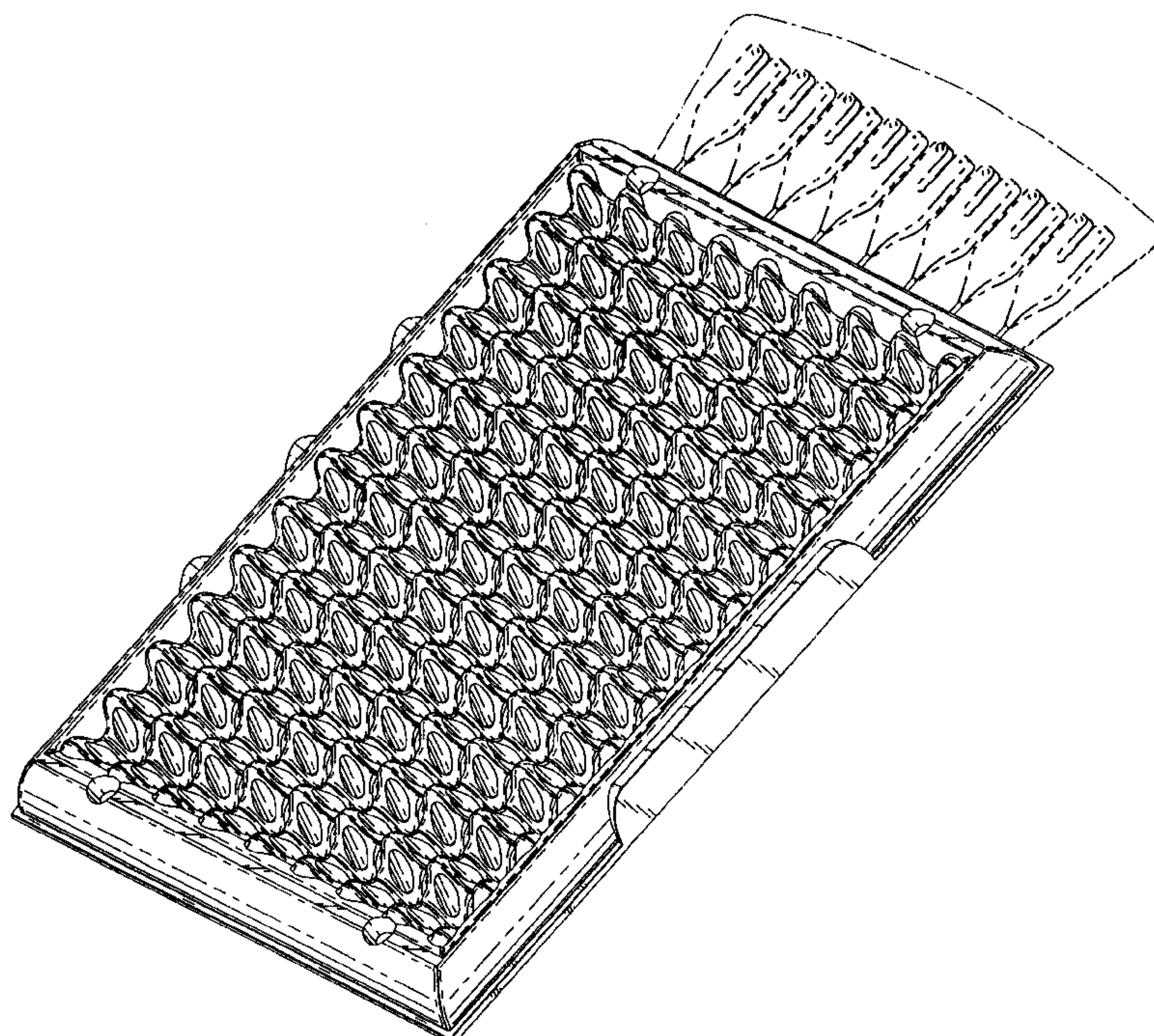
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sample processing device with carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sample processing device with carrier showing the new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a side view taken from below the design as depicted in FIG. 2;
 FIG. 5 is a side view taken from above the design as depicted in FIG. 2;
 FIG. 6 is a right side view of the design taken from the right side of the design as depicted in FIG. 2; and,
 FIG. 7 is a left side view of the design taken from the left side of the design as depicted in FIG. 2.
