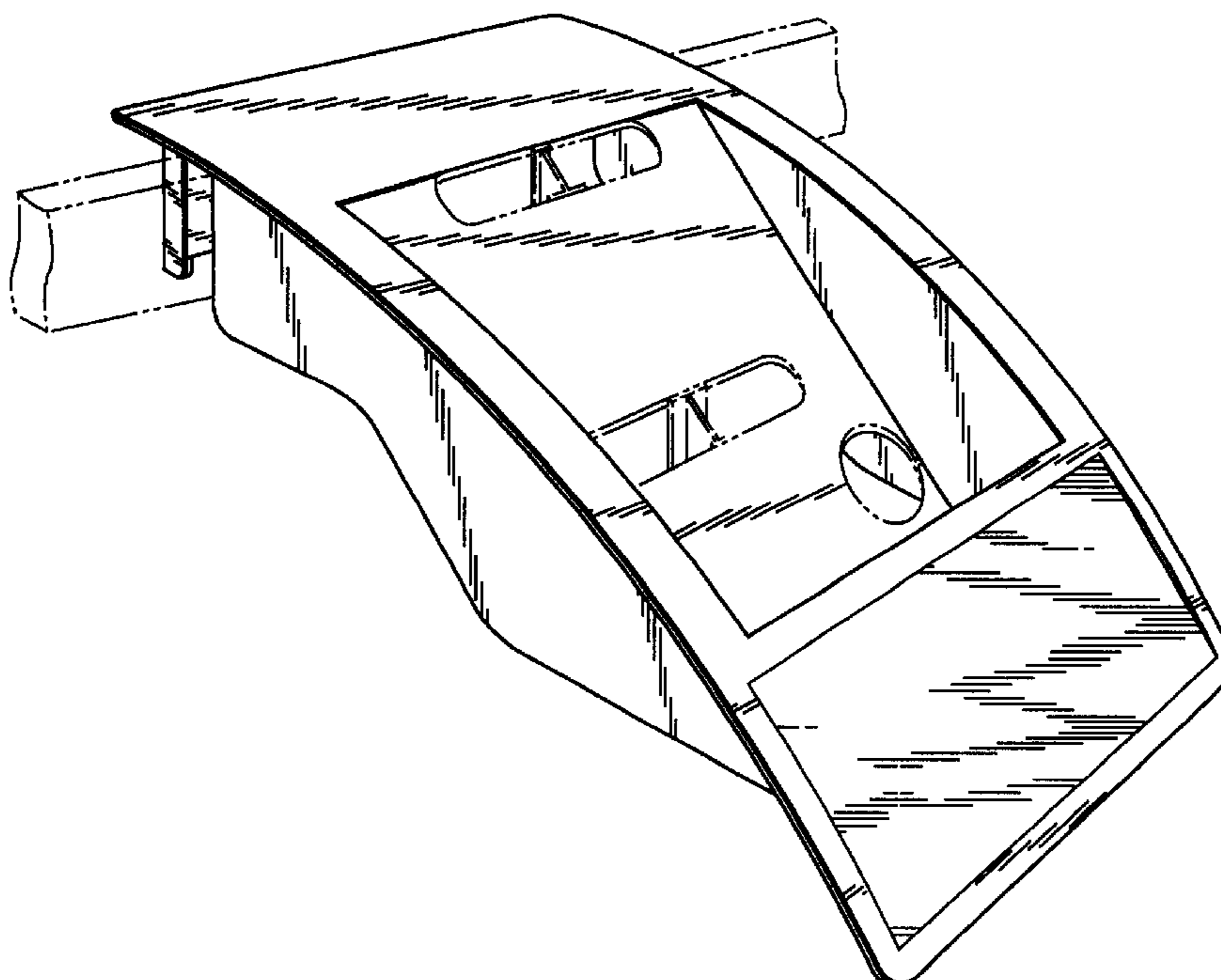
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a merchandise display holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a merchandise display holder of the present invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a rear plan view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a side view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 7 is an opposite side view of the merchandise display holder of FIG. 1.

