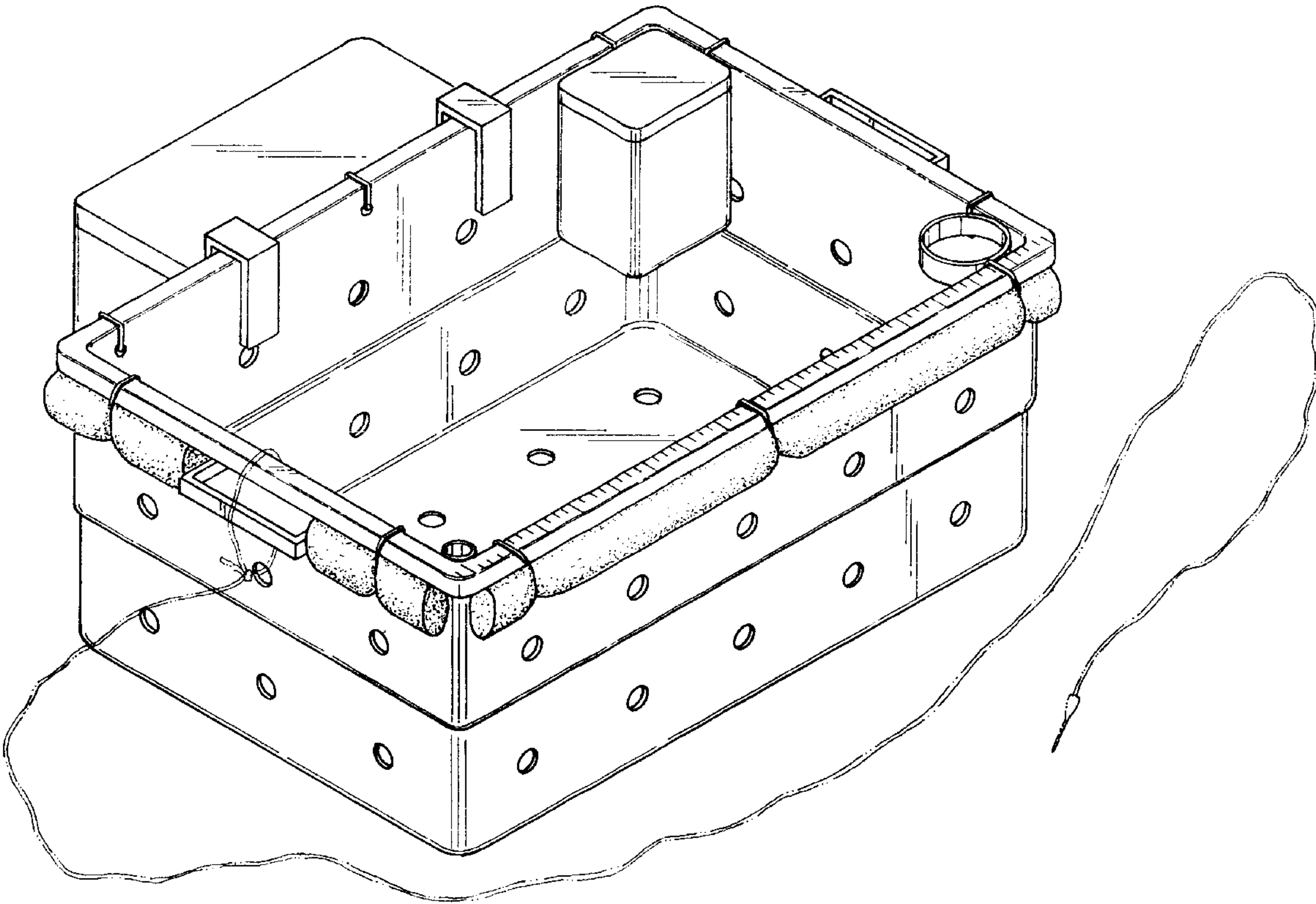

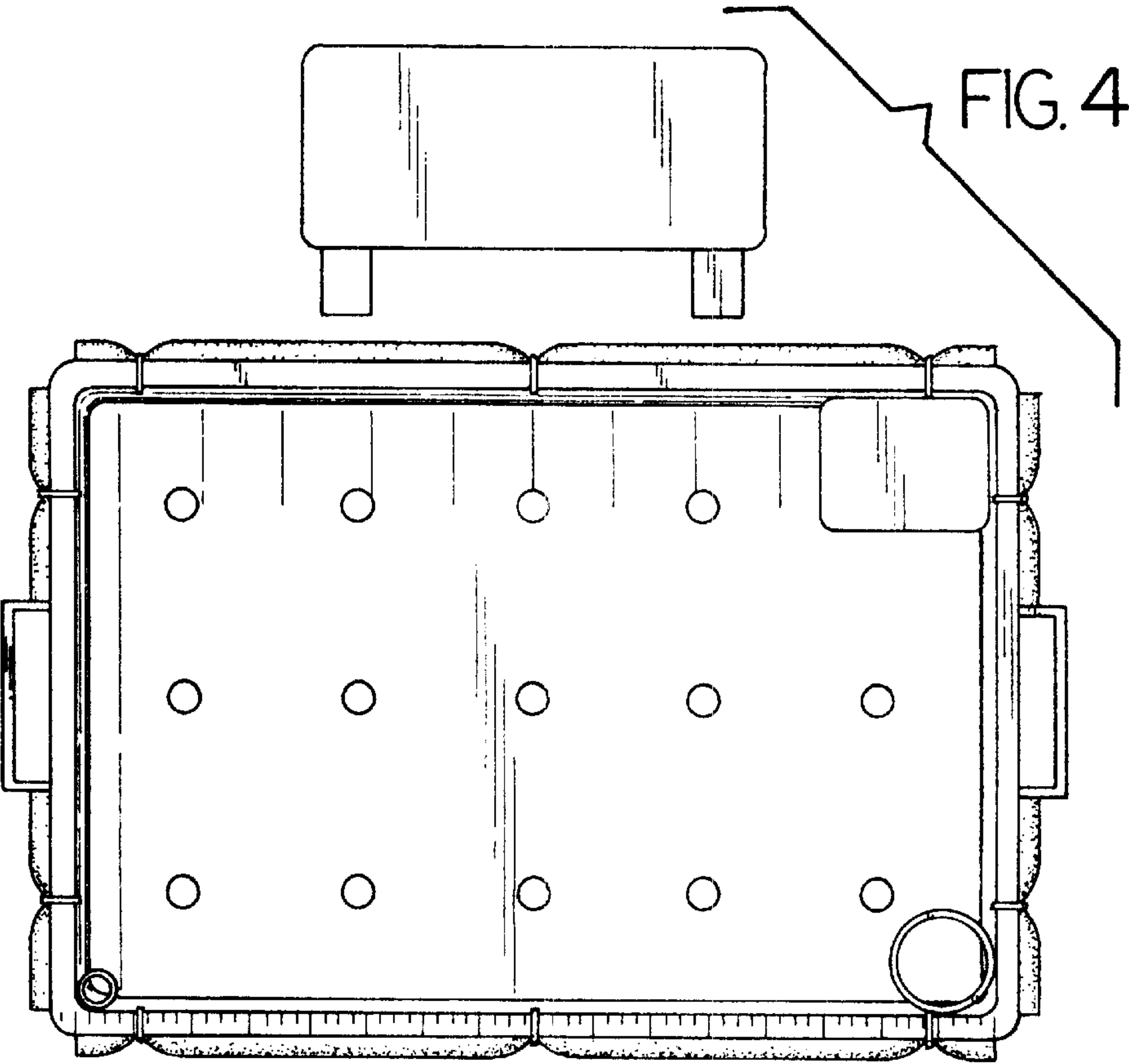
