The ornamental design for a climbing belay device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a climbing belay device showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof without the wire;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is another side elevational view thereof; and,

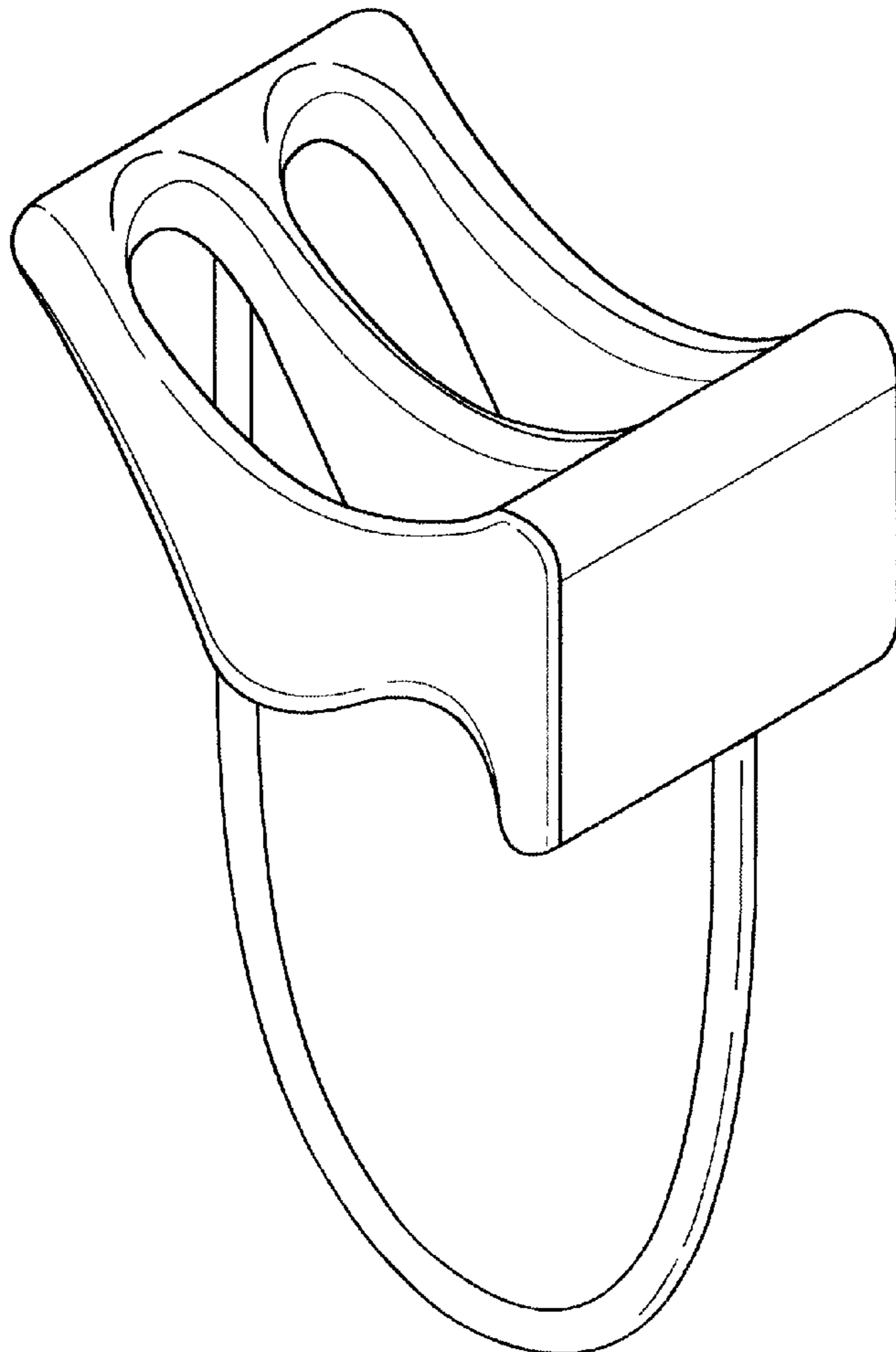

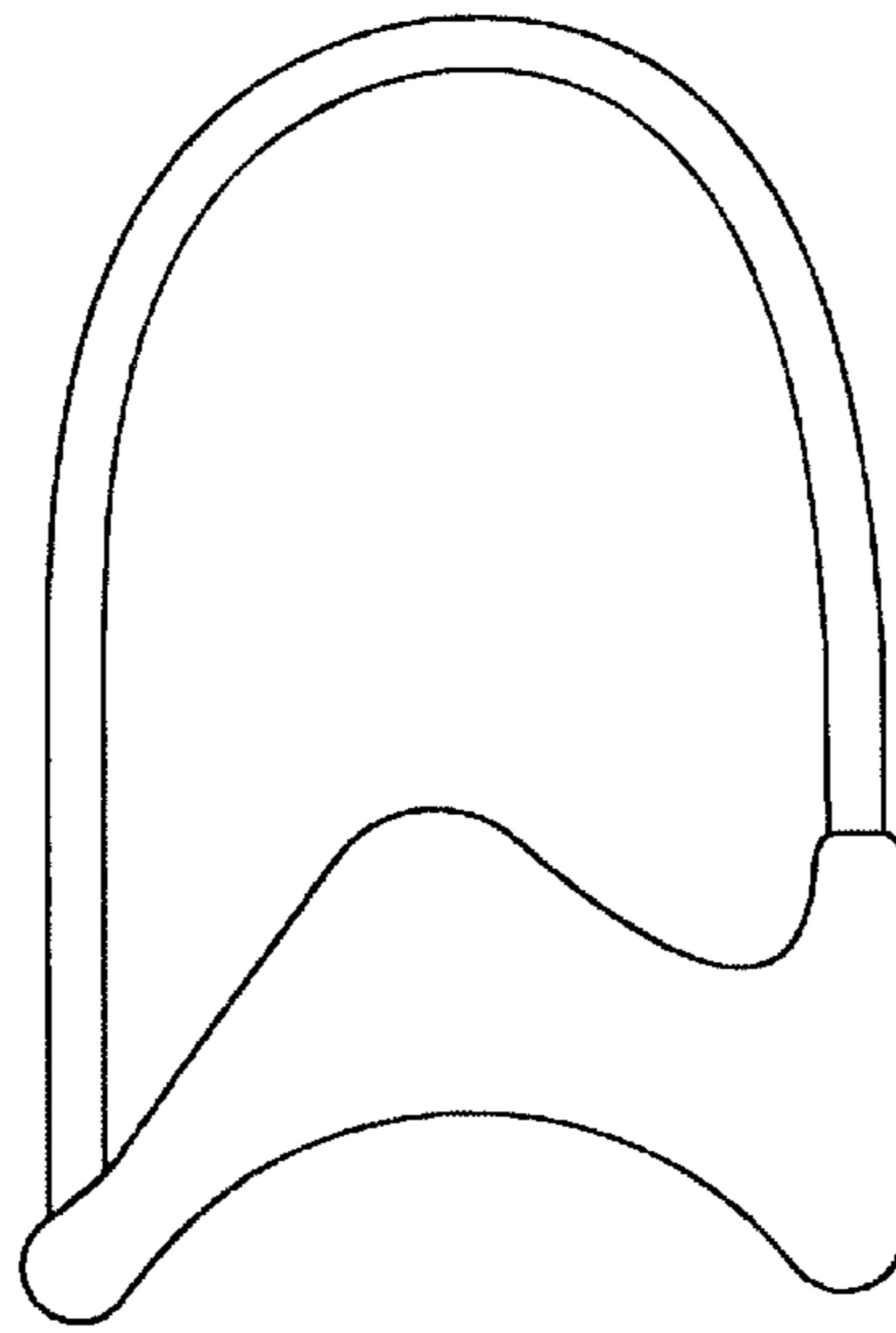

