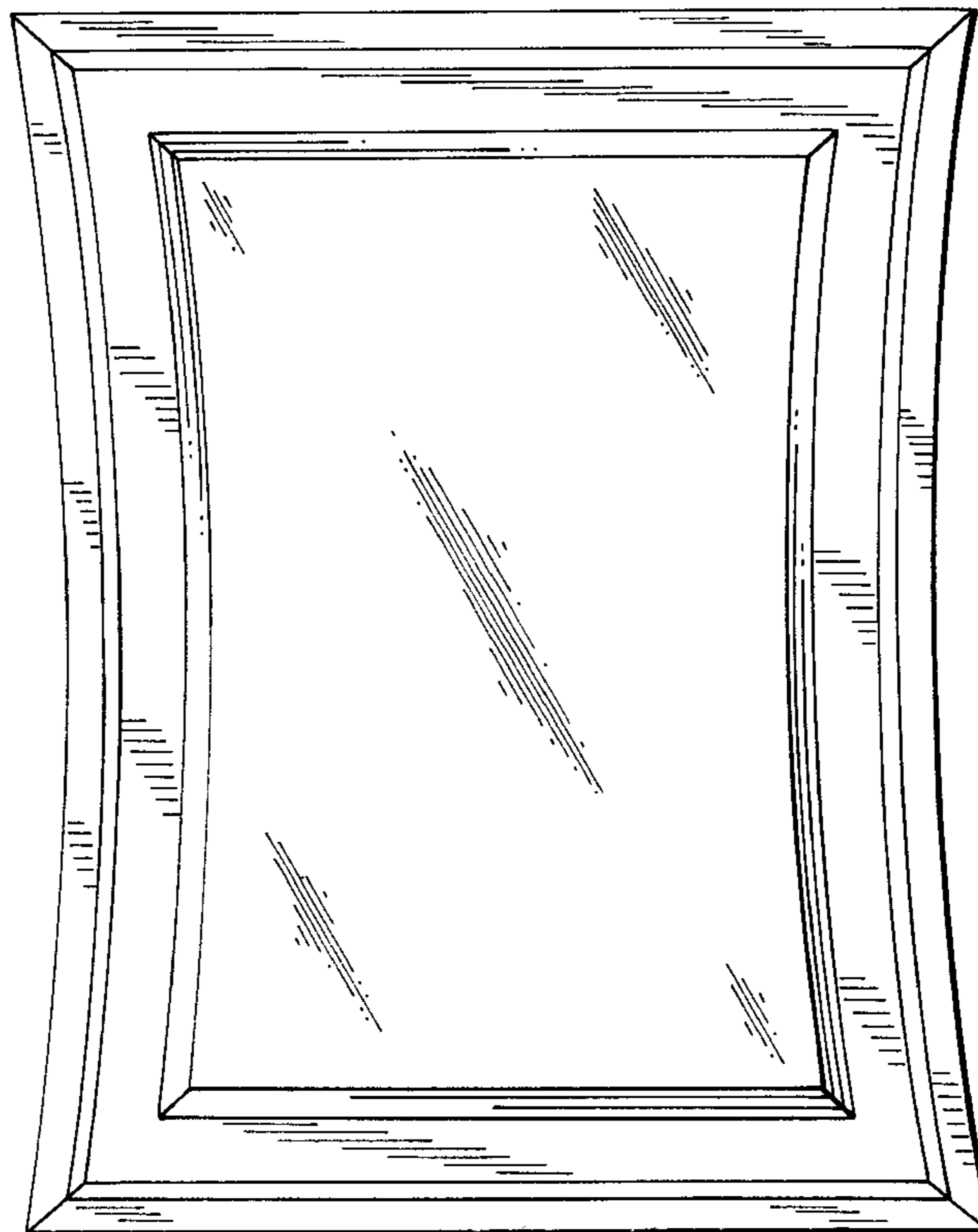
FIG. 1 is a front view of the new design;

