(57)**CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a portion of a motorcycle swing arm, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the portion of a motorcycle swing arm, shown in position of use from the left side of the motorcycle; and,

FIG. 2 is an enlarged side perspective view of the portion of a motorcycle swing arm.
