DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

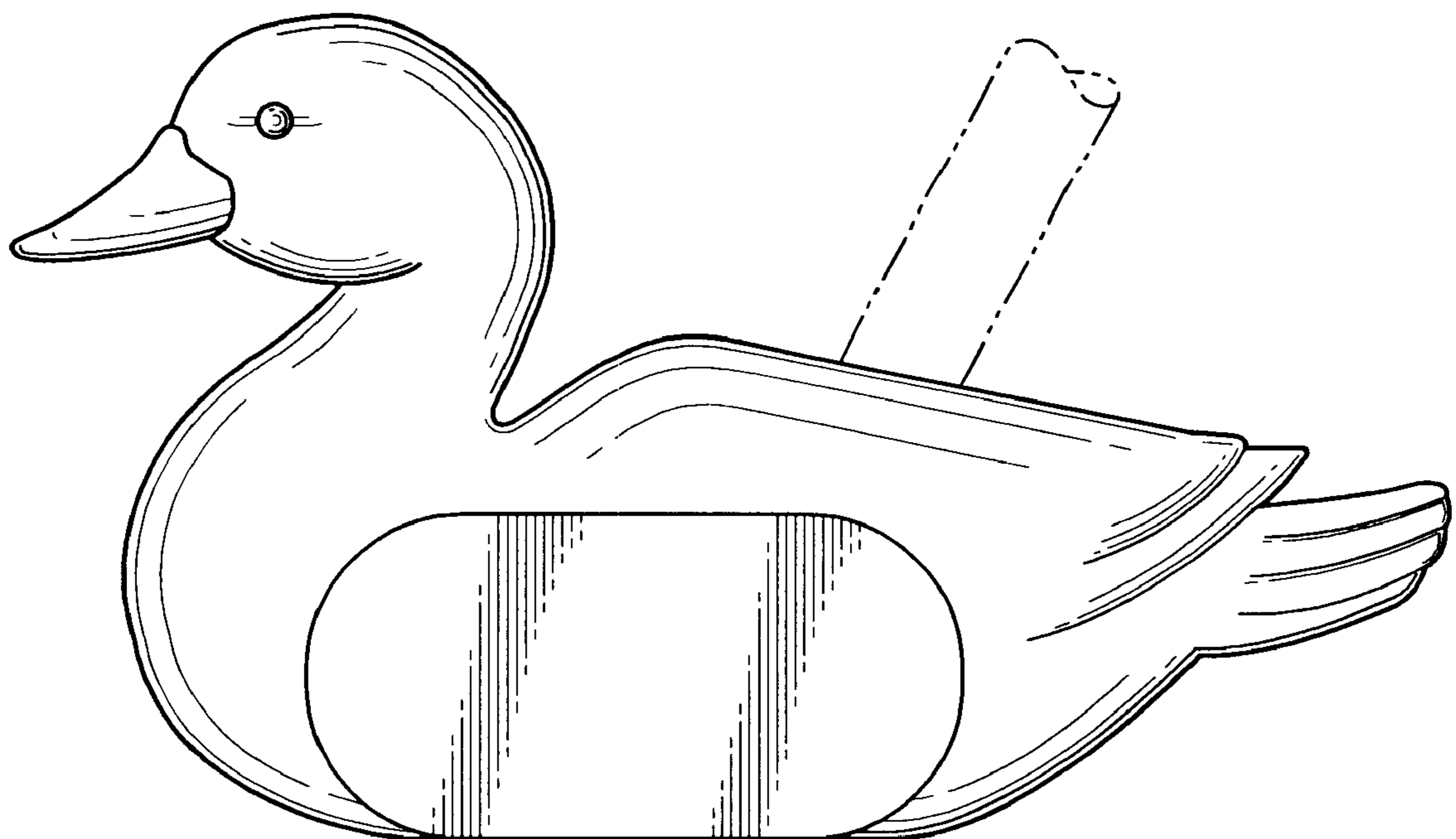
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

