FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof; and,

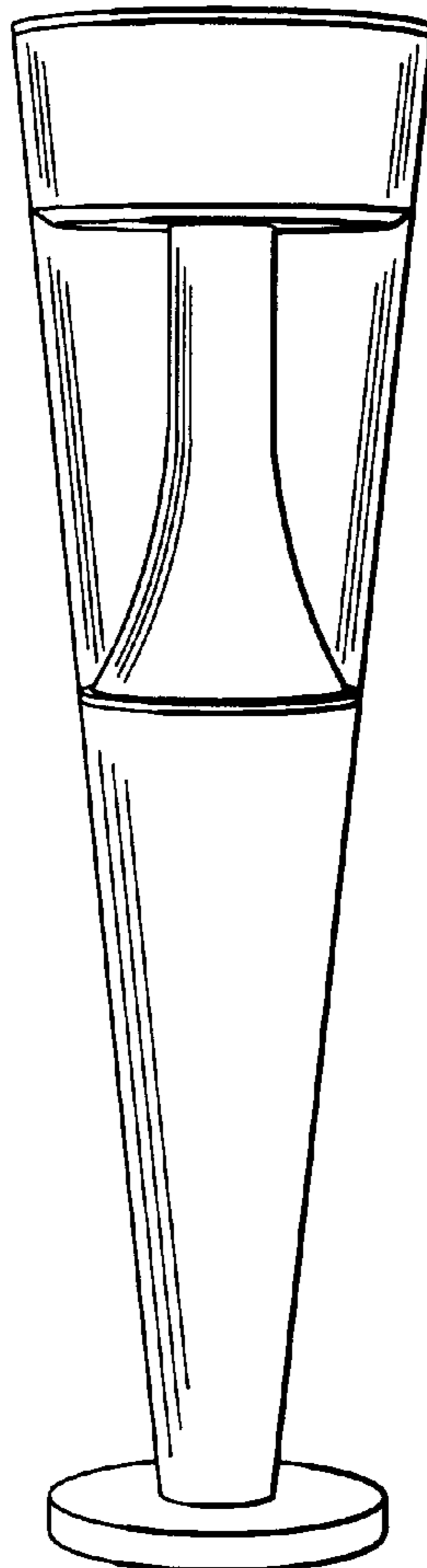
FIG. 3 is an enlarged top view thereof.

