(57) **CLAIM**

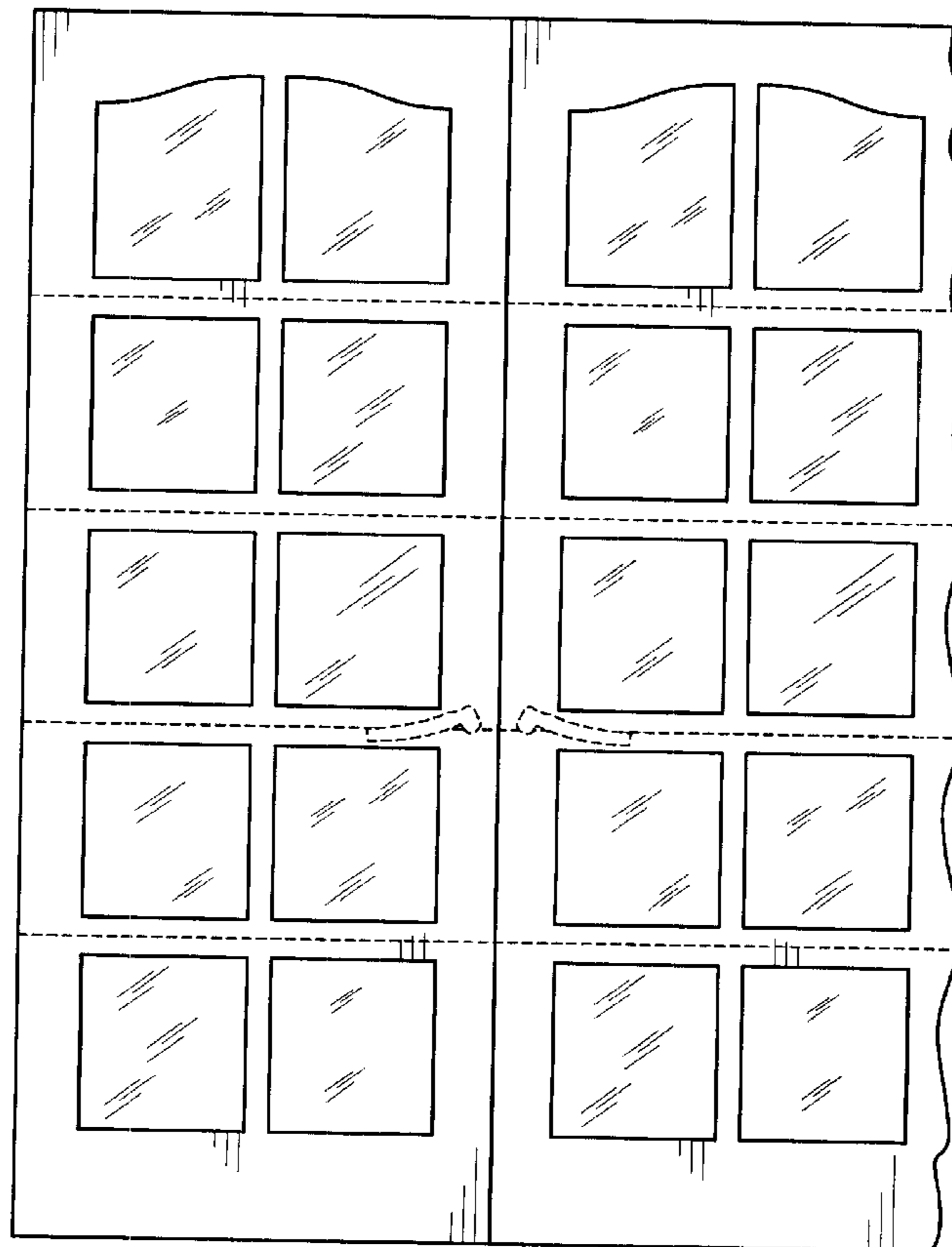
The ornamental design for a portion of an overhead garage door façade, as shown and described.

