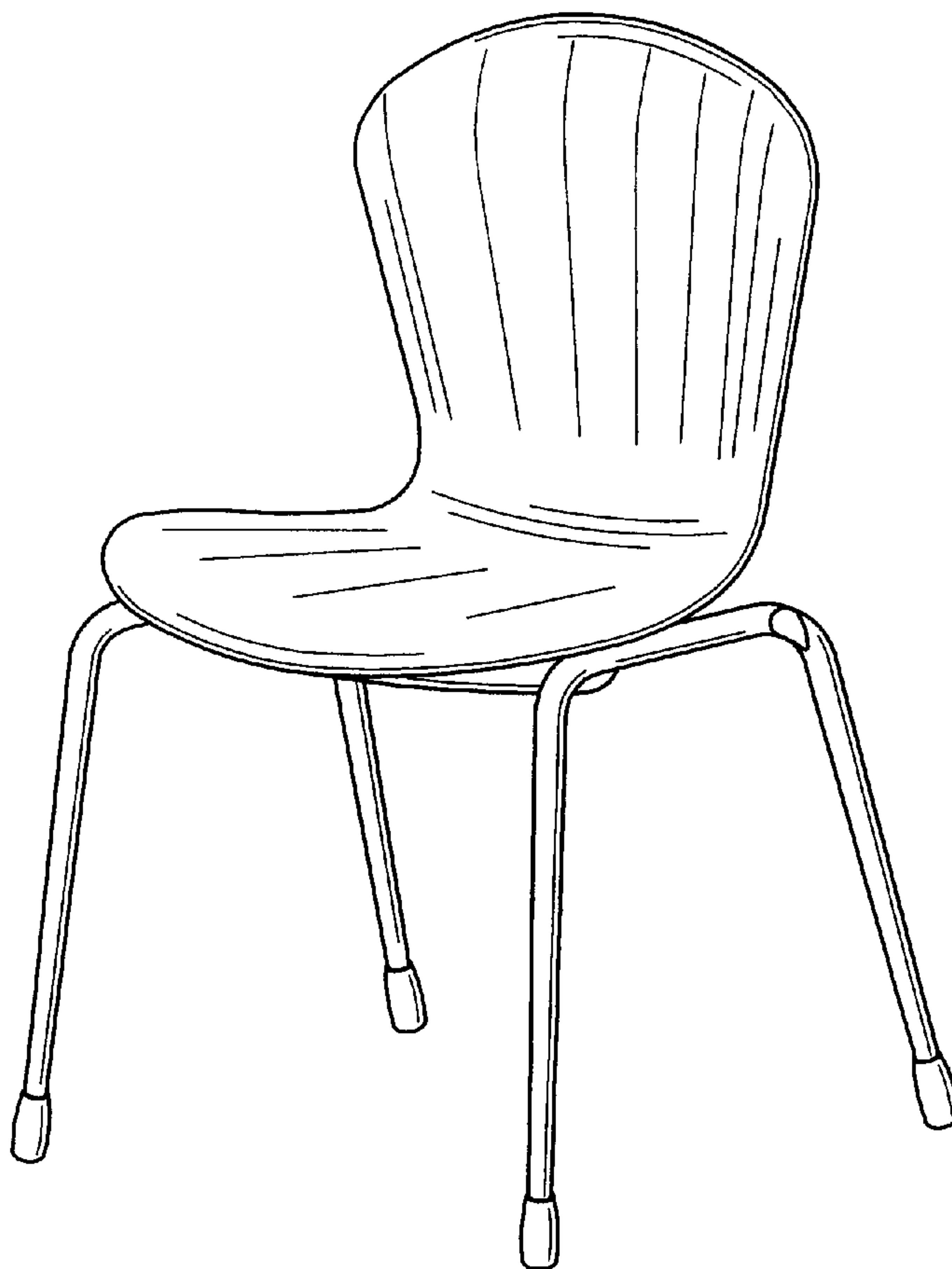
