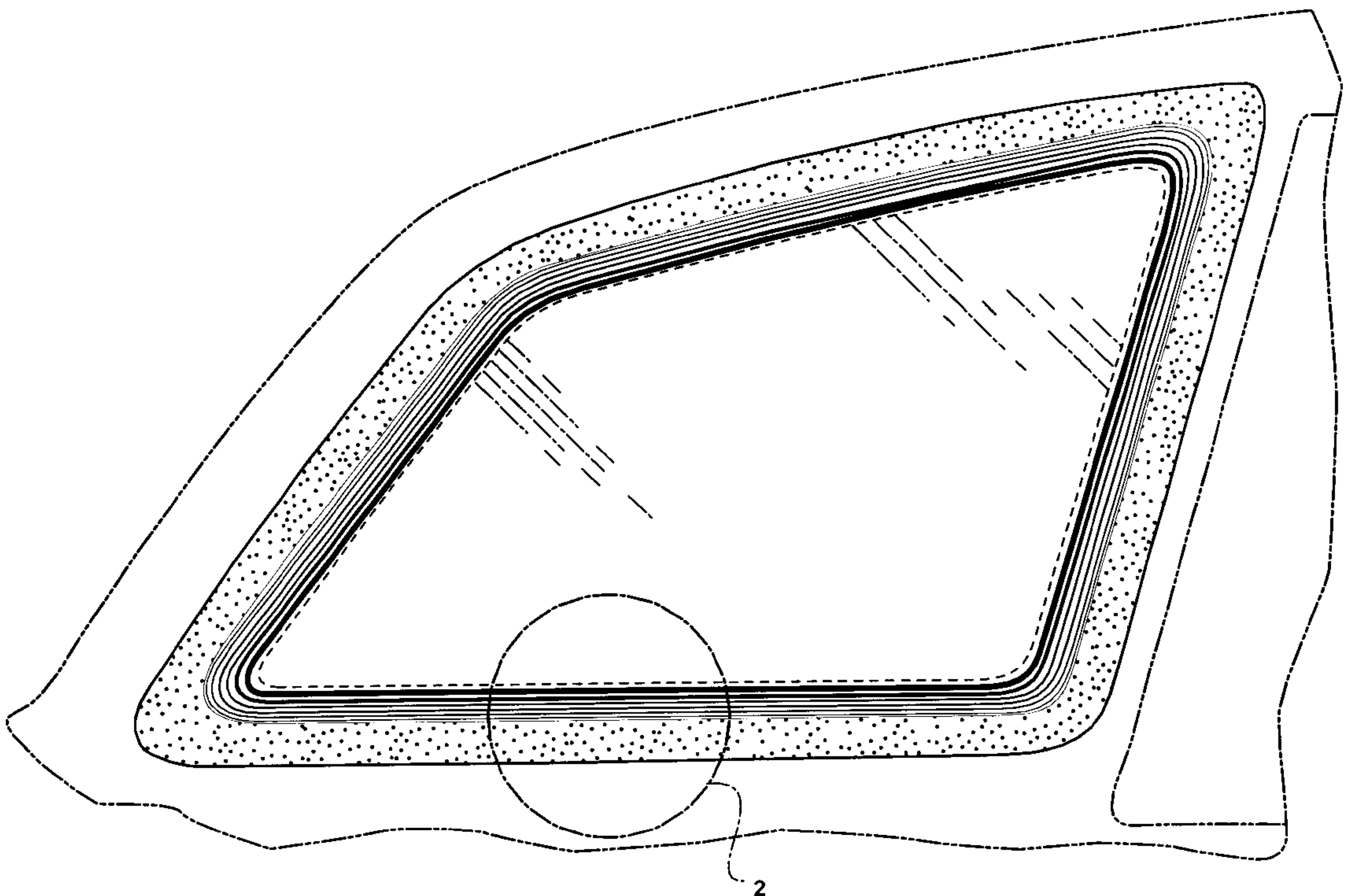
The ornamental design for an automotive window glazing border, as shown and described.