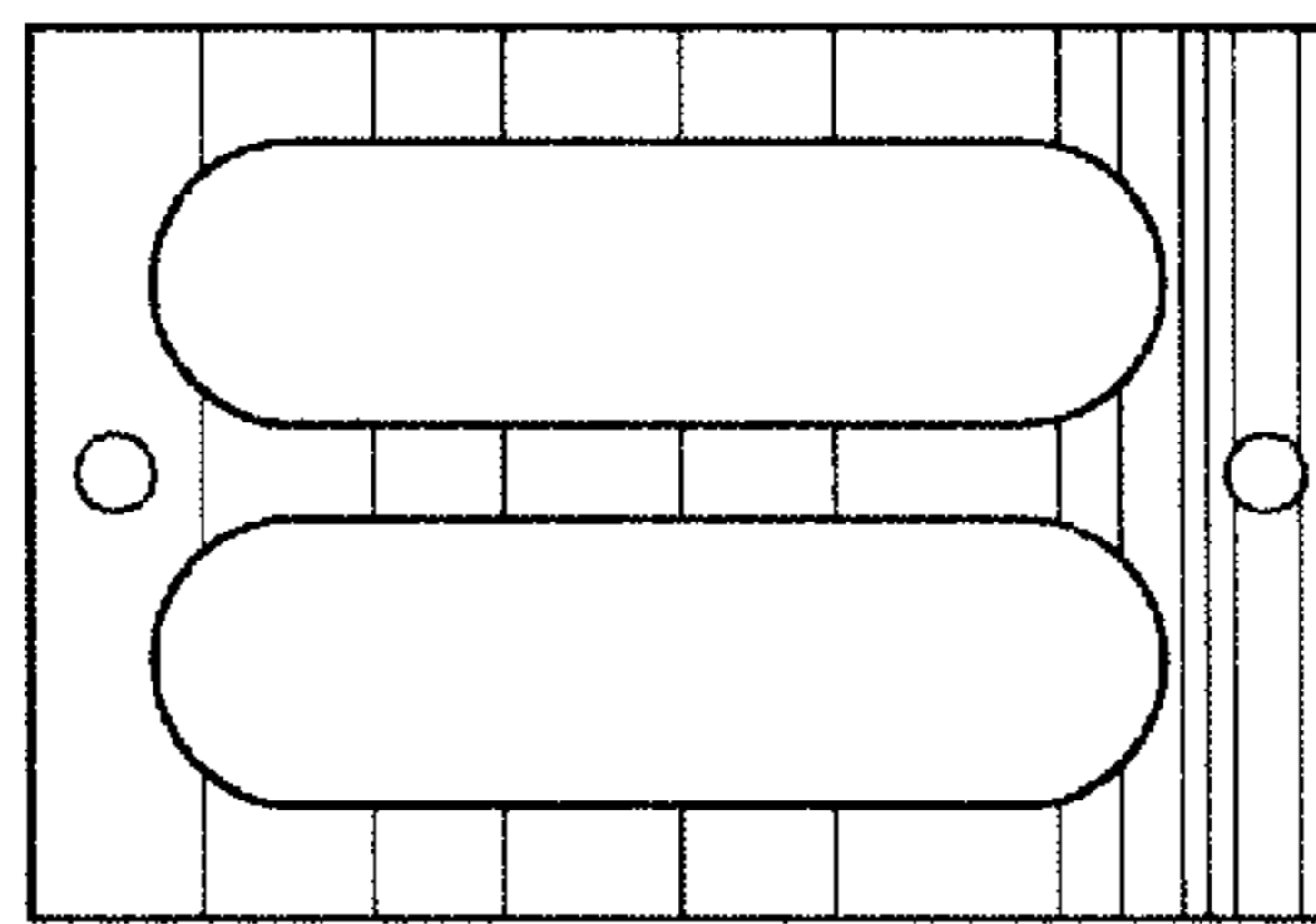

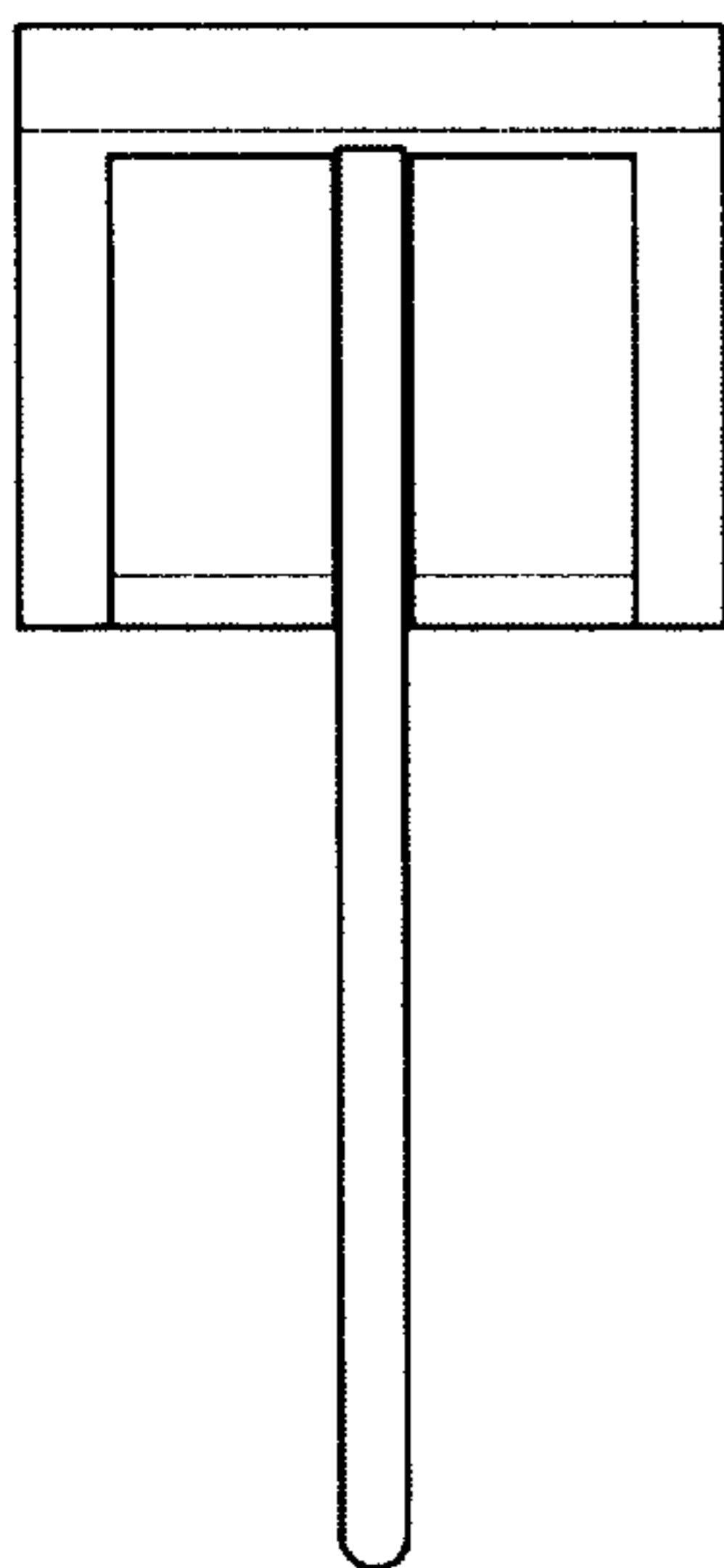

