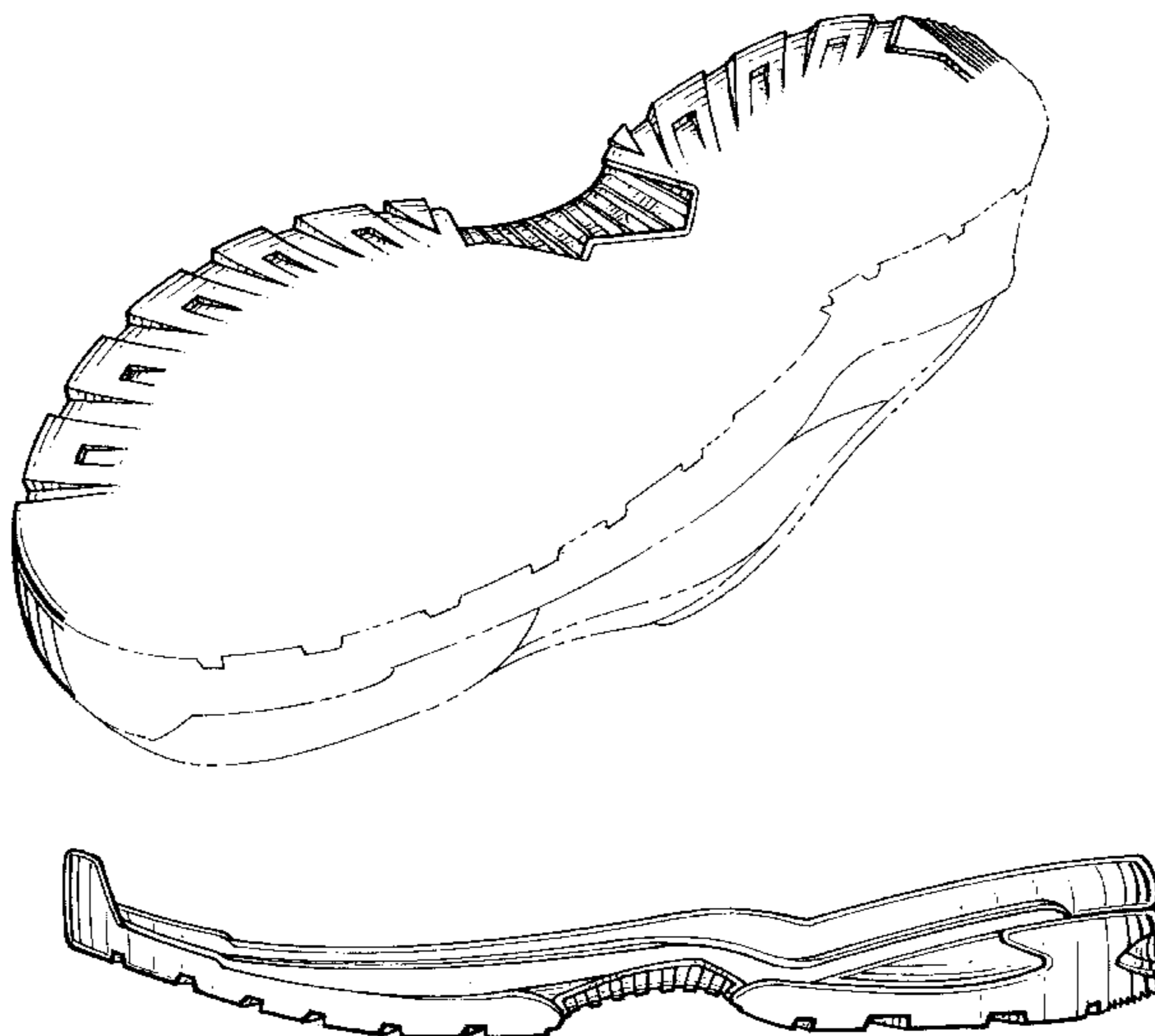
The ornamental design for a portion of a periphery, as shown and described.

