DESCRIPTION

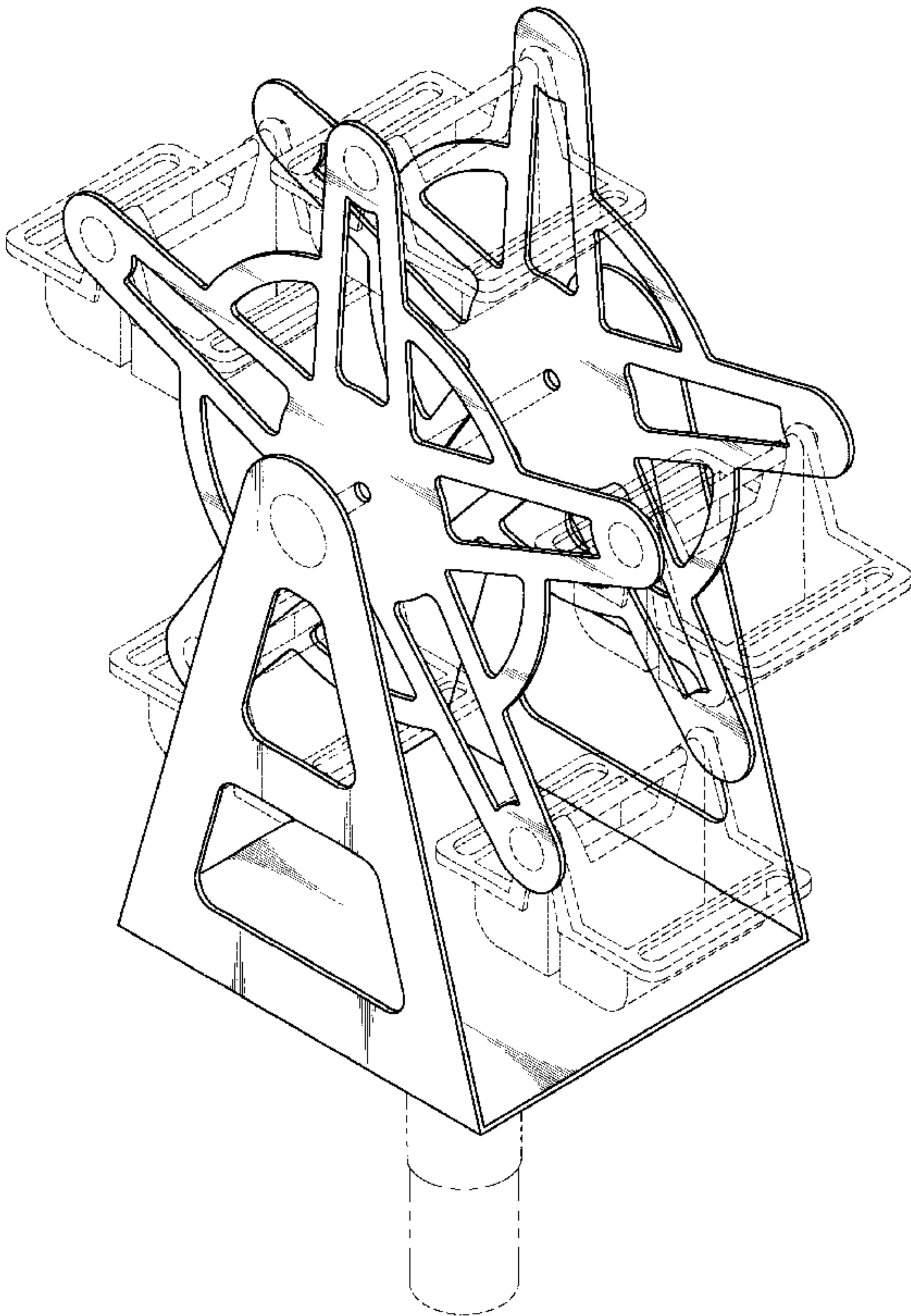
FIG. 1. is a perspective