The ornamental design for a radar detector, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a radar detector.  
FIG. 2 is a top view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 3 is a bottom side view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 4 is a first side view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 5 is a second side view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 6 is a front view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 7 is a rear view of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the radar detector shown in FIG. 1.  
FIG. 9 is a top view of the radar detector of FIG. 8.

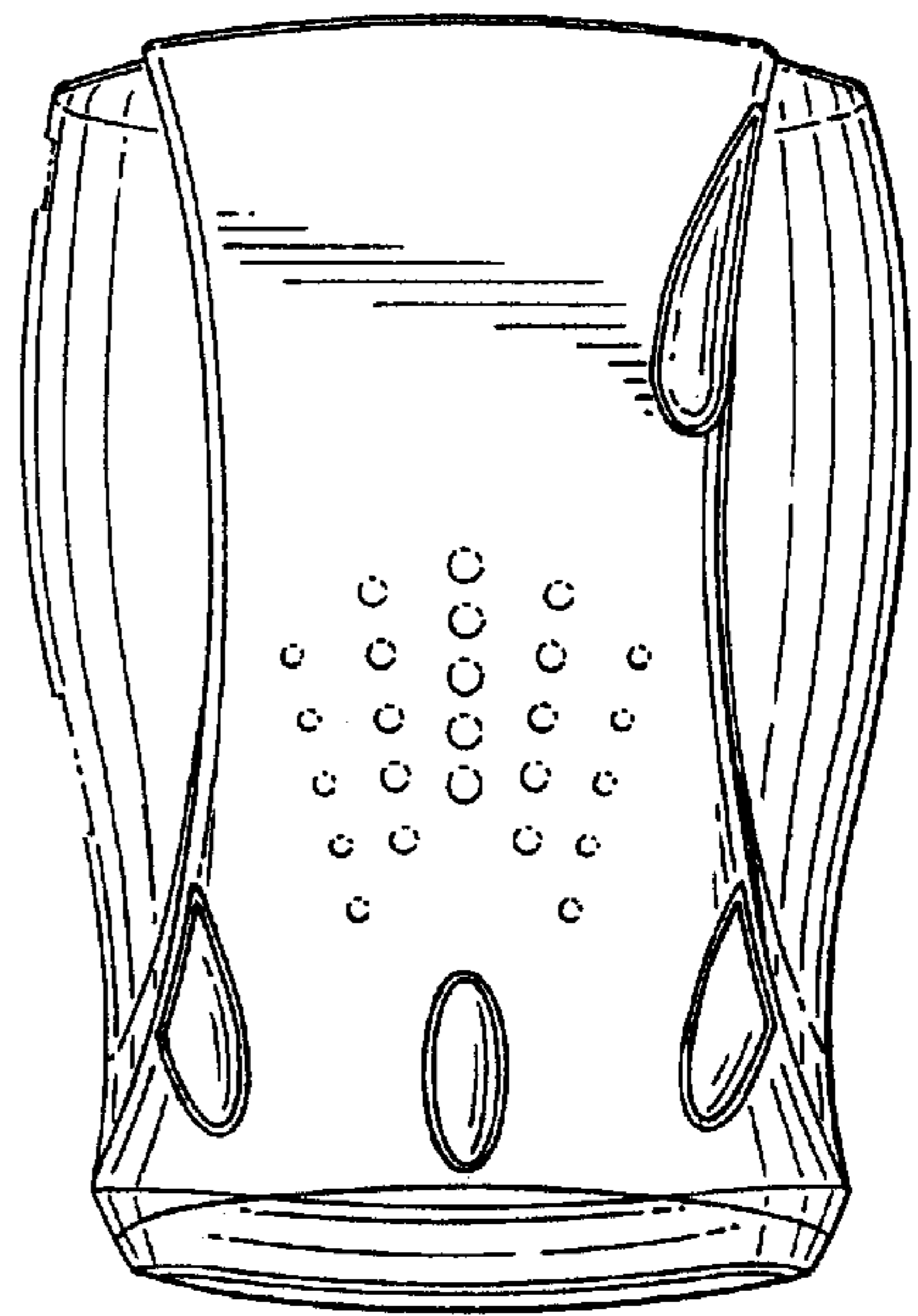


FIG. 10 FIG. 11

FIG. 10 is a first side view of the radar detector of FIG. 8.  
FIG. 11 is a second side view of the radar detector of FIG. 8; and,  
FIG. 12 is a top view of the radar detector of FIG. 8.