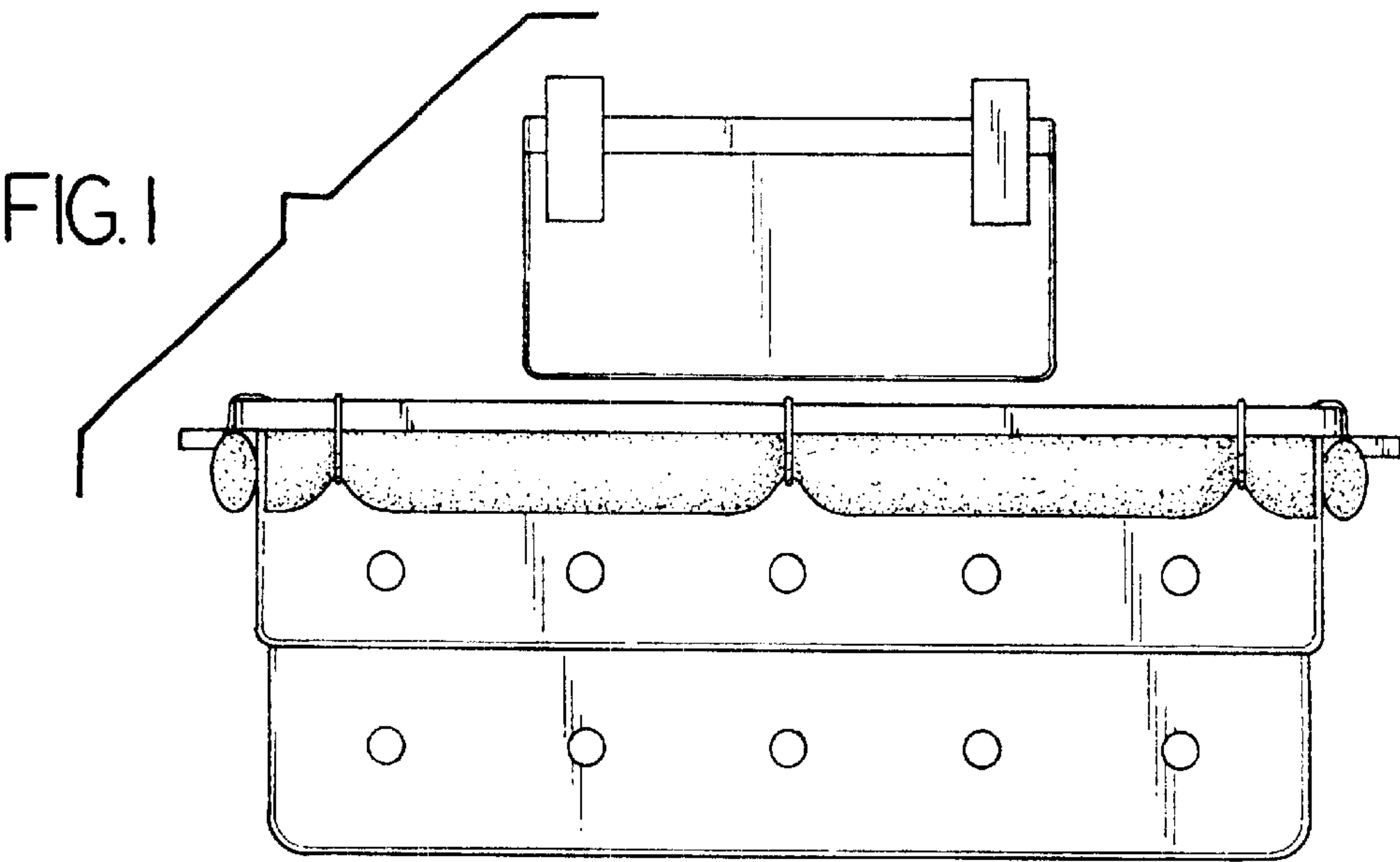
The ornamental design for a floating fishing accessory, as shown and described.