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a generally perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

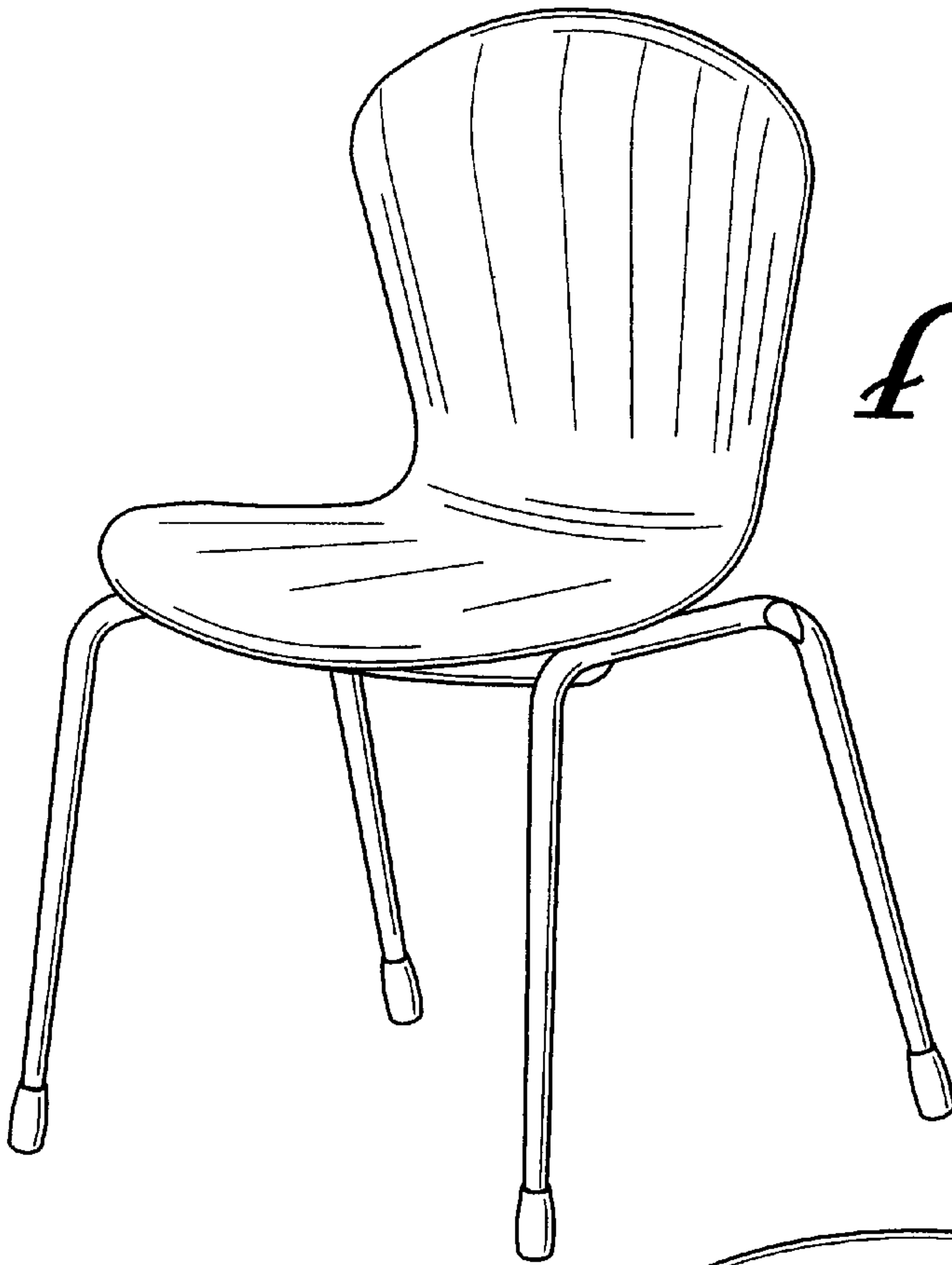

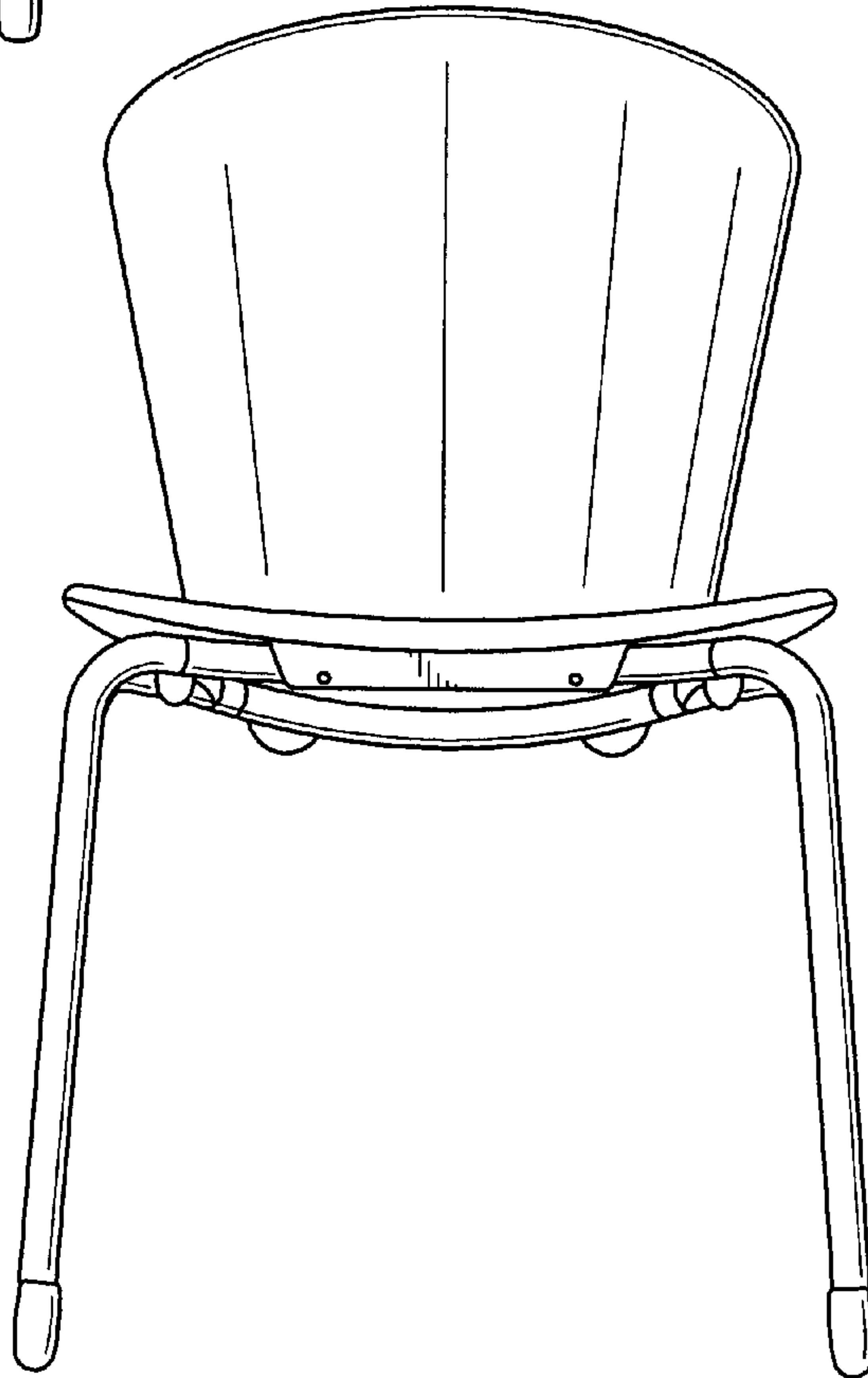

