(57) **CLAIM**

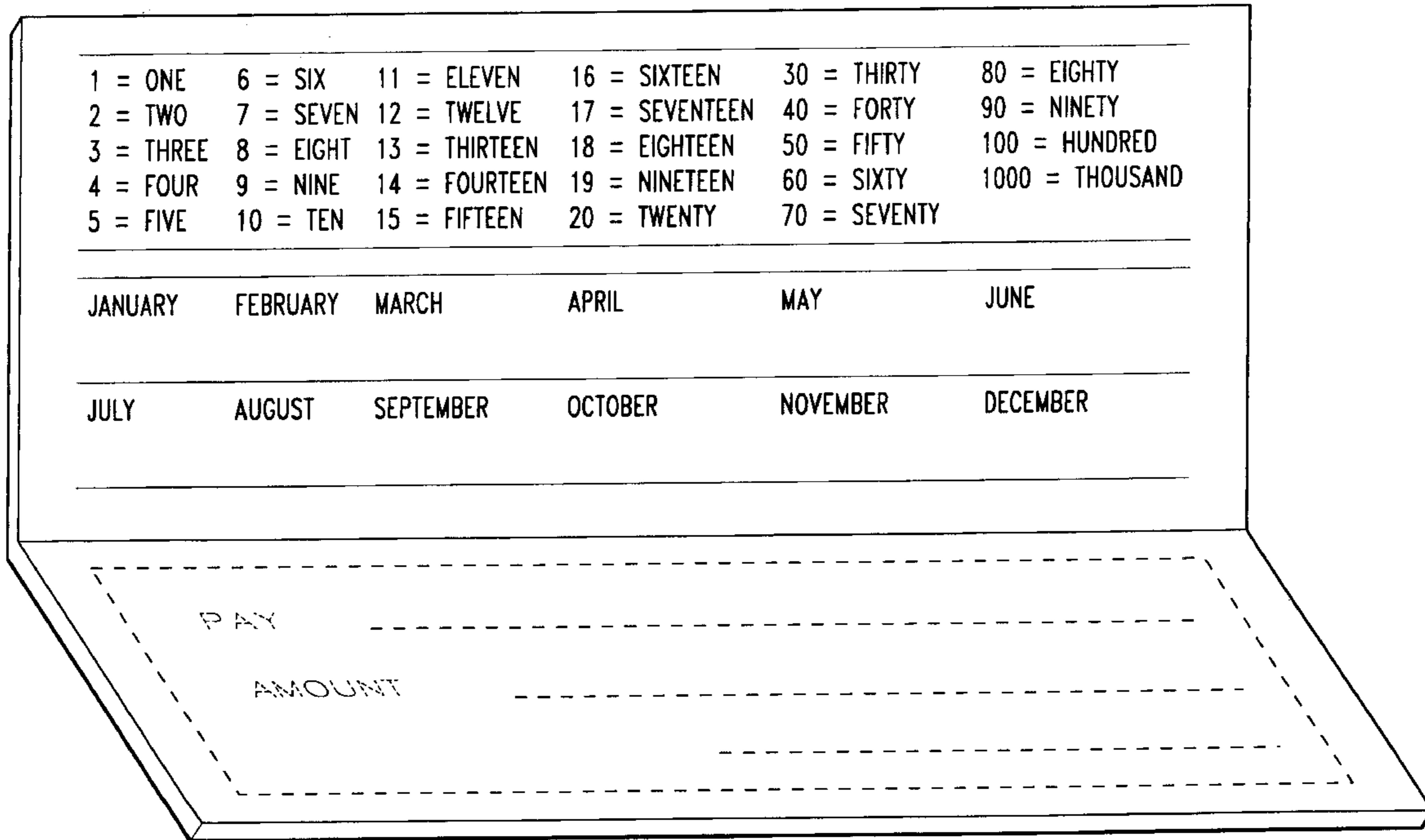
The ornamental design for a front of a check speller, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of a front of a check speller showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment thereof.

