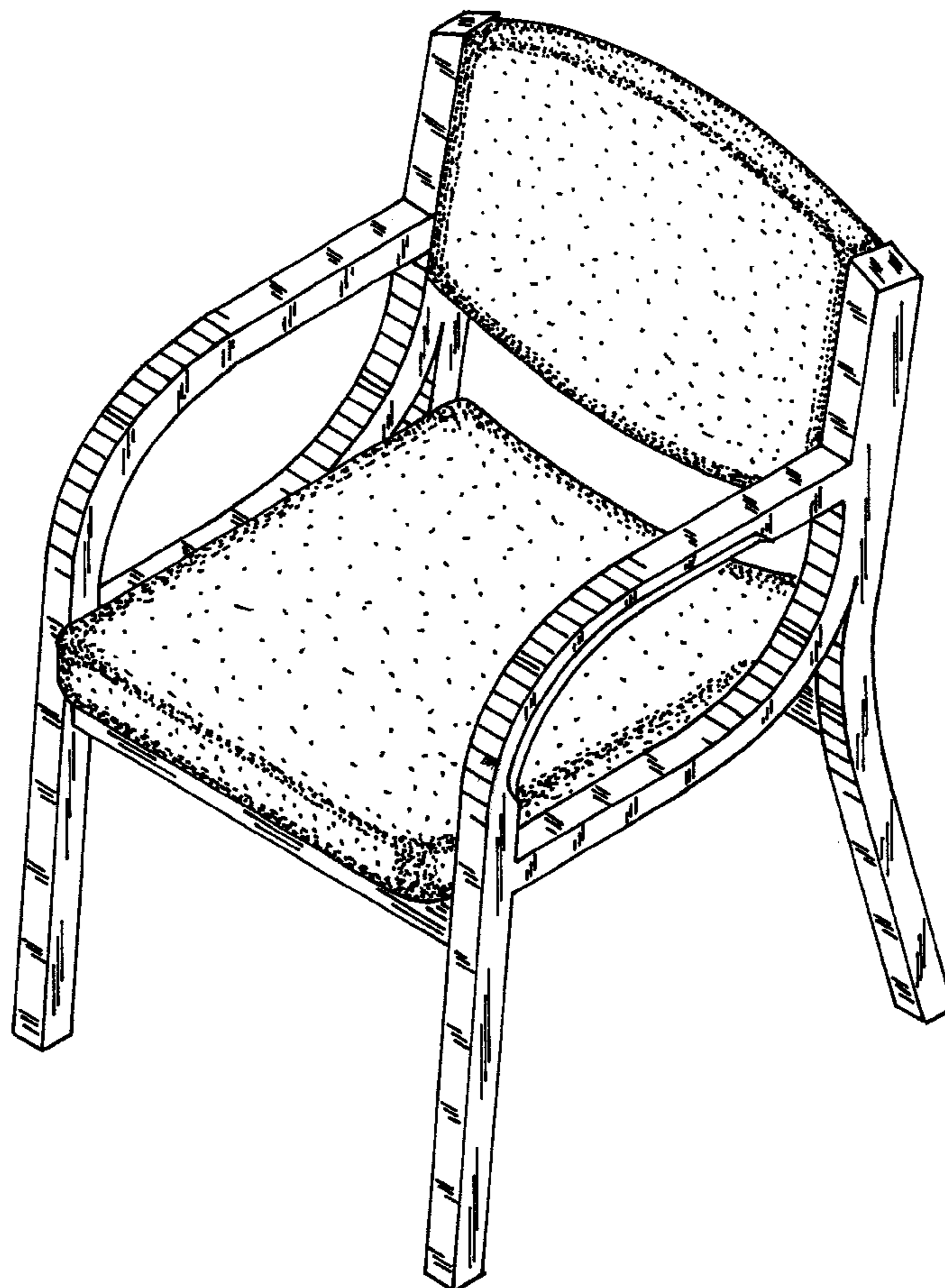
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a four-legged chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the new and ornamental four-legged chair of the invention; FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front view of the chair of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the chair of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the chair of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is a left-side view of the chair of FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image thereof.

