(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an insect control station, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an insect control station in accordance with the invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the insect control station of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the insect control station of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the insect control station of FIG. 1, showing an alternative arrangement now having a first decorative pattern supported thereon, the first decorative pattern comprising spaced indicia of varying width positioned about the pedestal;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 7 ;

FIG. 10 is a right-side elevational view of the insect control station of FIG. 7;

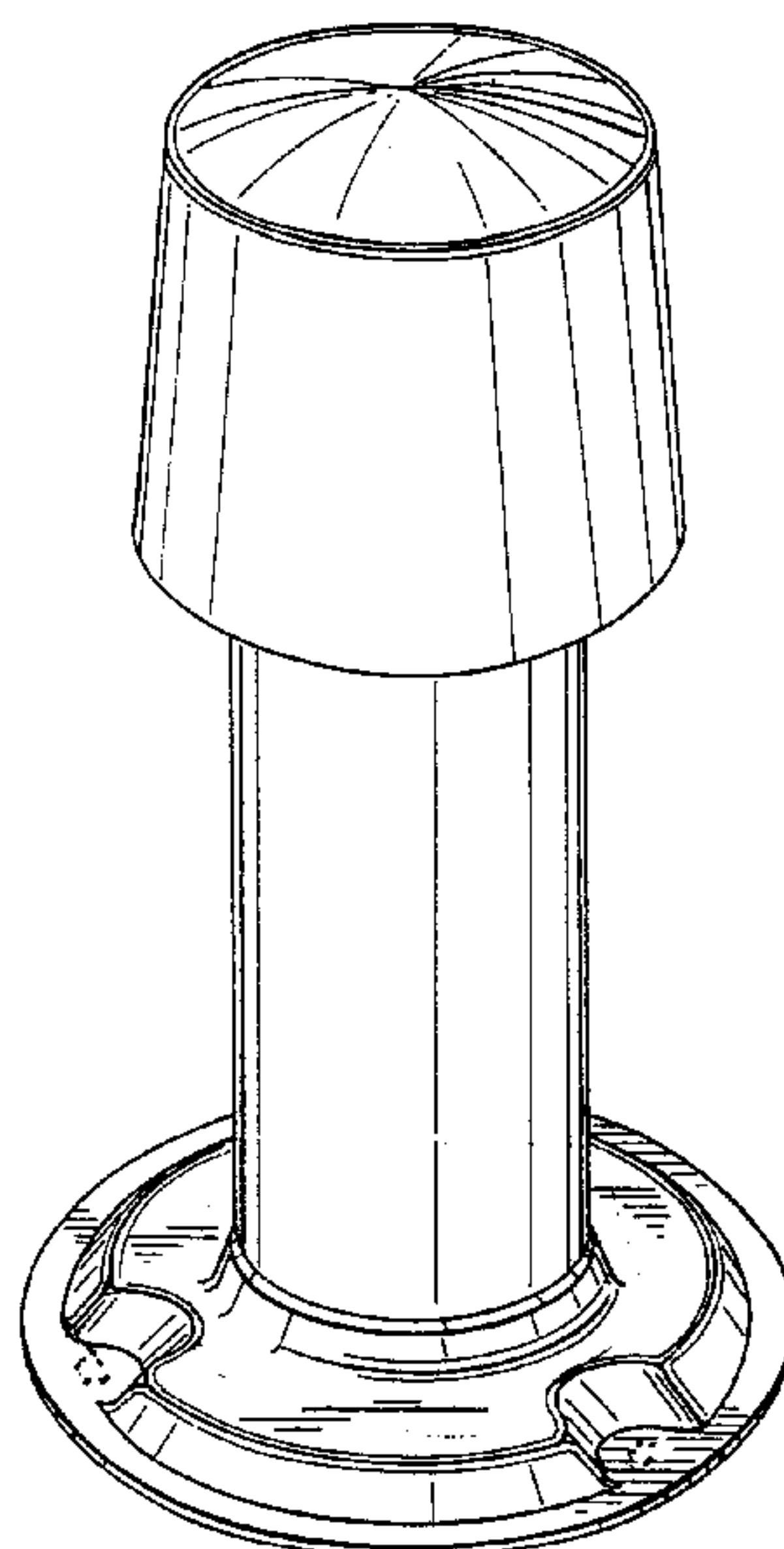
FIG. 11 is a cylindrical projection view of a portion of the insect control station of FIG. 7, showing the first decorative pattern;

FIG. 12 is a perspective view of the insect control station of FIG. 1, showing a further arrangement in which a second decorative pattern is supported on the pedestal and comprises spaced indicia of uniform width positioned about the pedestal; and,

FIG. 13 is a cylindrical projection view of a portion of the insect control station of FIG. 12, showing the second decorative pattern.

The broken lines showing of the holes are to show the environment only and are not part of the claimed design.