 The features illustrated in broken lines in FIGS. 1–7 do not form a part of the claimed invention.

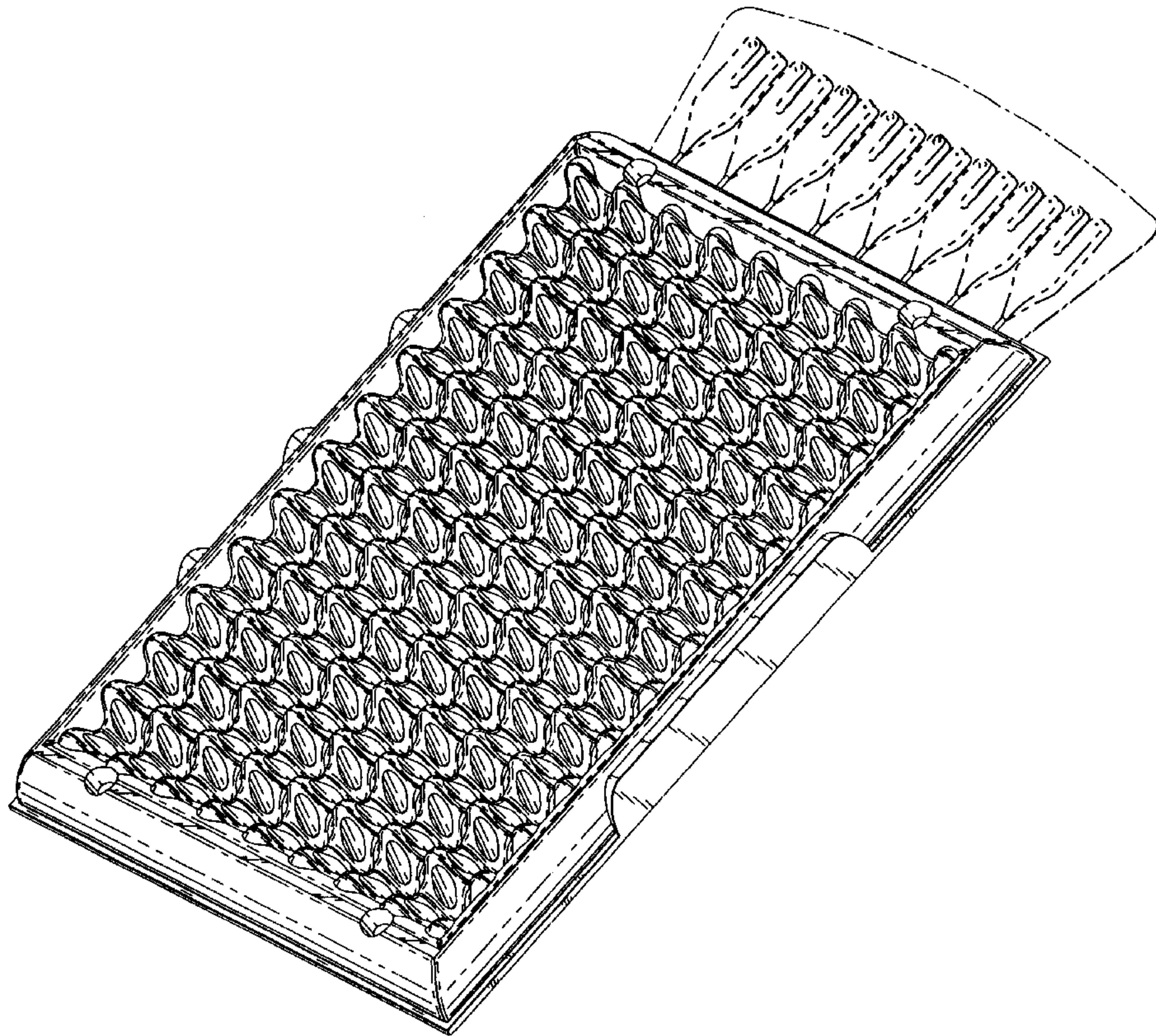

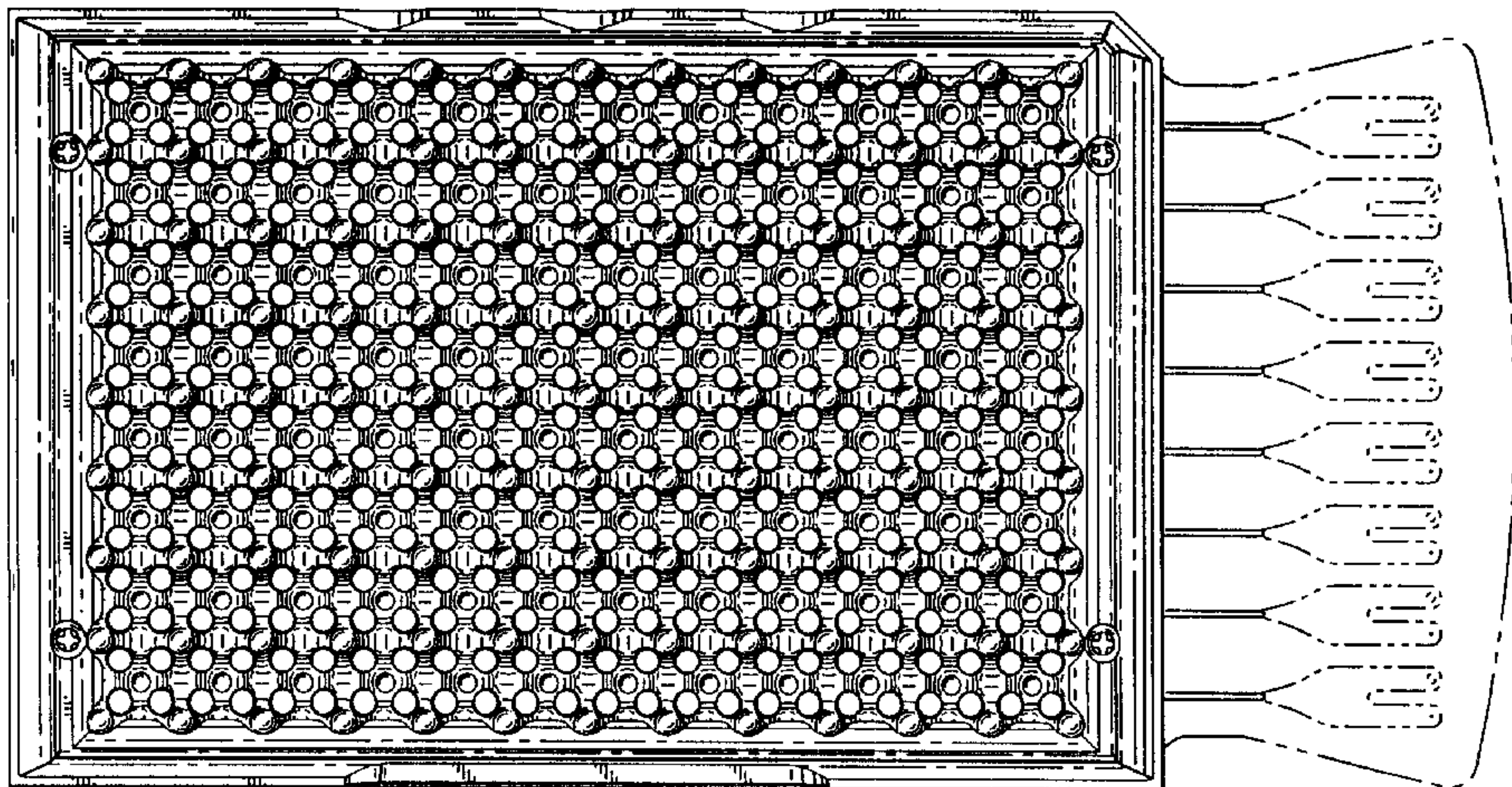