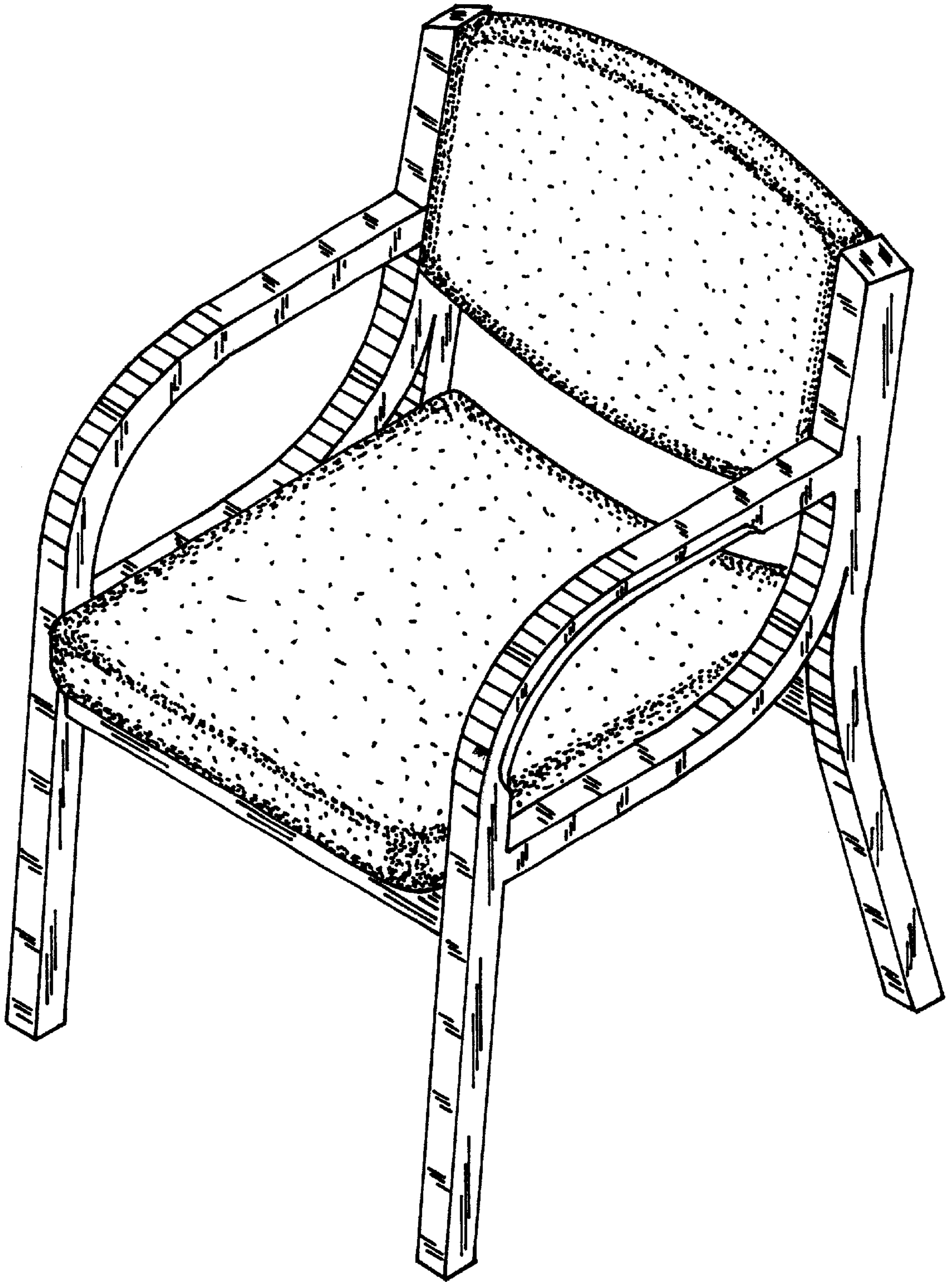

