We claim the ornamental design for housing portions of a cam lock, as shown and described.

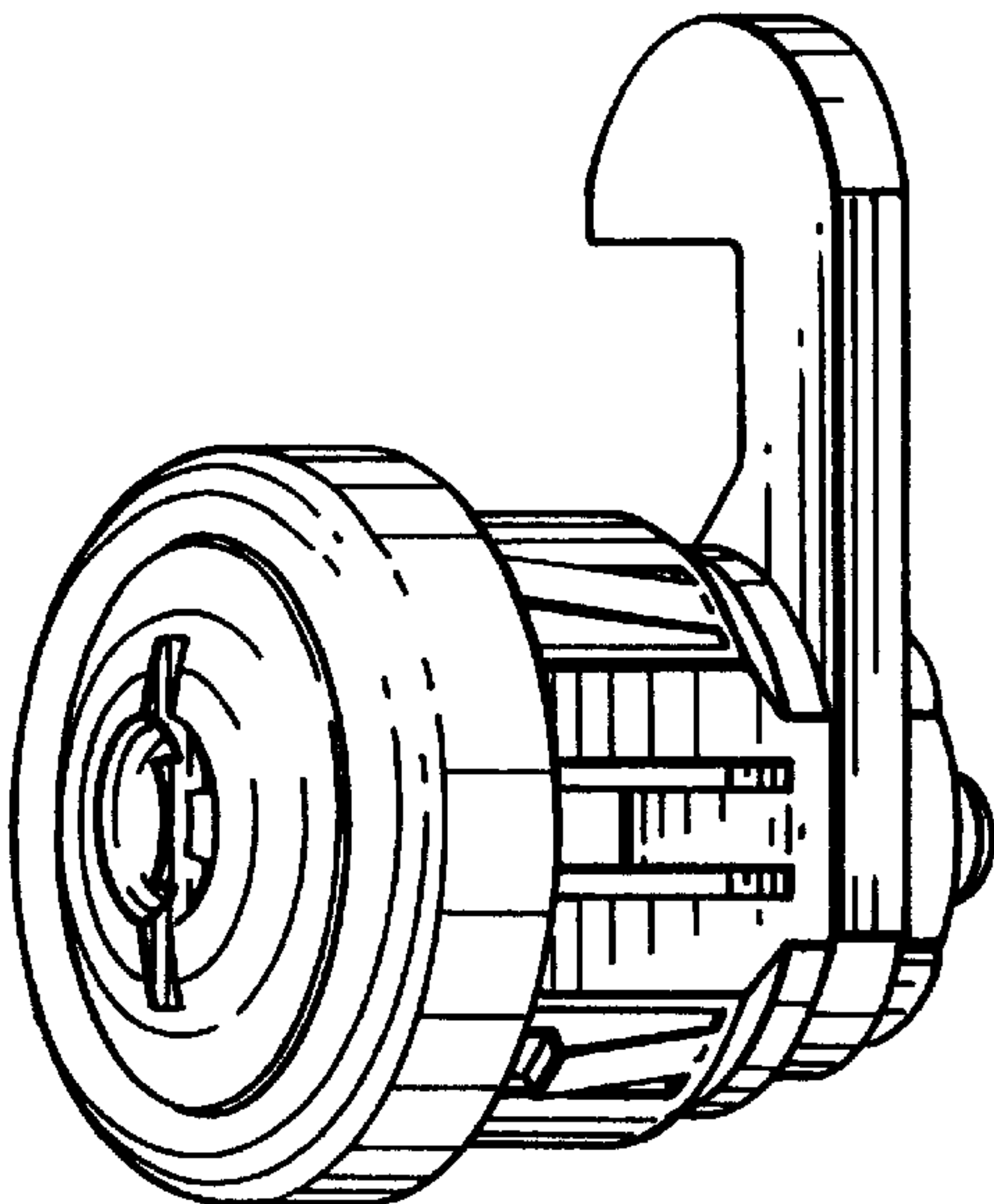
