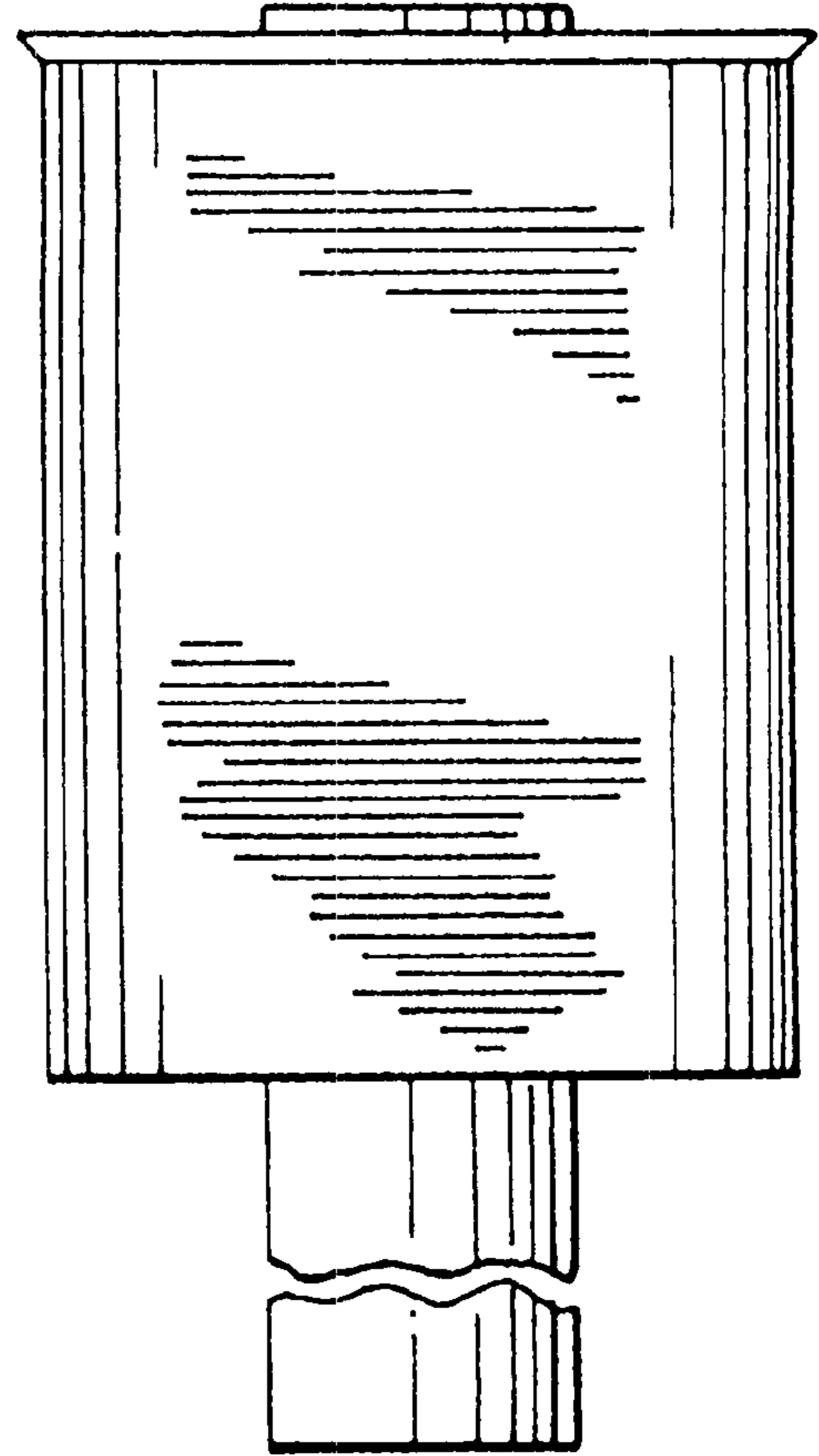
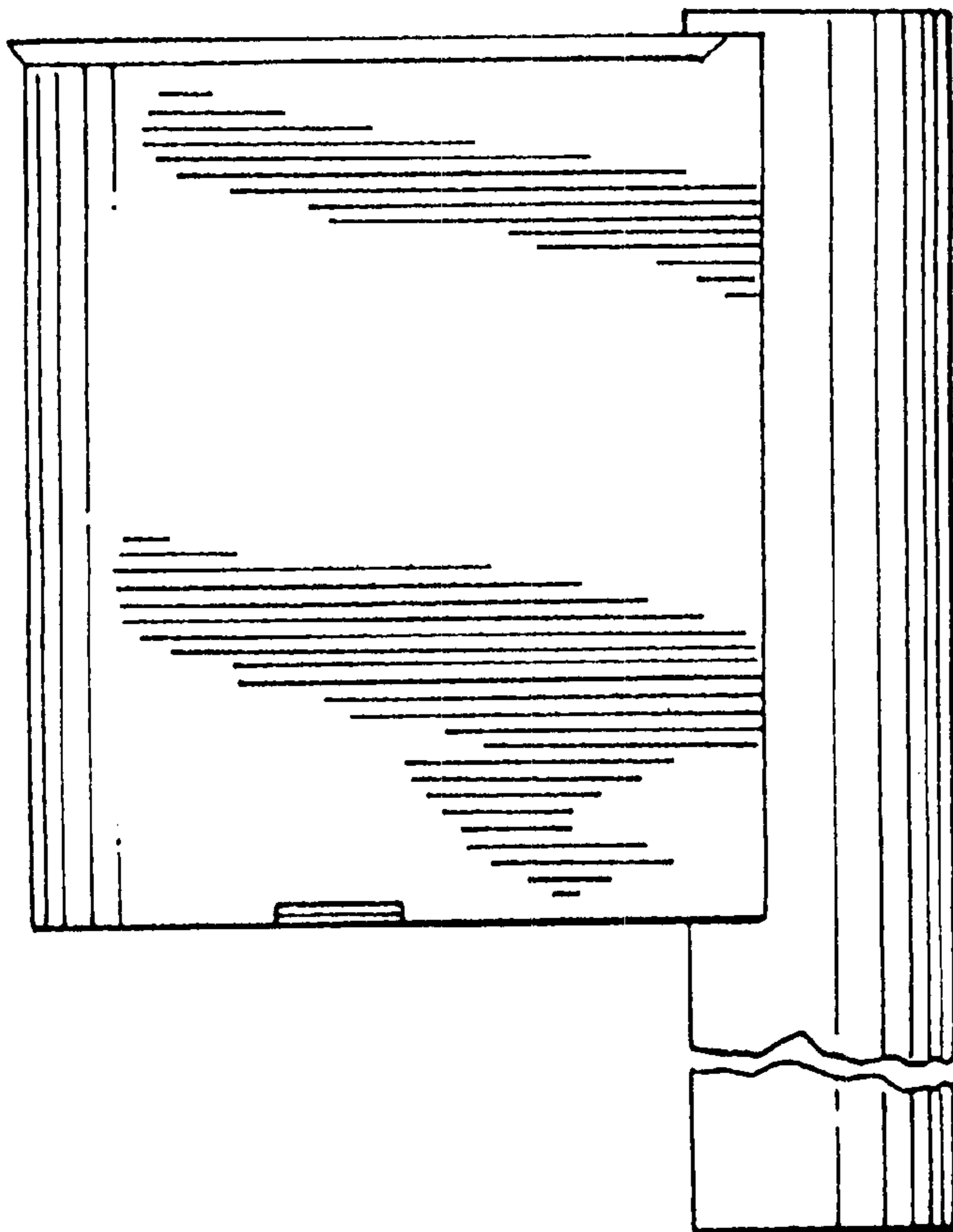
