DESCRIPTION

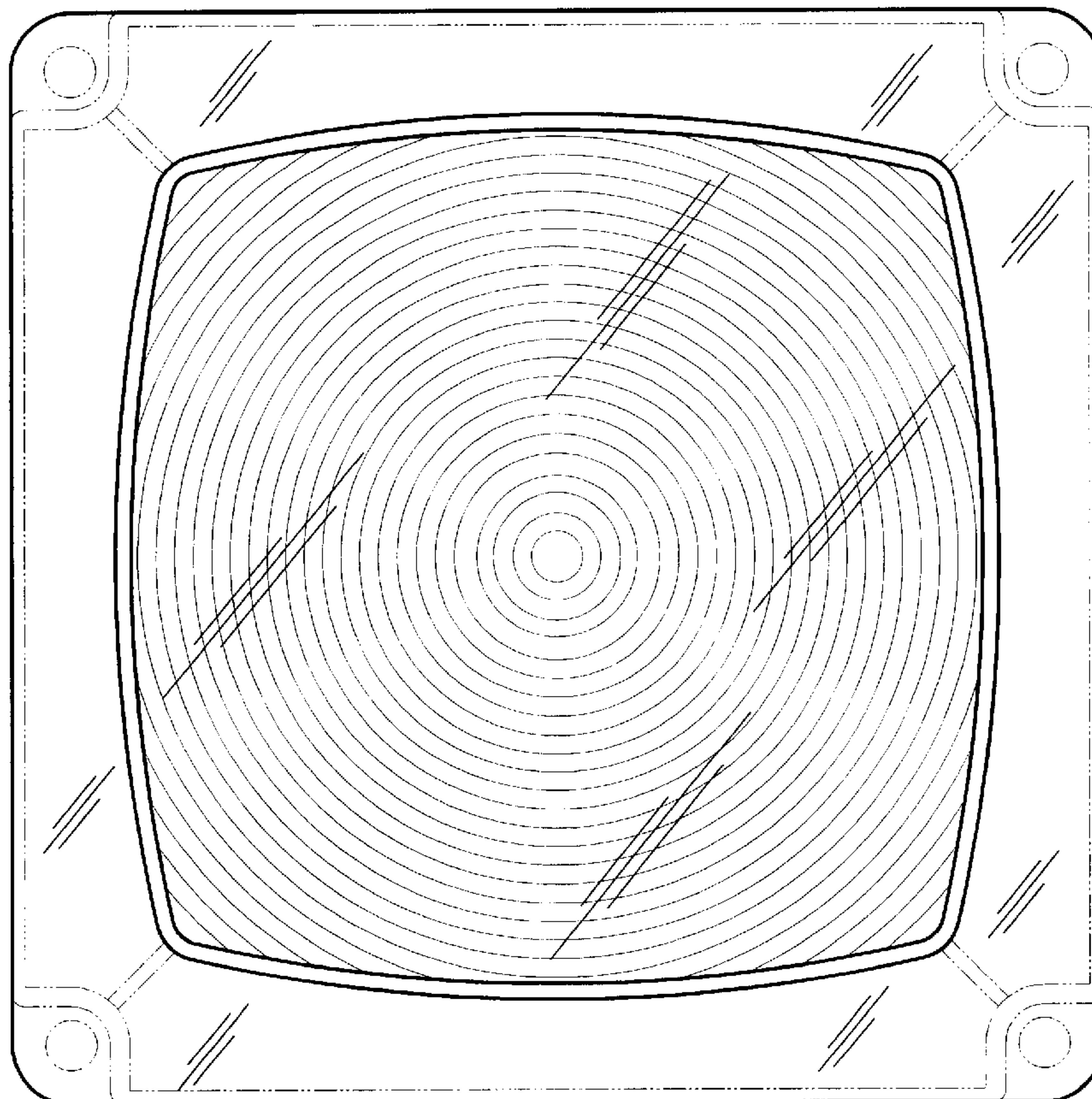
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