The ornamental design for a mirror construction, as shown  
and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mirror embodying the  
present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being  
a mirror image of the right side;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

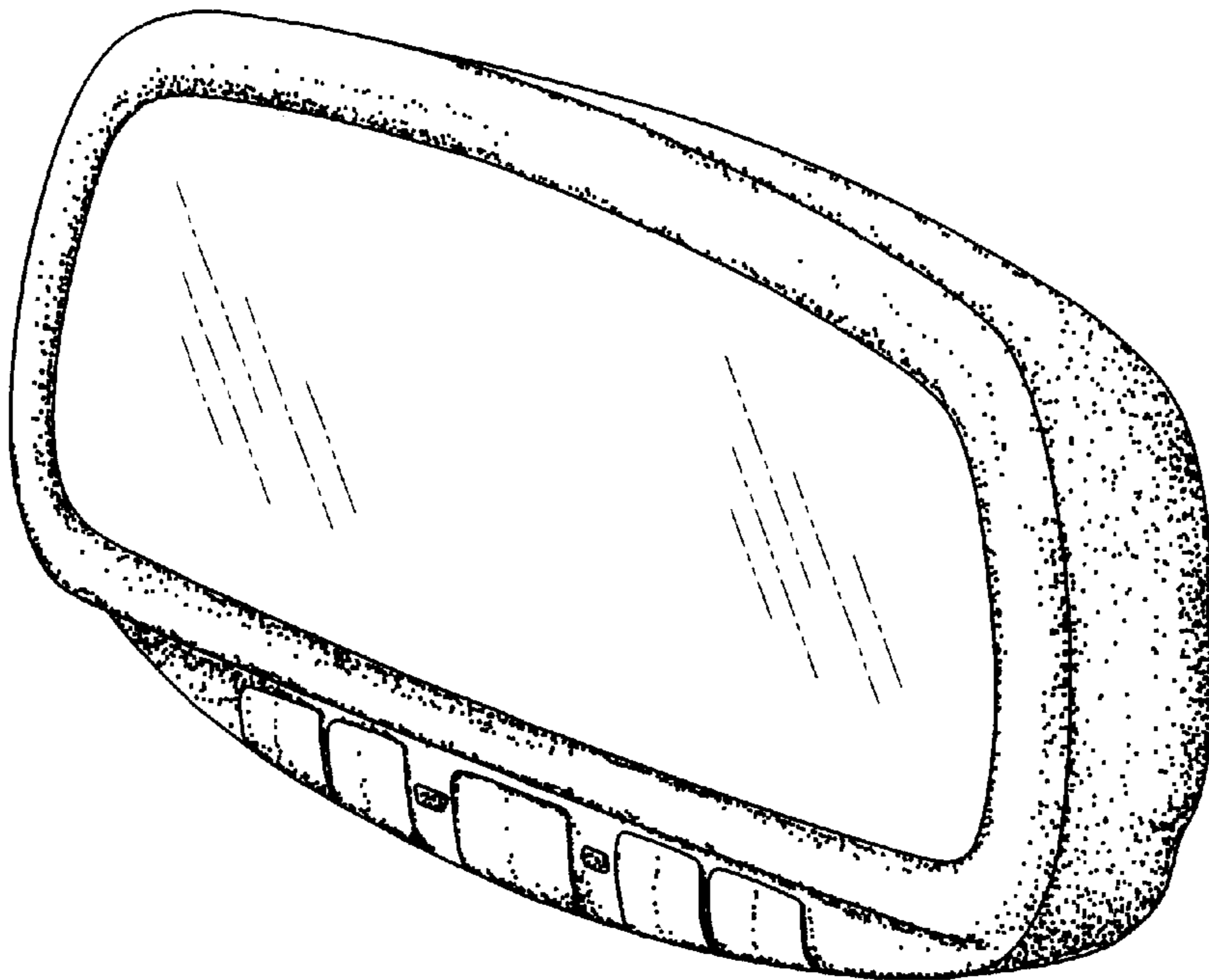
FIG. 7 is a top front fragmentary perspective view of a  
button construction embodying the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a front view thereof; and,

FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof.

