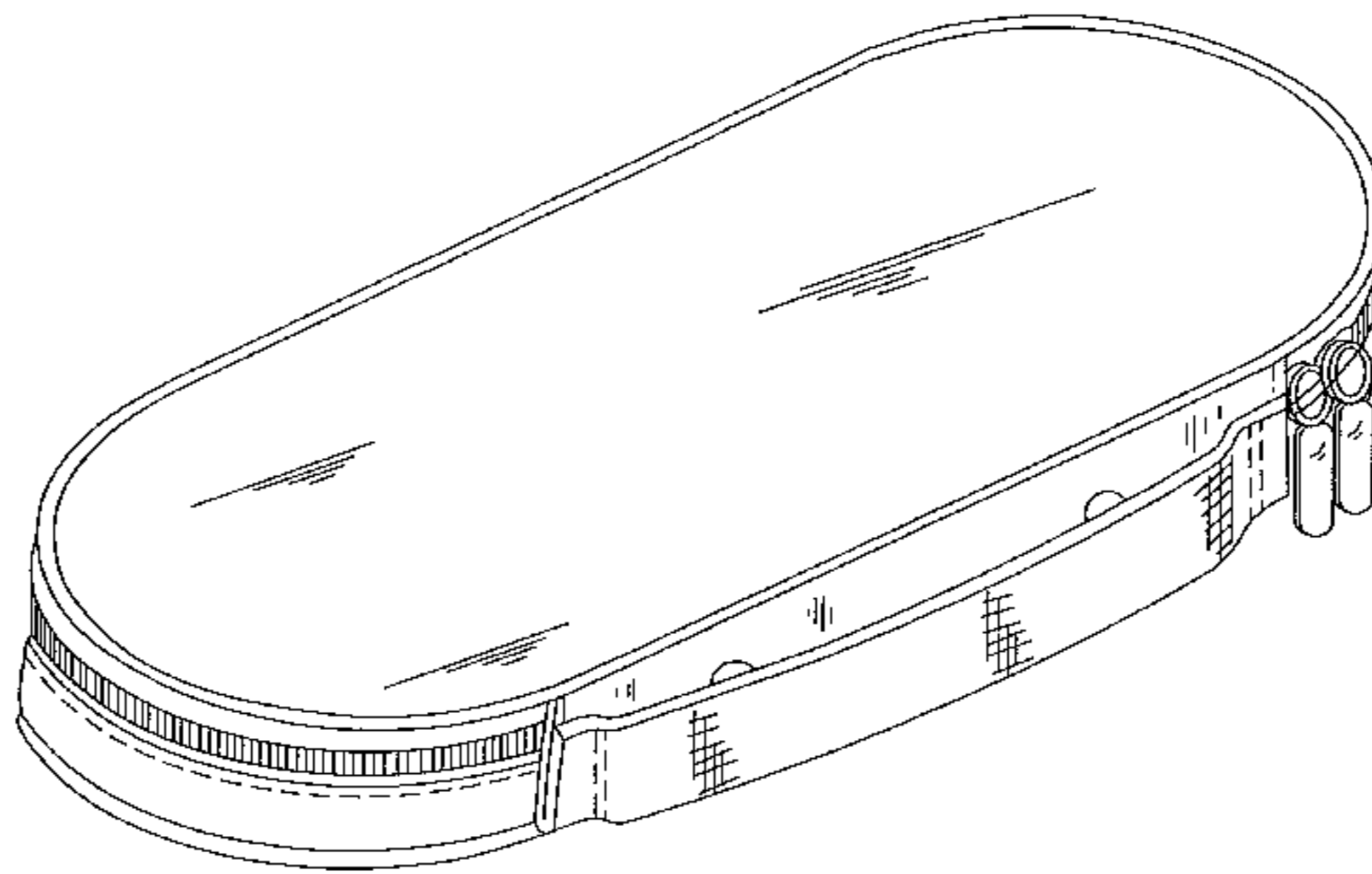
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the oblong CD case embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing the oblong CD case in an open configuration.
 The broken lines shown throughout the views are understood to represent stitching.

