(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sauce pan/sauce pot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sauce pan/stock pot showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being identical;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of one side thereof, the other side being identical;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing a second embodiment of our design.

The only difference is the proportions.

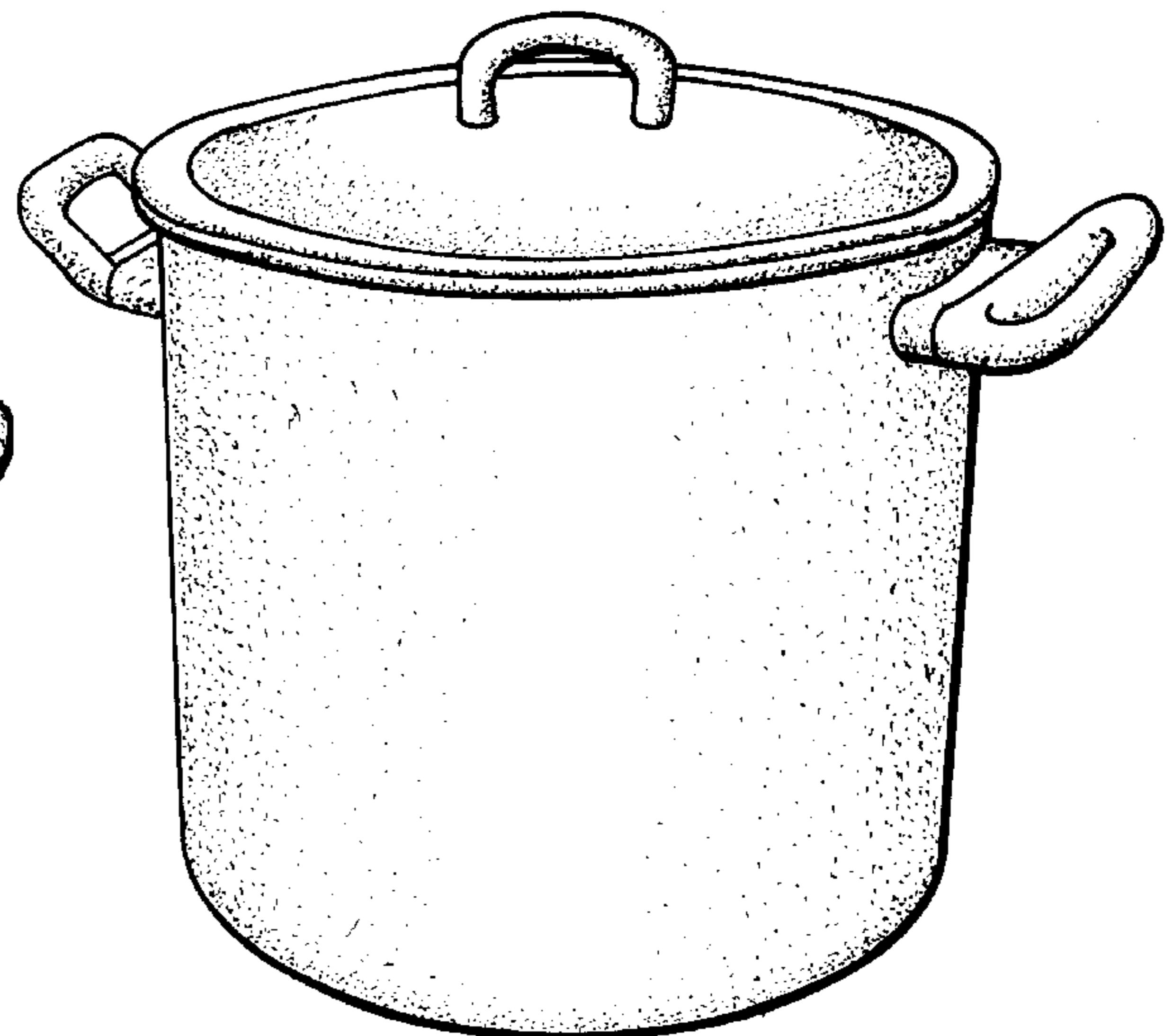
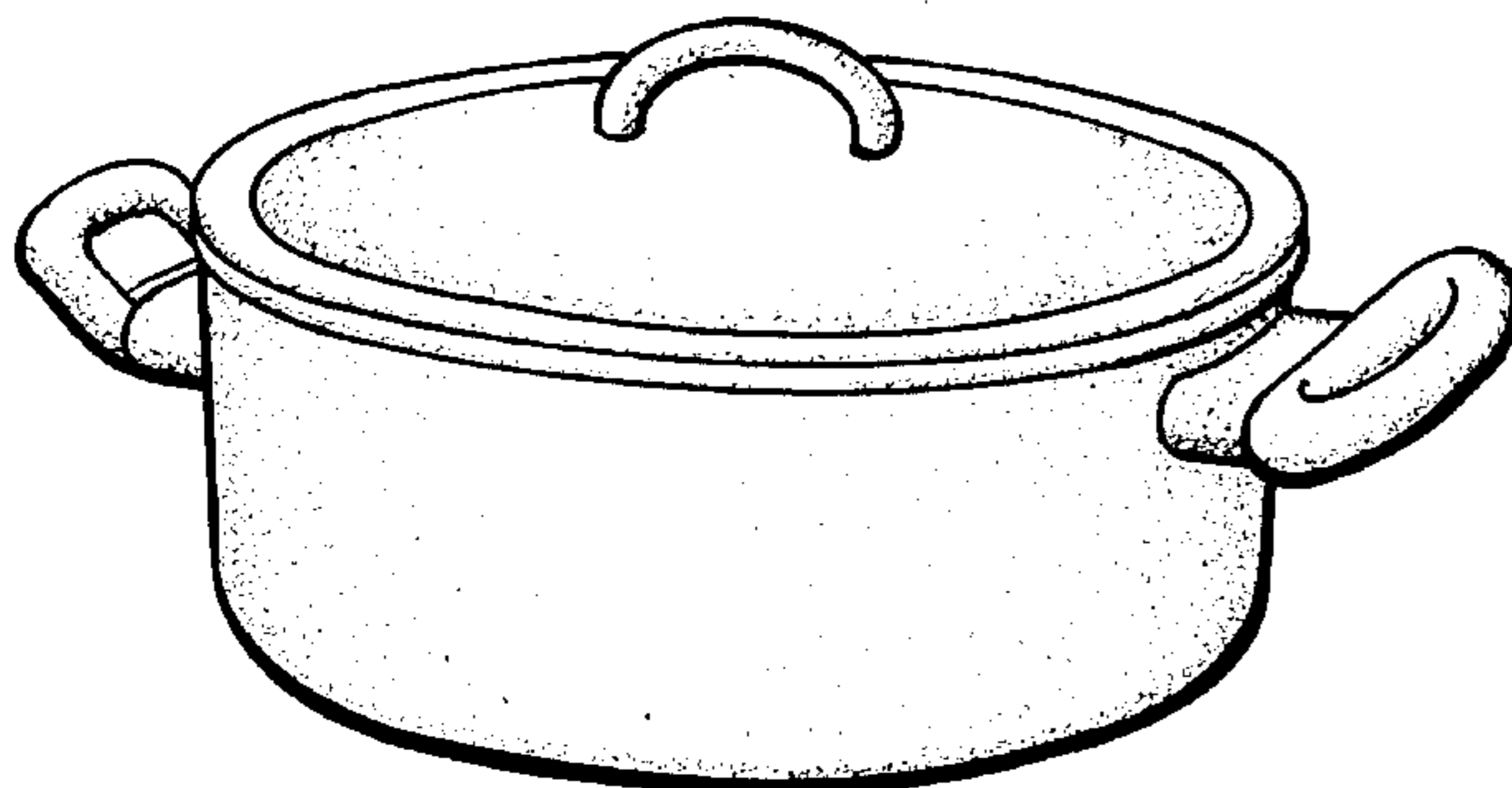