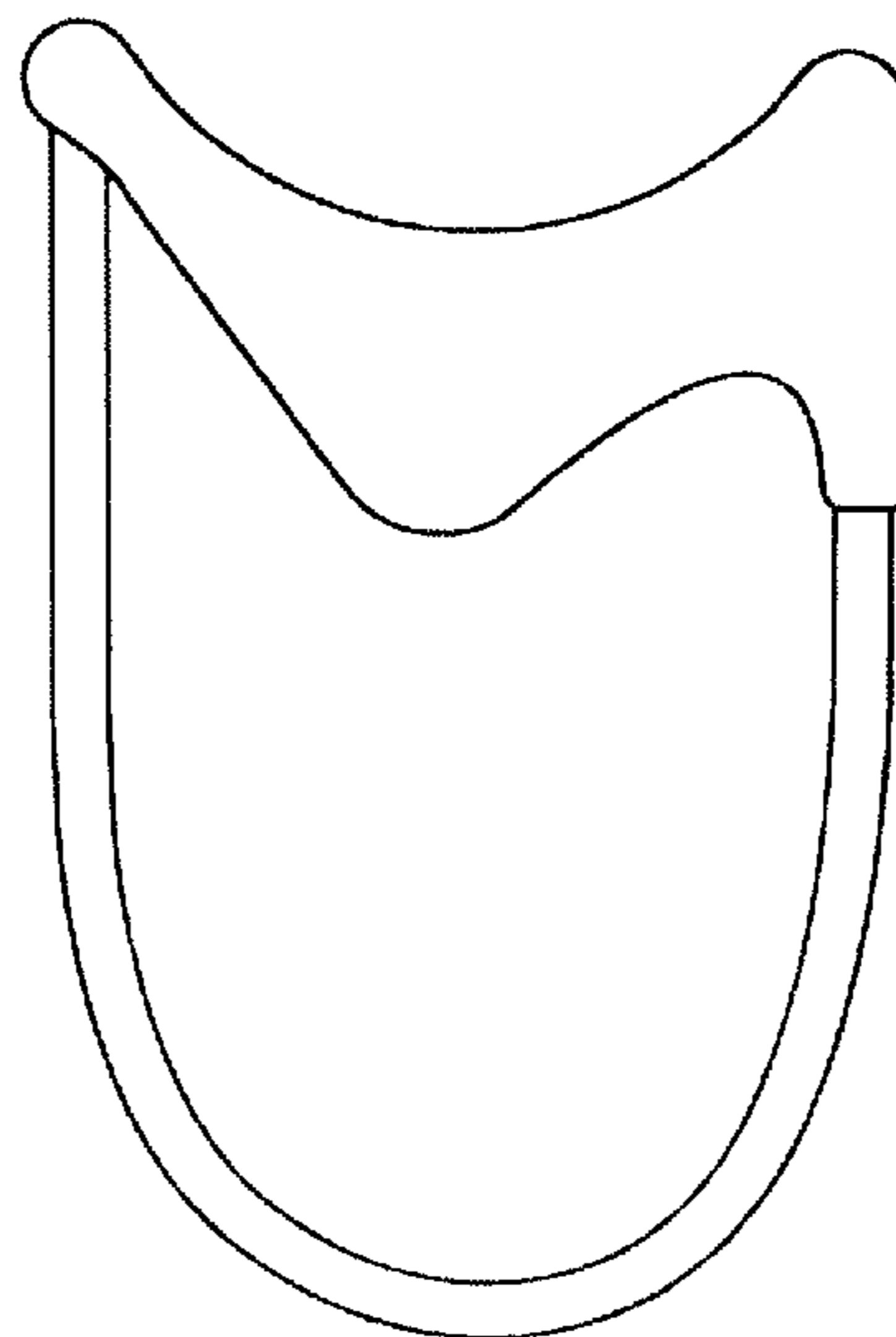

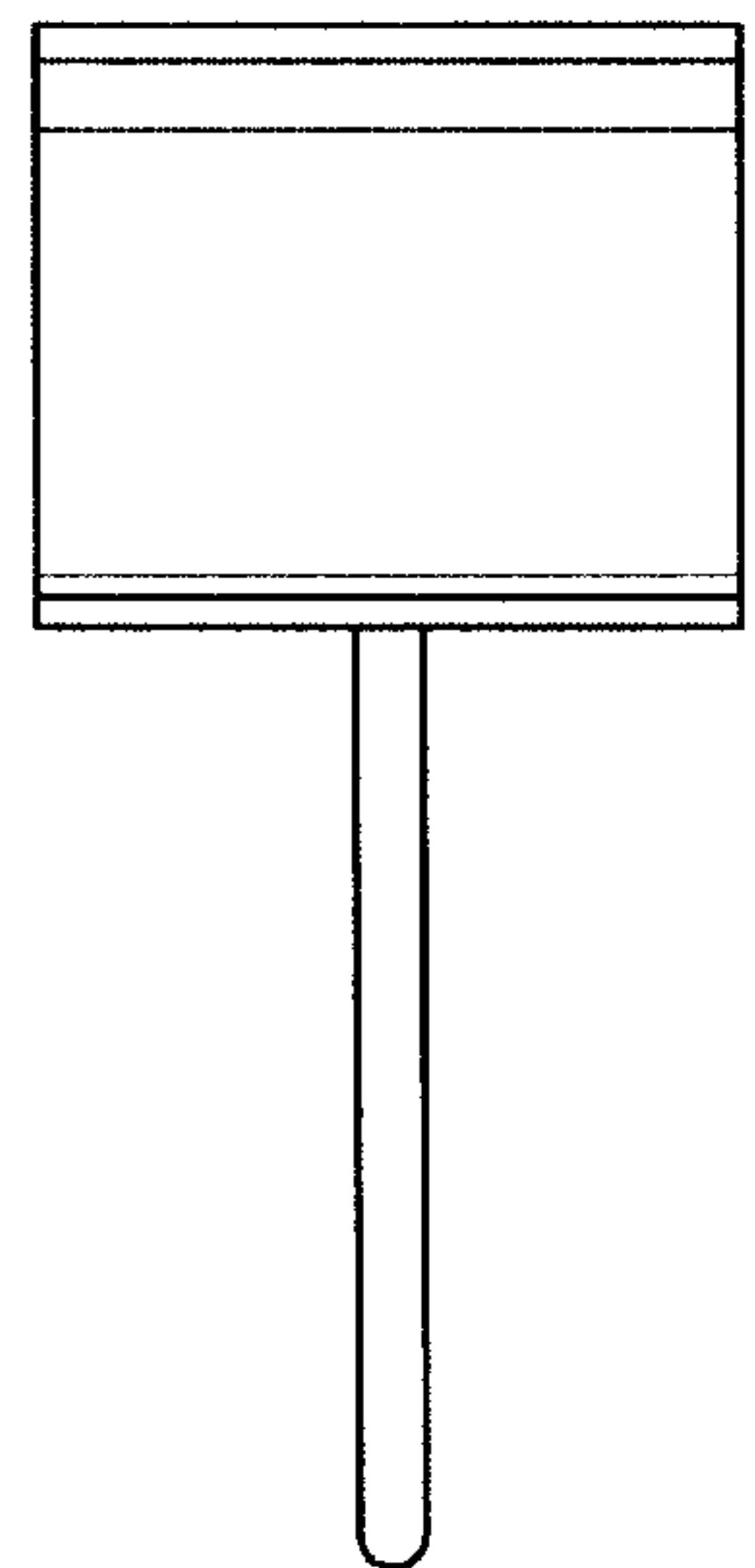