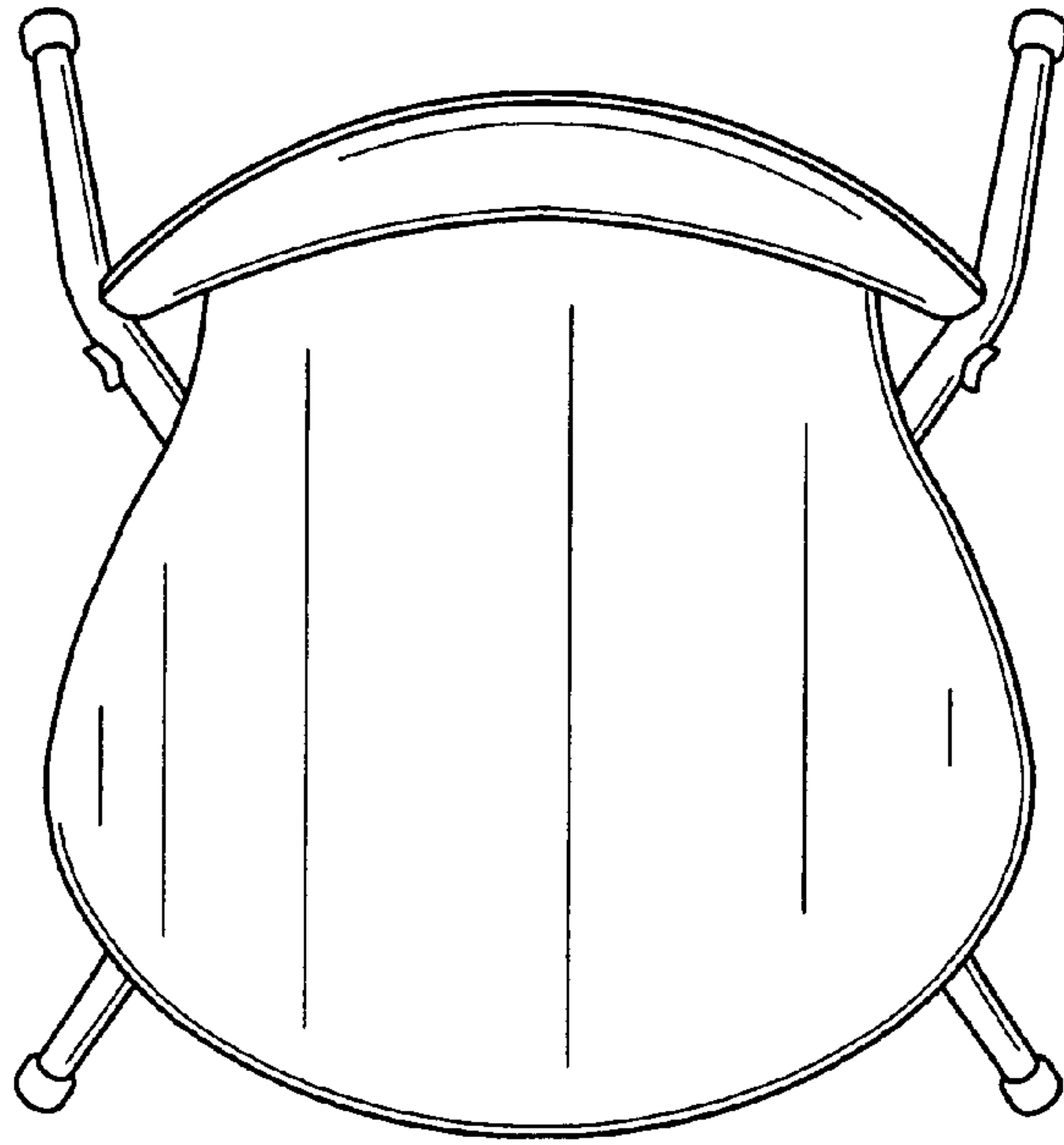