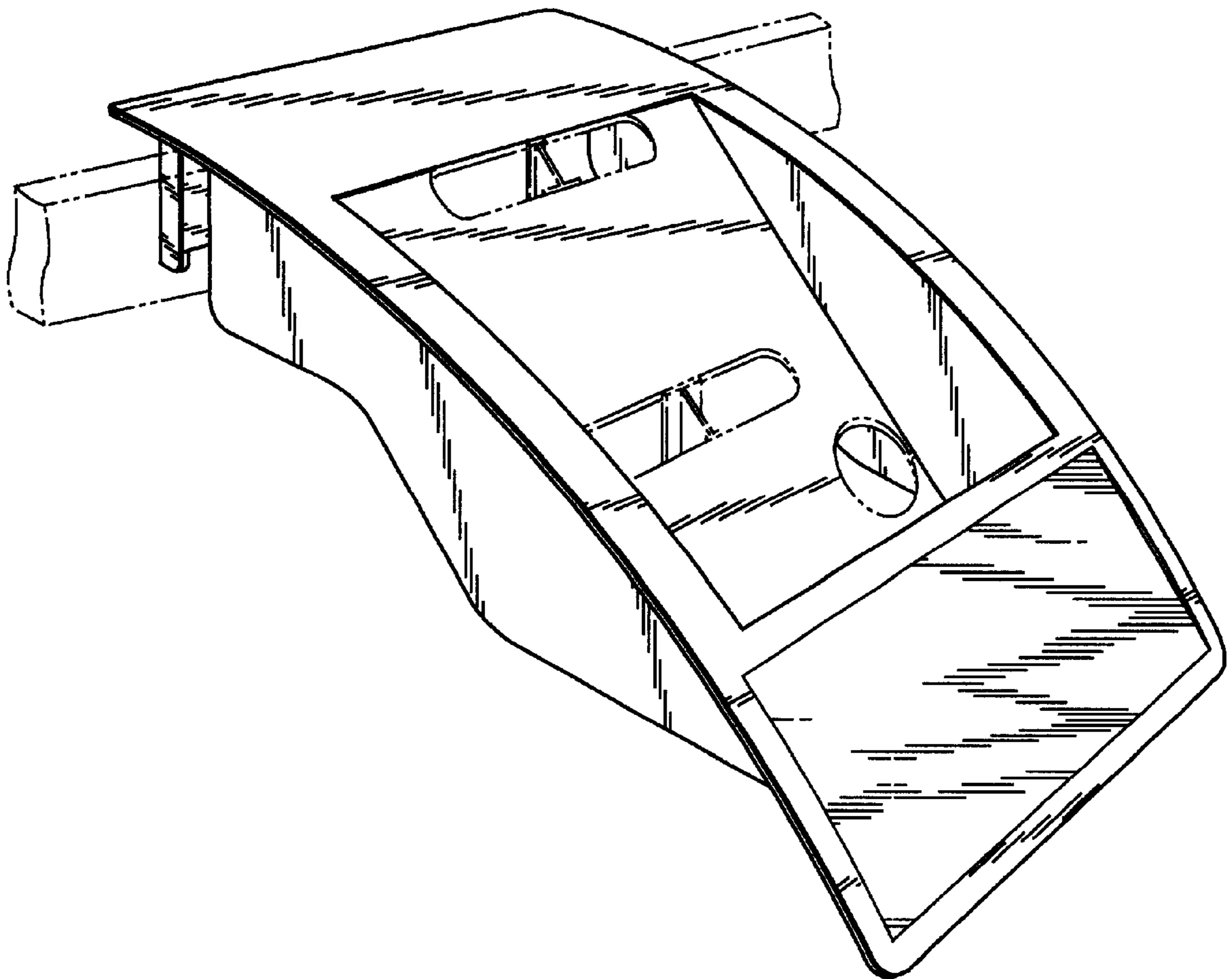

