The ornamental design for an armoire, as shown and described.

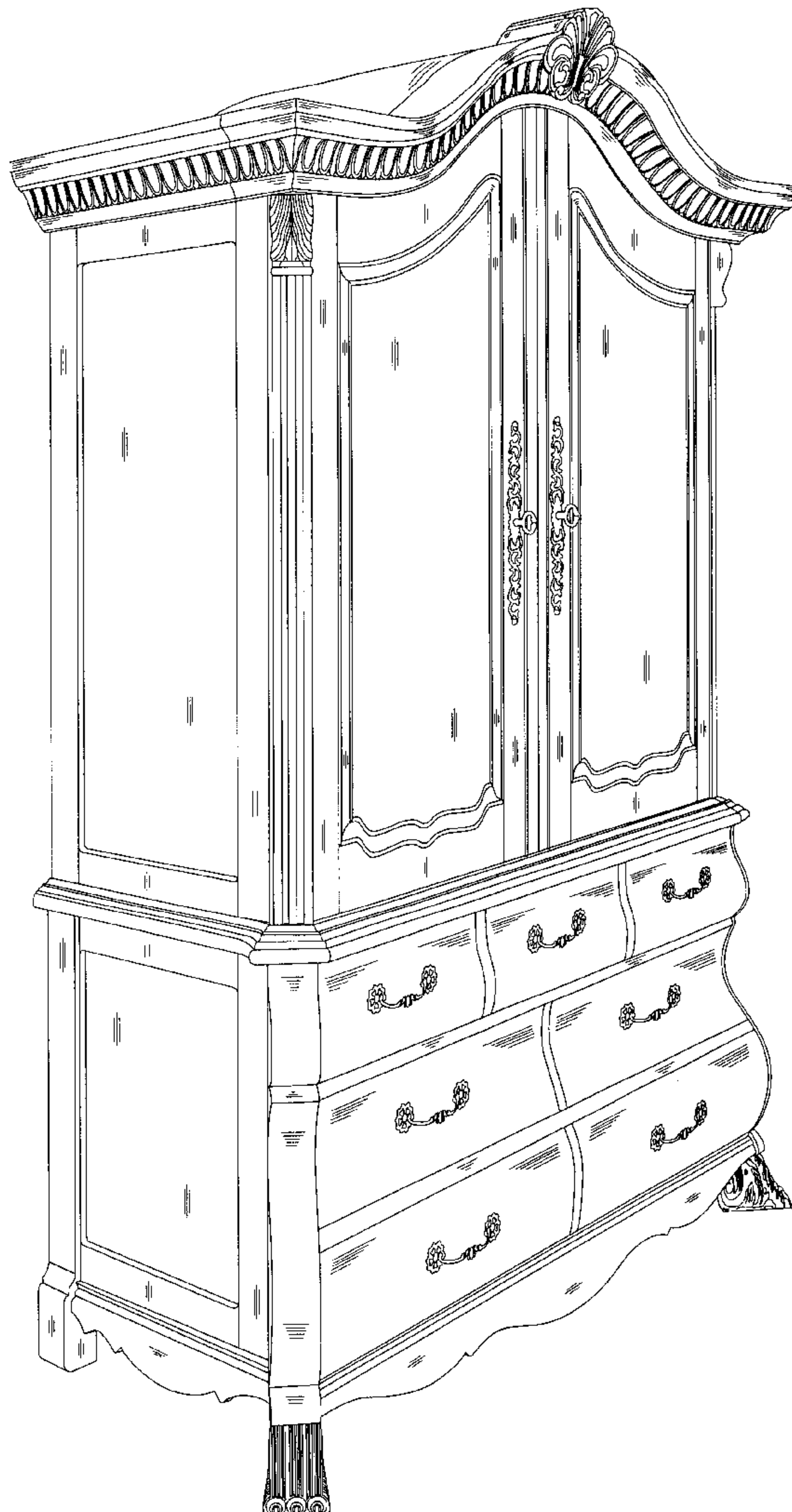
DESCRIPTION

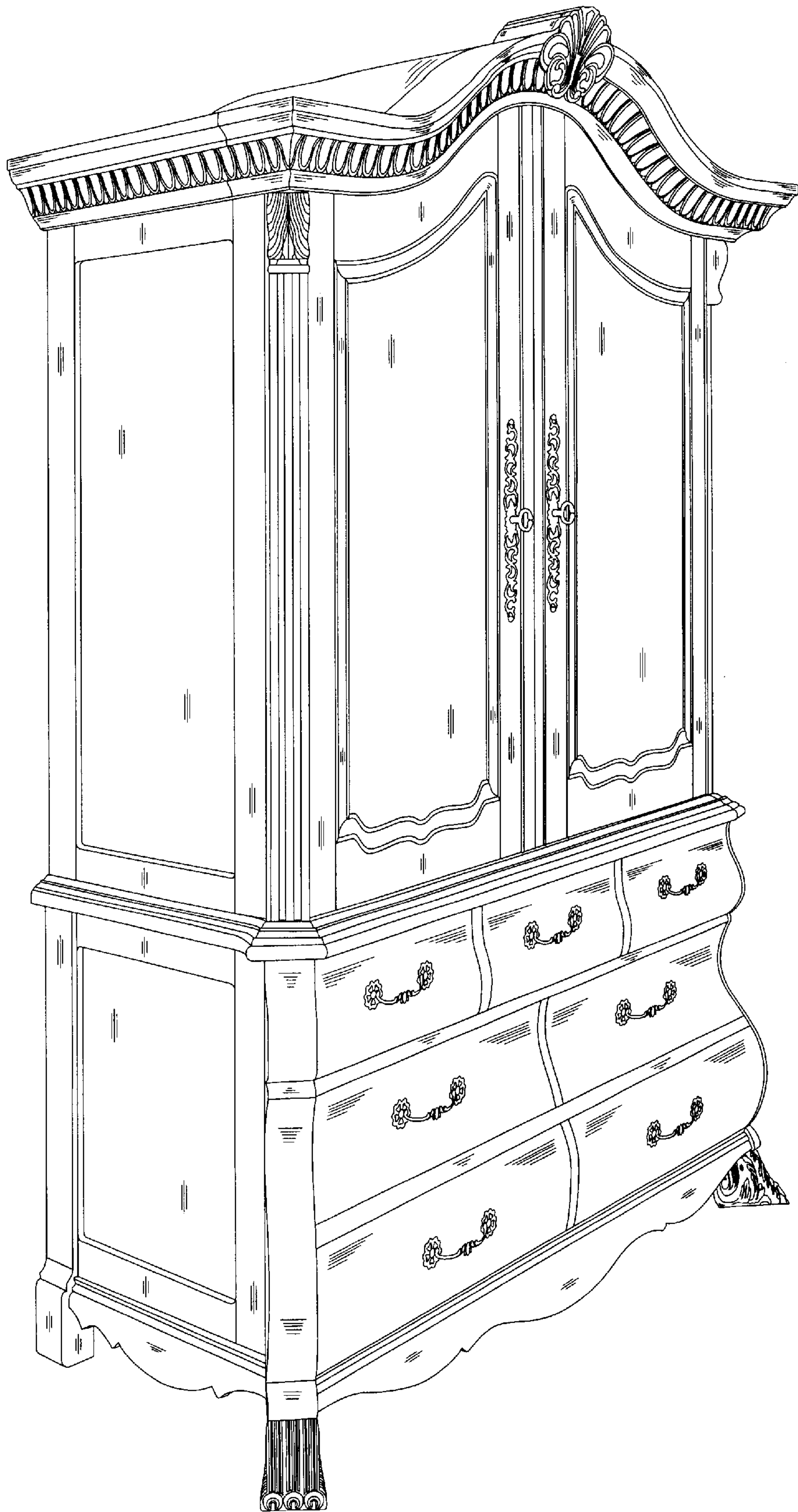

