DESCRIPTION

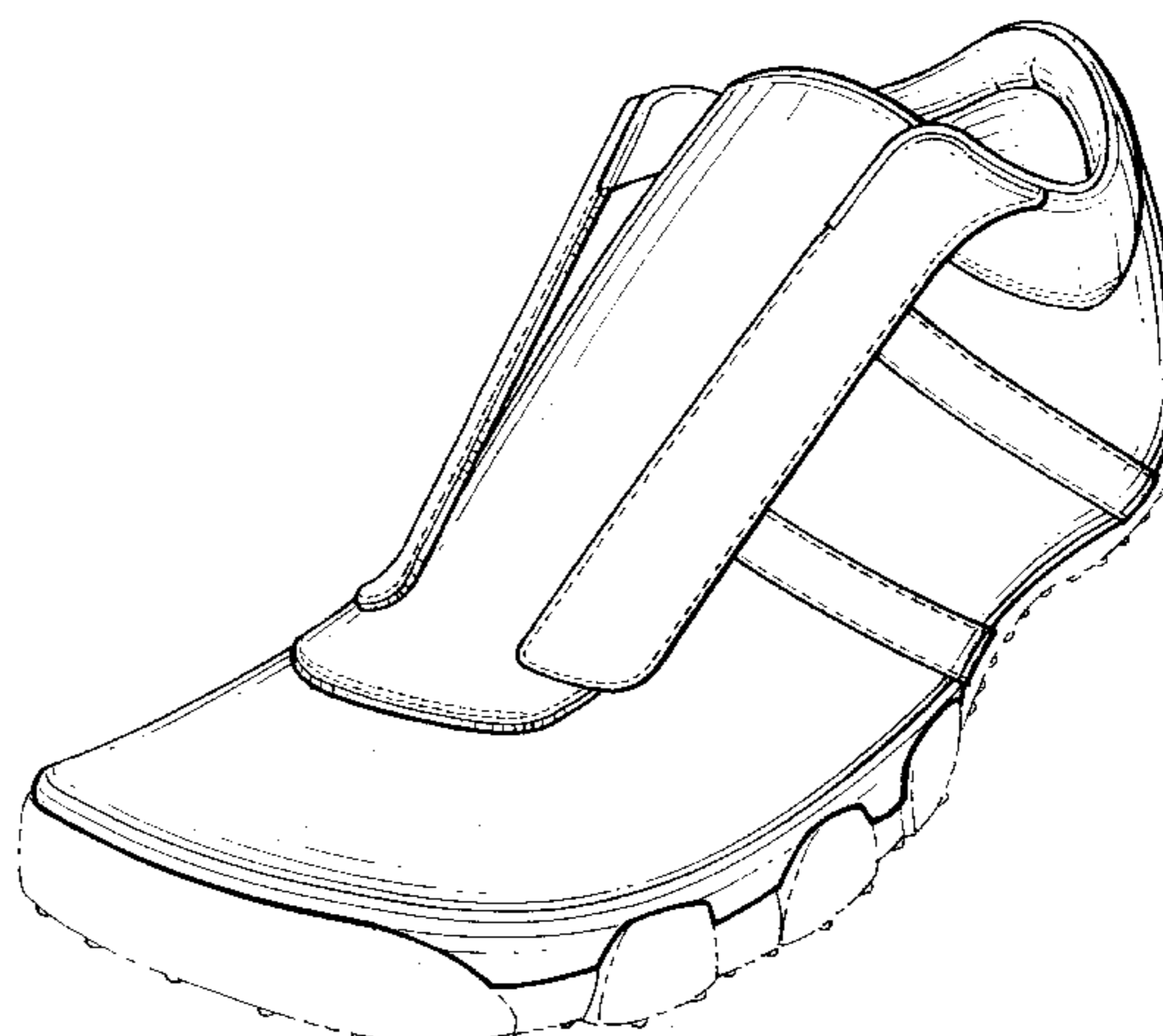
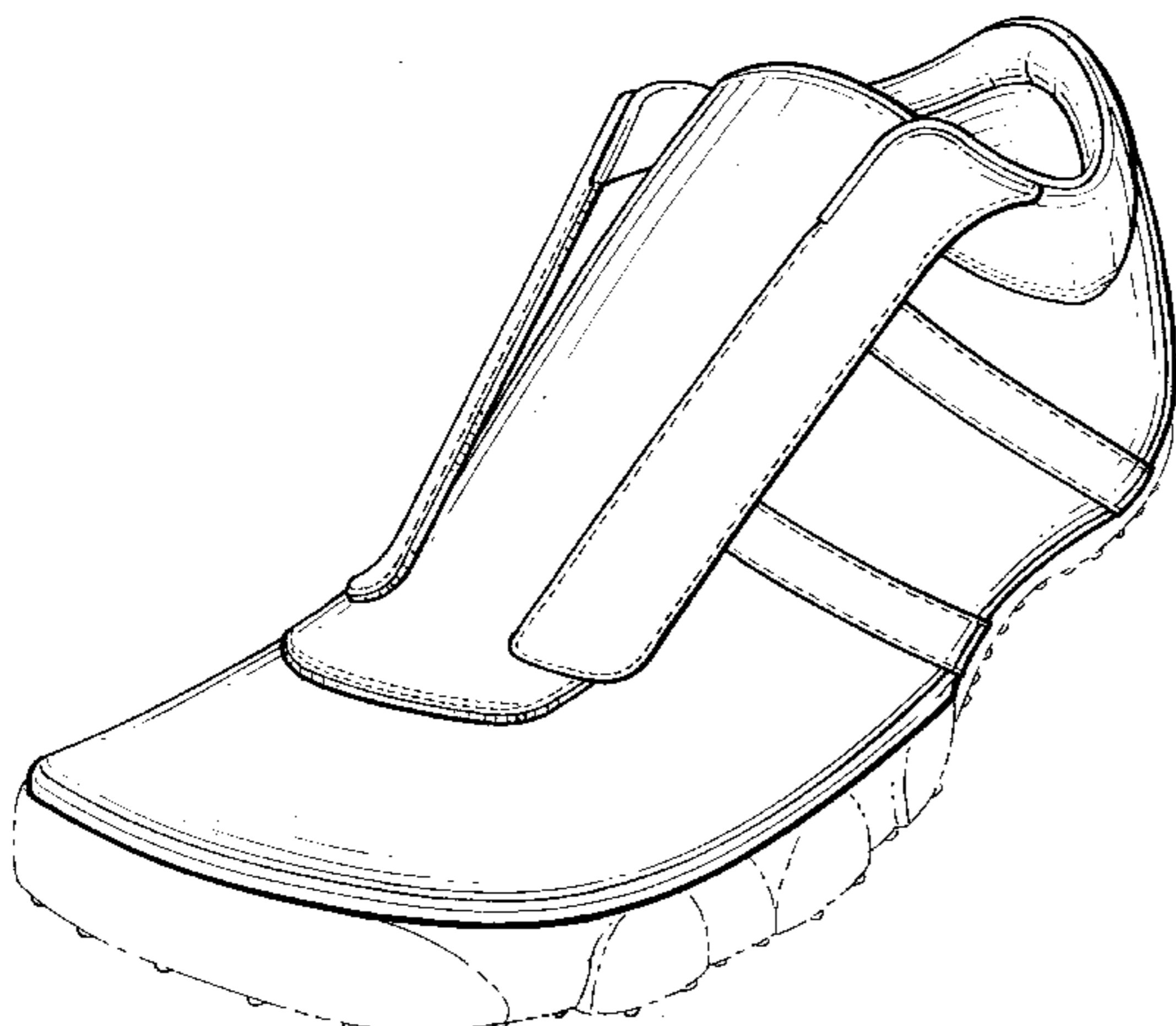