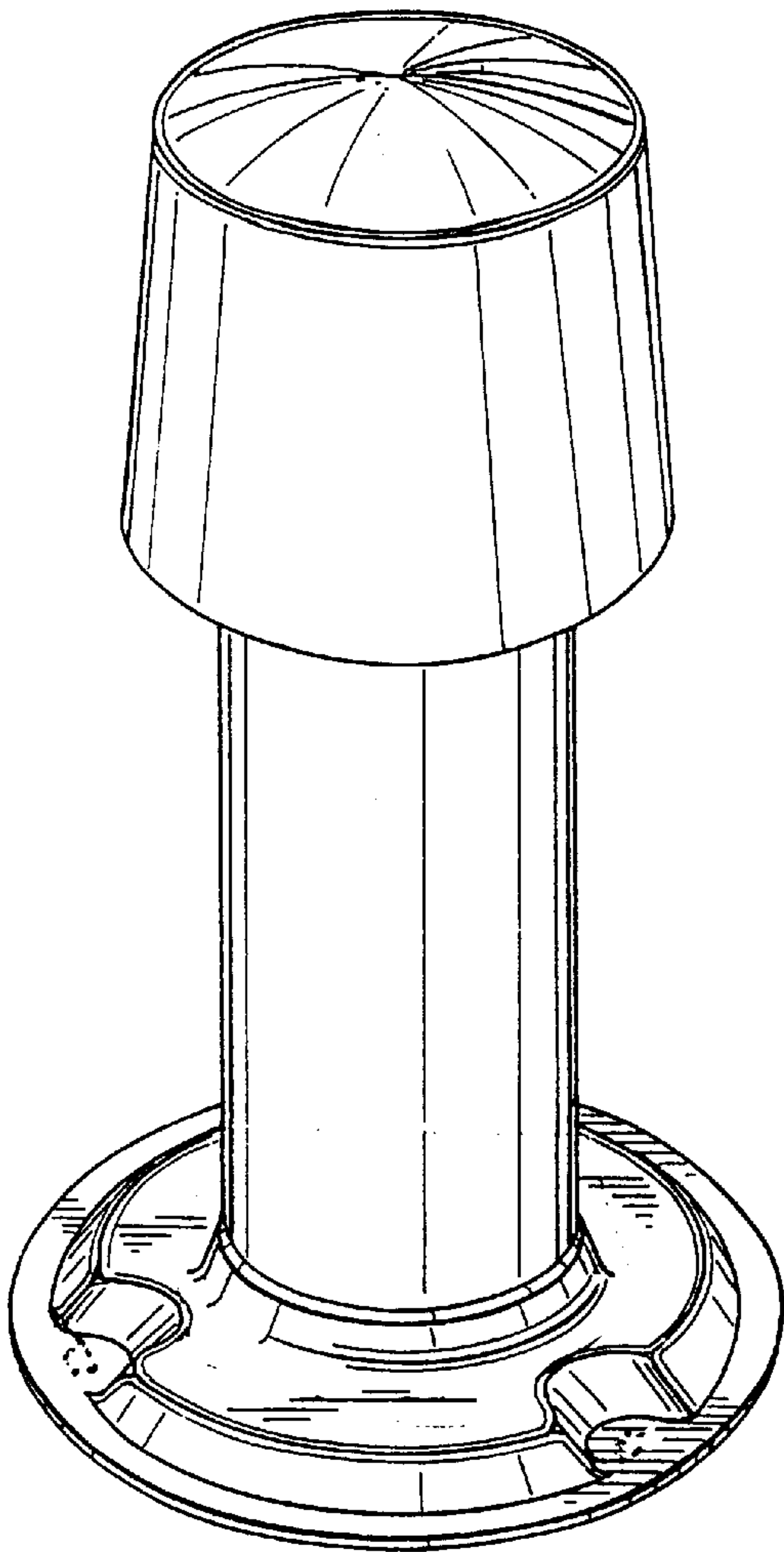

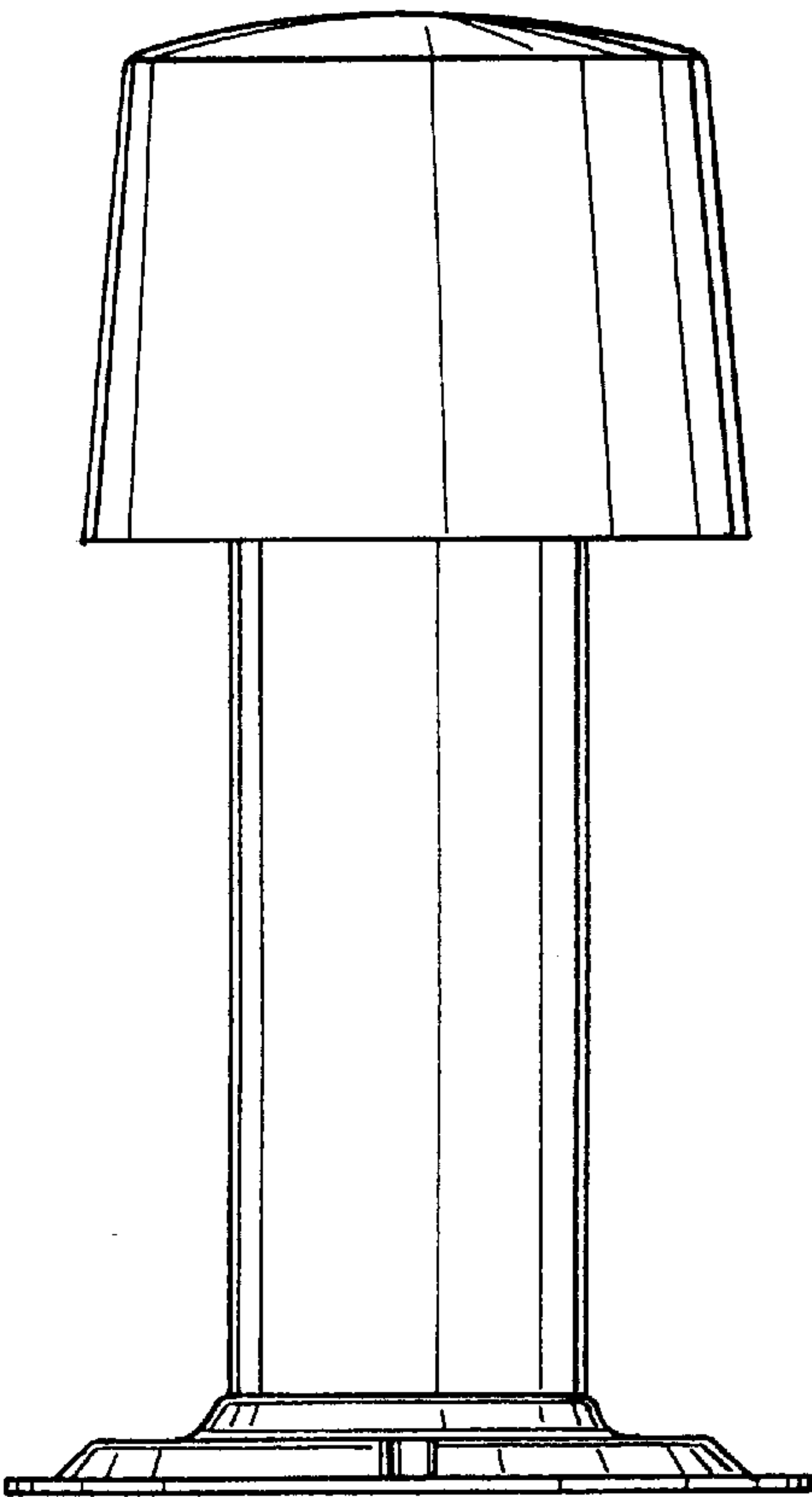

