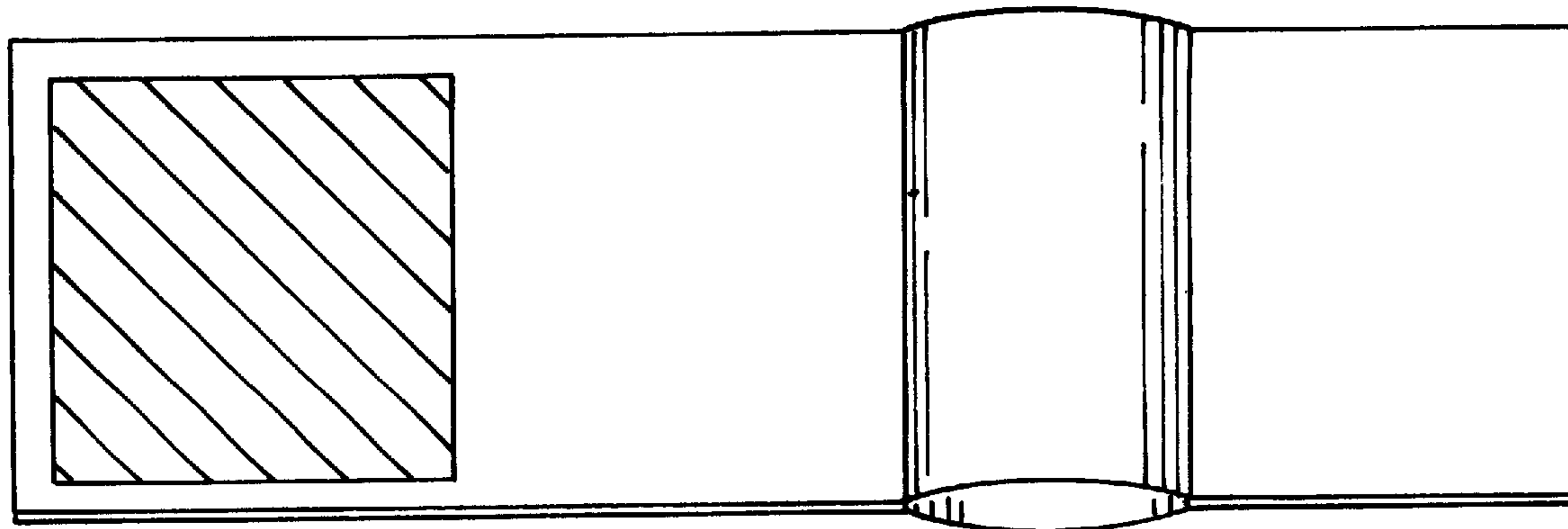
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the