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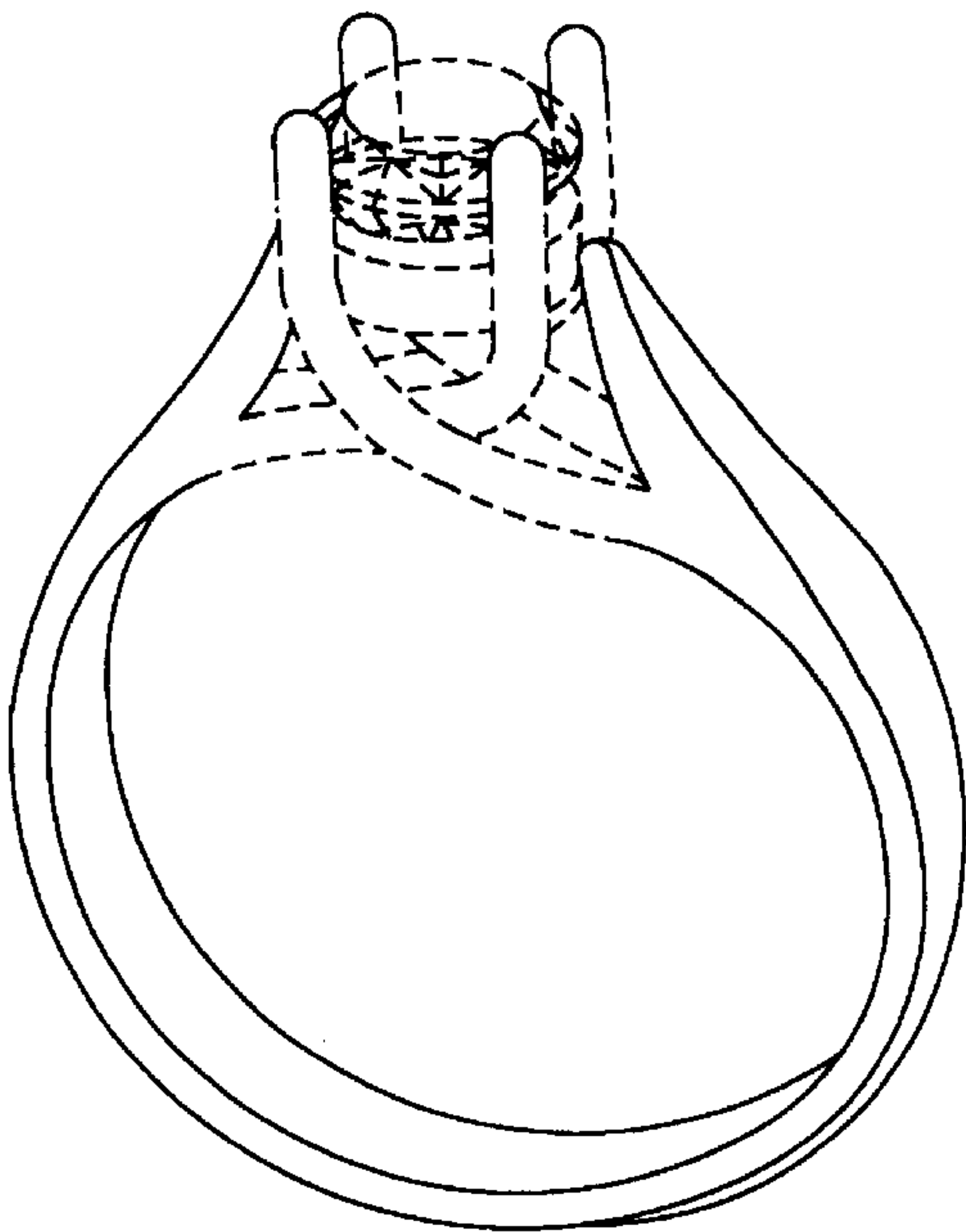
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a solitaire ring, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the solitaire ring;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear is a mirror image
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side is a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.
The precious stone and other portions of the ring are shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1–5 for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
No rear or right side views are presented as these are mirror images of the left side and front plan views.