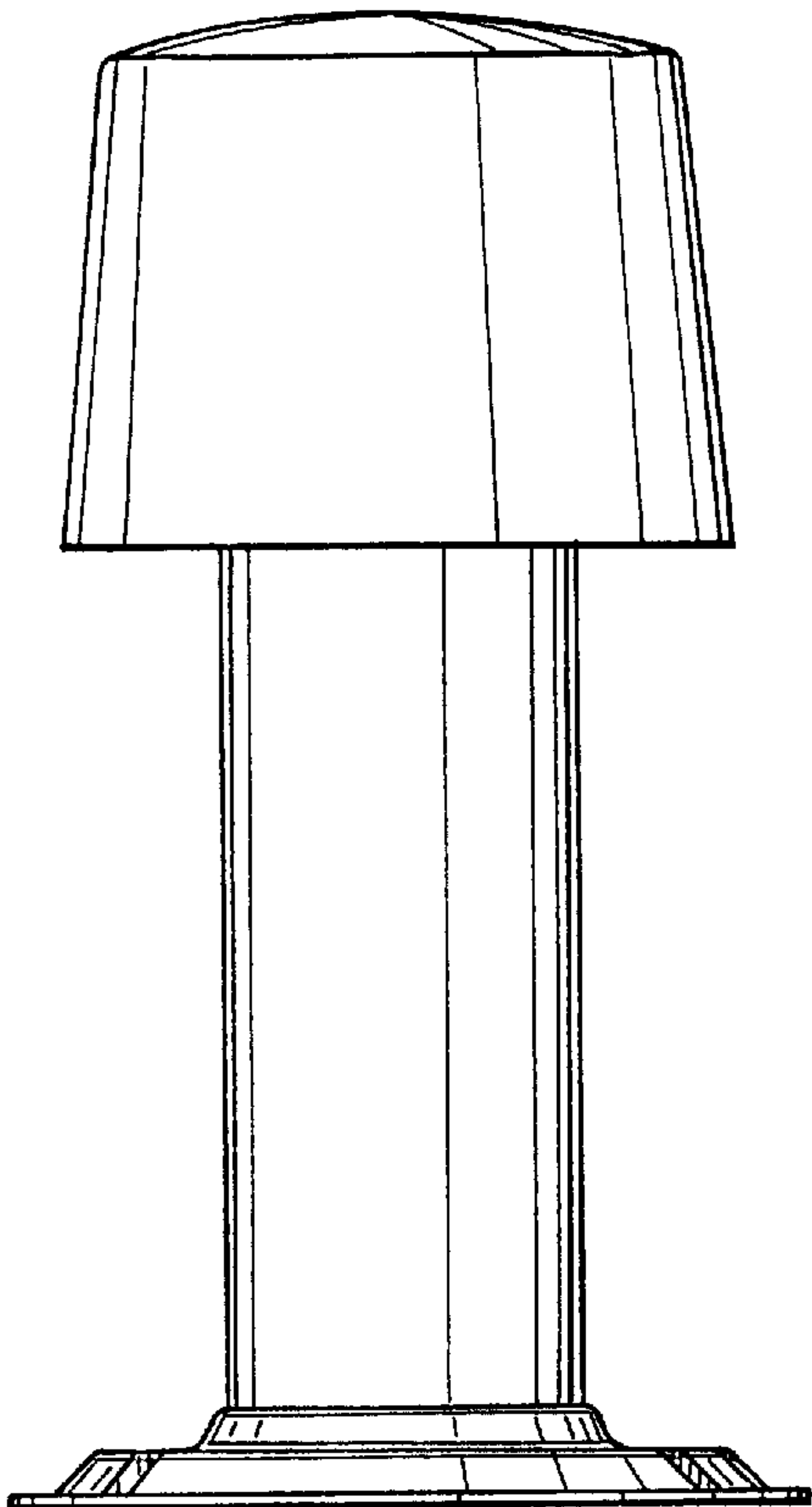

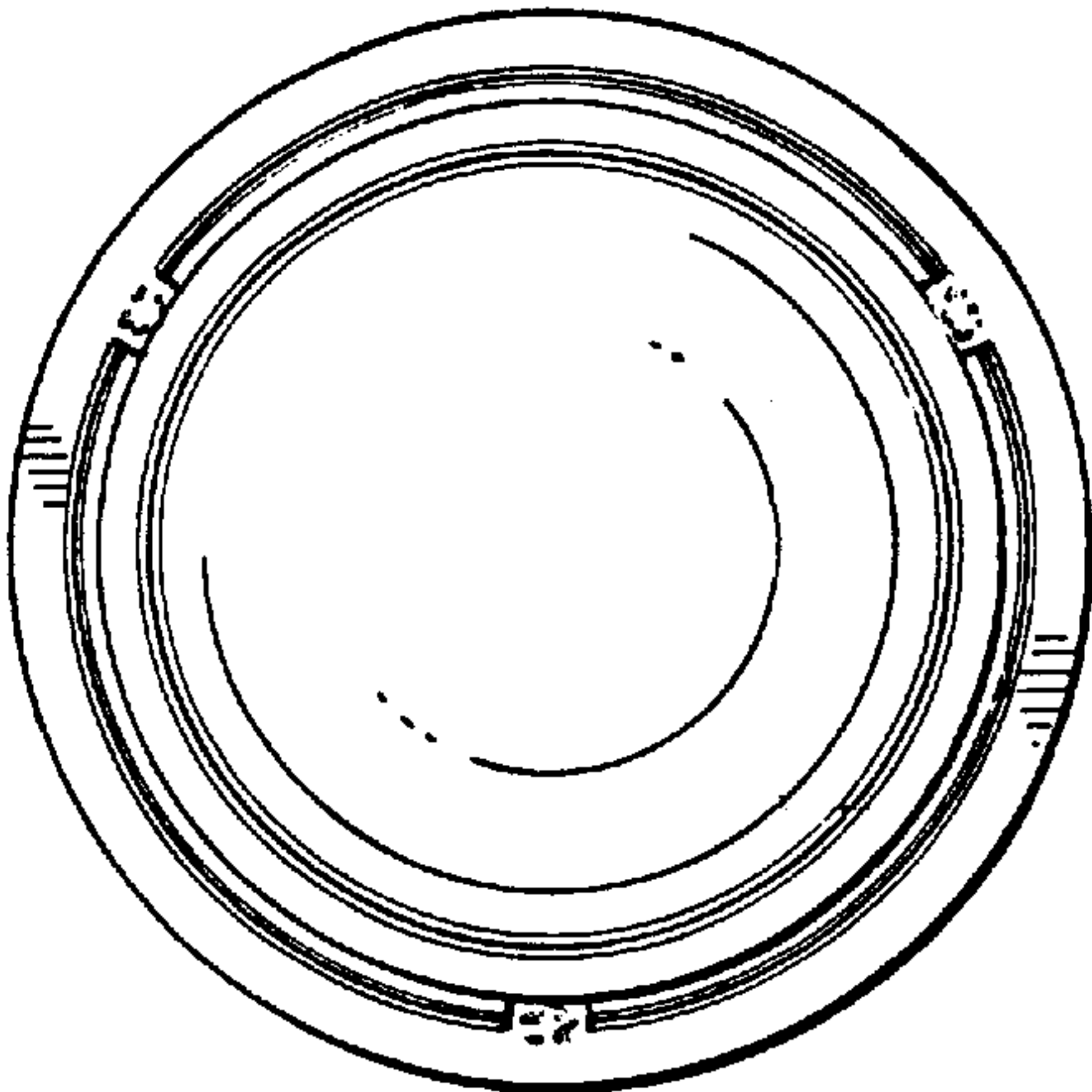