a trailer lamp lens showing my new design;

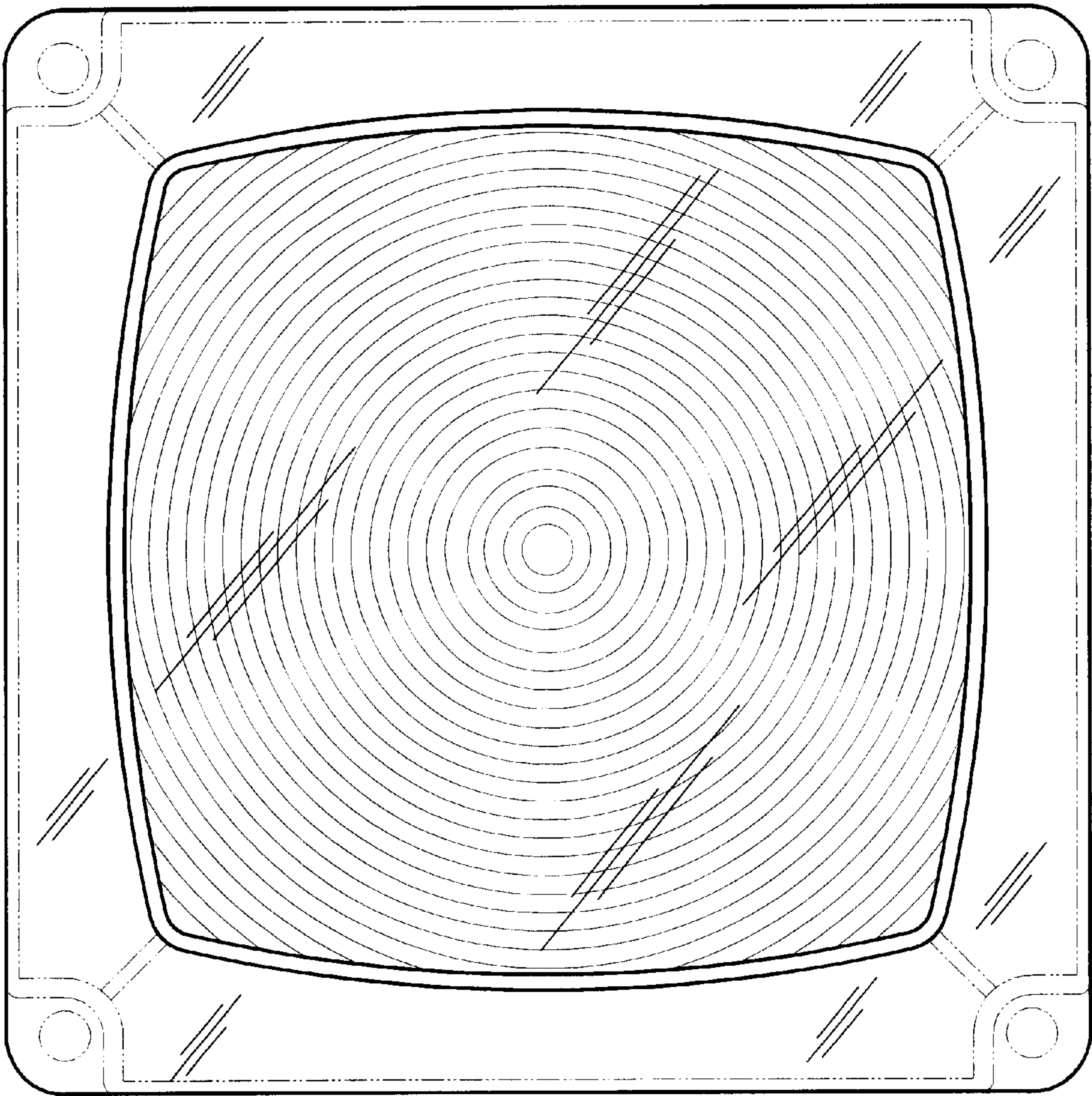

