FIG. 4 is a front view of the second embodiment;

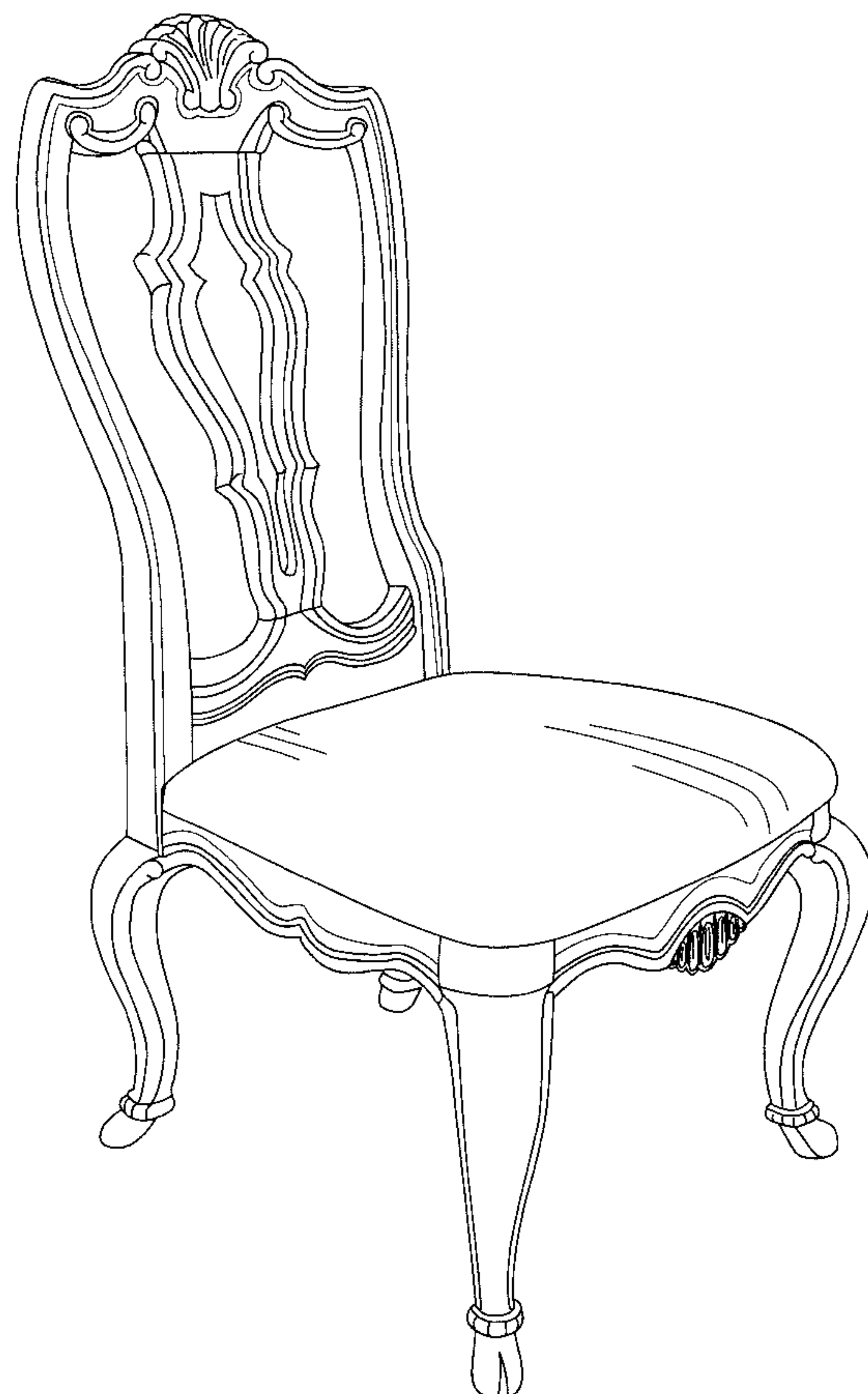
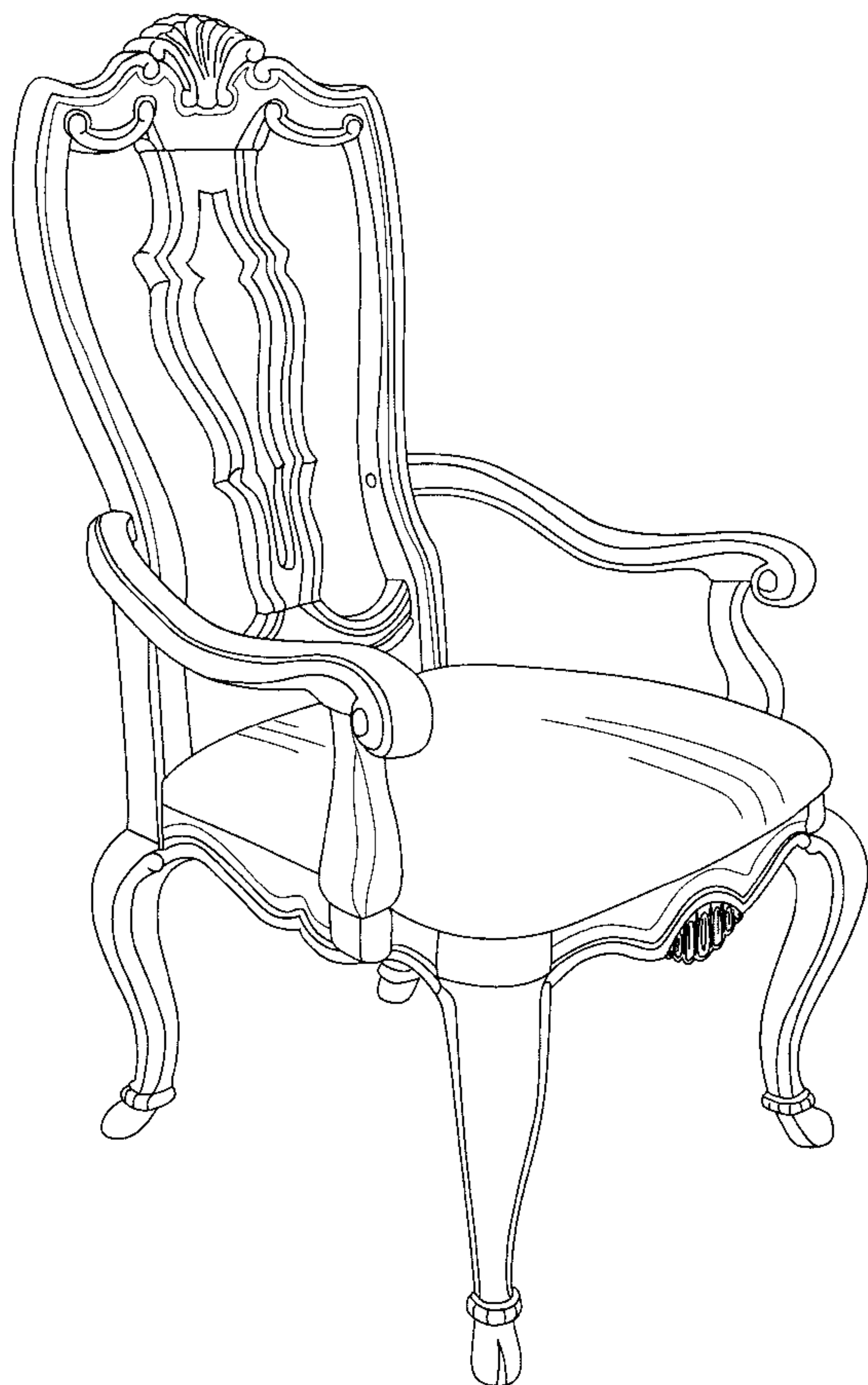
