The ornamental design for a runner for umbrella, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a runner for an umbrella showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the runner in an umbrella showing the environment in which the runner is used.

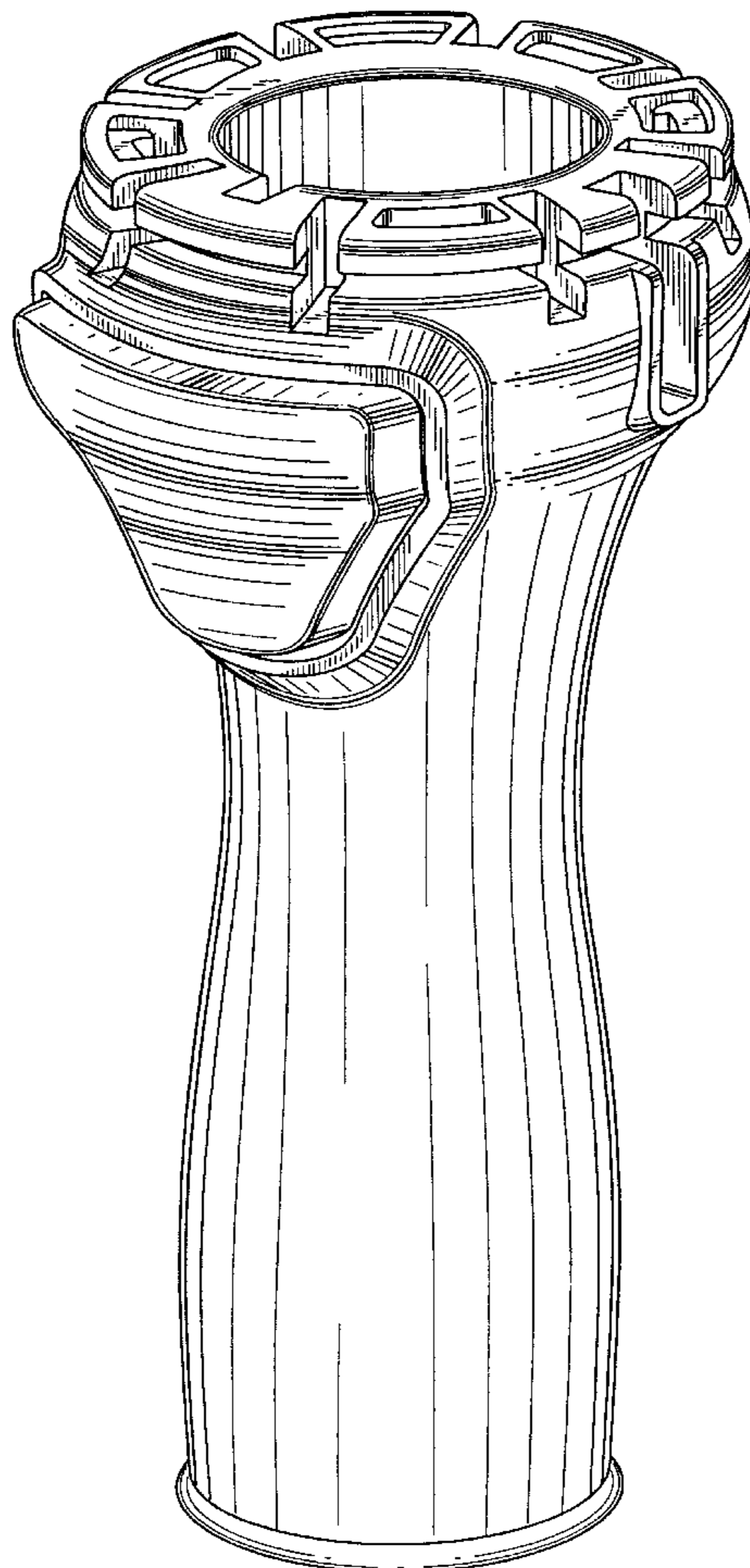

