The ornamental design for an architectural light, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an architectural light
embodying the principles of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the architectural light of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 3 is a representative side view of the architectural light
of FIGS. 1 and 2, the opposite side view and the front and
rear views being essentially identical thereto.

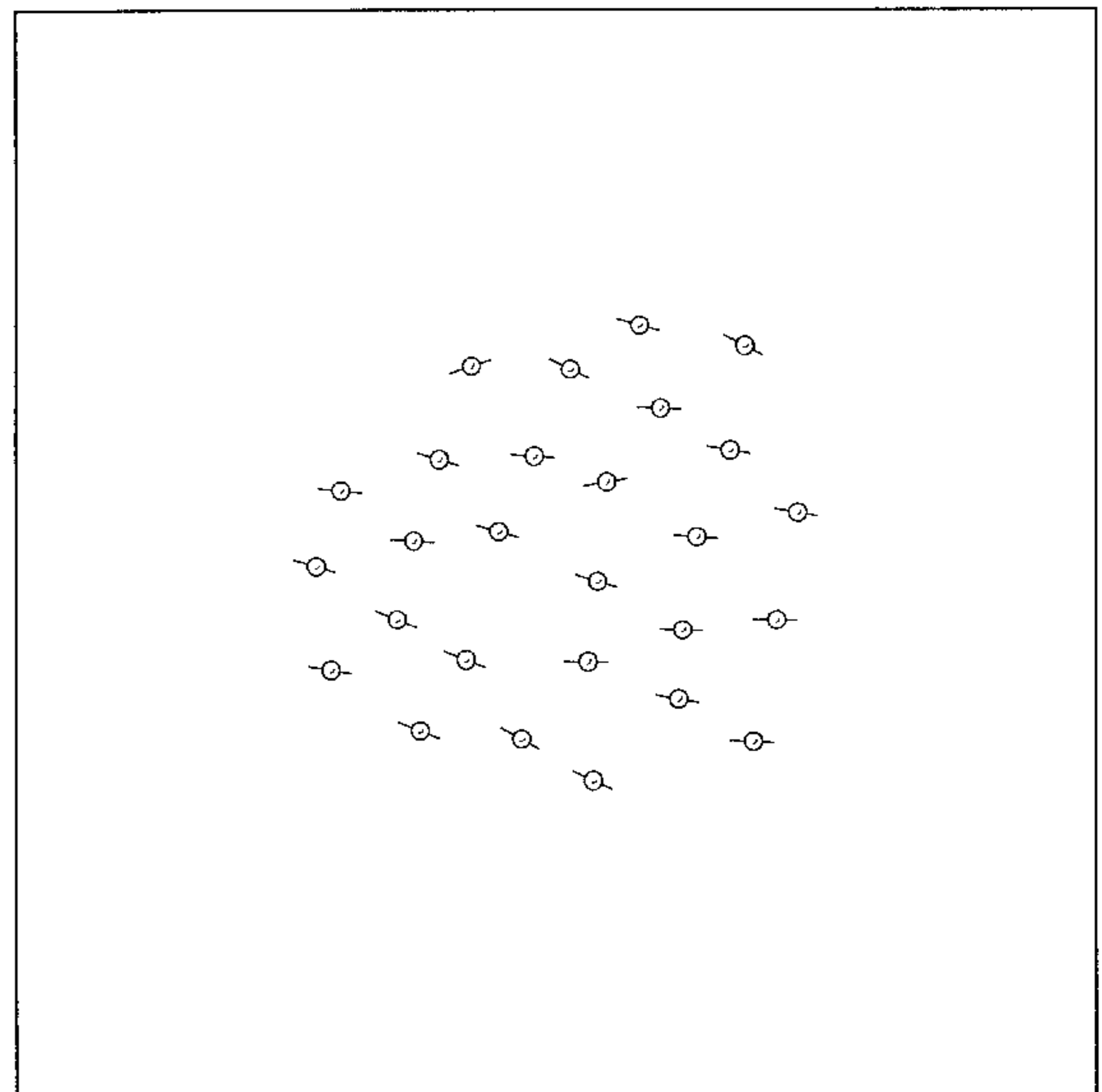
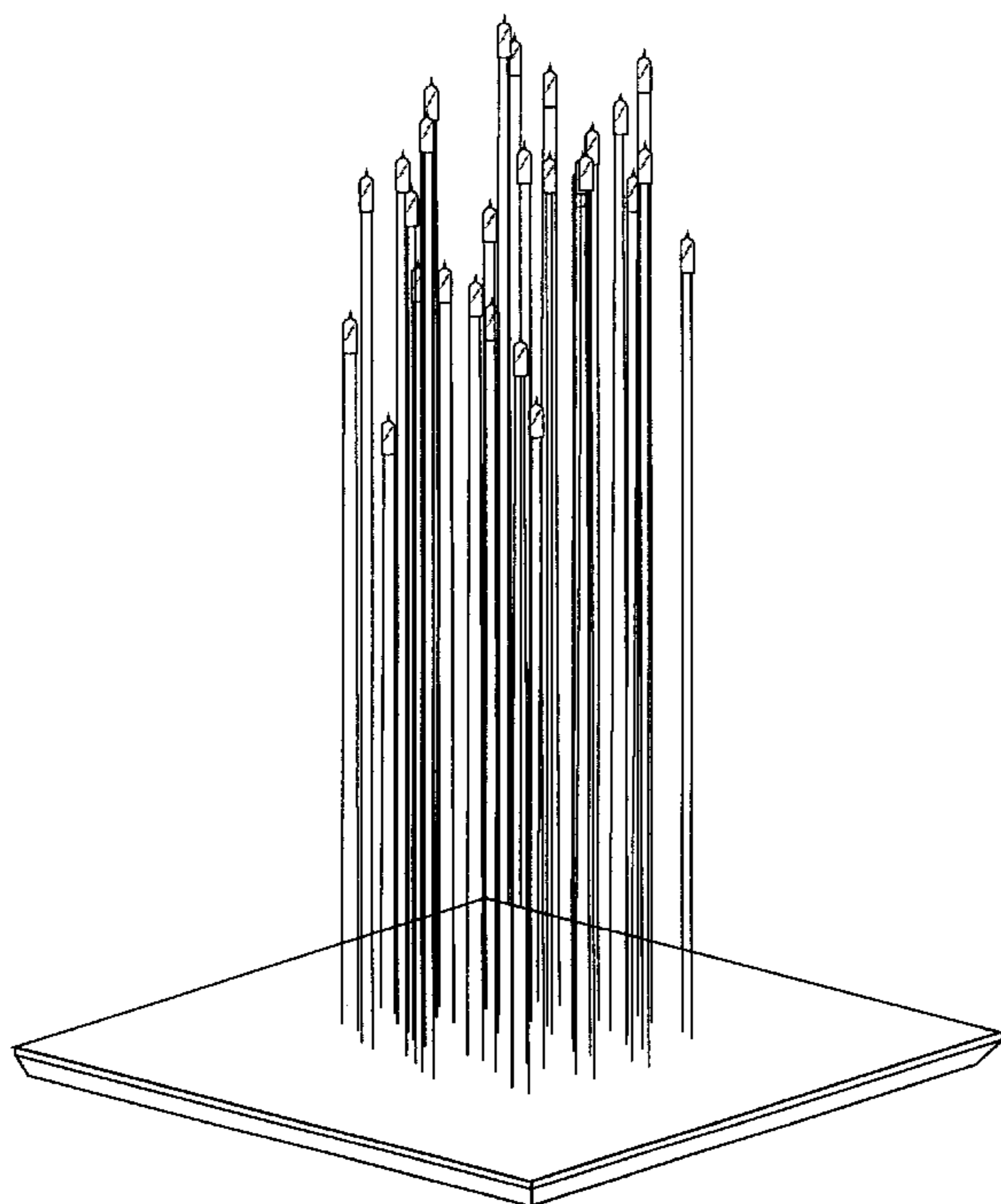

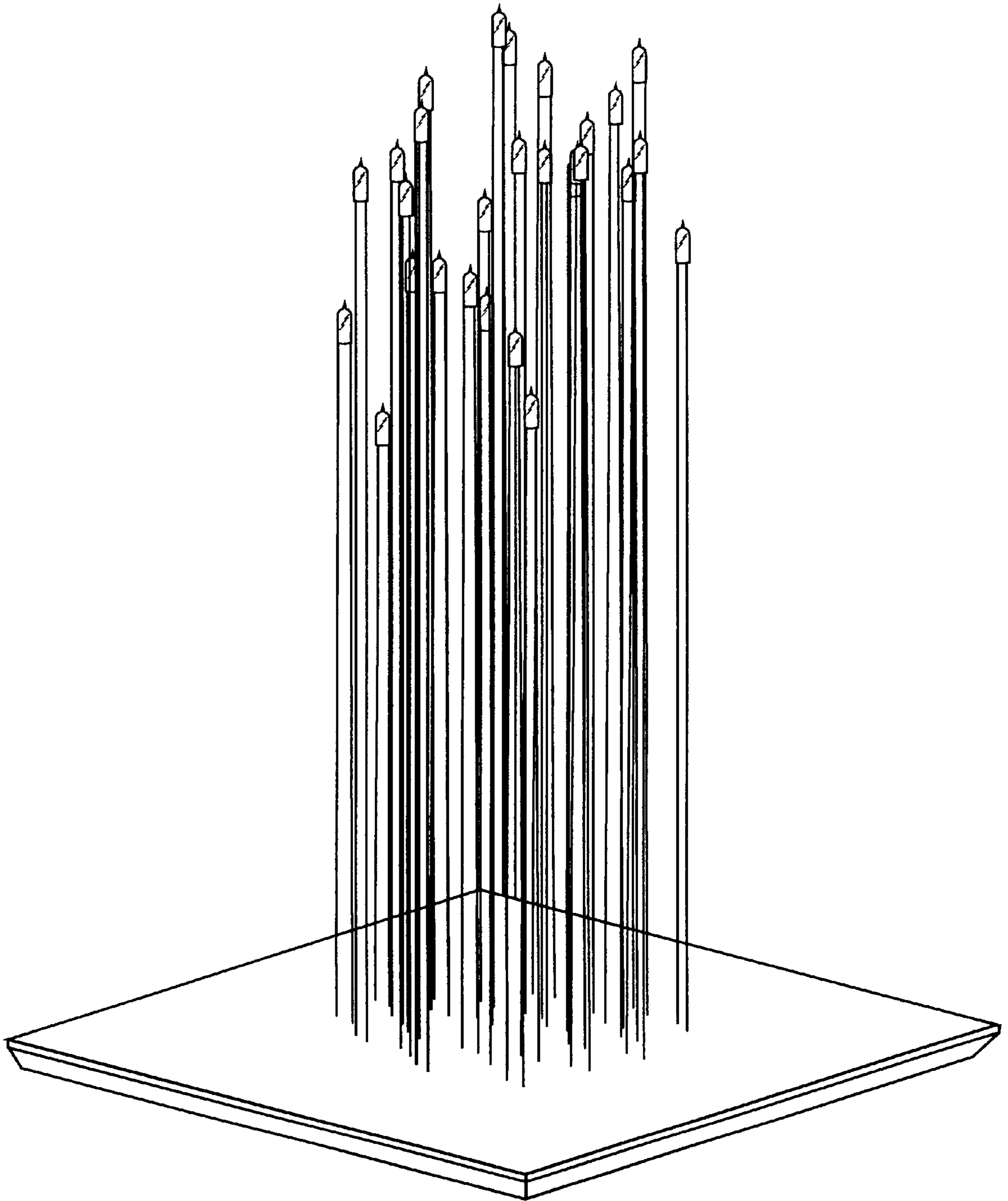

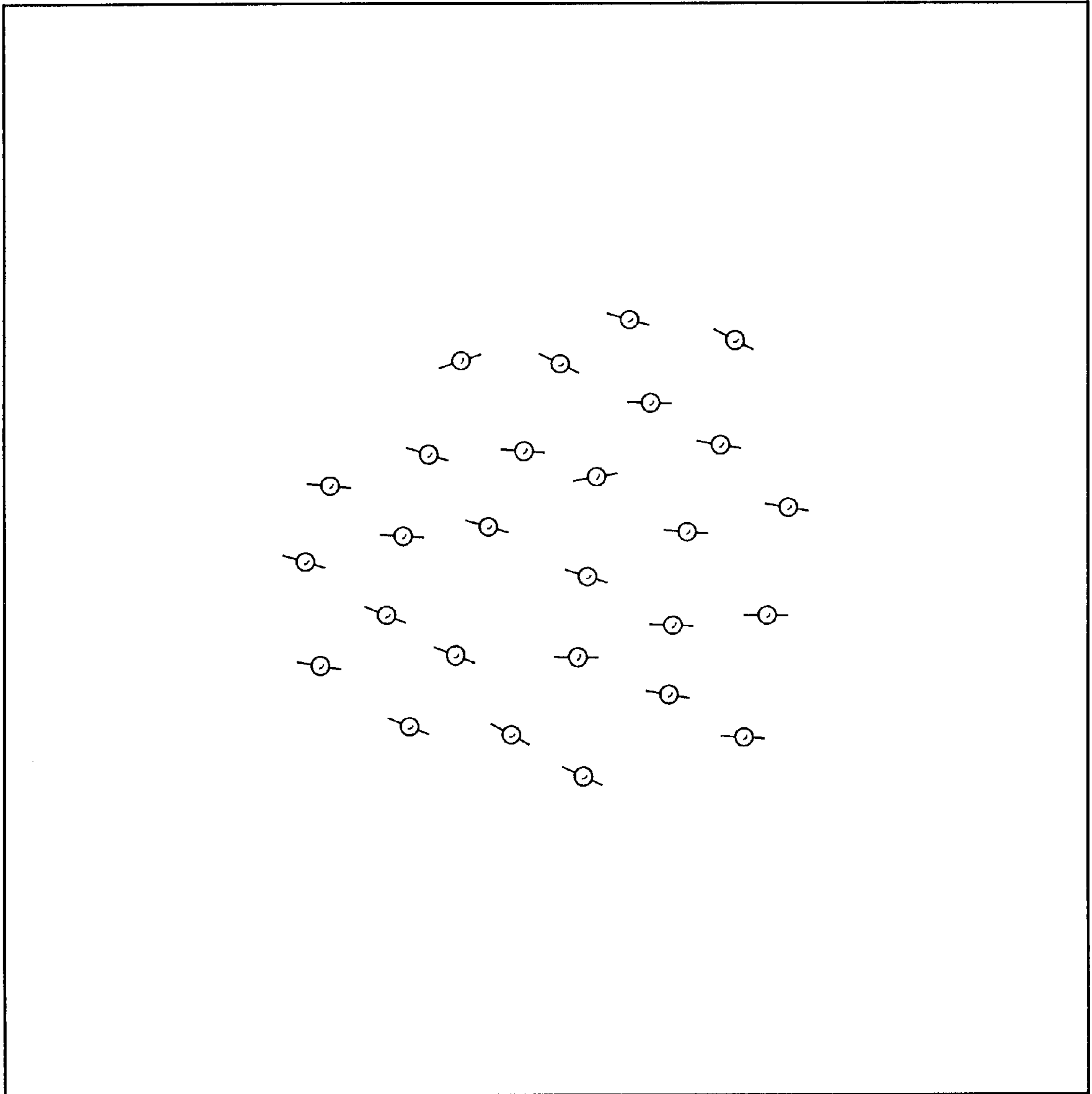