FIG. 5 is a side view of the first embodiment, the opposite side being a mirror image;

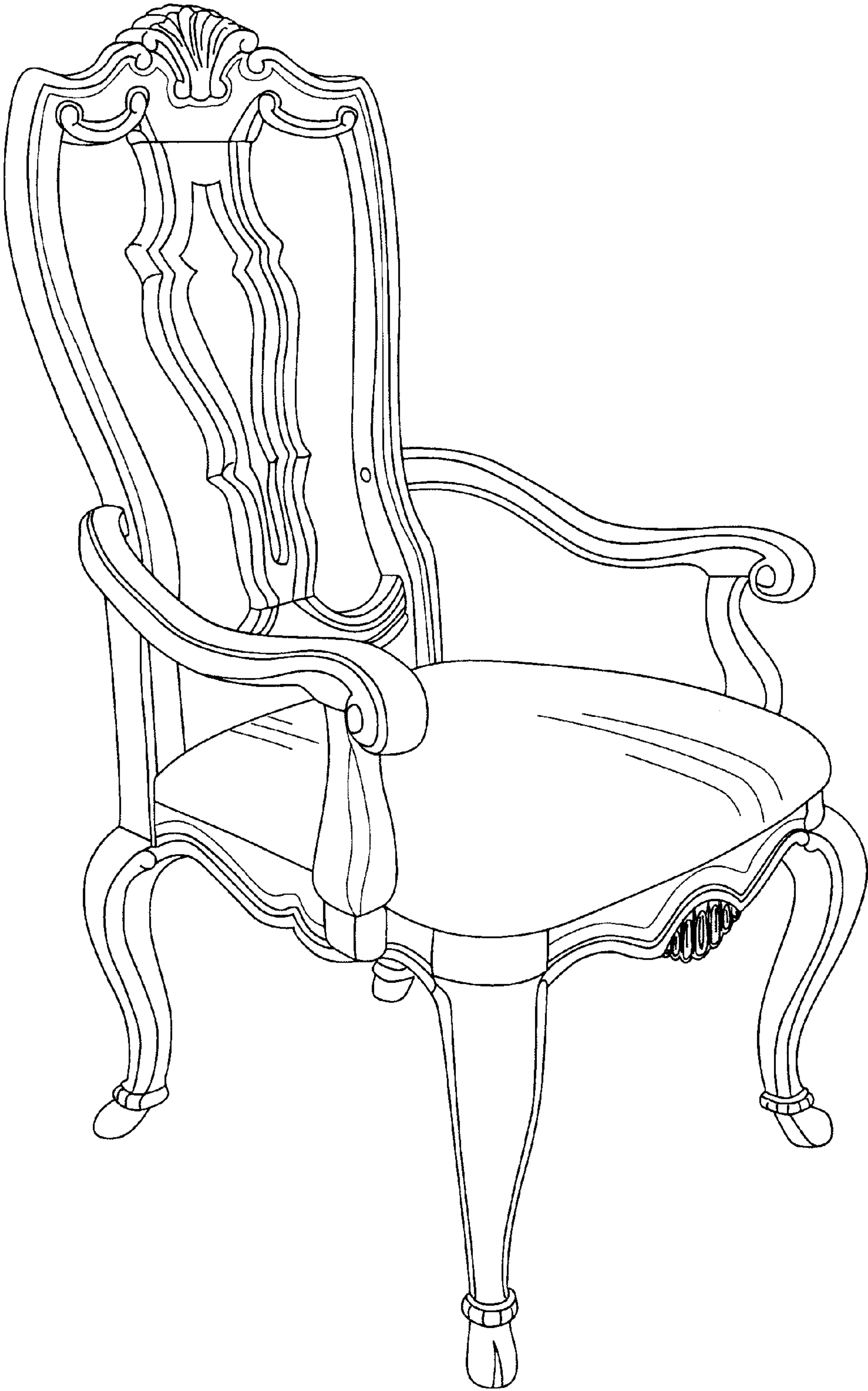