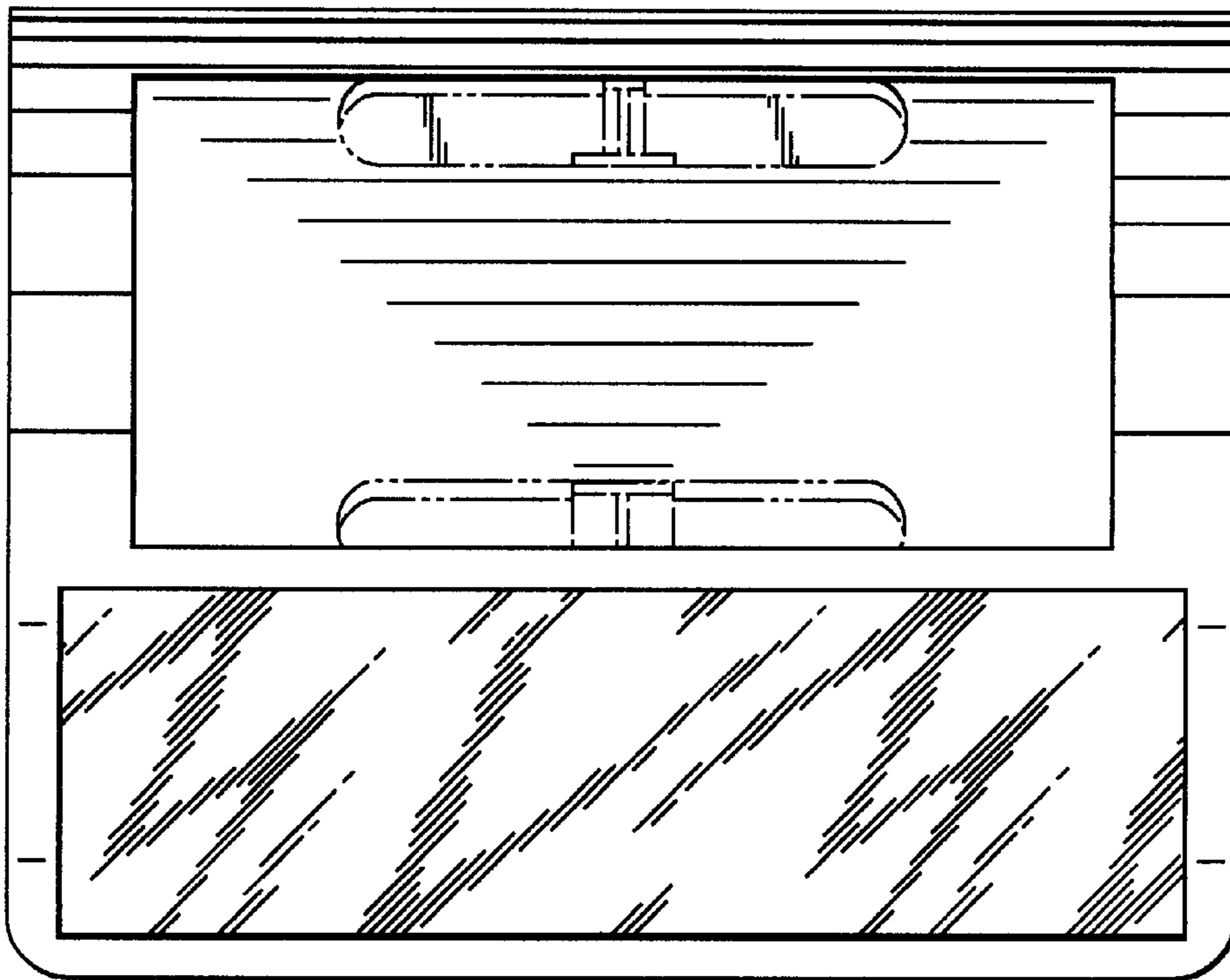