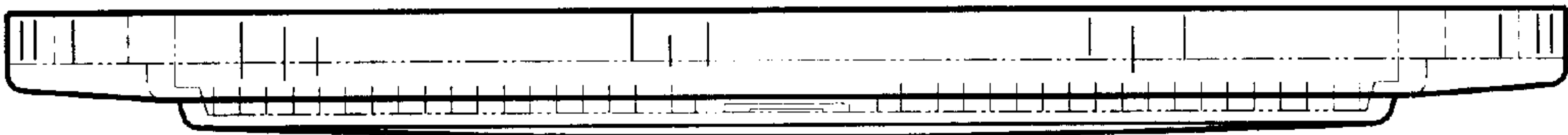

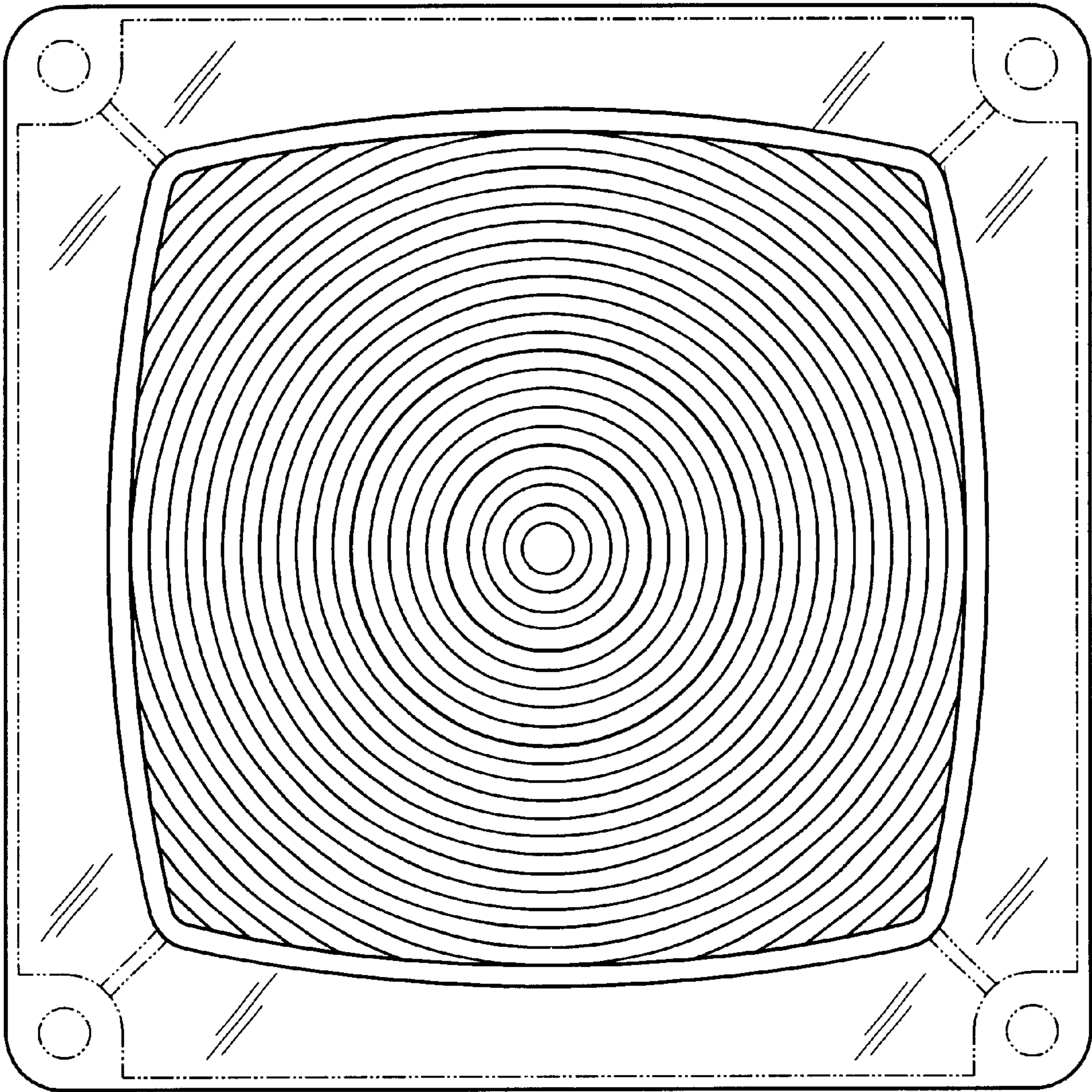