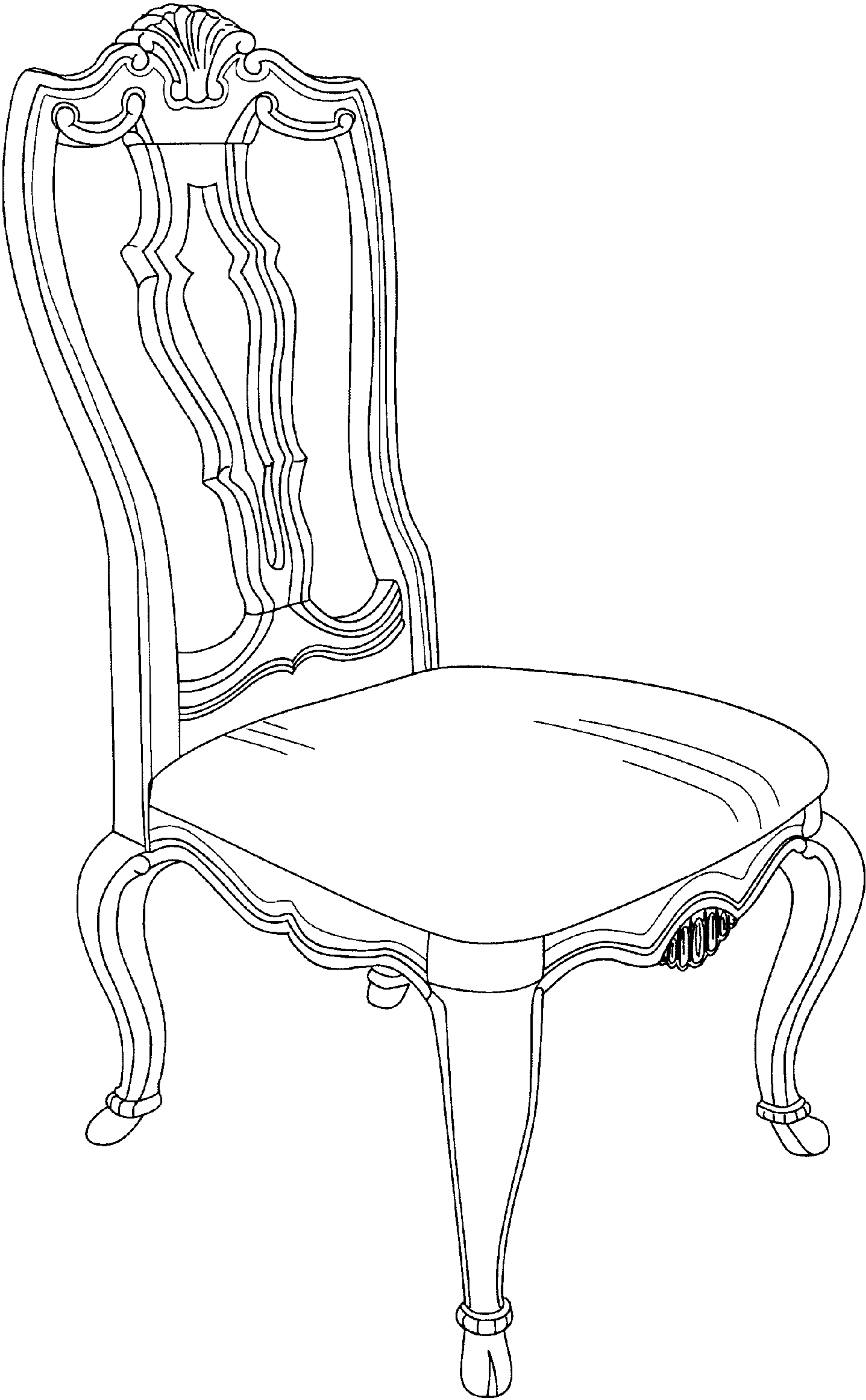

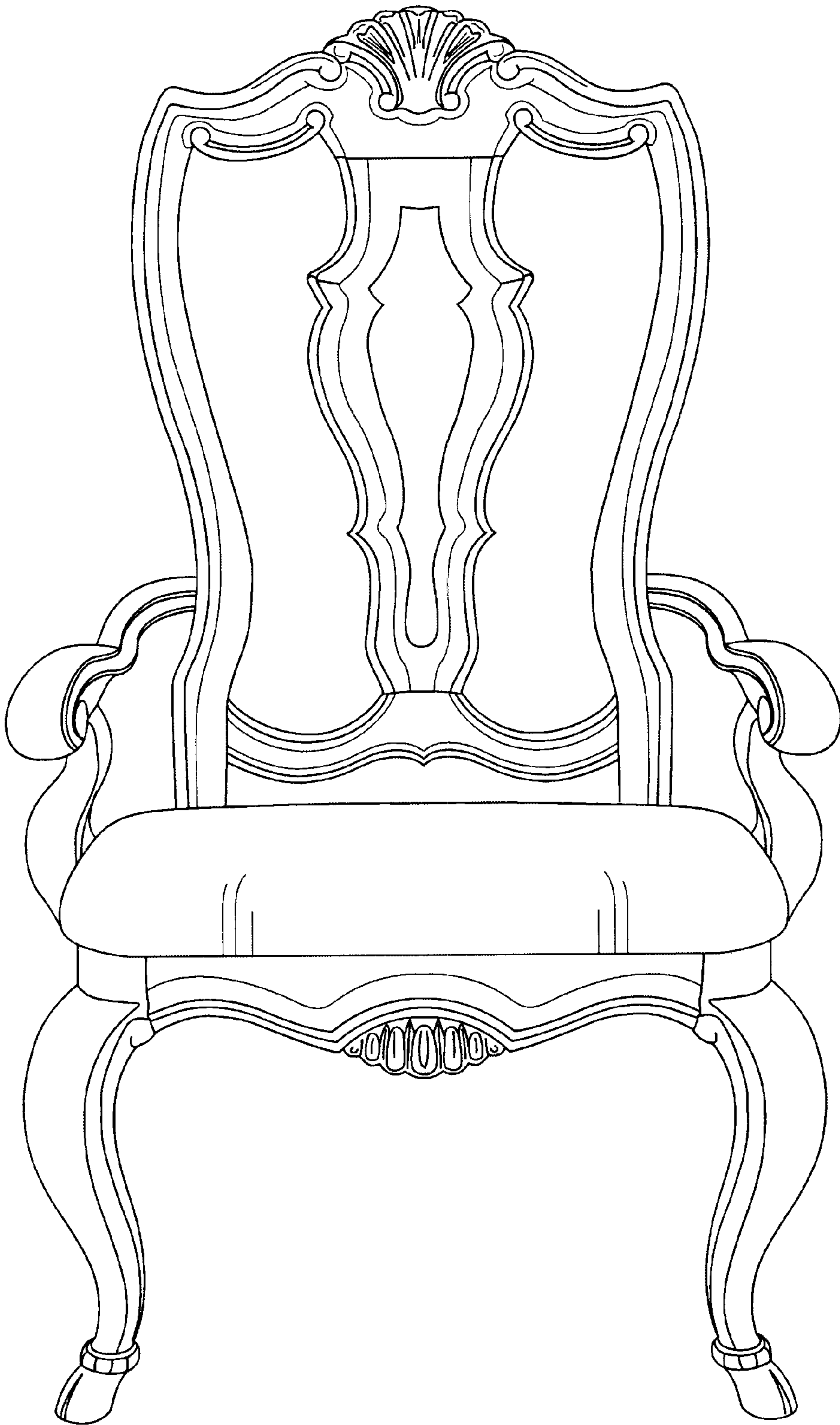