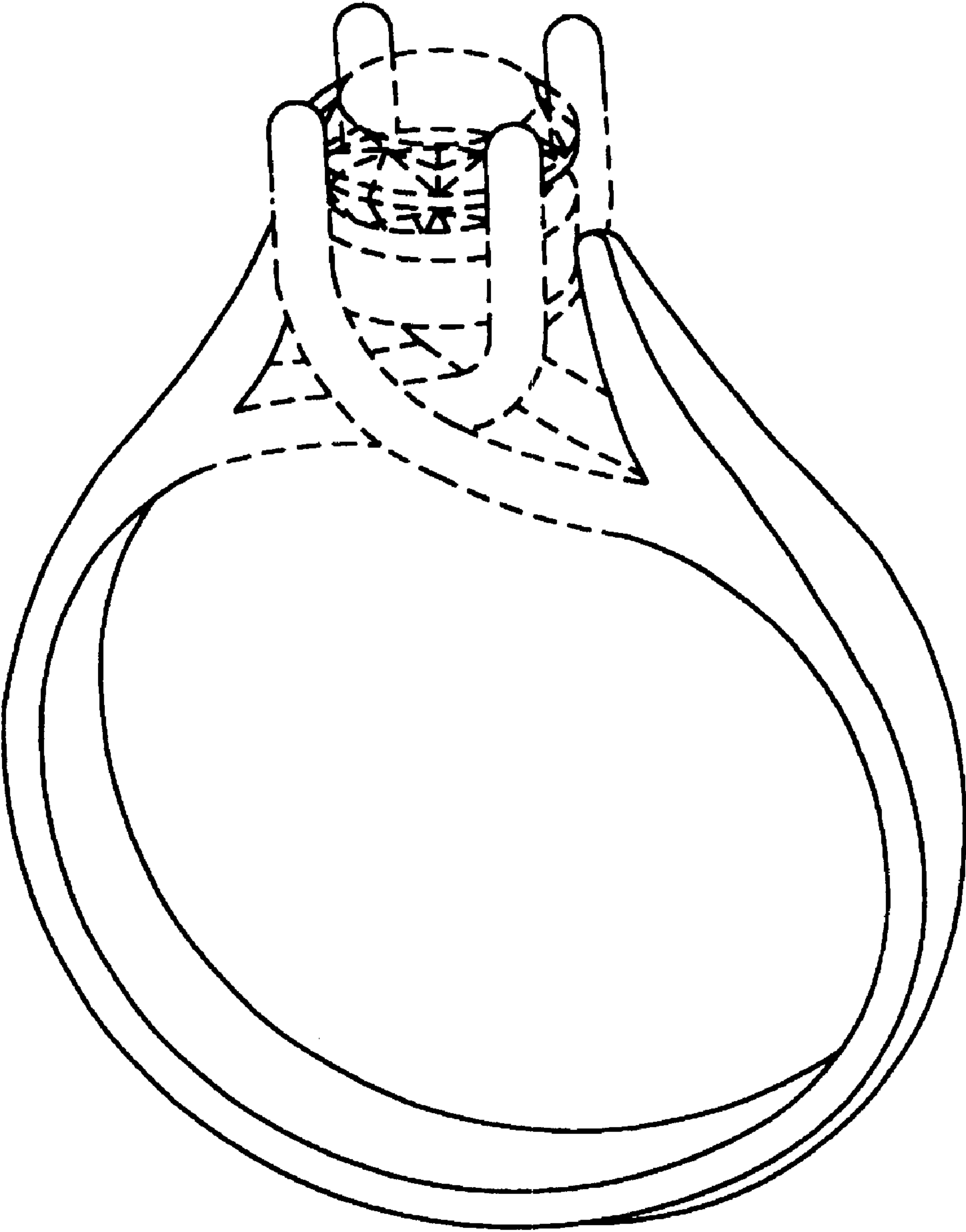

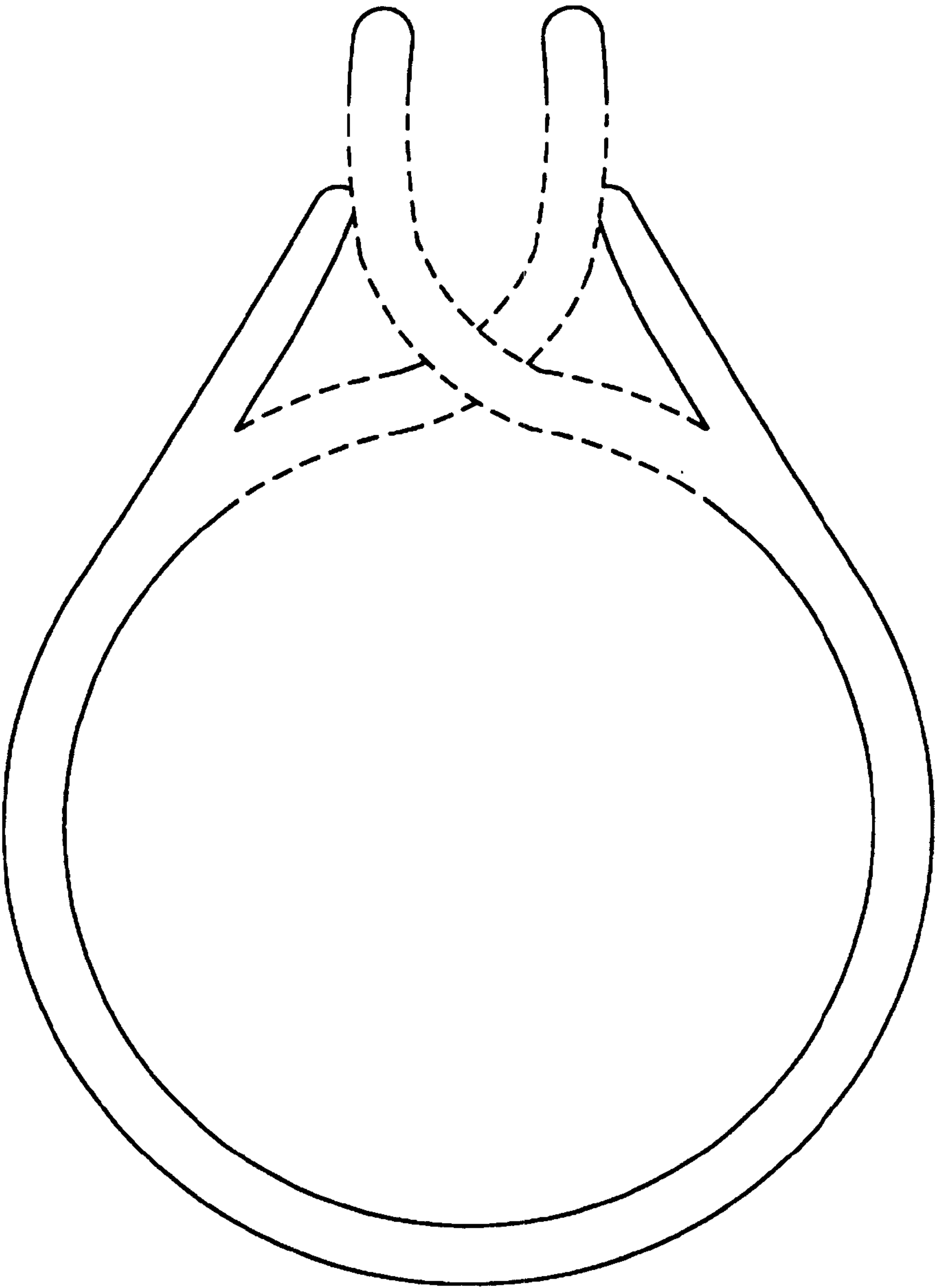