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the portion of a shoe upper showing our new design;

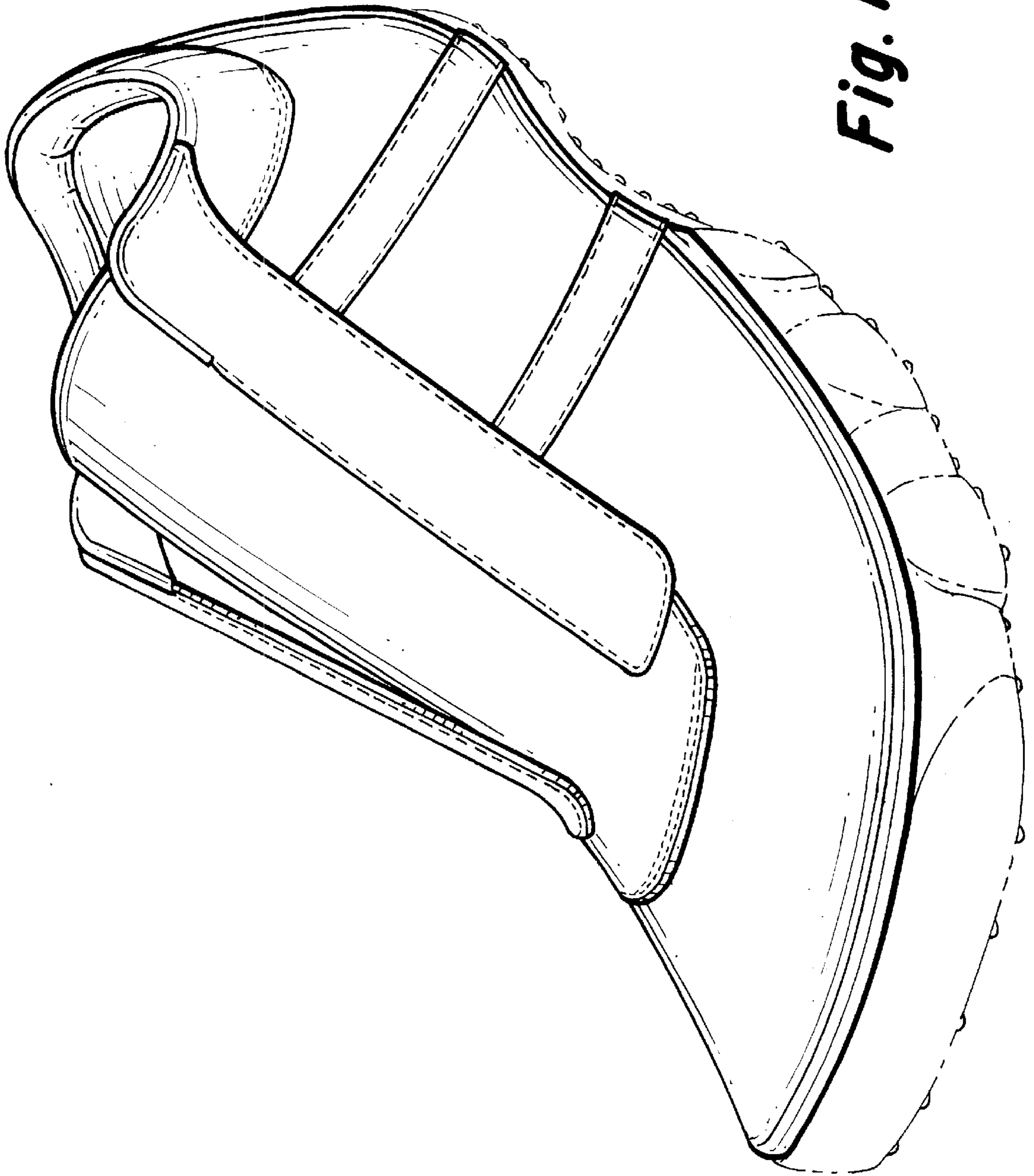

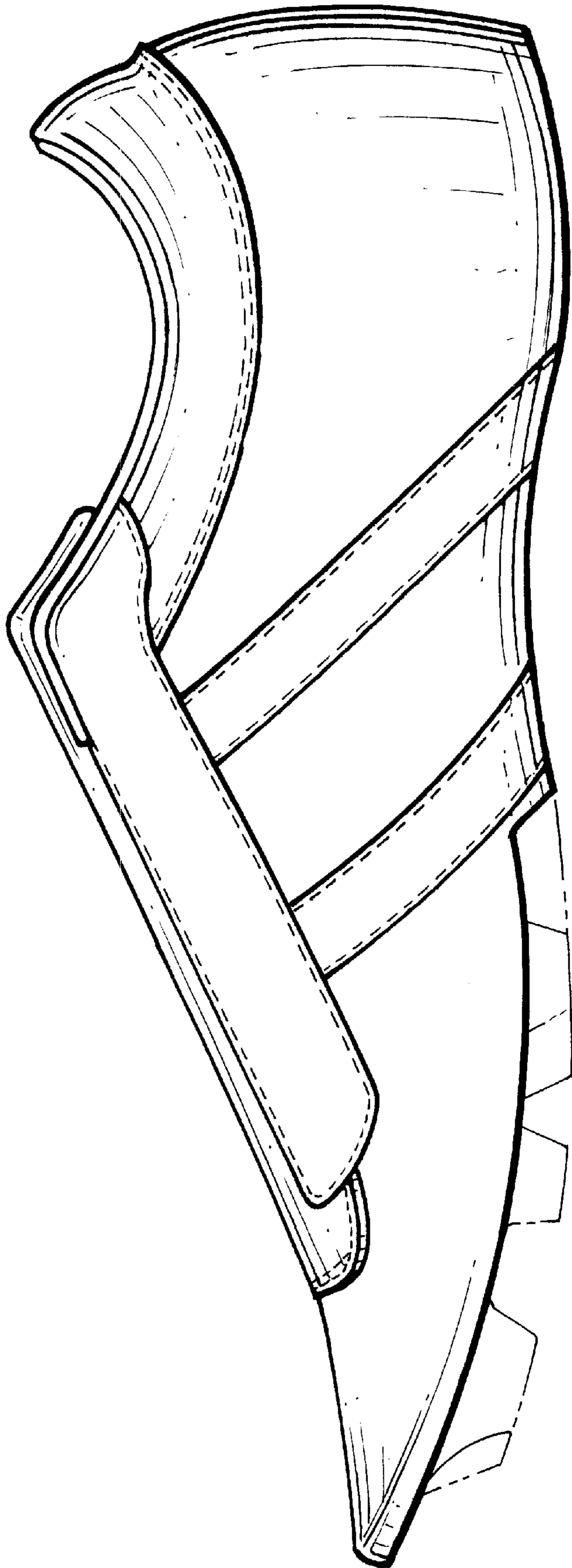