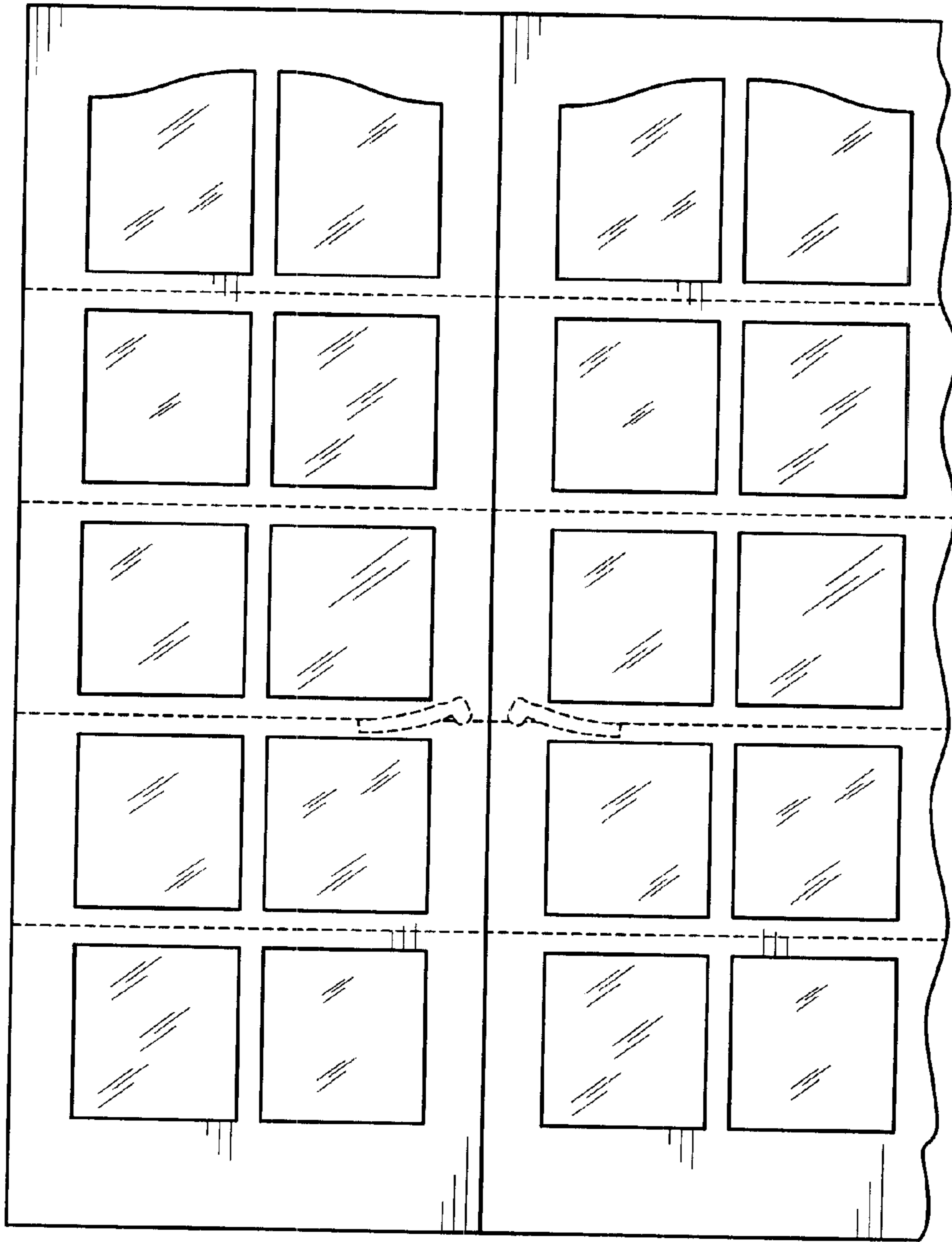
DESCRIPTION