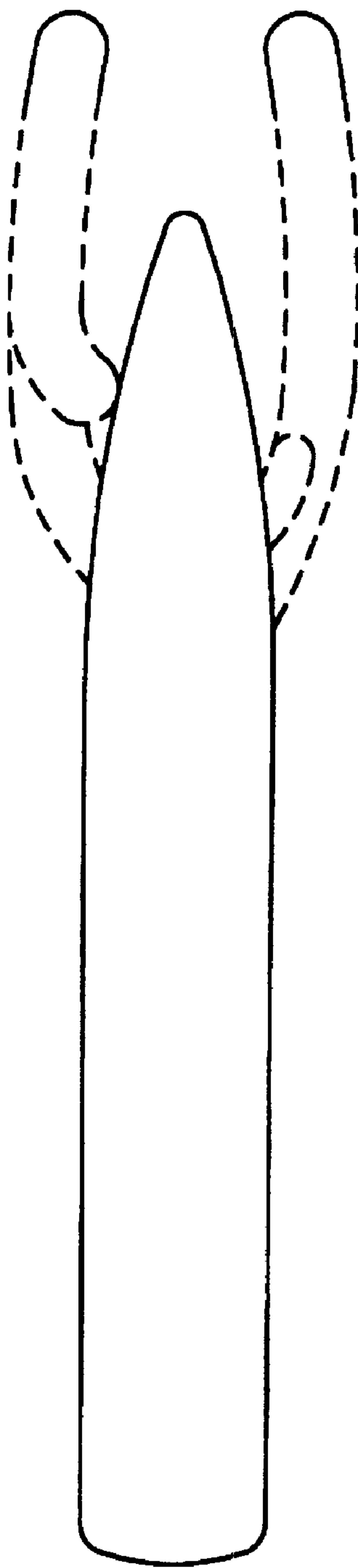