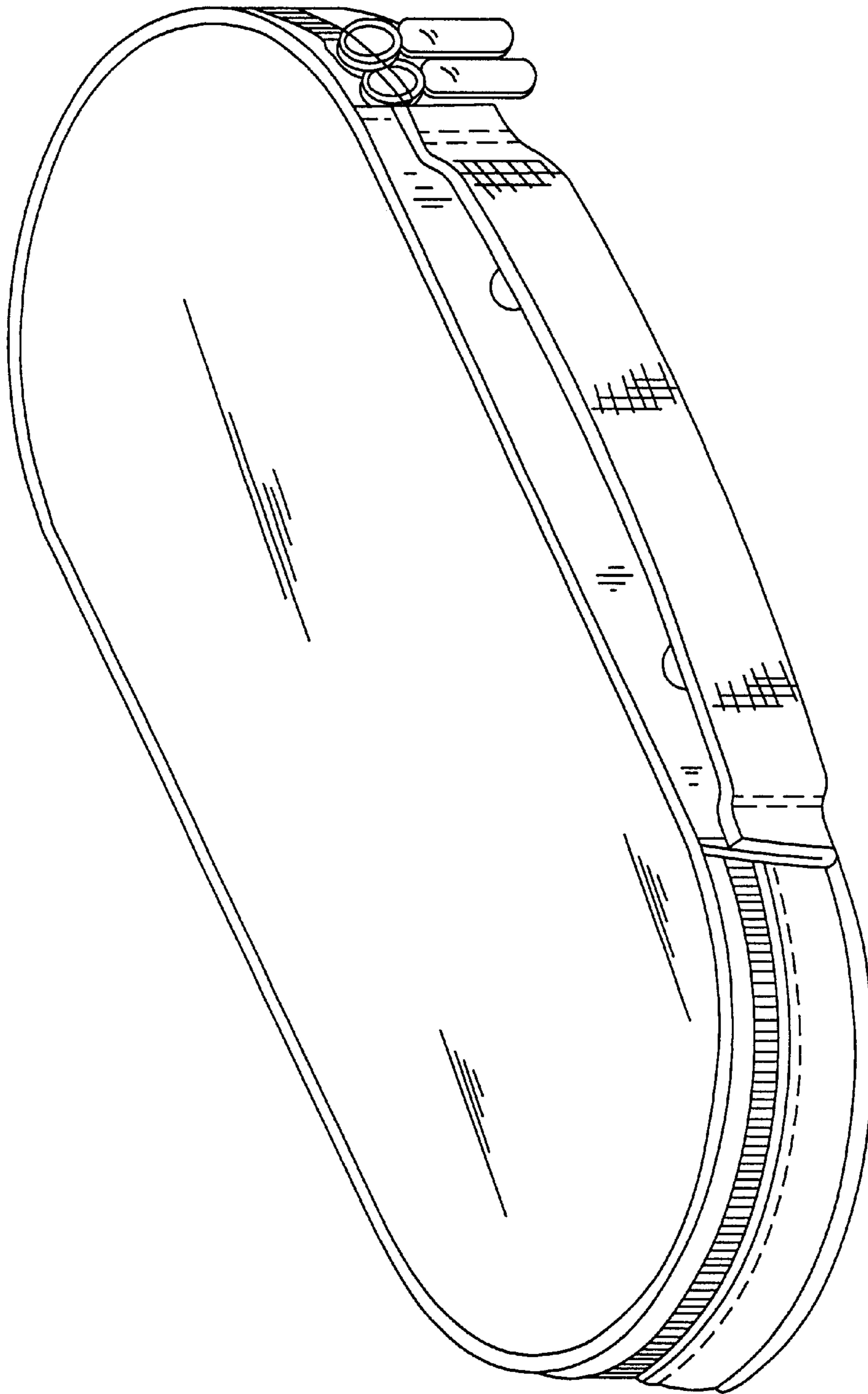

