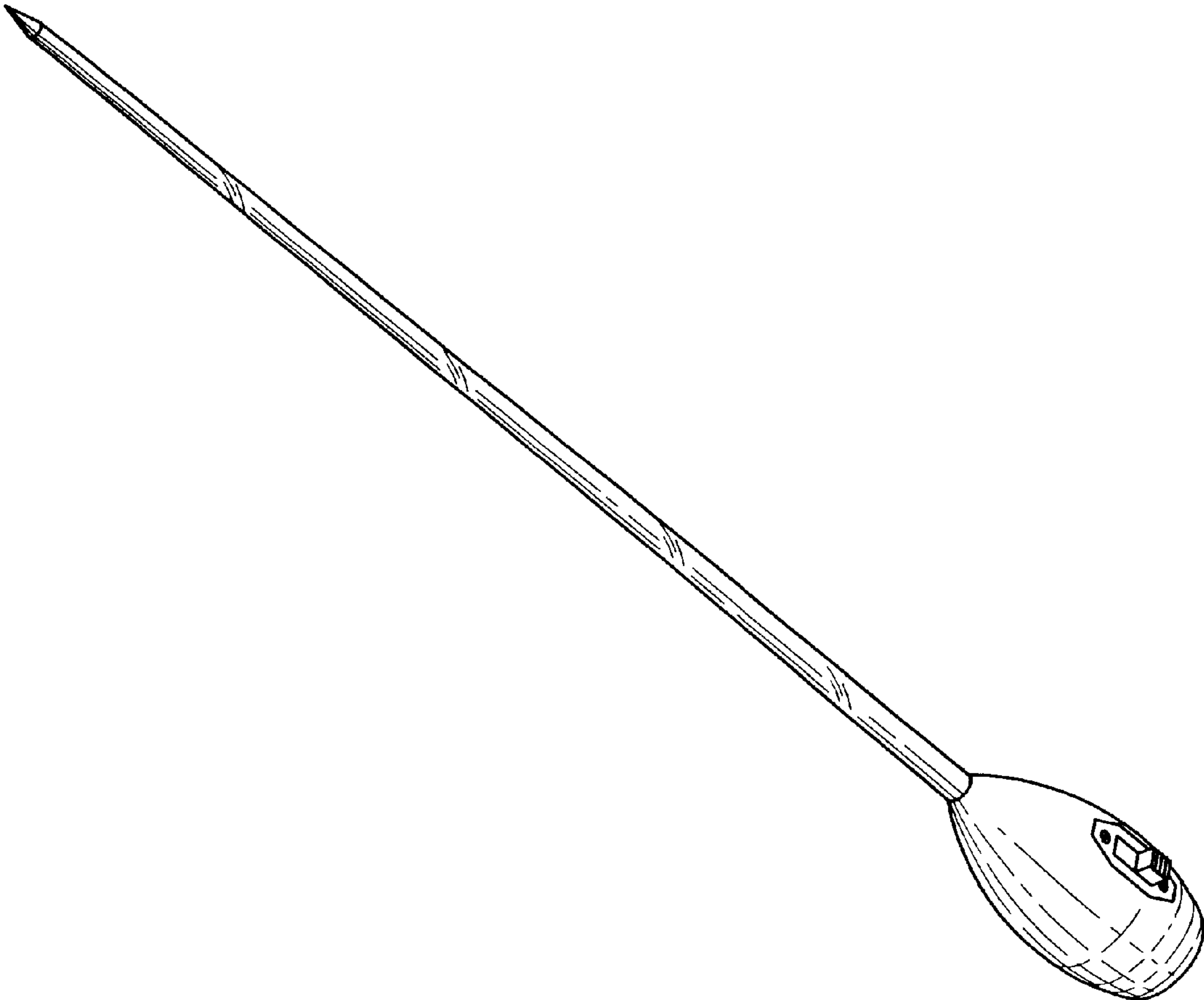
(57) CLAIM

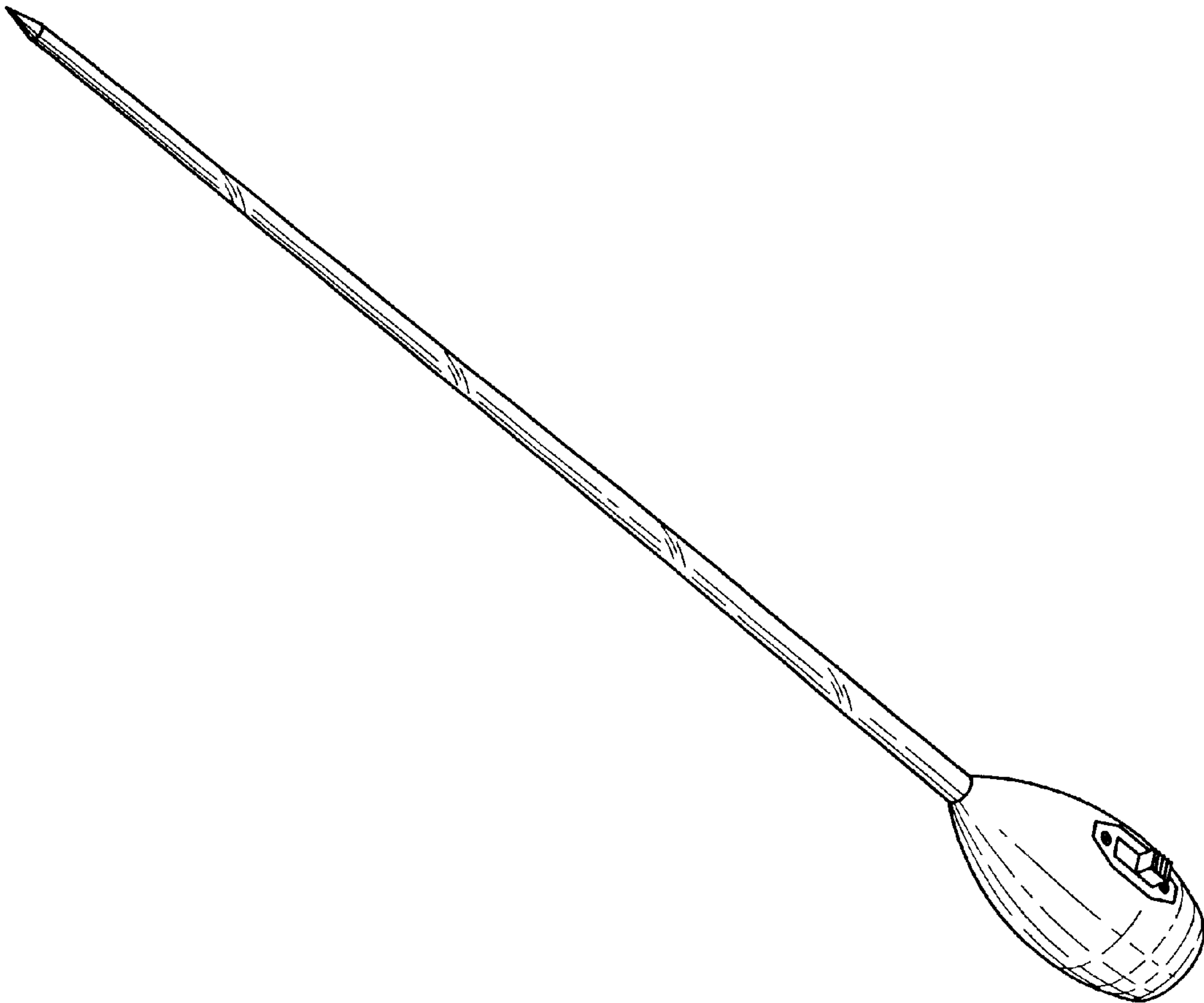