teaching aid to chip a golf ball without breaking wrists;

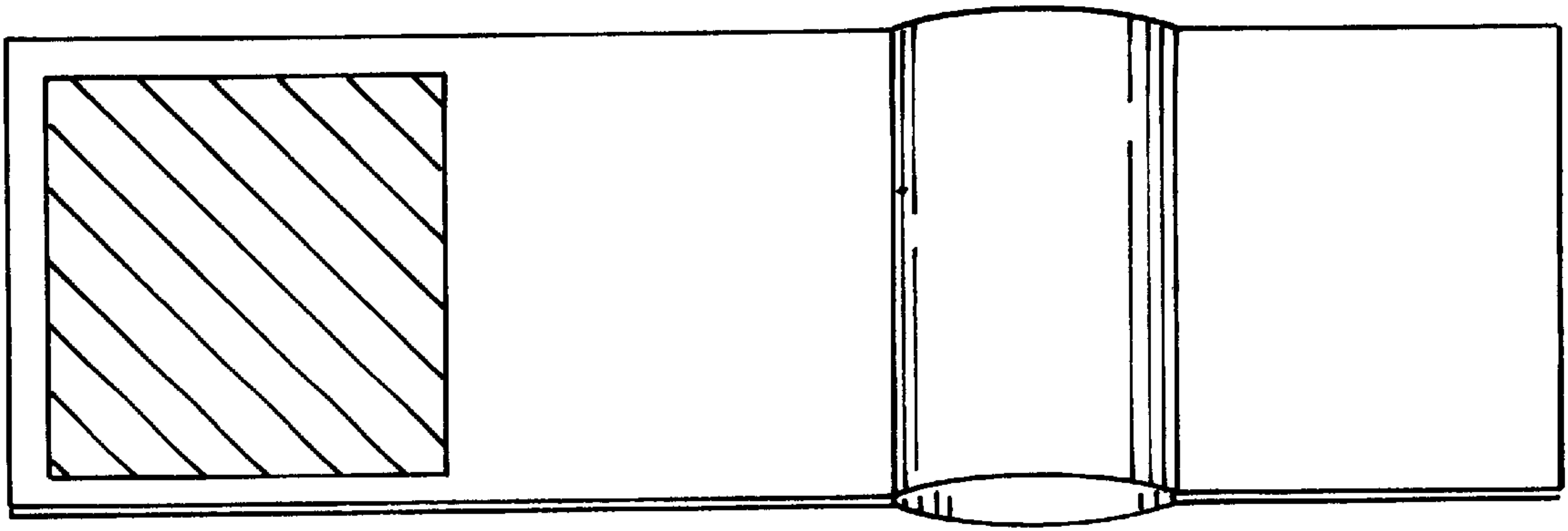

