DESCRIPTION

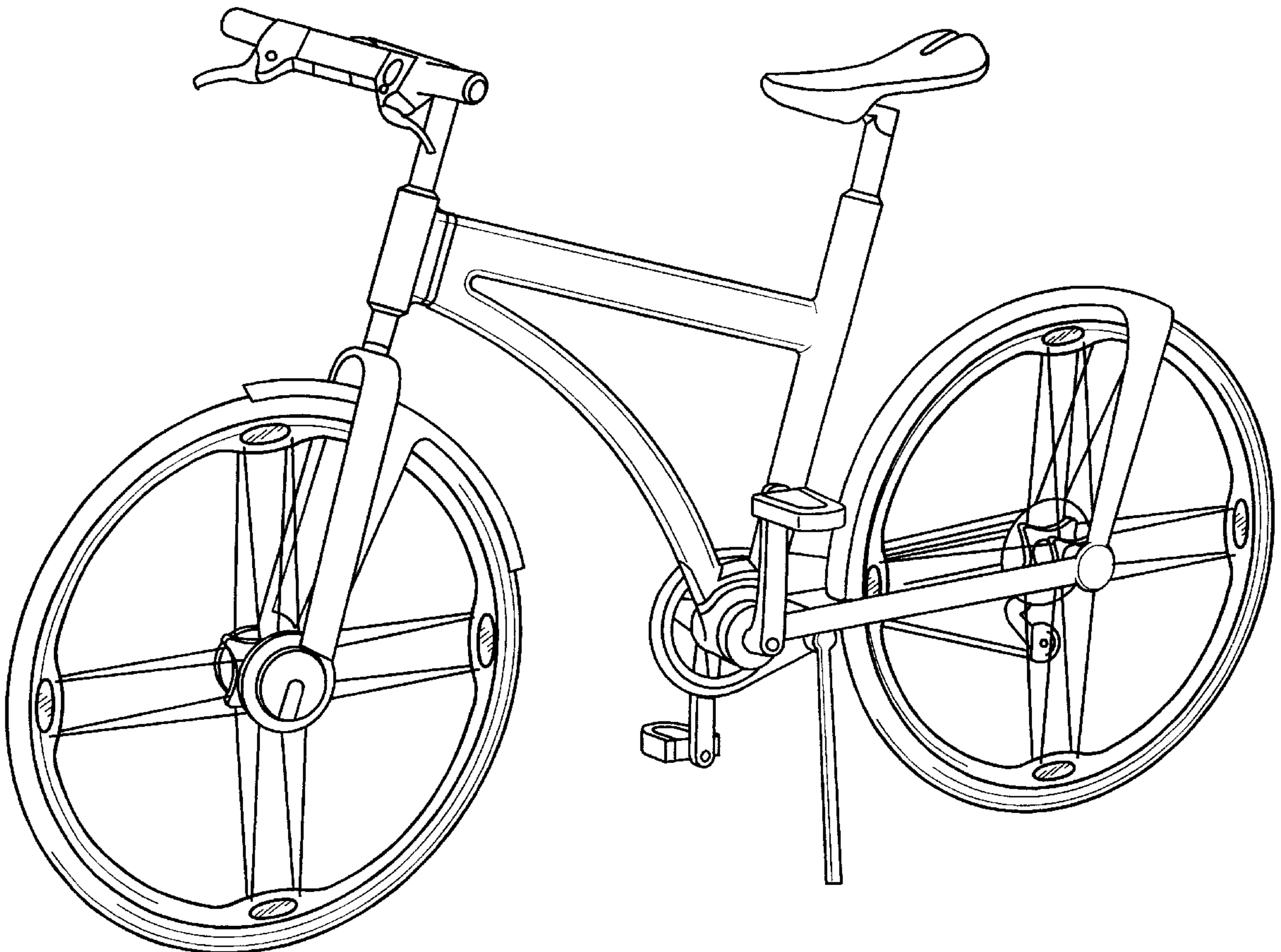