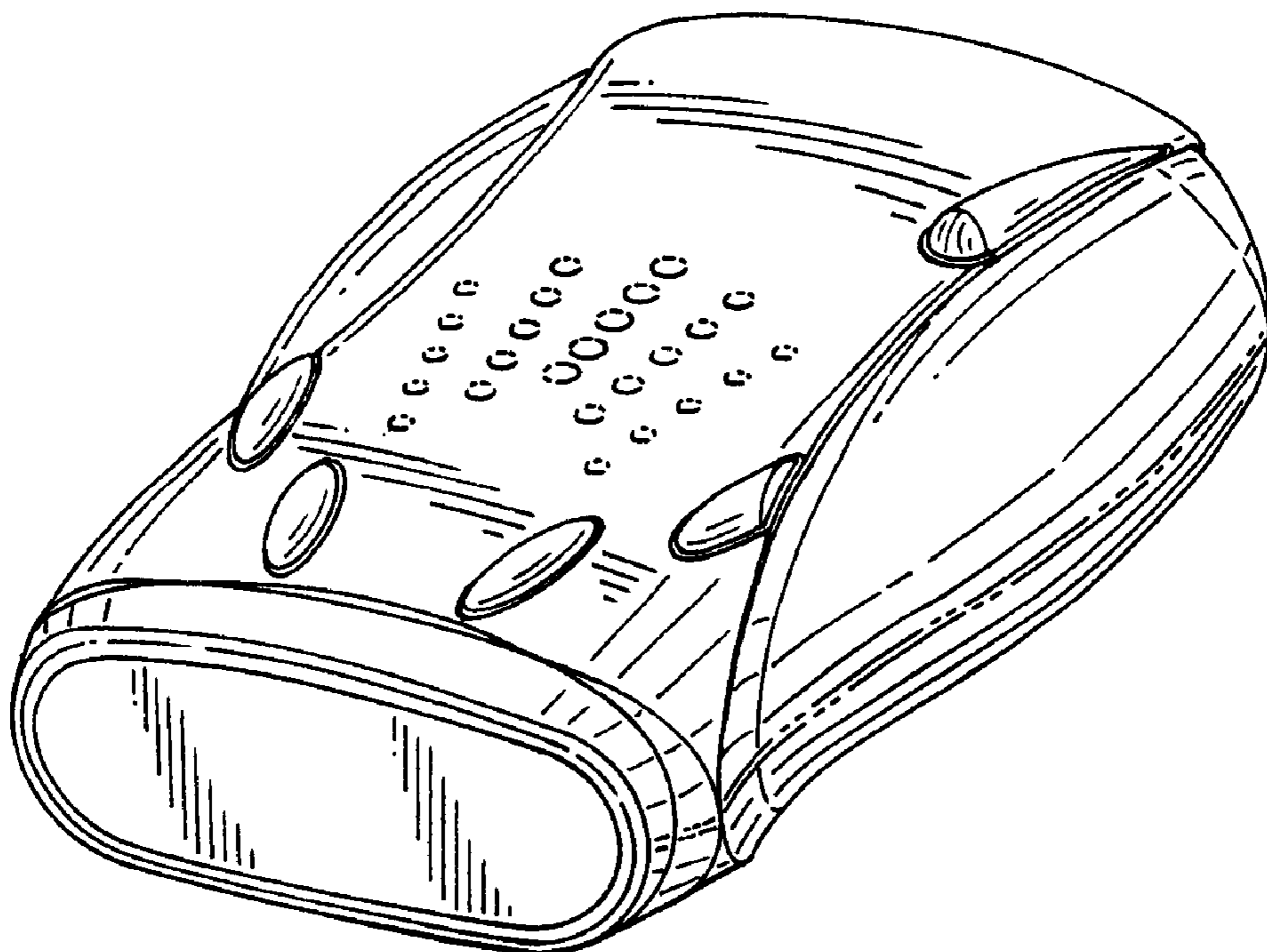