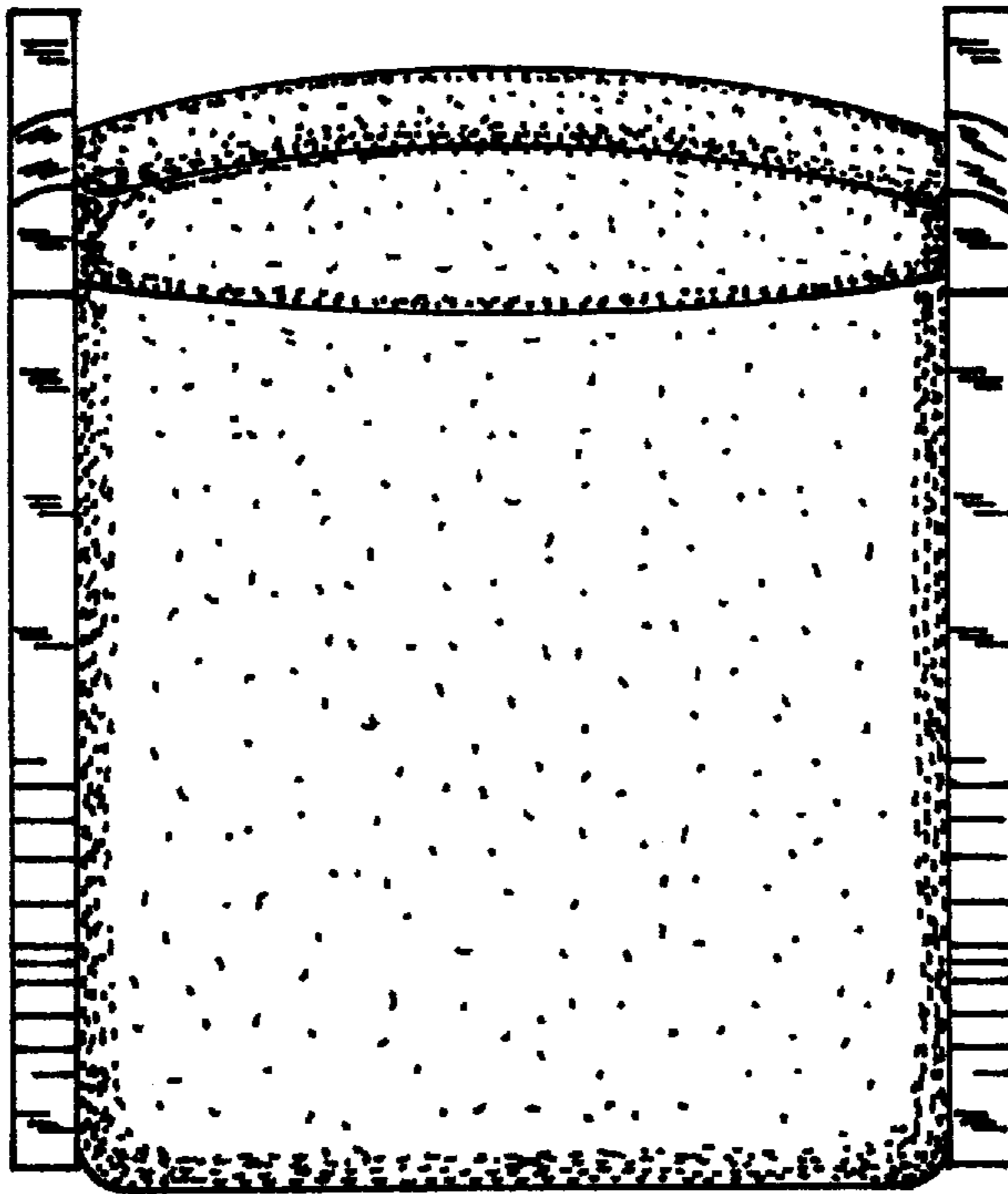