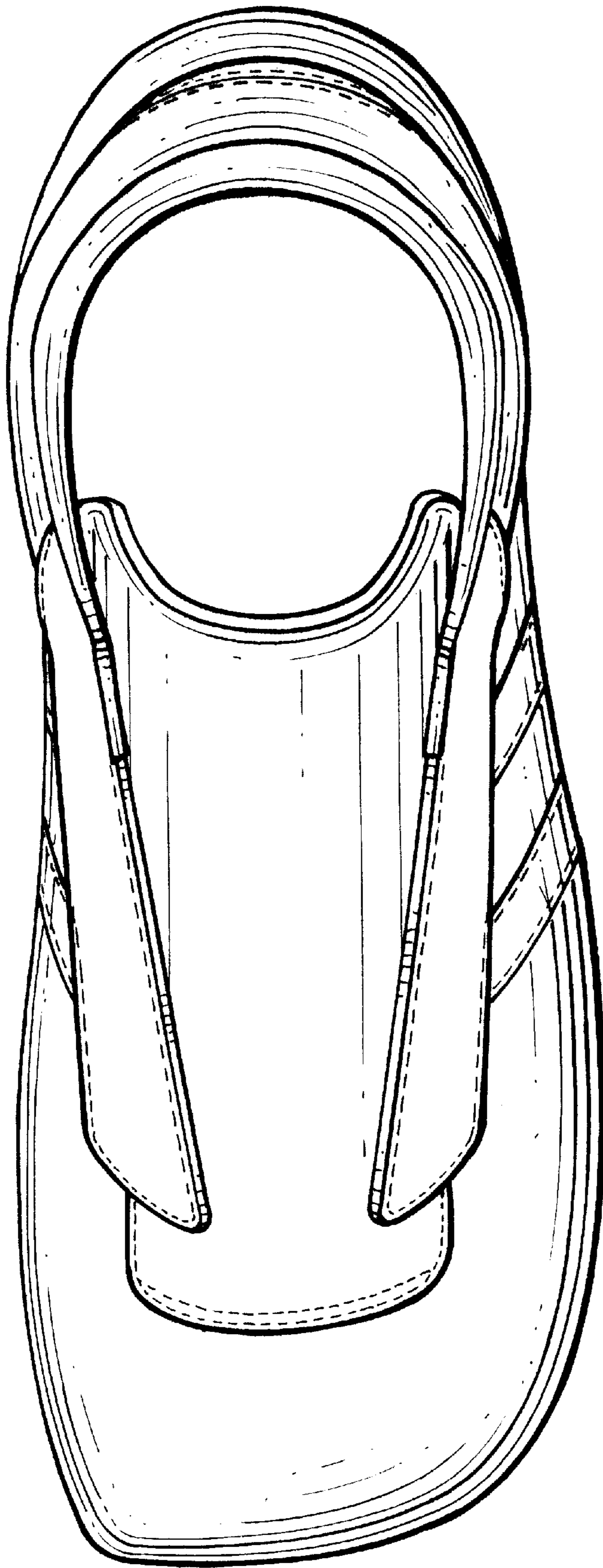

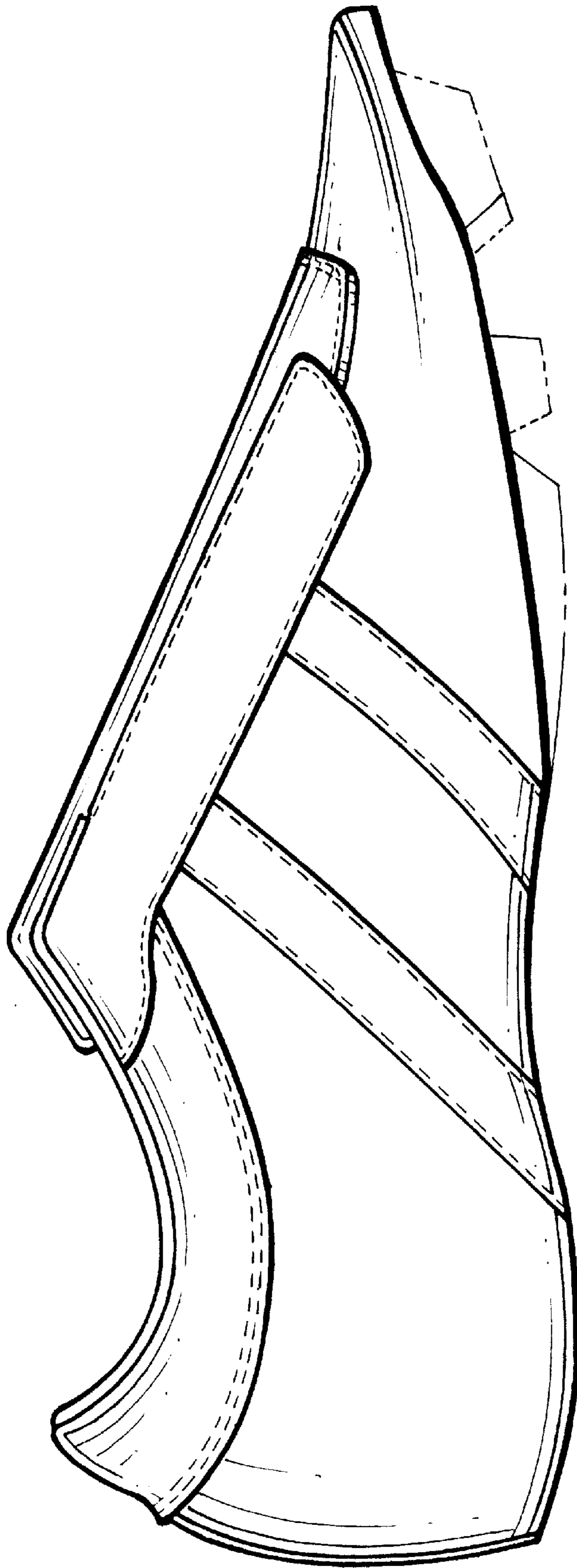

