DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the snowboarder keychain ornament shown in FIG. 1;

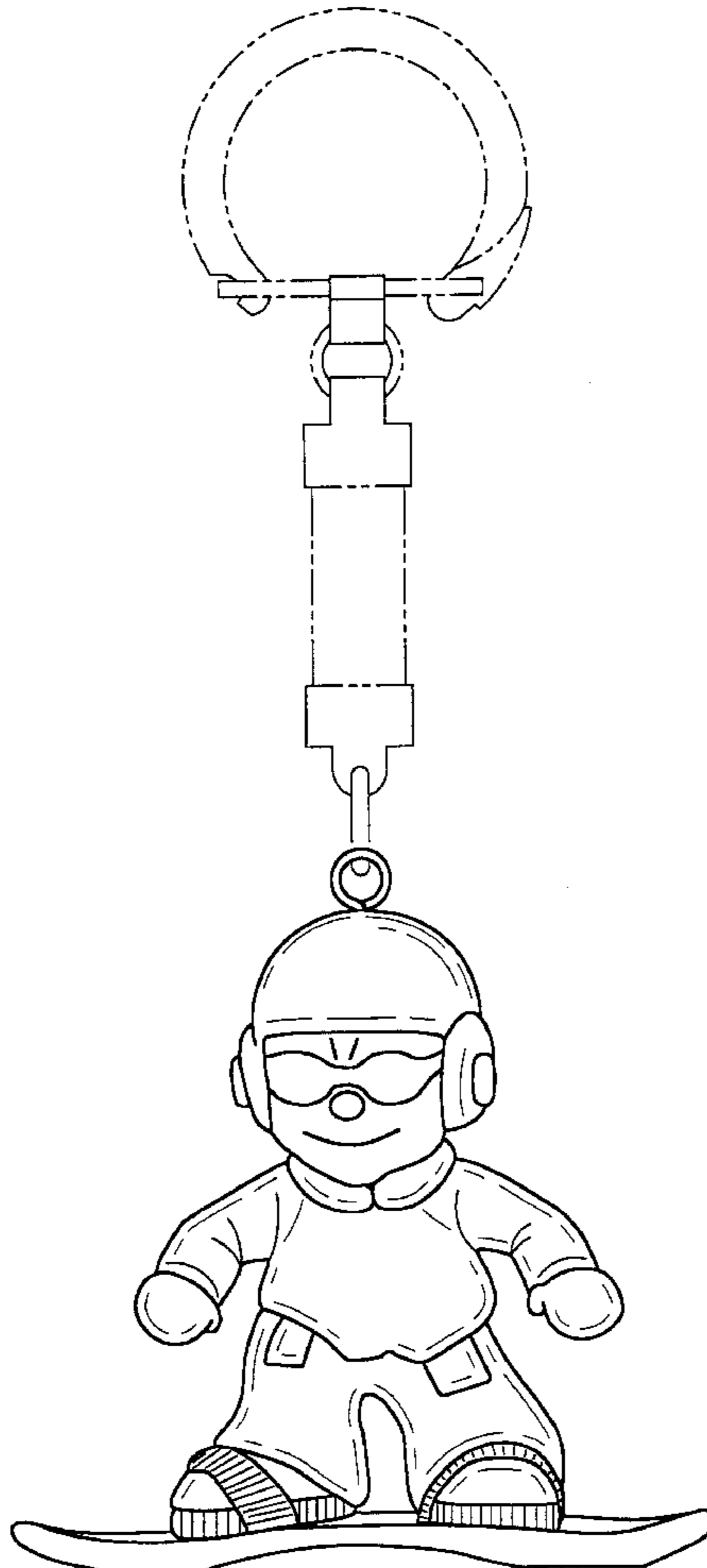