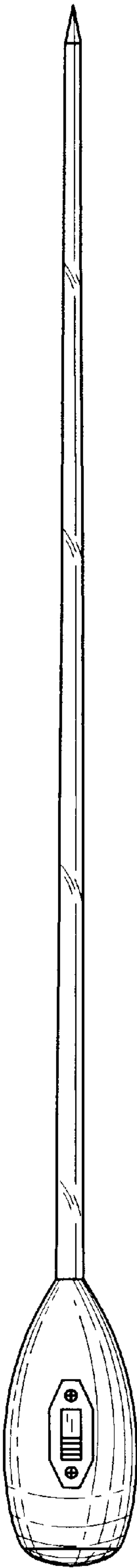

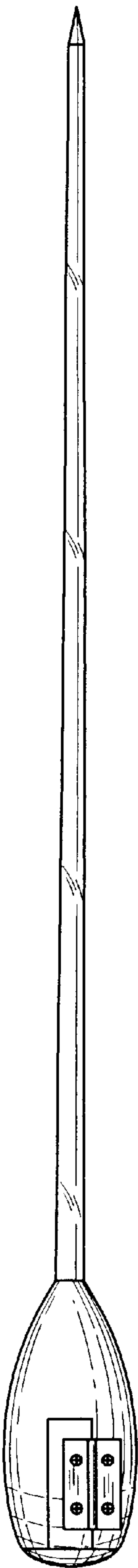