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bicycle in accordance with our new design;

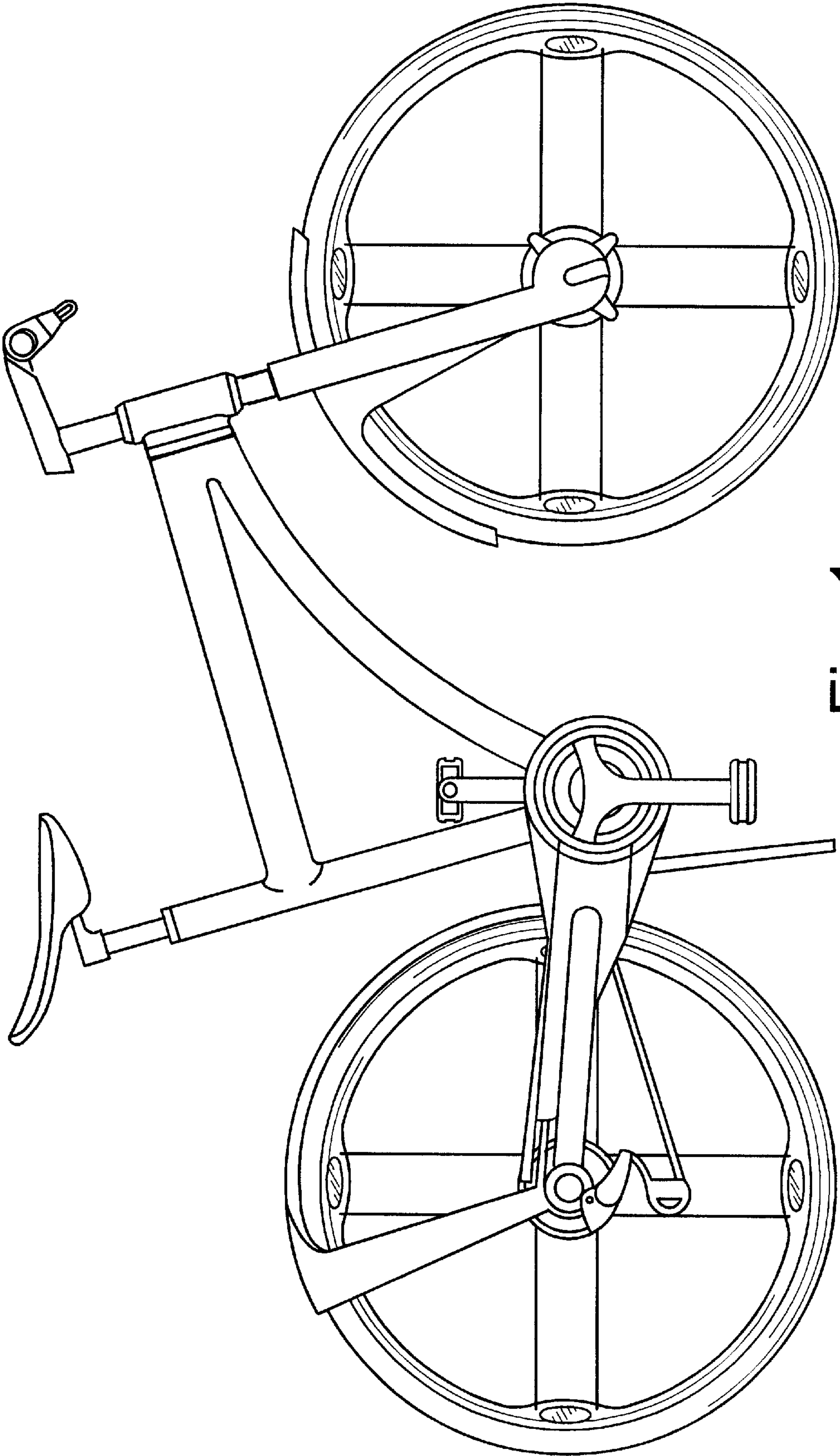