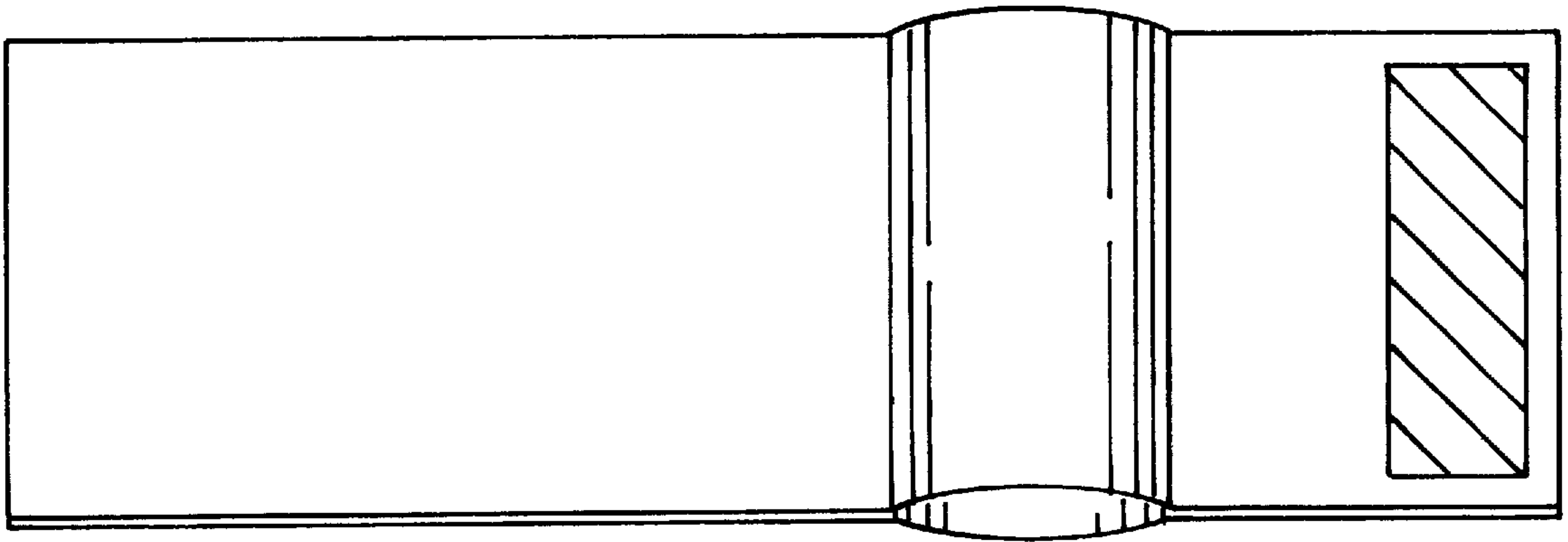

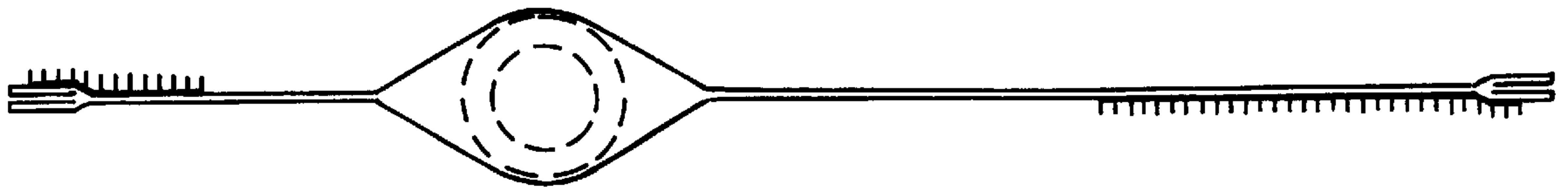