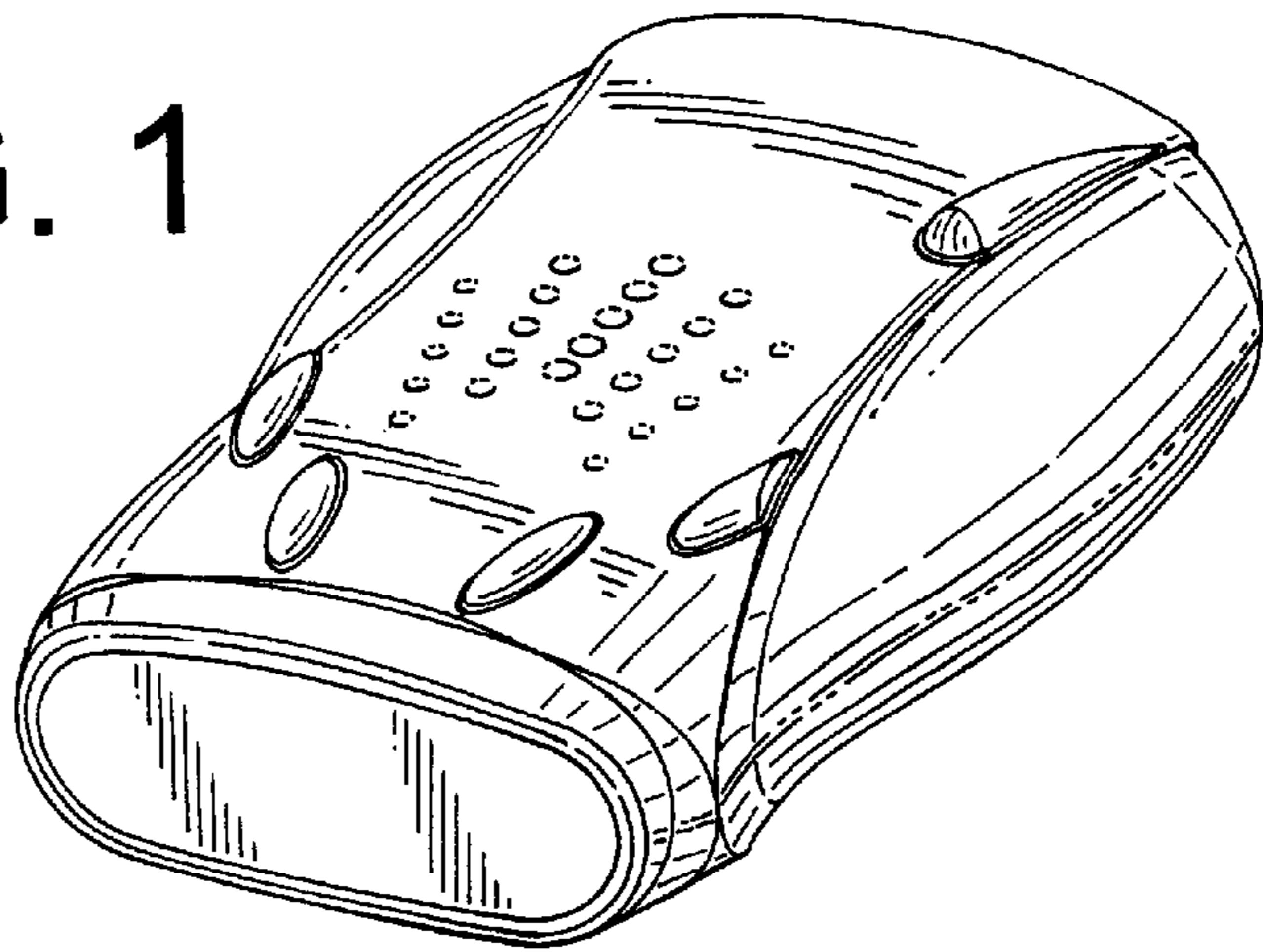

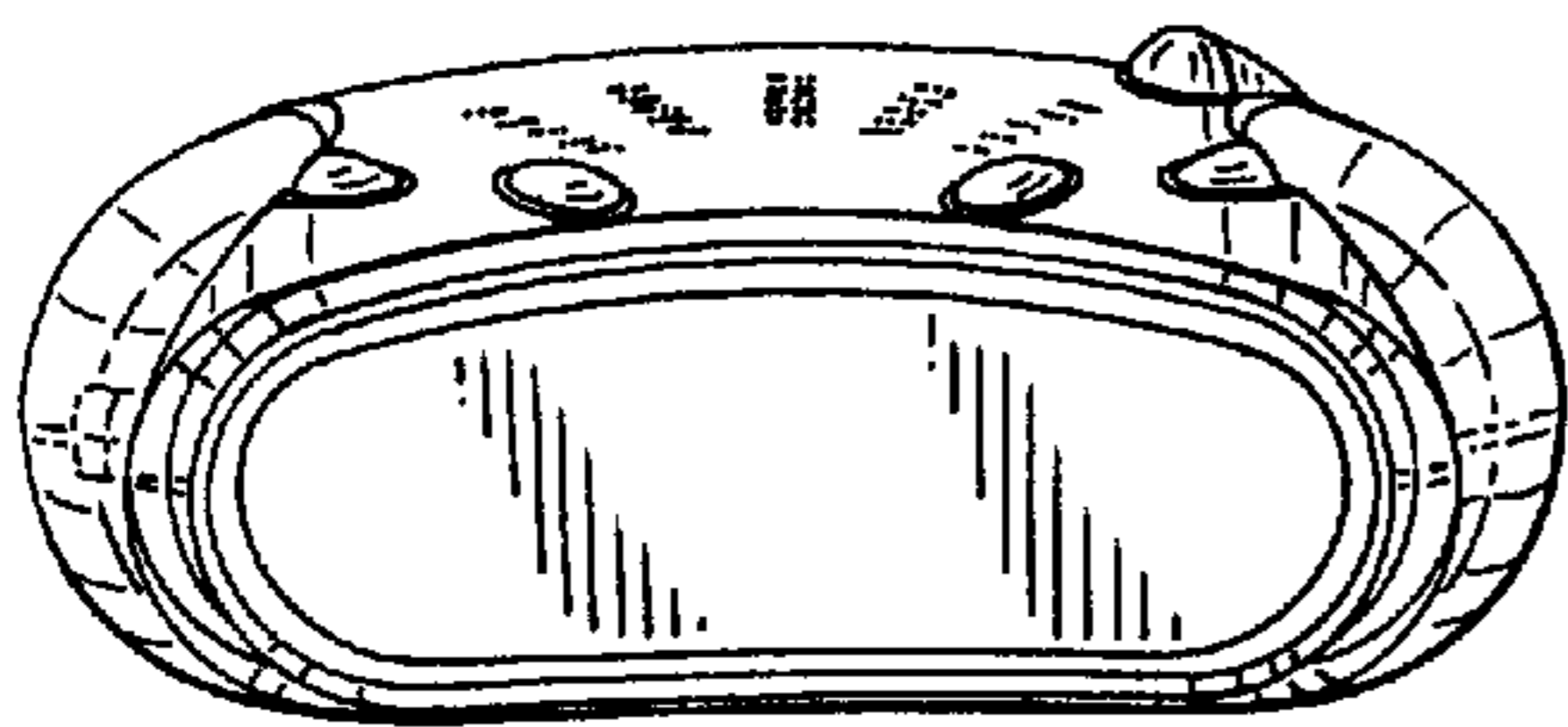

