(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a “segmented, hook joint, hockey stick”, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a segmented, hook joint, hockey stick, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational exploded view showing two segments thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational exploded view showing the two segments thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational exploded view showing the two segments thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan exploded view showing the two segments thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan exploded view showing the two segments thereof; and,
 FIG. 11 is a sectional view taken along line 11—11 in FIG. 7.

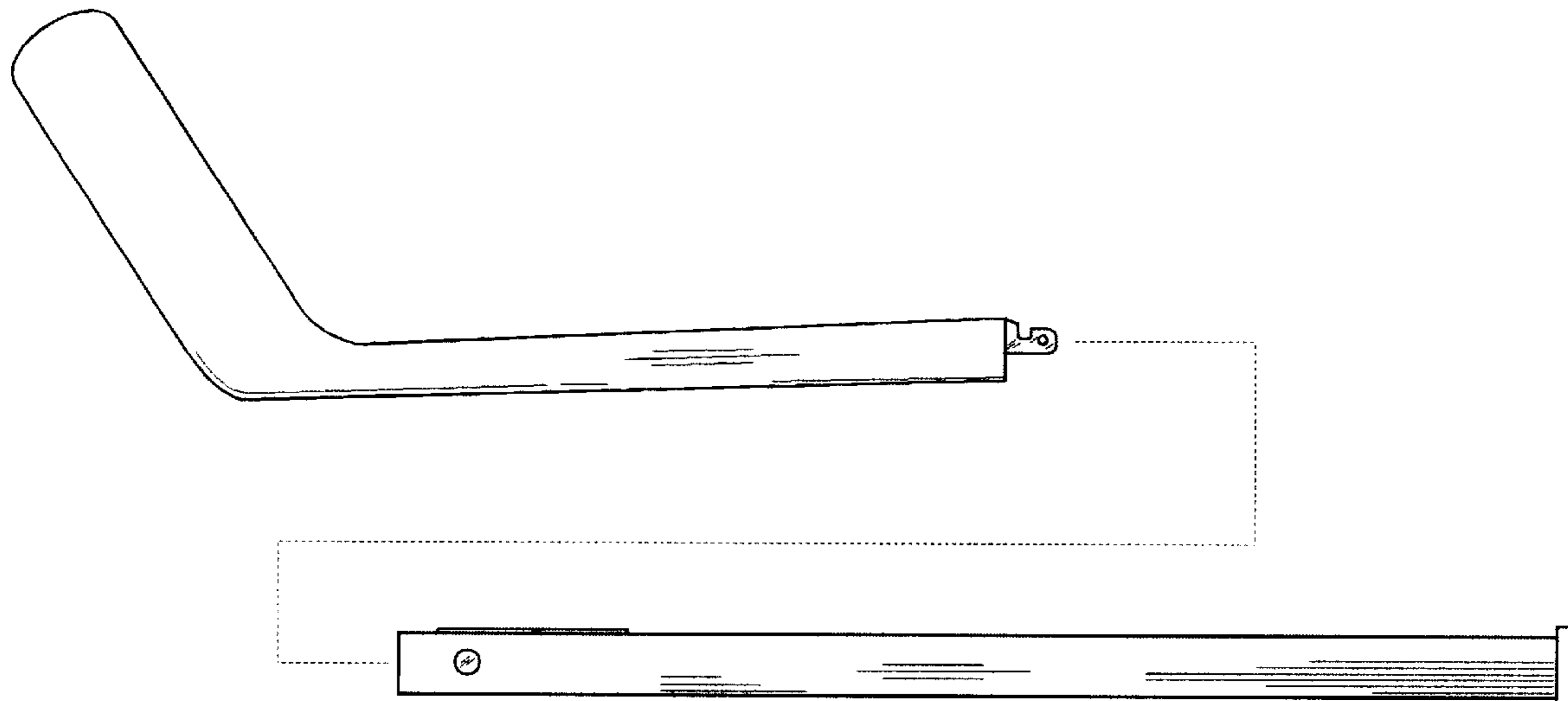

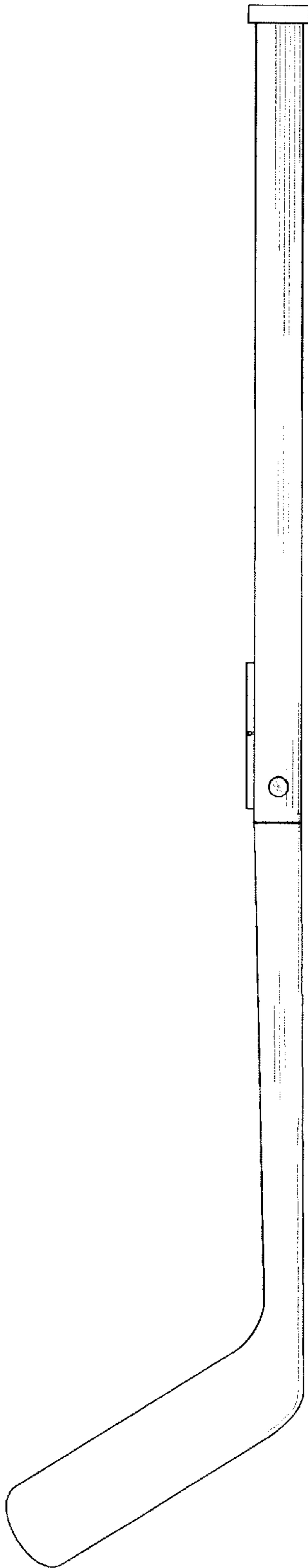

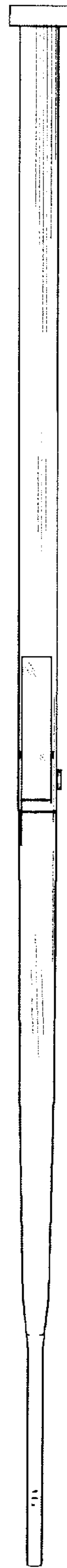

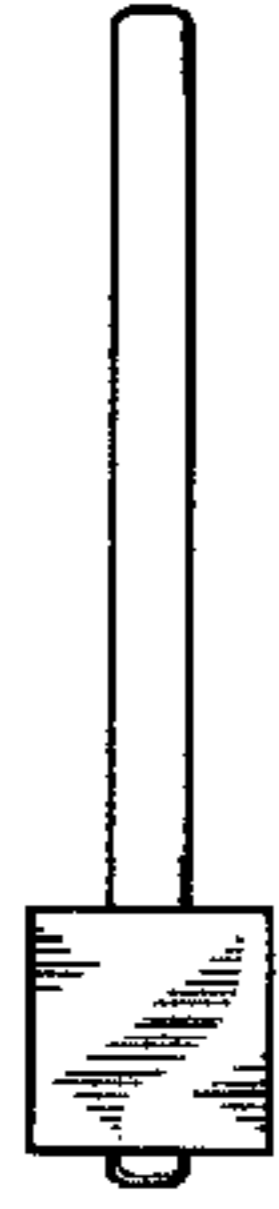

