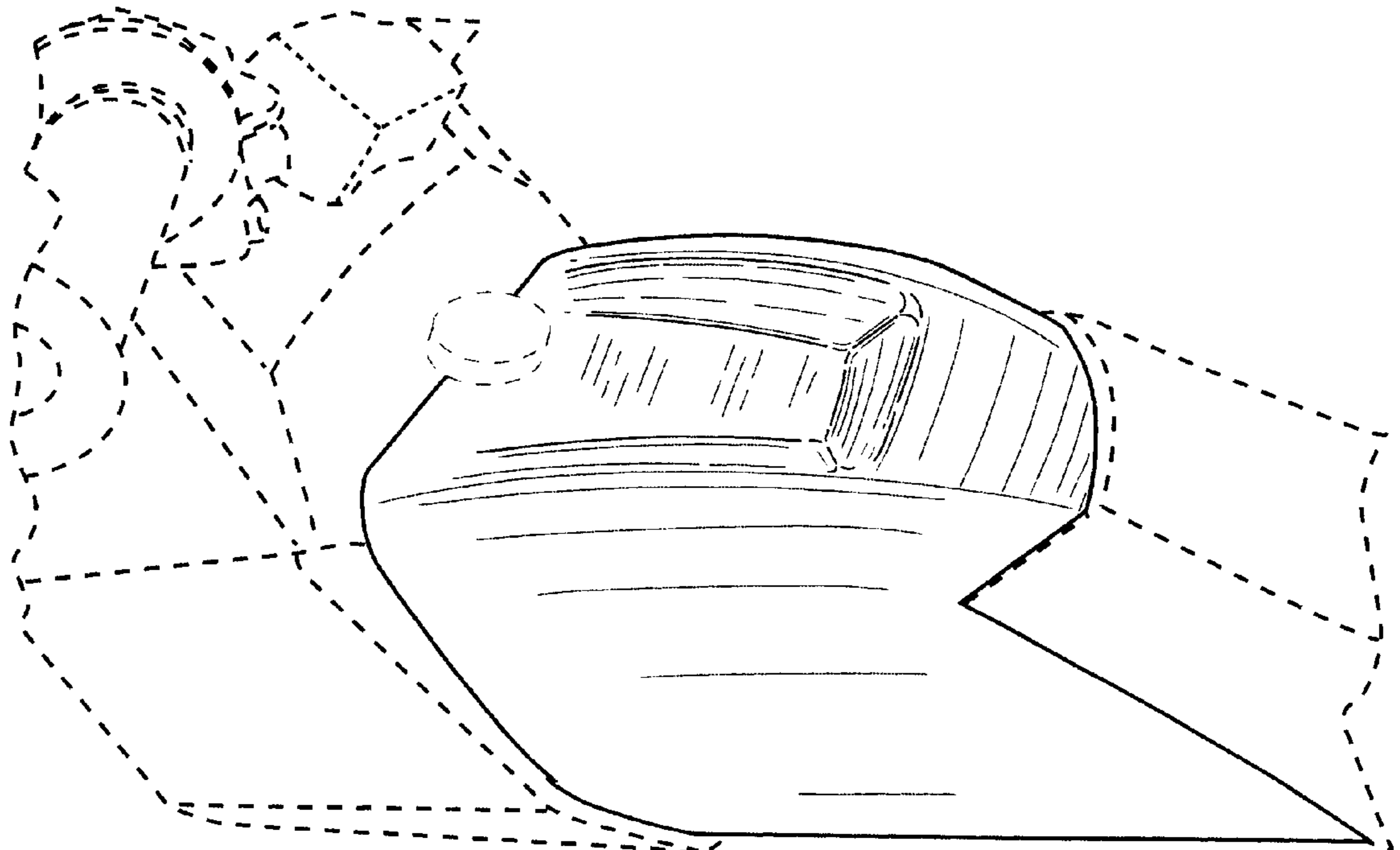
The ornamental design of an element of an all terrain vehicle, as shown and described.