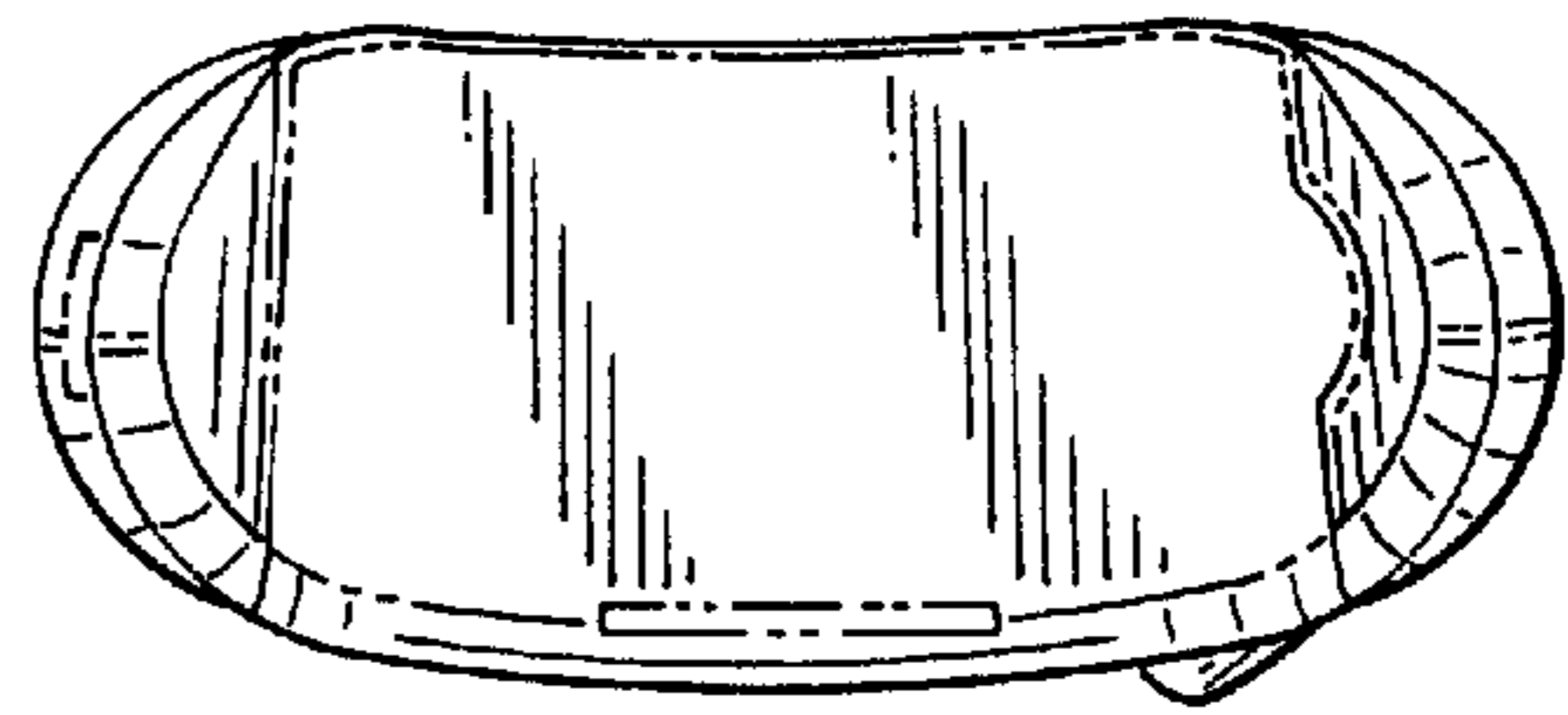

