FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the cookie pan with dimples;

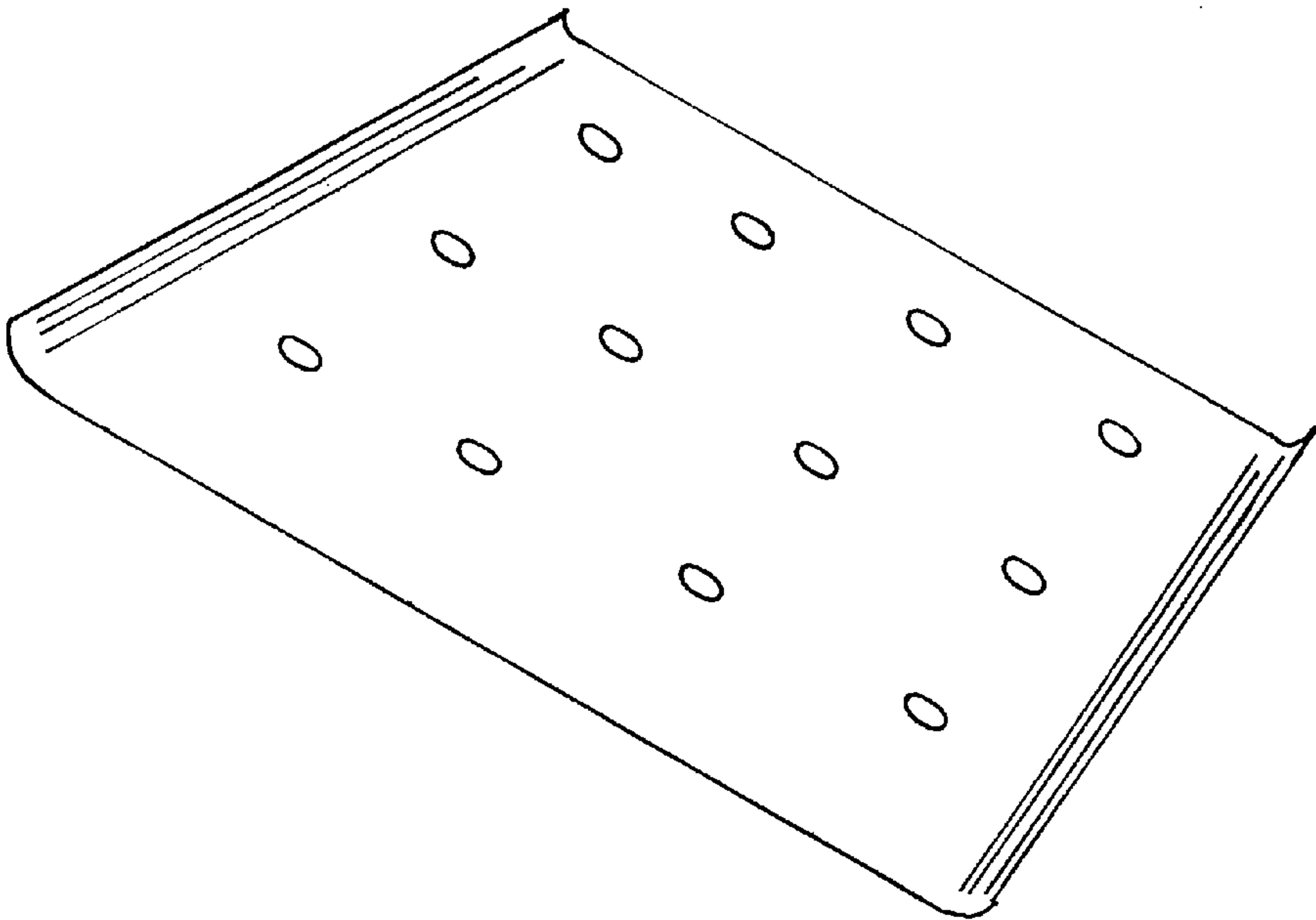
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the