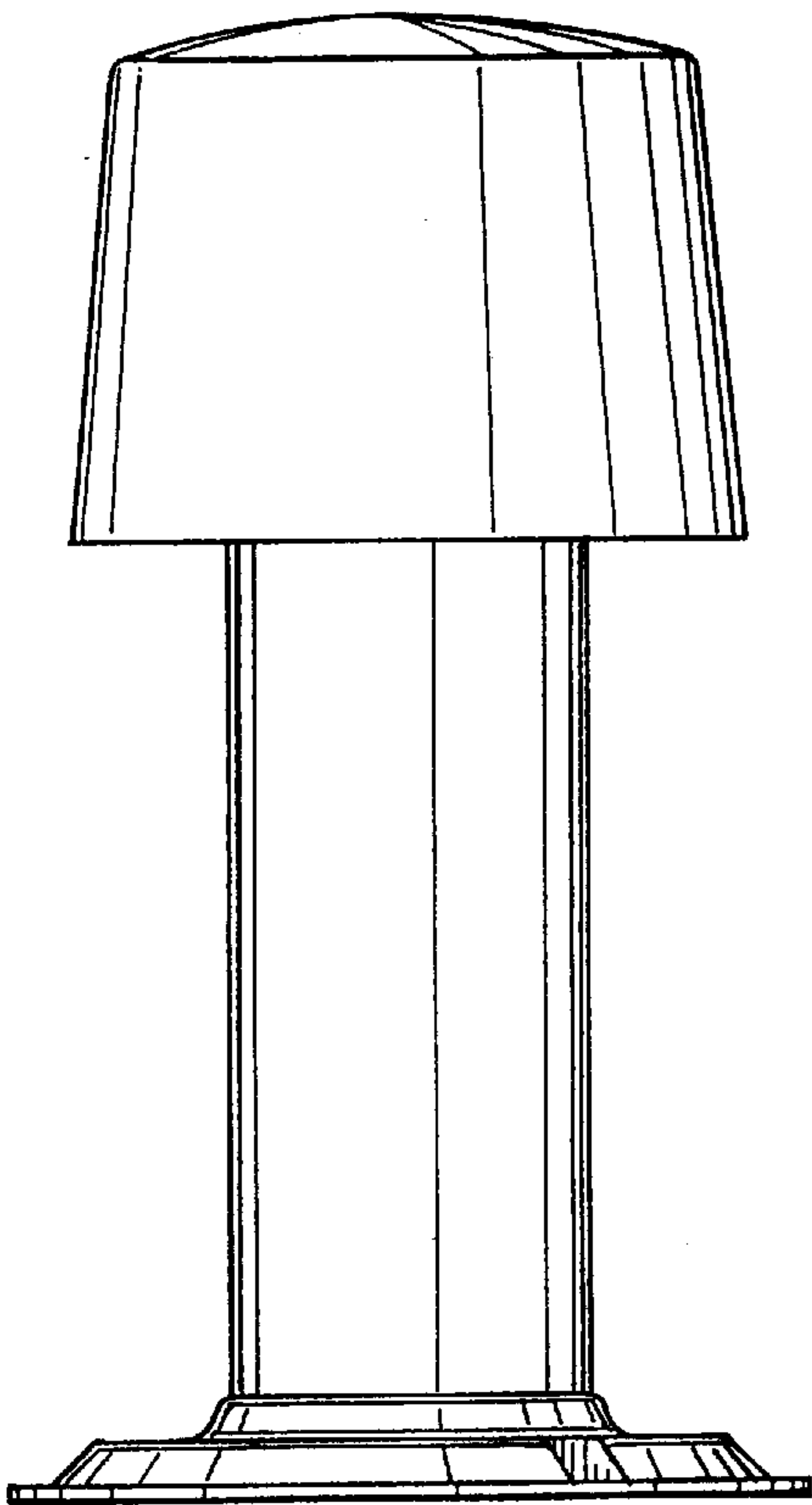
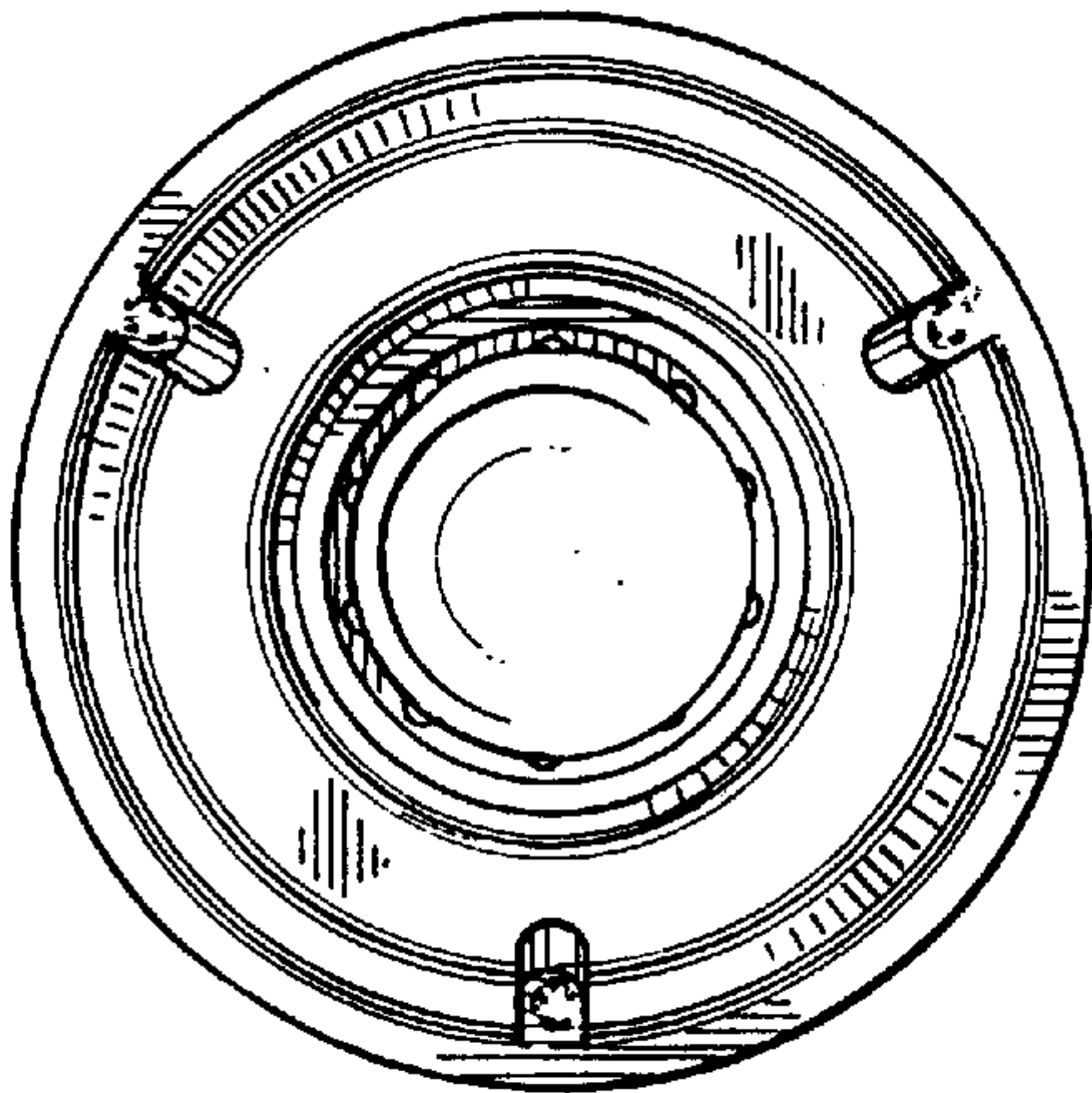