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DESCRIPTION

Reference is made to utility application Serial No. 09/768, 866 filed (concurrently herewith) by Timothy P. 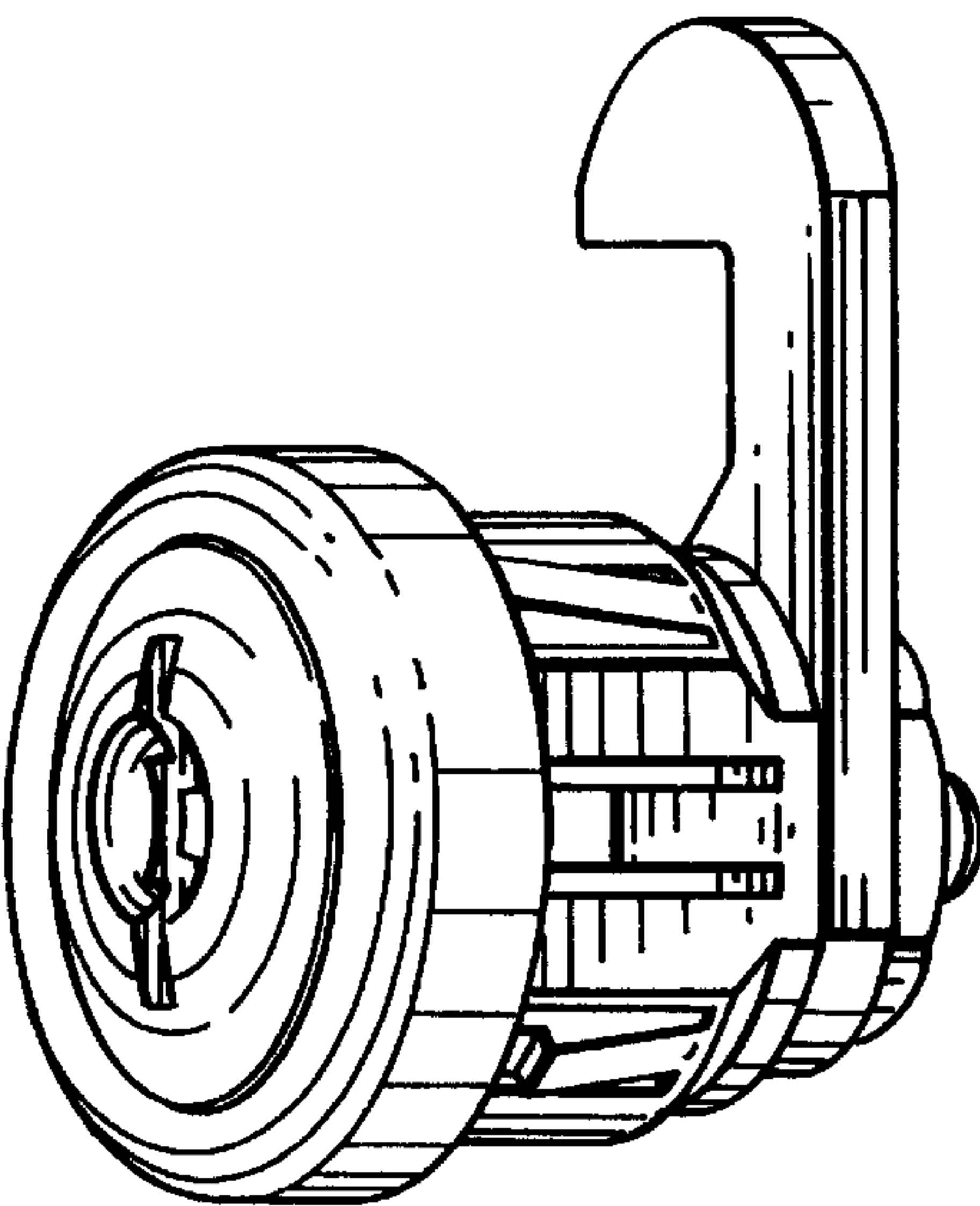

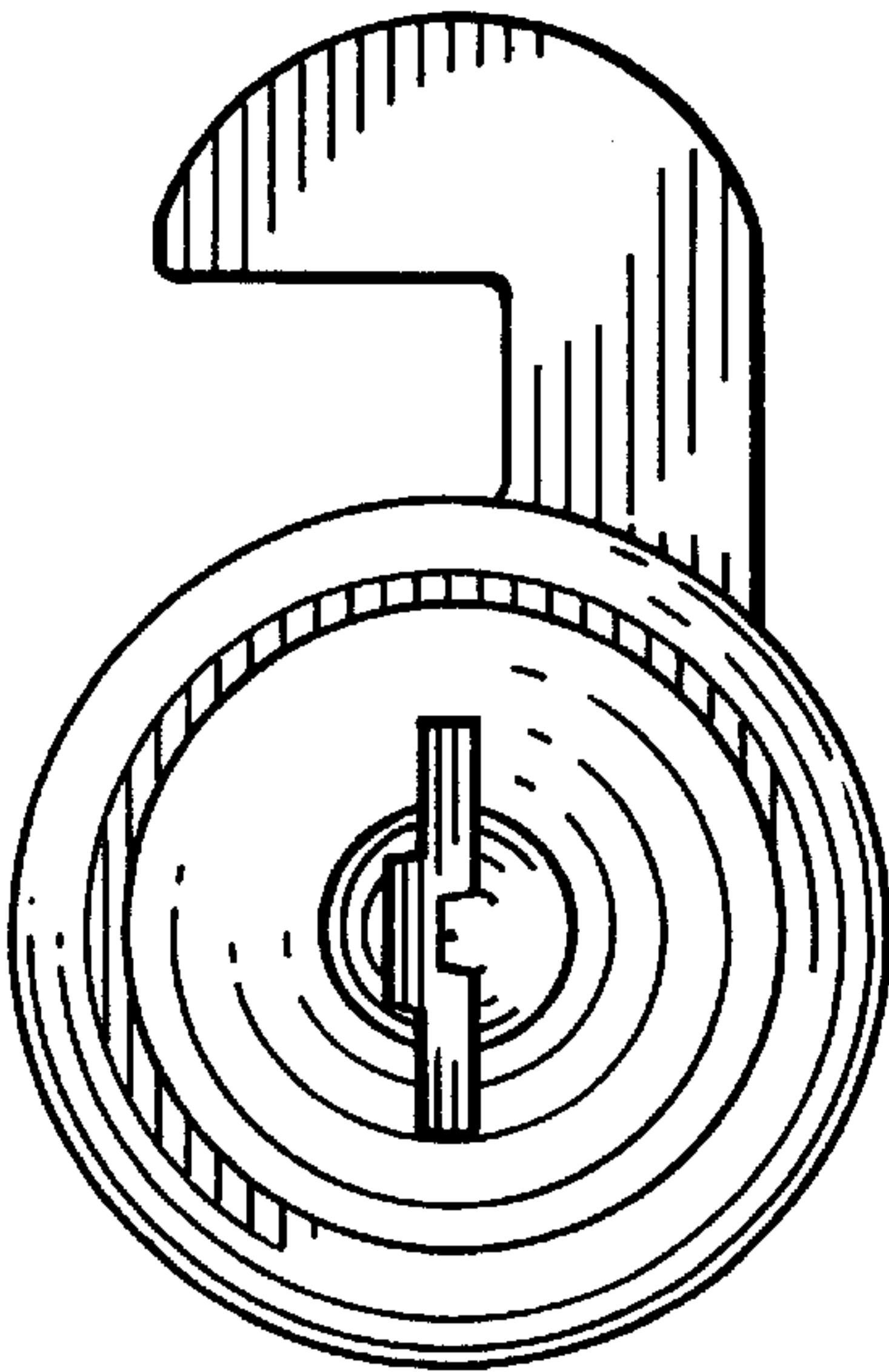