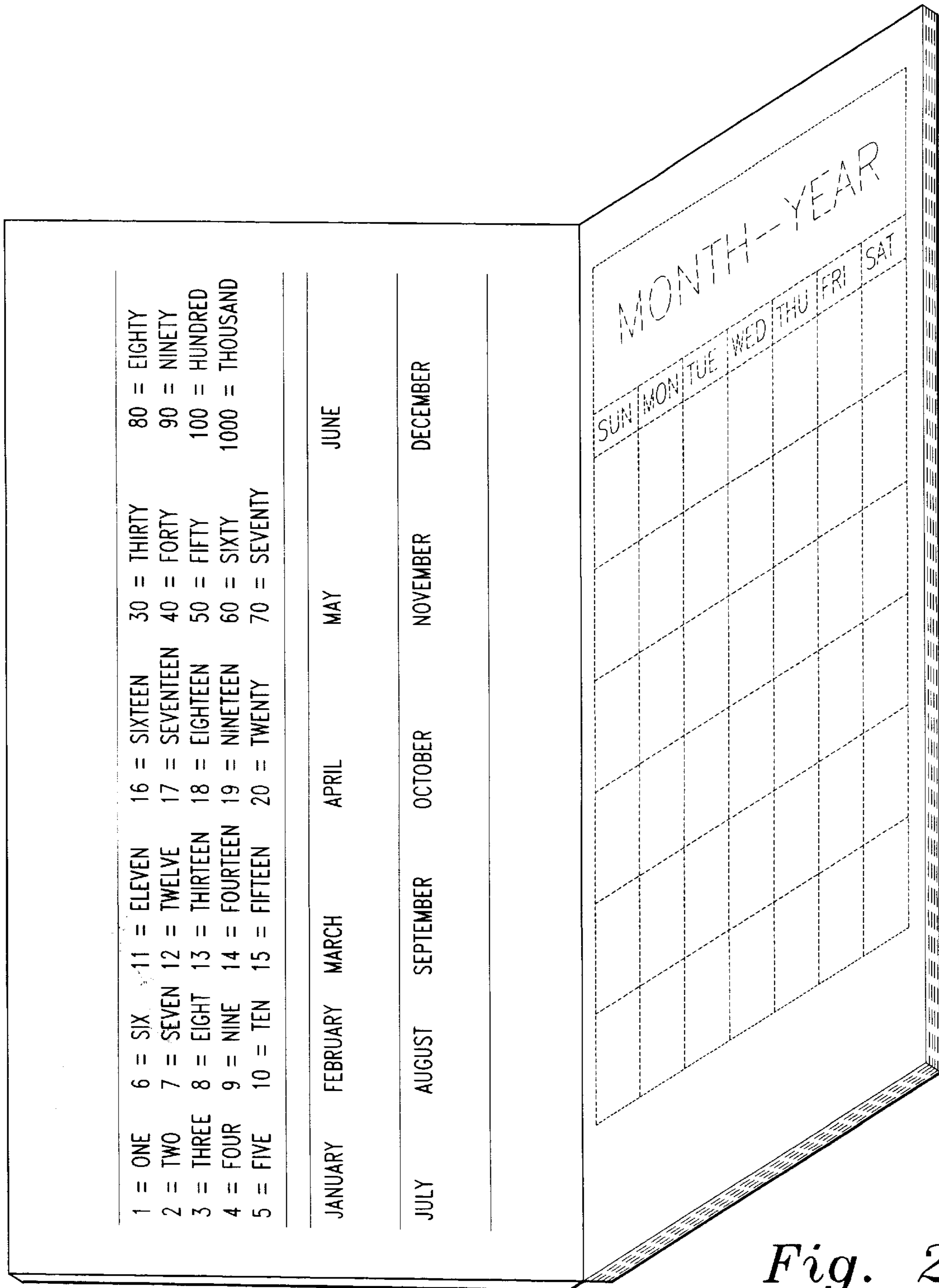