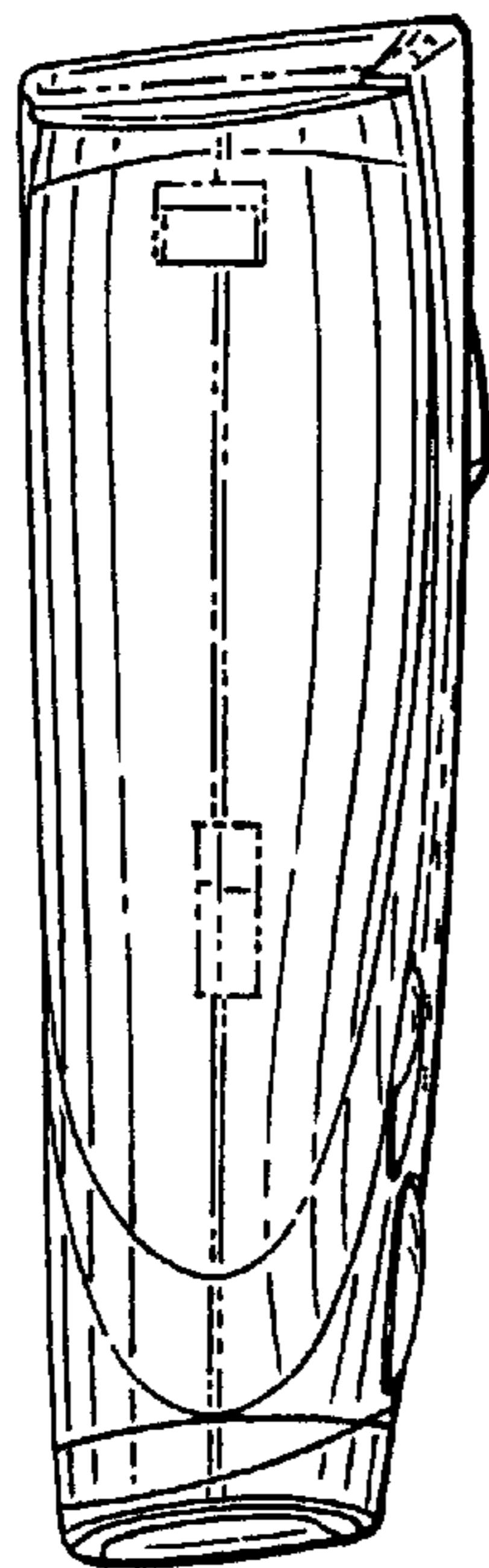

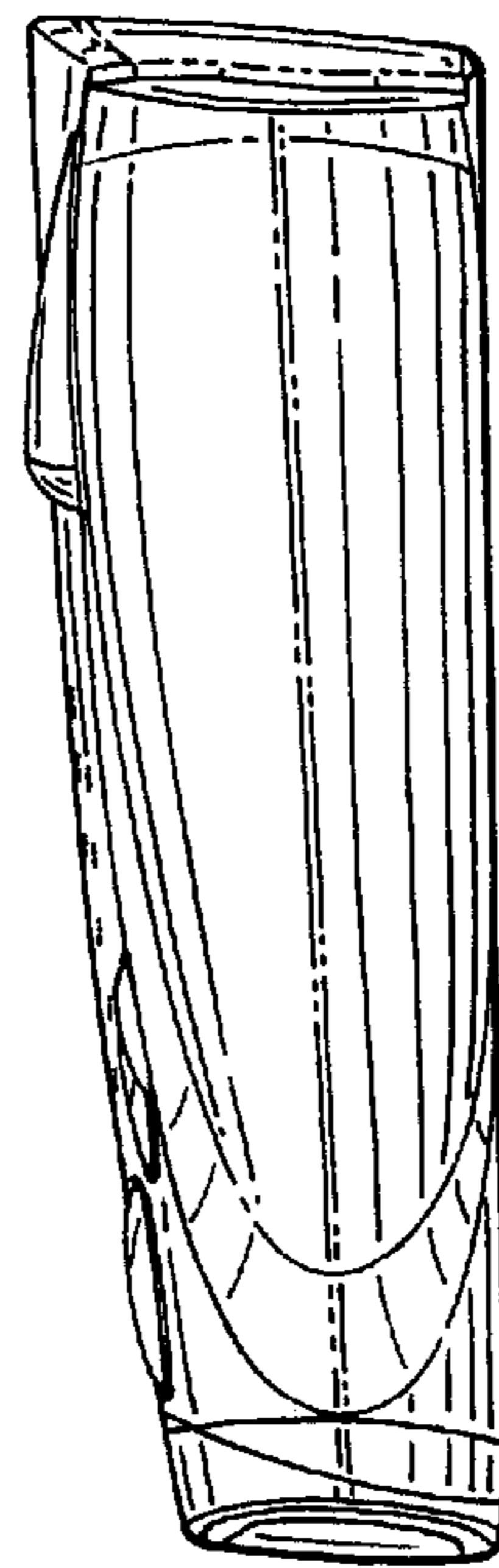