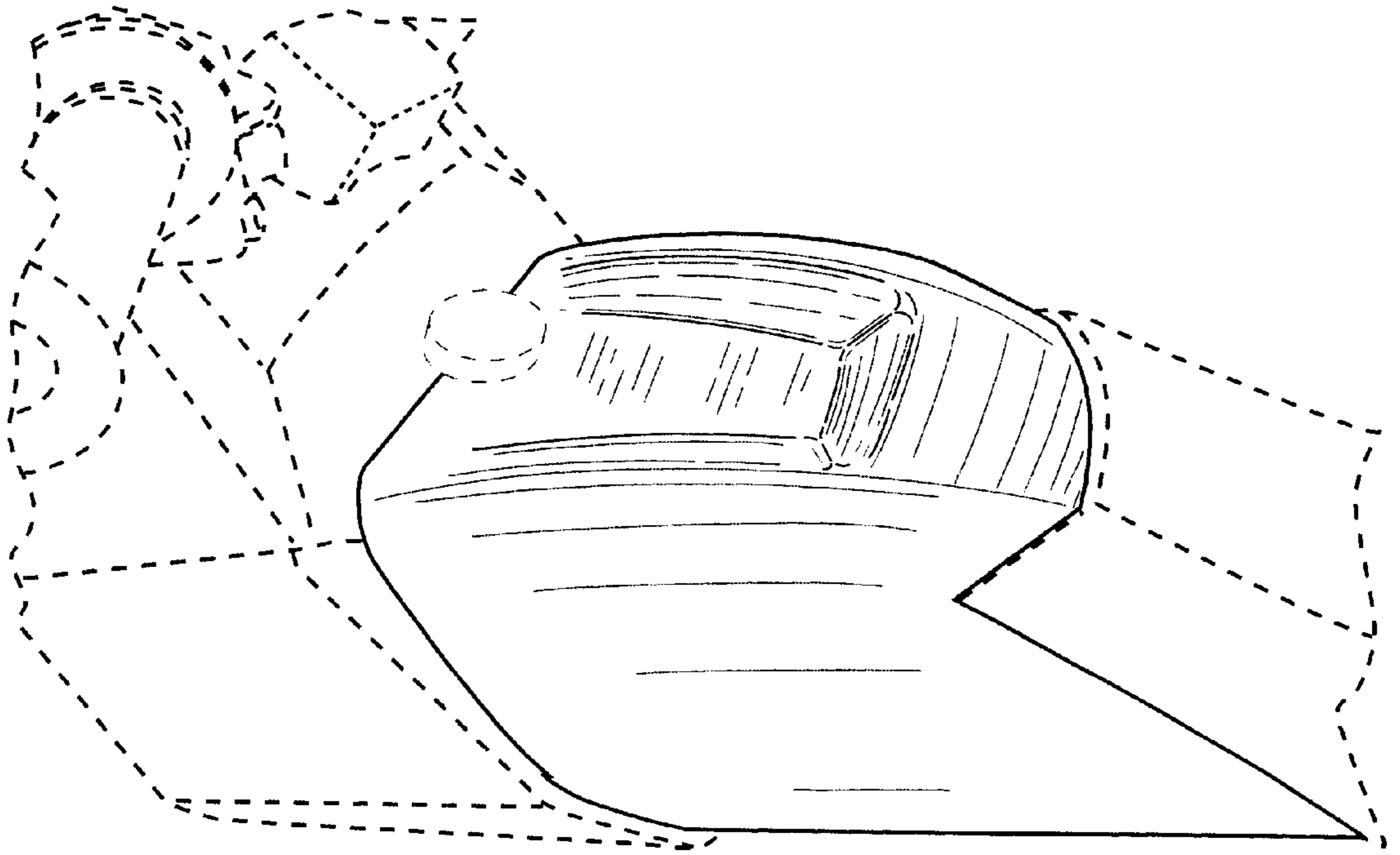