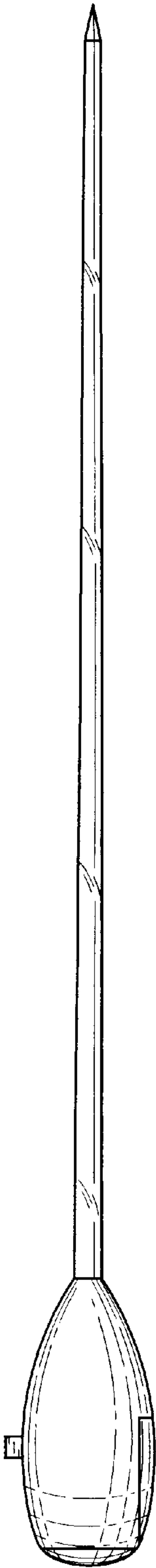

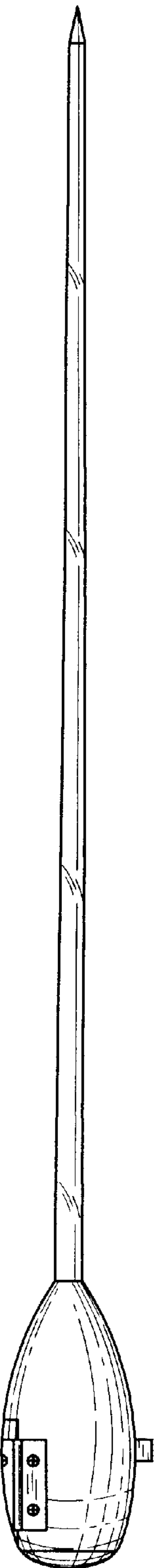