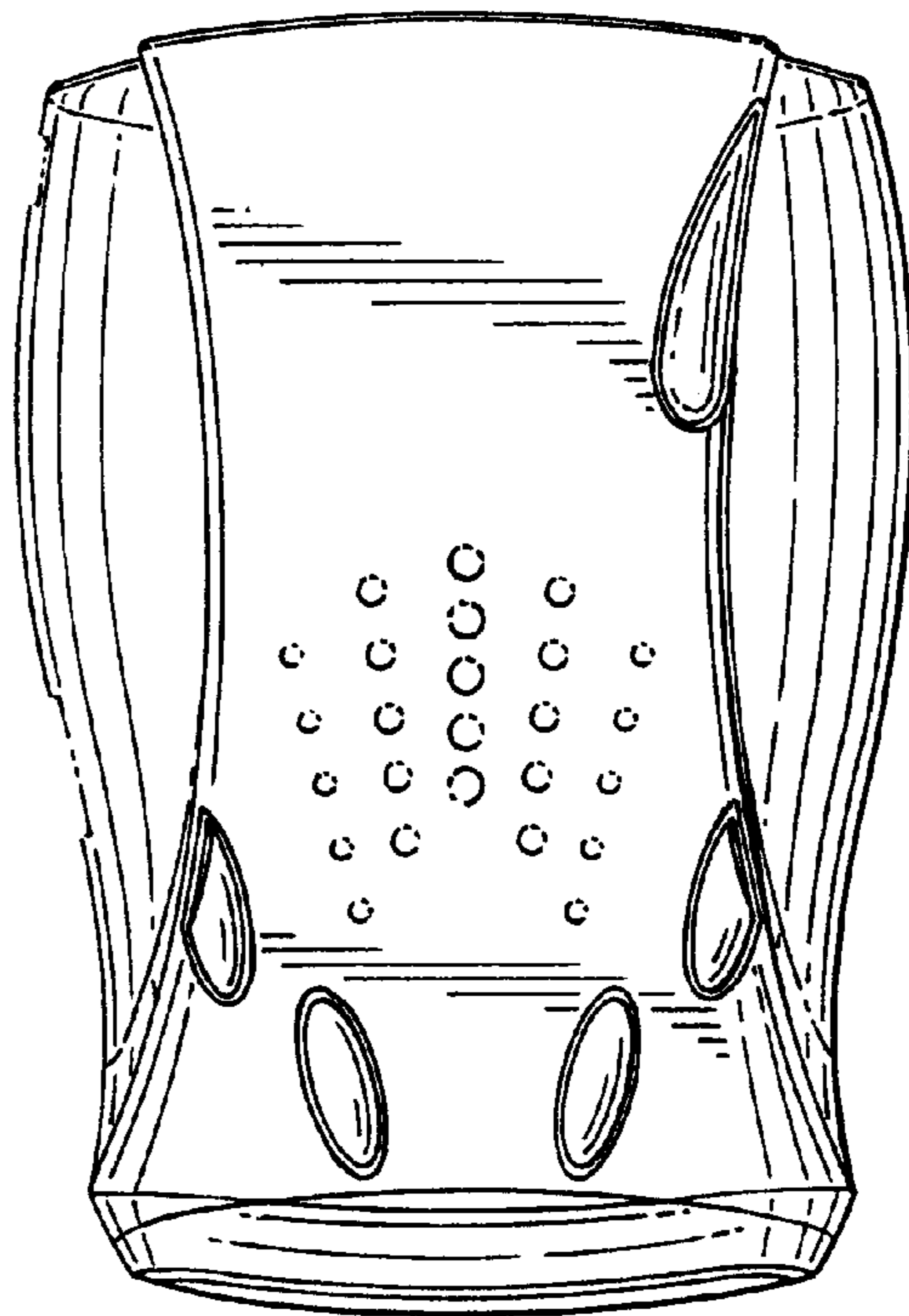

