DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a rational inquiry sash showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

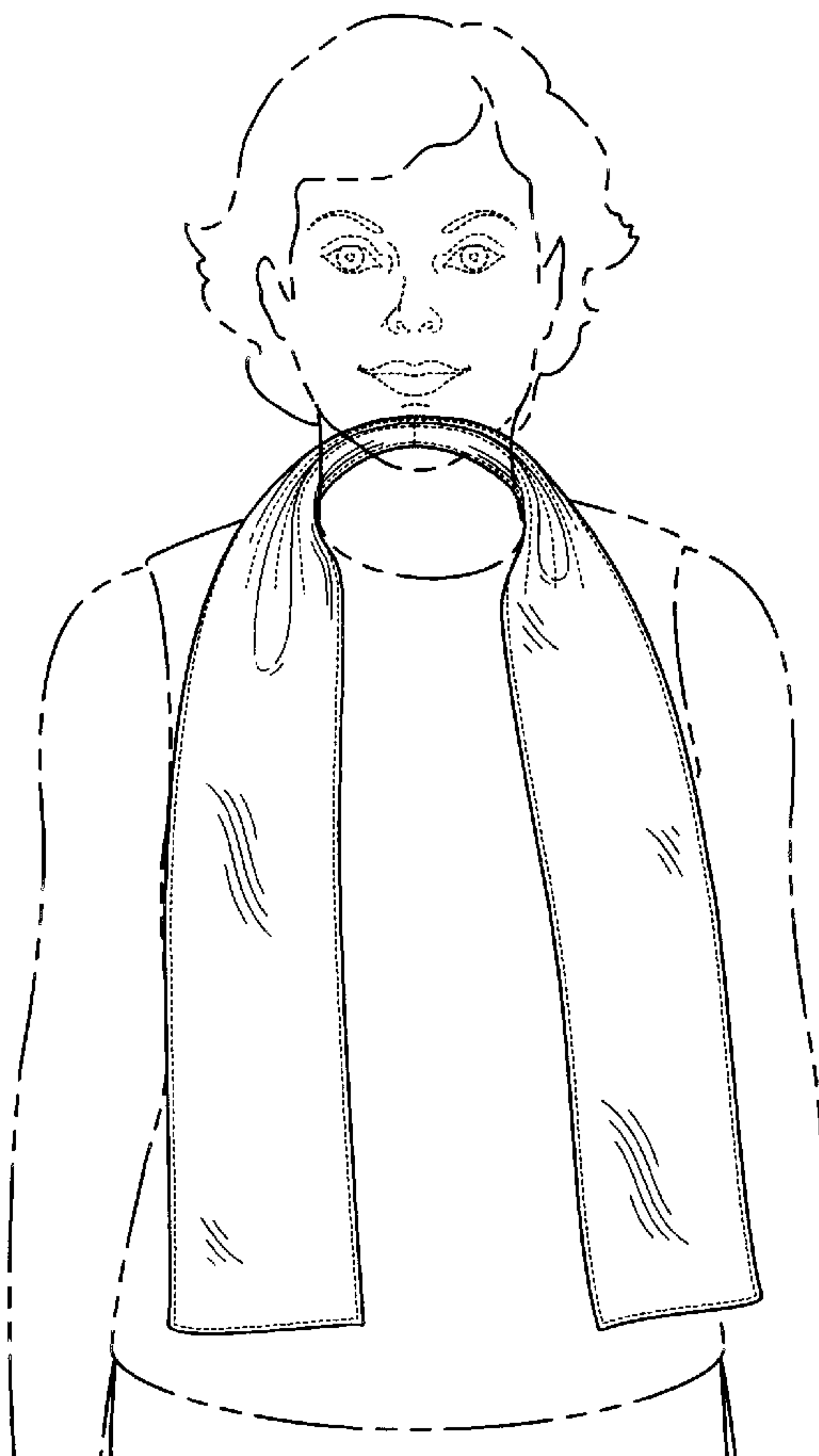
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