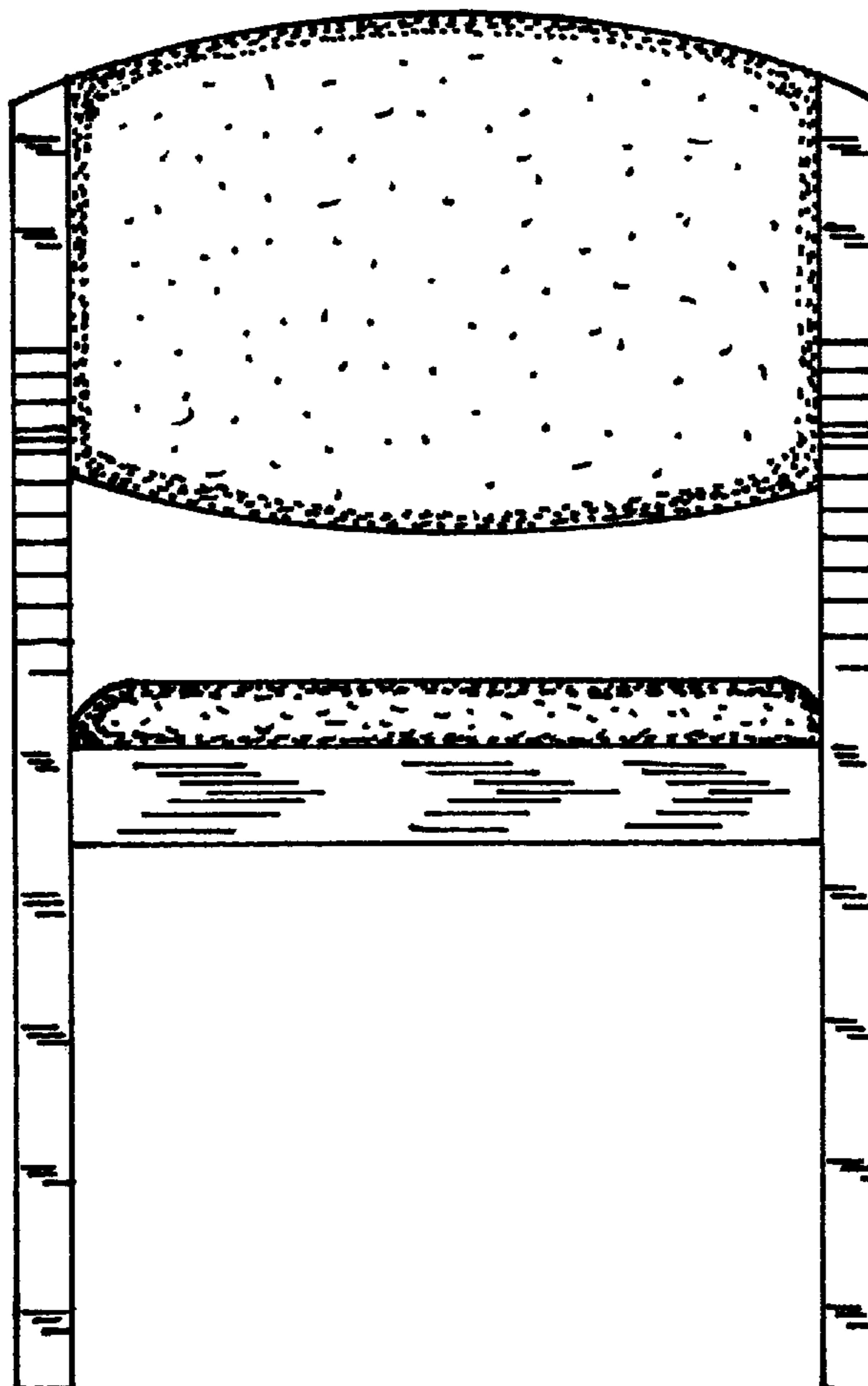