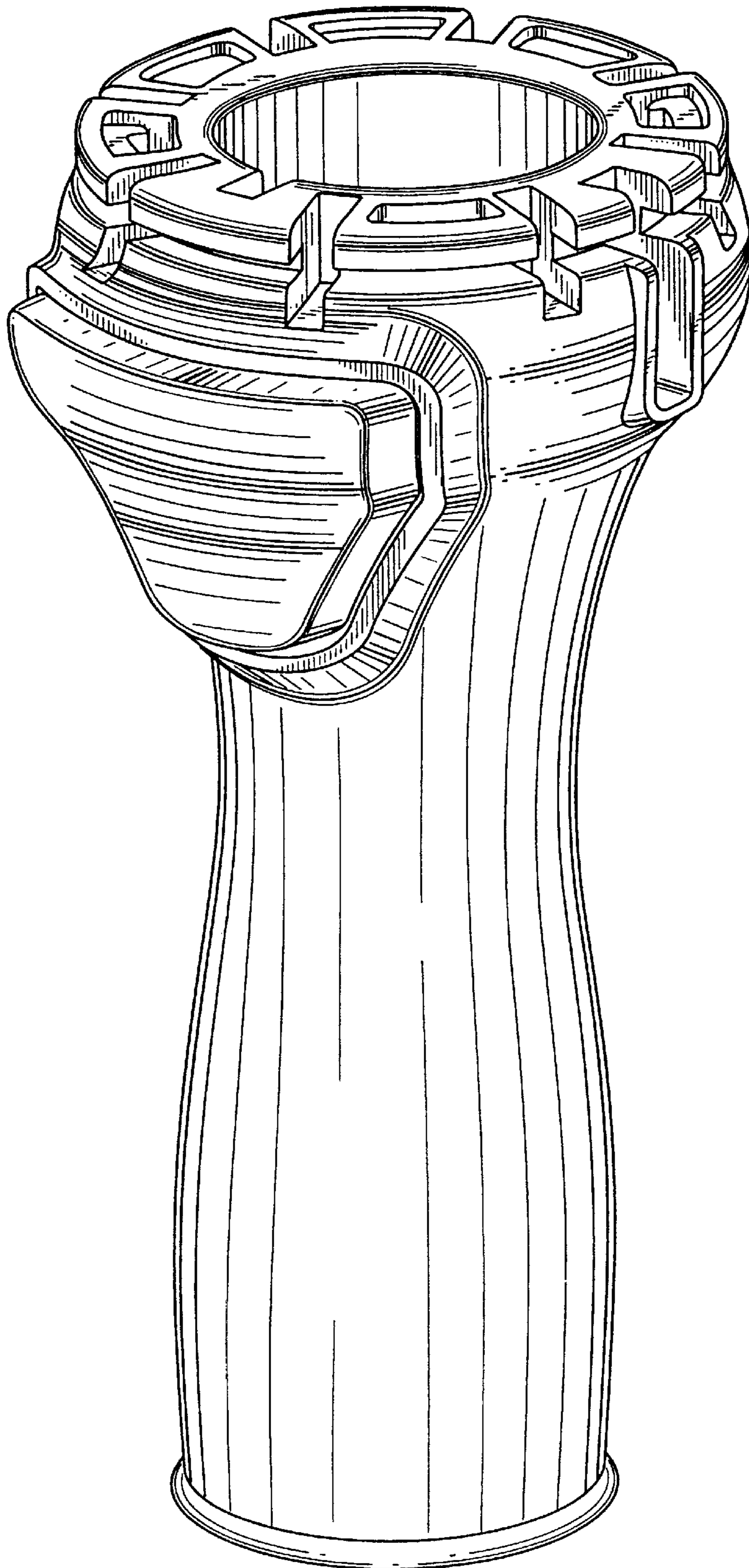

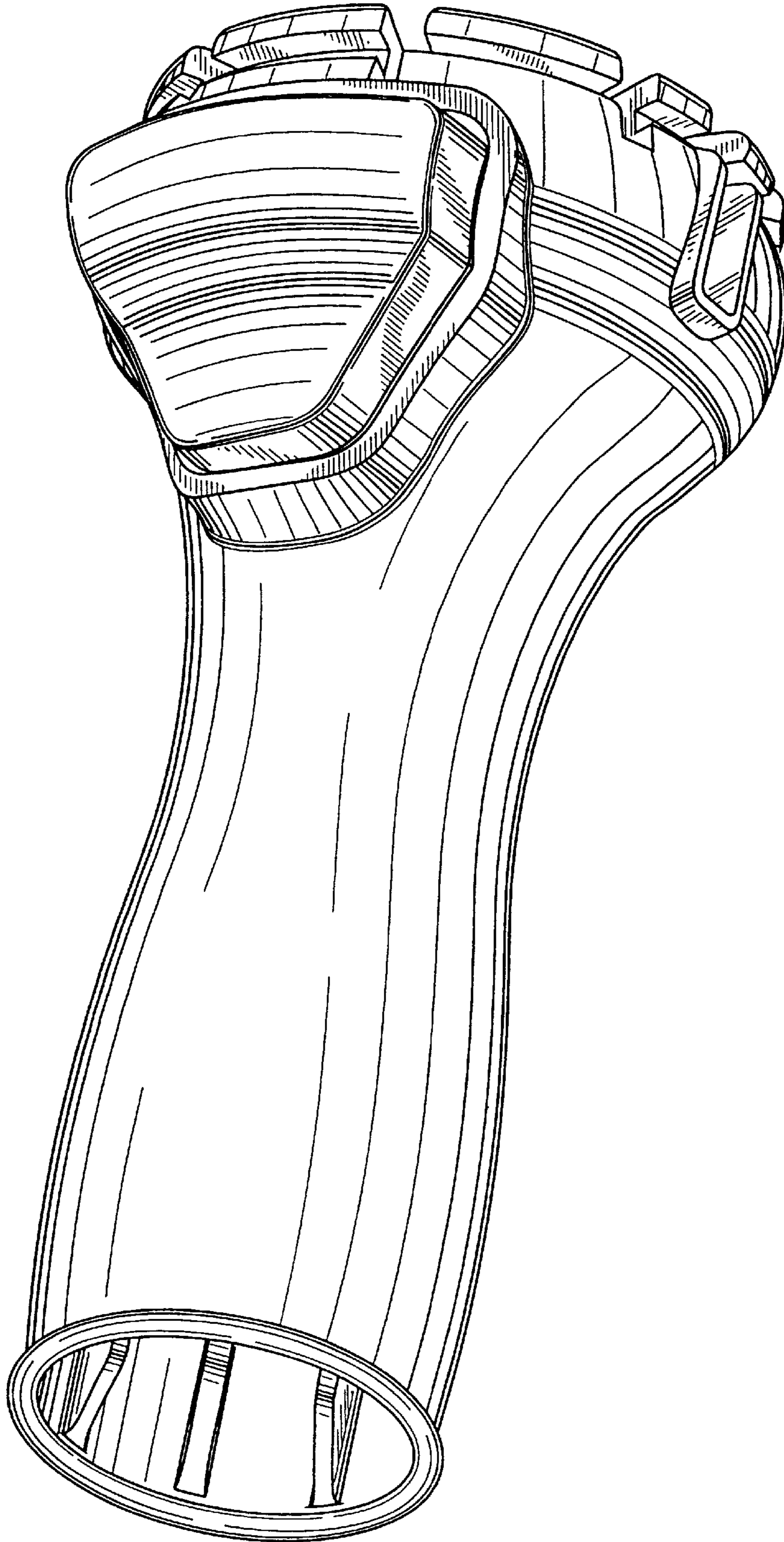