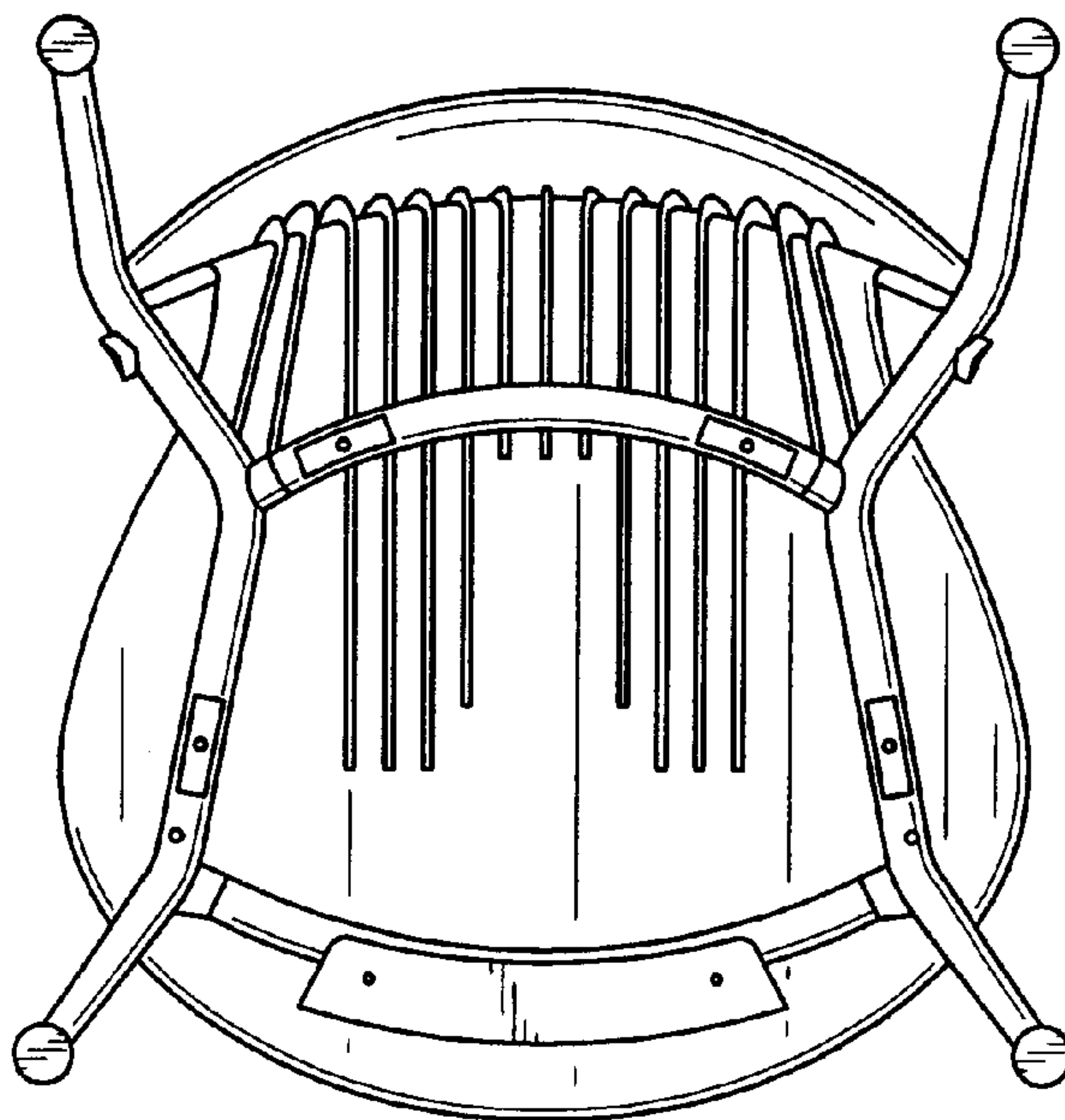

