(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a “drapery hardware bracket,” as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective front elevation view showing a “drapery hardware bracket” according to the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front end view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear end view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a left side view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 7 is a right side view of the bracket shown in FIG. 1.