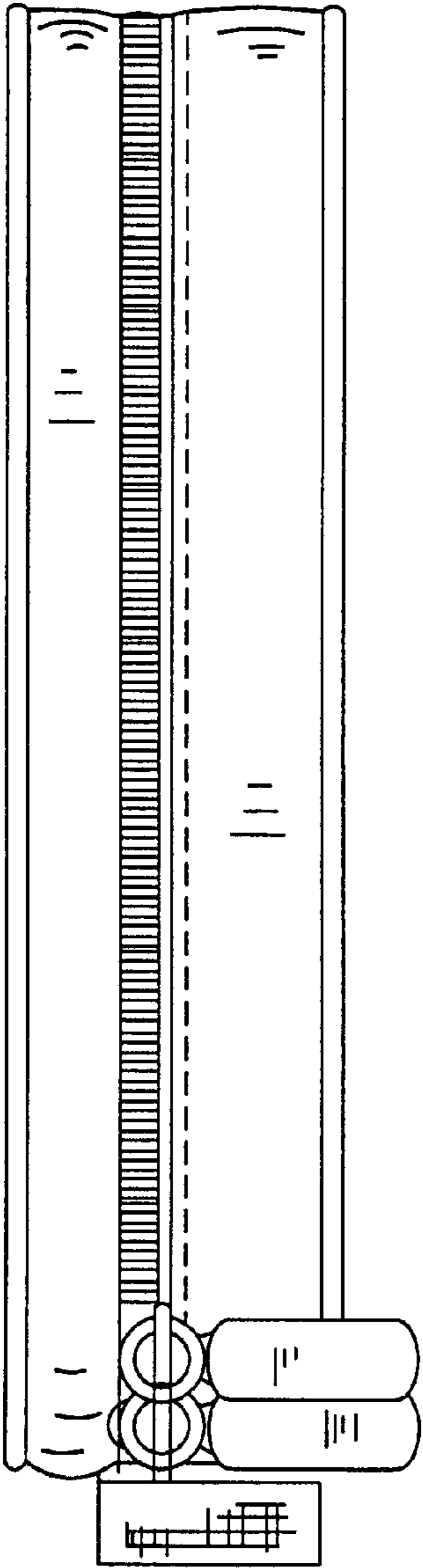

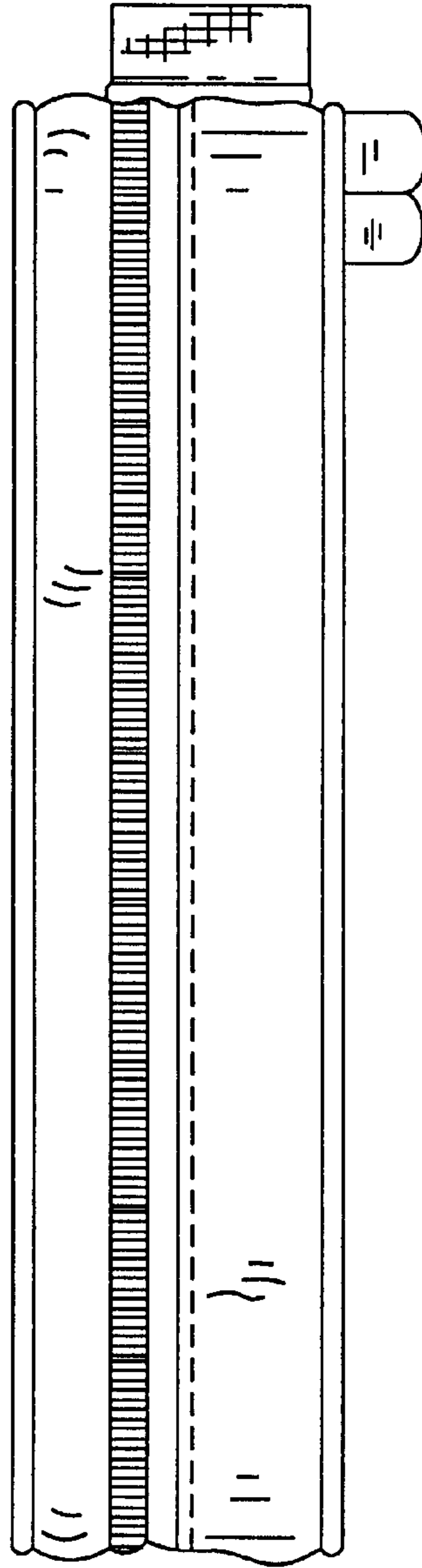