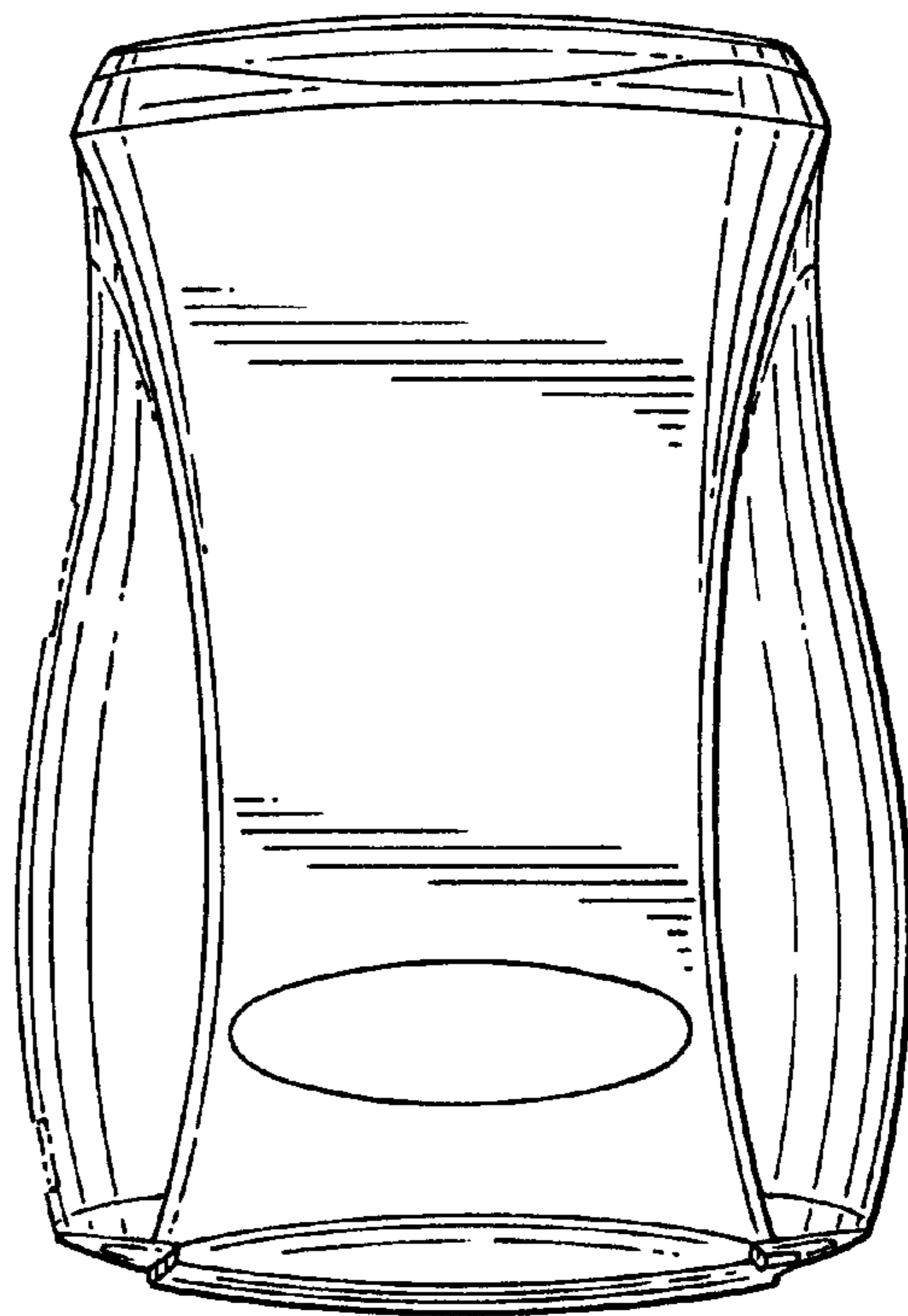

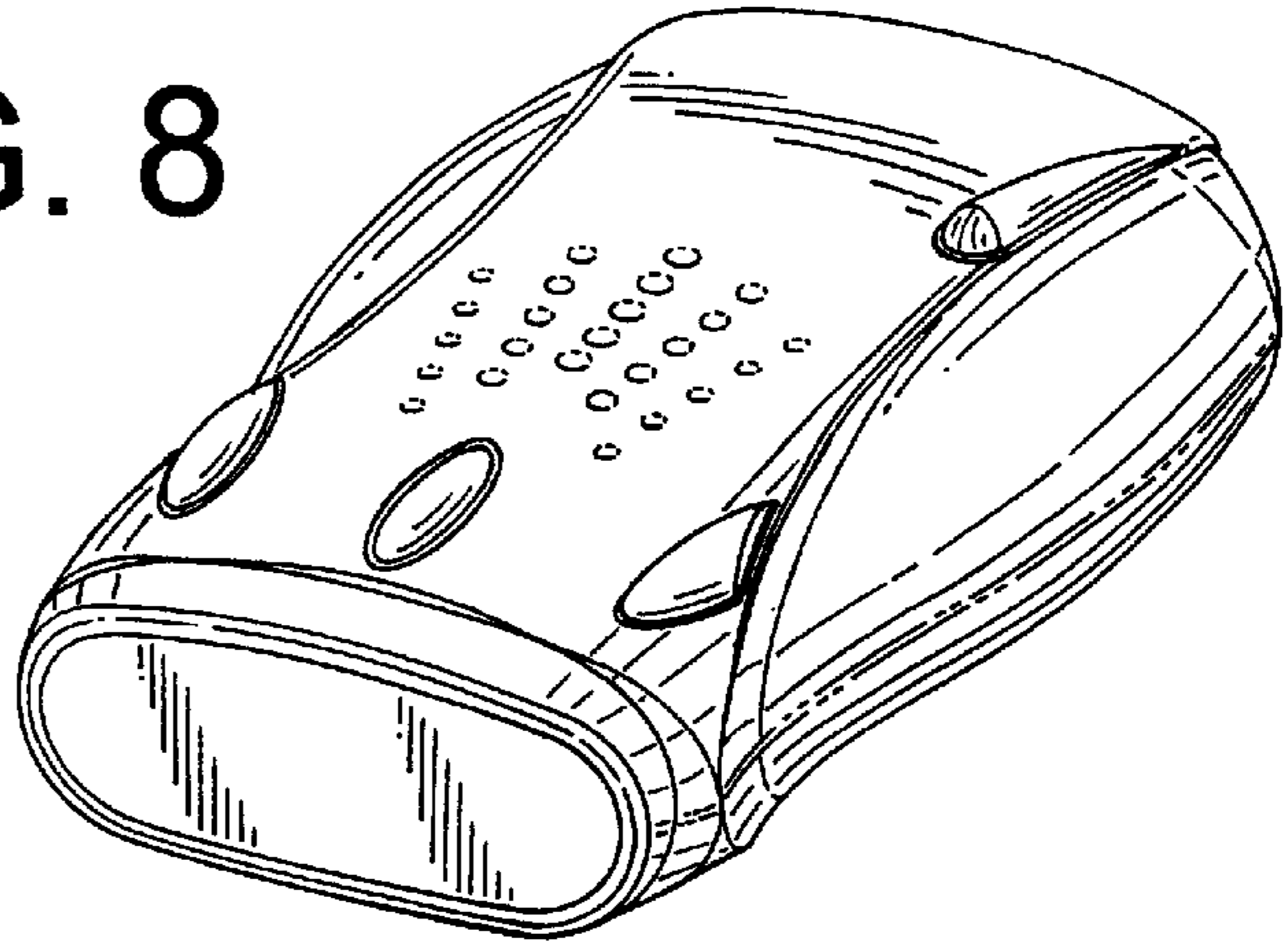