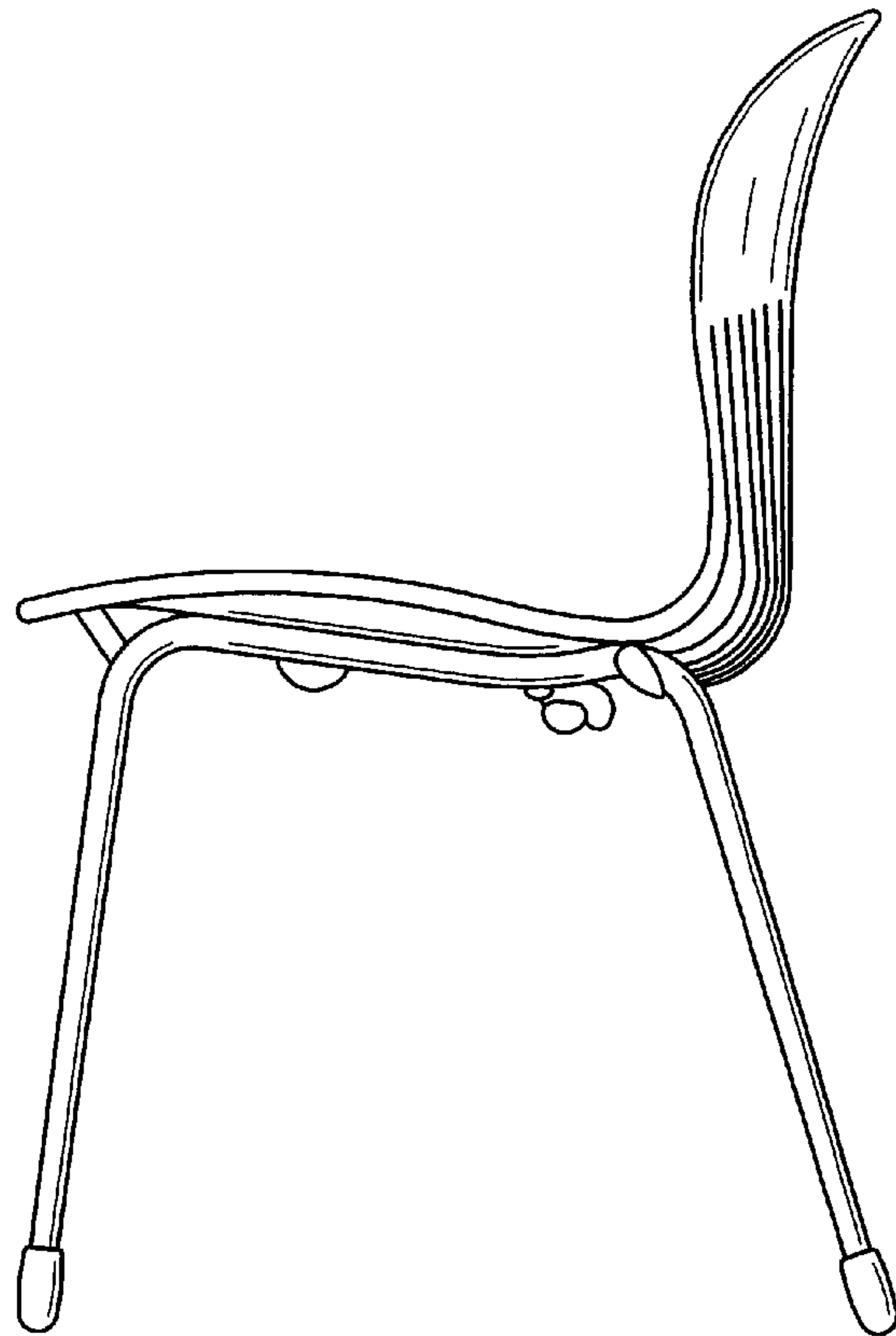

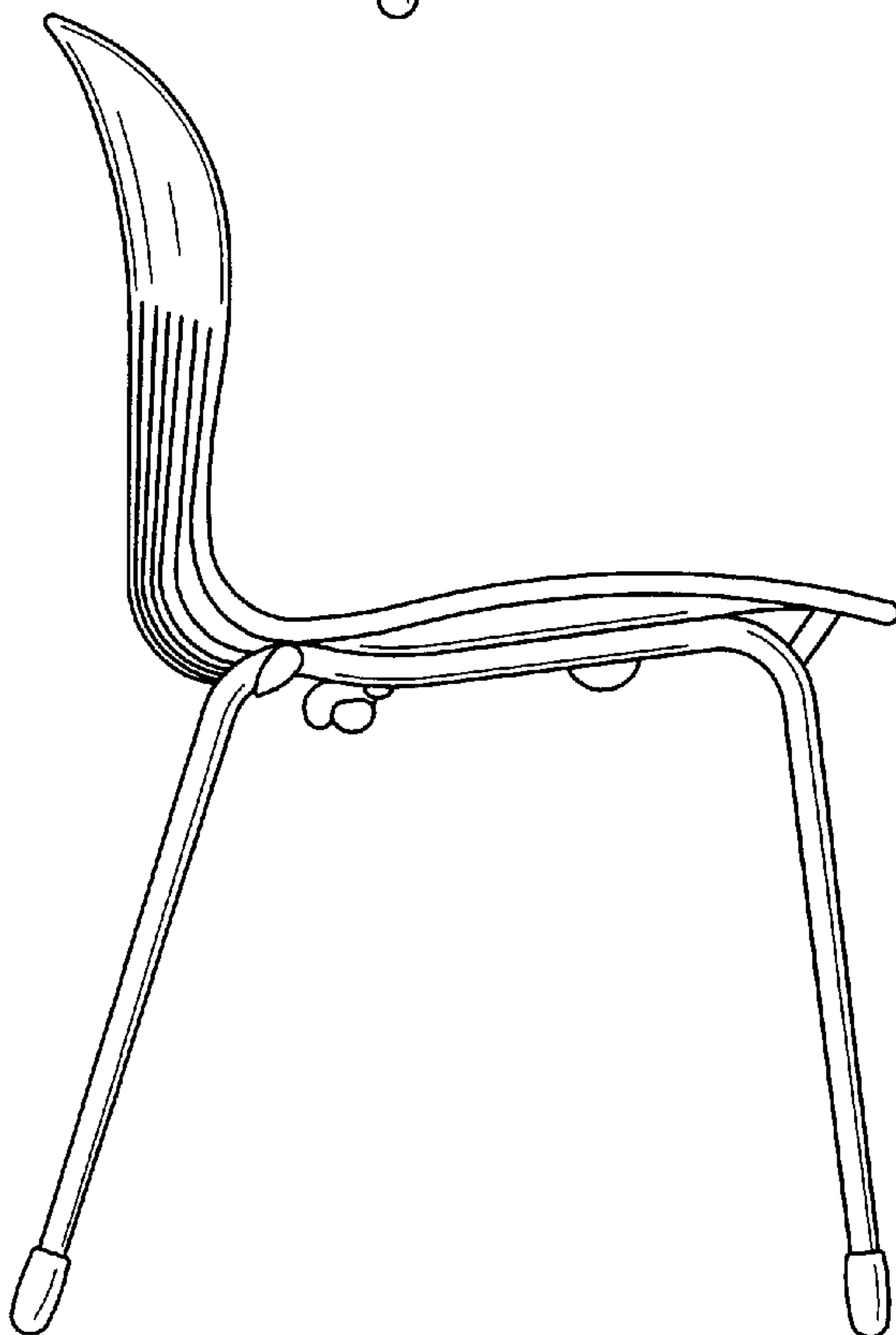