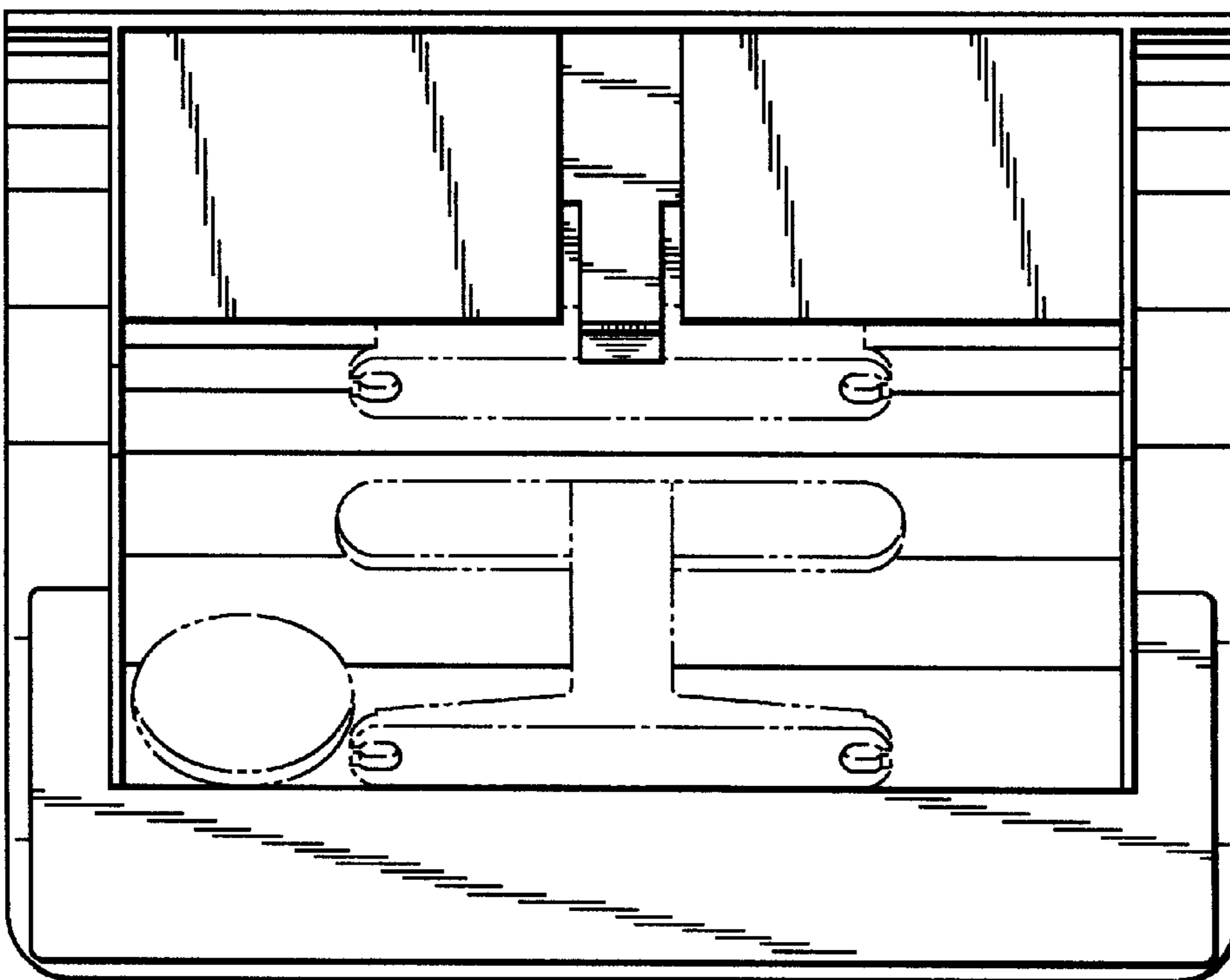