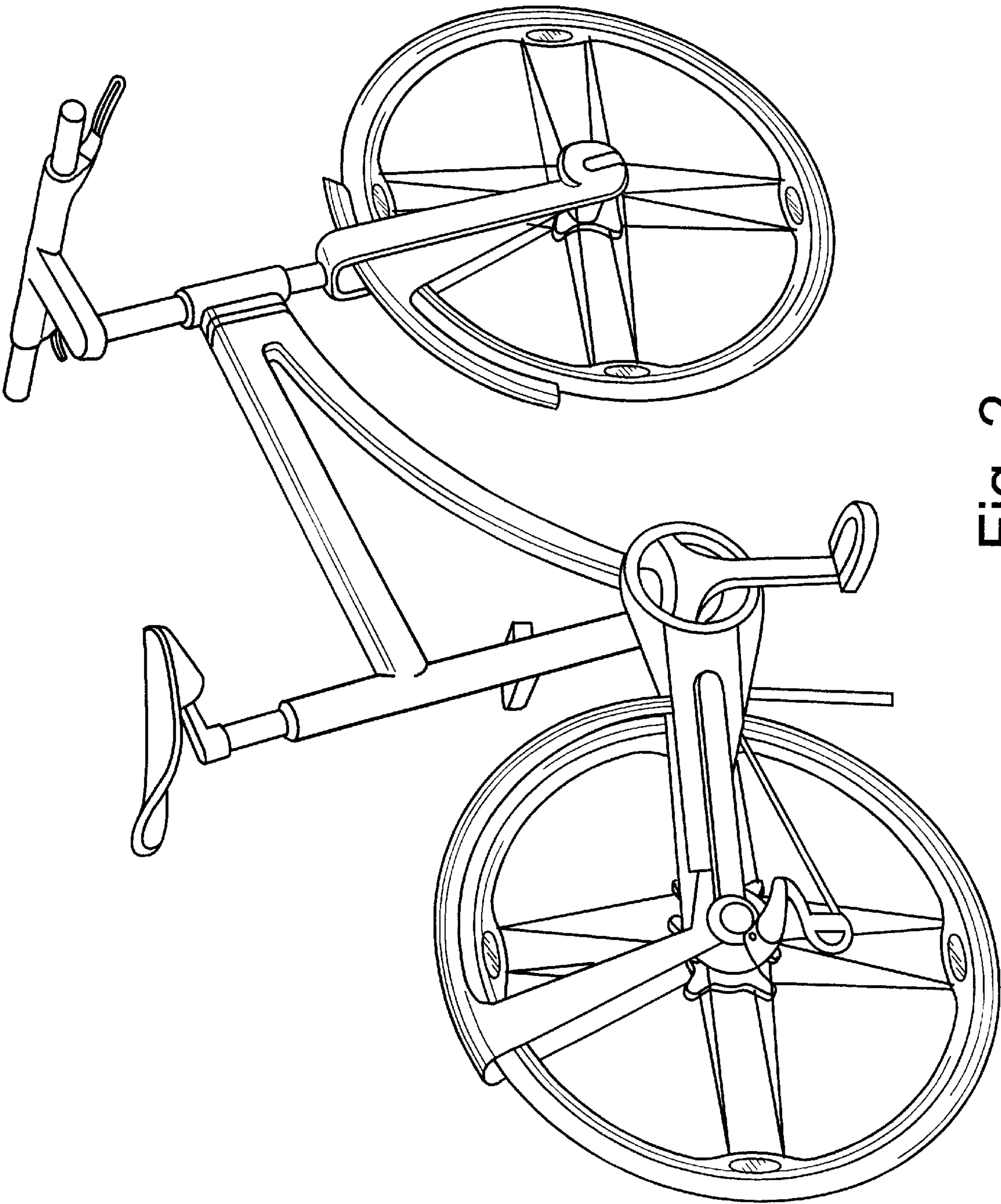

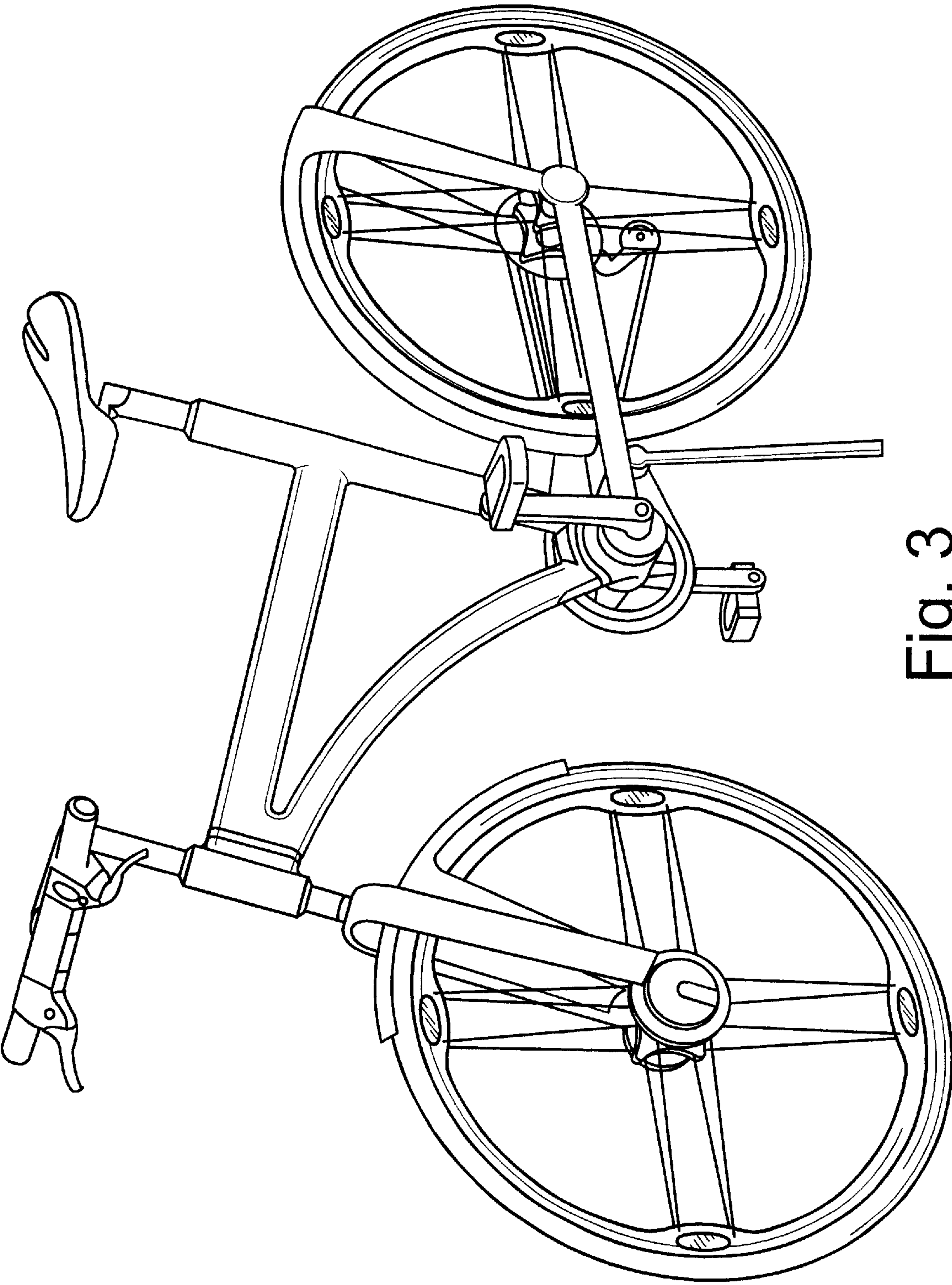