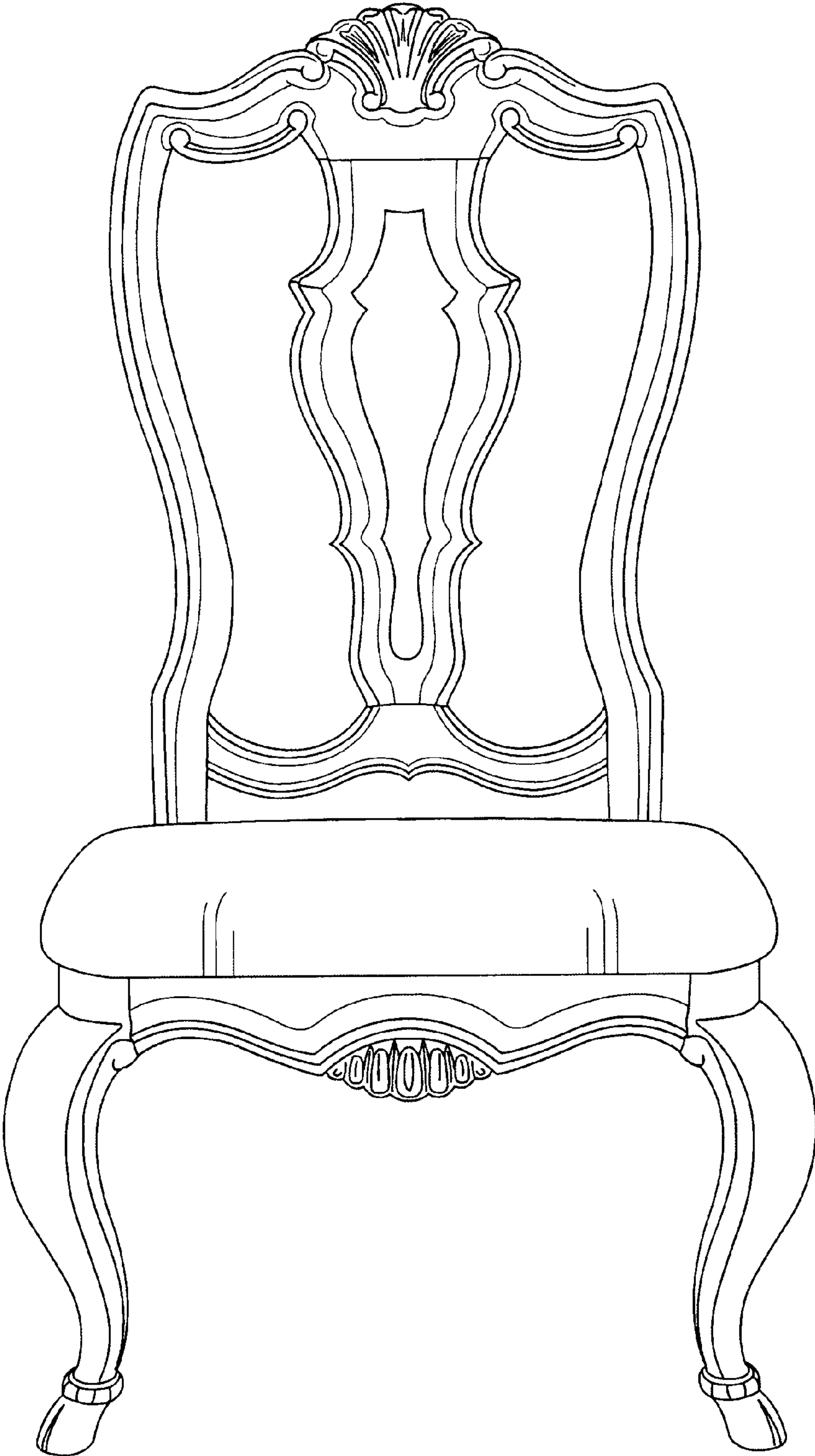

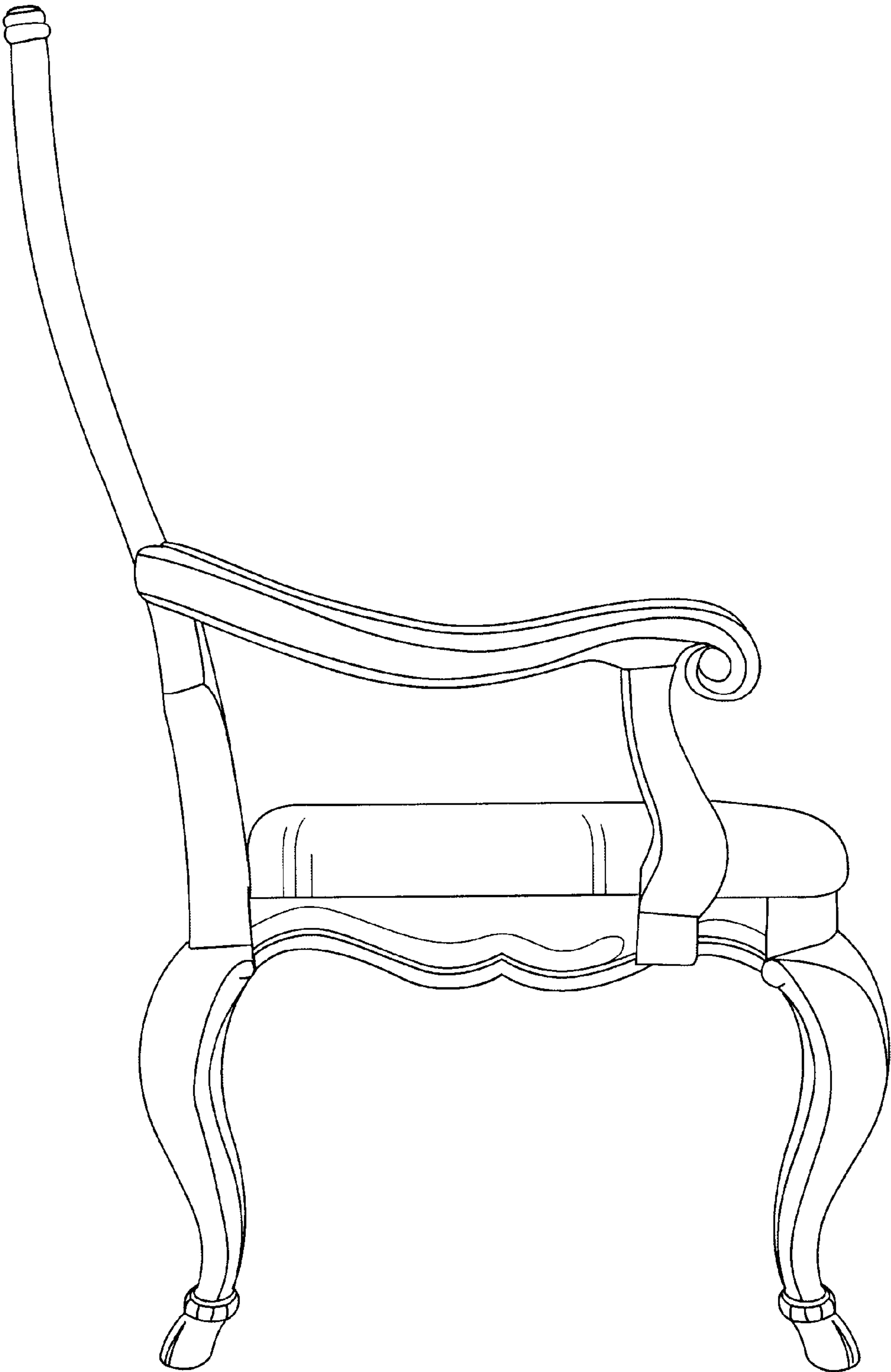