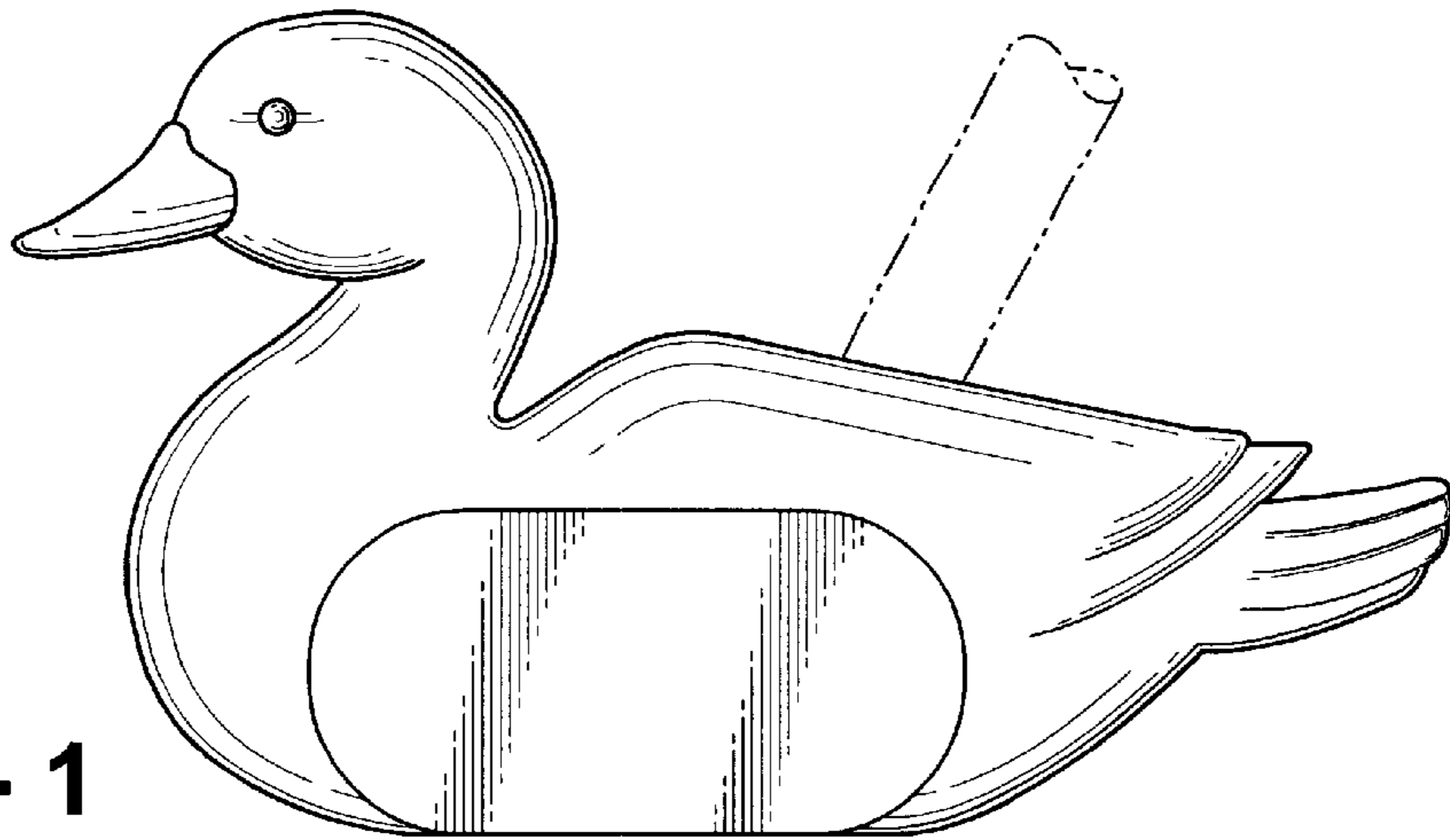

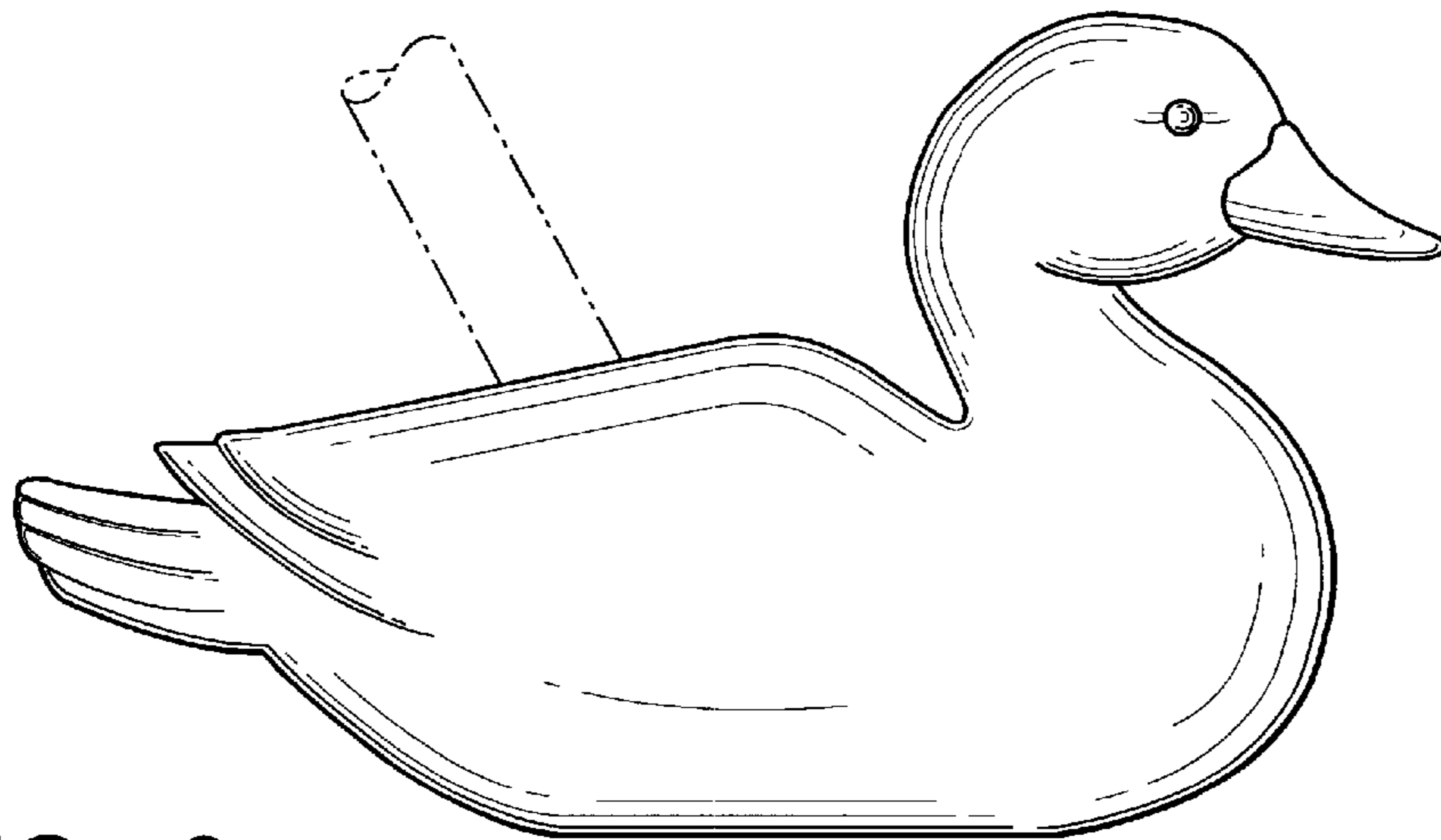