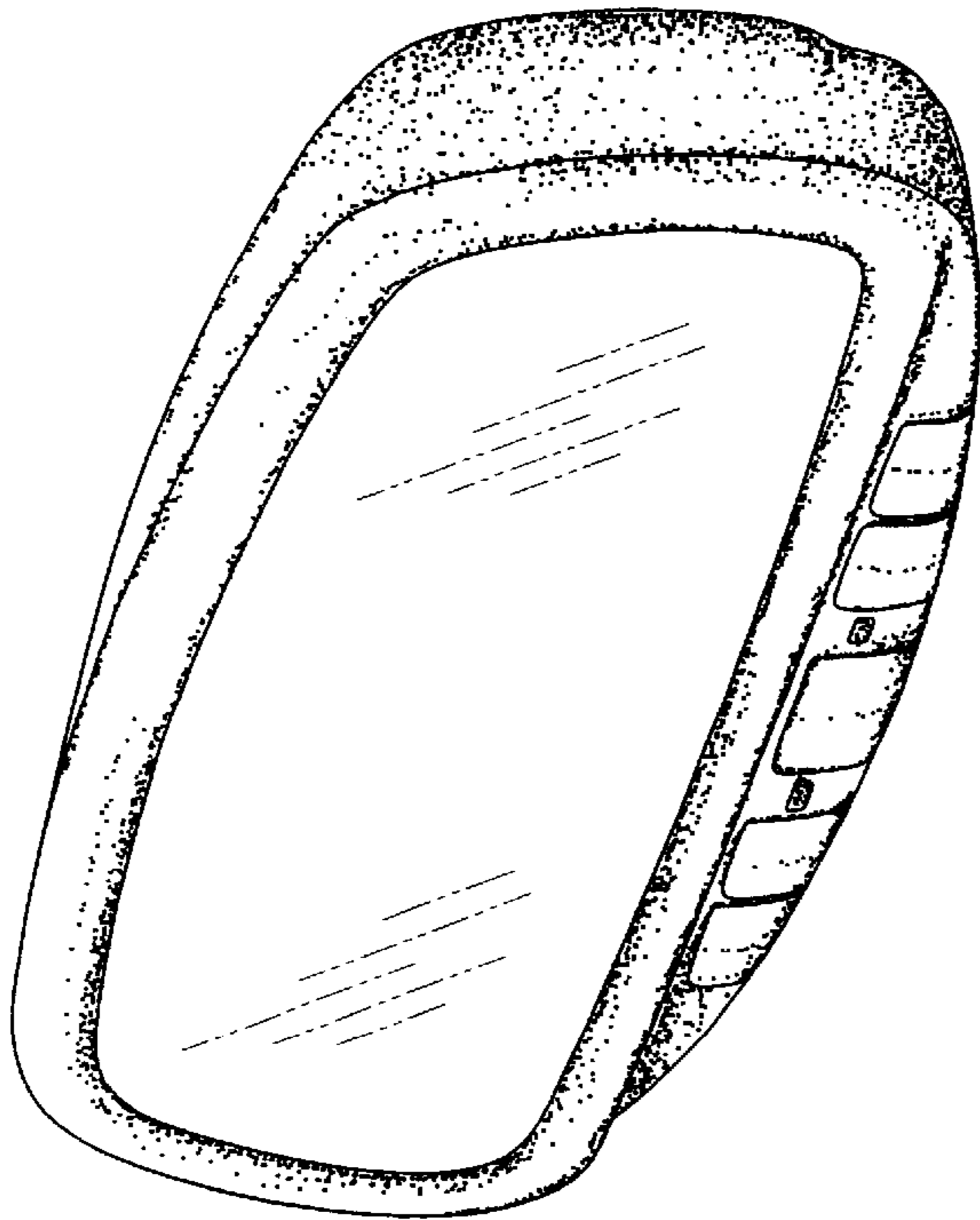