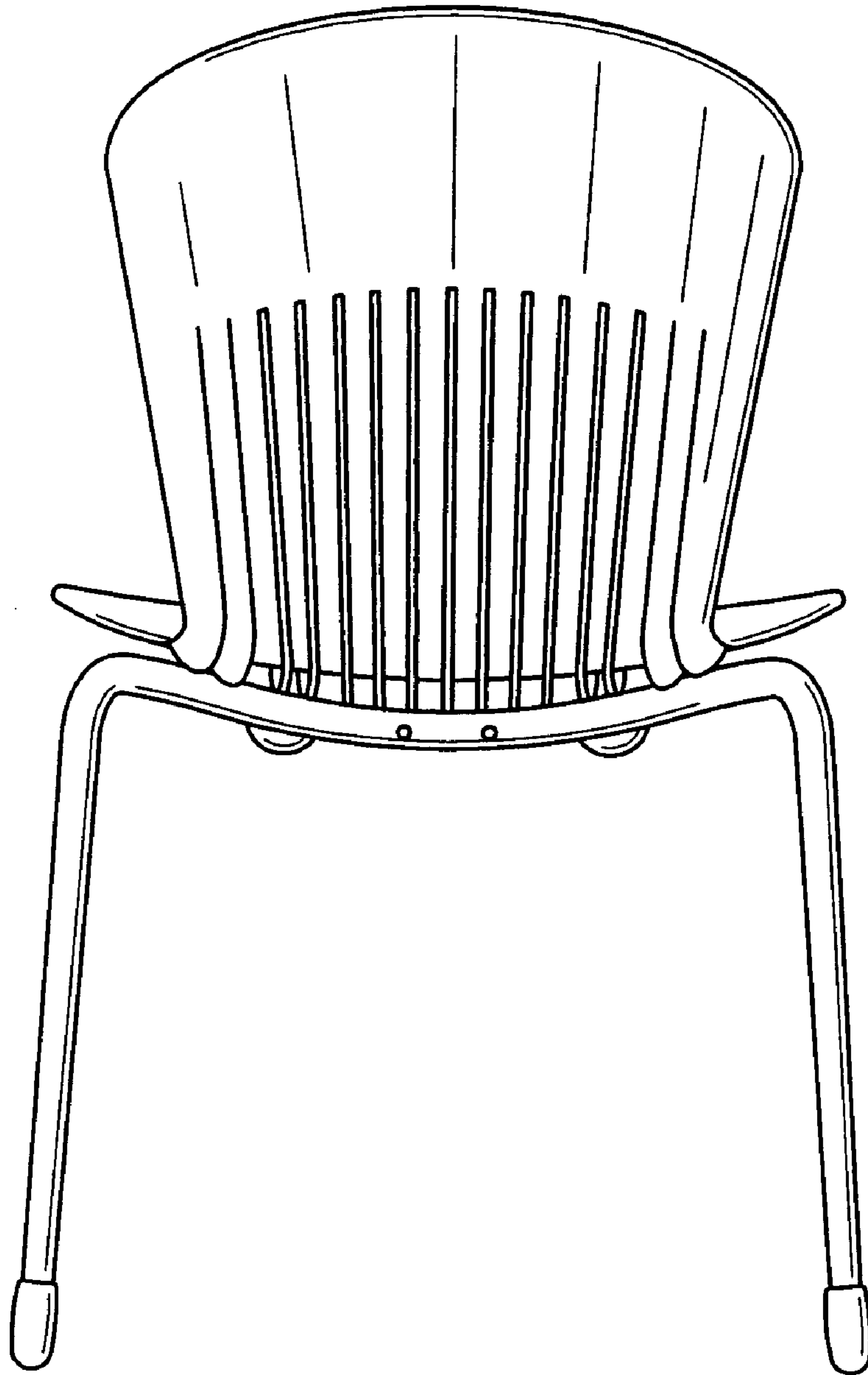