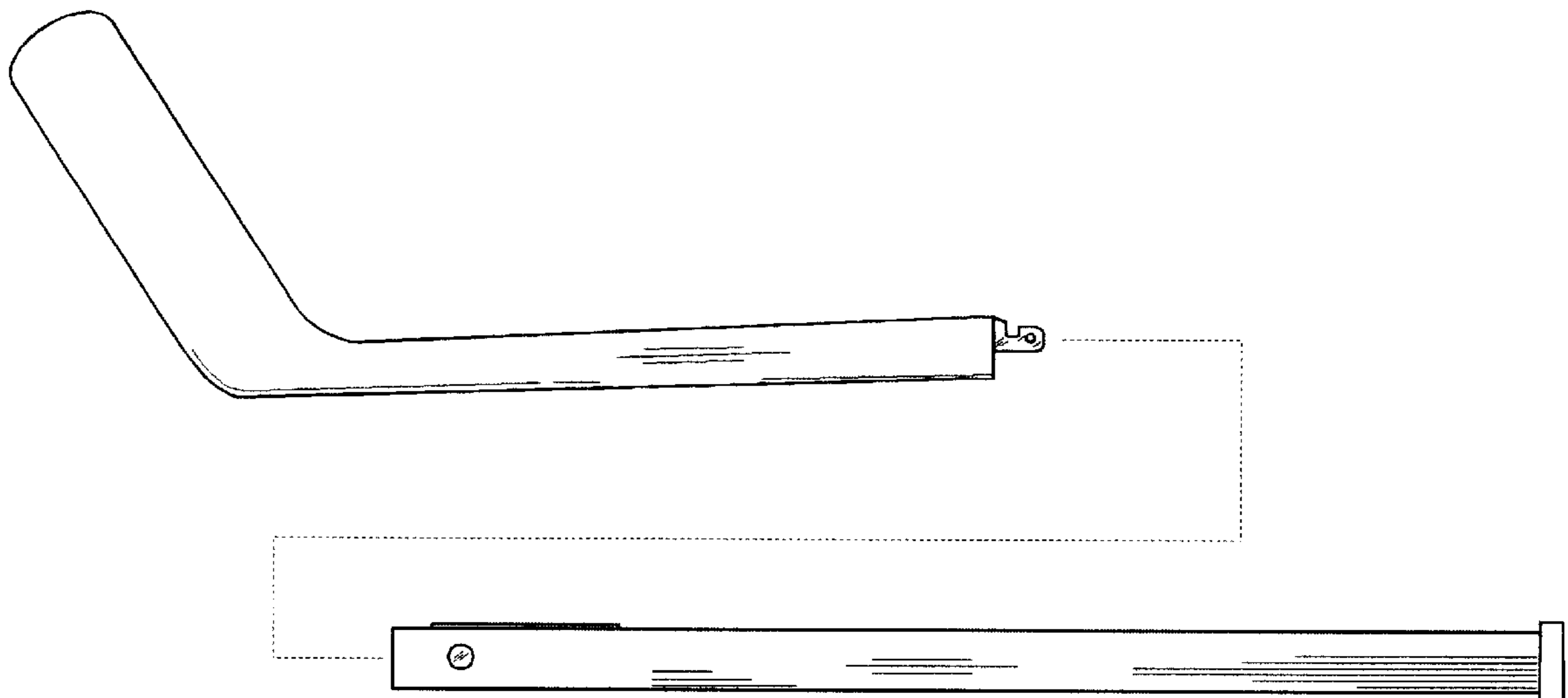

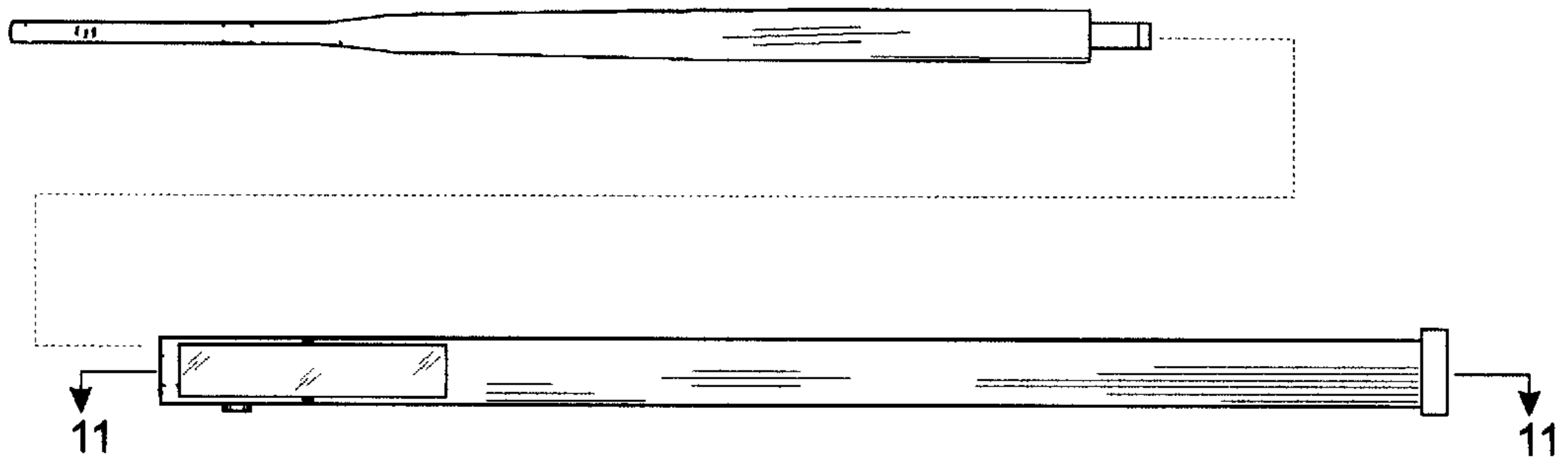

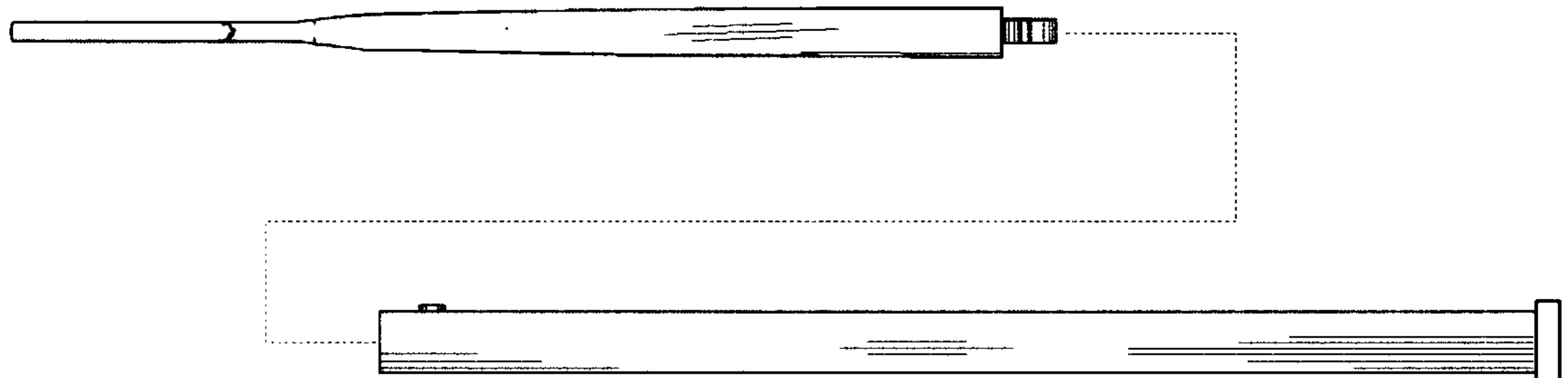

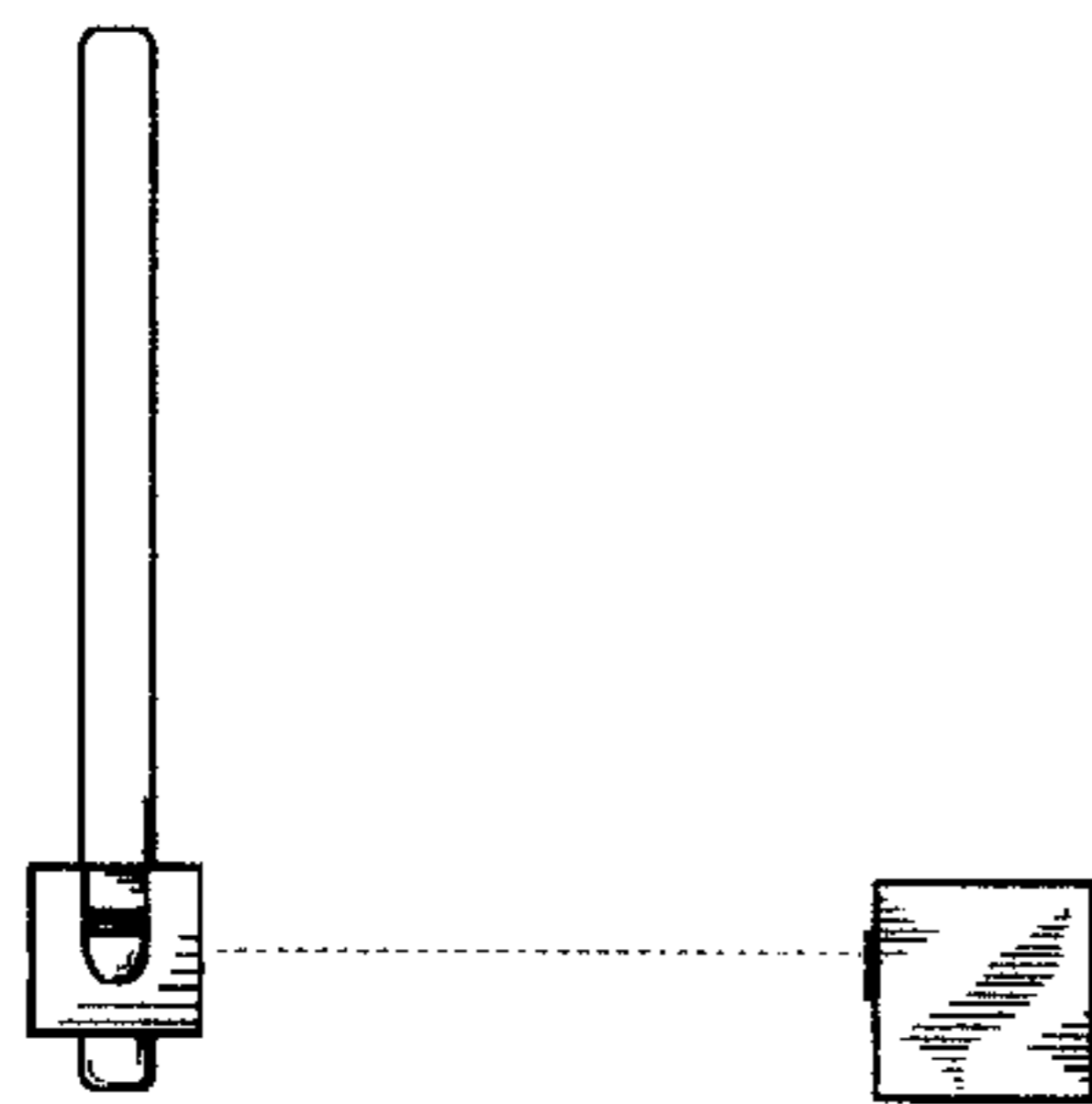

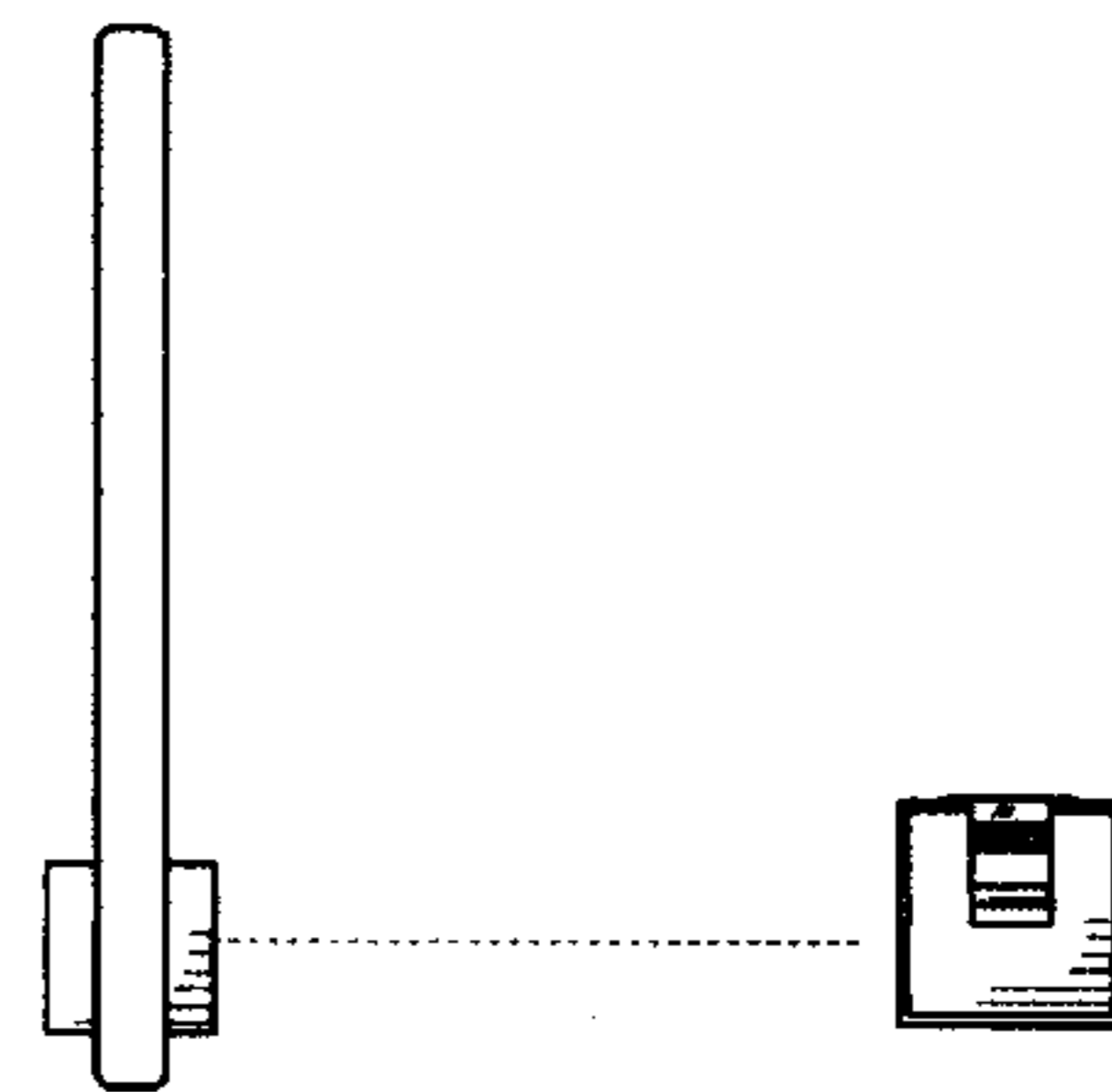