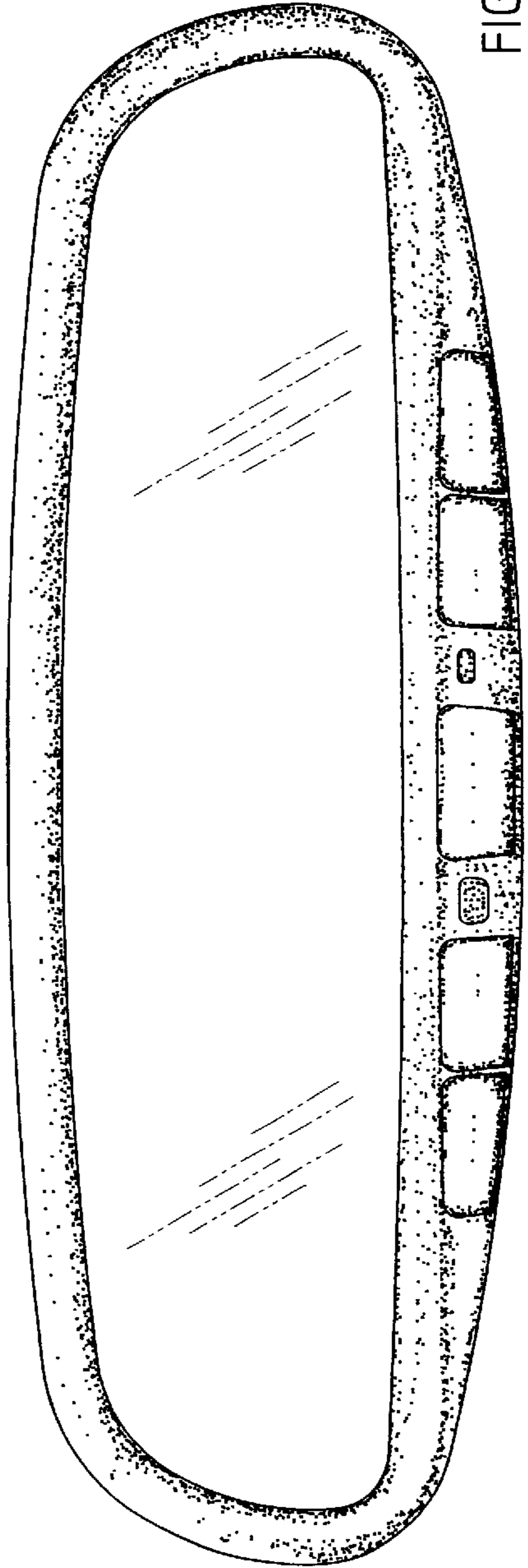

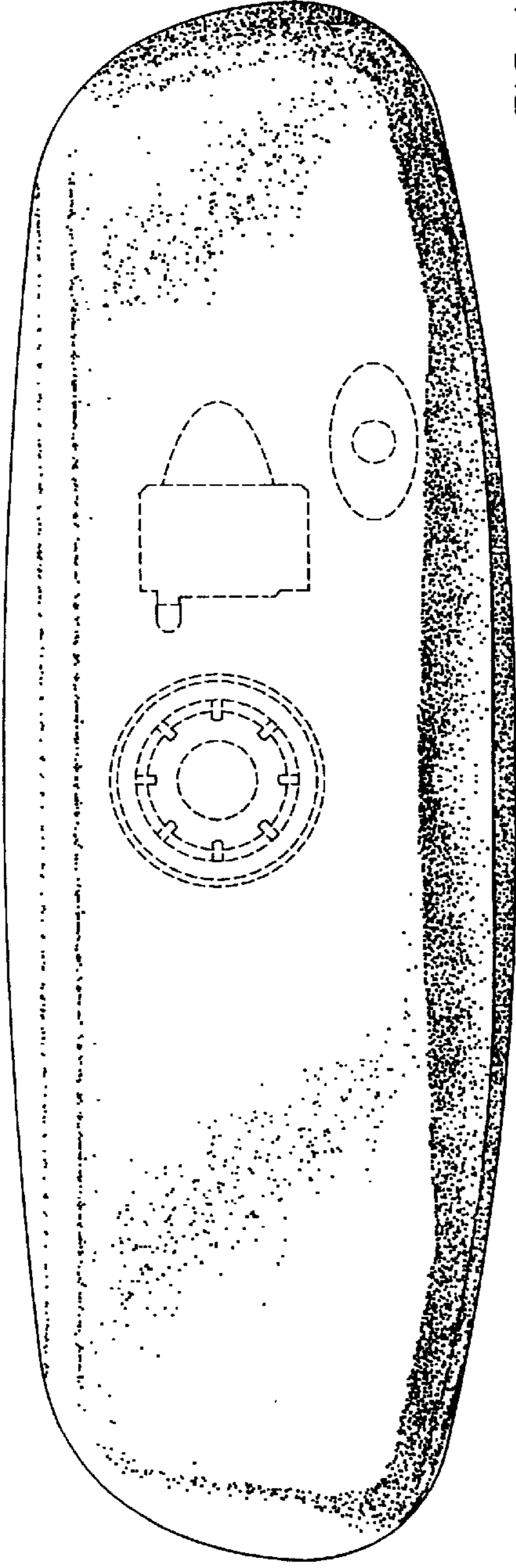

