FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the preferred embodiment thereof,

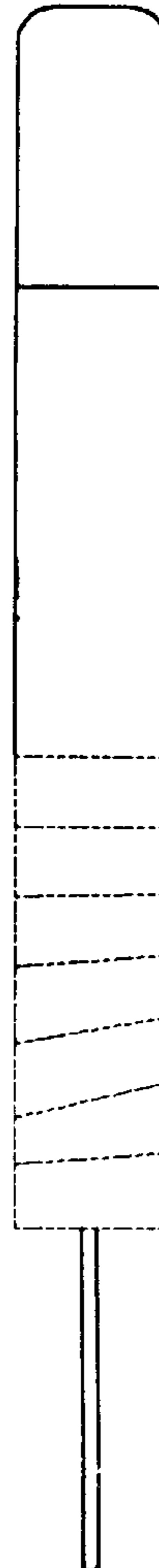
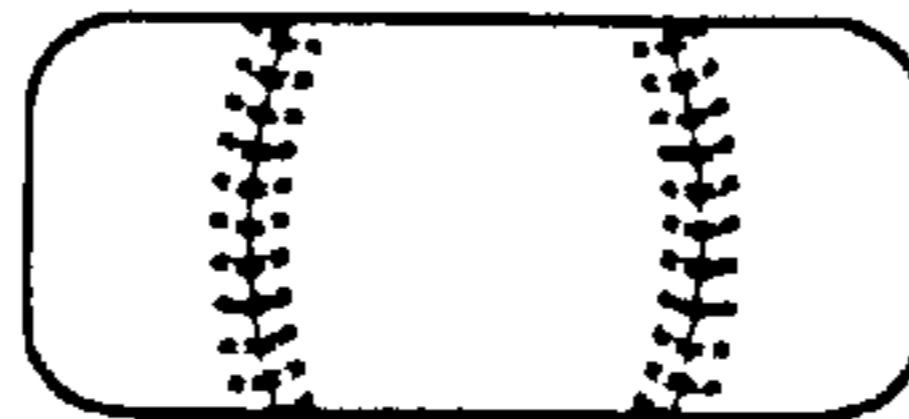
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the preferred embodiment thereof,