view of a rotatable bird feeder-planter showing our new design, the broken lines shown are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

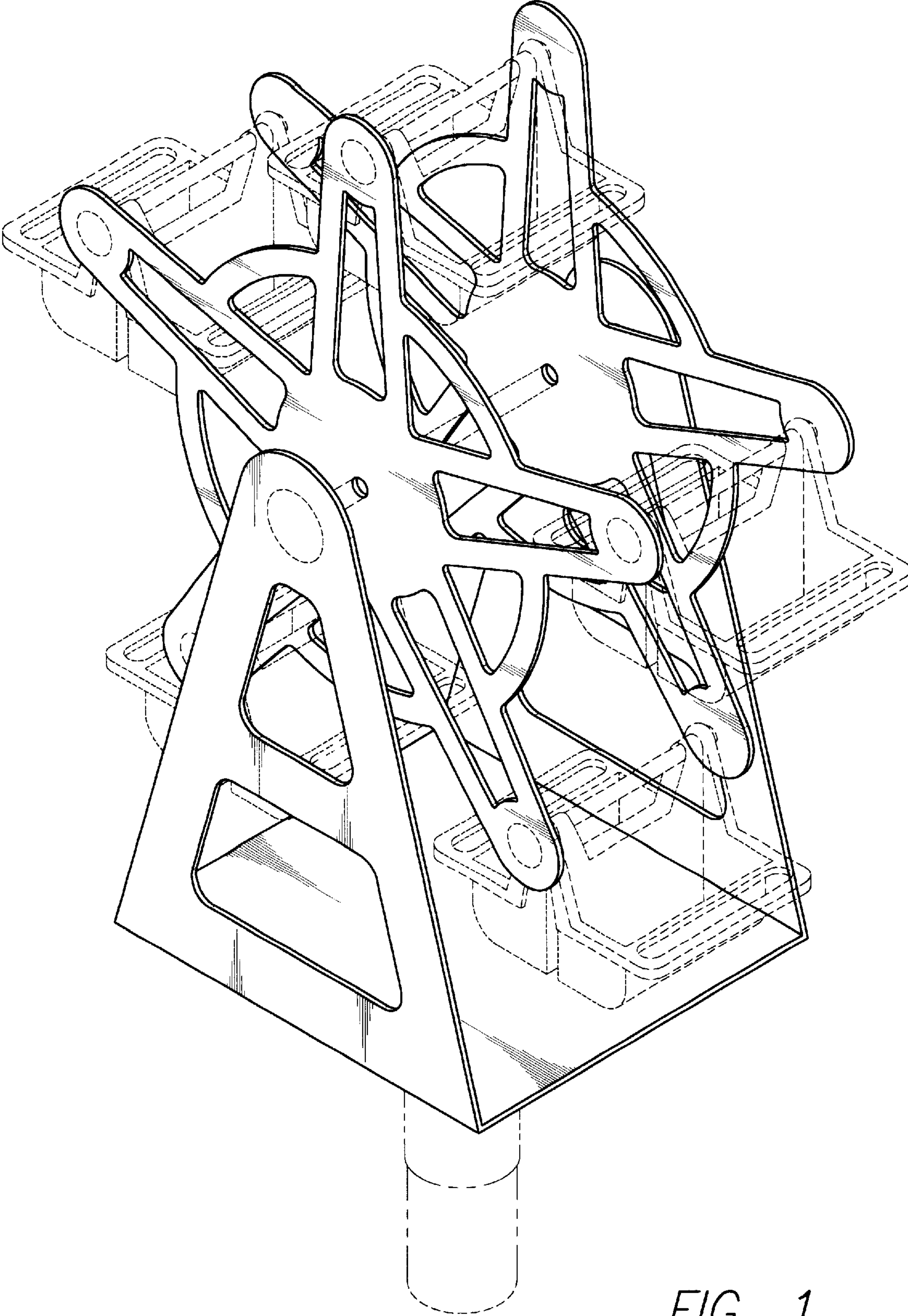

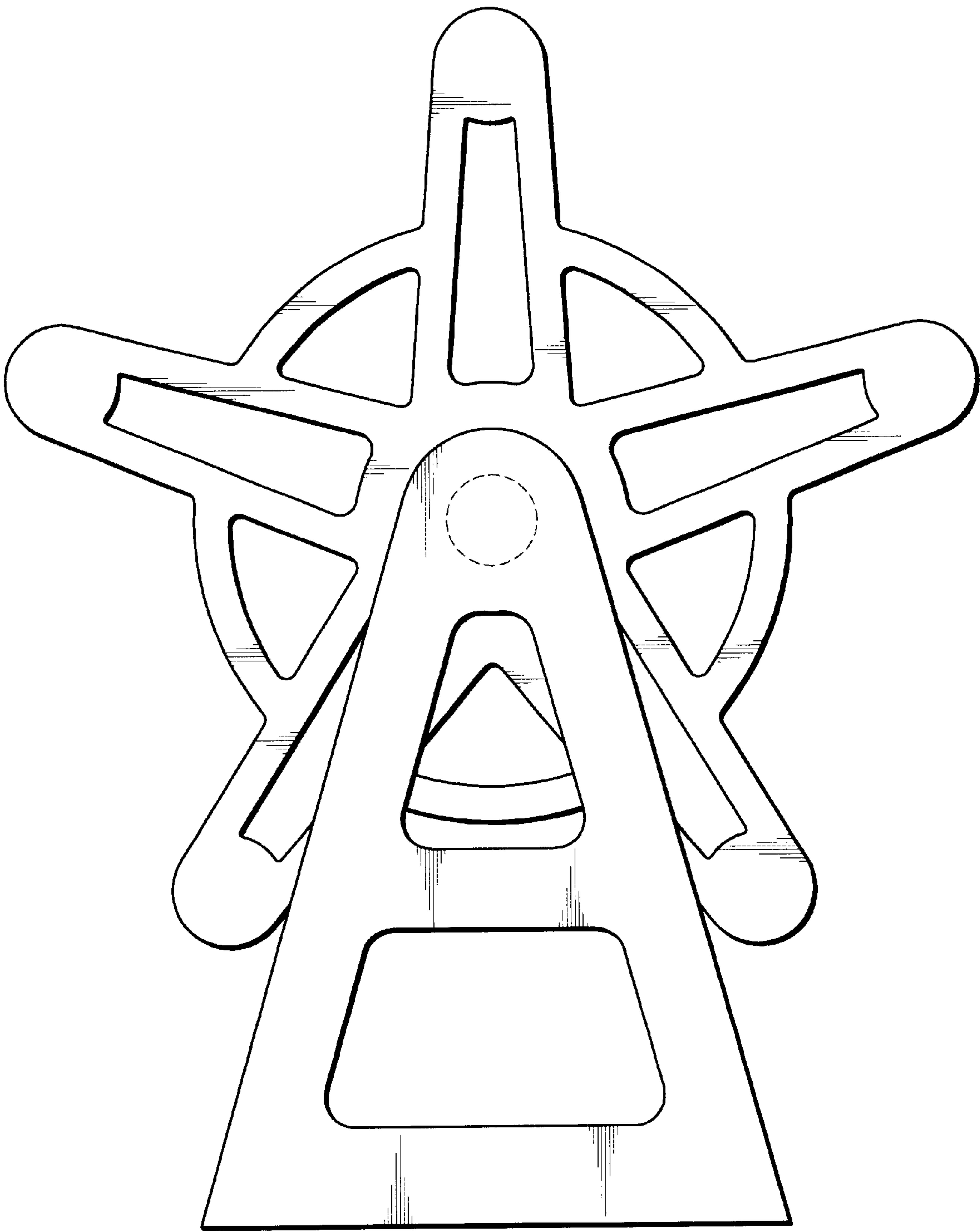

