**DESCRIPTION**

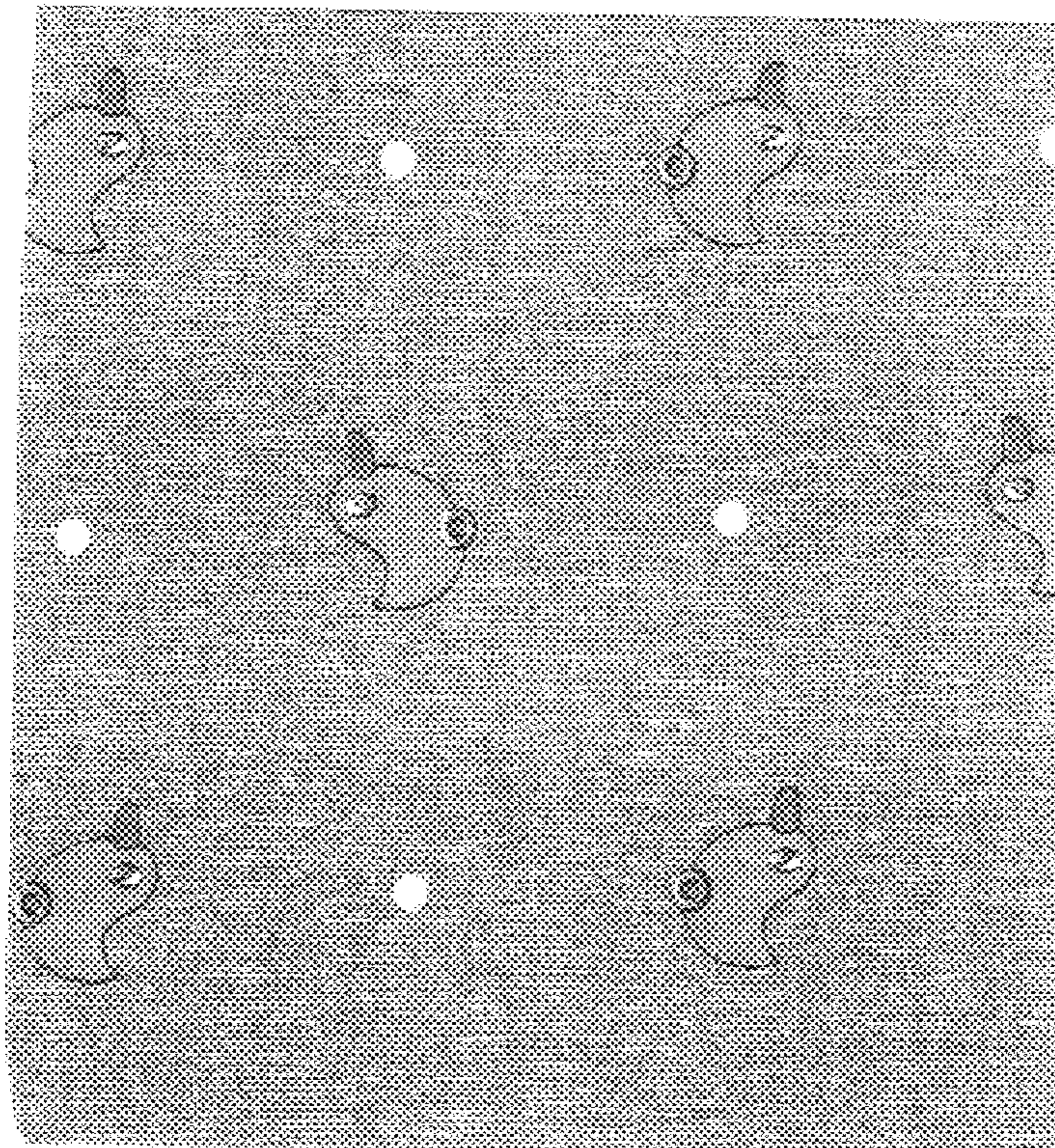