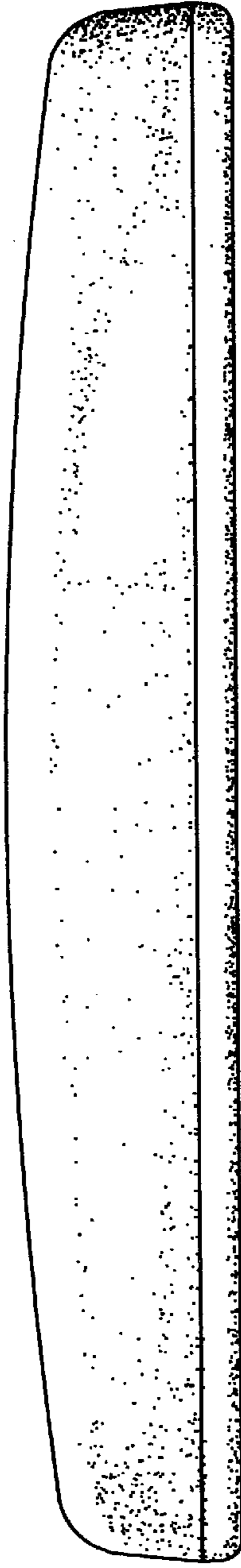

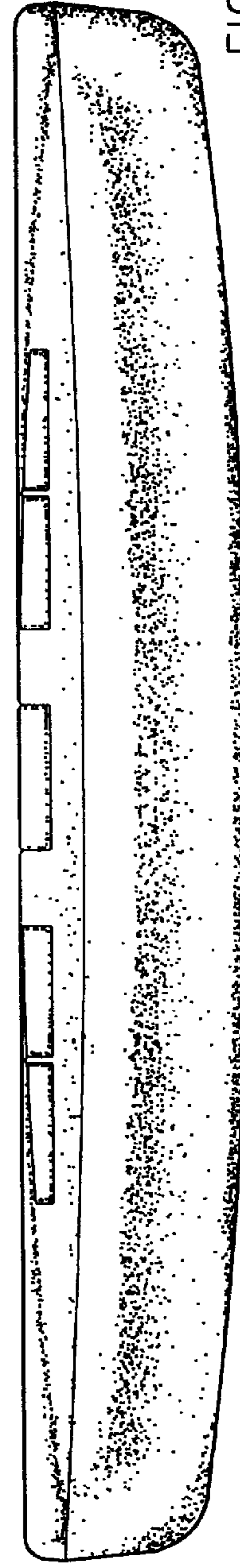

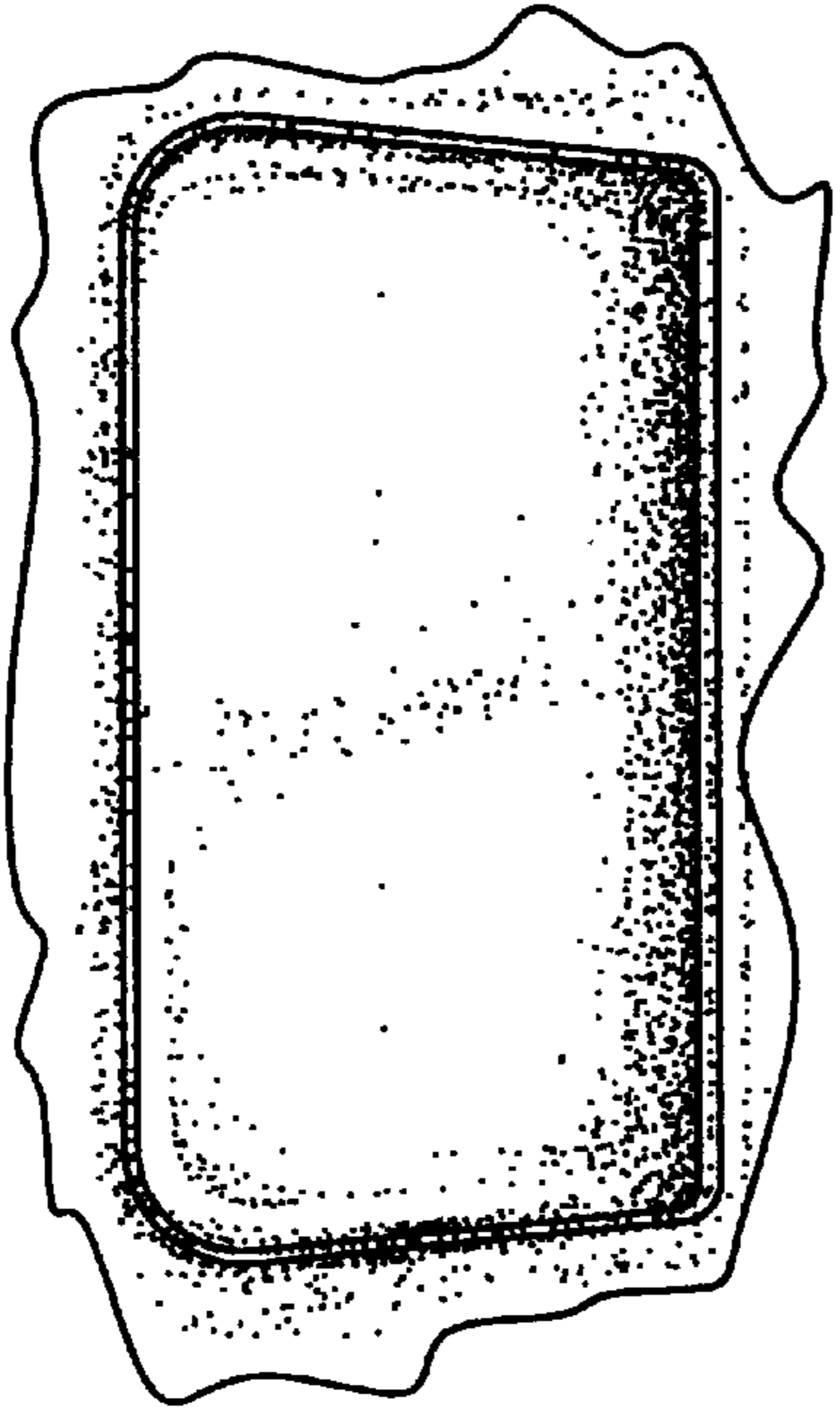