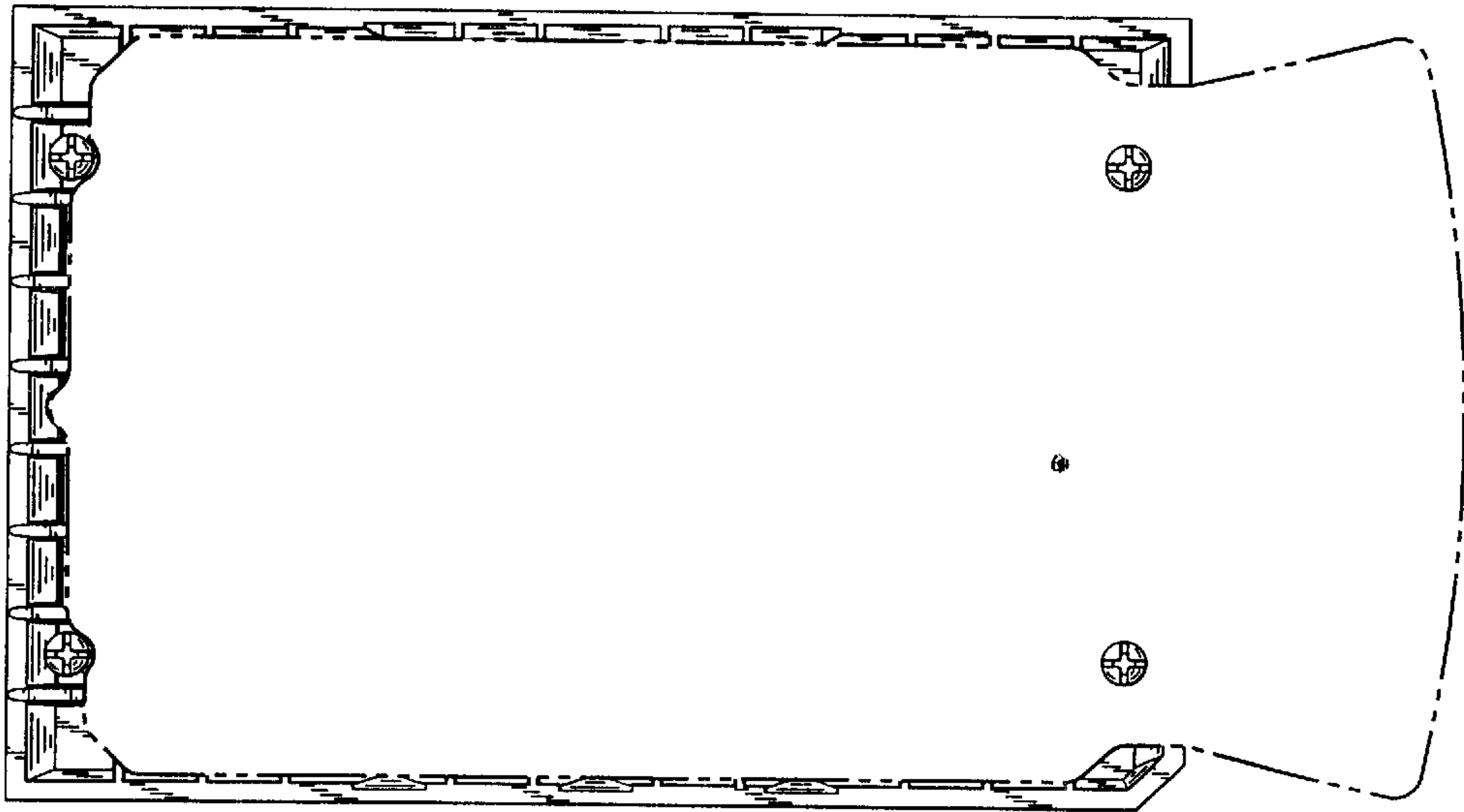

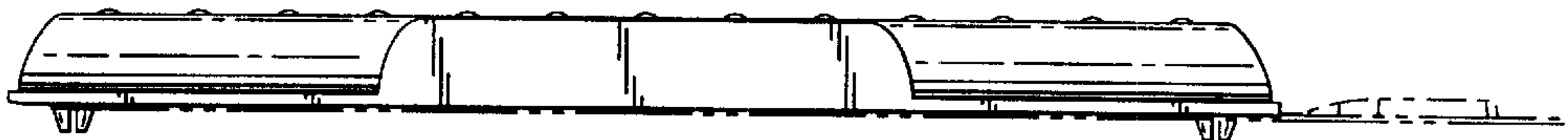