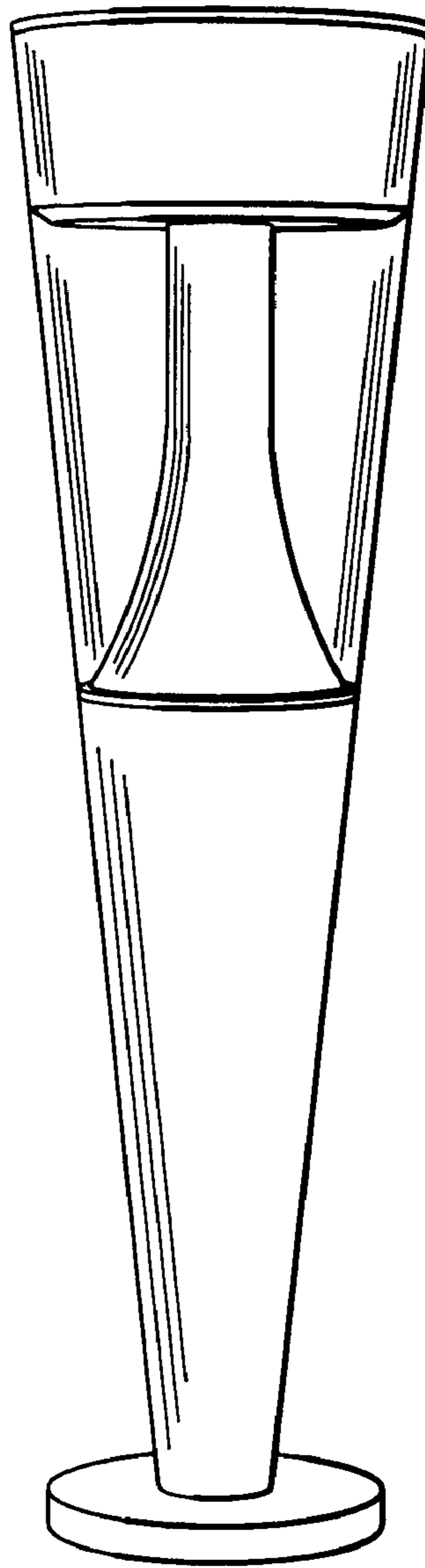

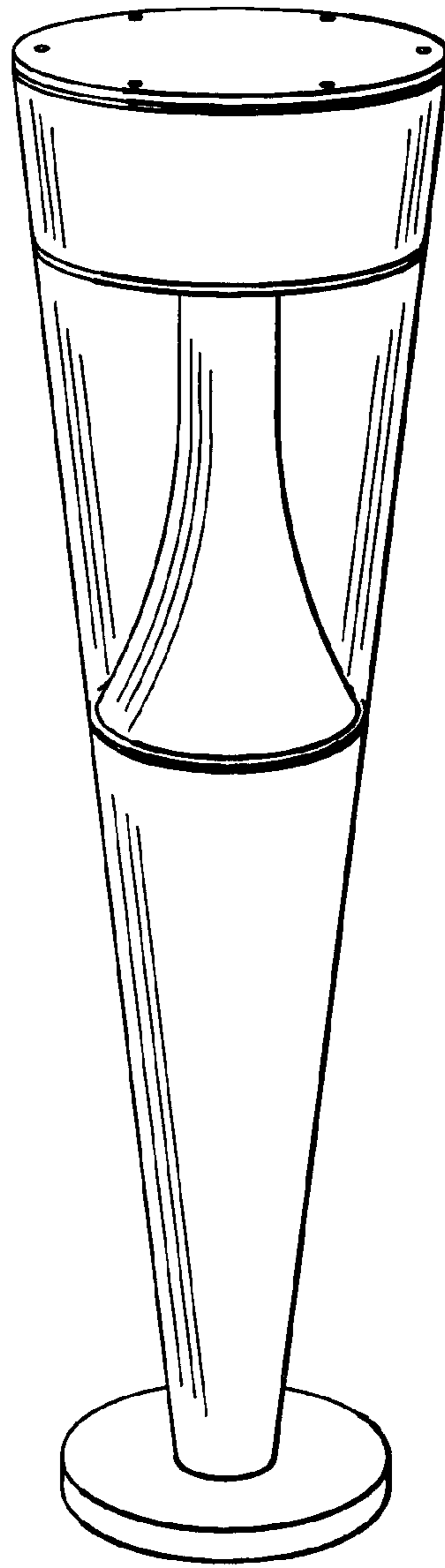

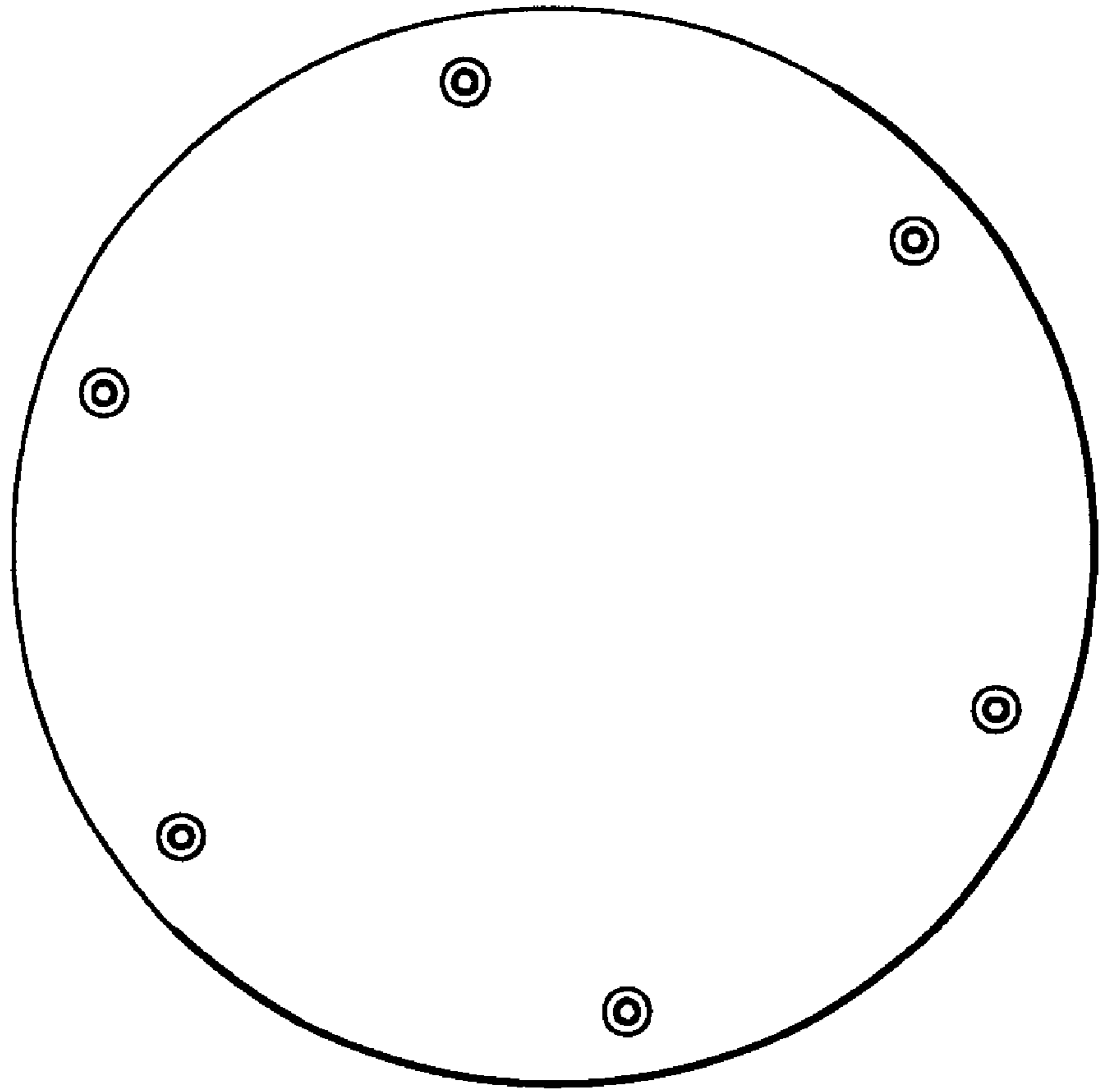
