The ornamental design for a two sided sheath for carrying a plurality of tools, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a two sided sheath for carrying a plurality of tools showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 7 is an upper right side perspective view thereof.