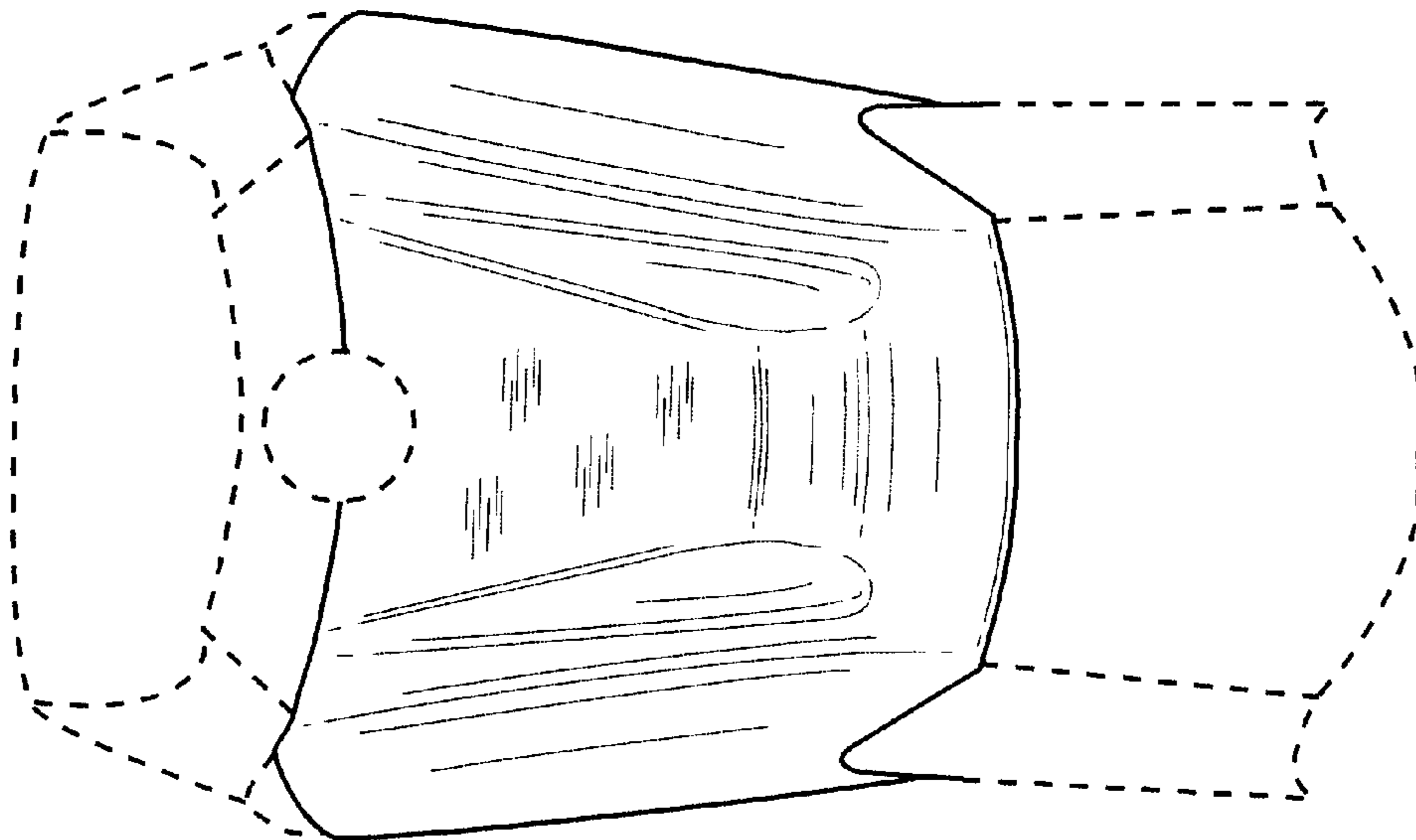