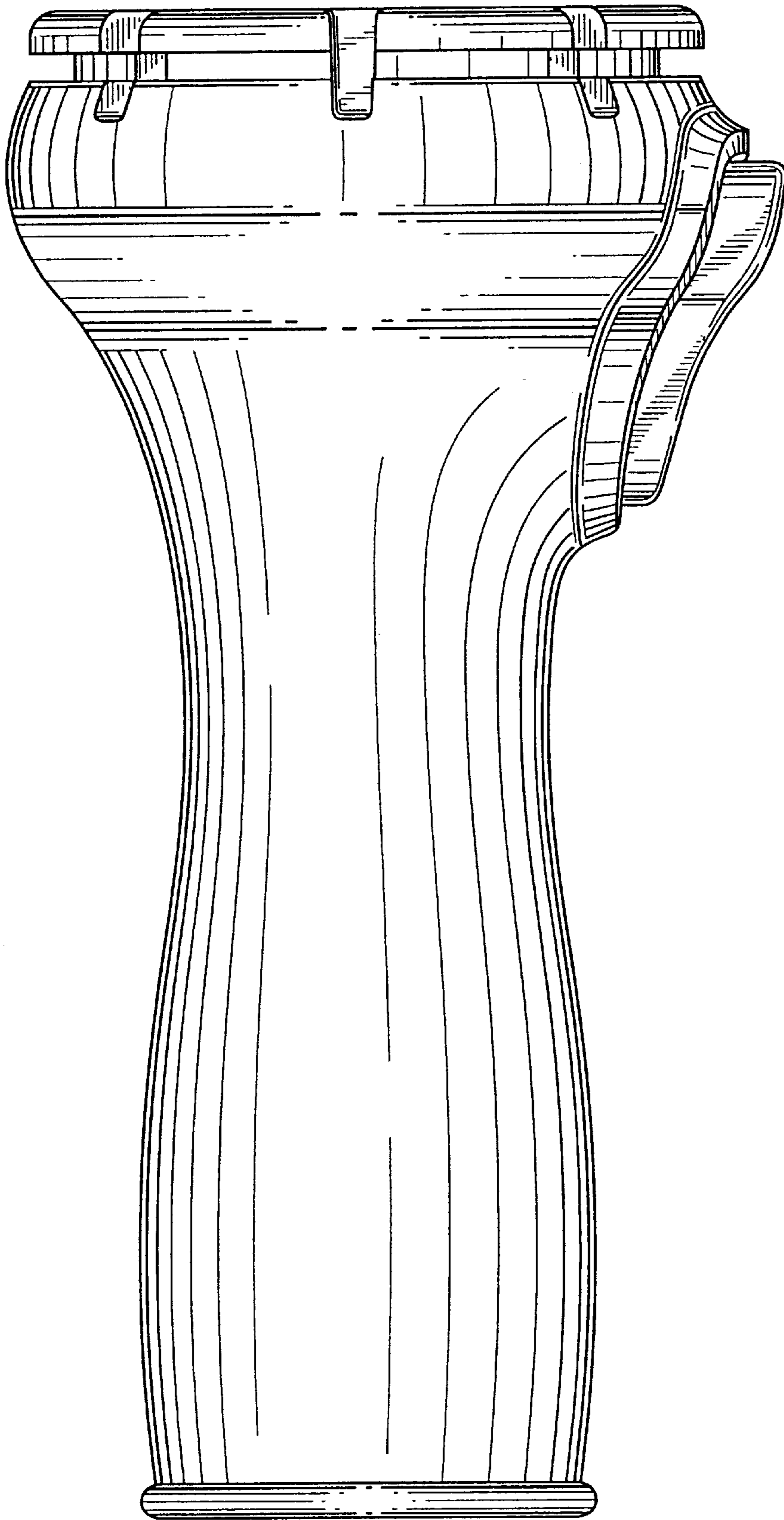

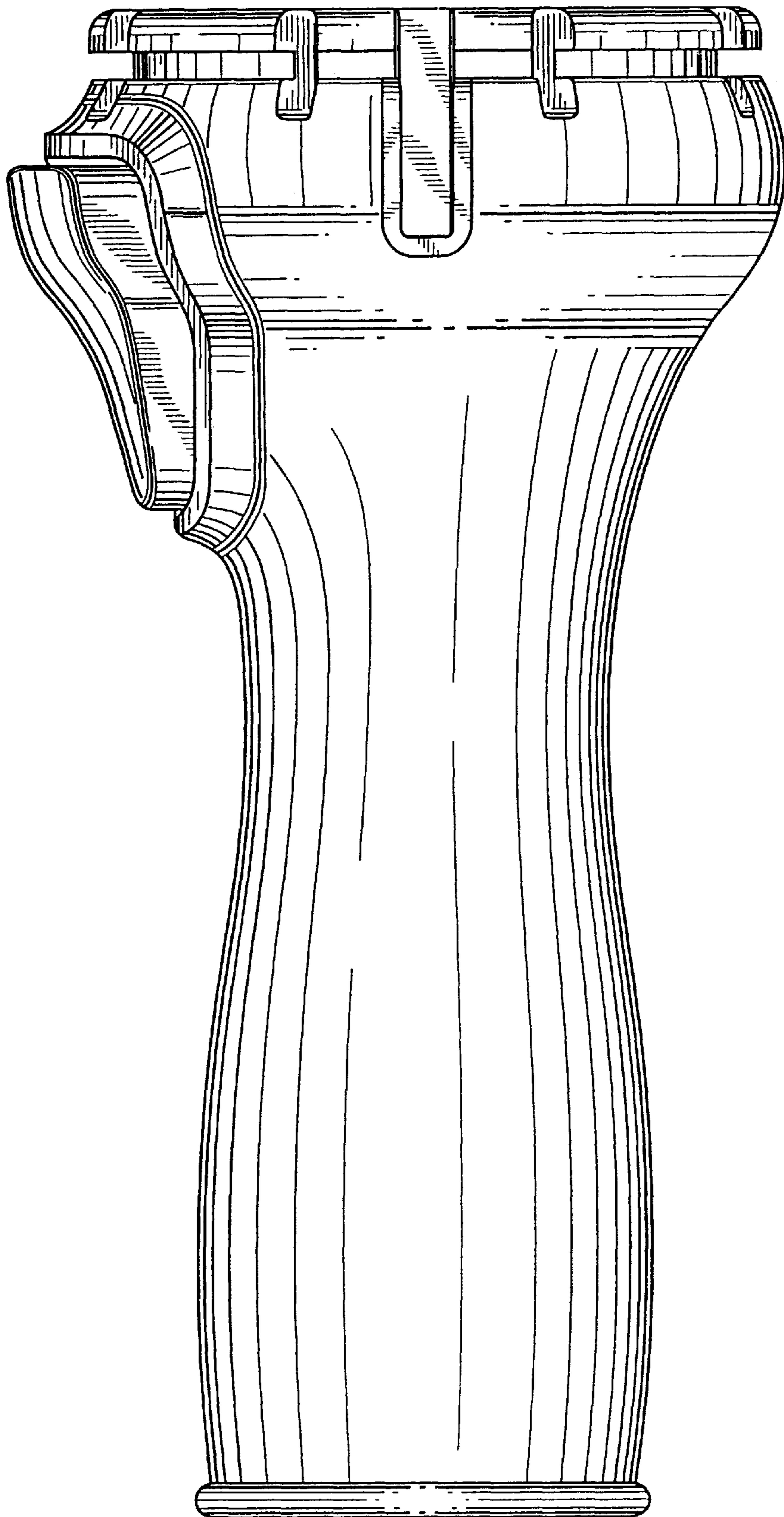