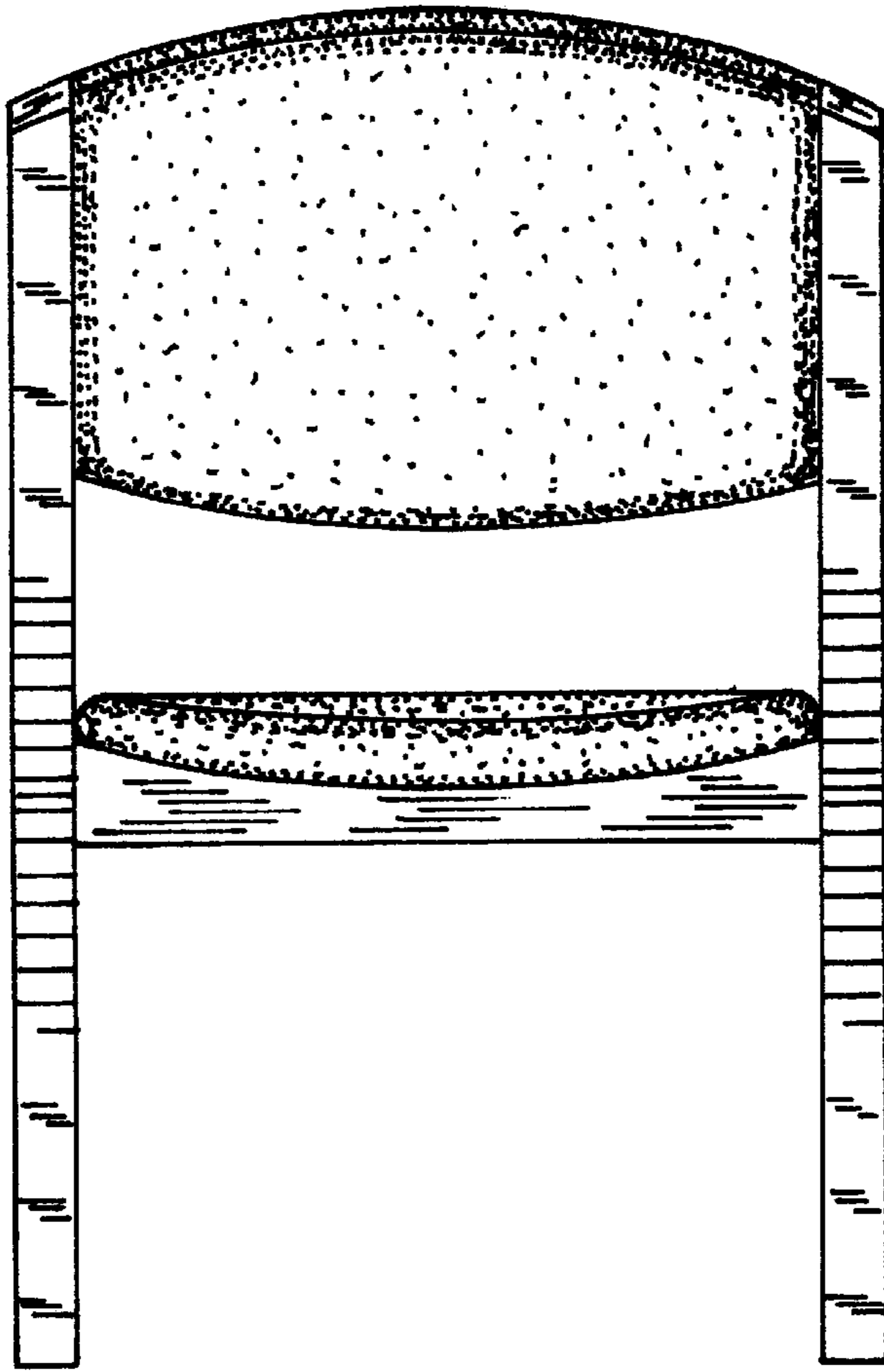