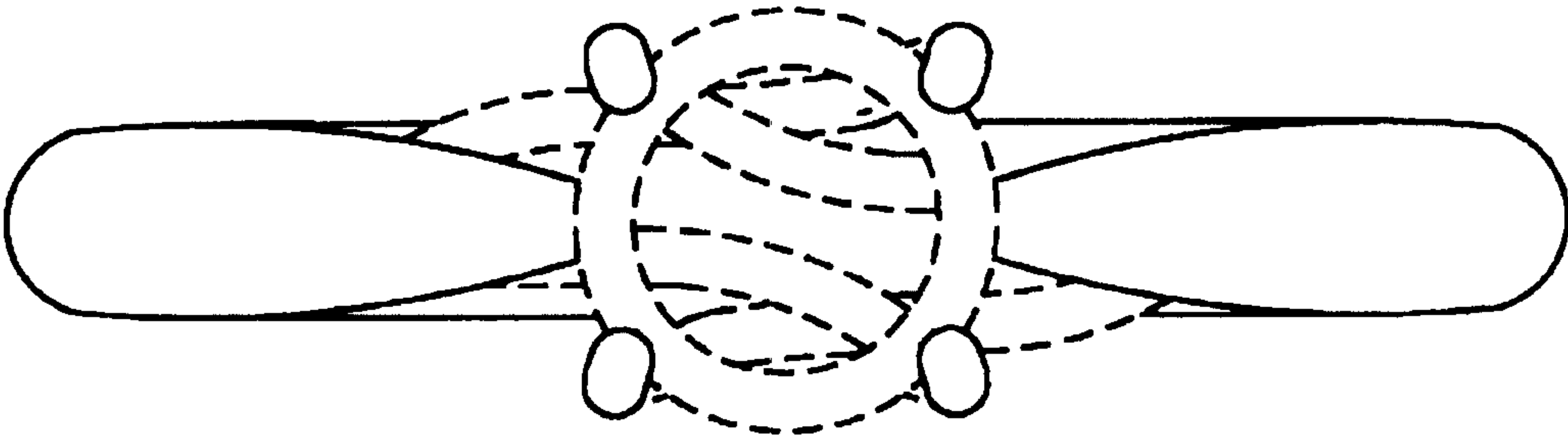

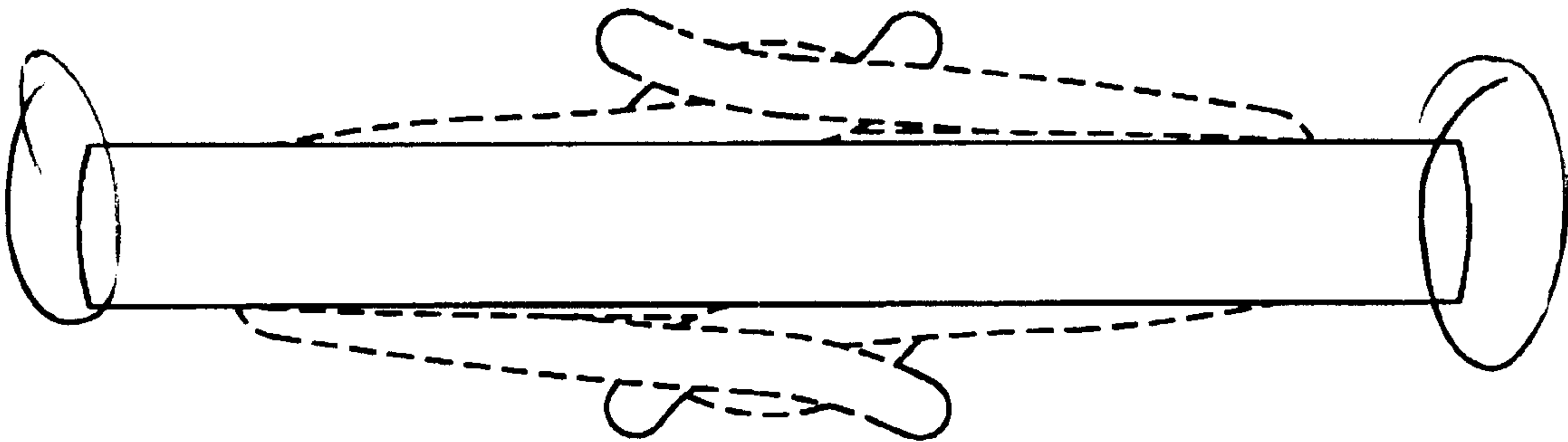