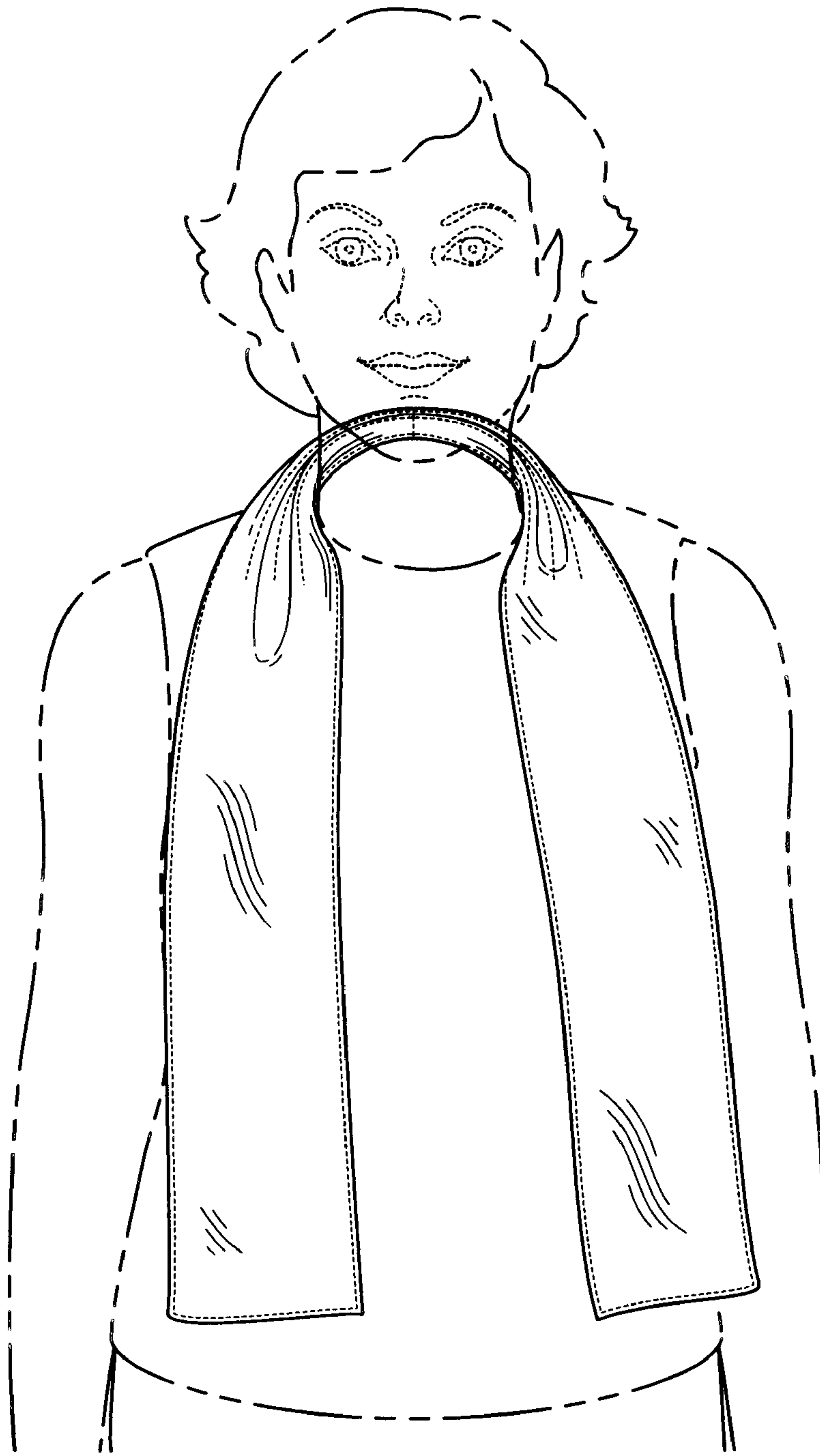

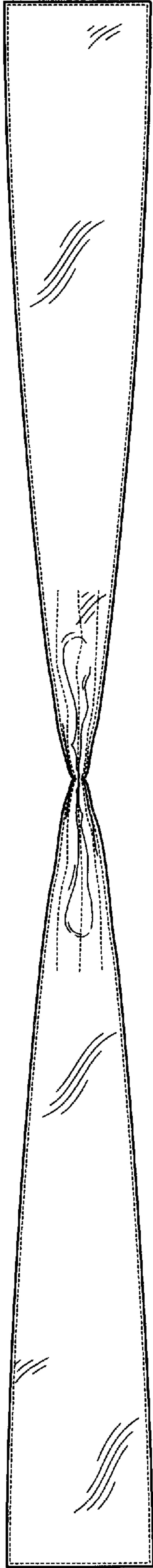