cookie pan with

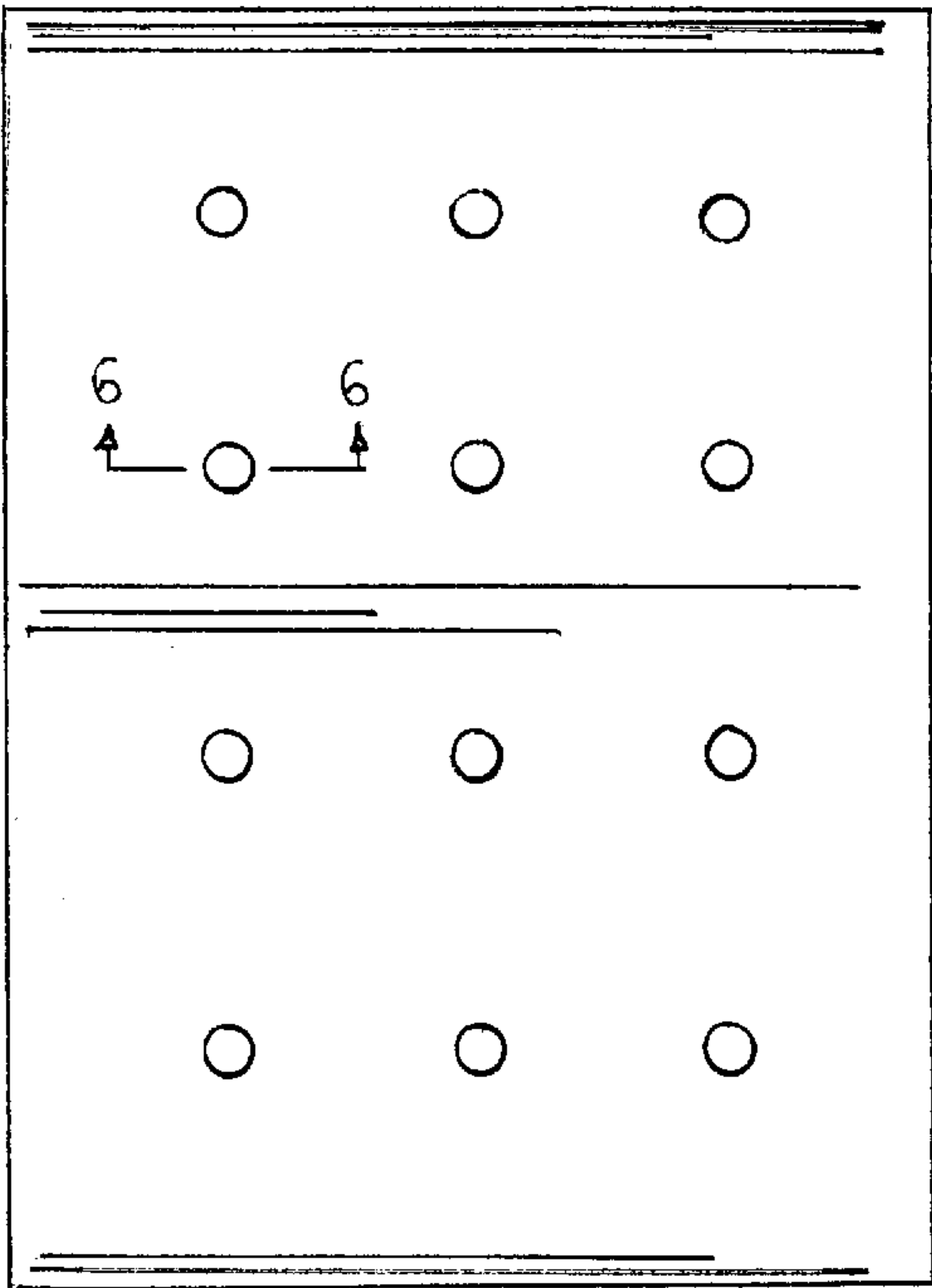

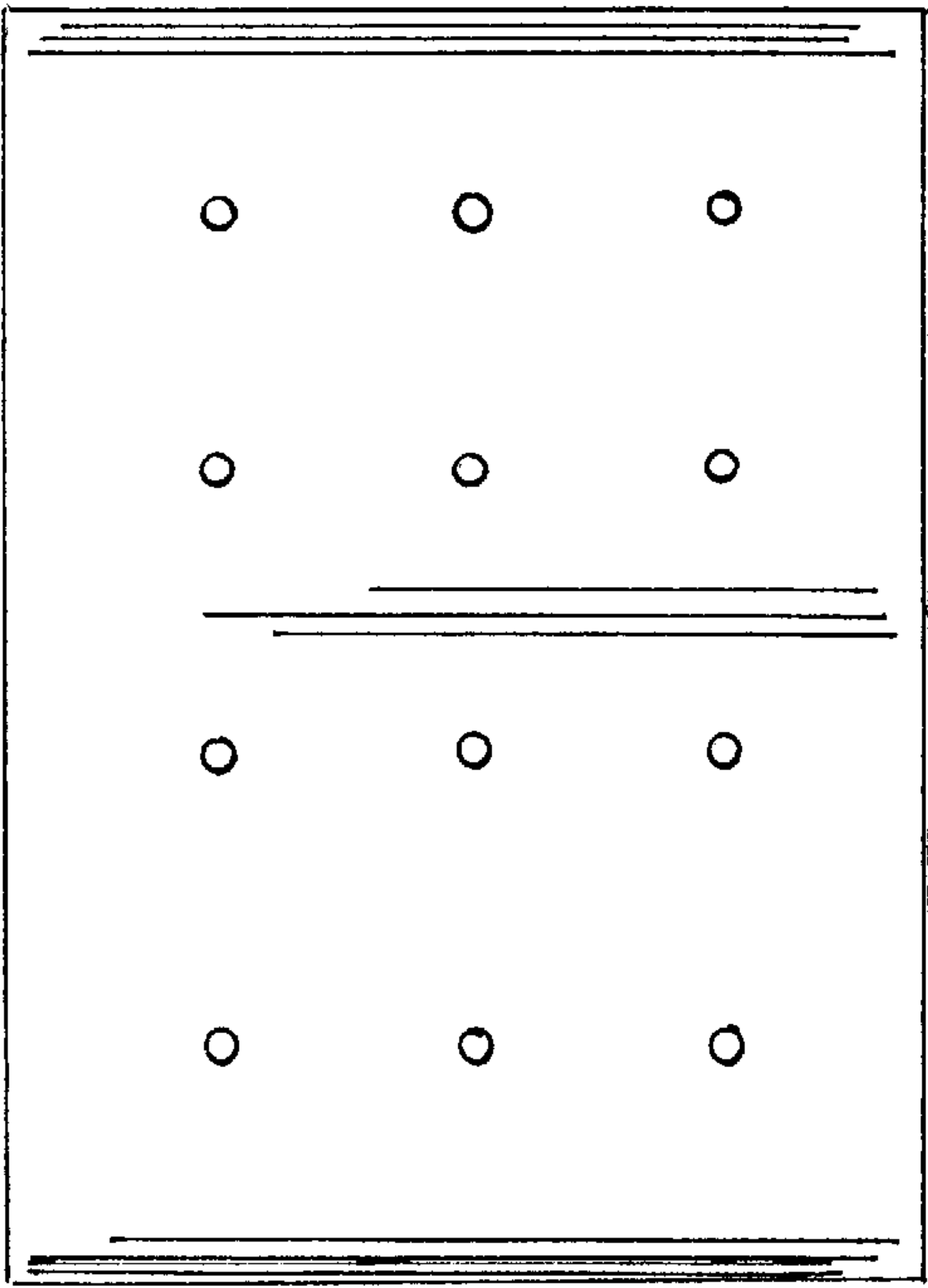