FIG. 1 is a right-side elevational view of a metallic support base with a round pipe support pole, with the pole broken away to indicate indeterminate length;

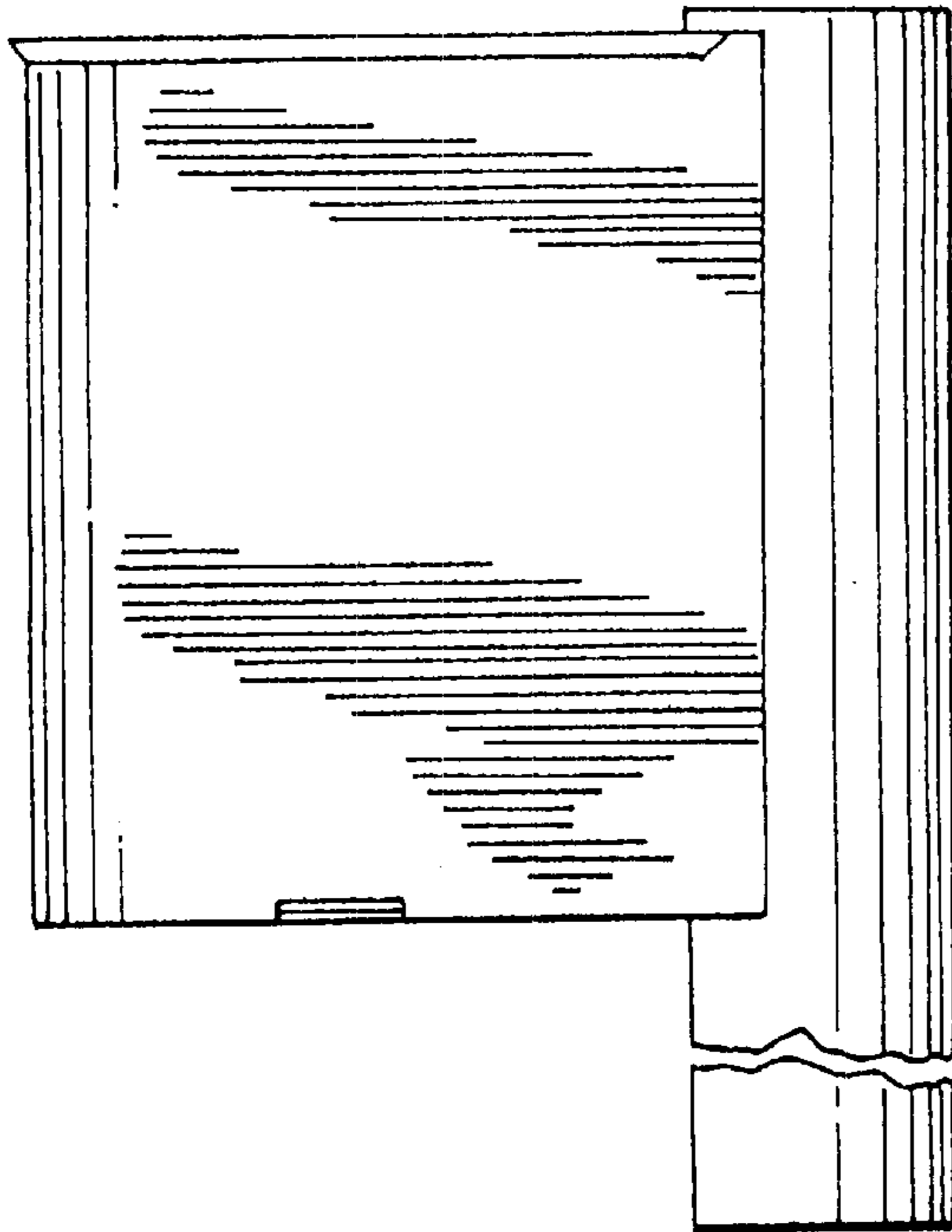

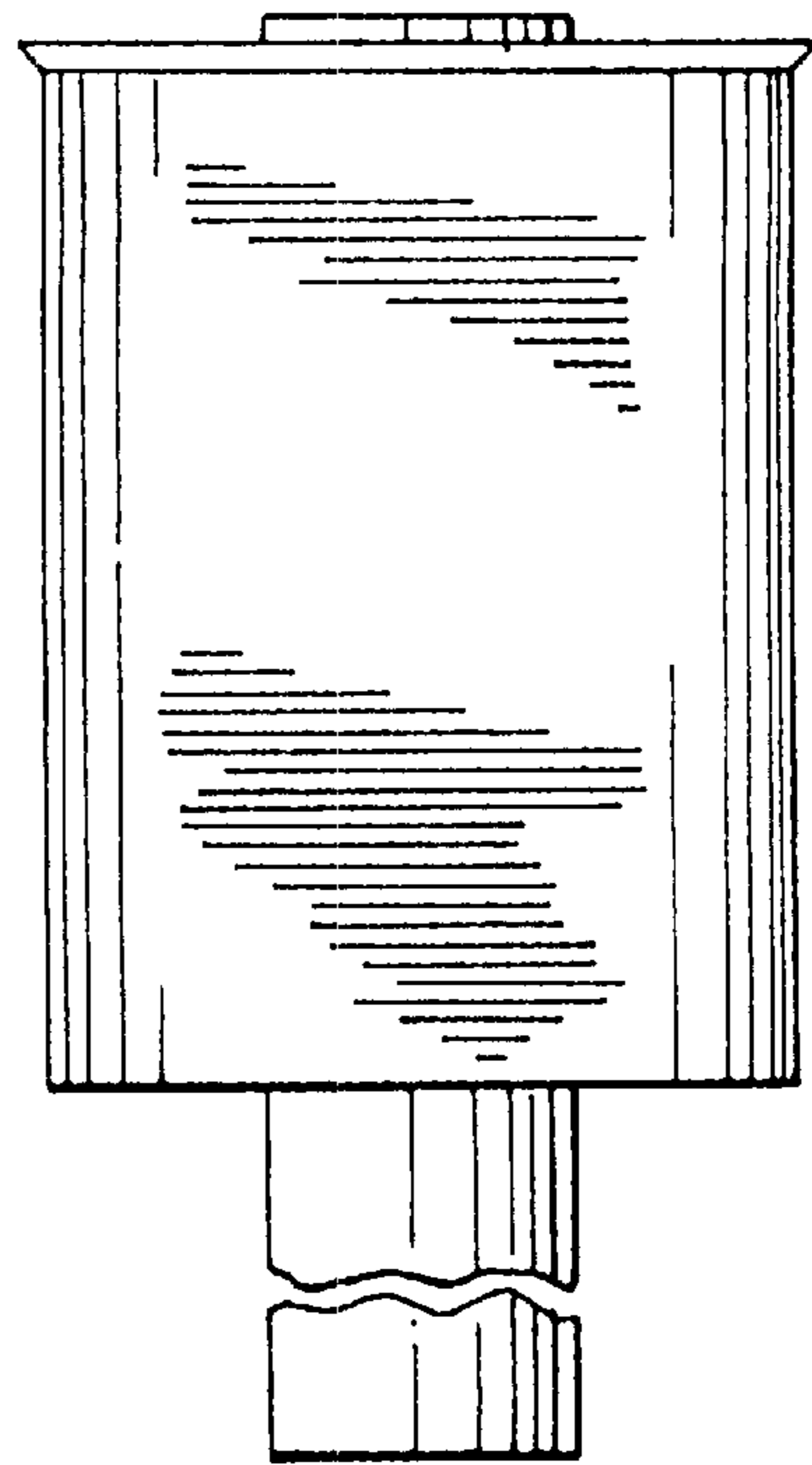

