## (57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a rechargeable batterypowered livestock prod, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the rechargeable battery-powered livestock prod, embodying the design of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,