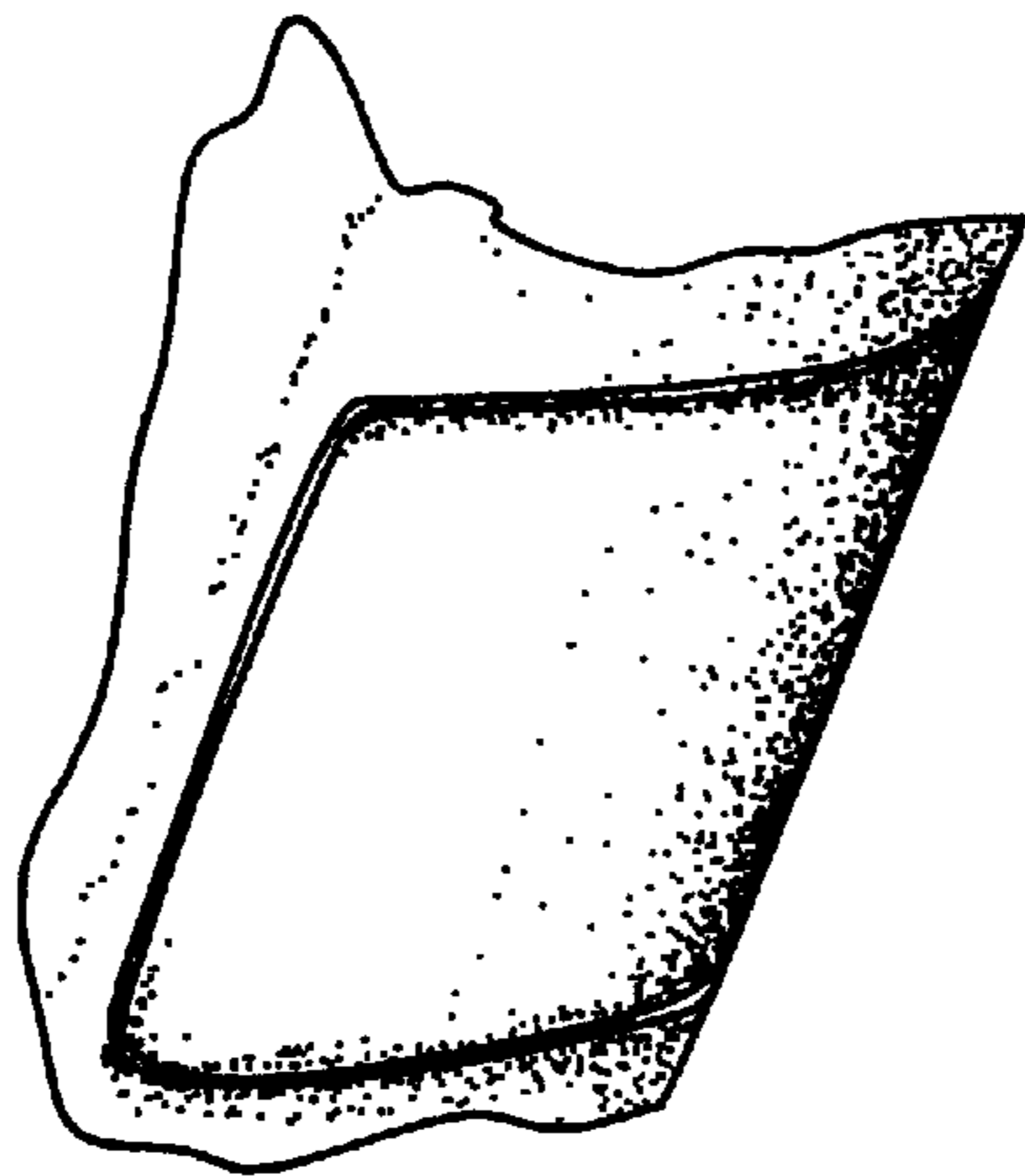