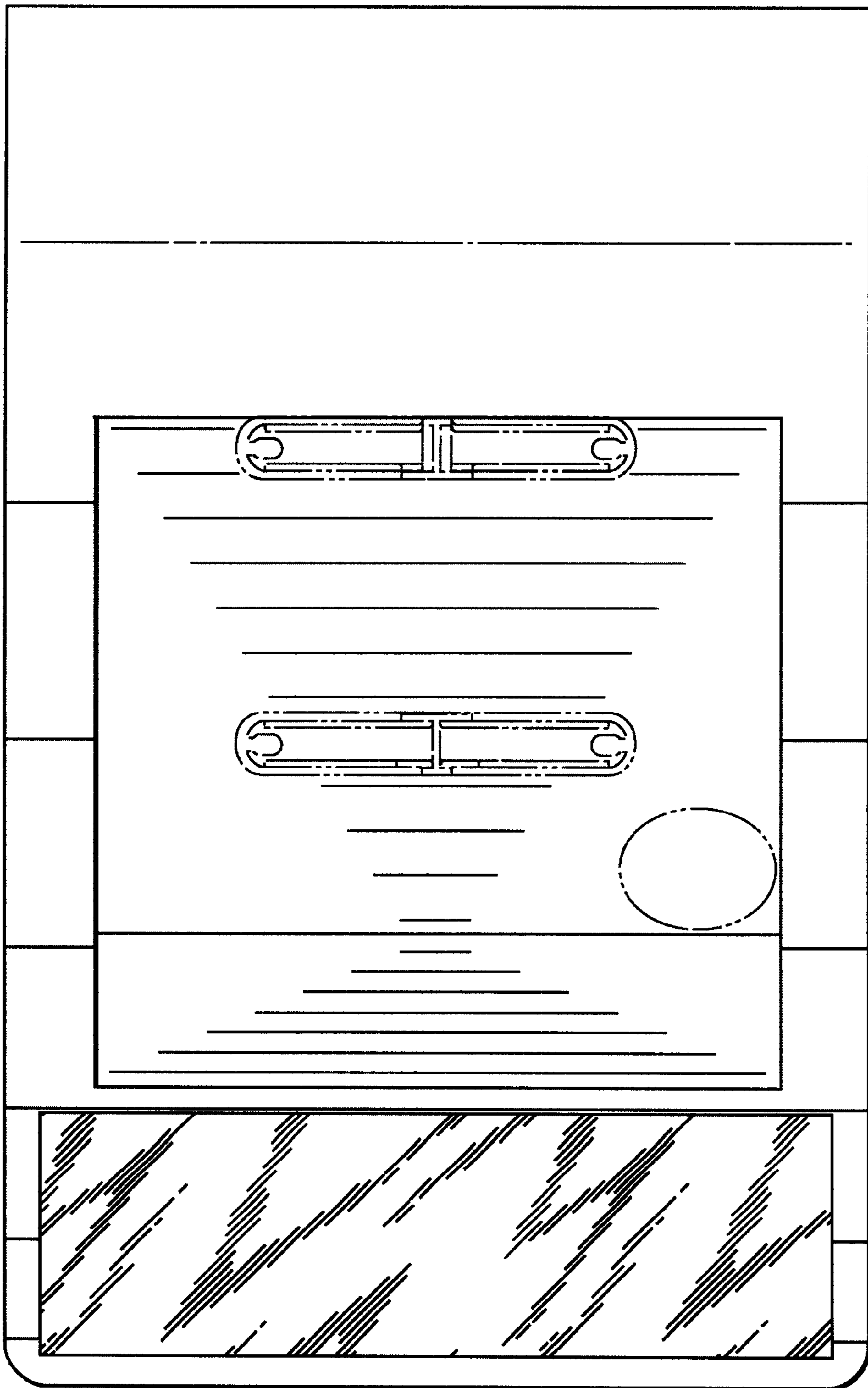