FIG. 4 is a back view of the snowboarder keychain ornament shown in FIG. 1;

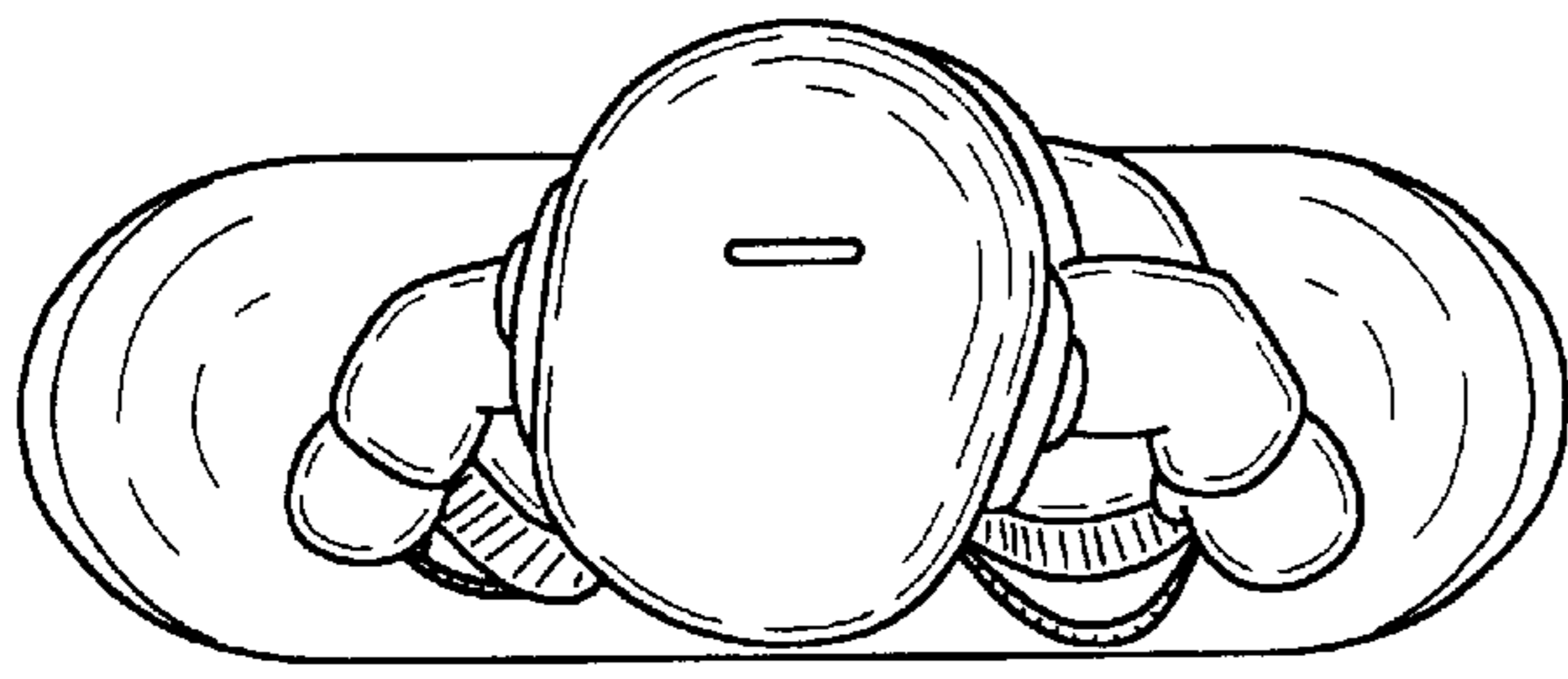

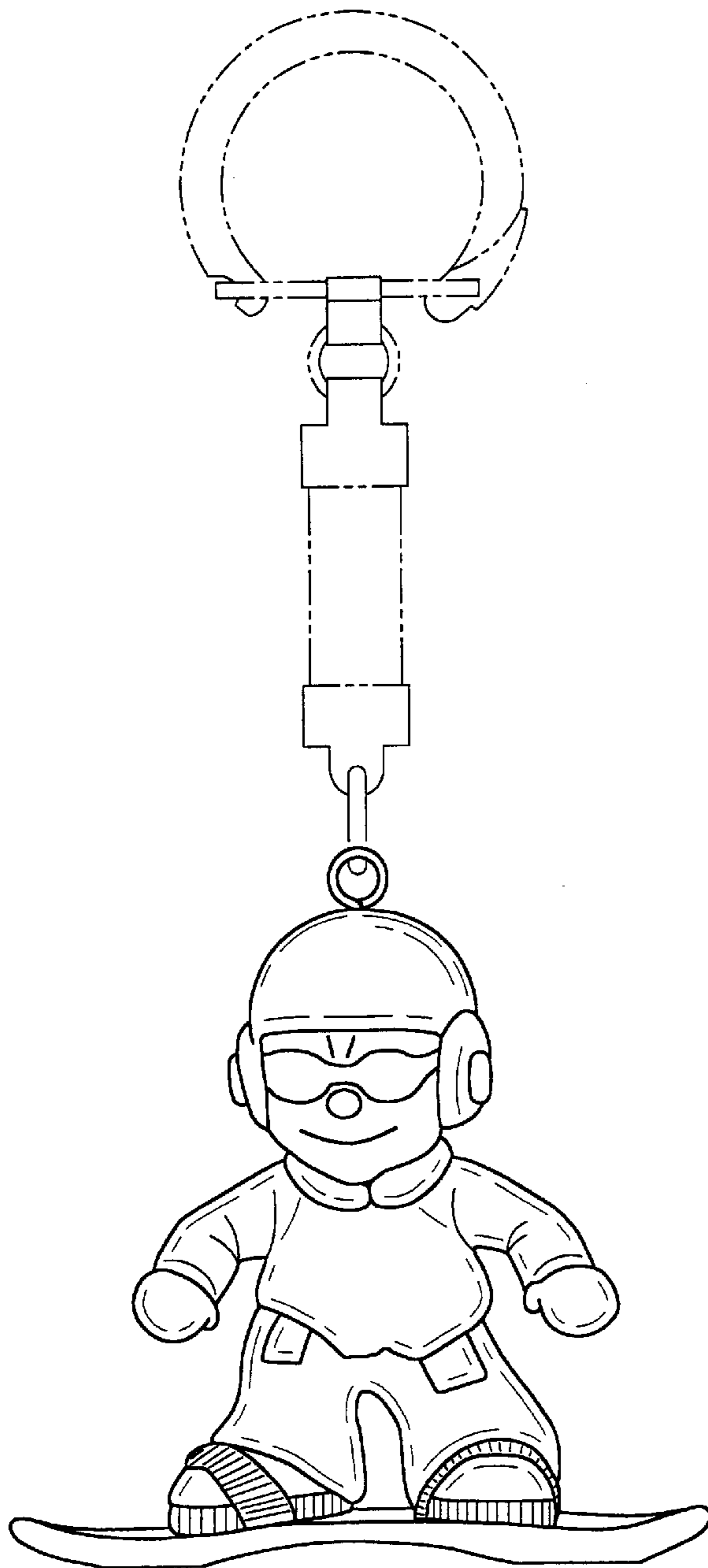