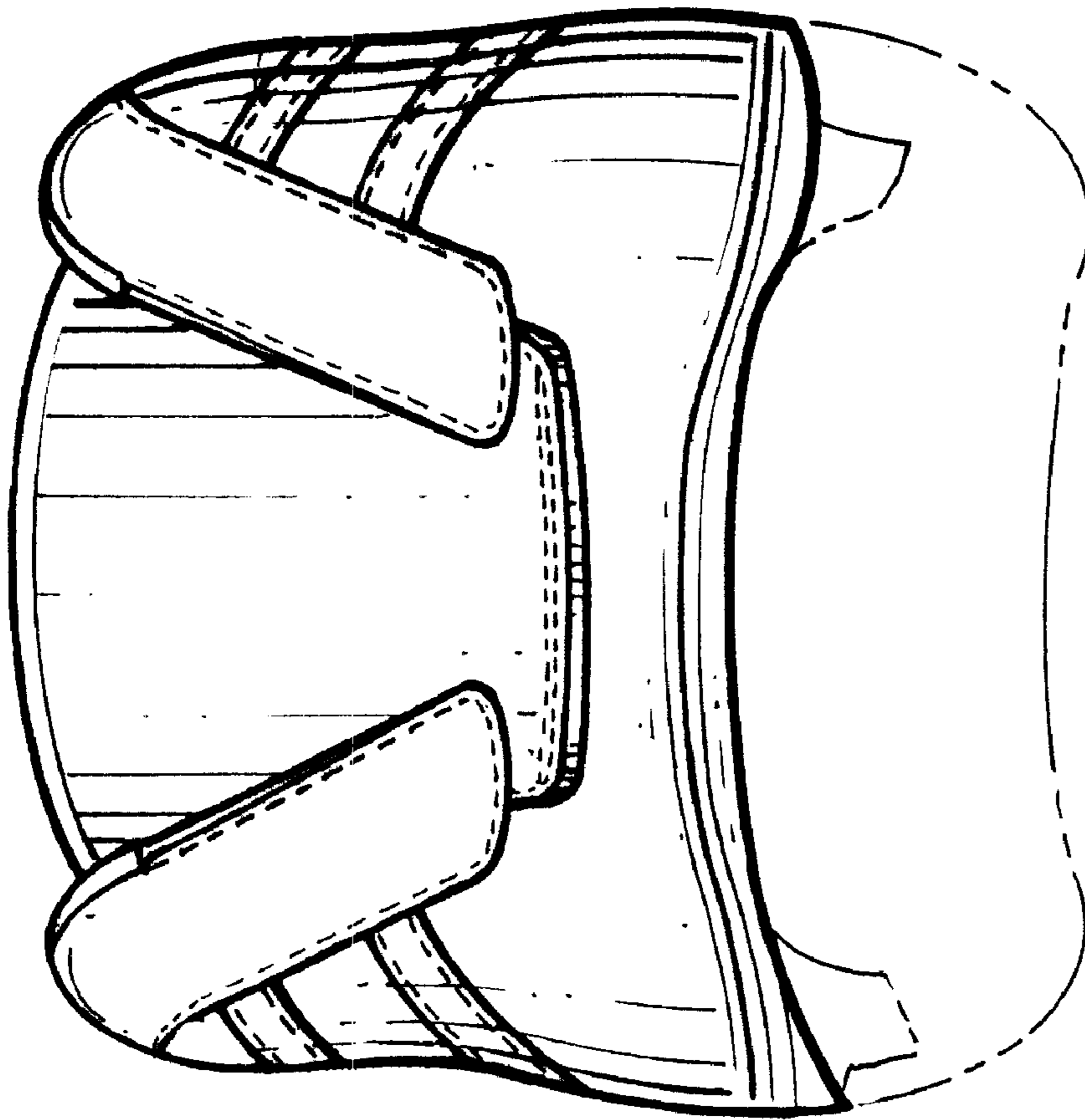

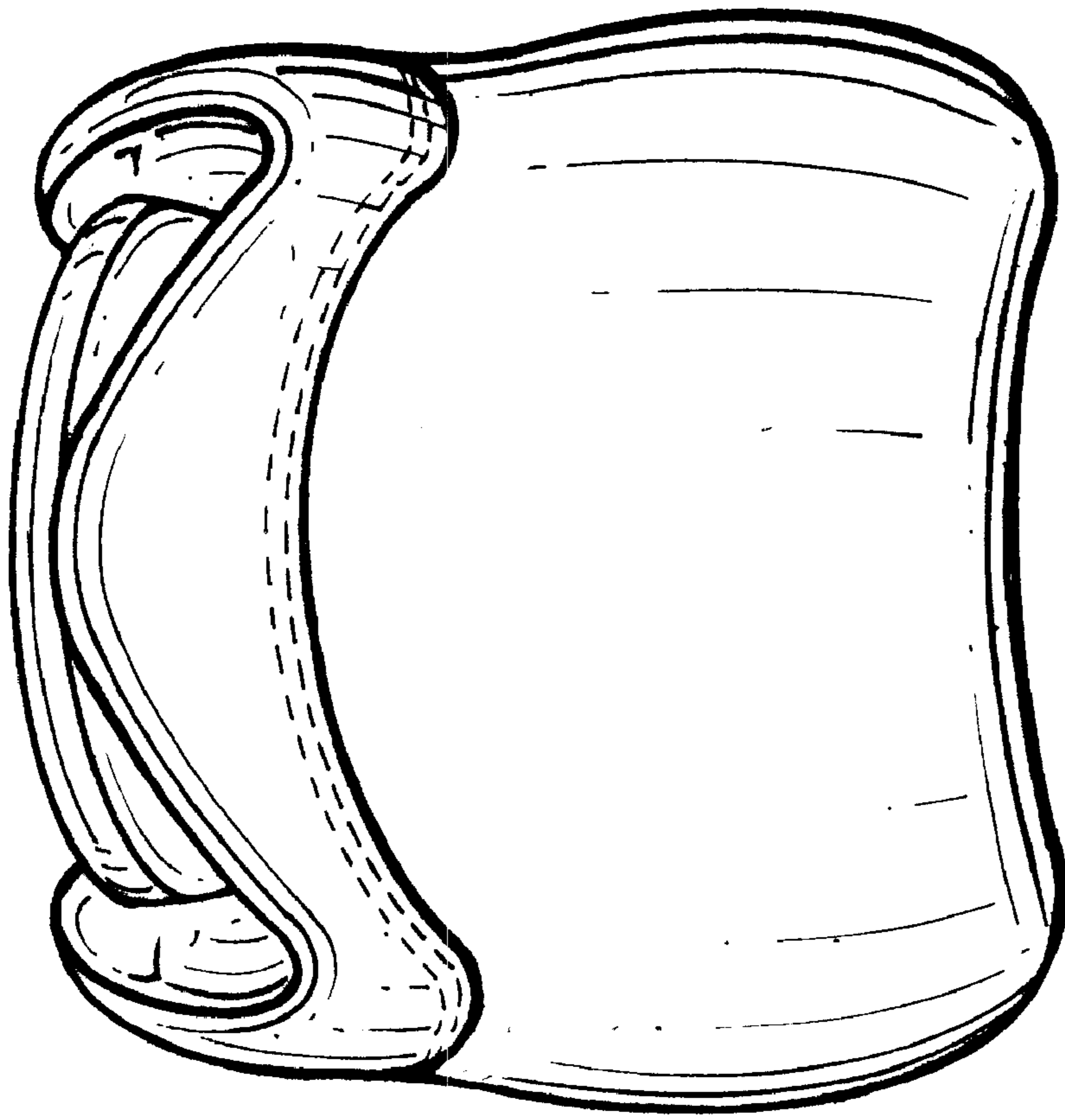