and therefore not shown; and,

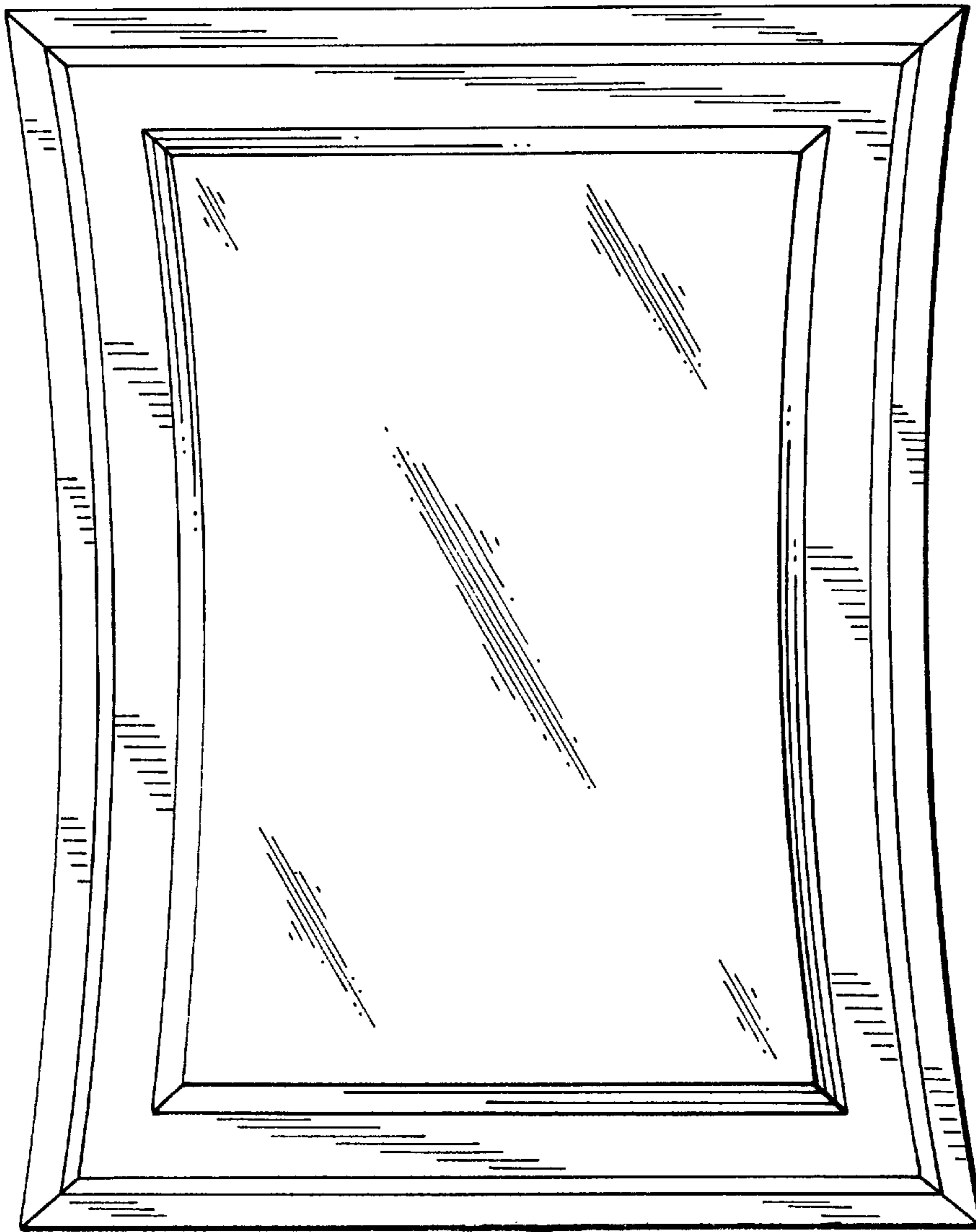
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; the bottom view is identical to

therefore not shown.

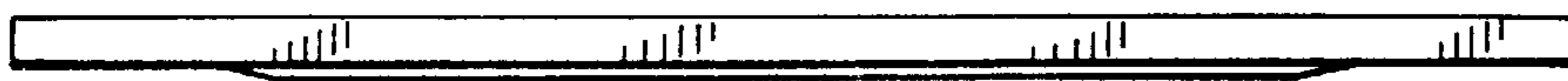
