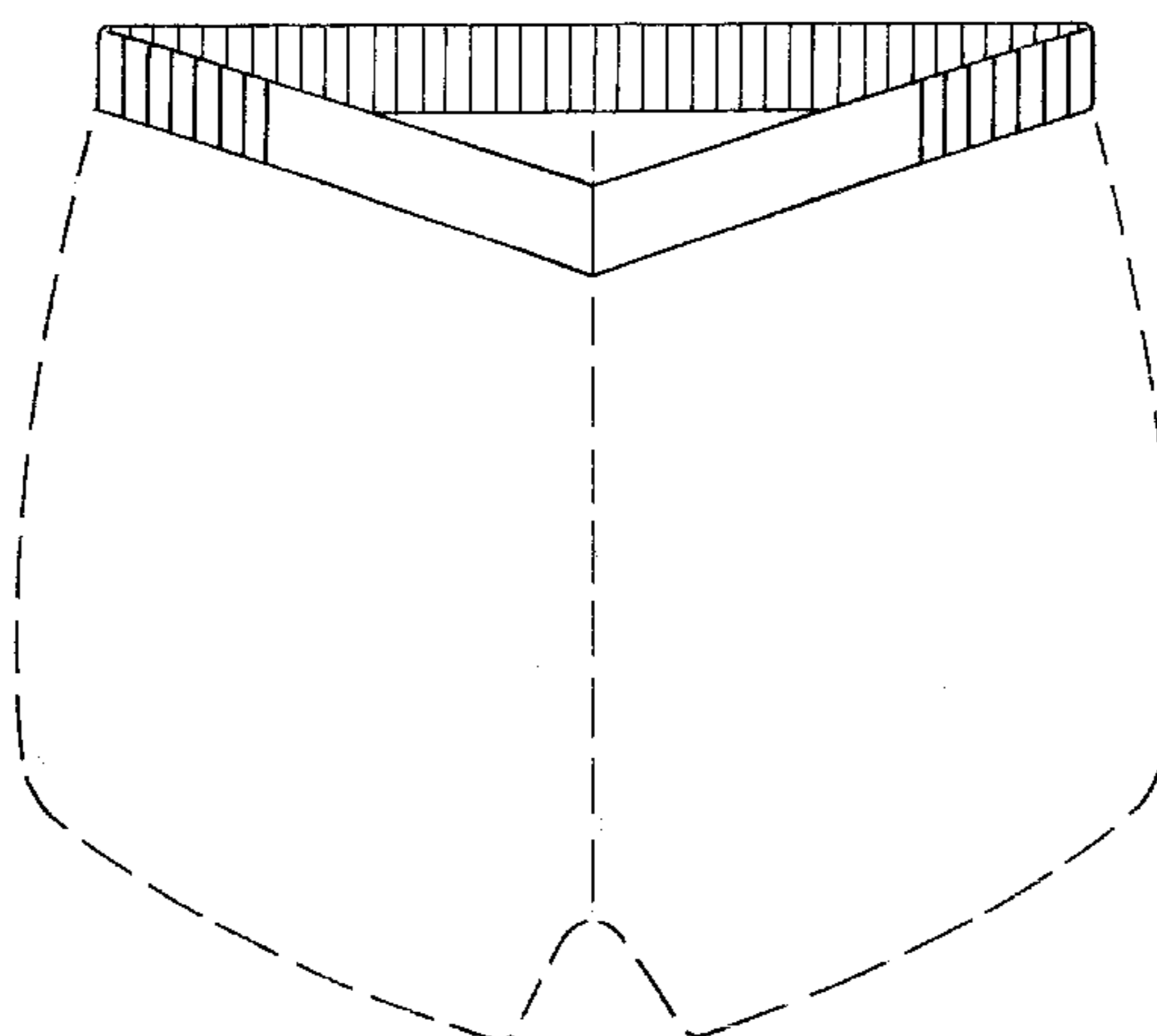
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the non-stretch front waistband
portion for wearing apparel embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror
image of the right side view;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror
image thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof.

