(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foot portion of a table leg, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a foot portion of a table leg of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view from the left side of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged perspective view from the right side of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 2;

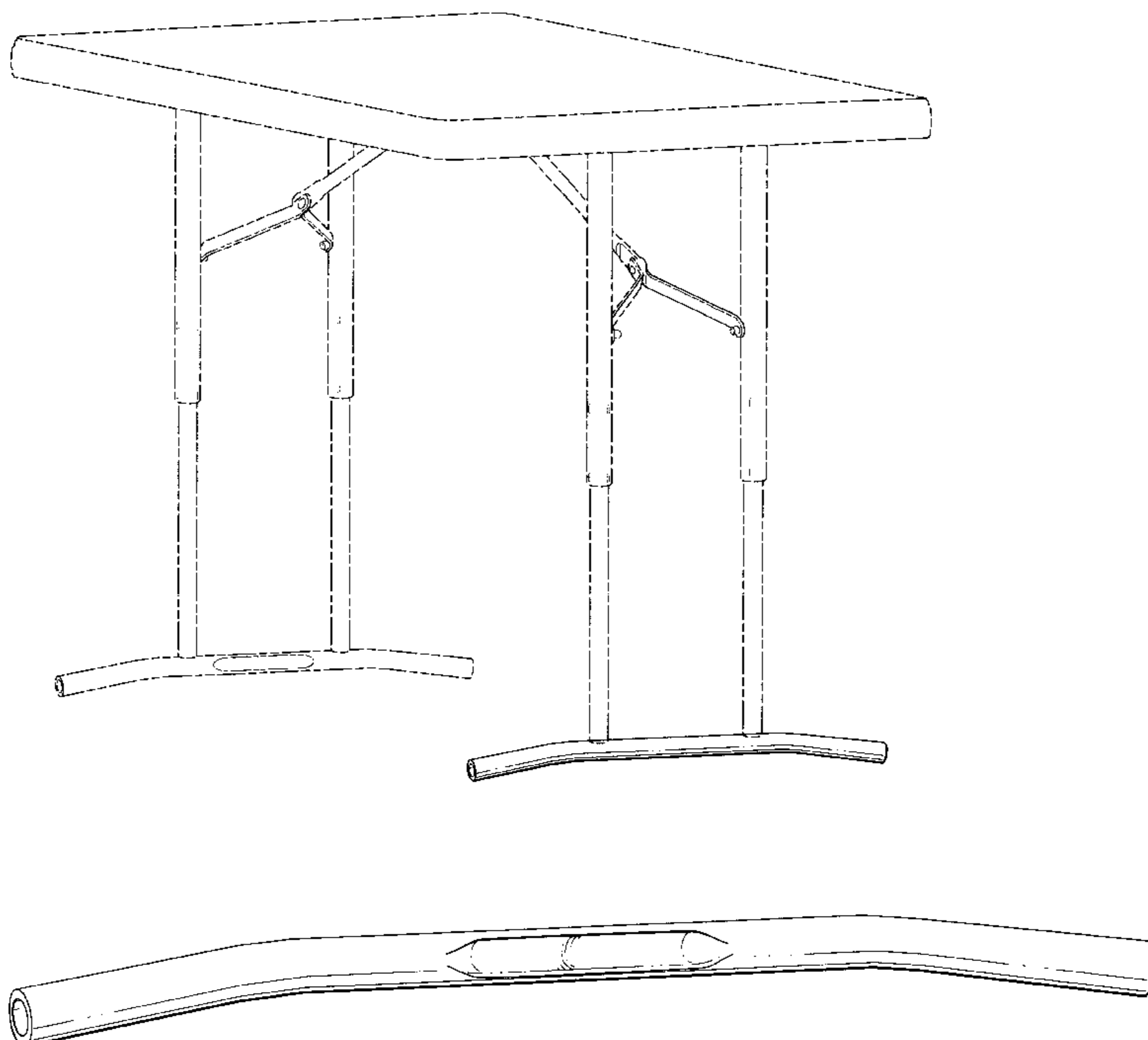
FIG. 5 is right side view of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a left side view of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the foot portion of the table leg shown in FIG. 2.