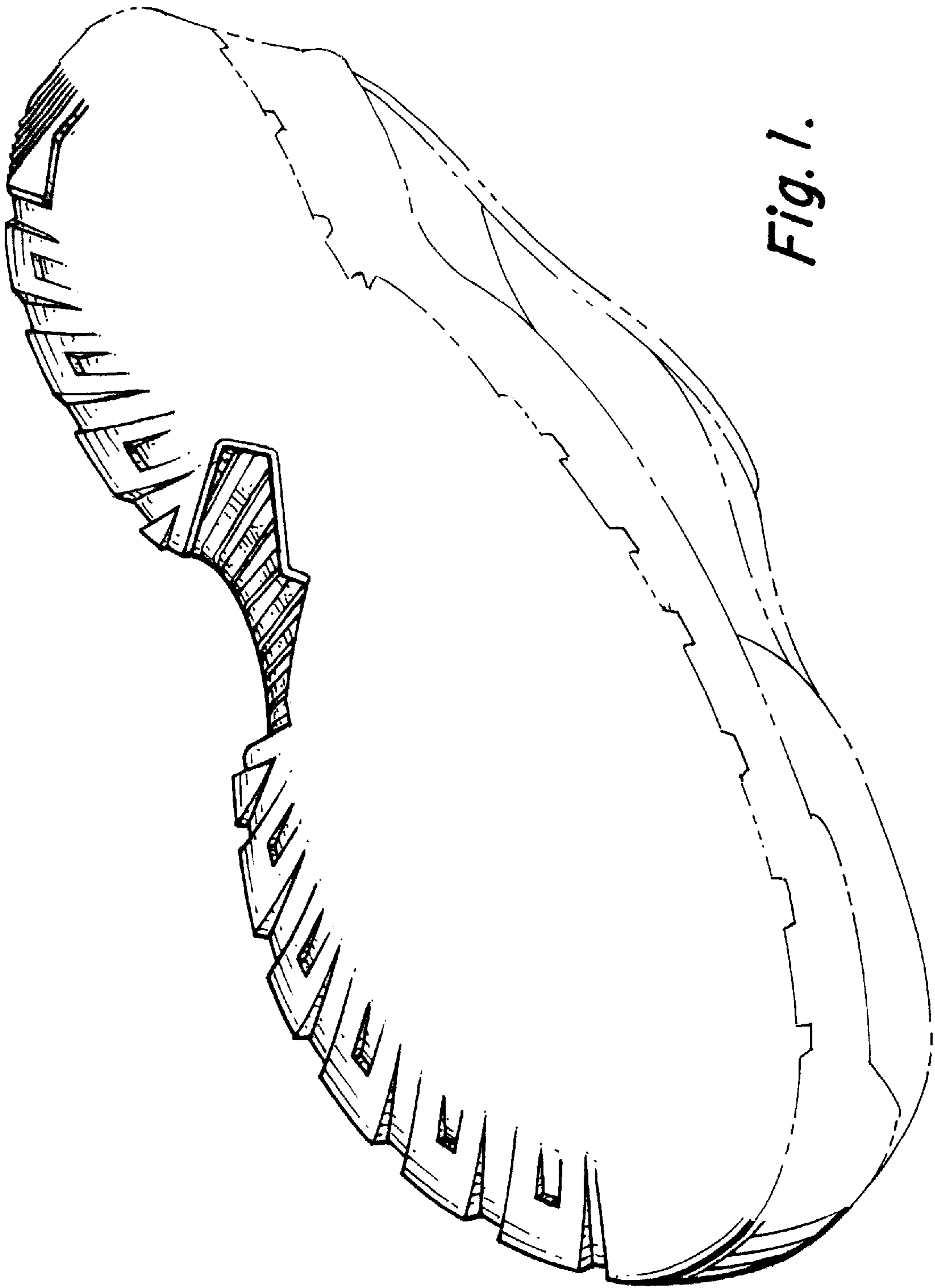
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

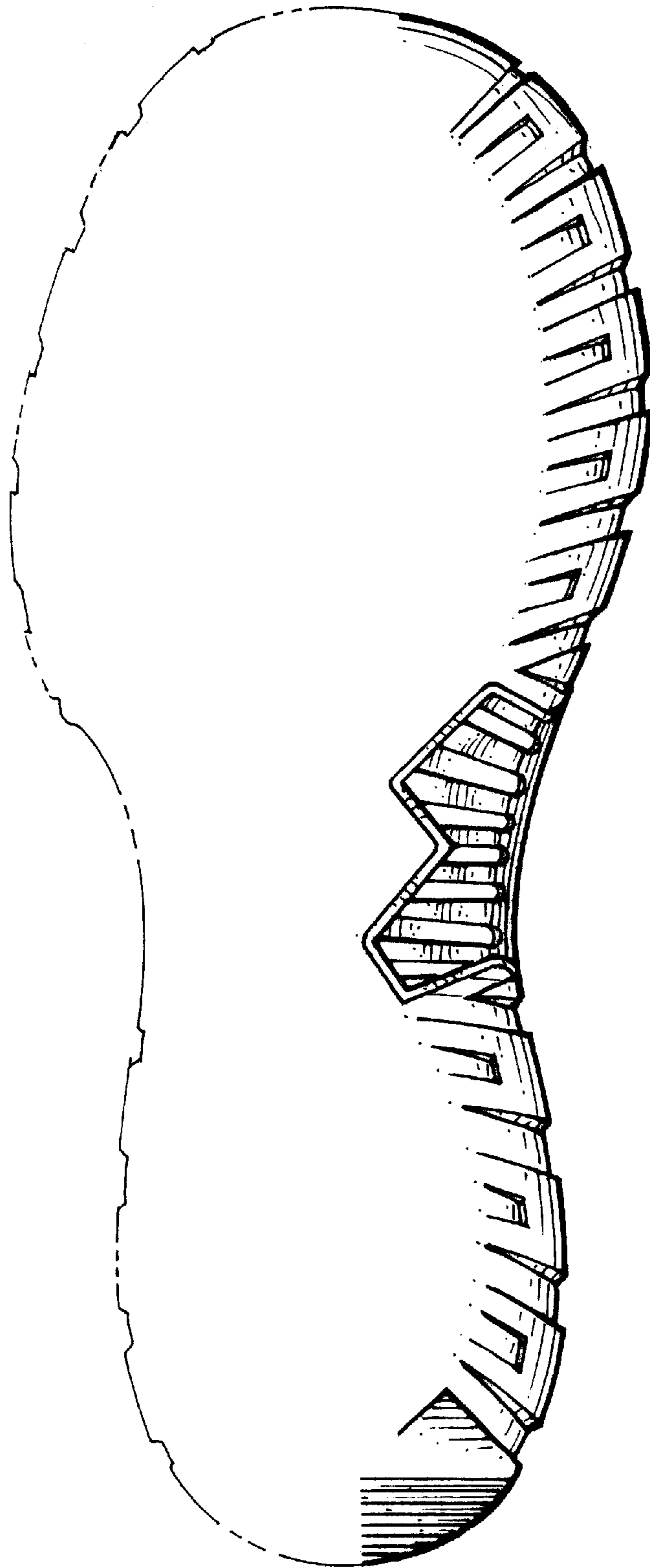
The broken lines shown throughout the views illustrate the environment in which the design resides, and form no part of the claim.