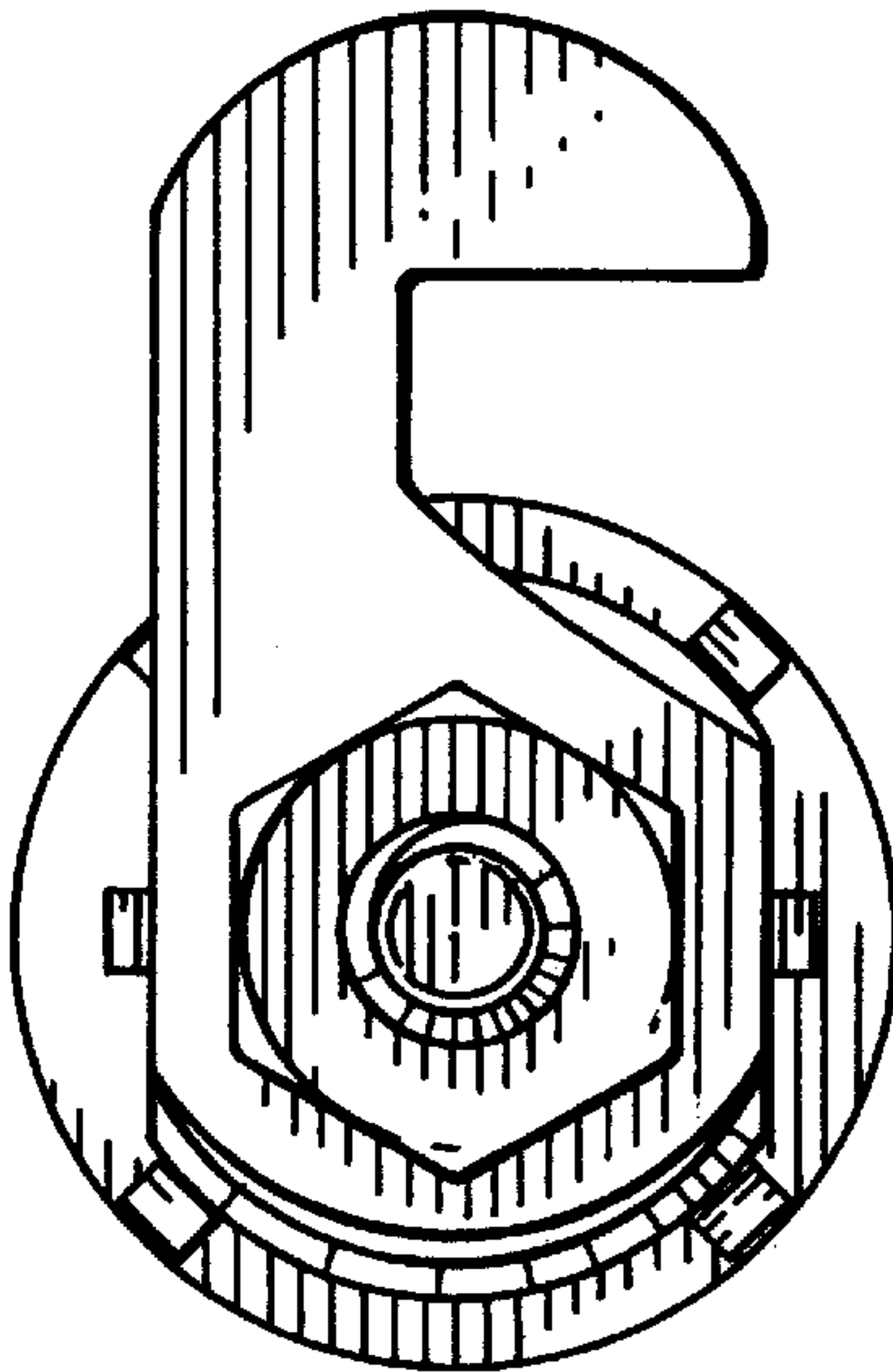