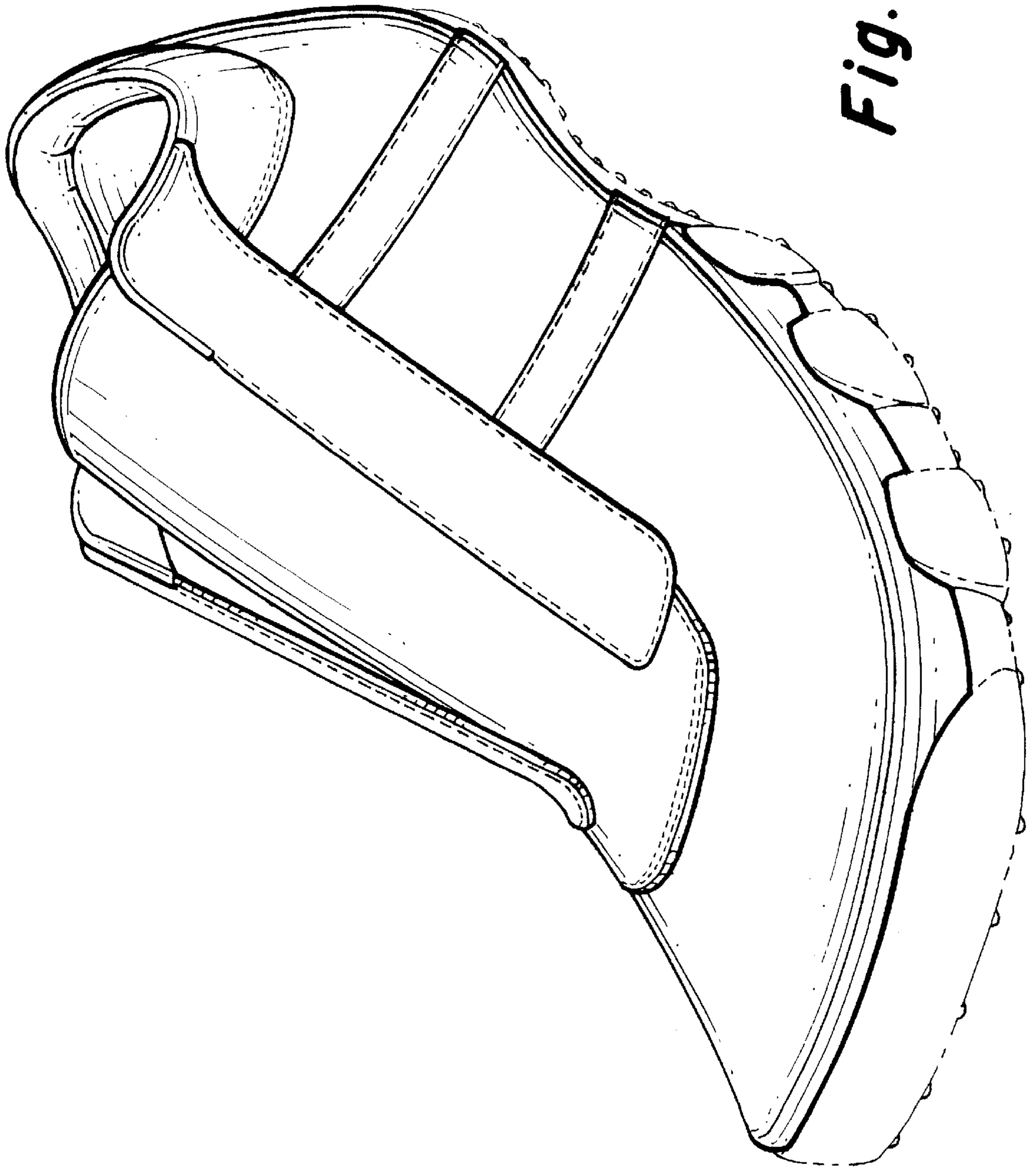

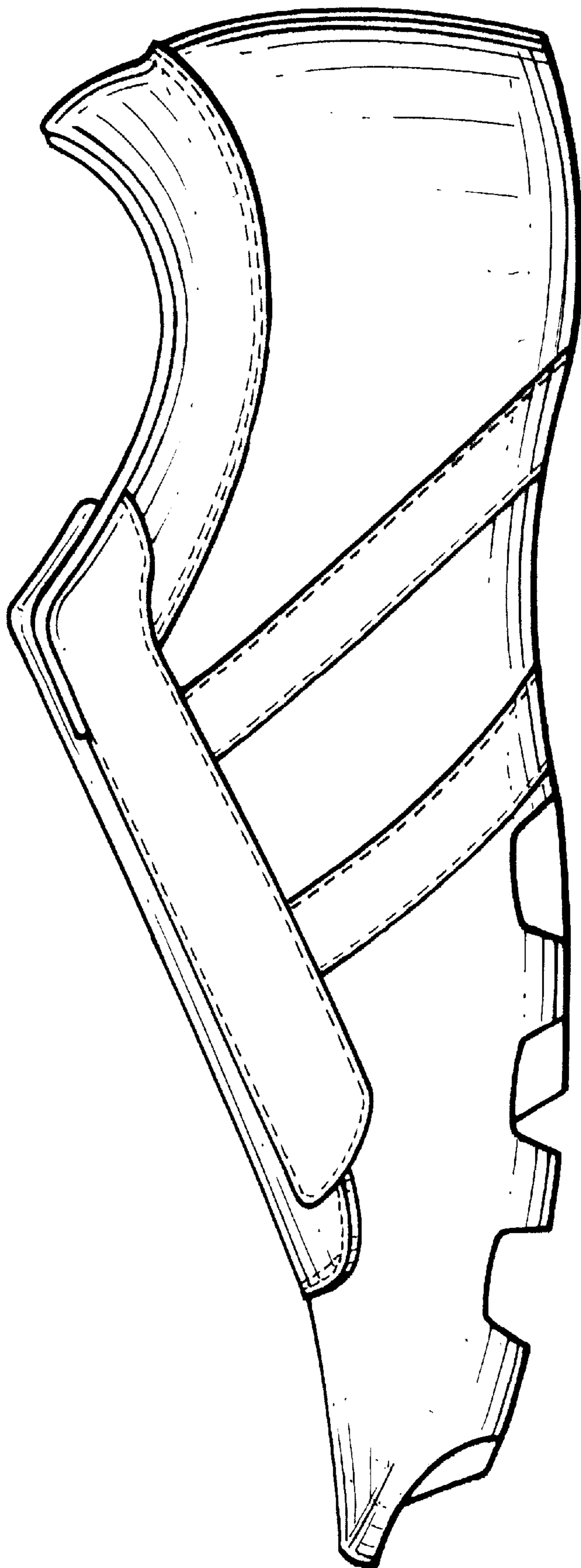