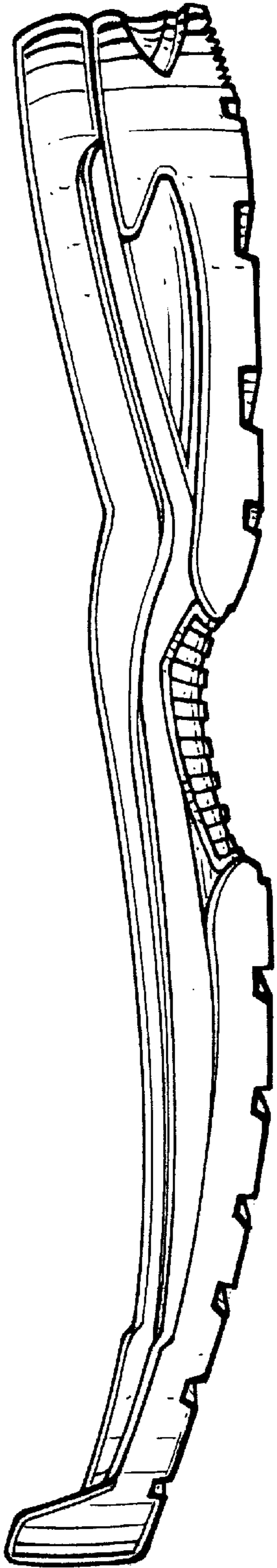