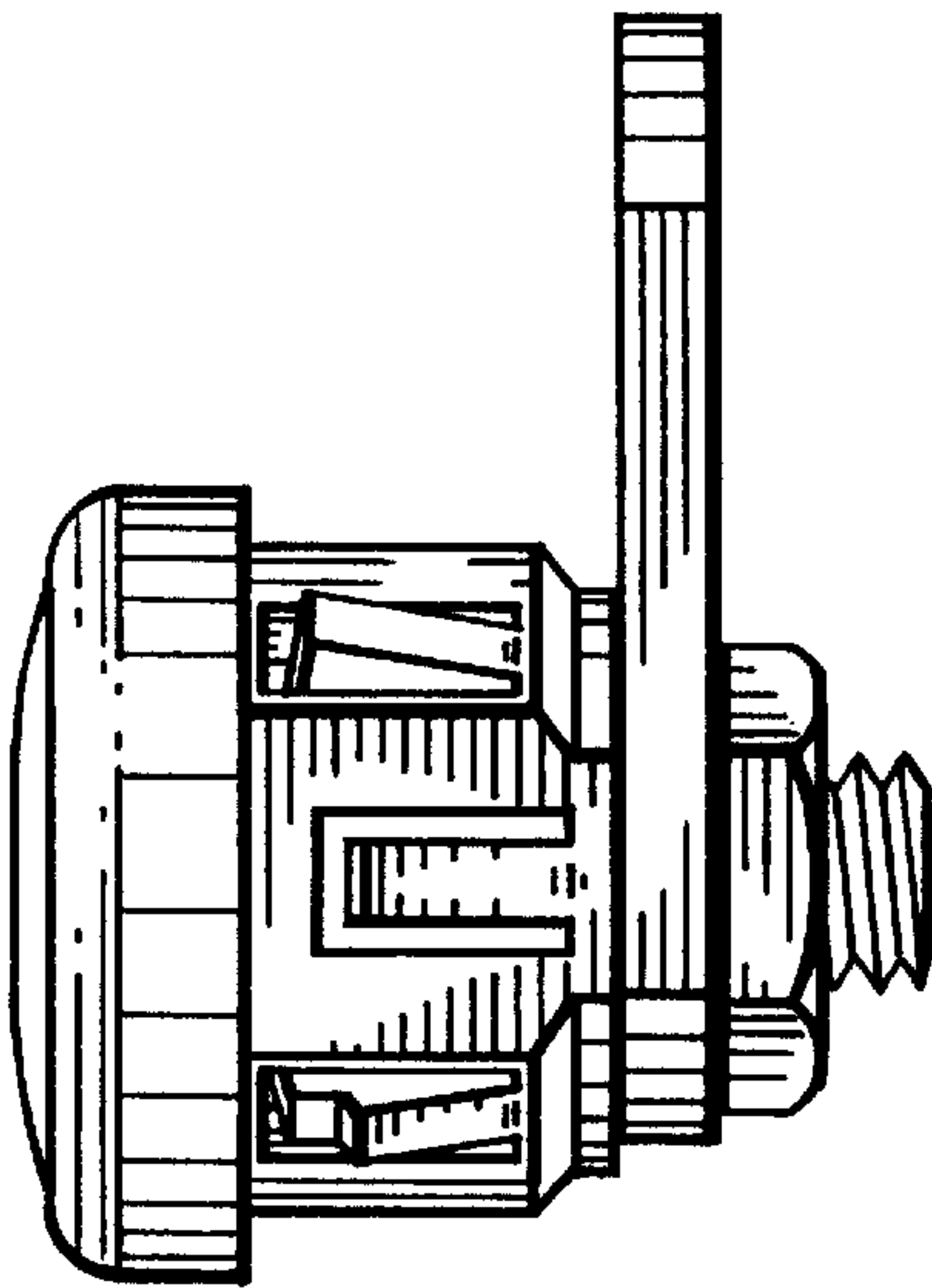

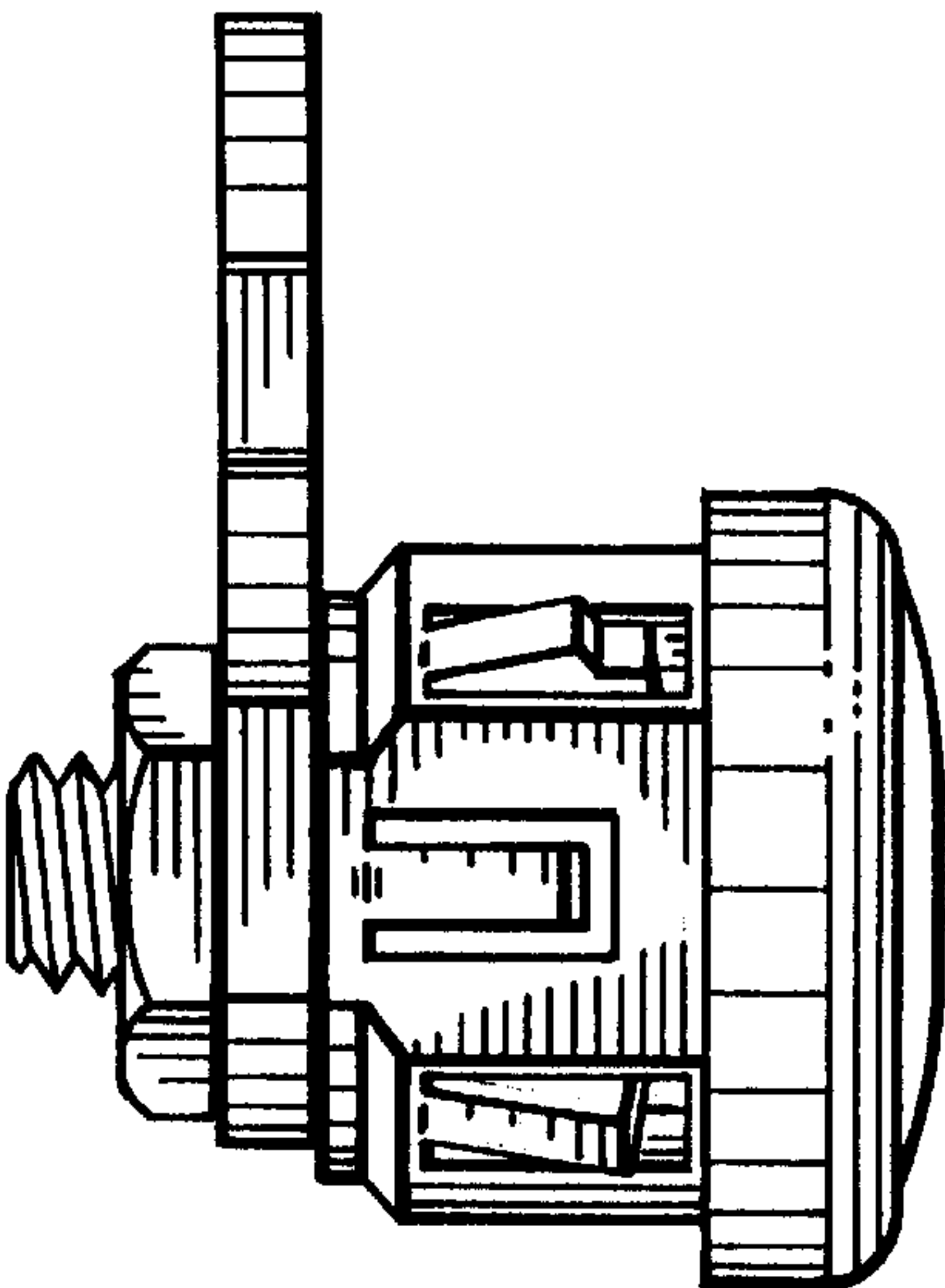