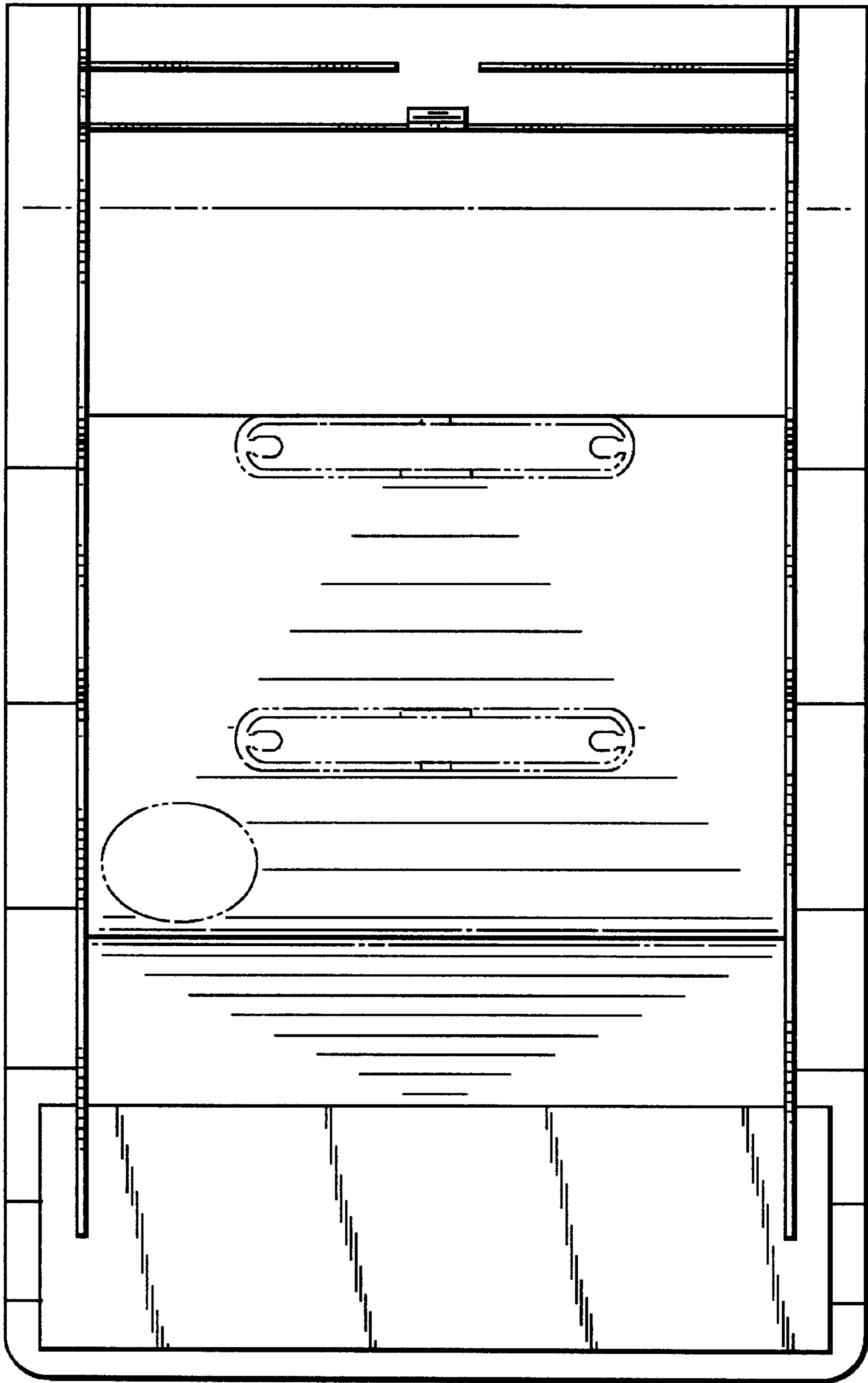