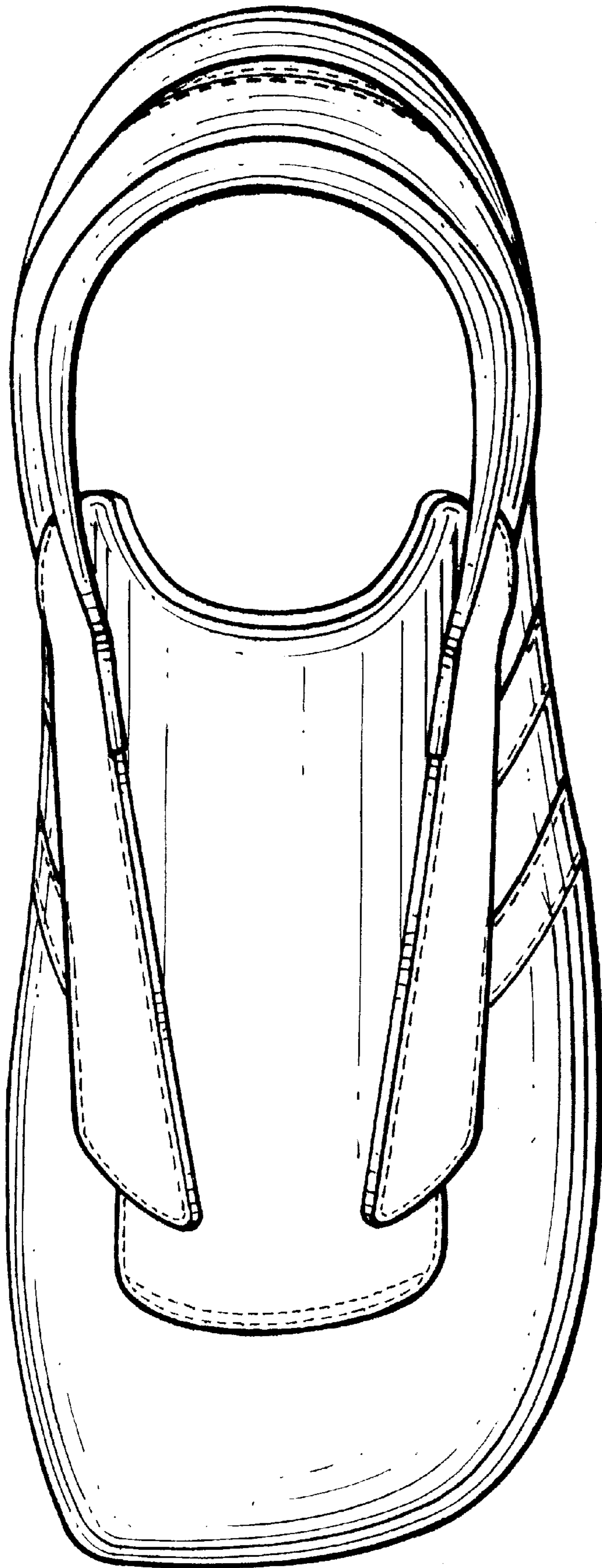

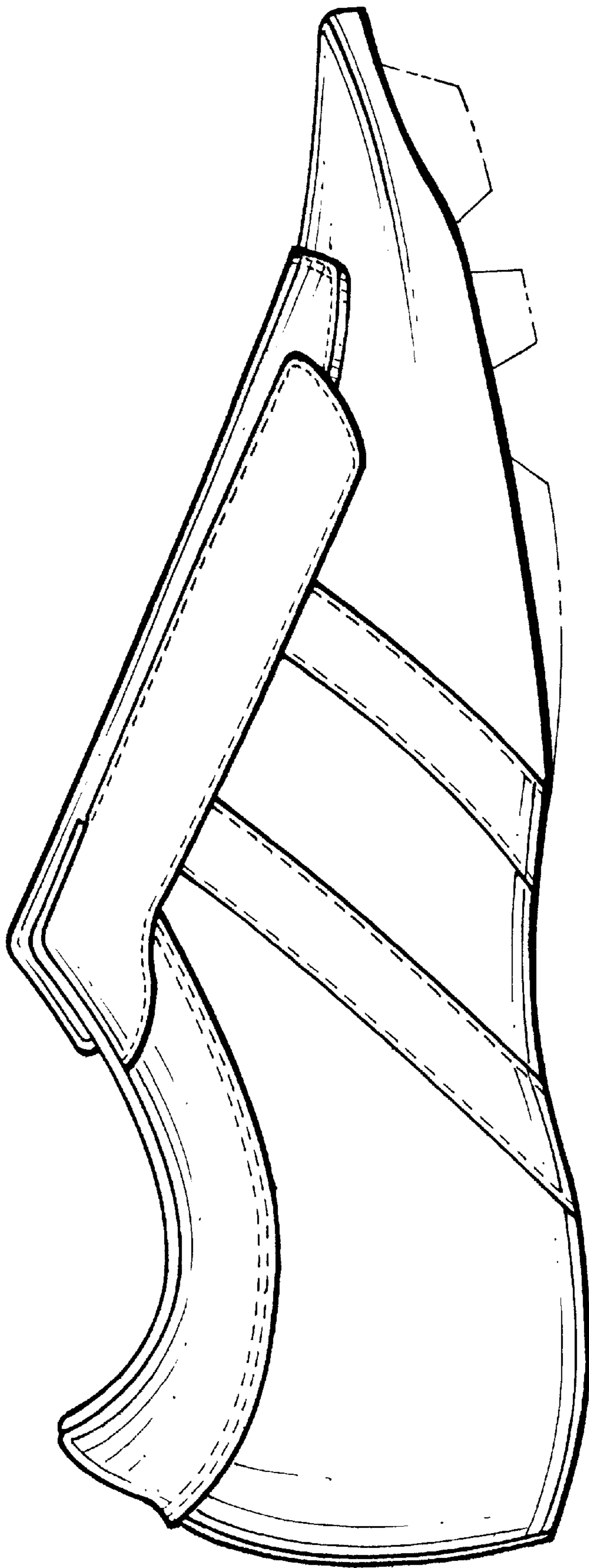