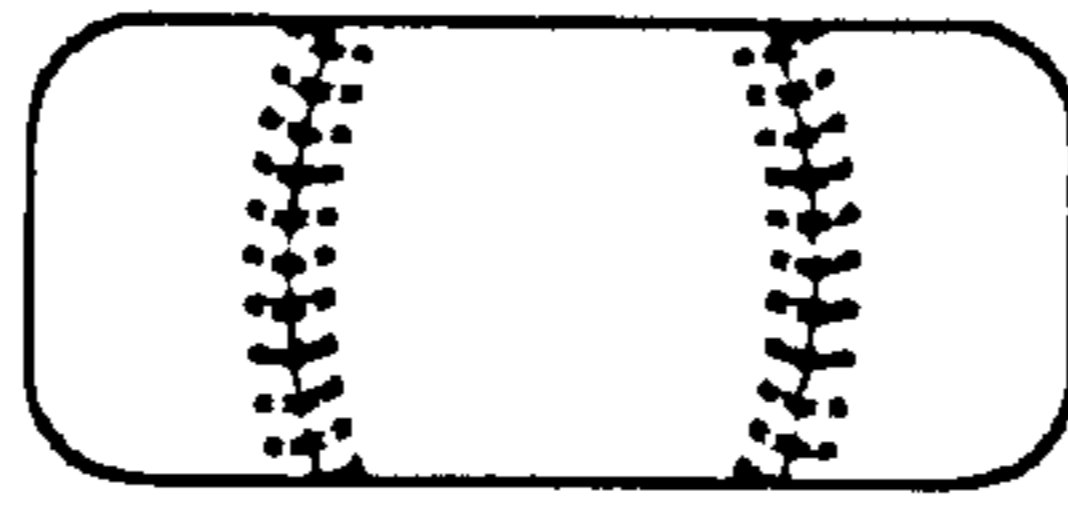

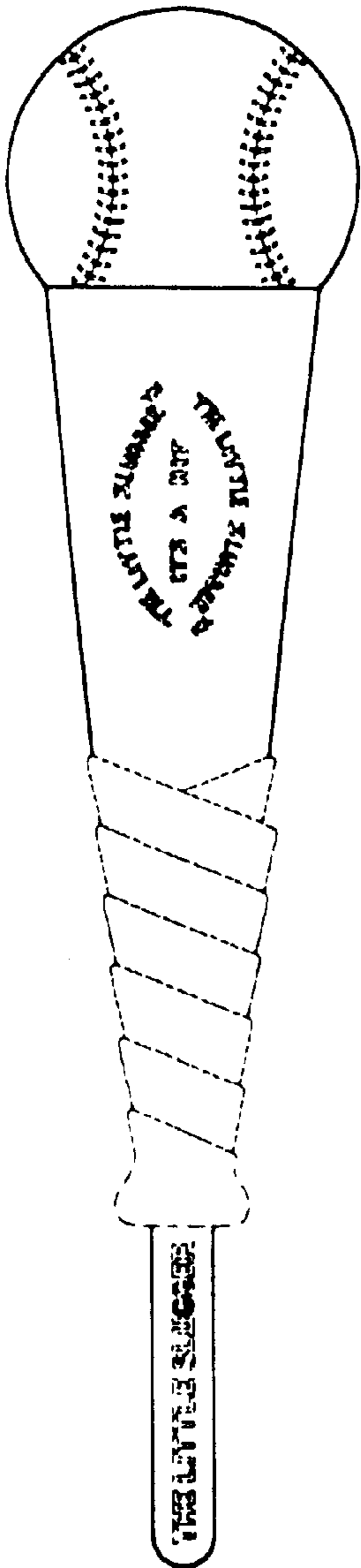

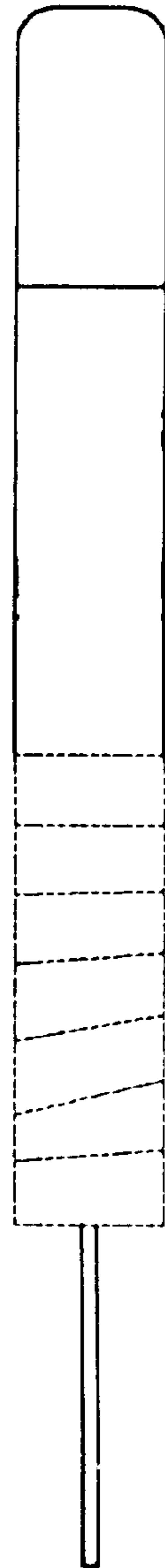

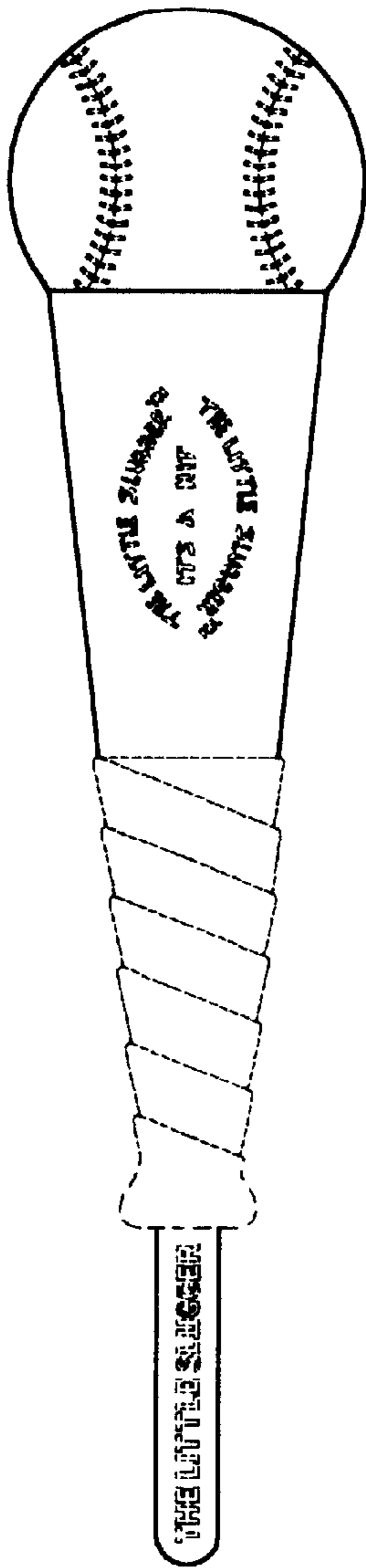

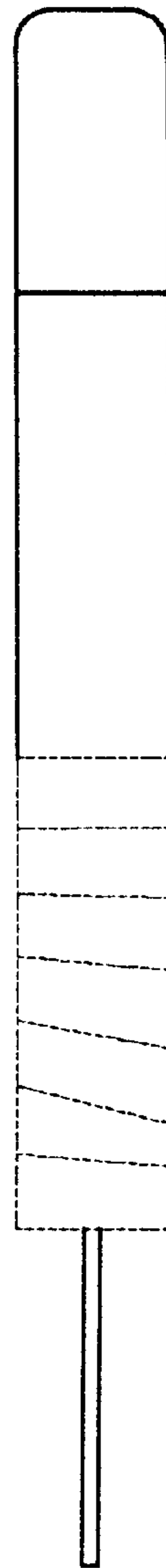

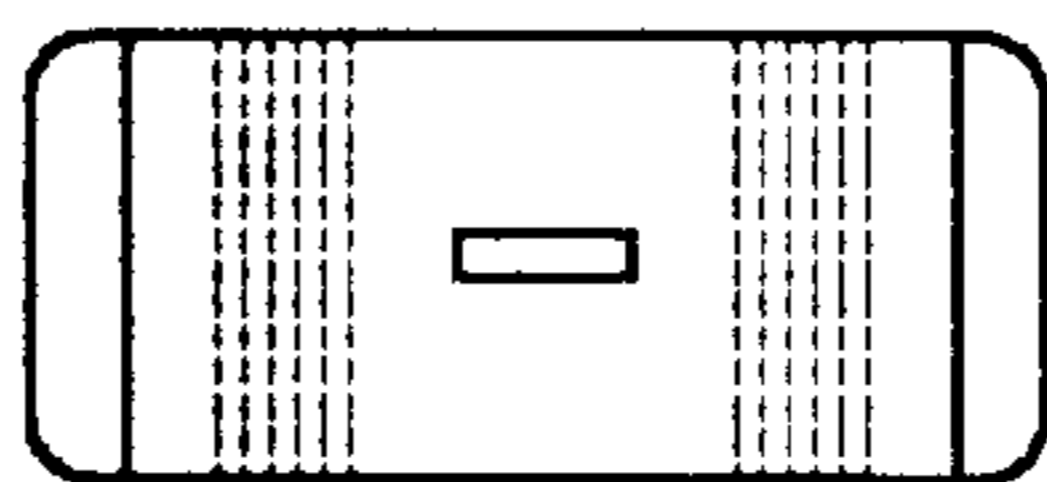