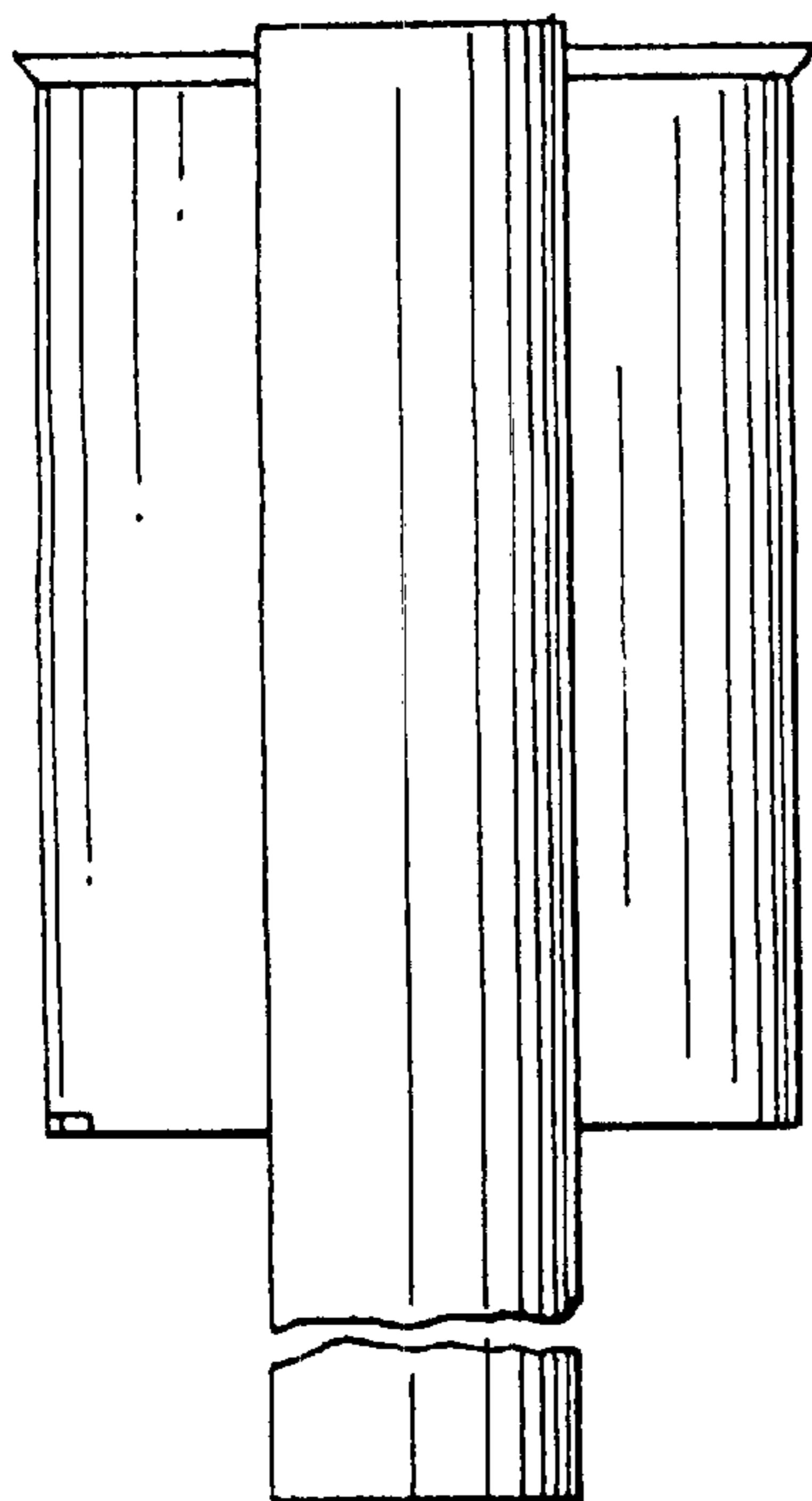

