FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

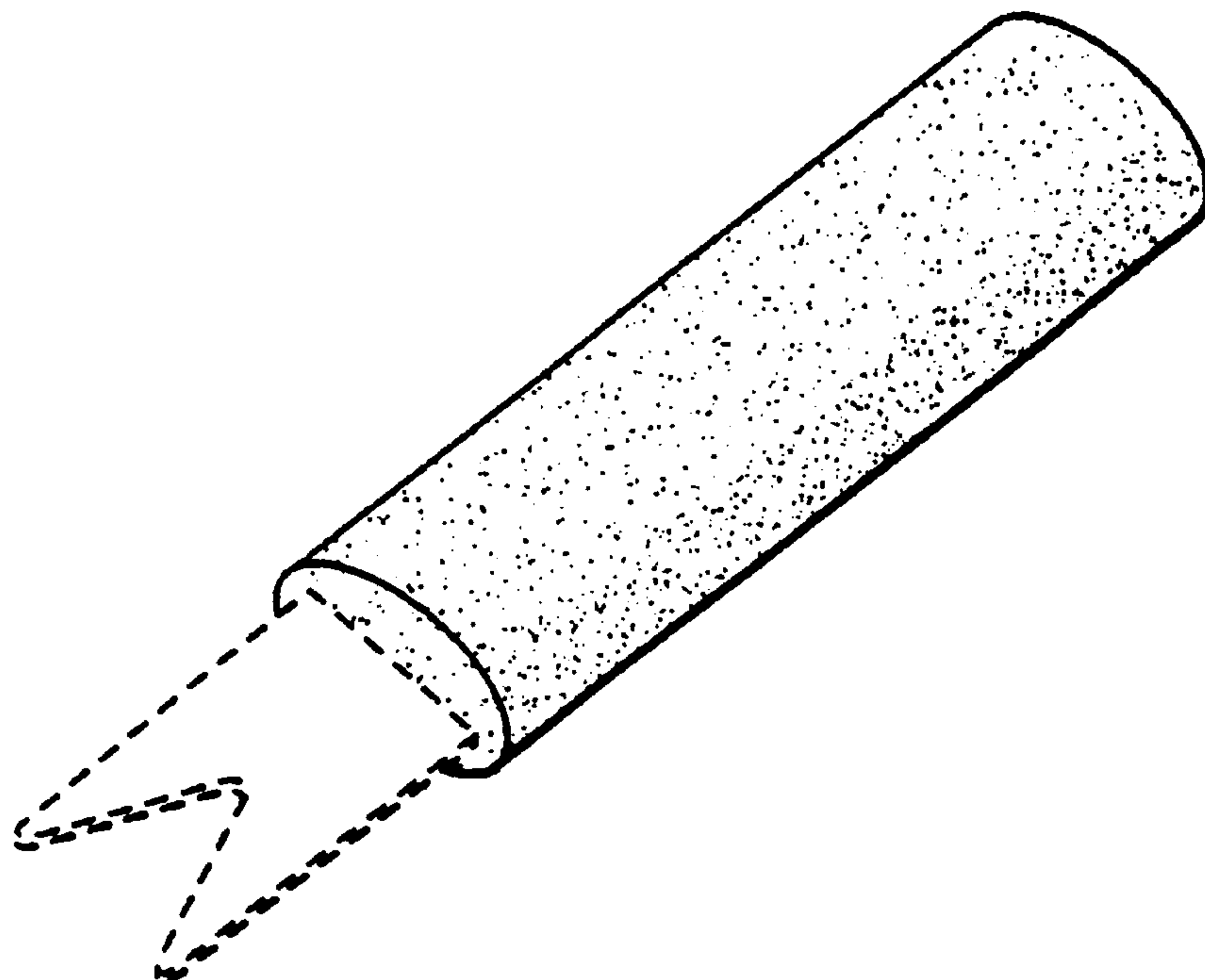
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