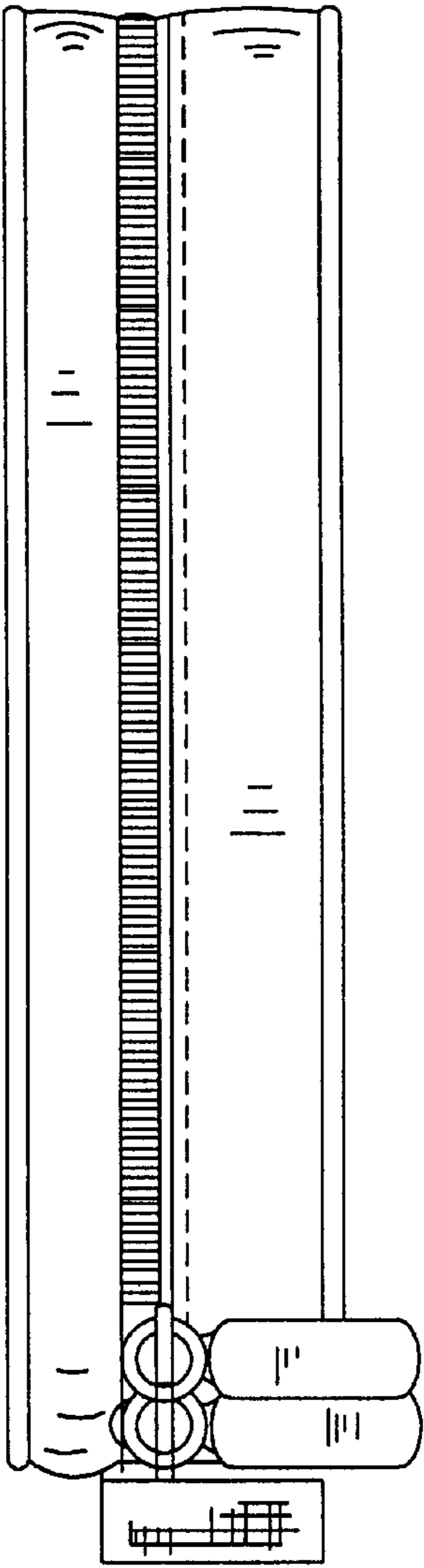