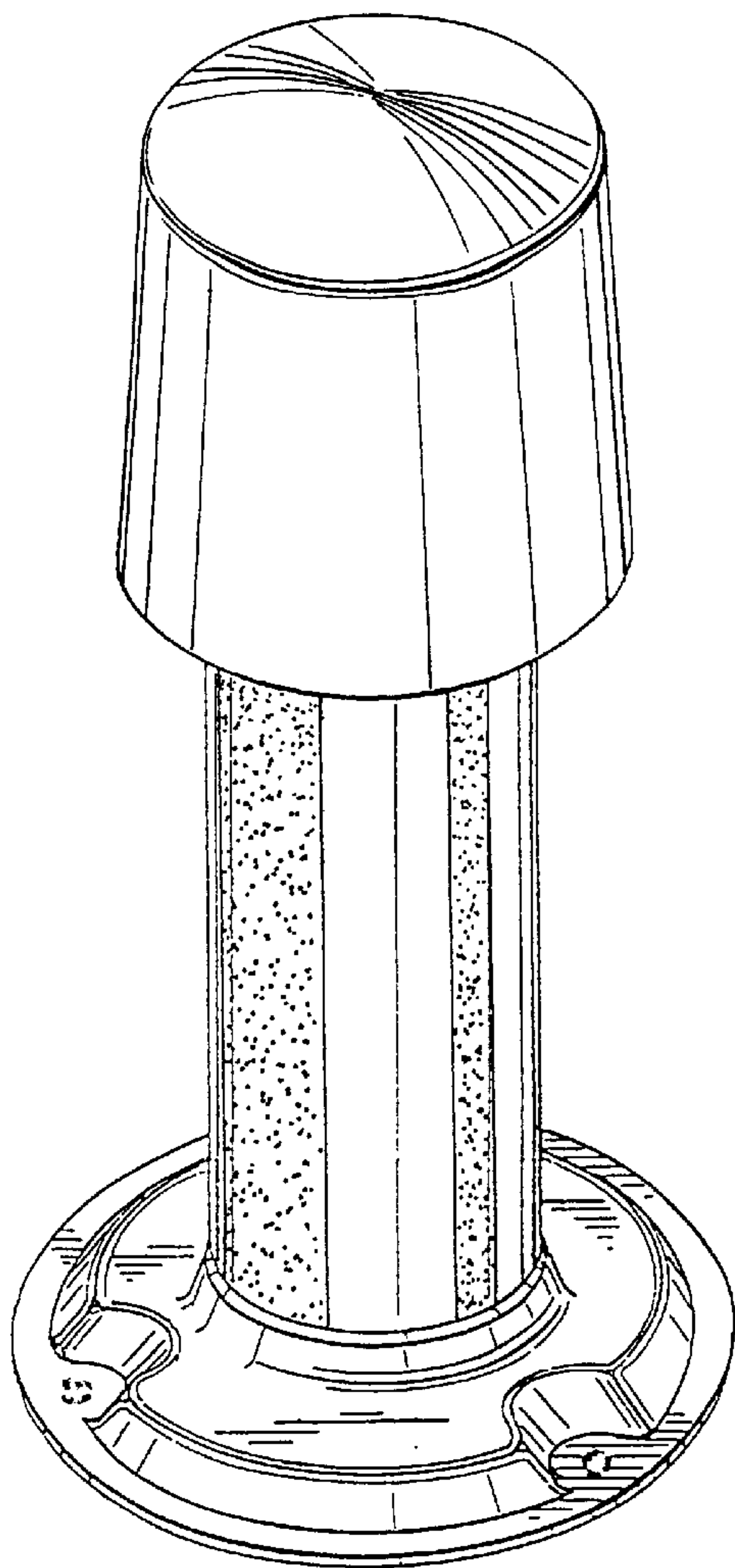

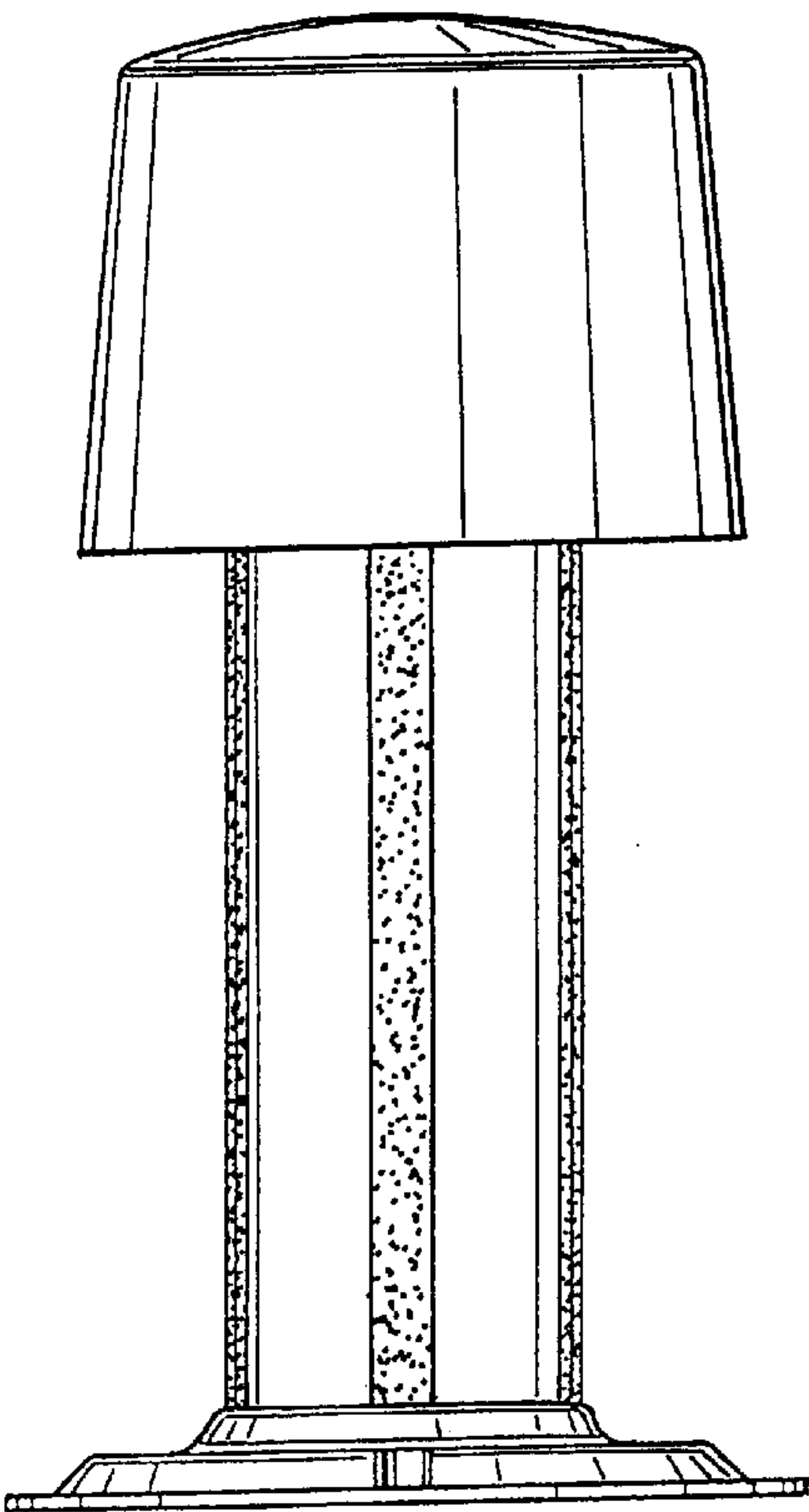