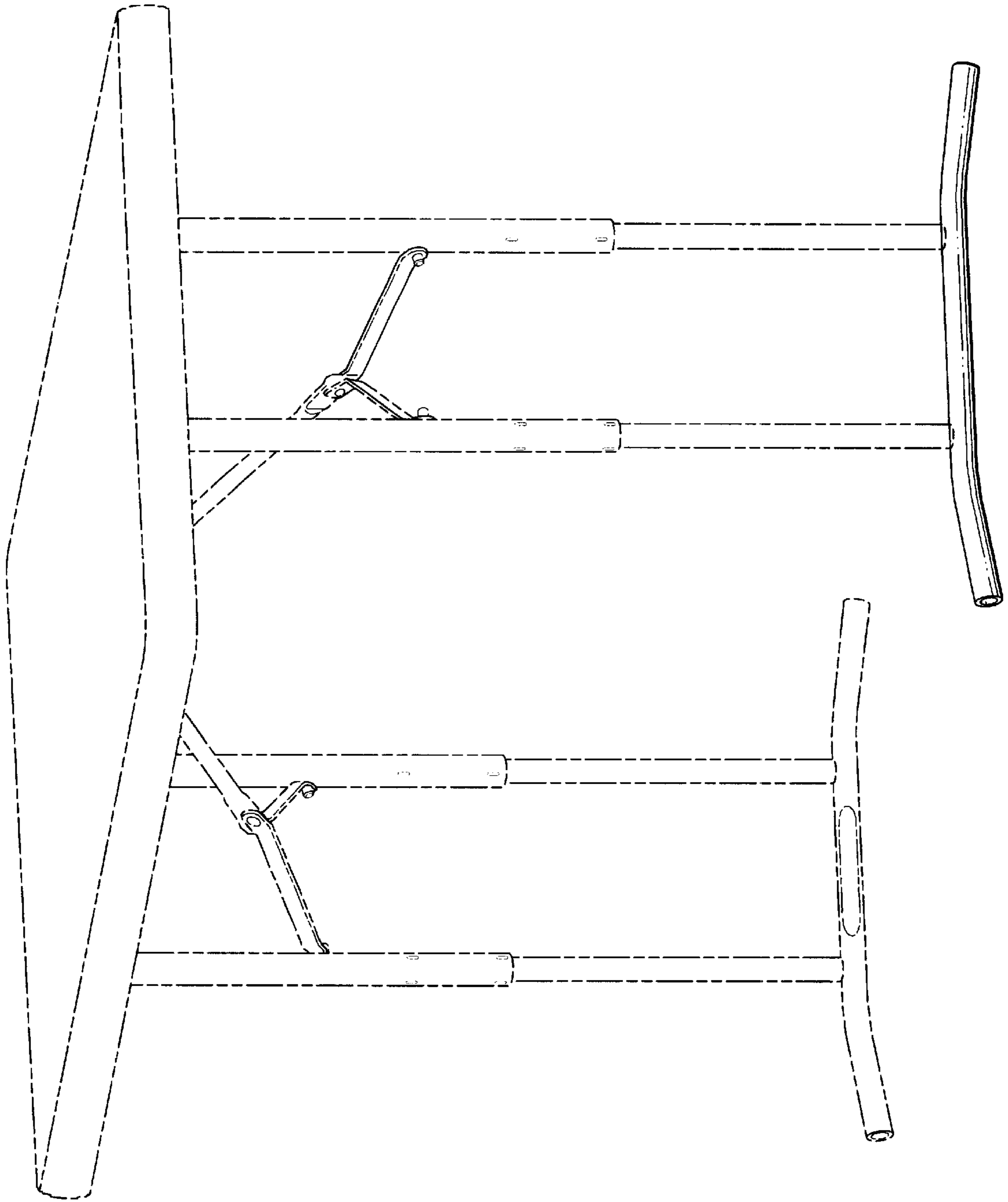

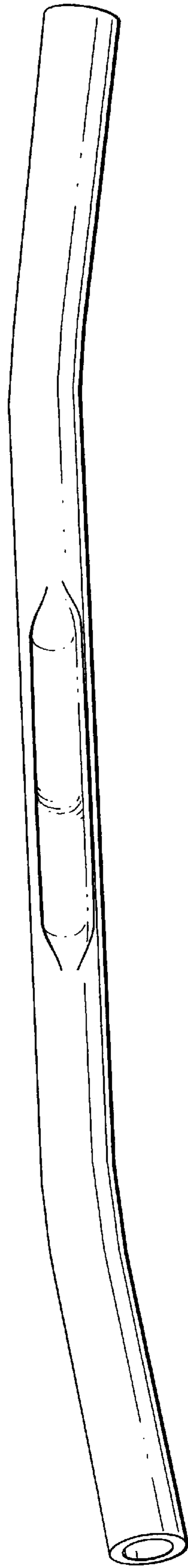

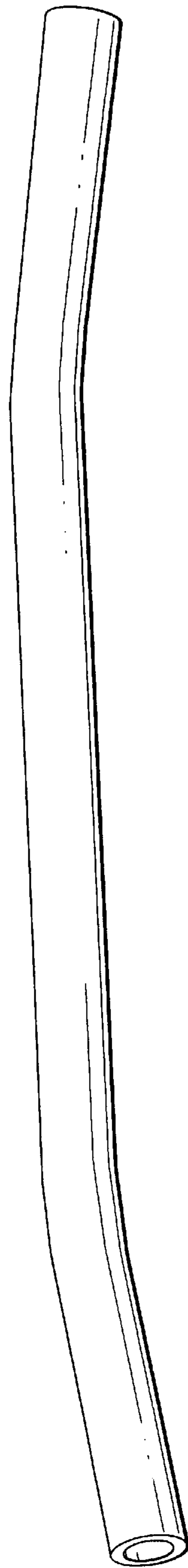