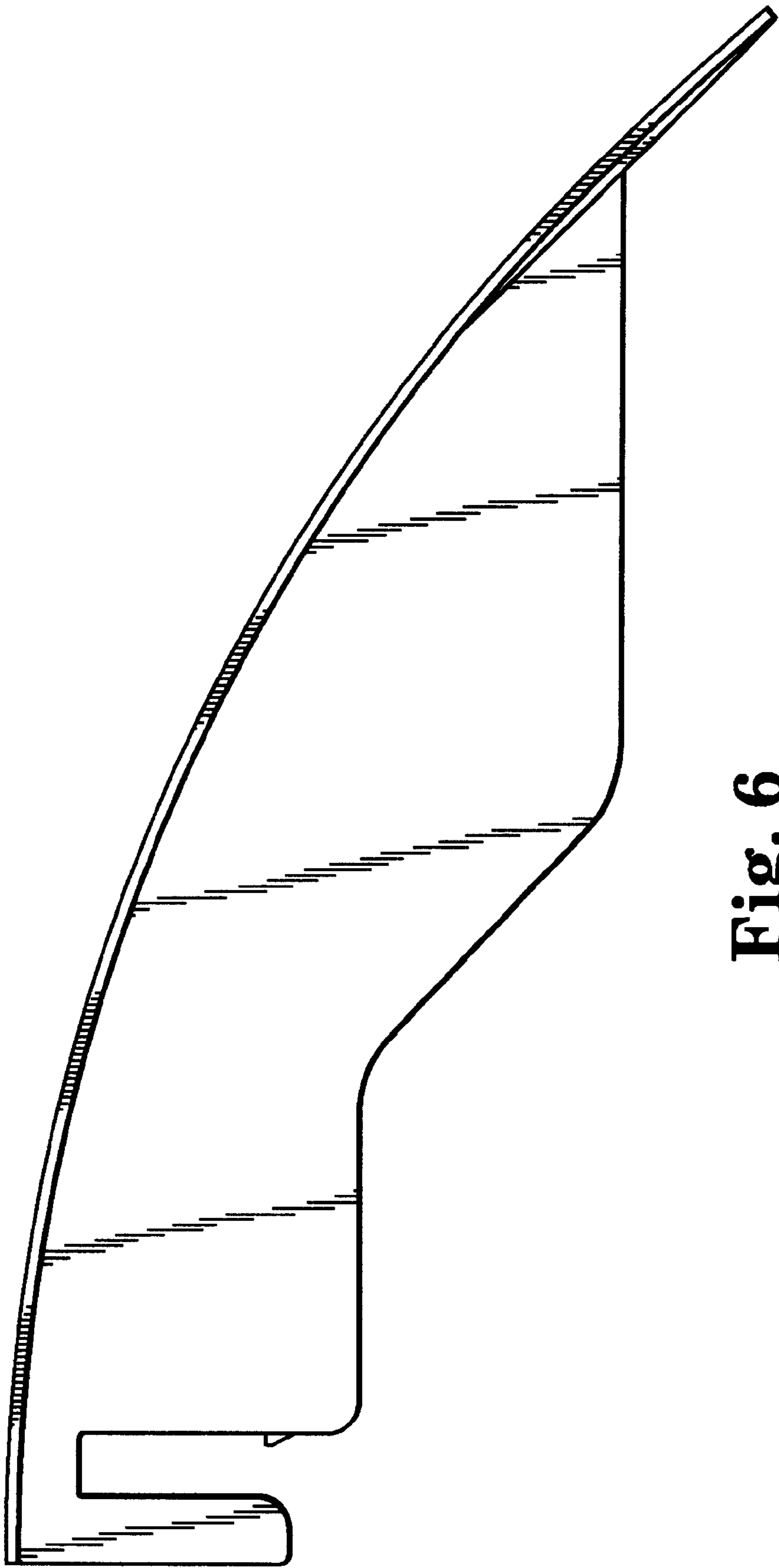