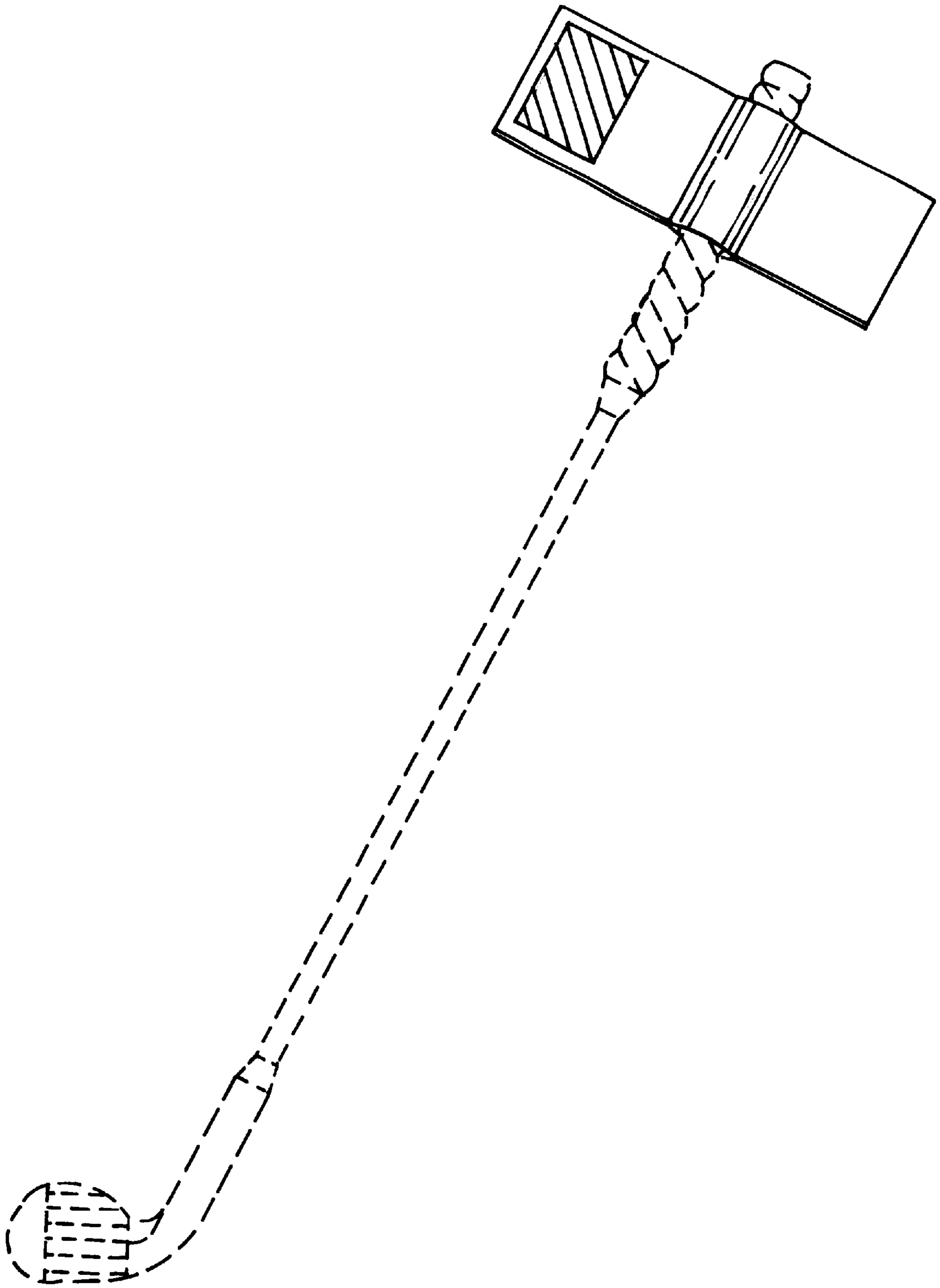

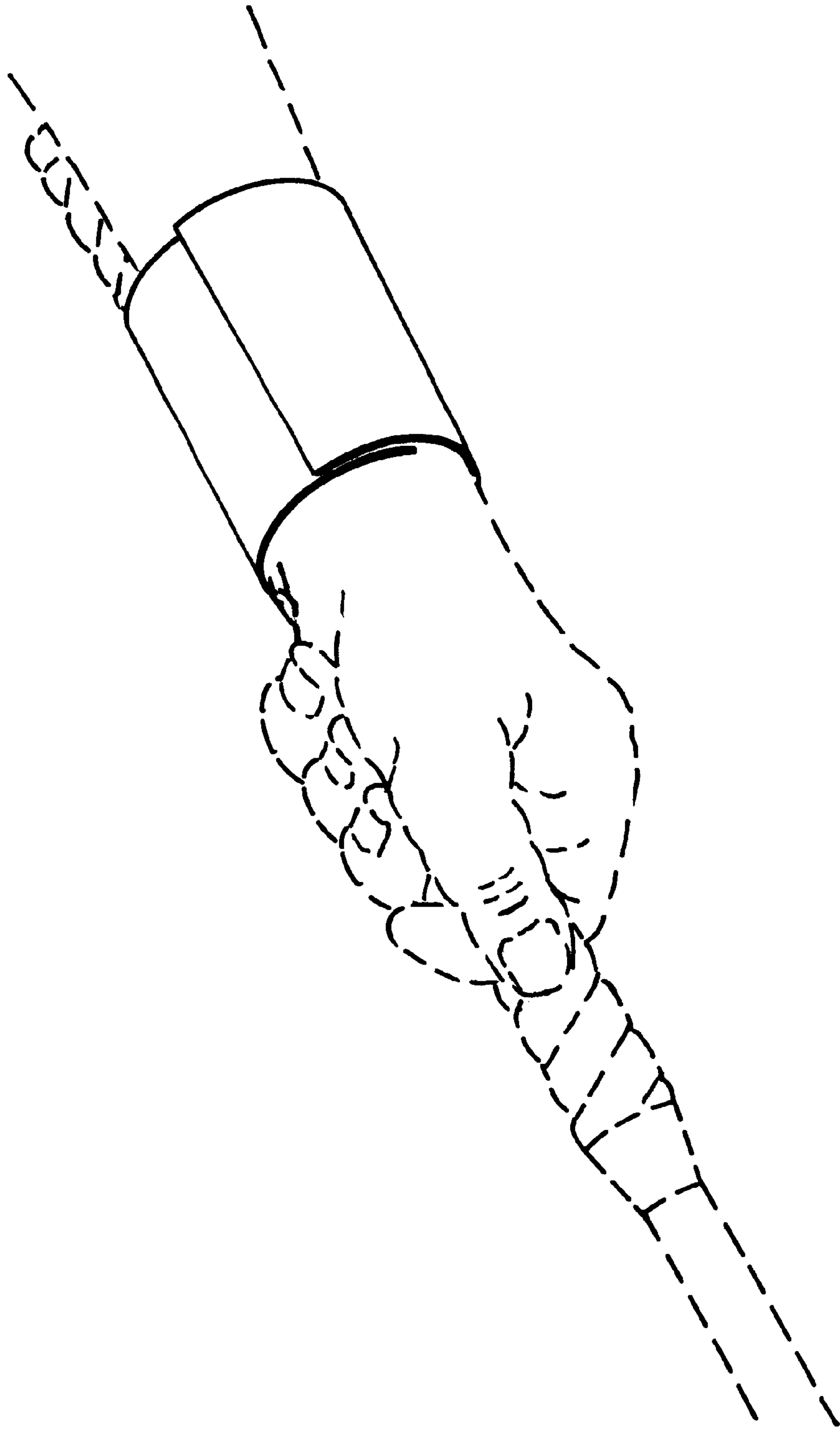