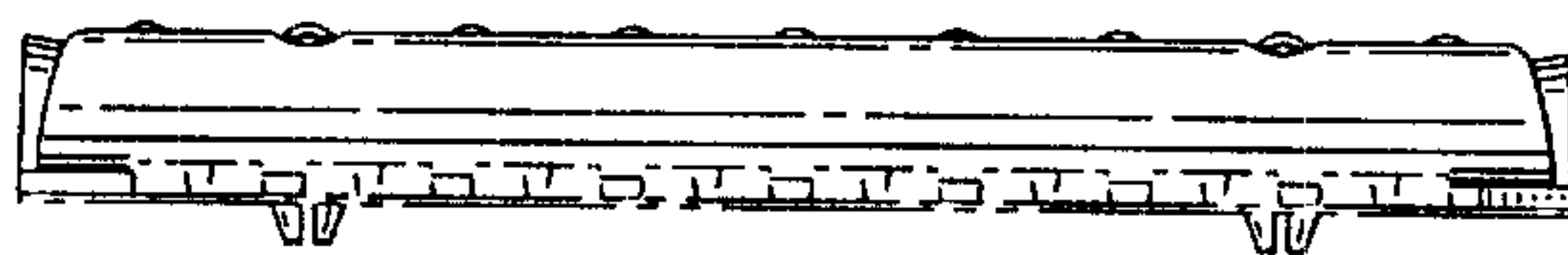

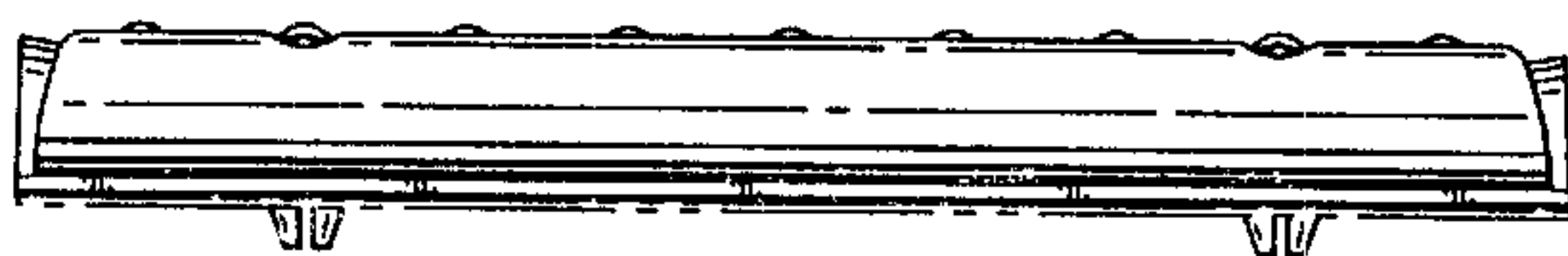