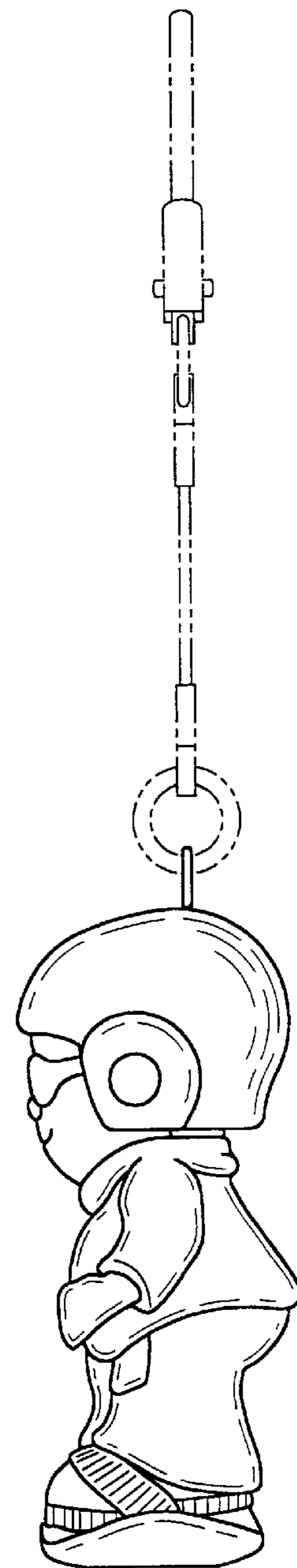

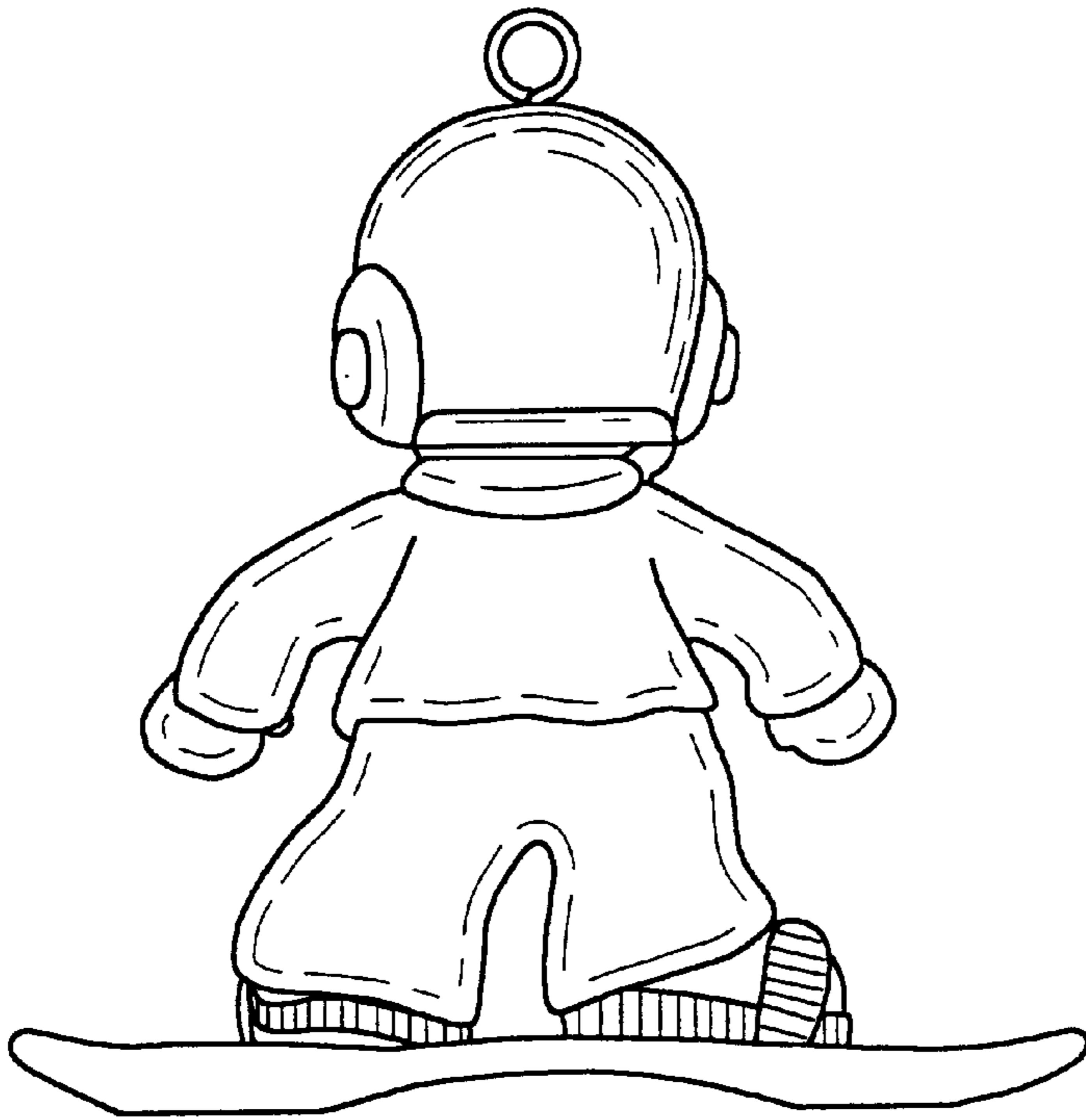