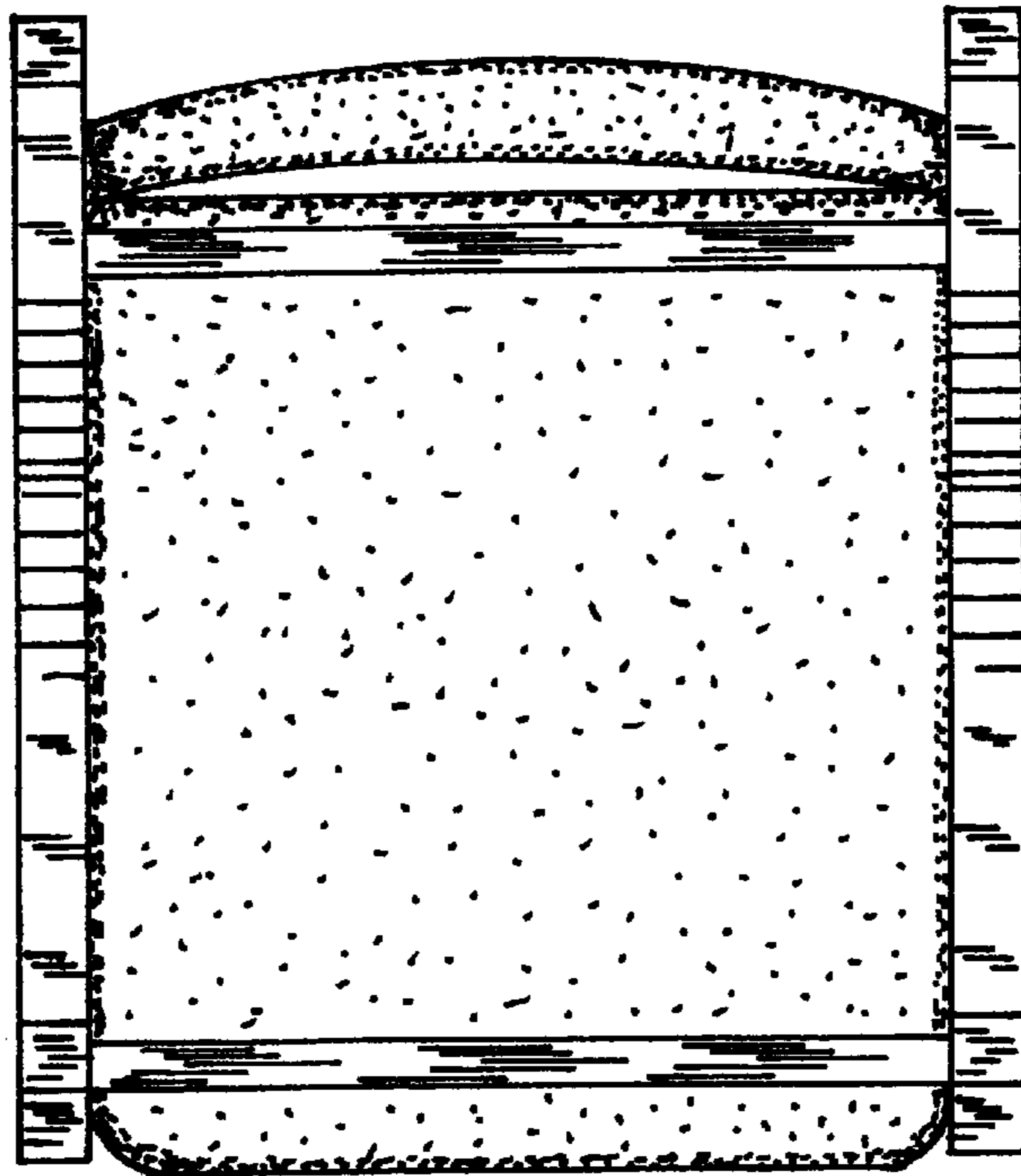