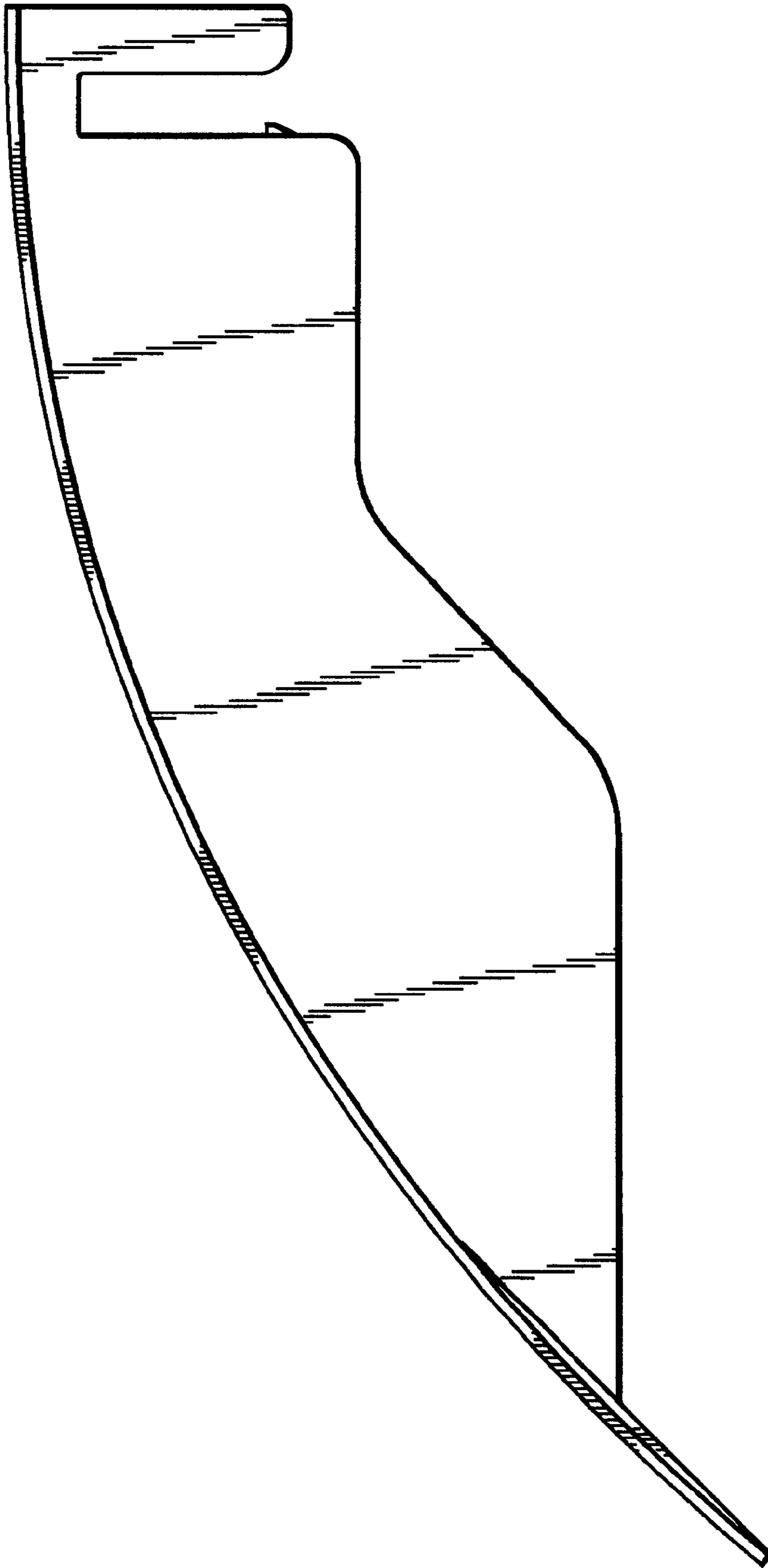