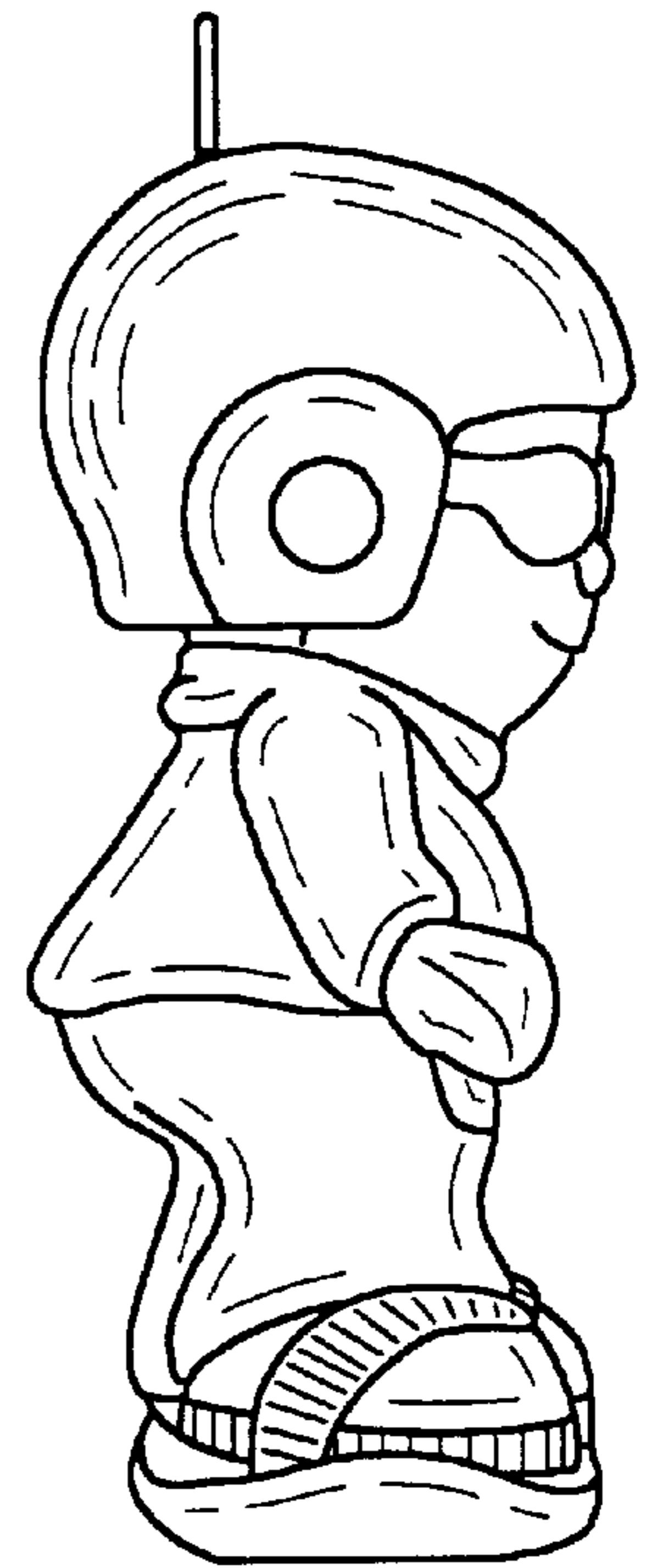

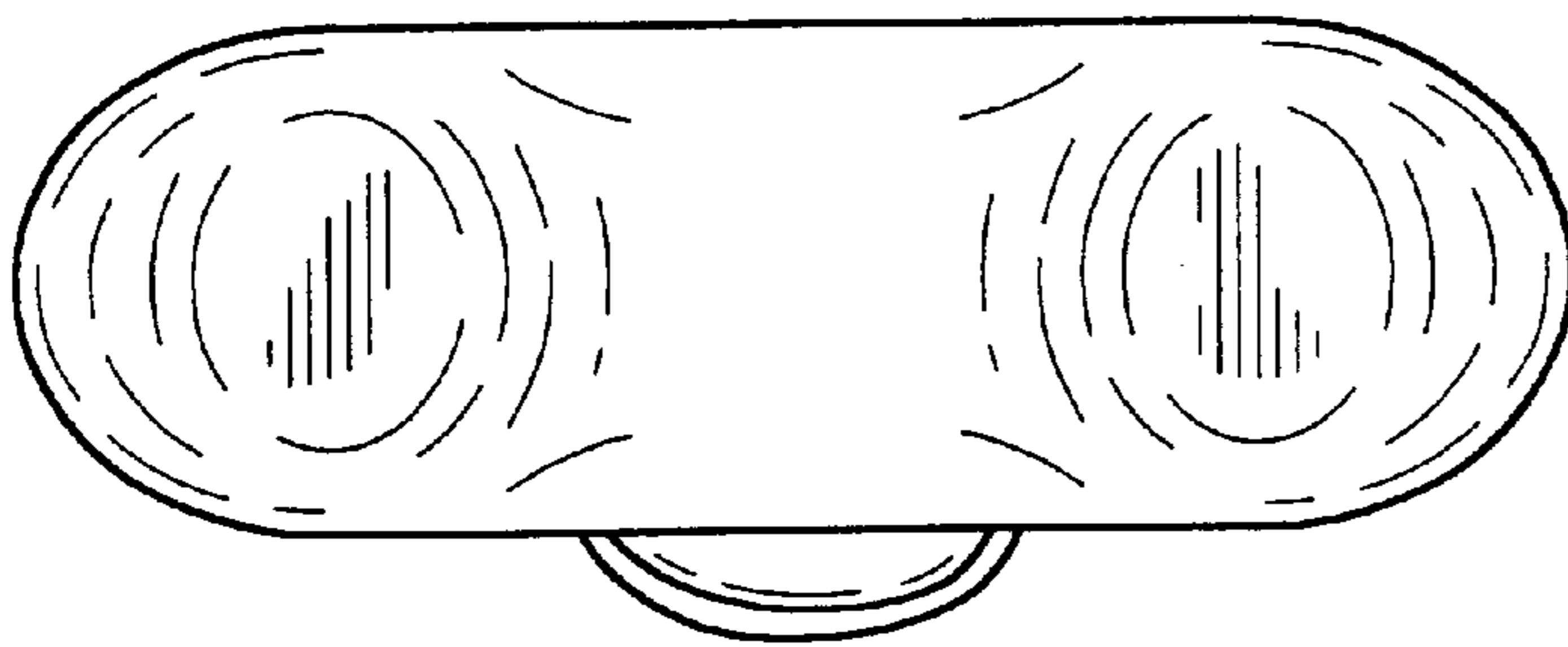