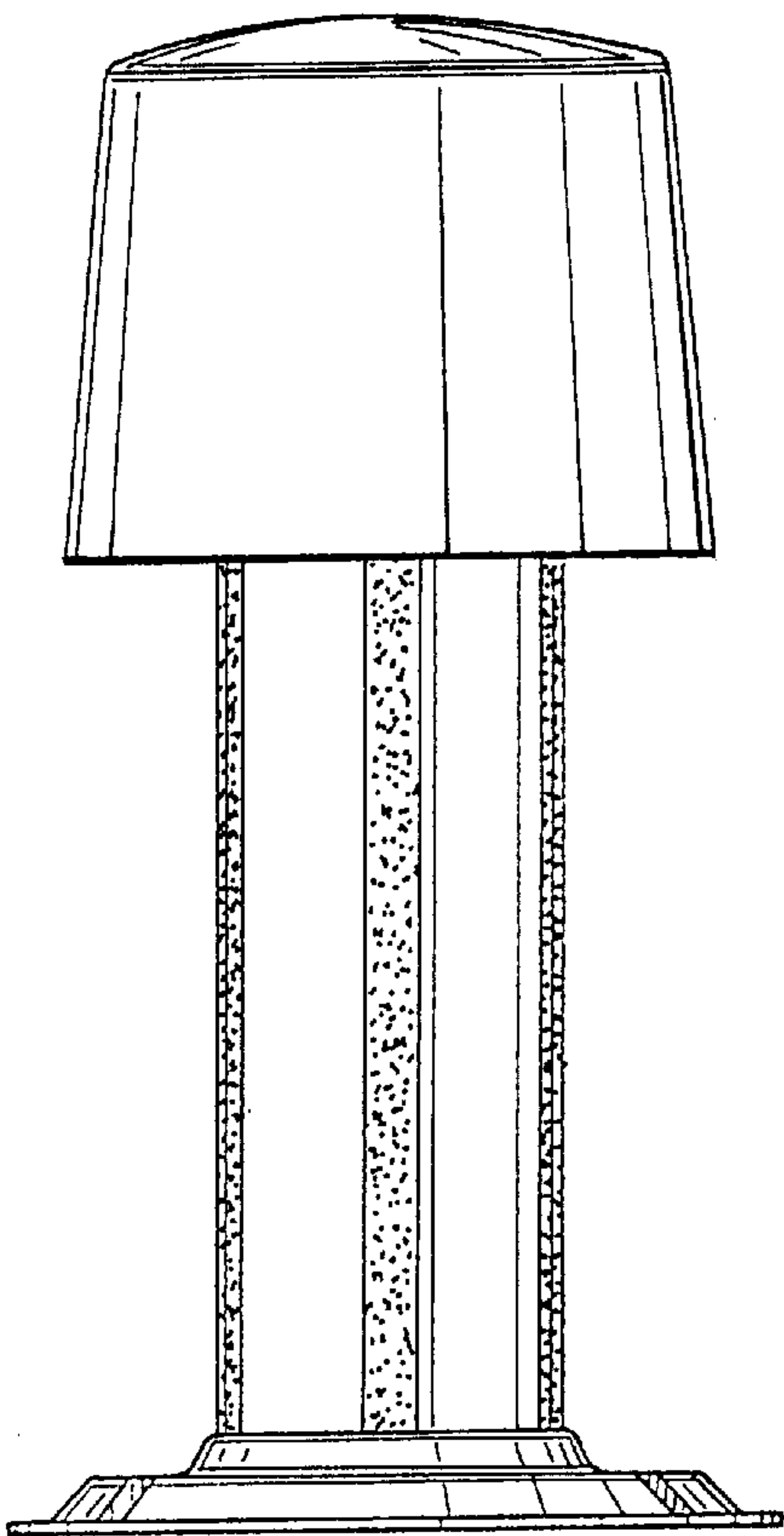