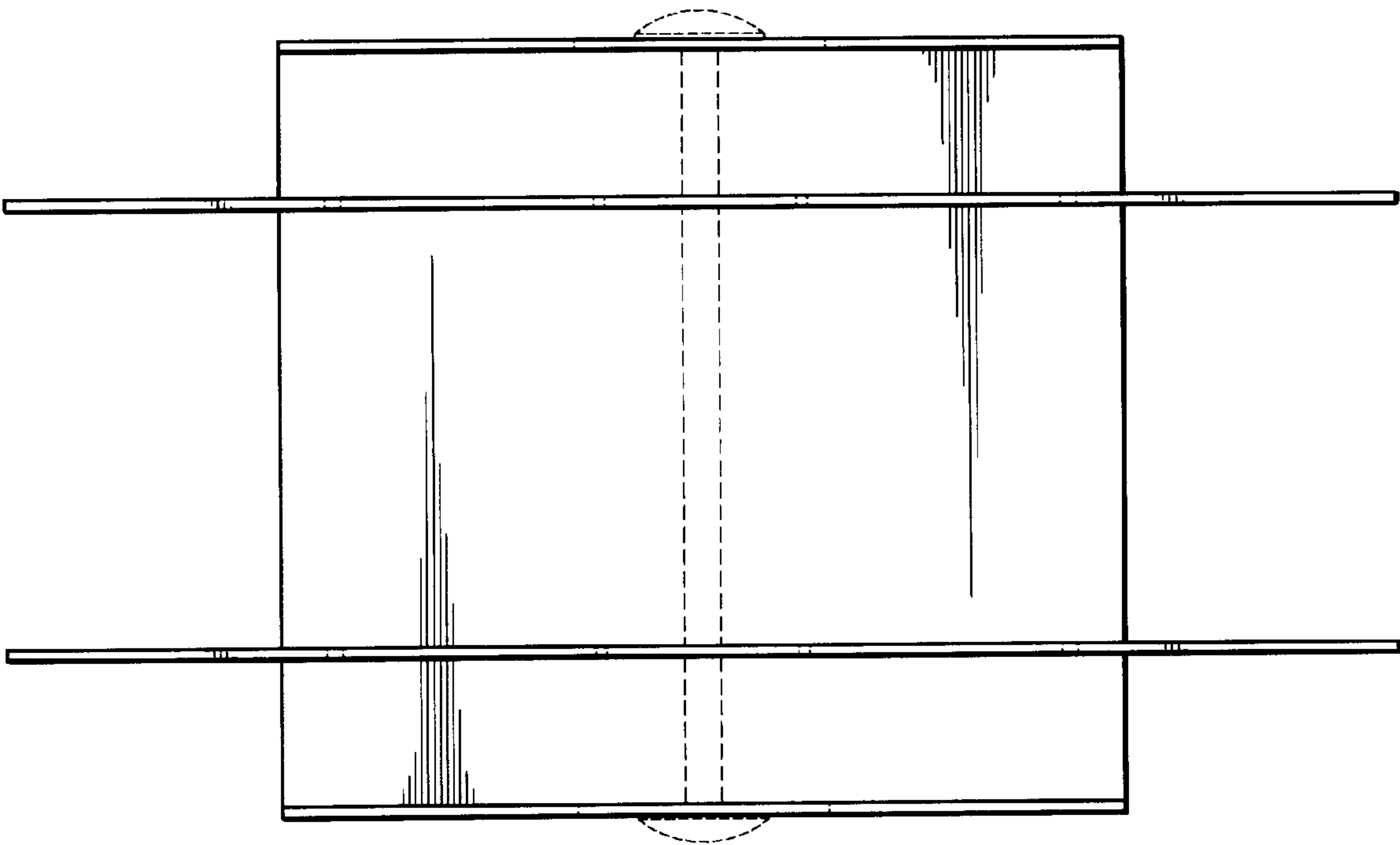

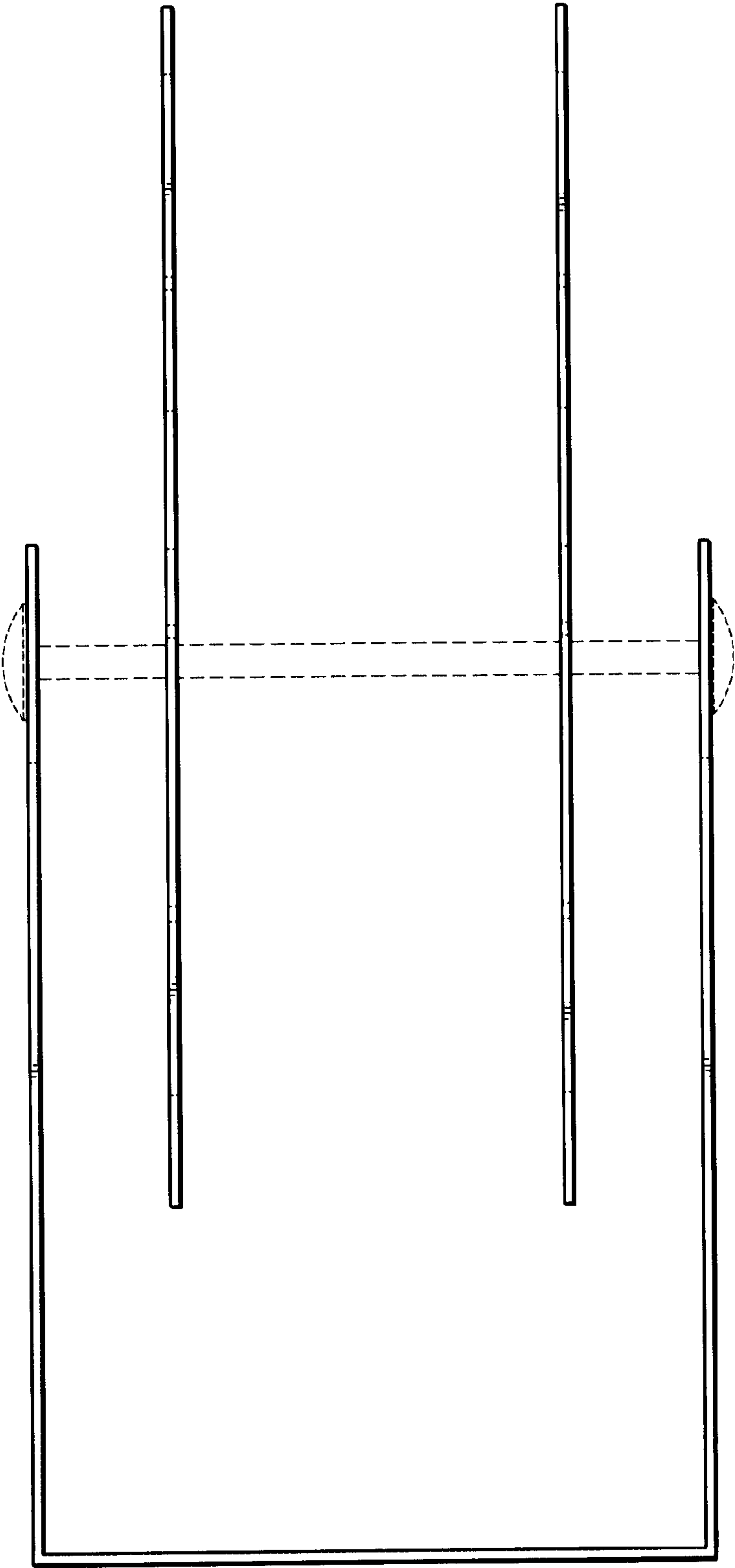