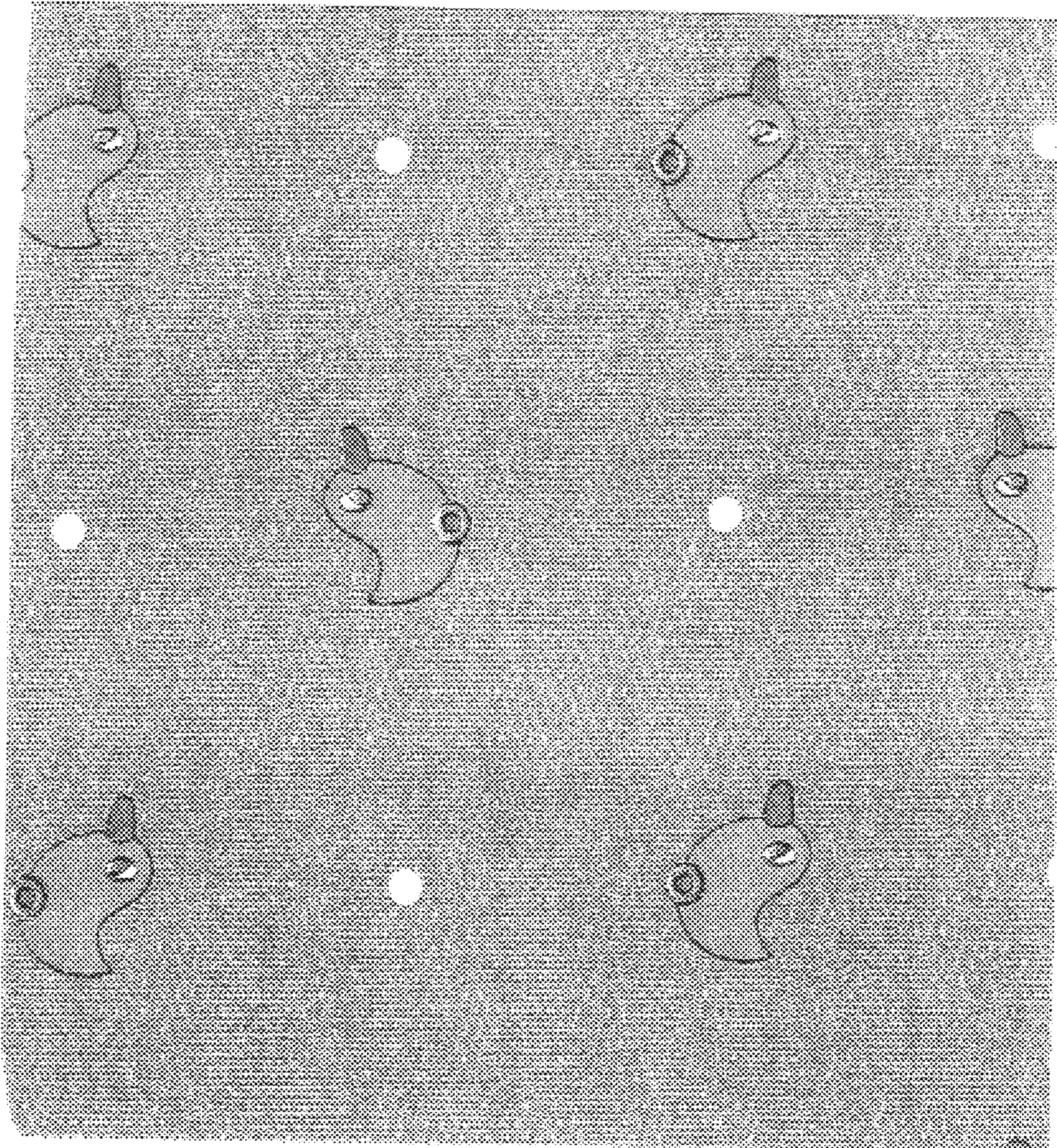