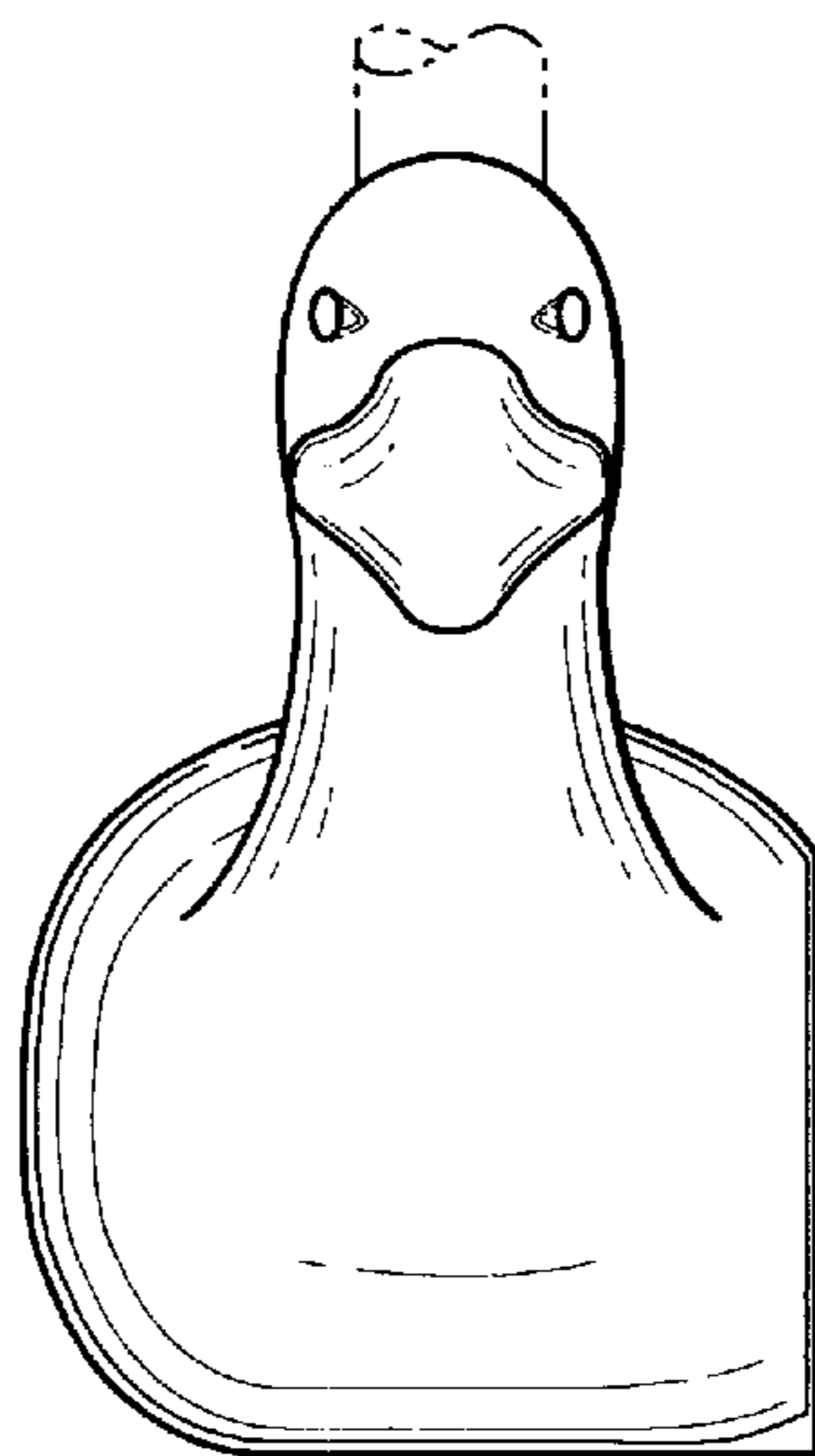