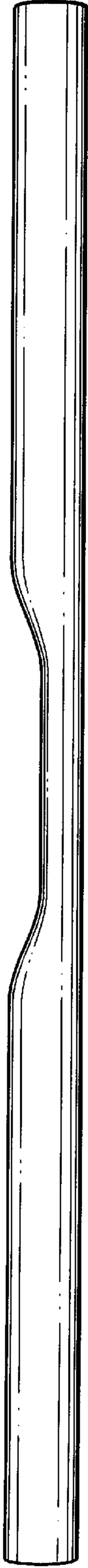

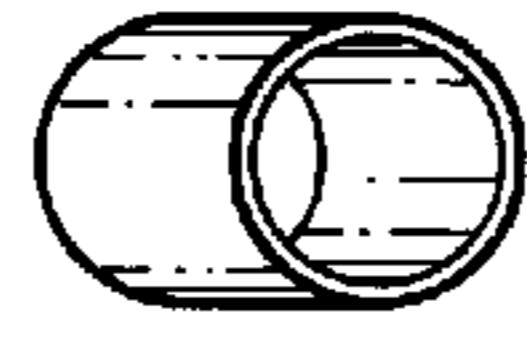

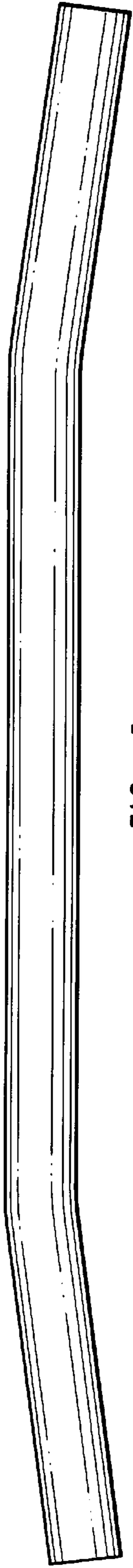

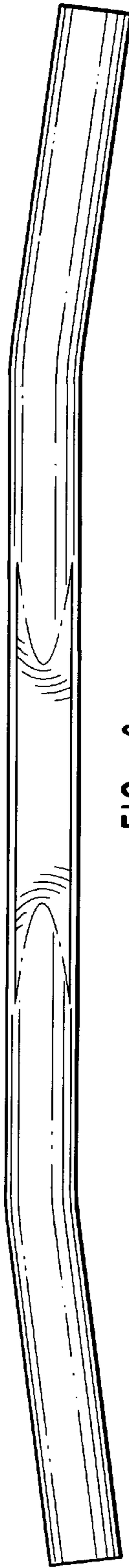