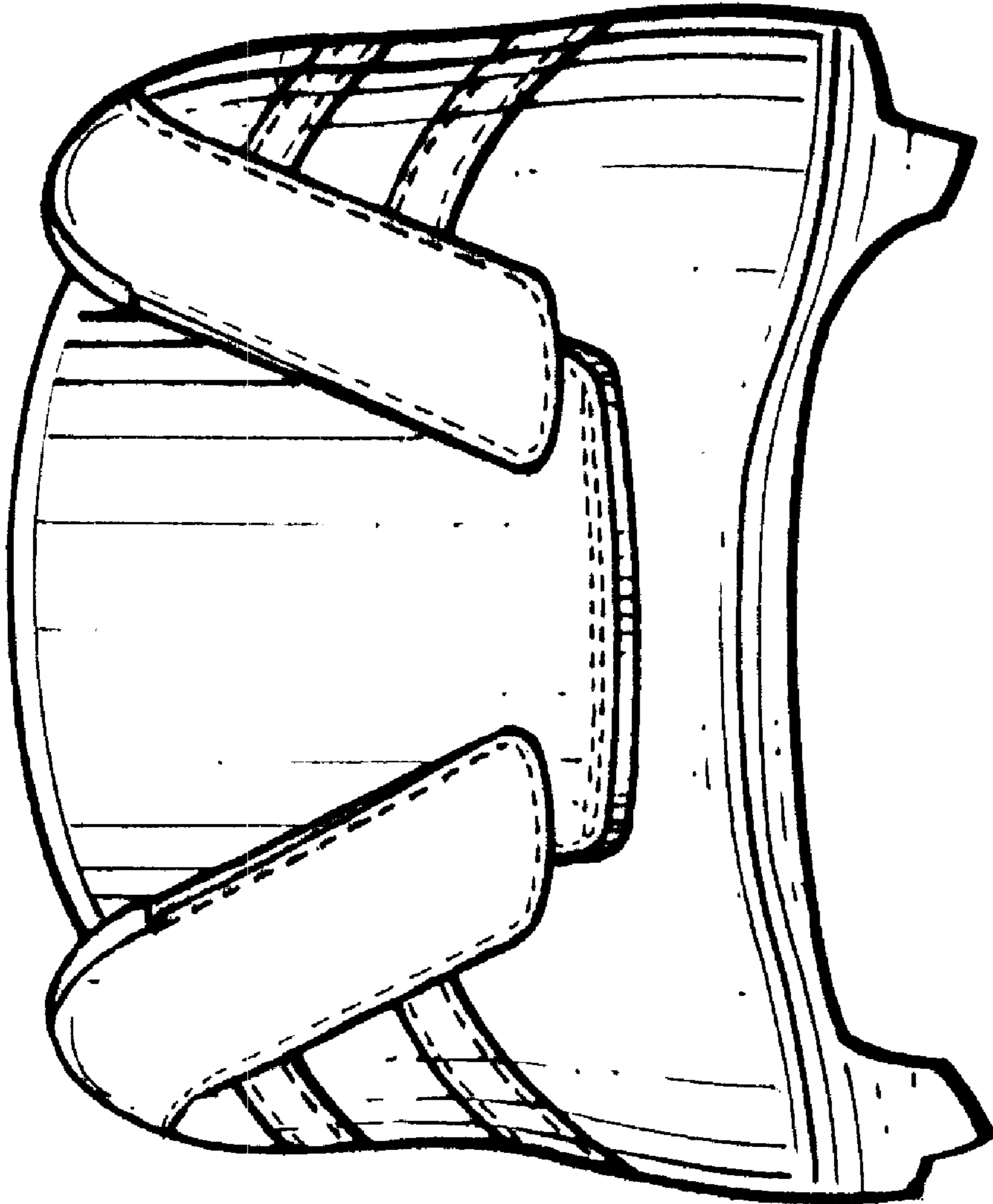

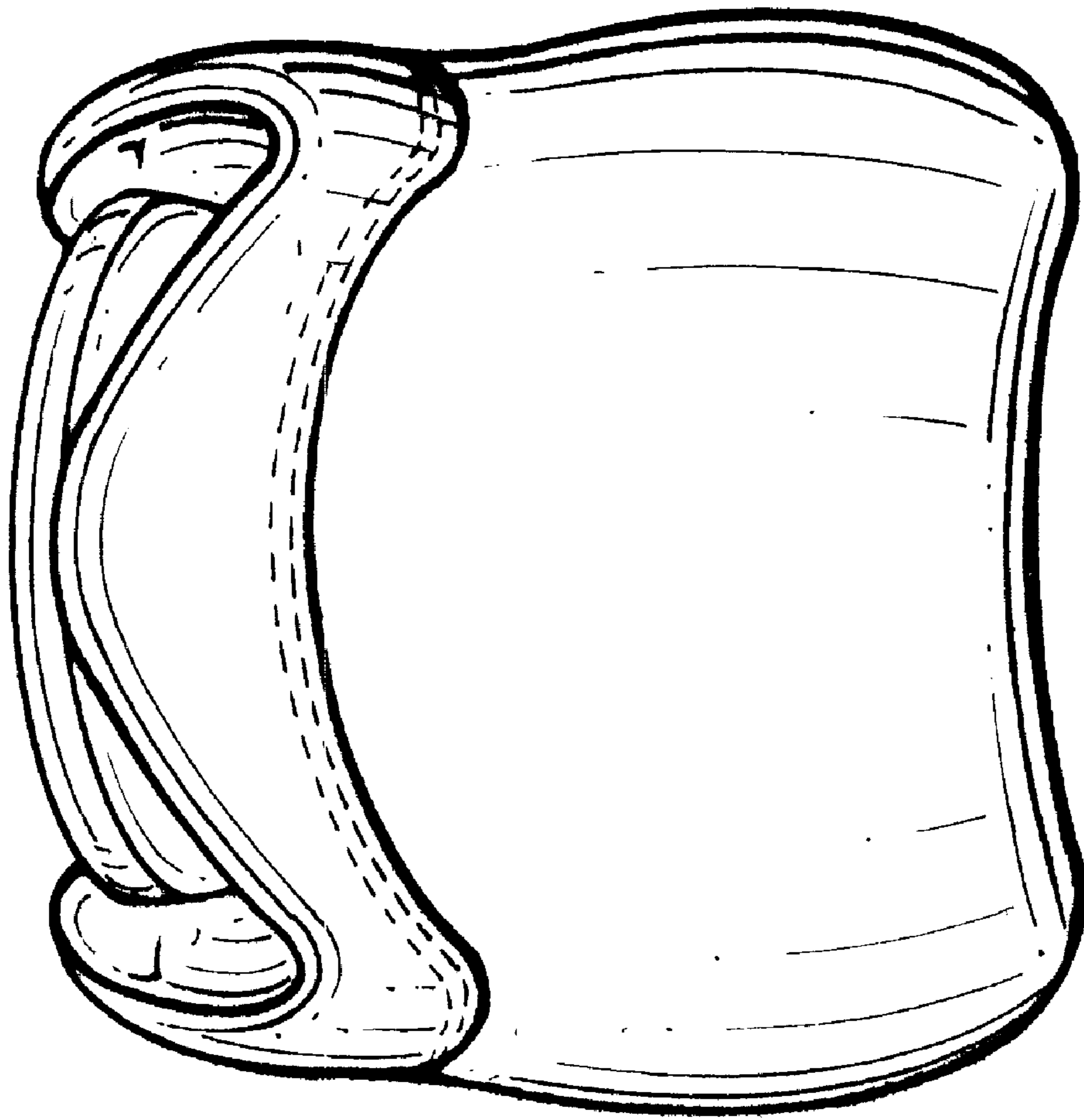