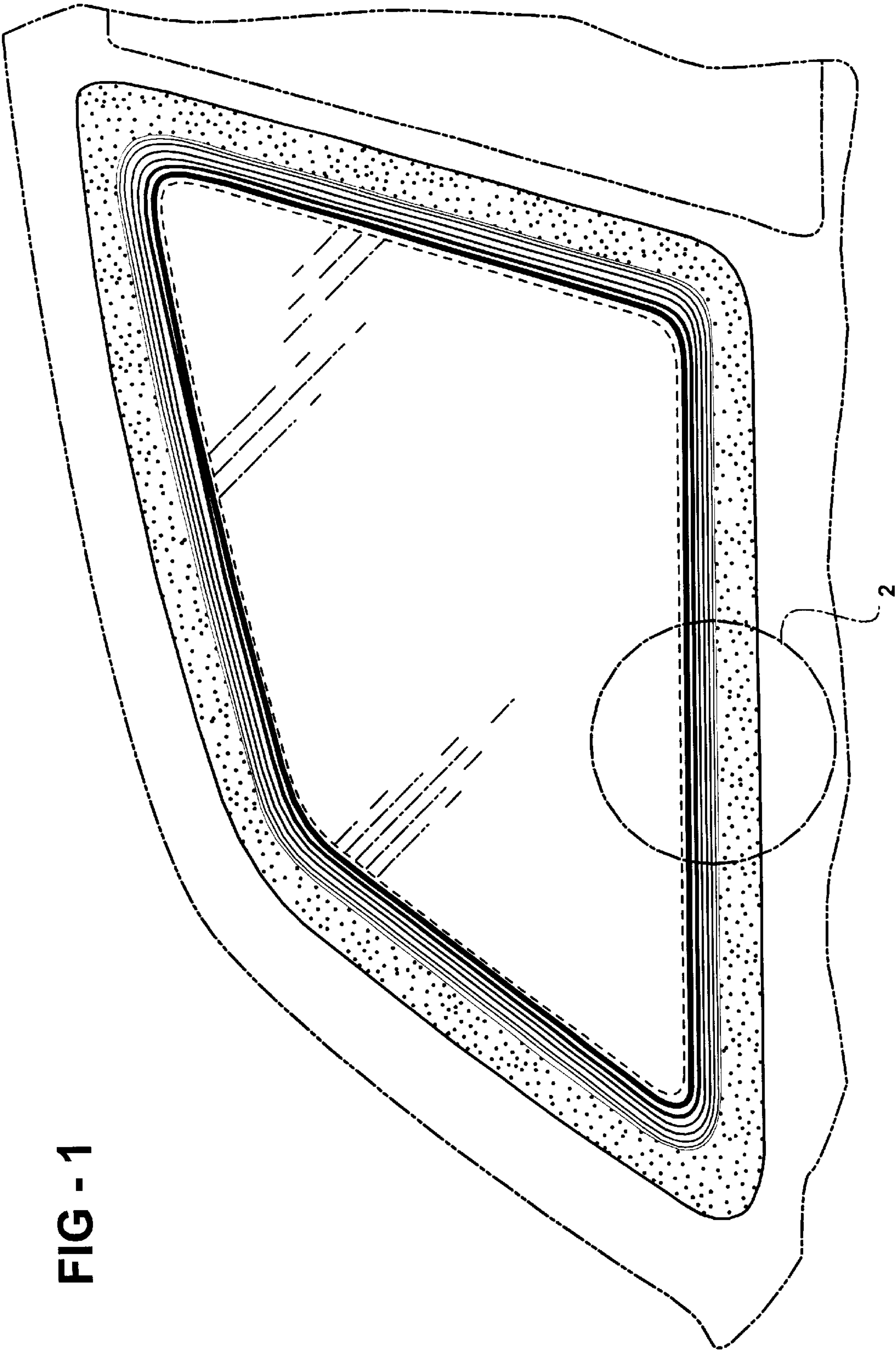