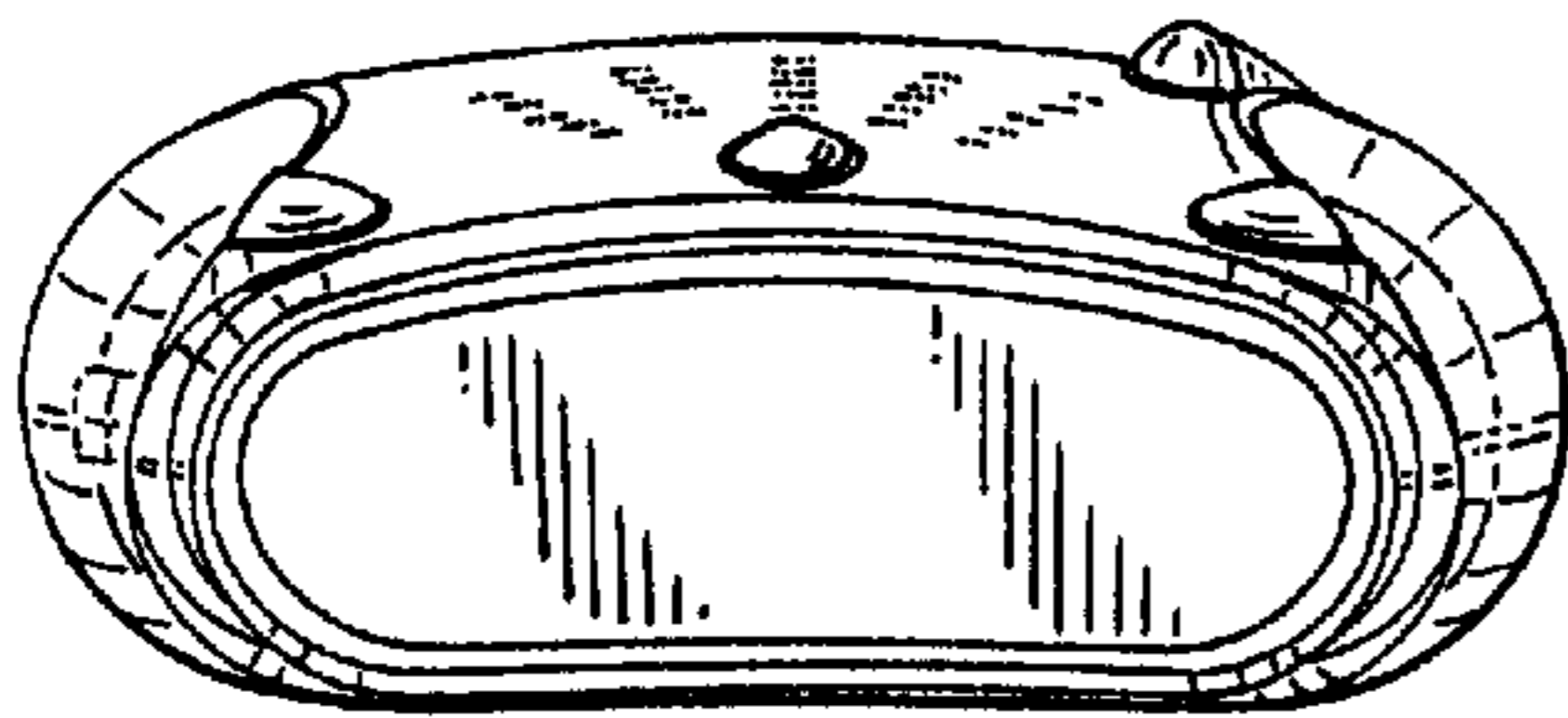