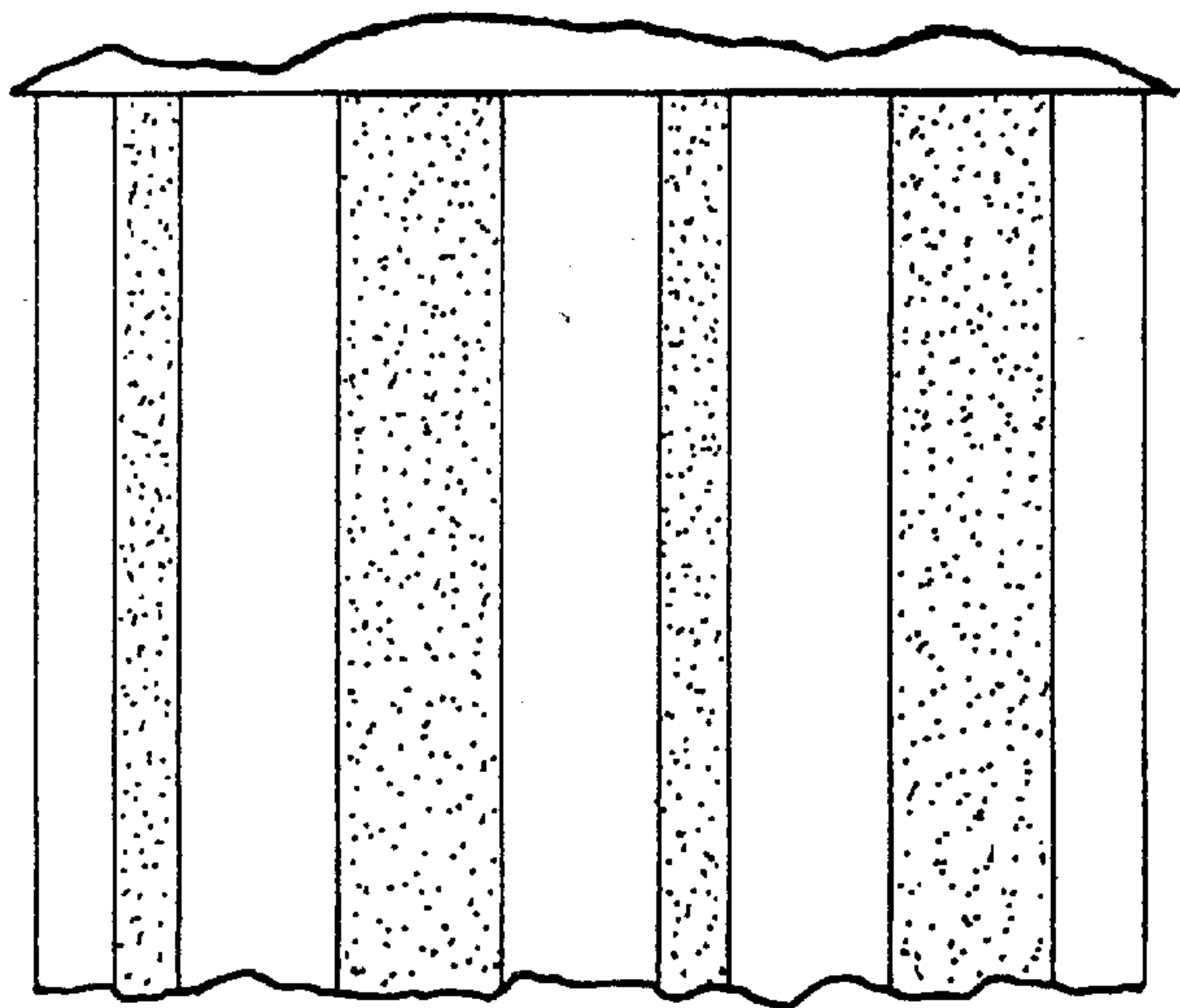
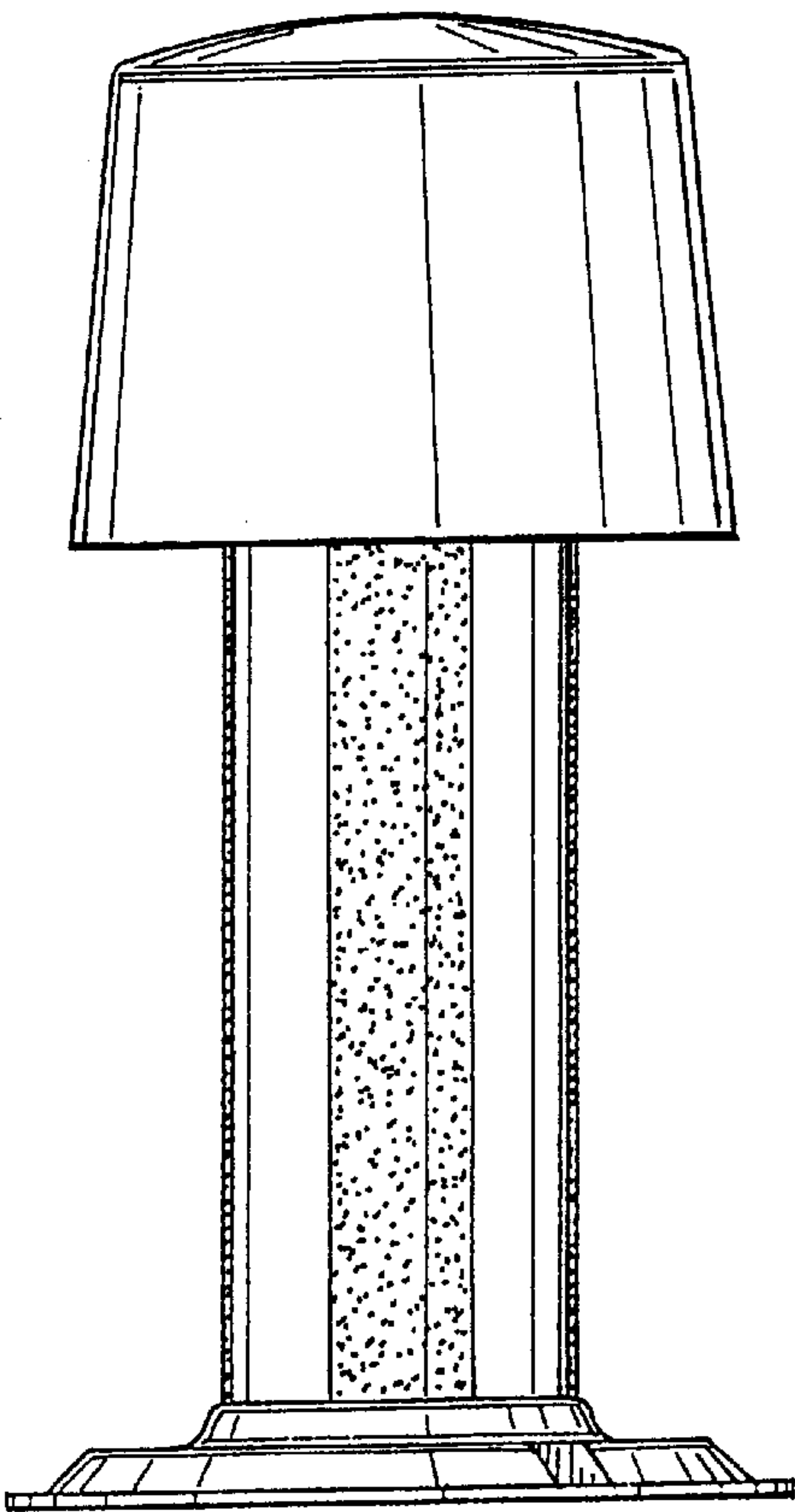