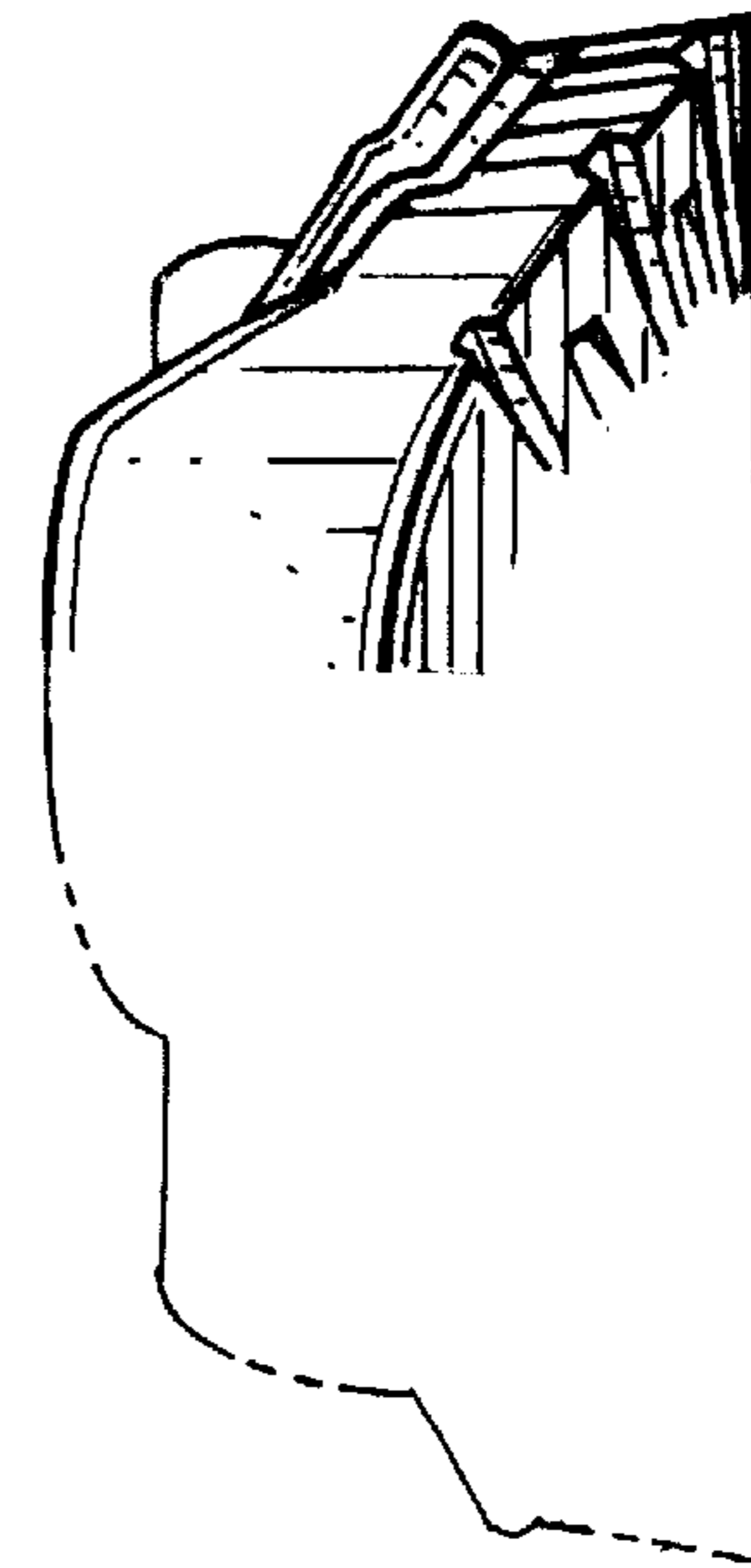

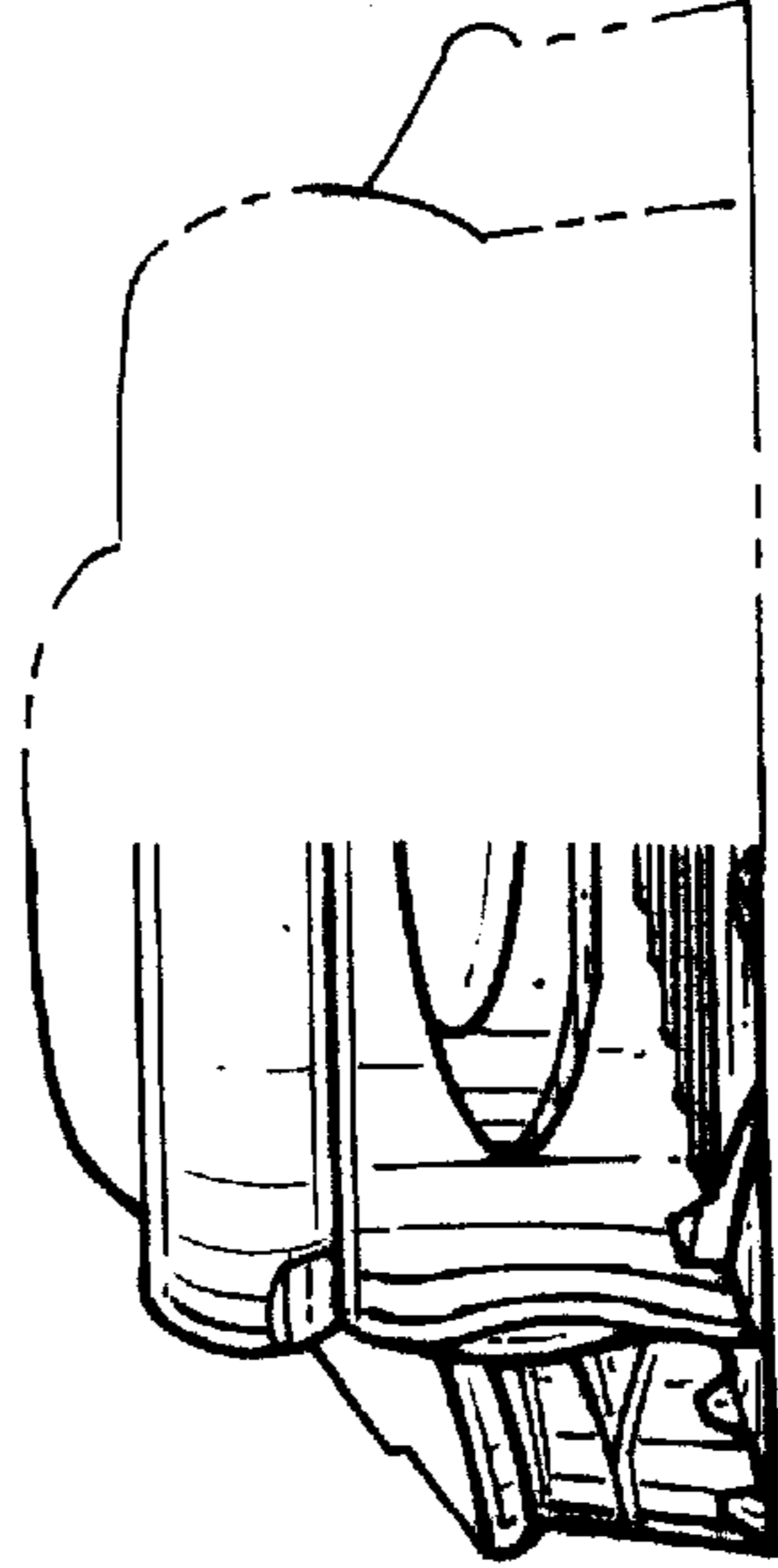