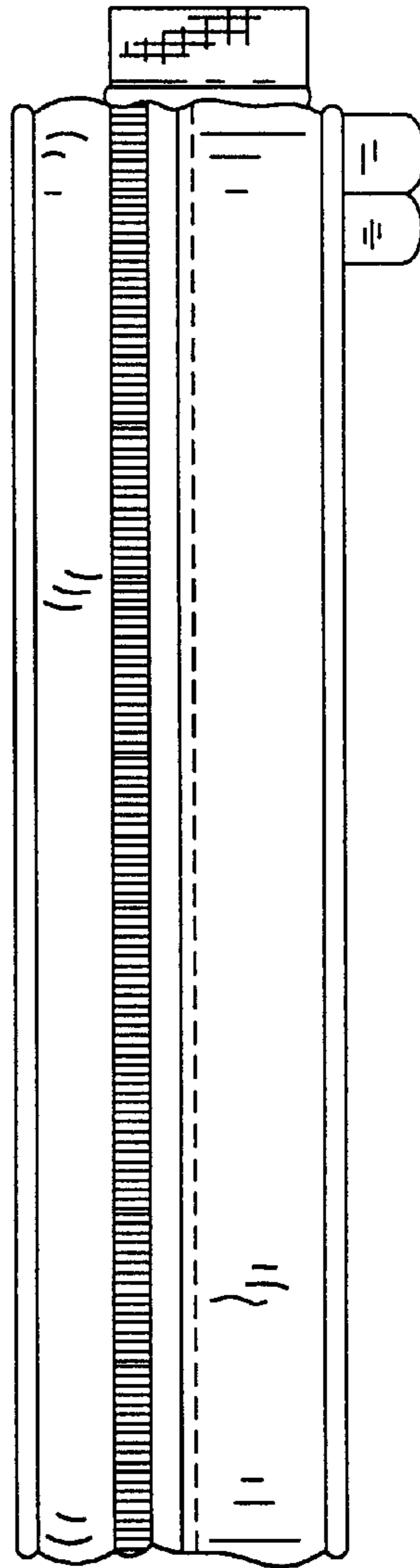

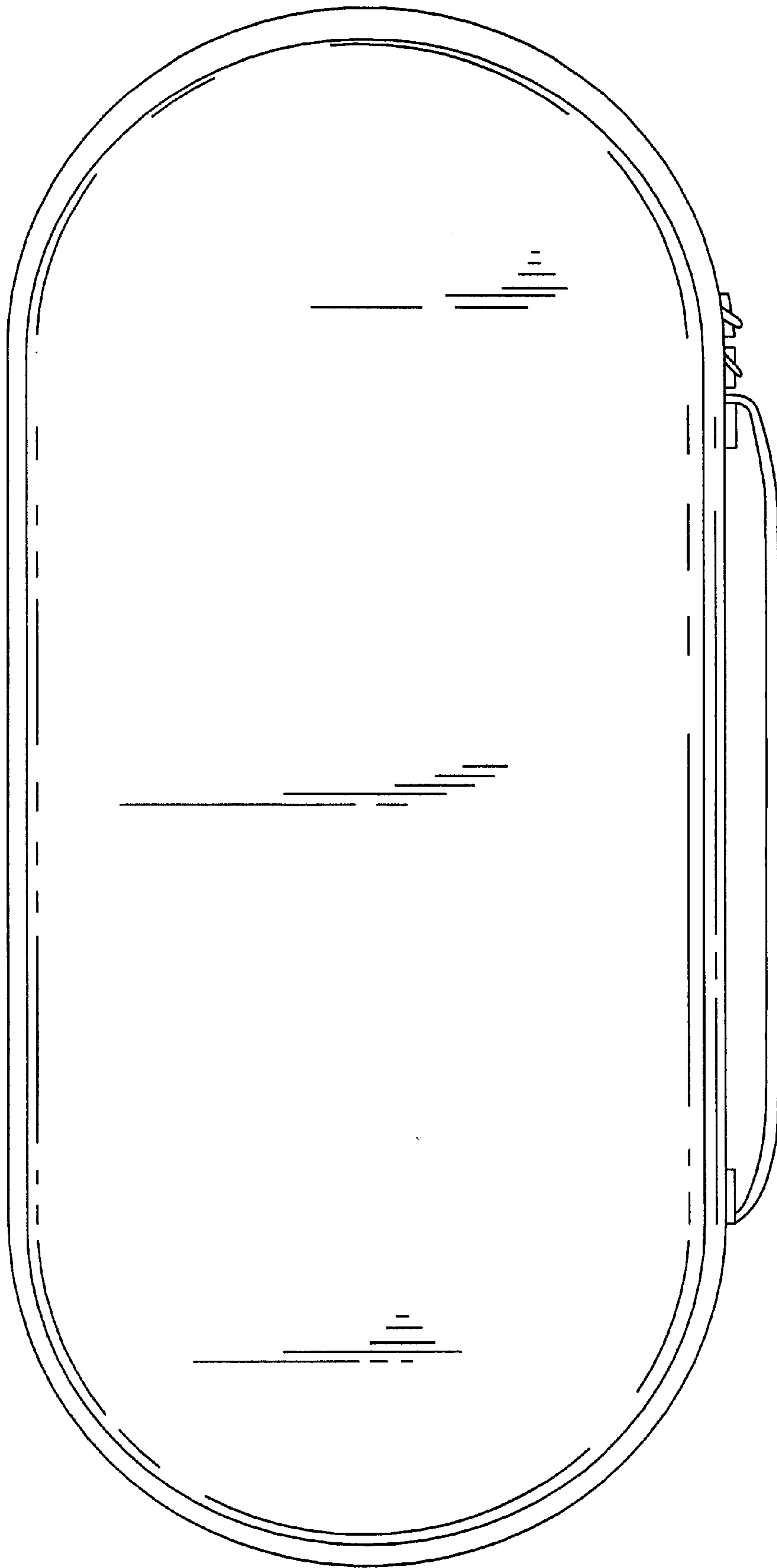