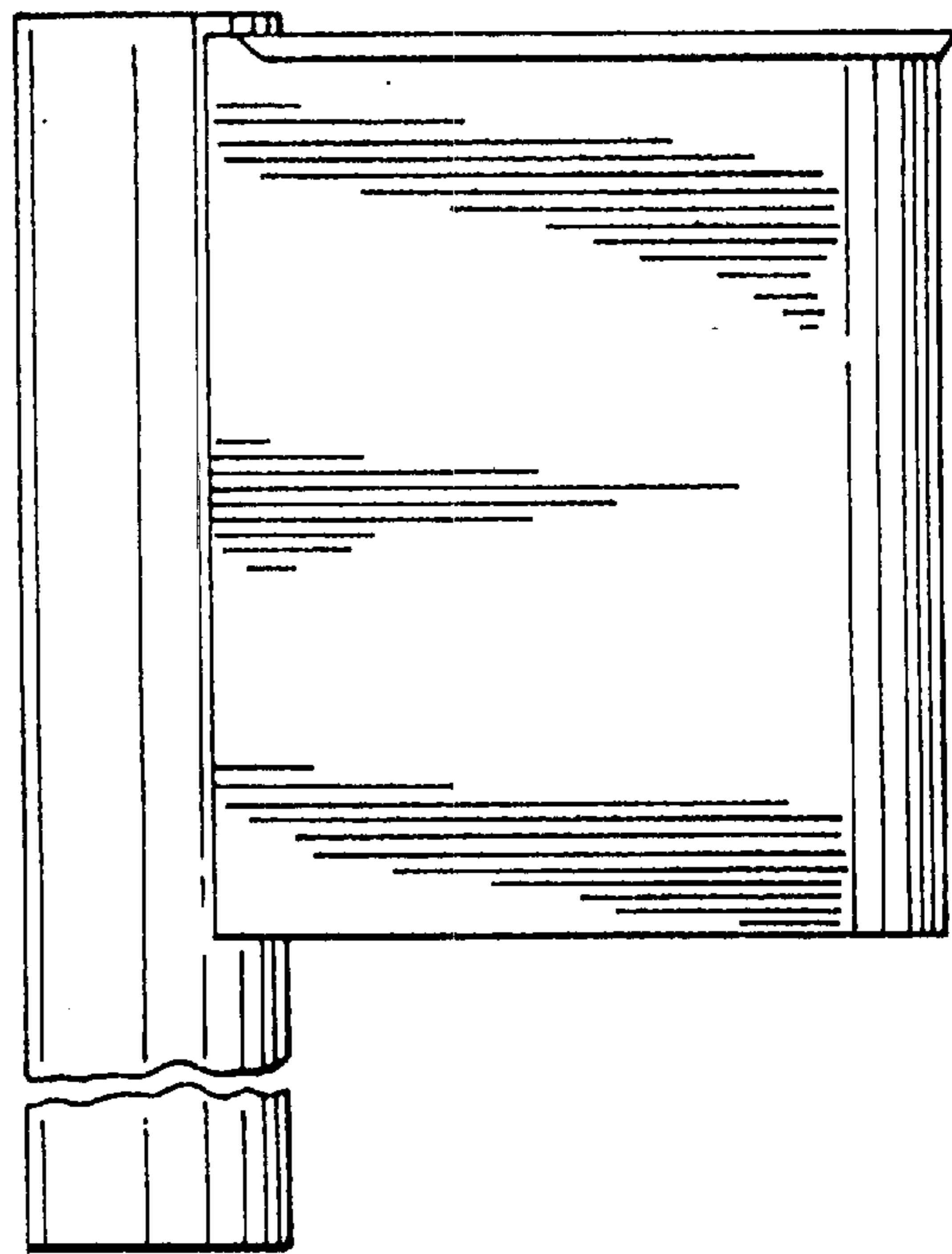

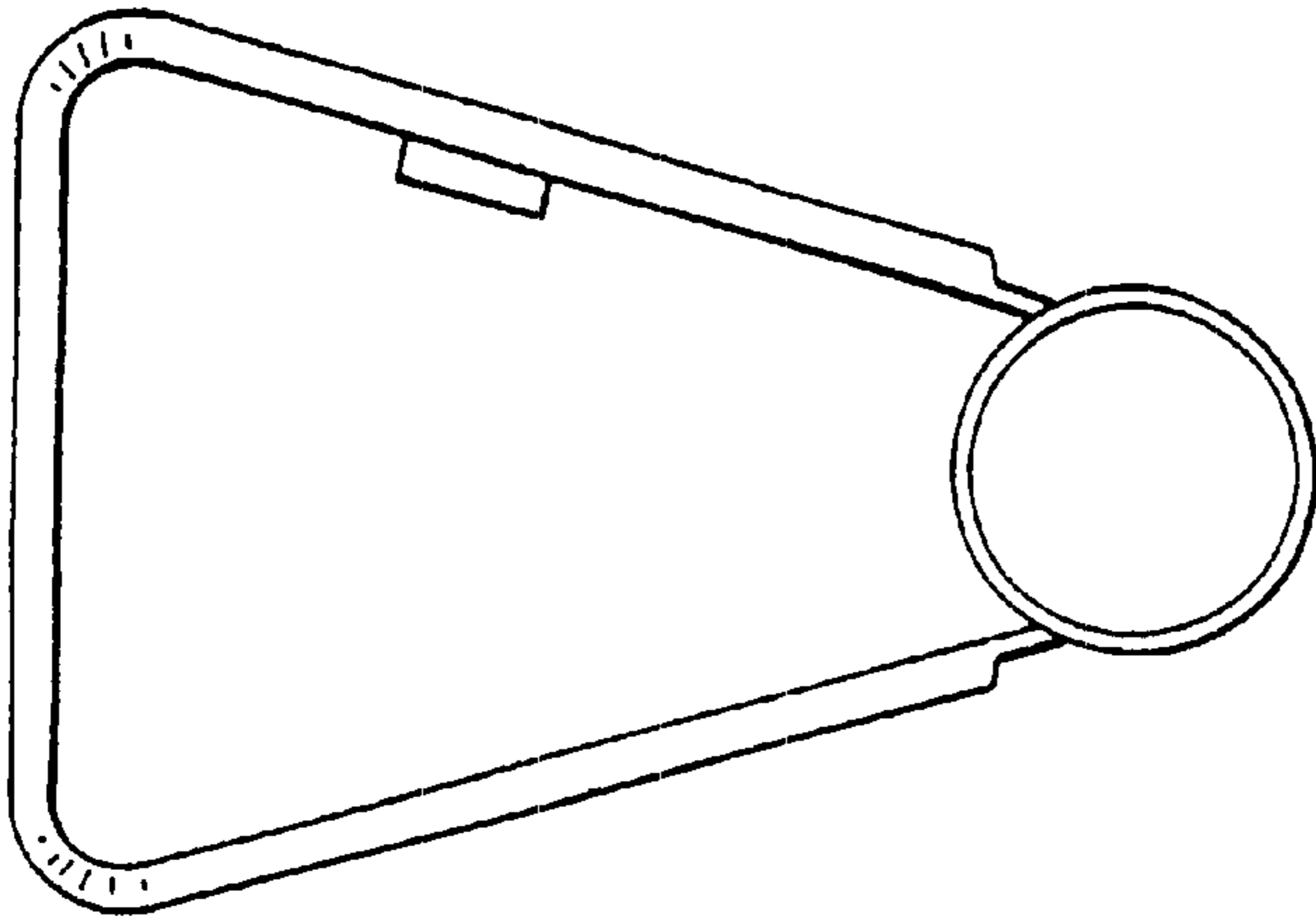