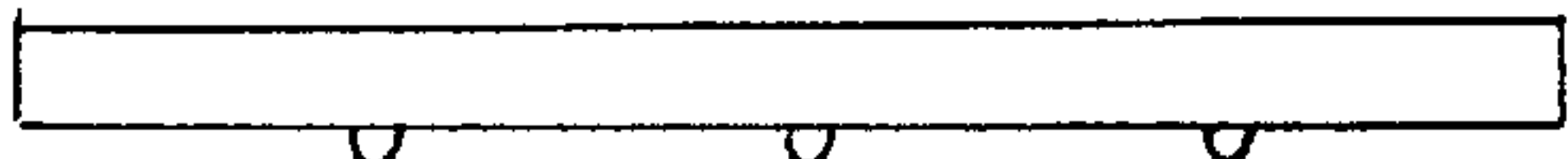

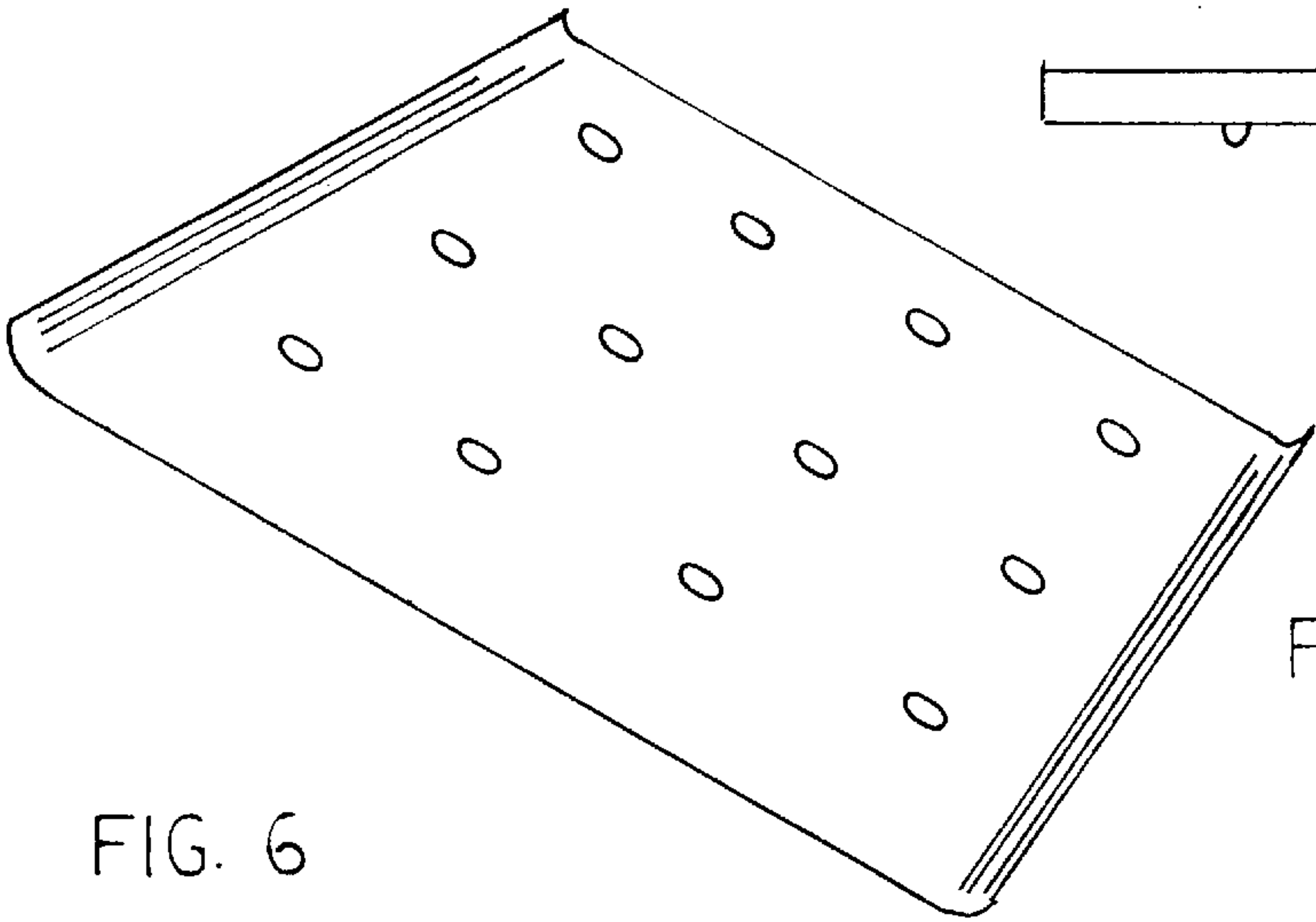