The broken lines showing of exterior and interior environ-
mental structure of the shorts in FIGS. 1-4 of the drawing
views form no part of the claimed design.

The area of the waistband including vertical lines indicates
the inclusion of elastic material, and the area of the waist-
band devoid of vertical lines indicates the inclusion of
non-elastic material.

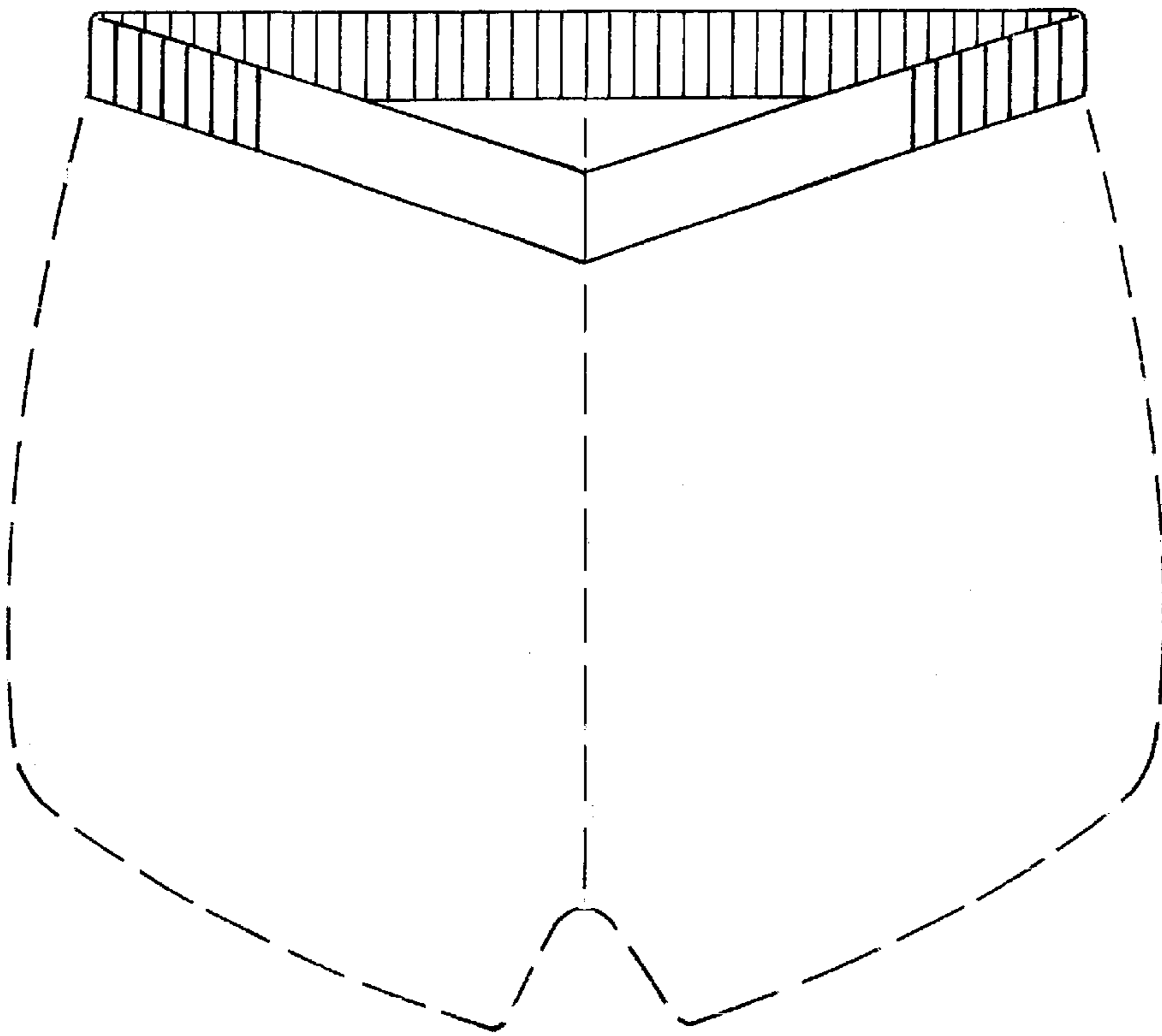

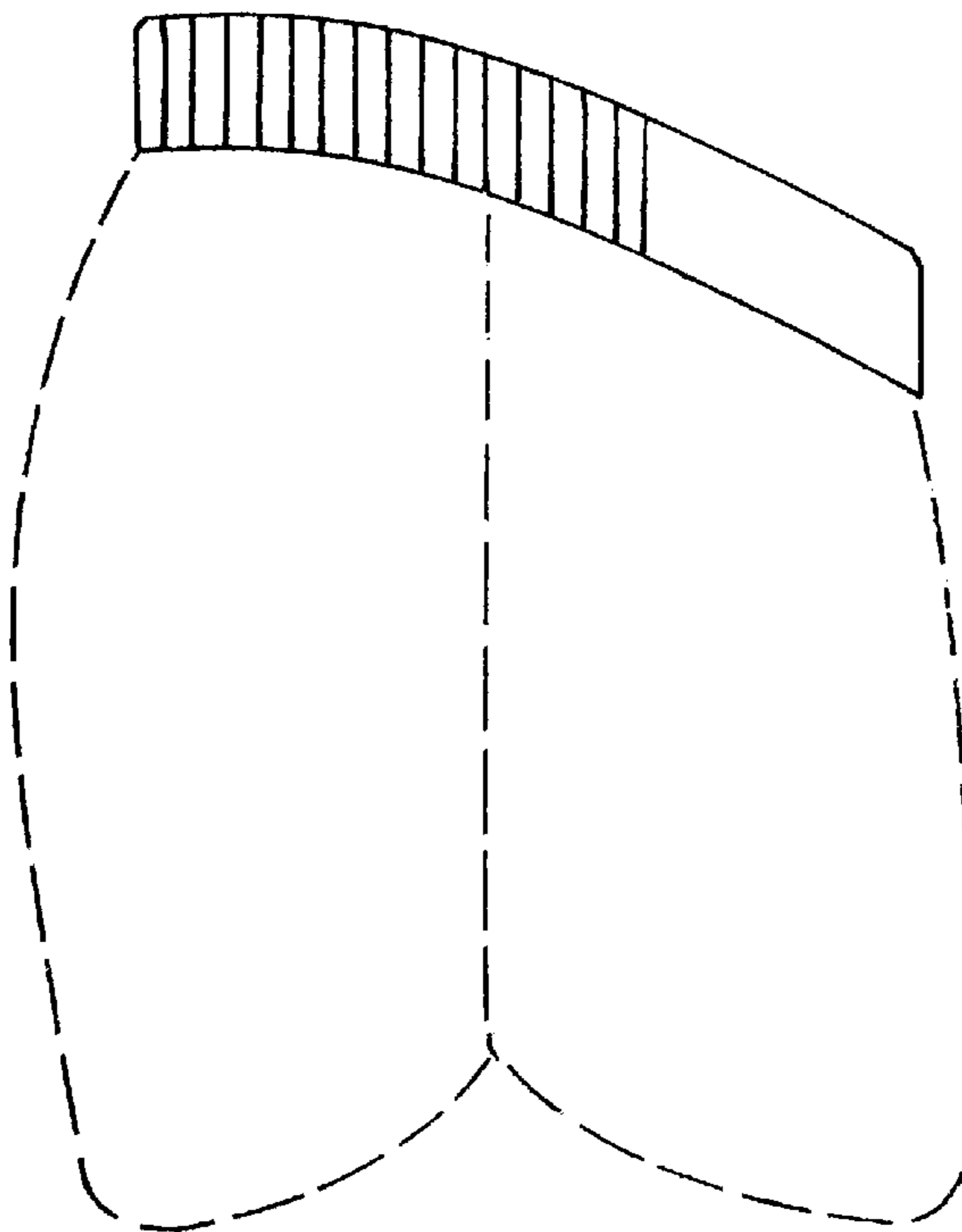

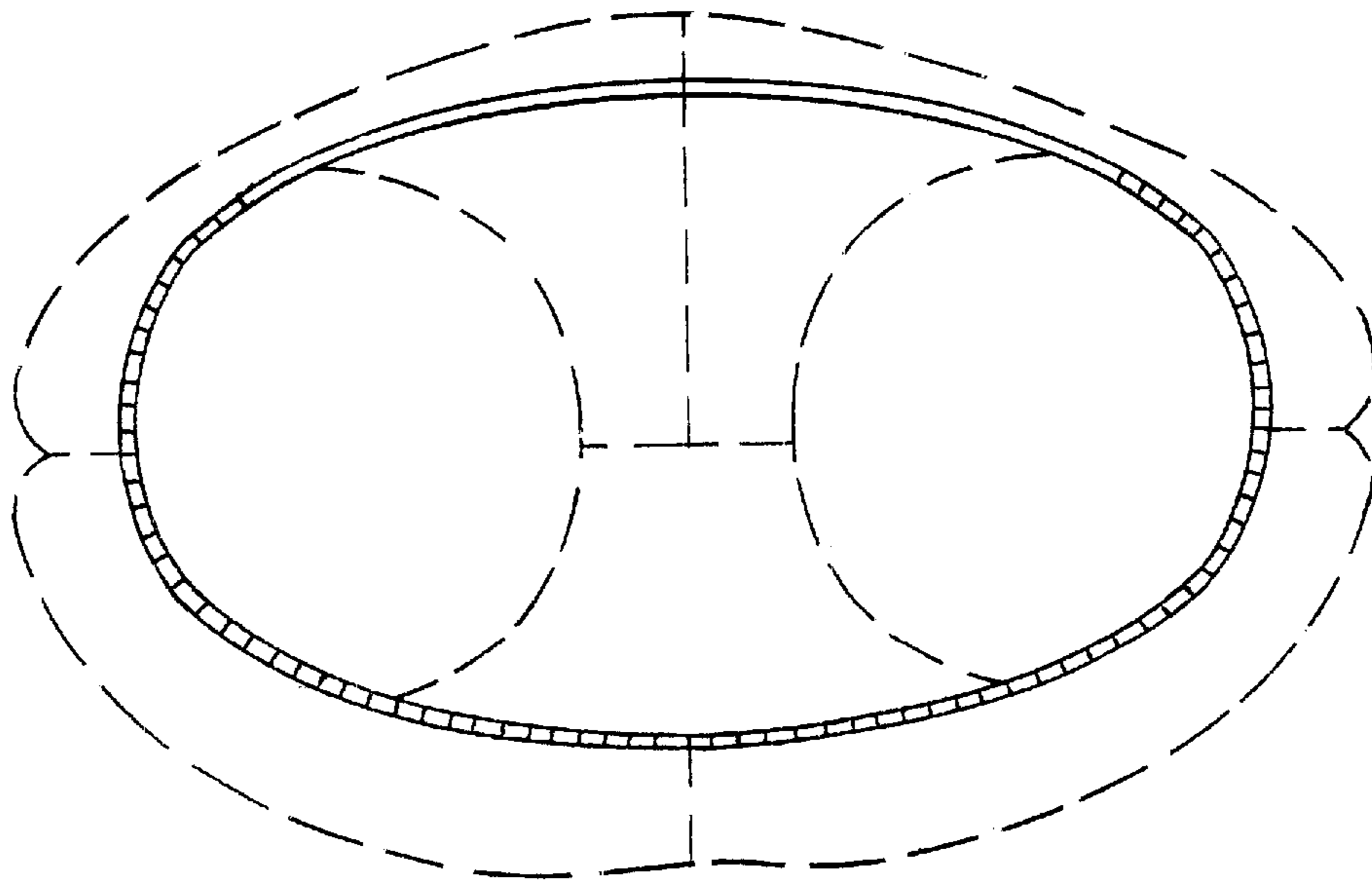