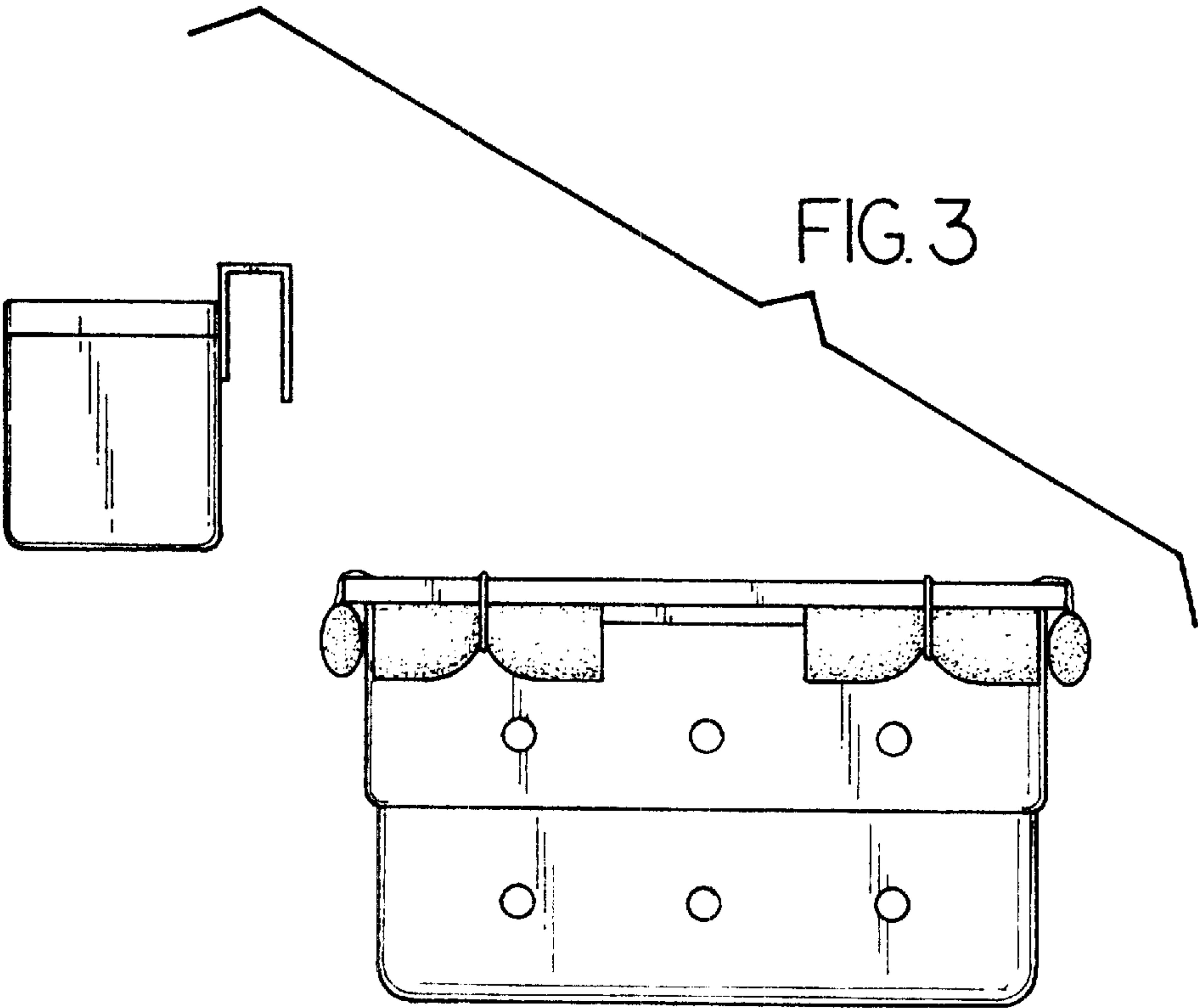
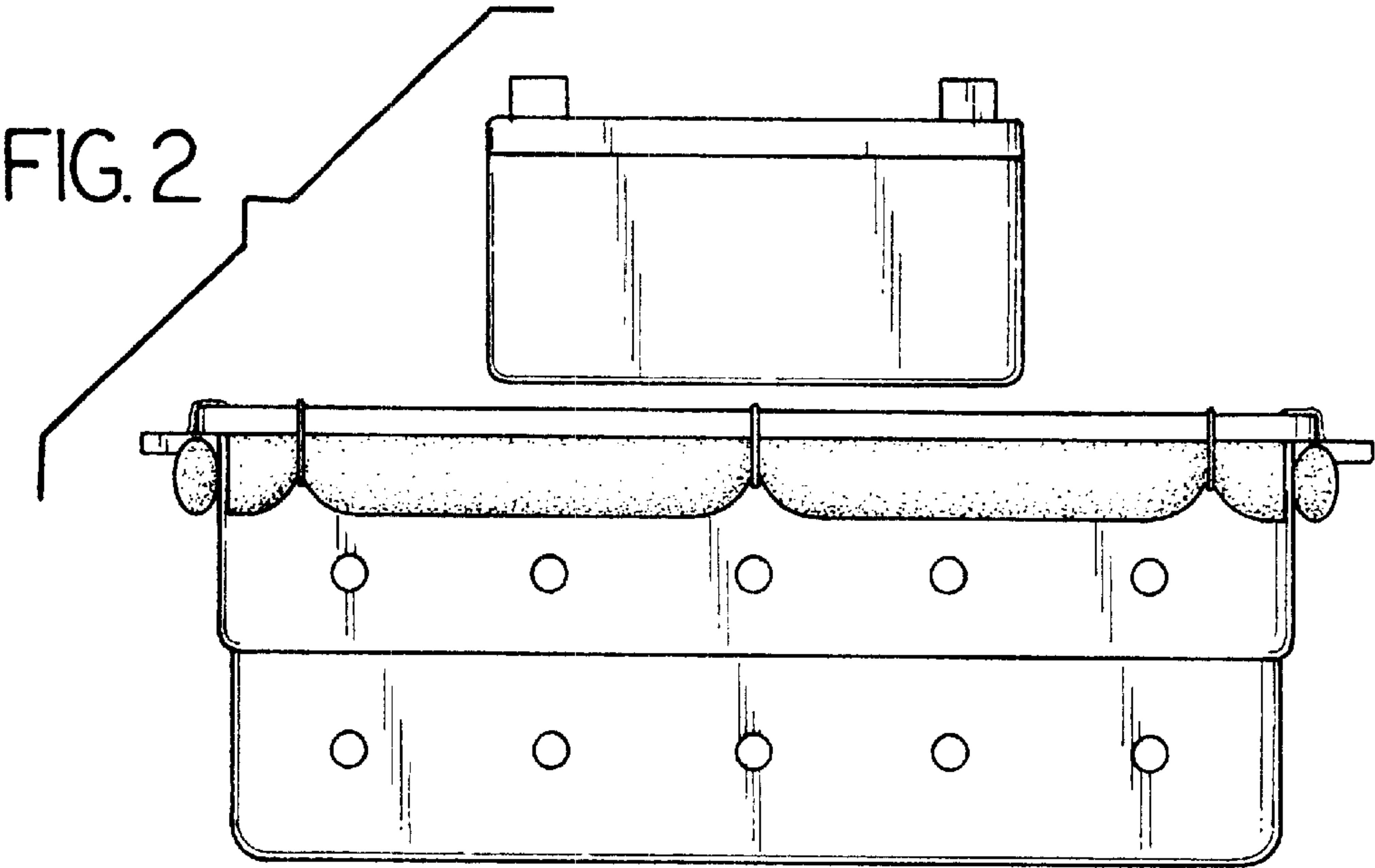