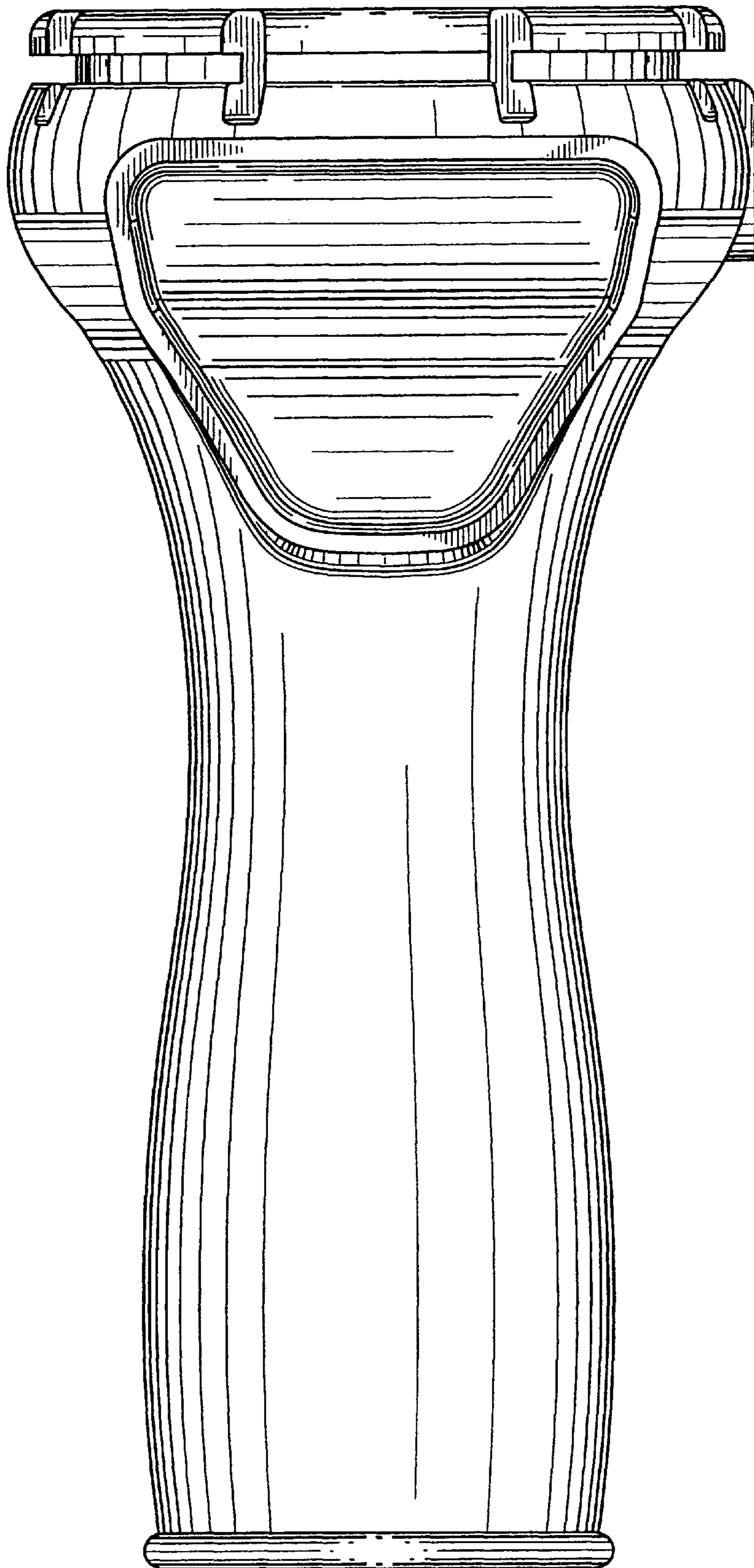

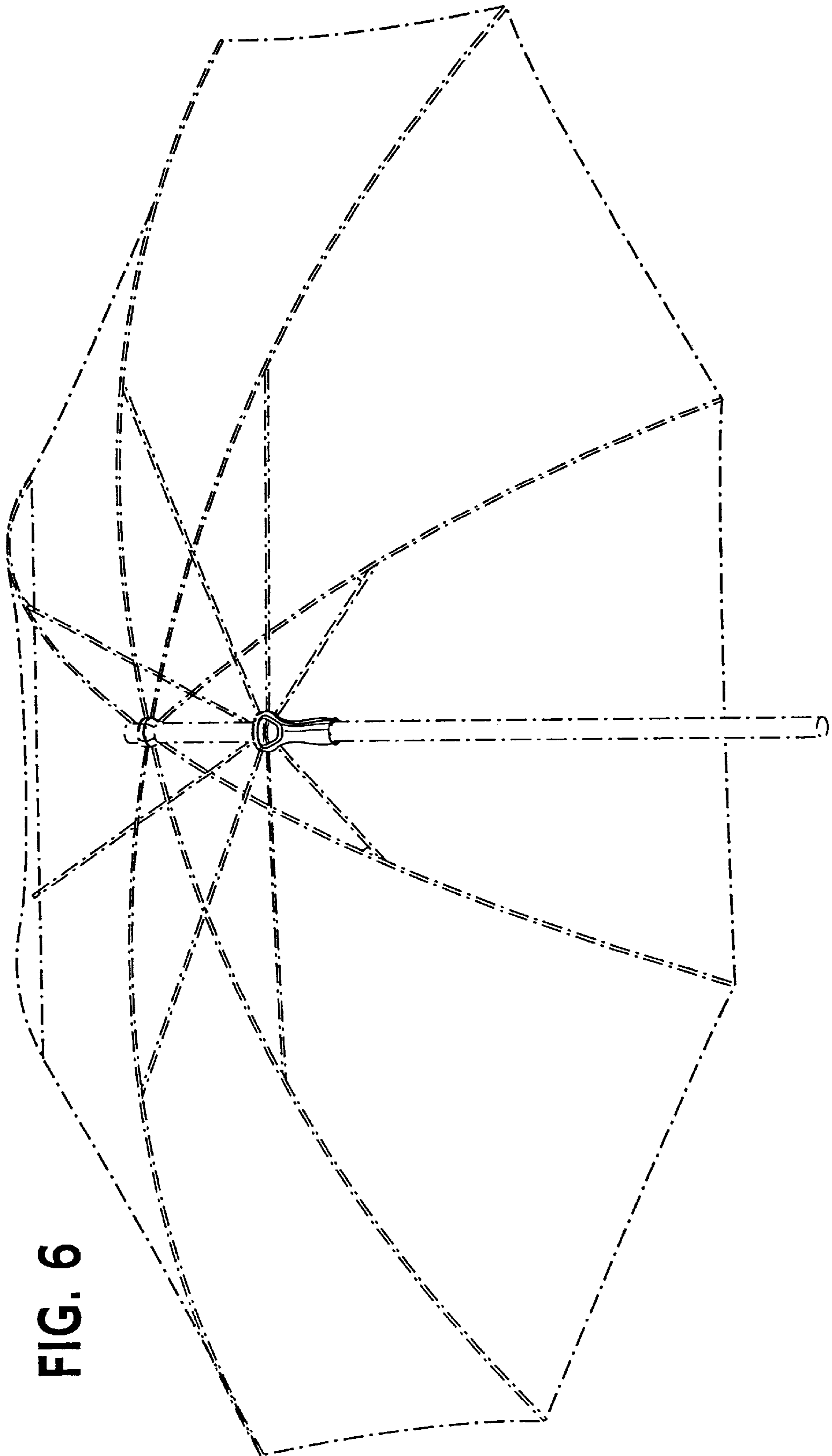