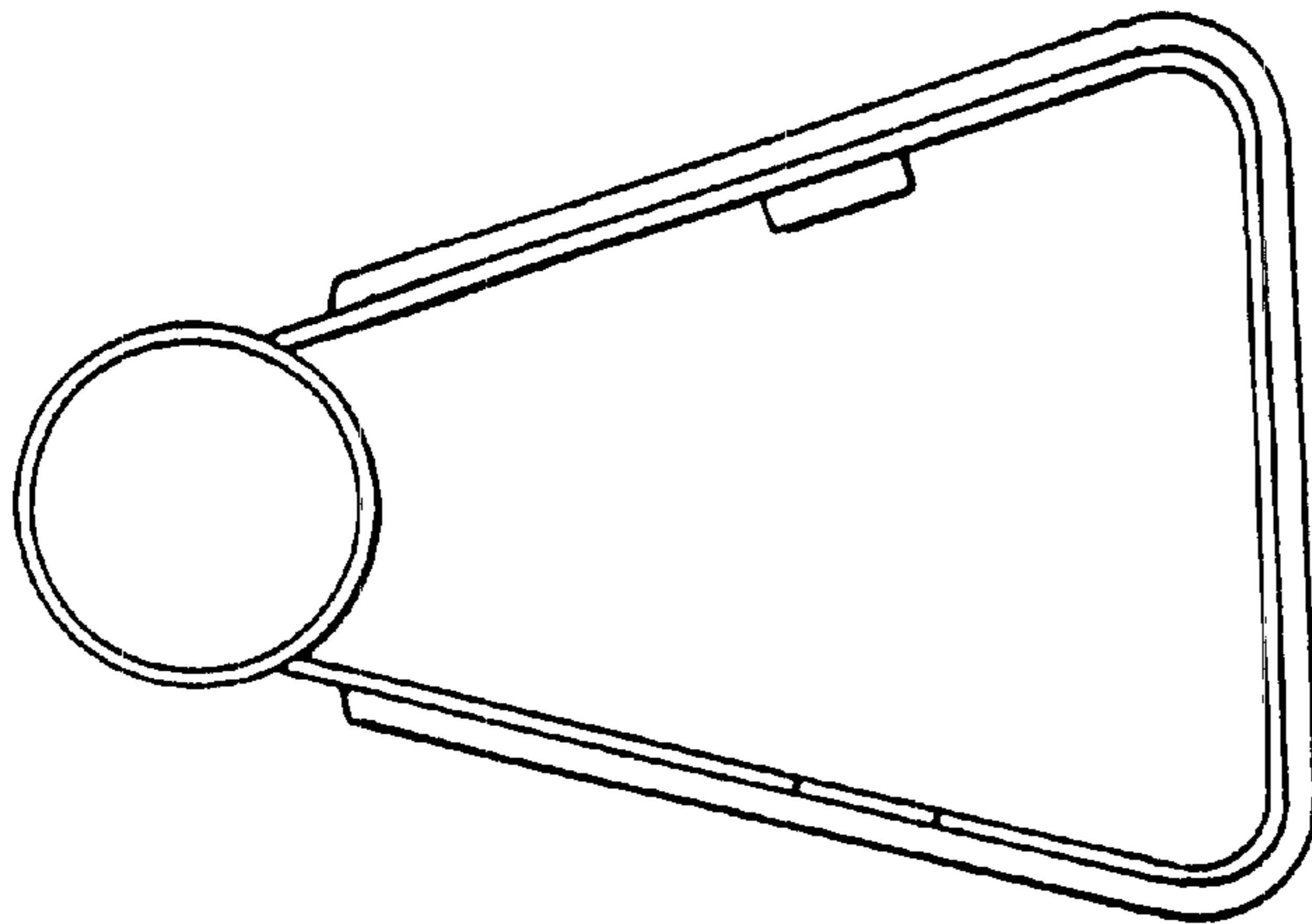