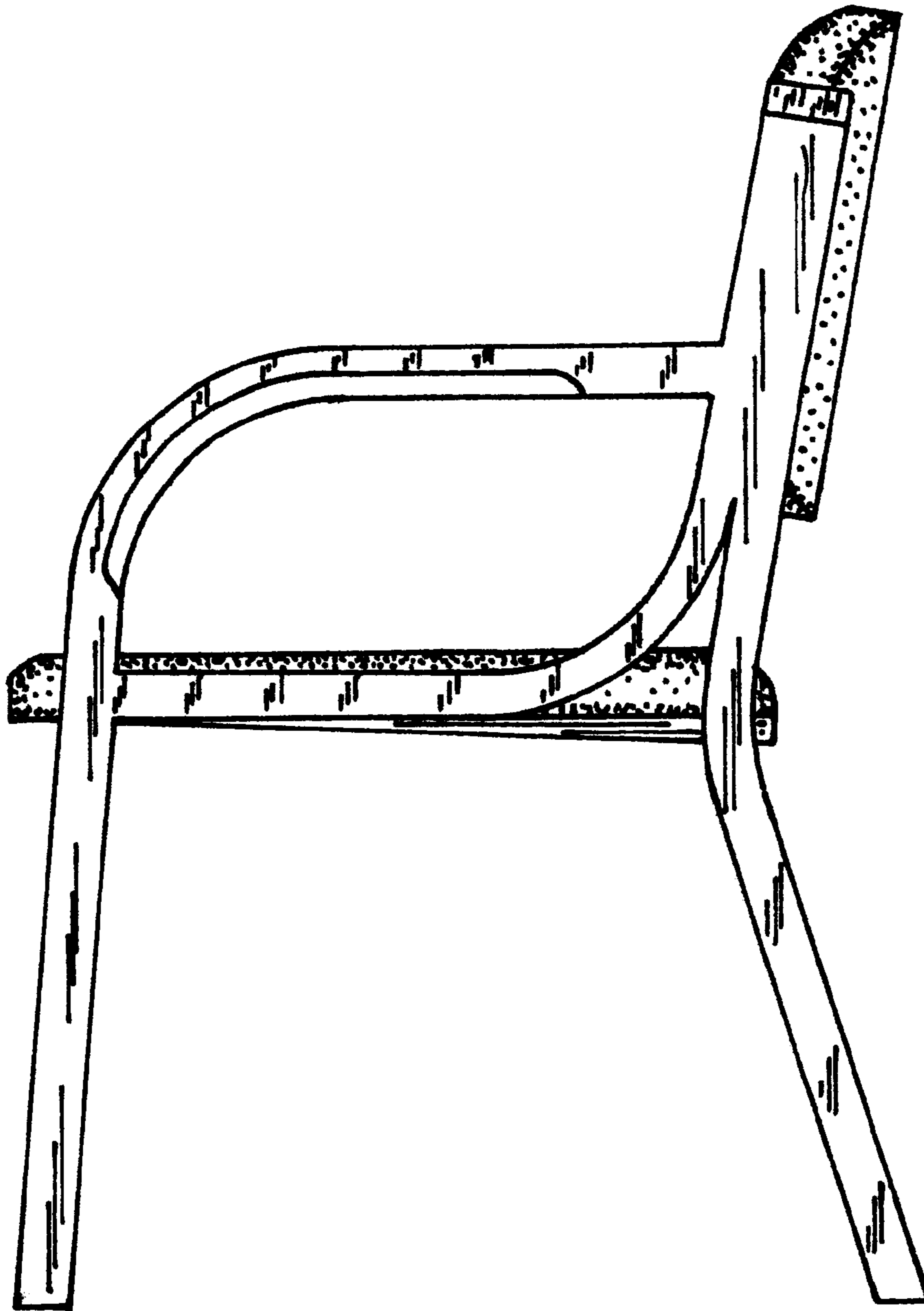