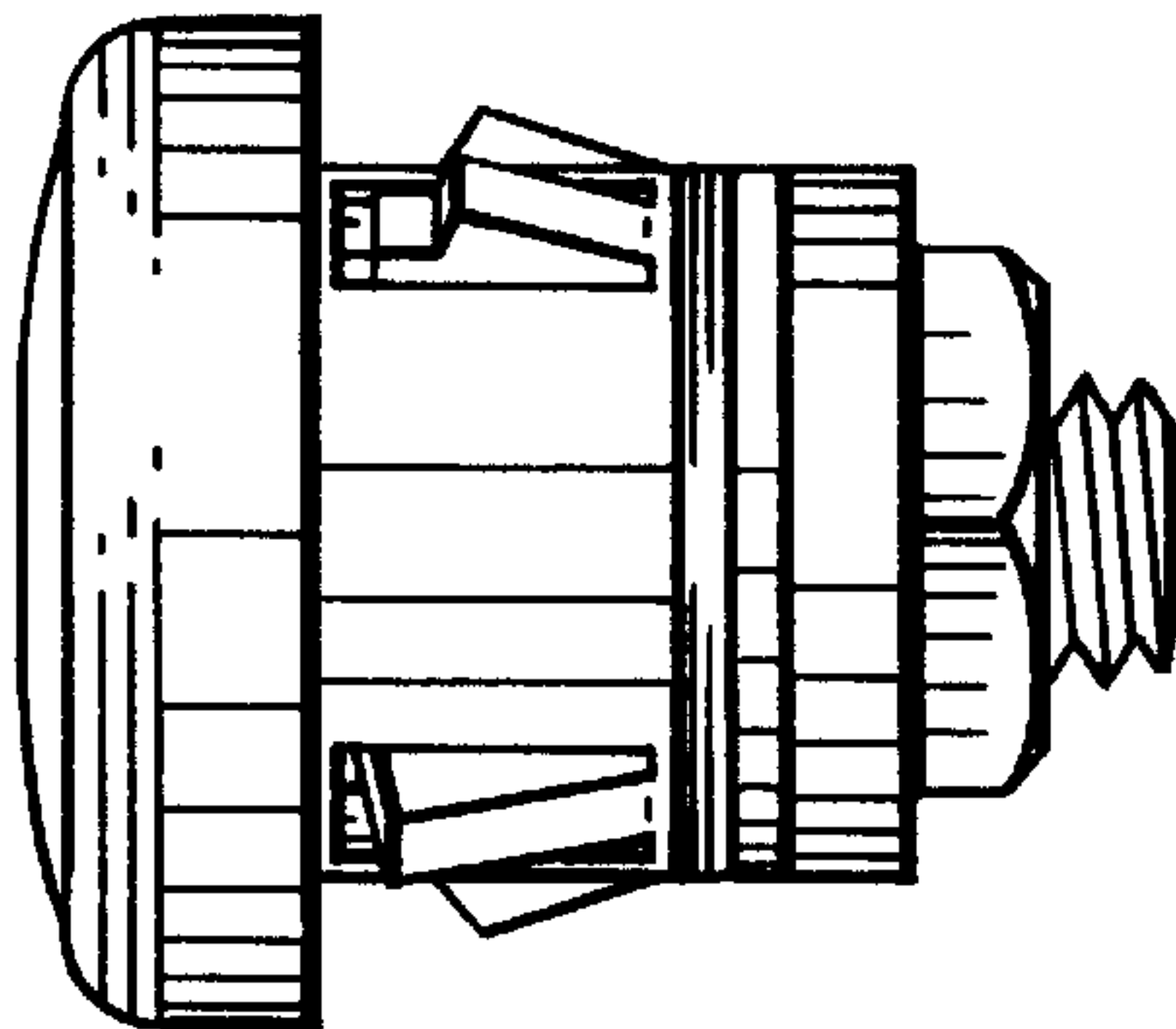

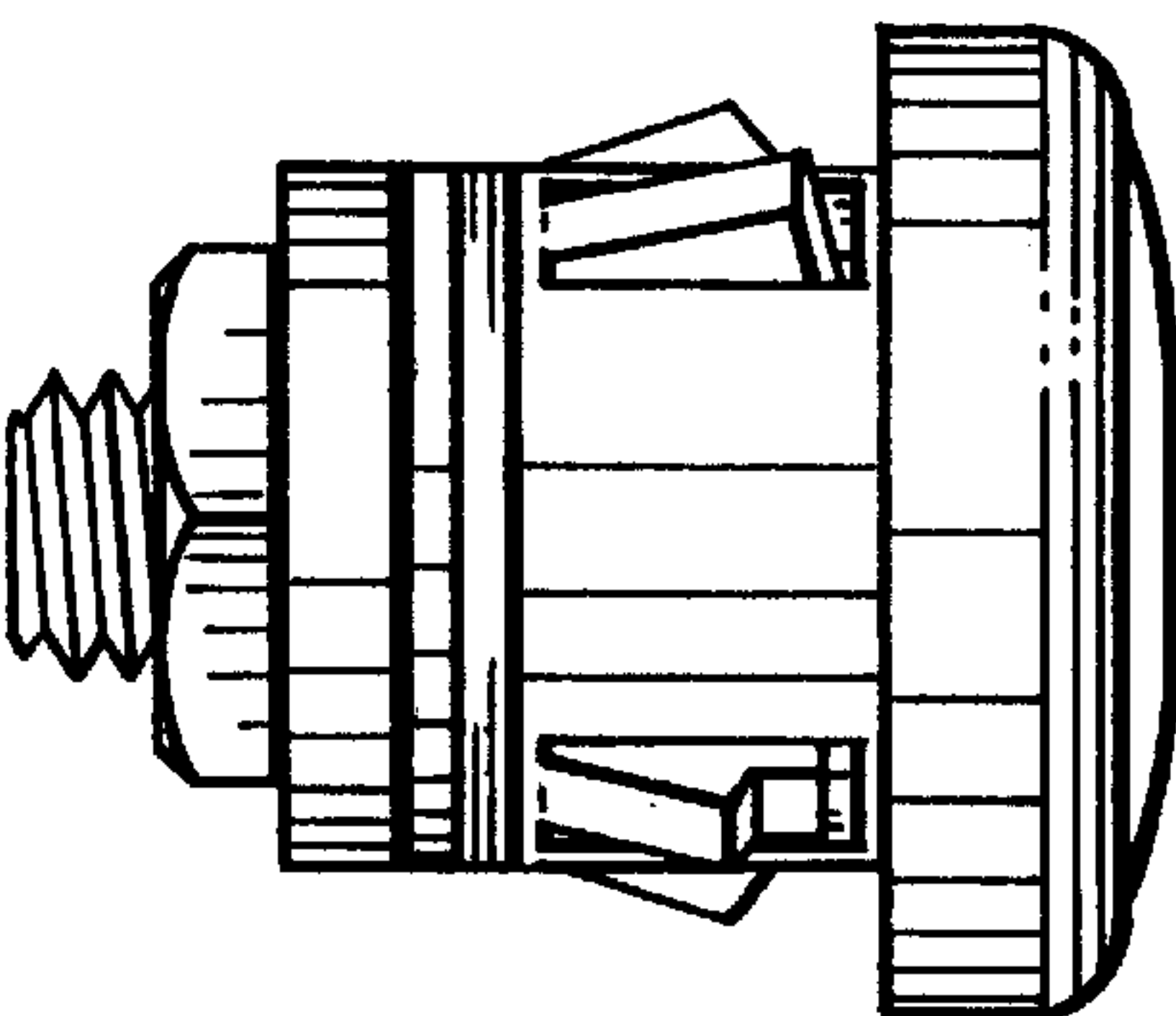