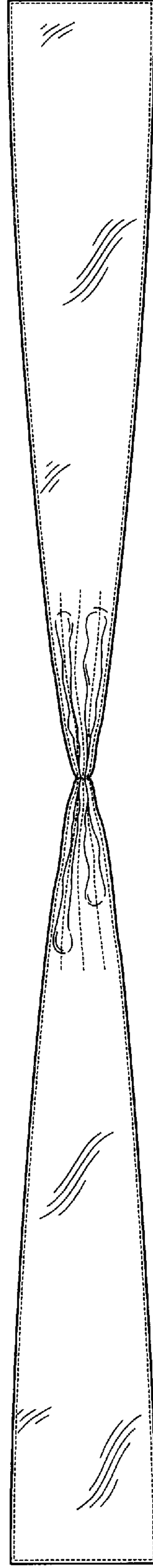

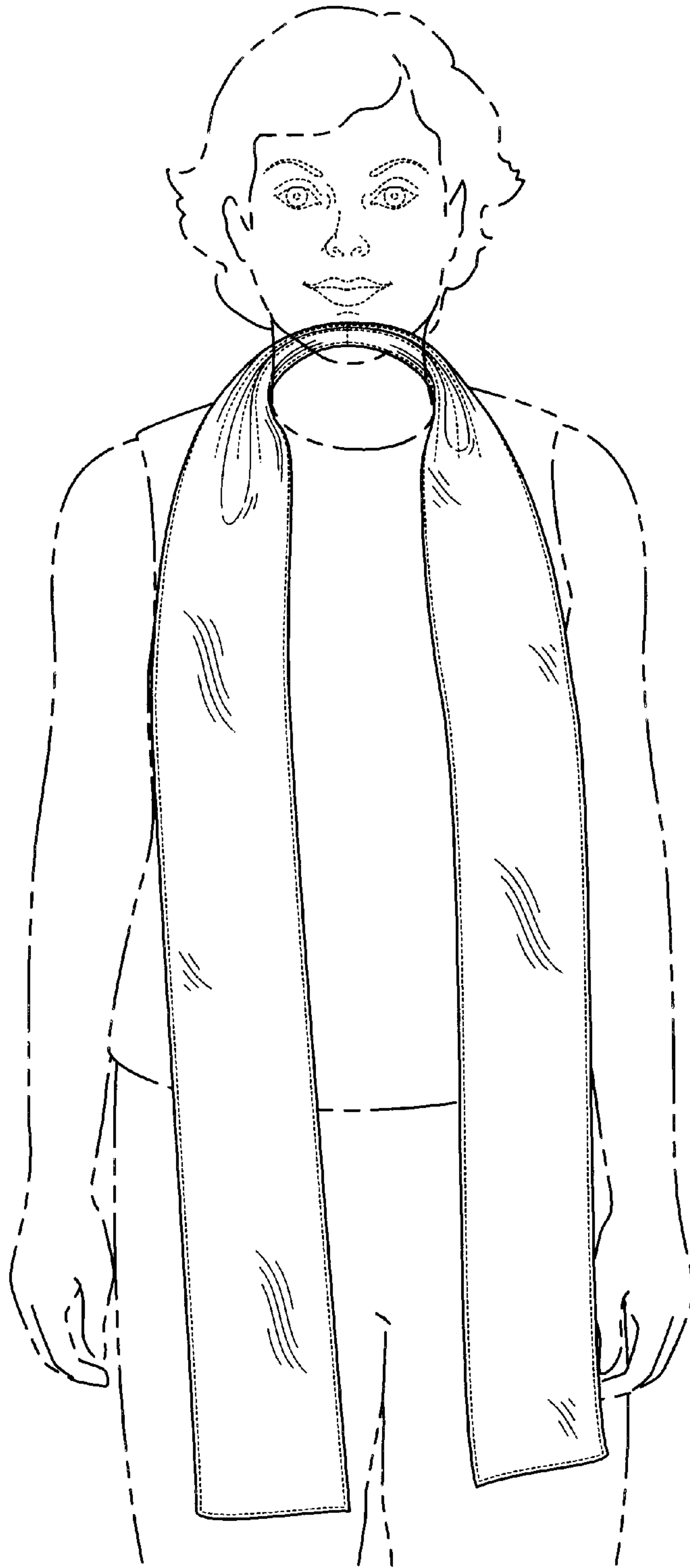