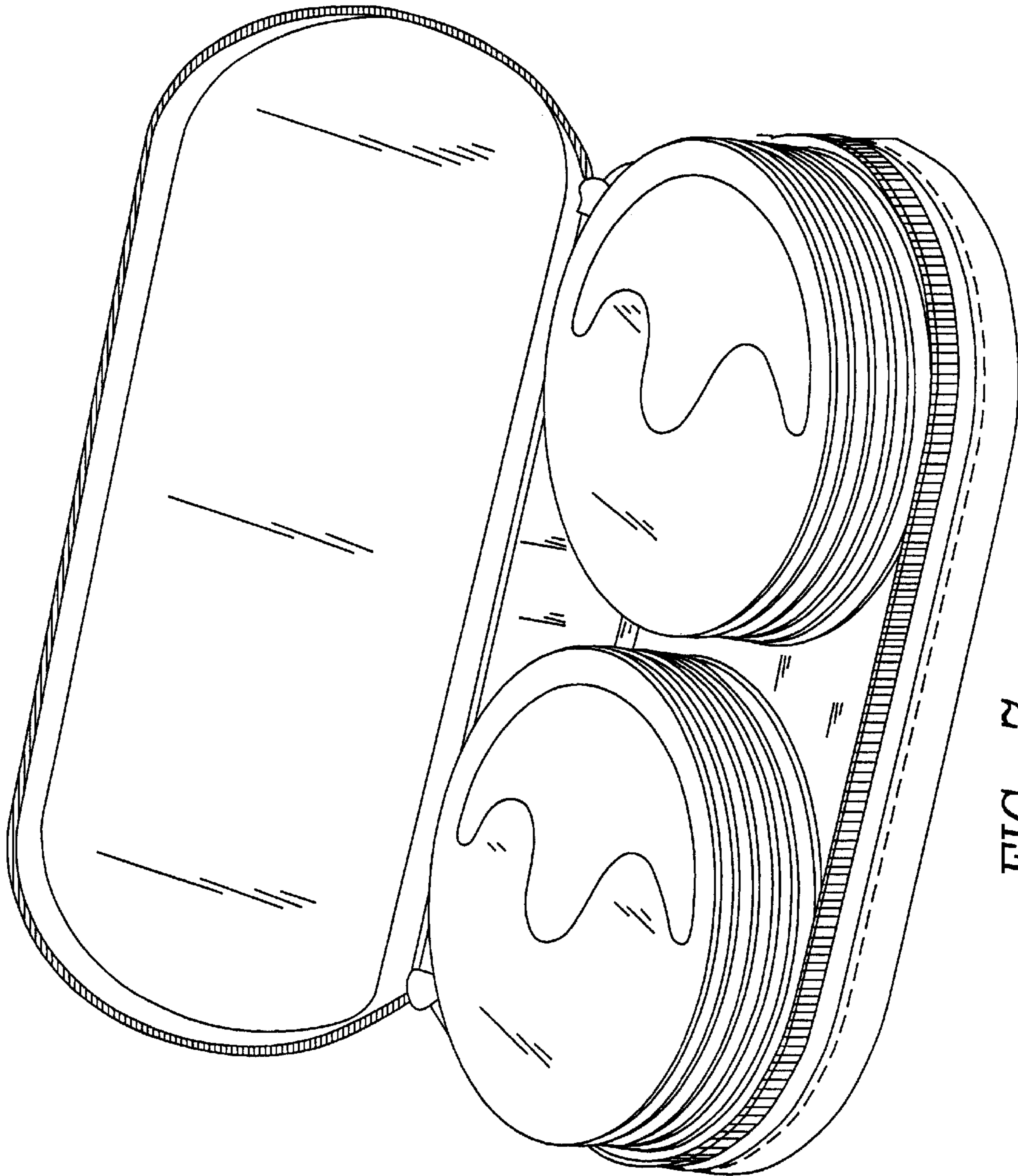