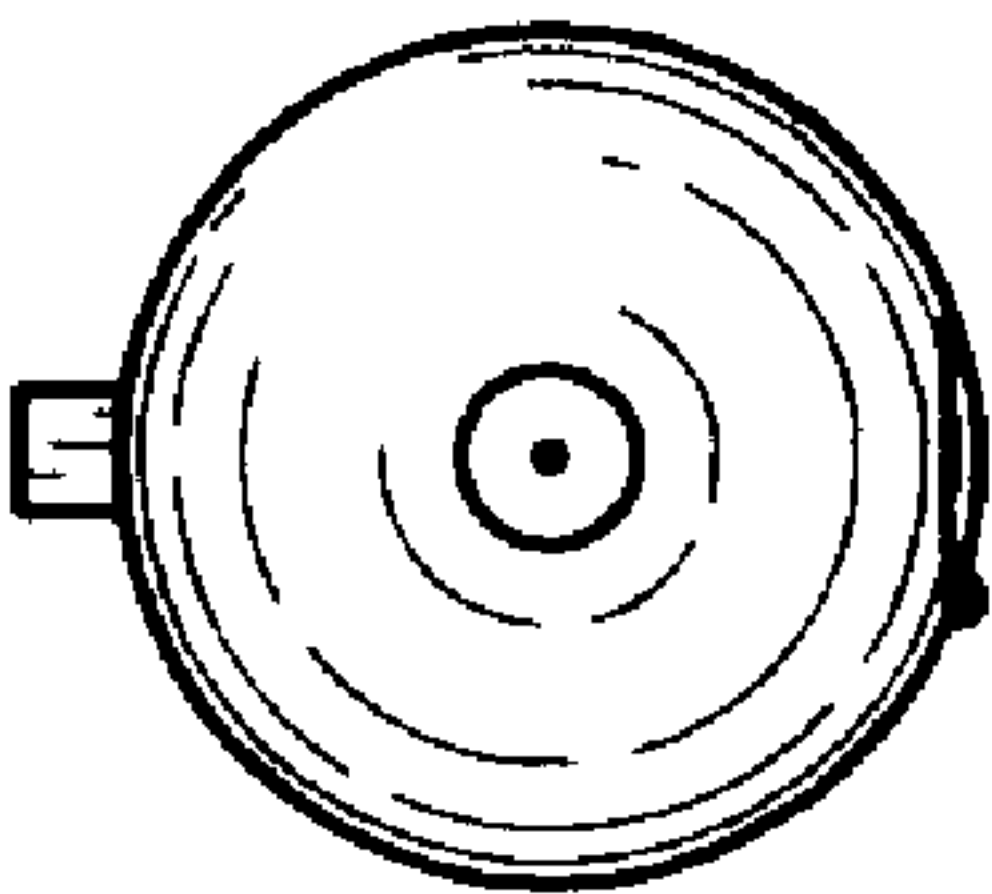

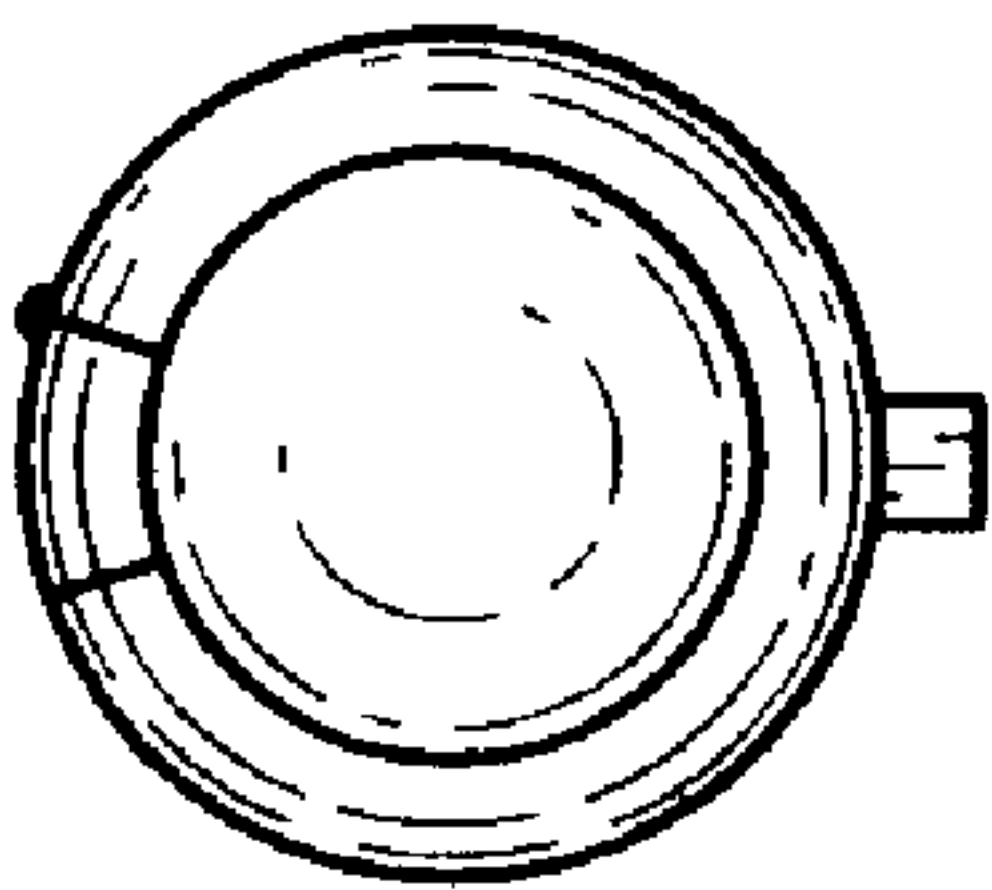