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a floating fishing accessory showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

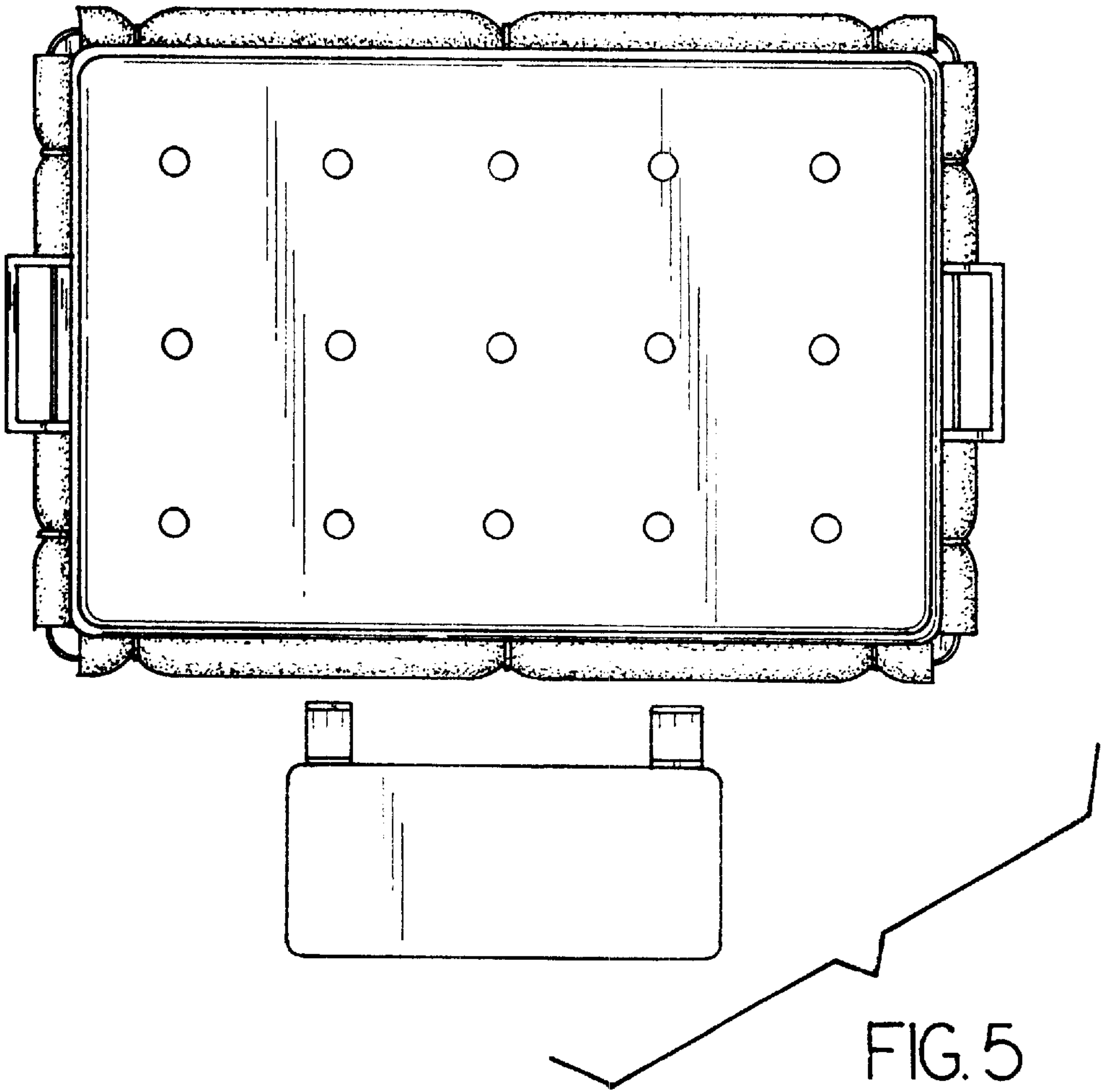