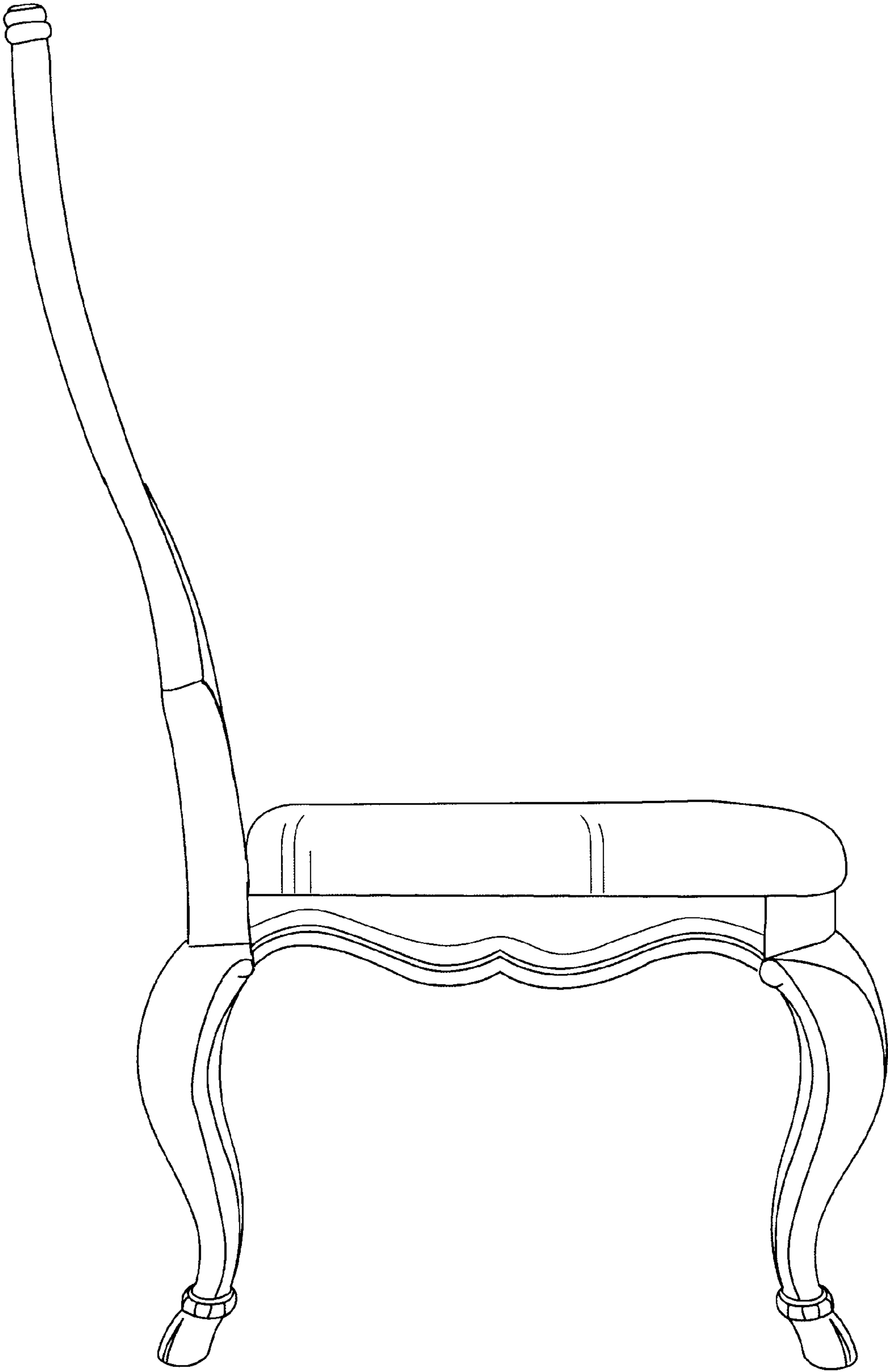