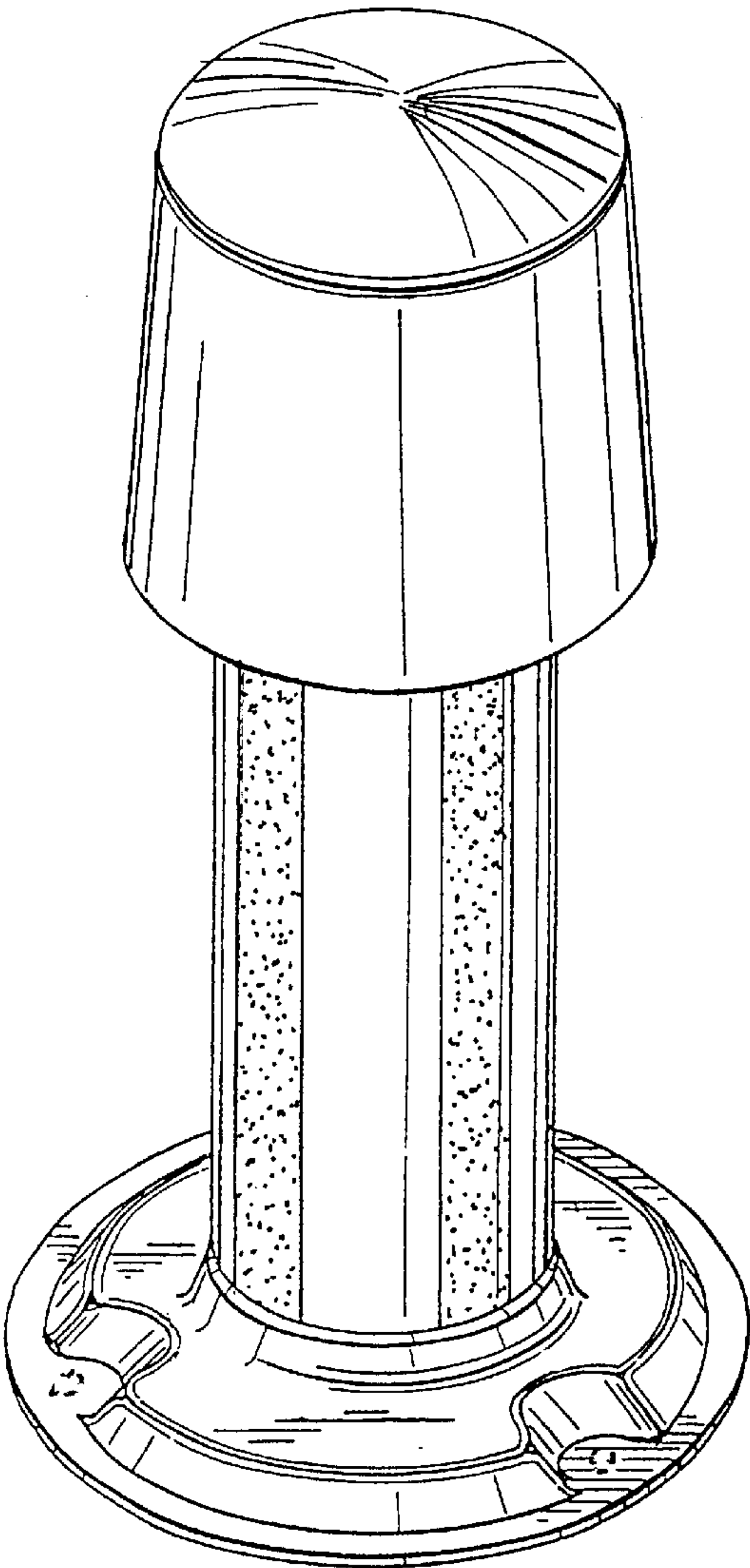
