(57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a receptacle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the receptacle according to an exemplary embodiment.

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the receptacle.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the receptacle; and,

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the receptacle.