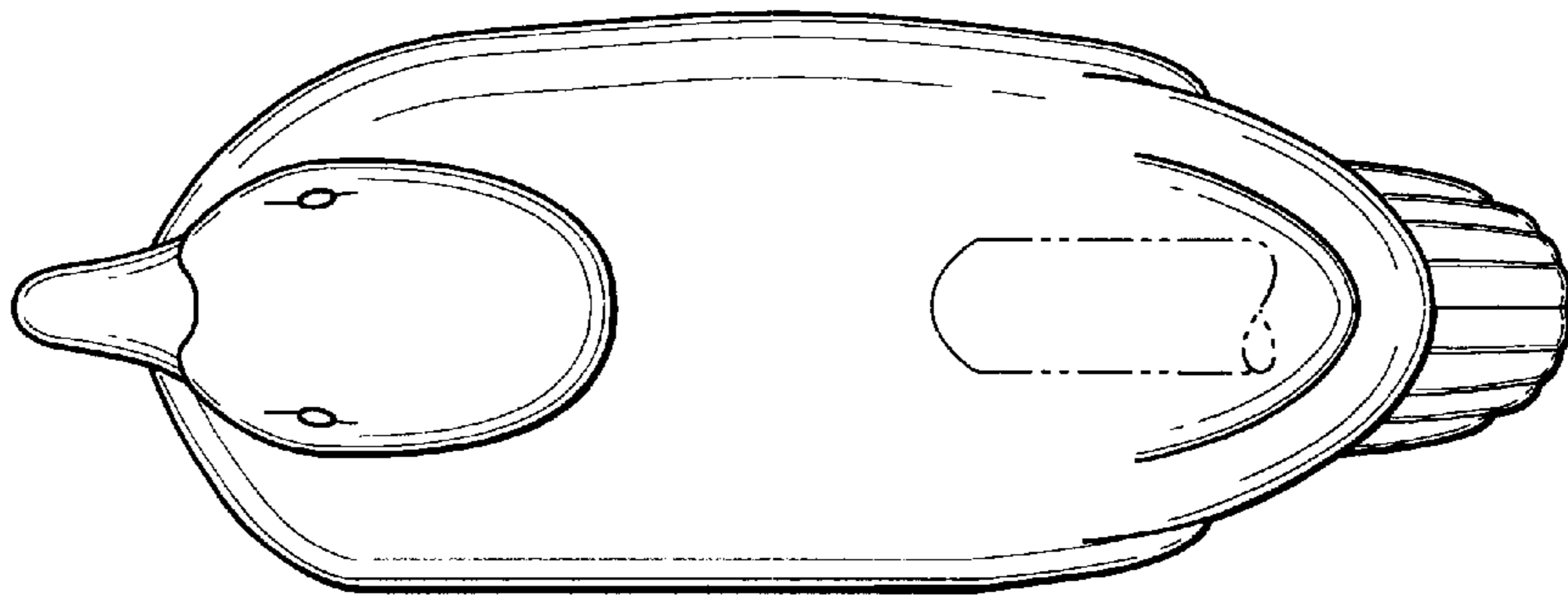

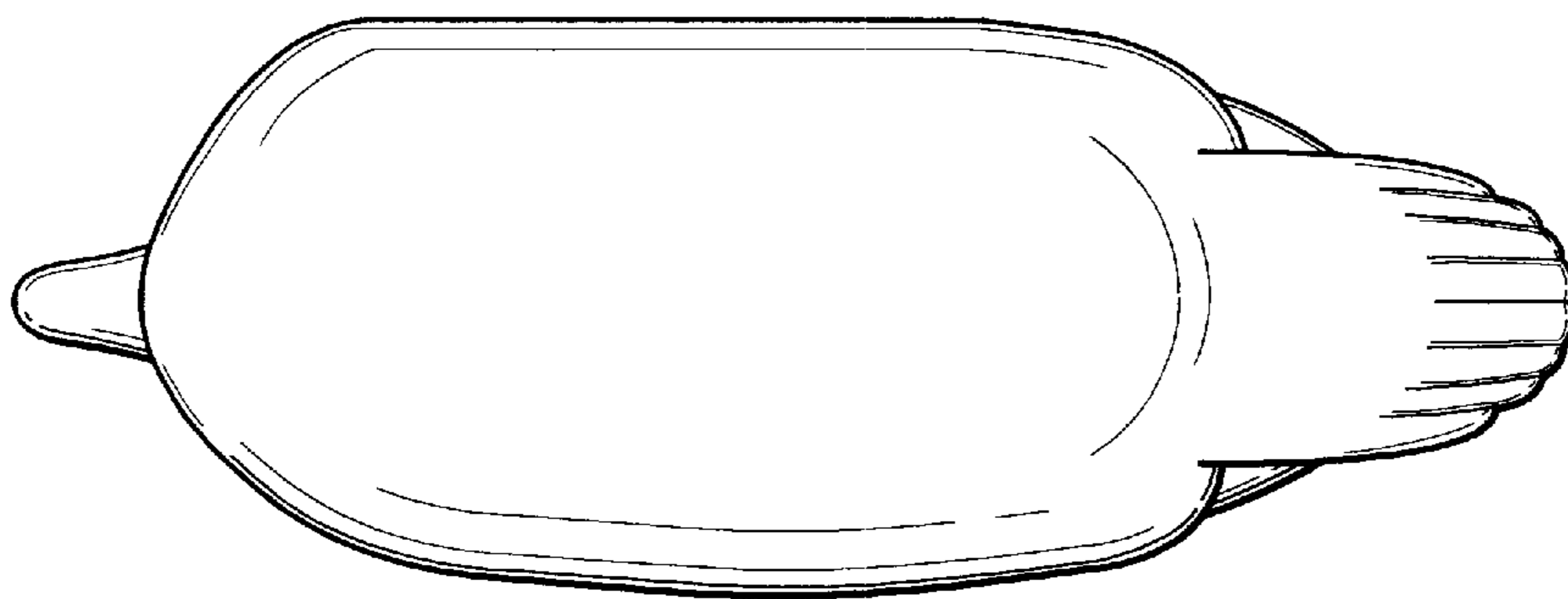