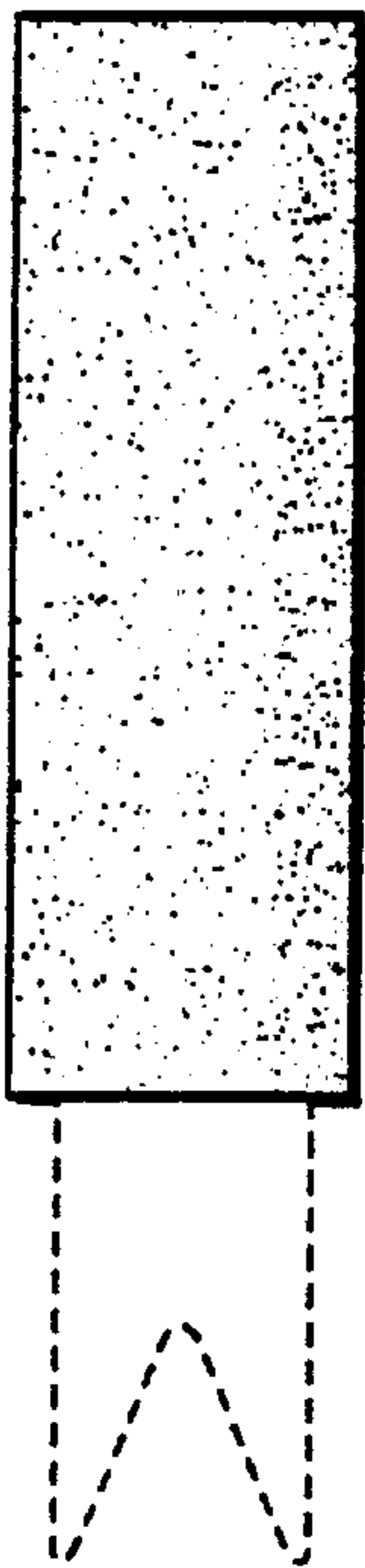

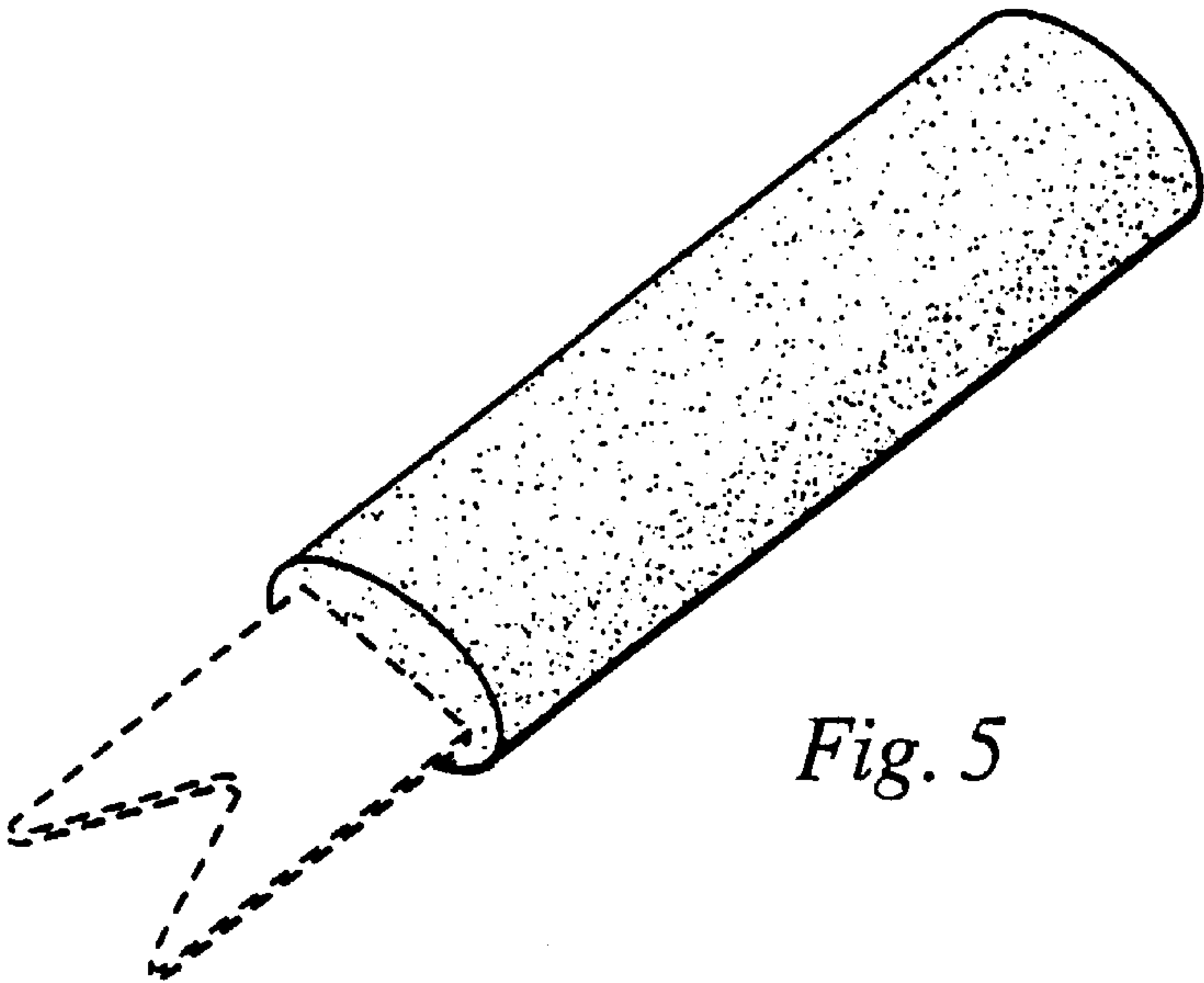