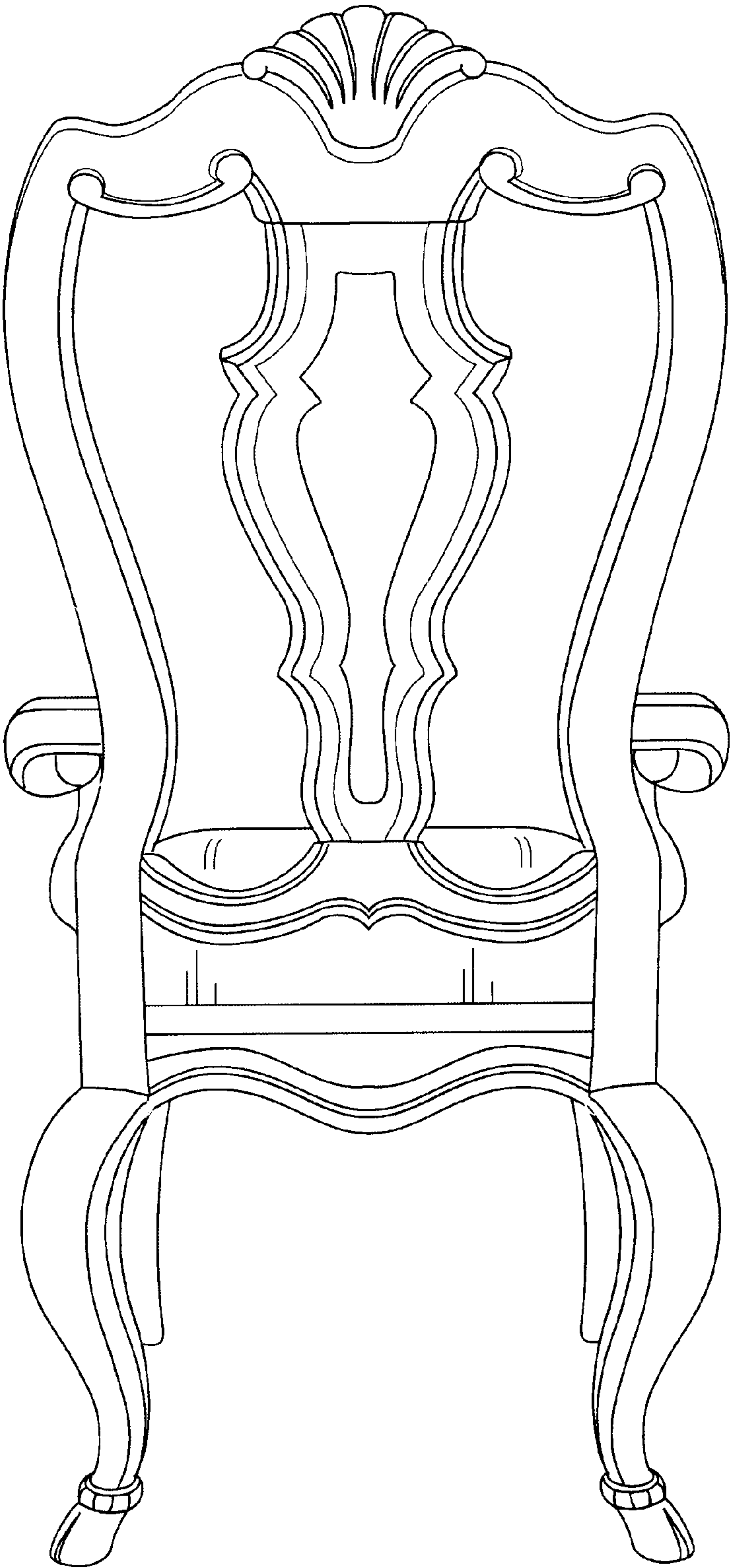

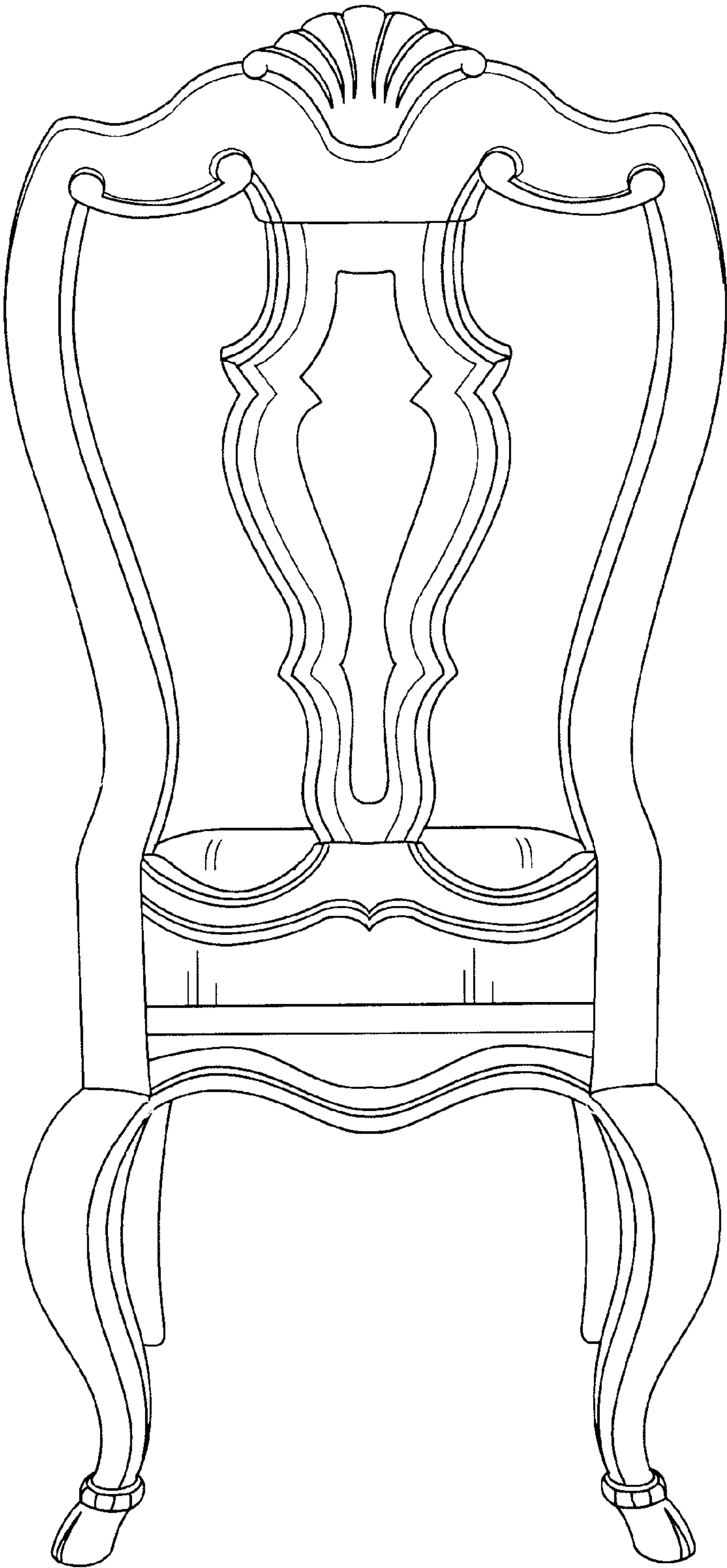