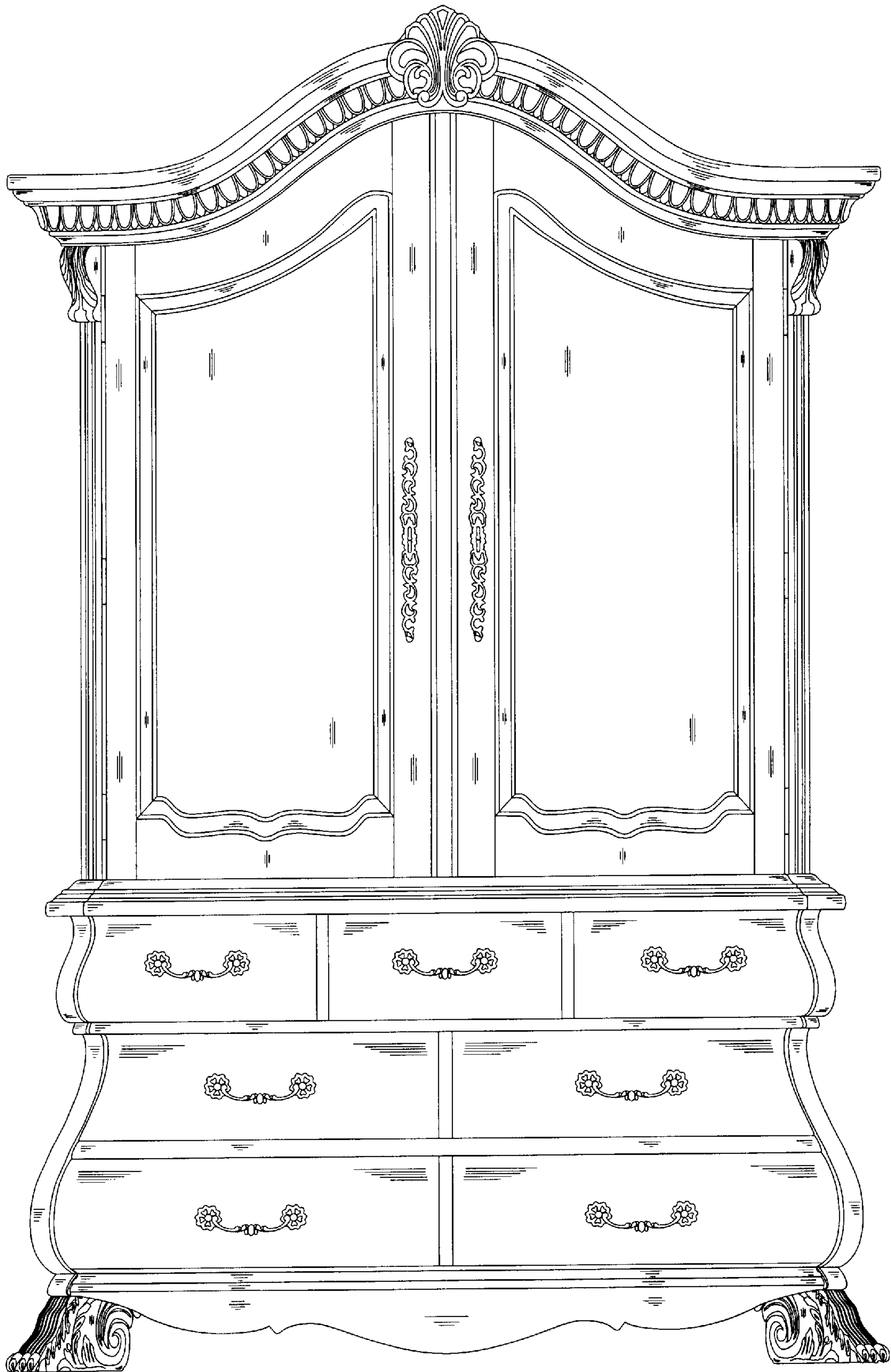

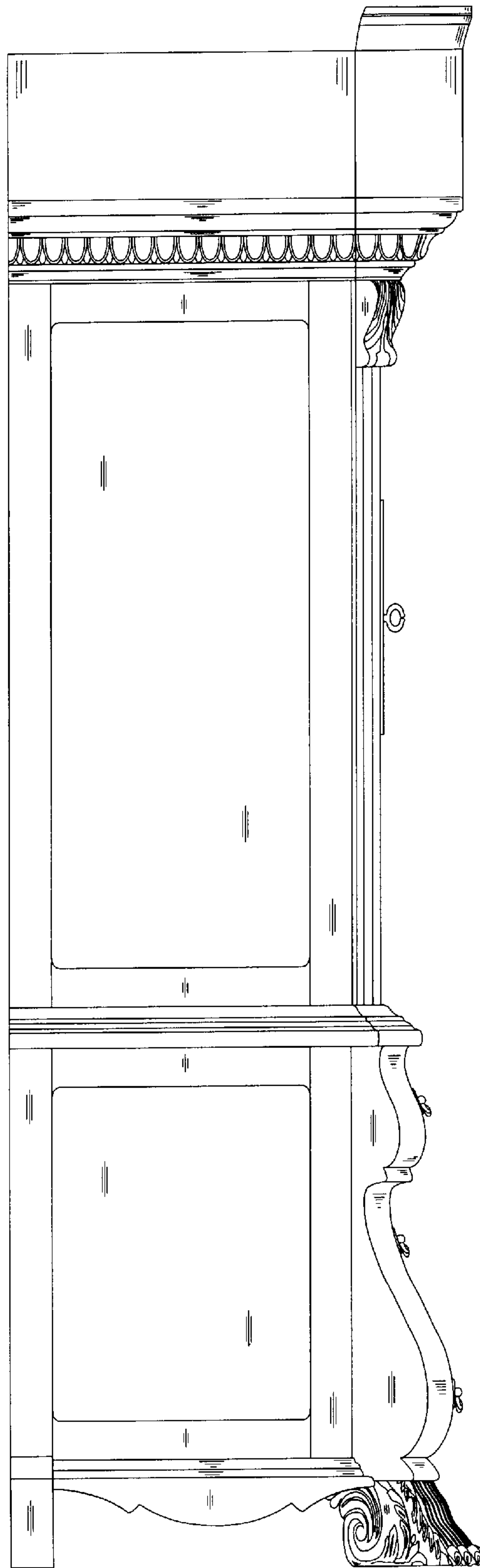