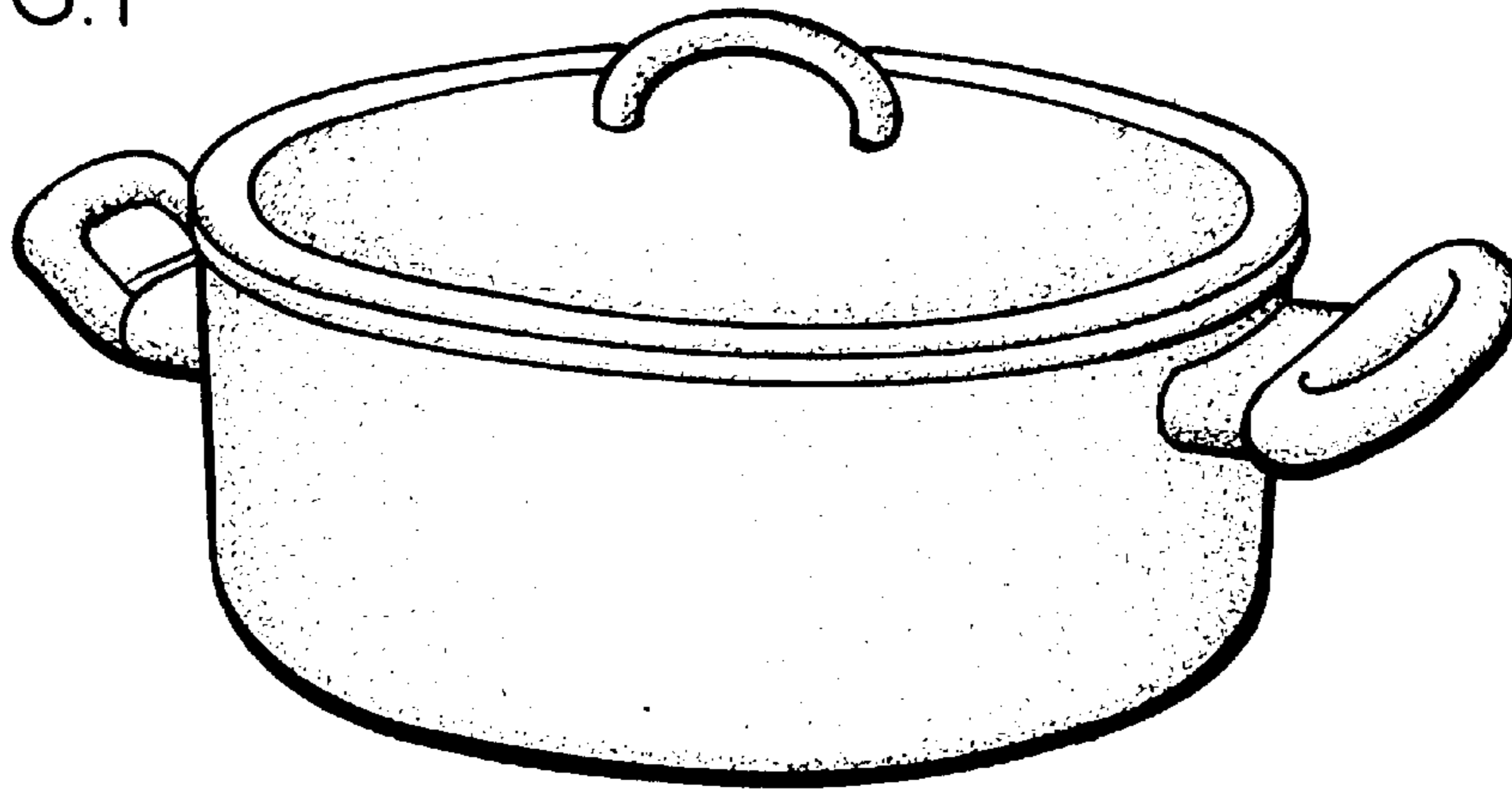

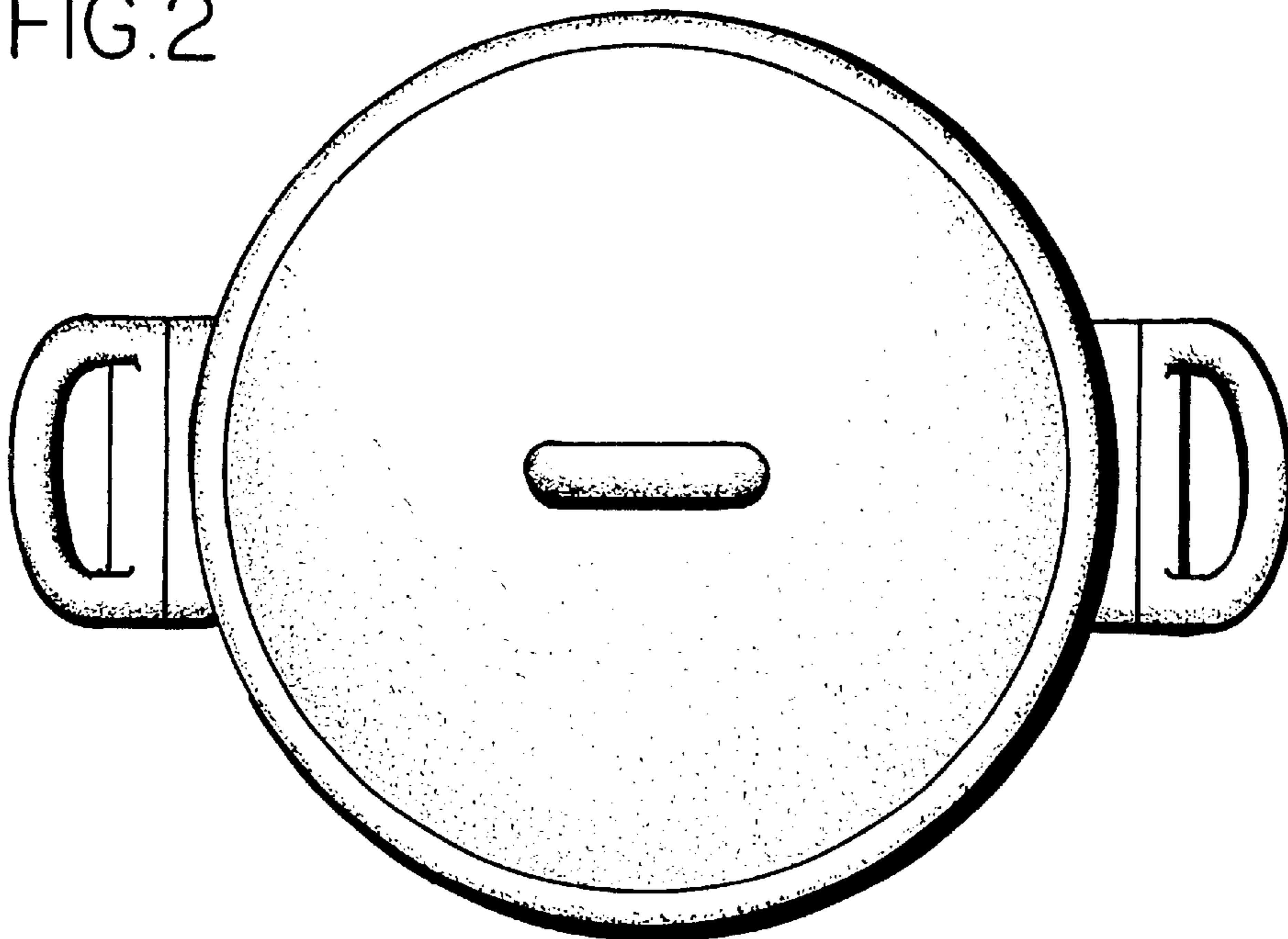