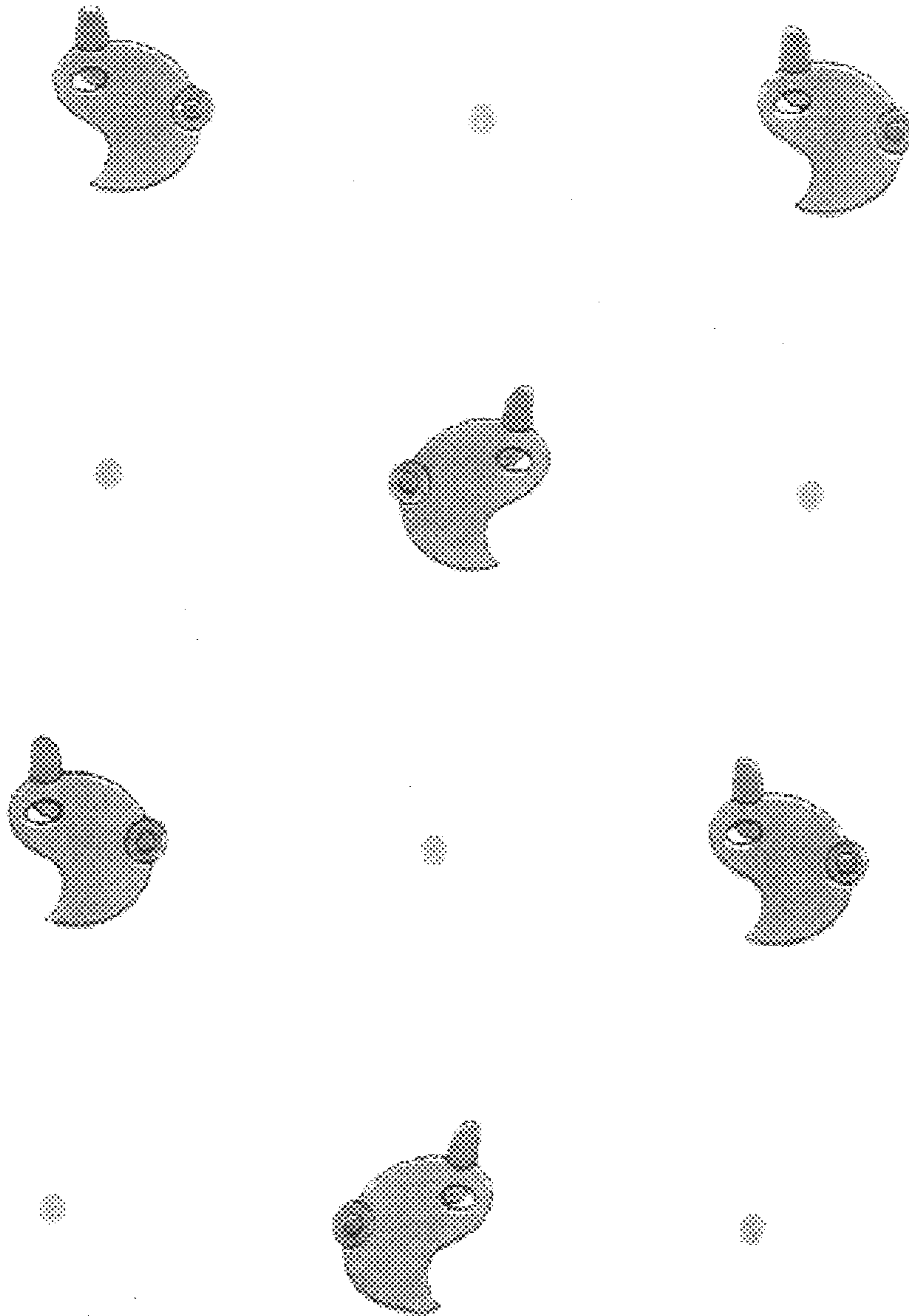