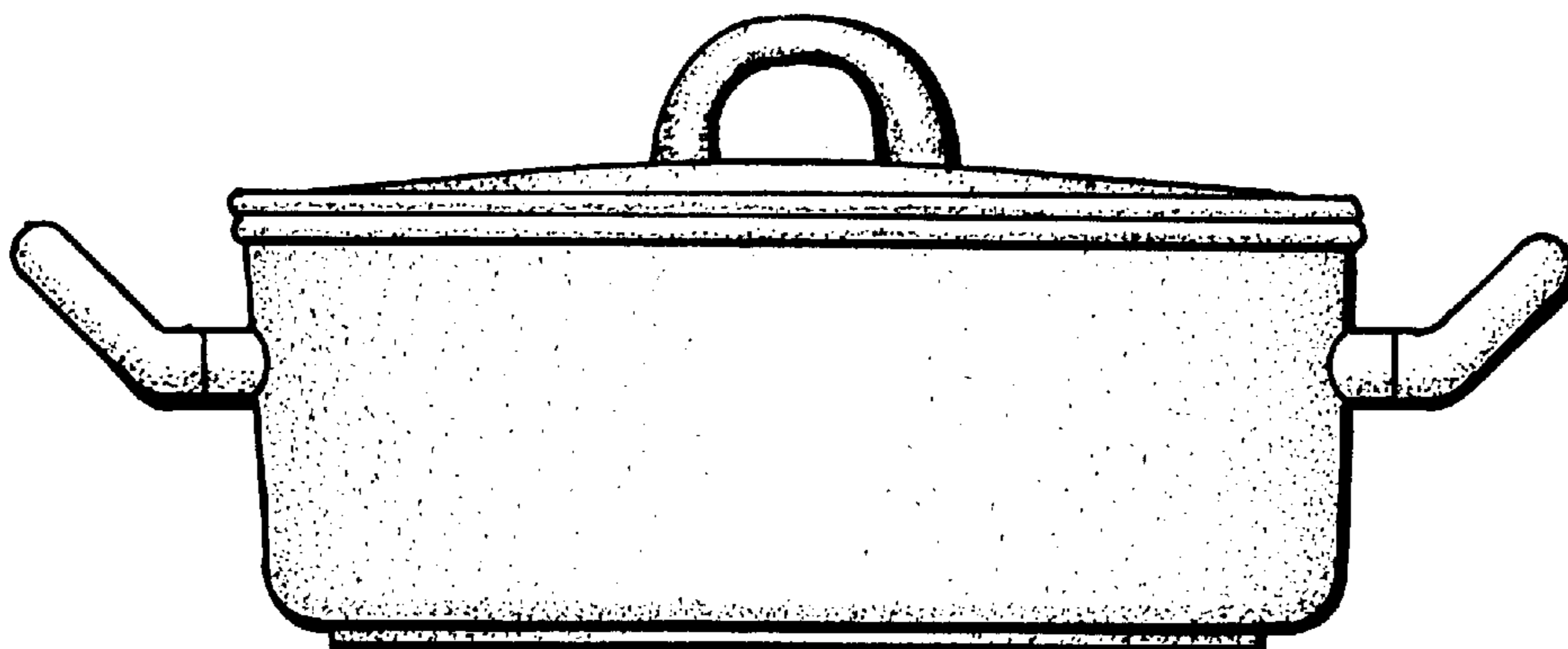

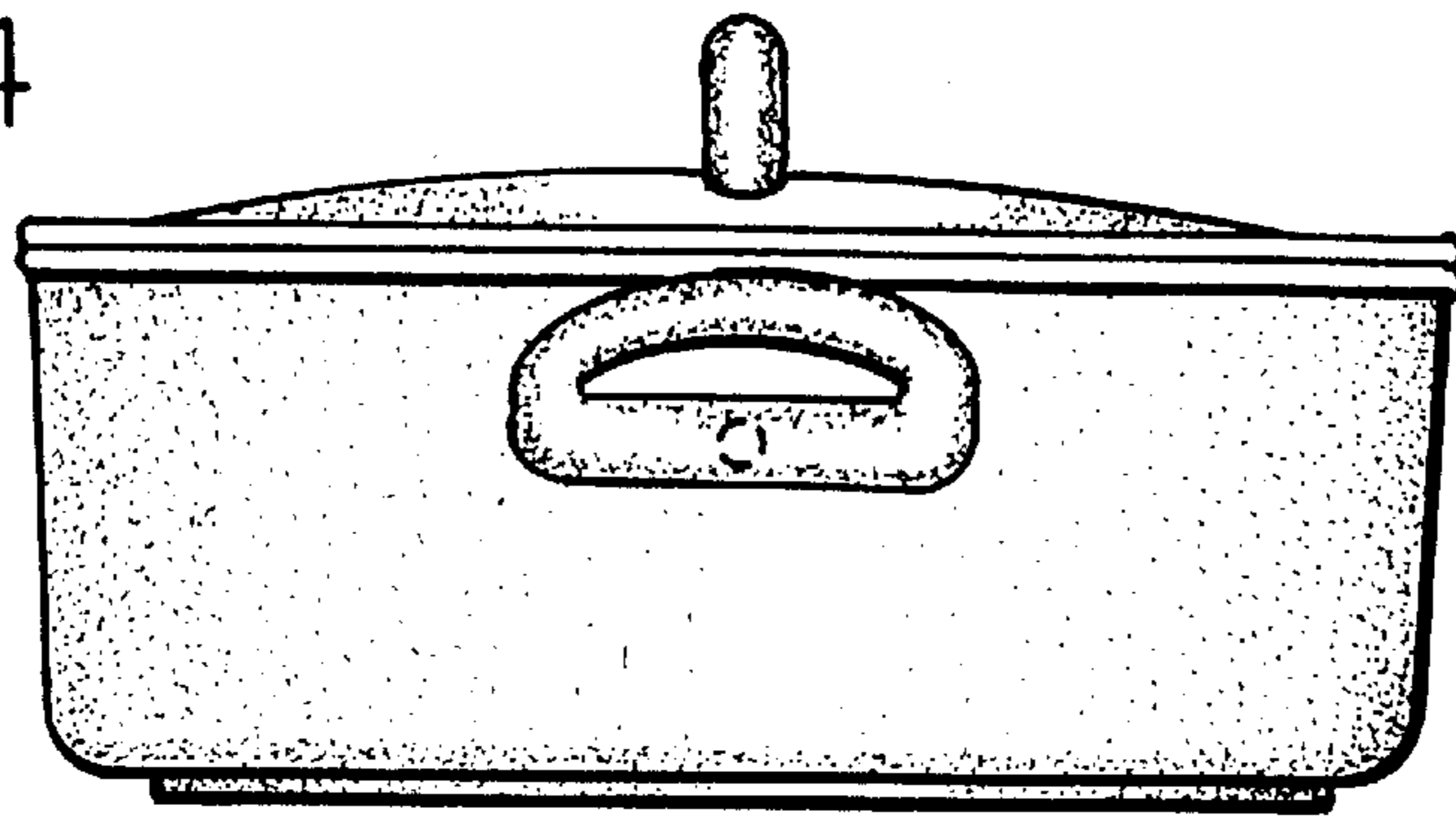

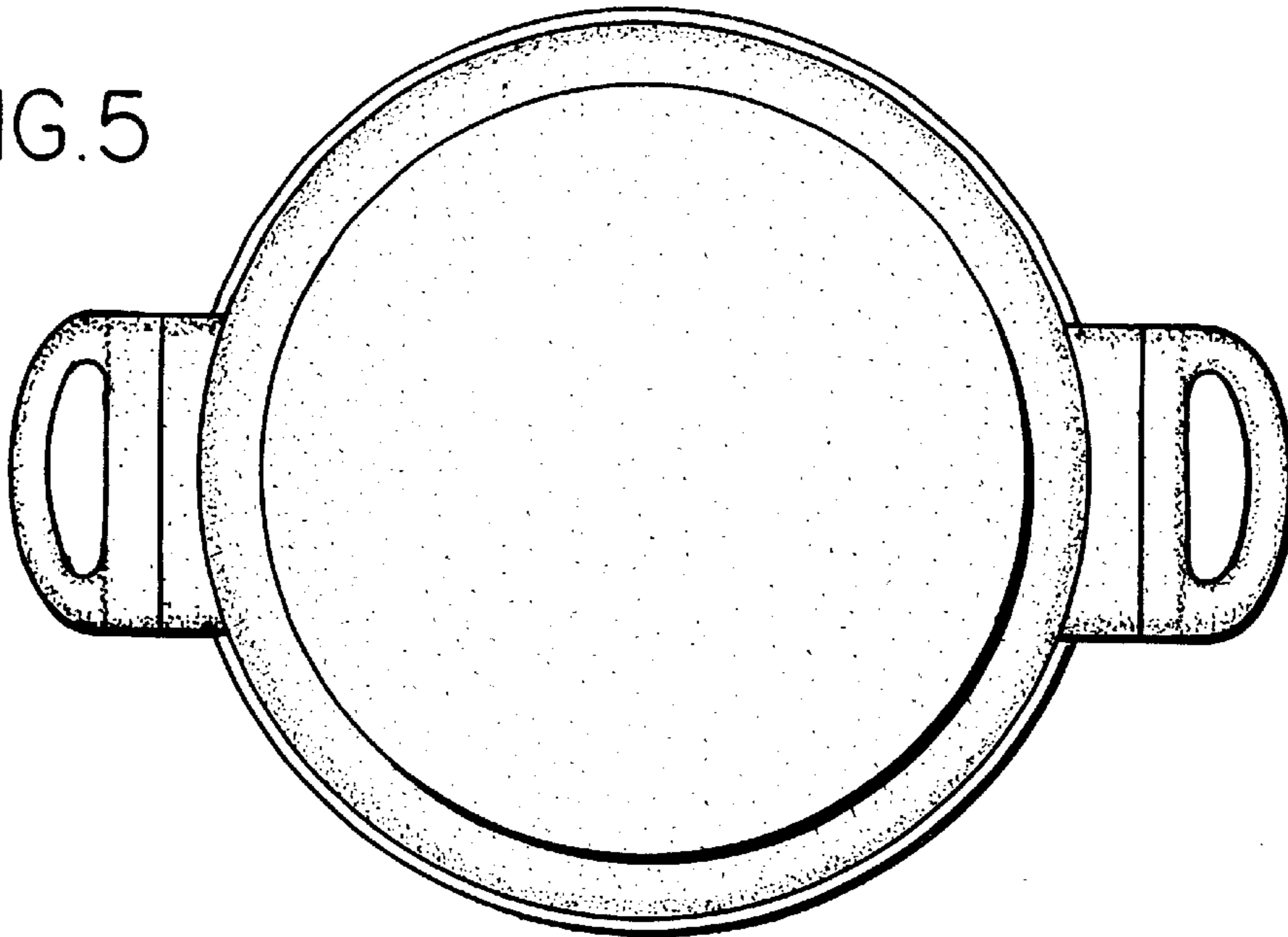
